invention;

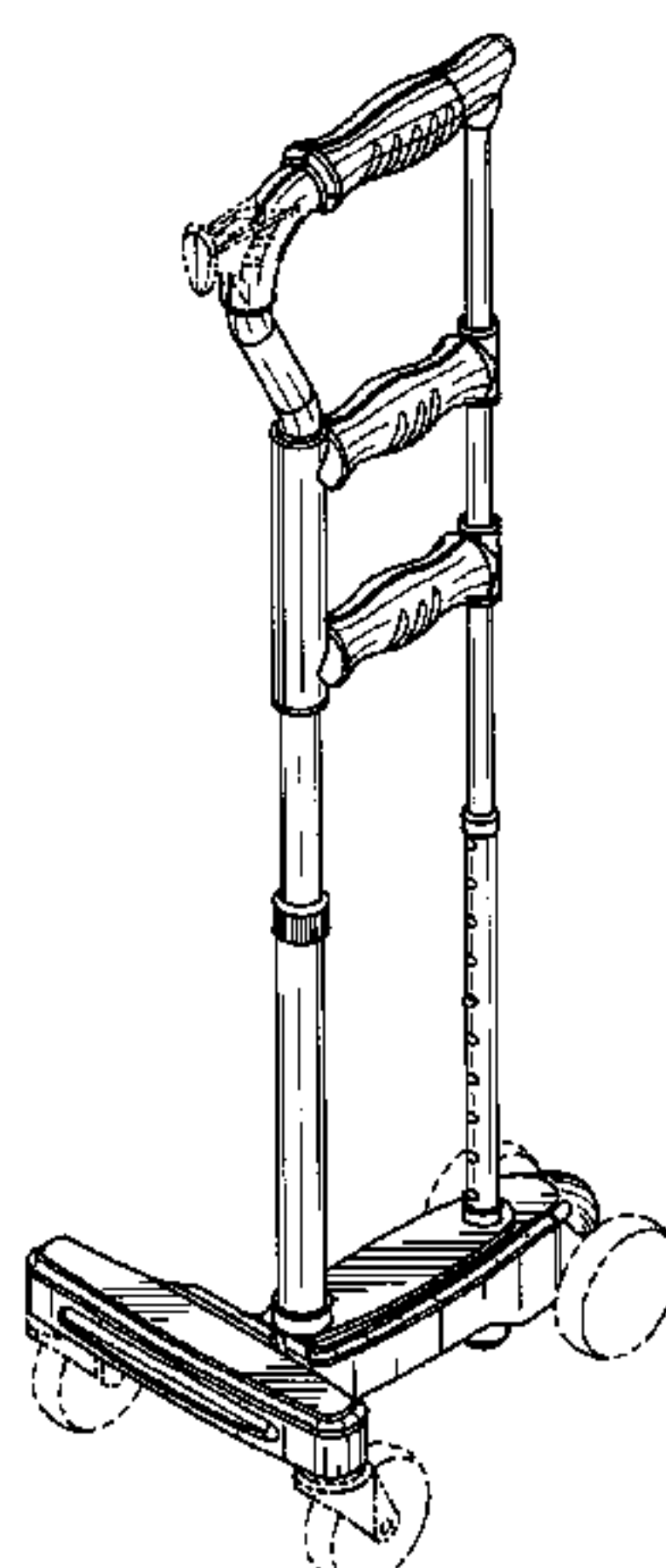
FIG. 2 is a front view of a cane;

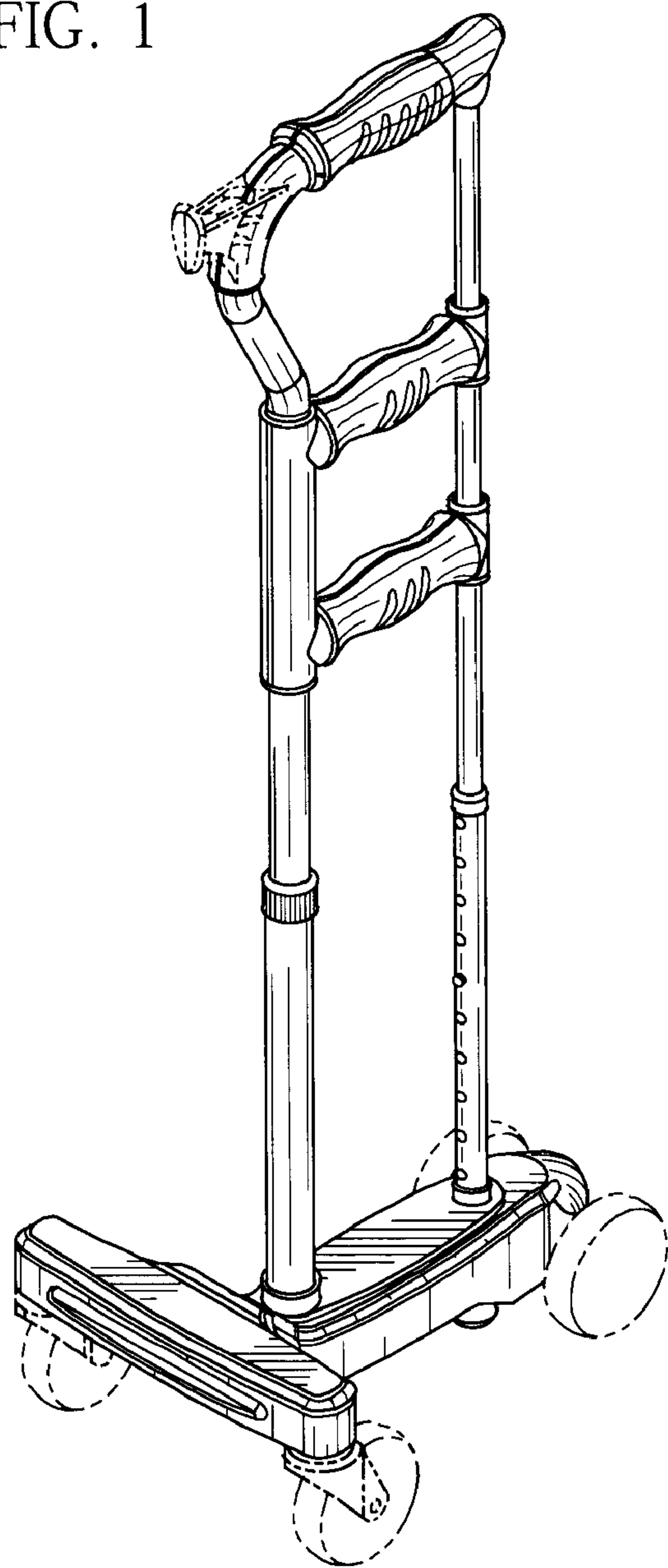

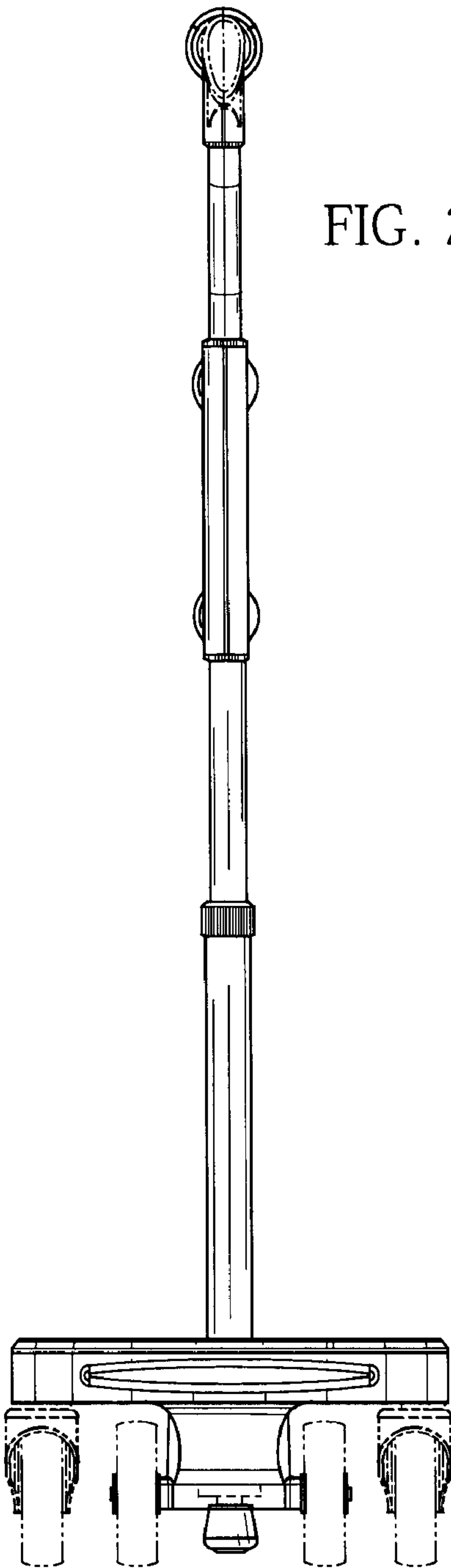

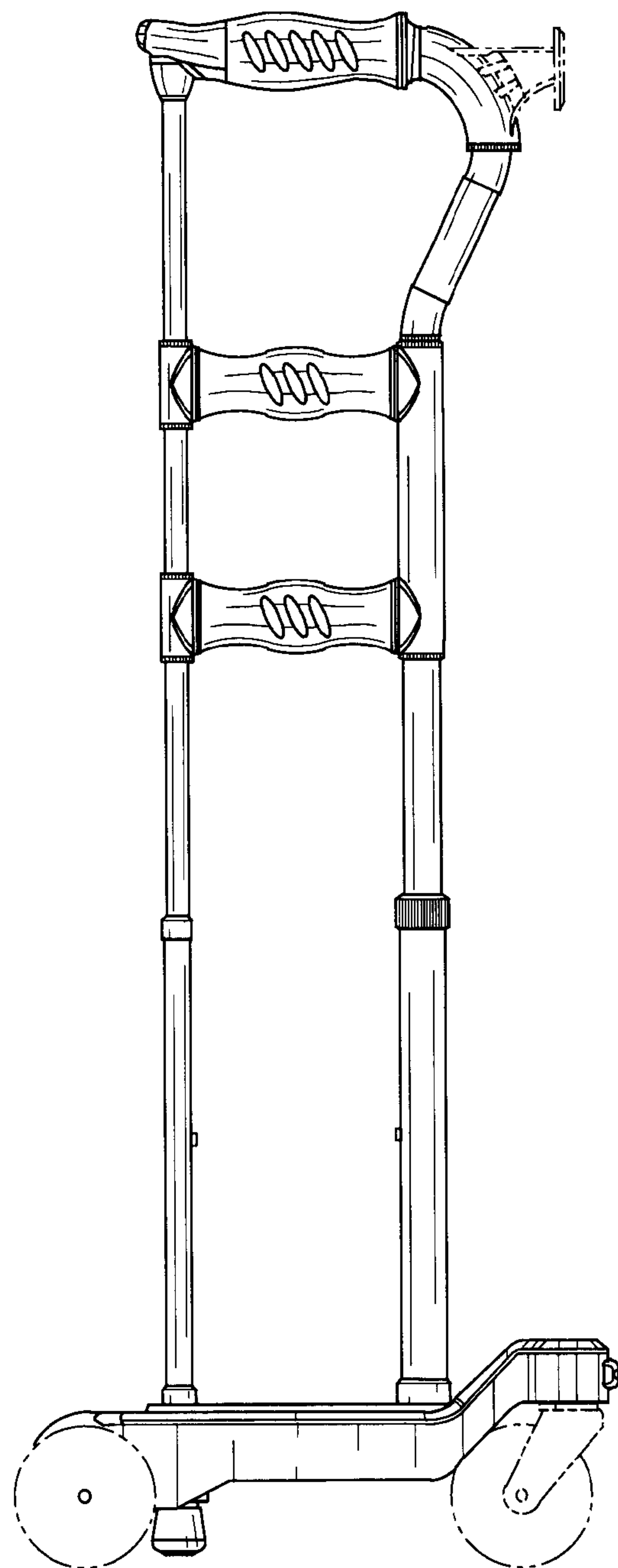
