FIG. 5 is a front view of a vehicle seat according to a second embodiment of my design;

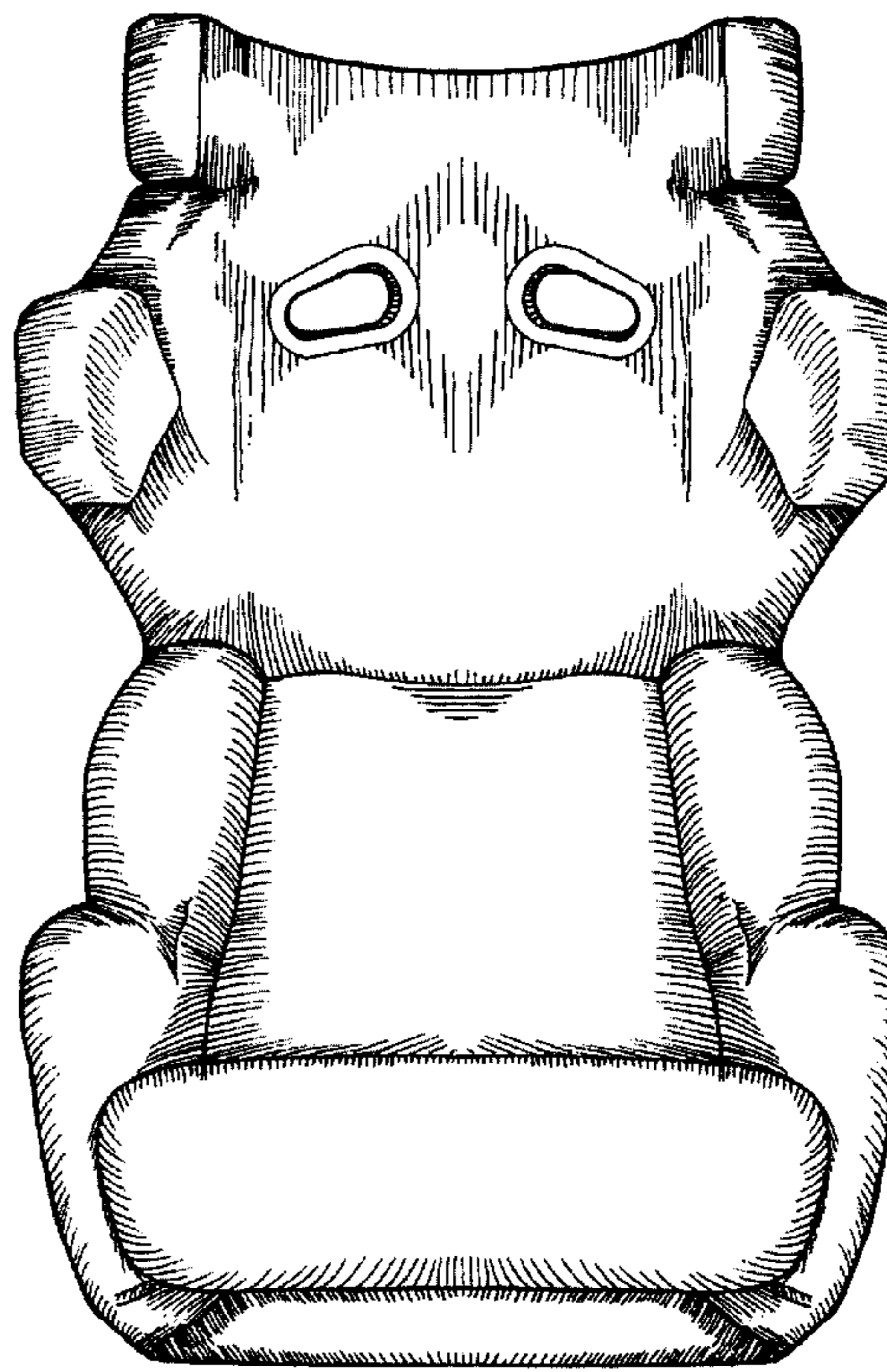
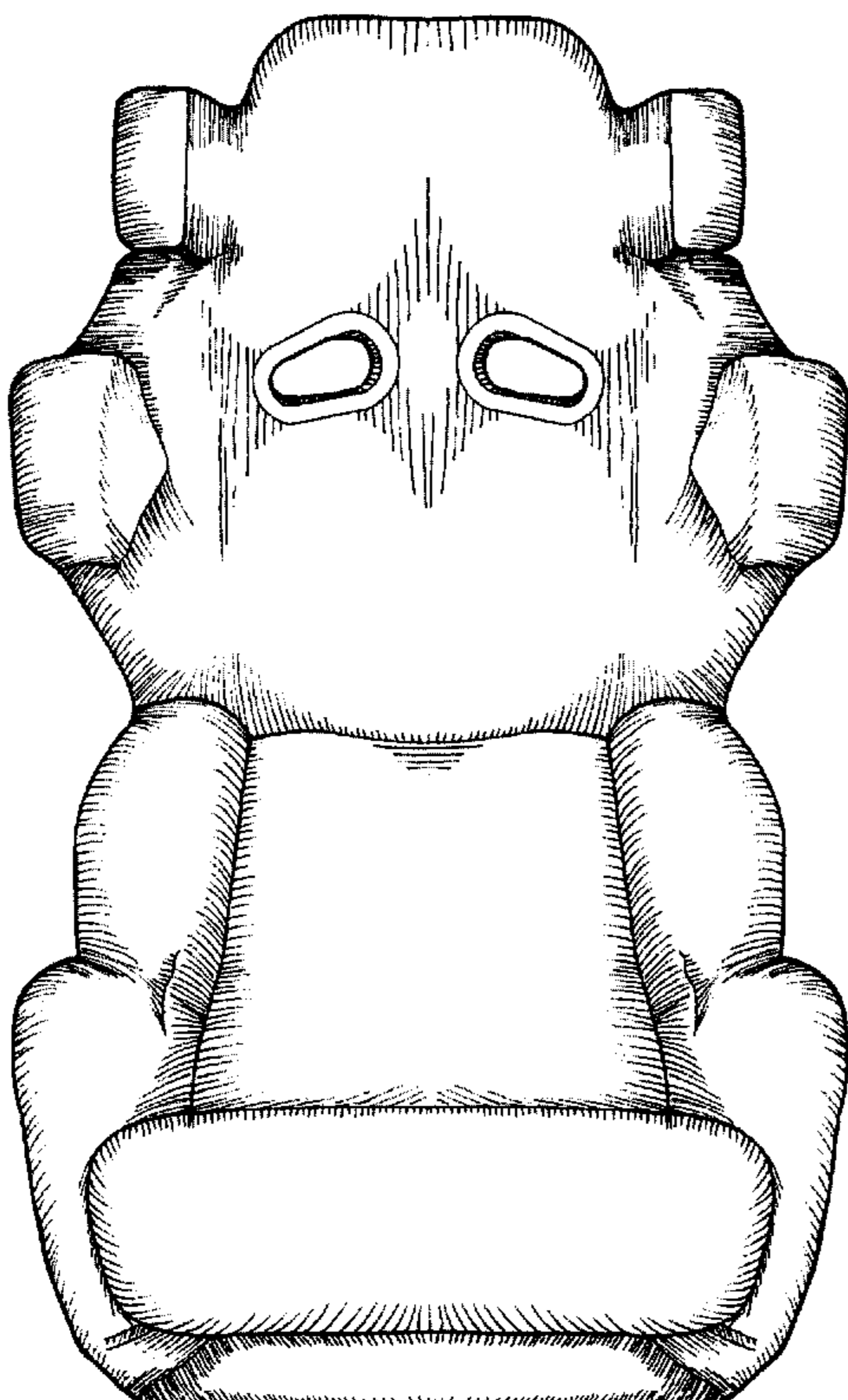
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof;

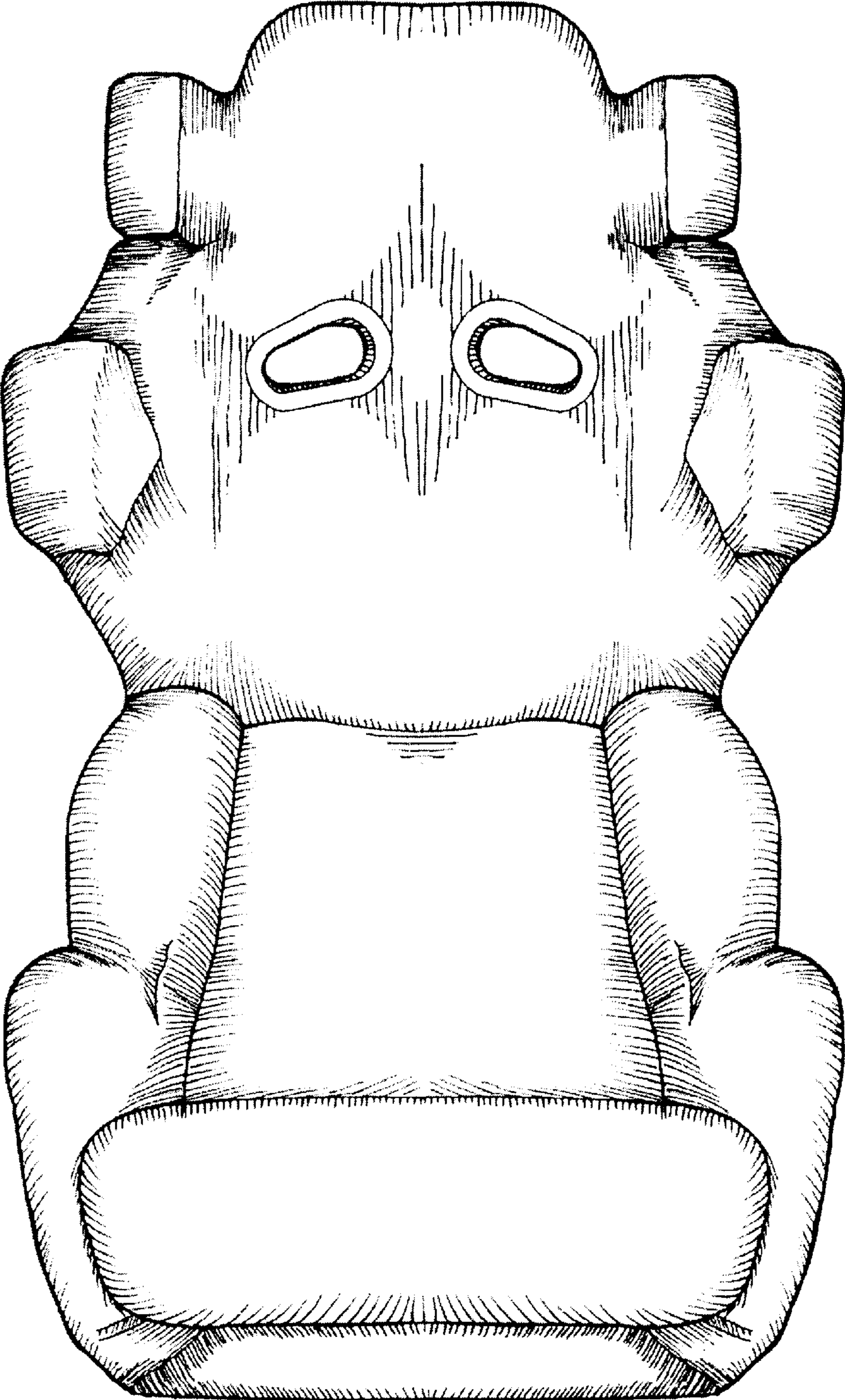

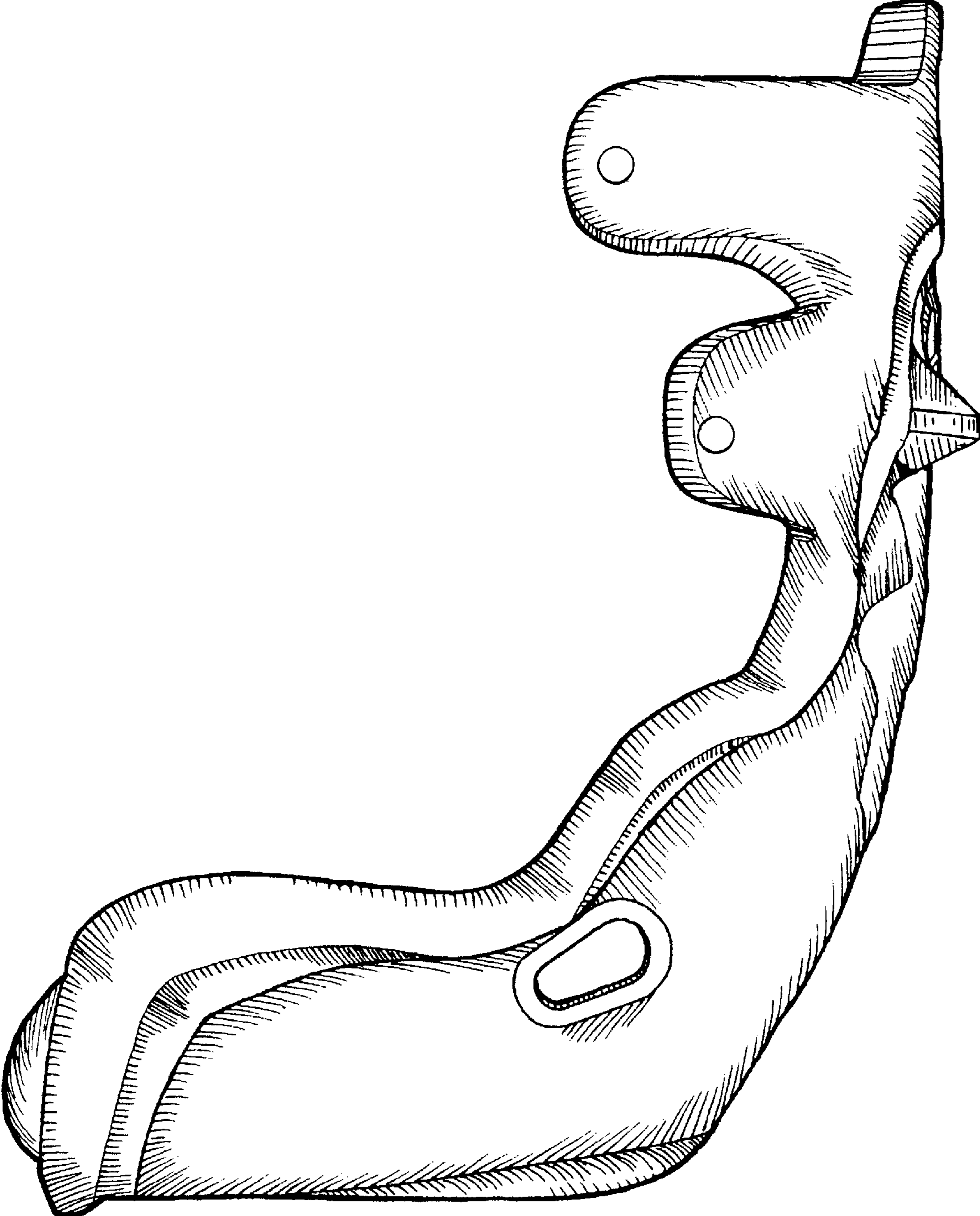

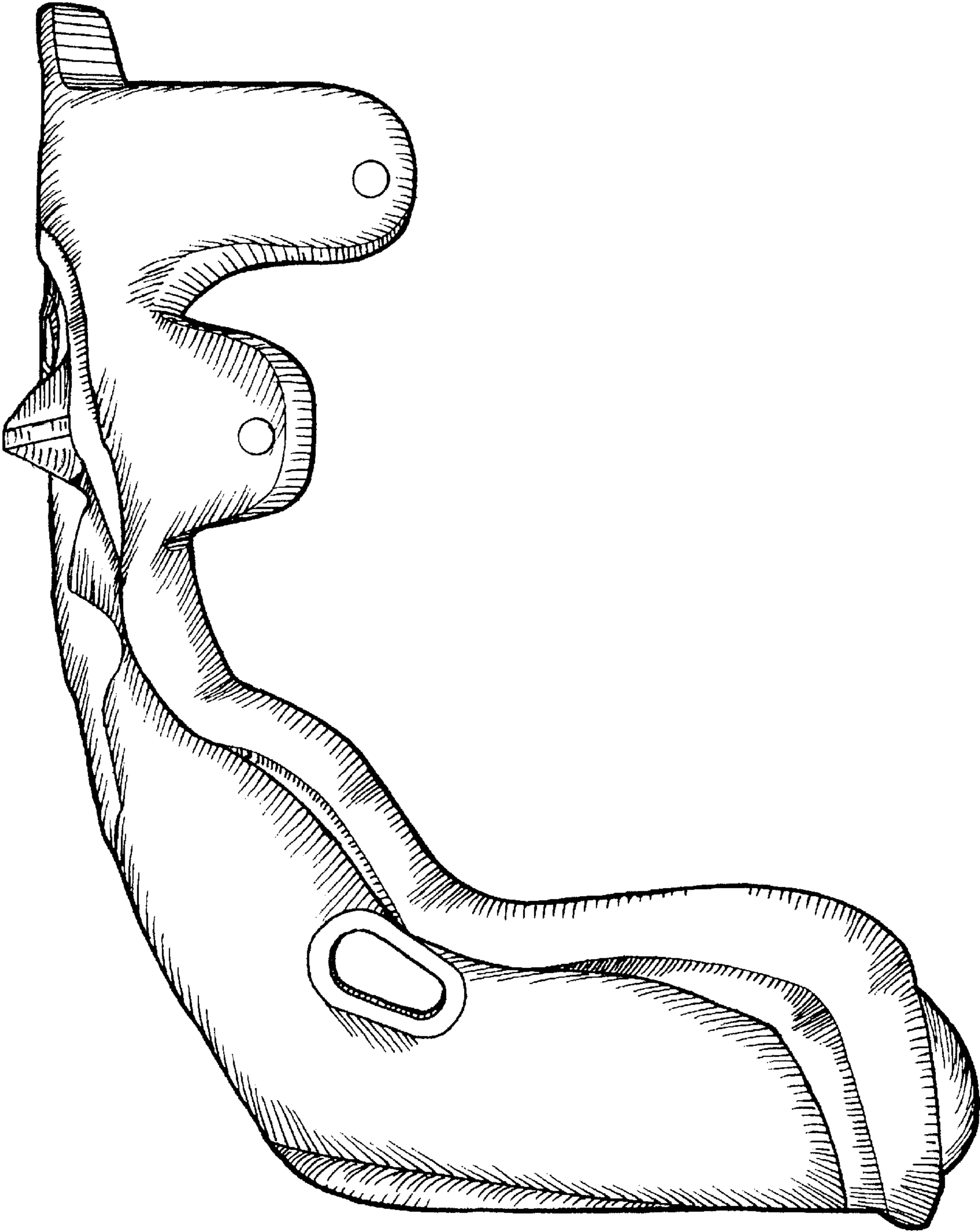

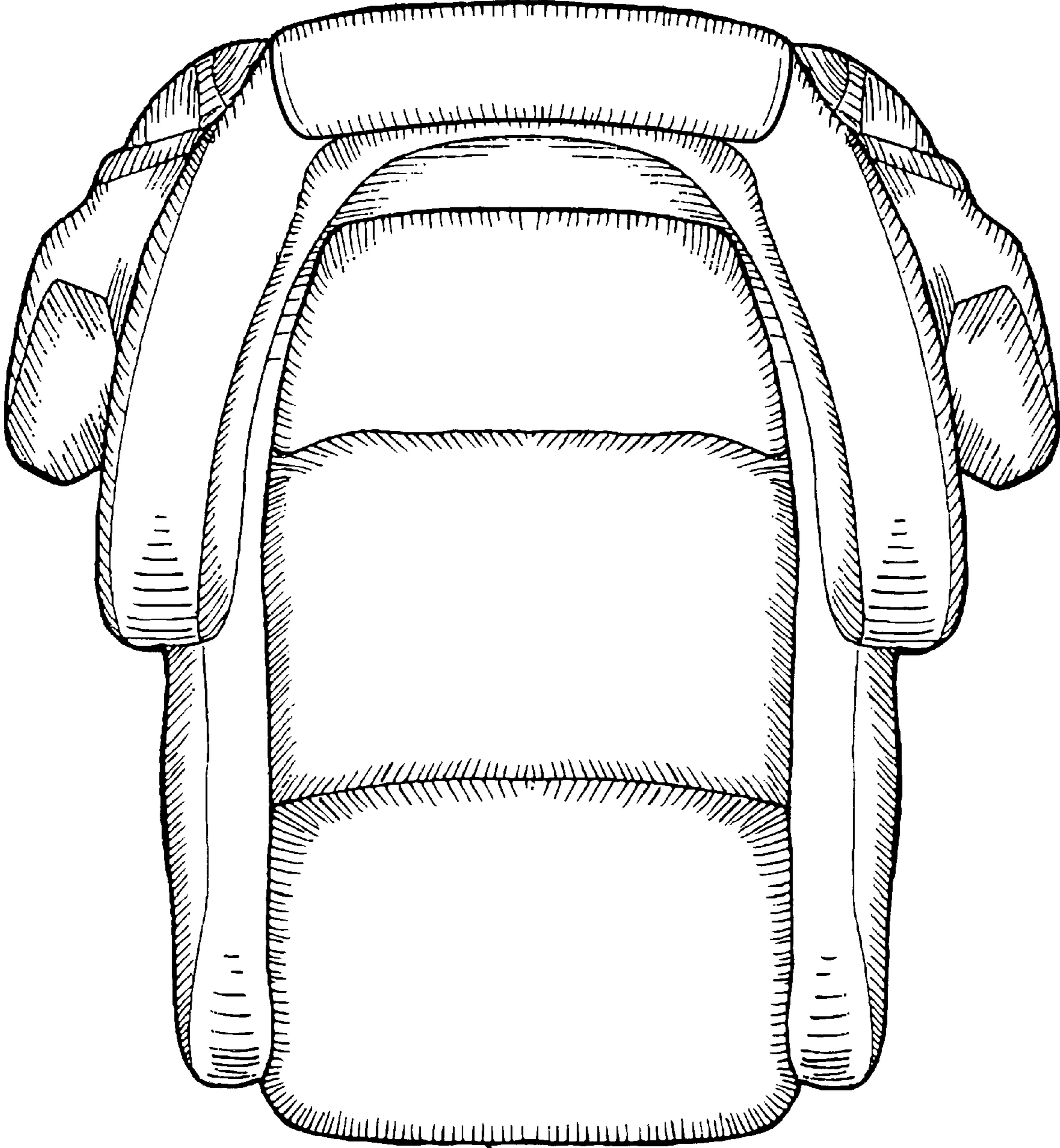

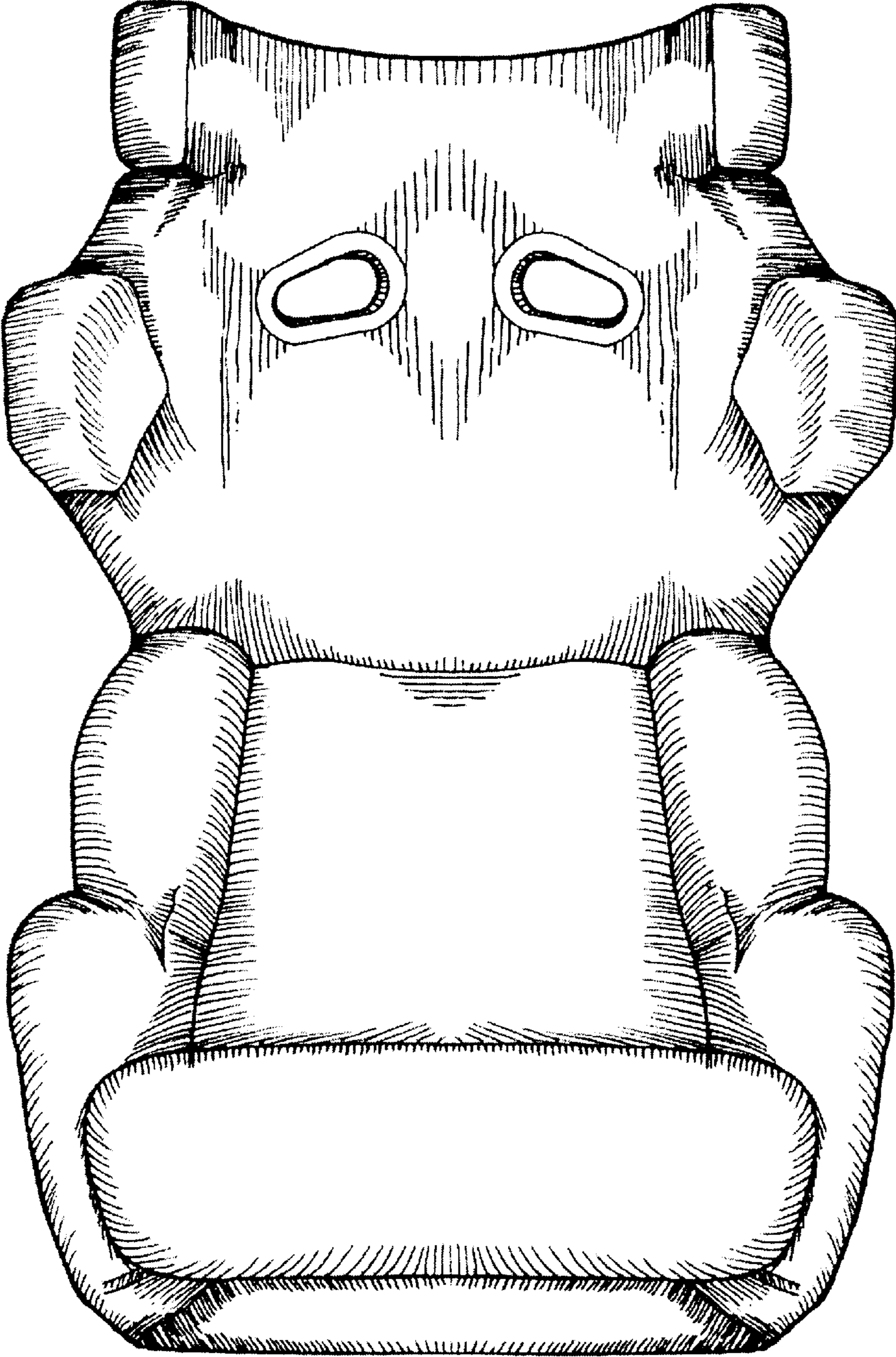

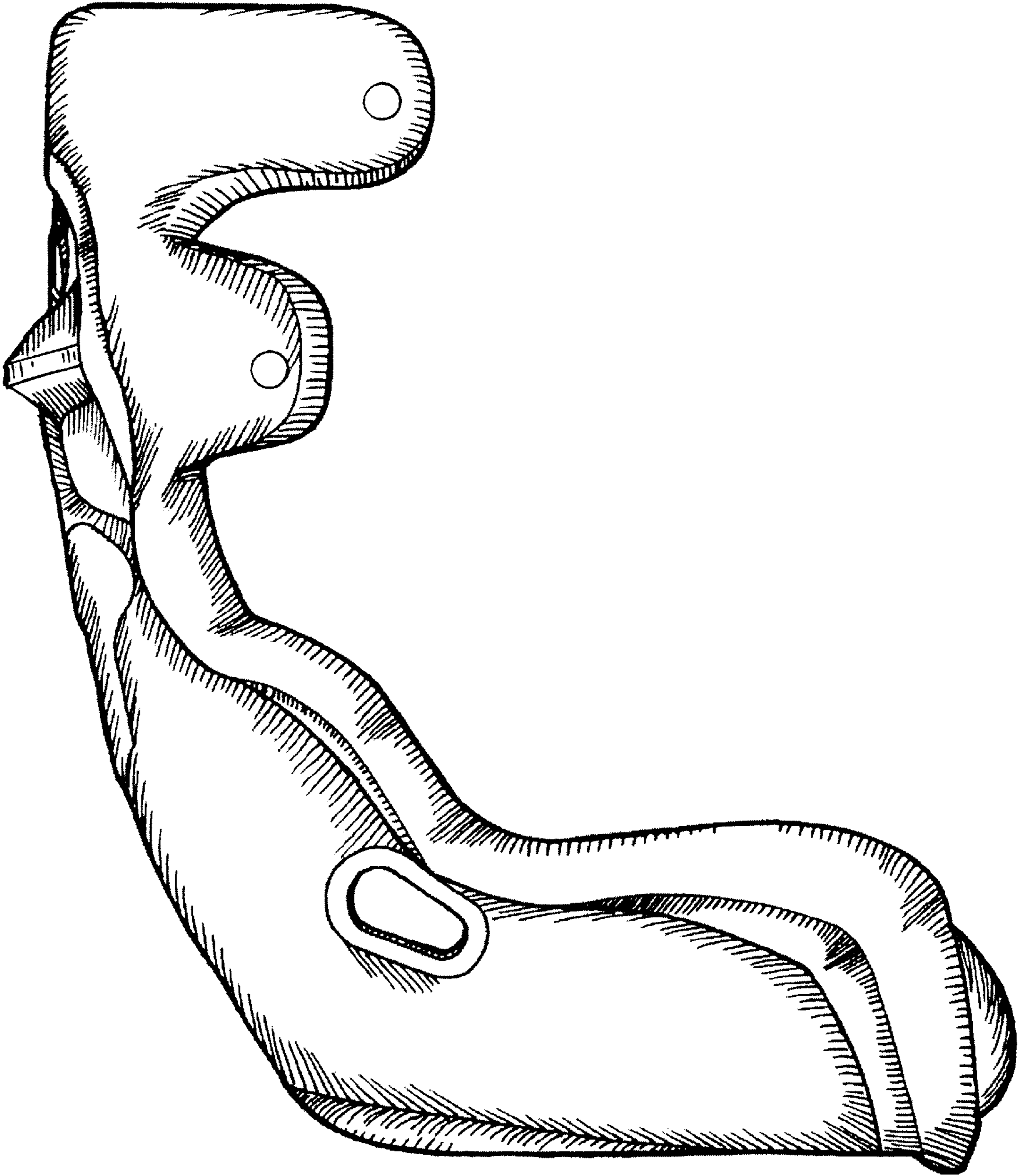

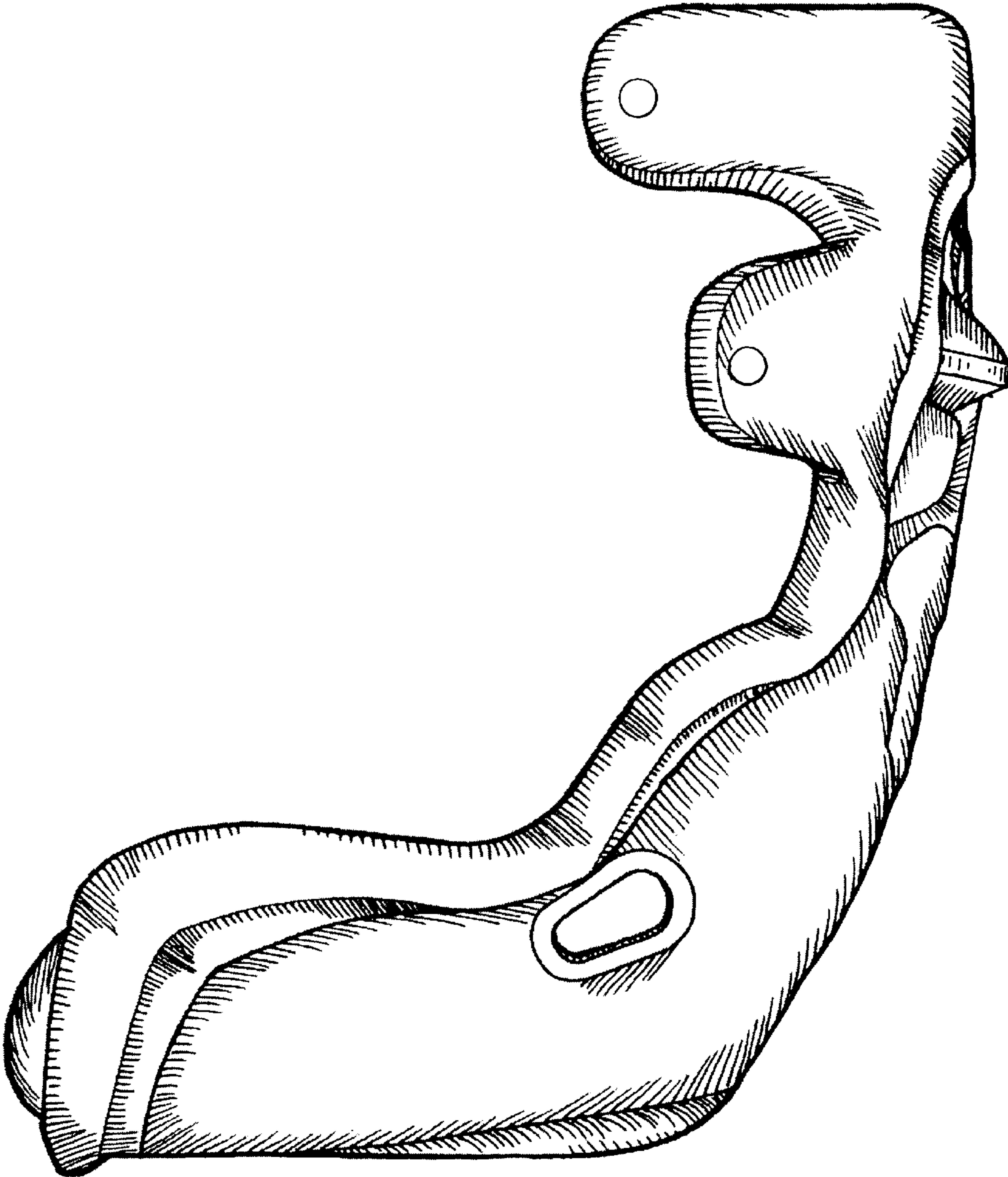

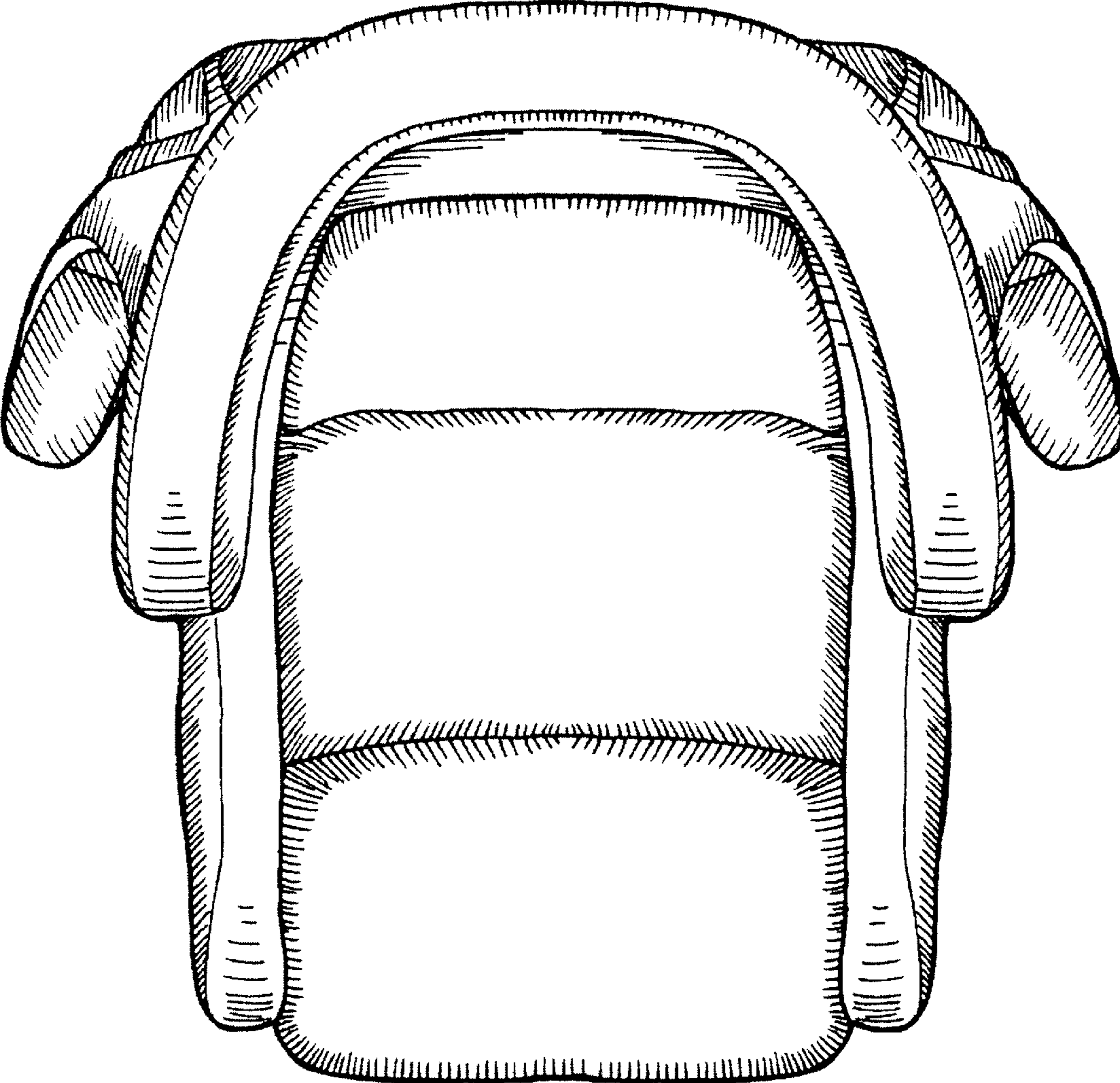
