(57) **CLAIM**

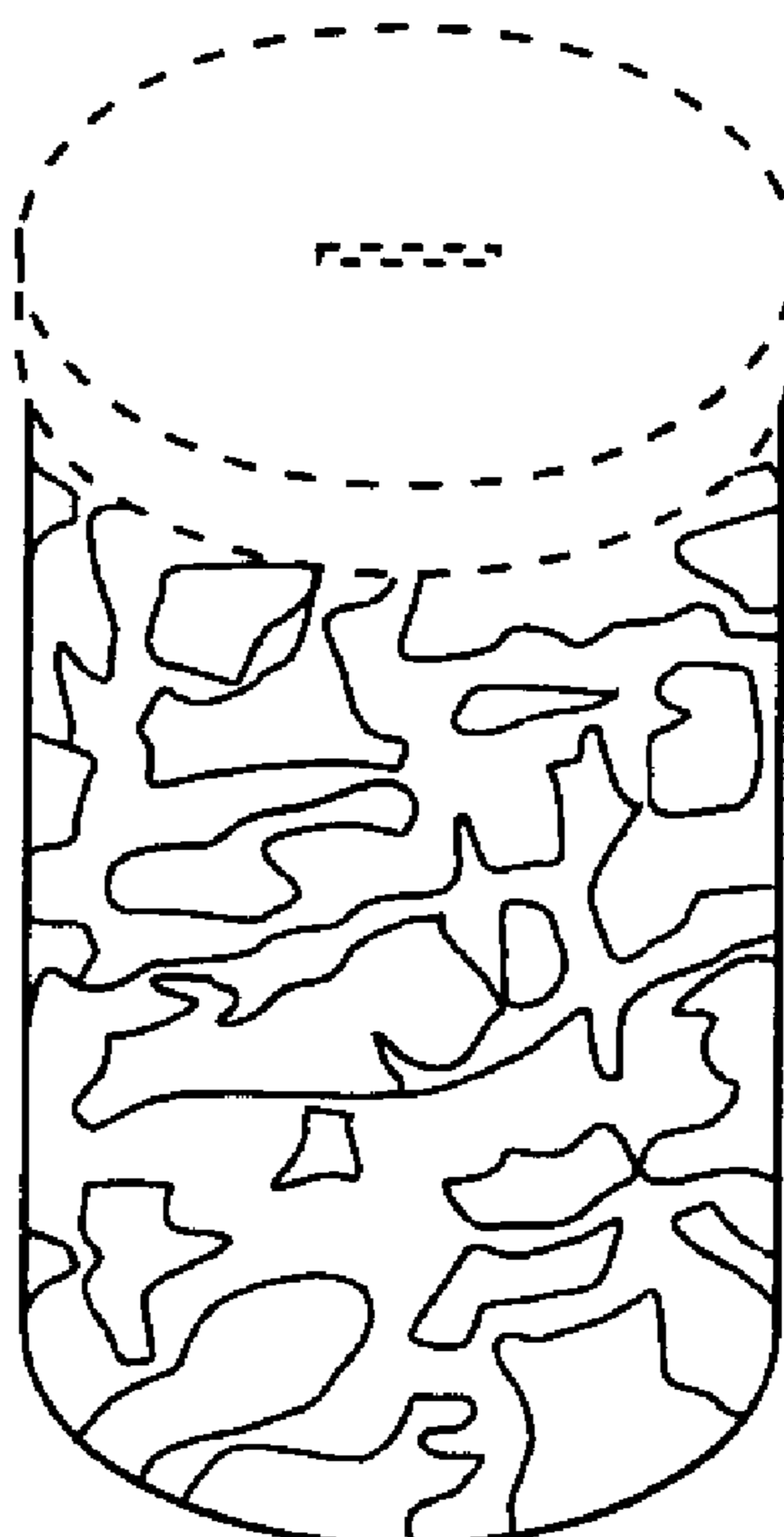
The ornamental design for a container for pre-moistened field towels, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

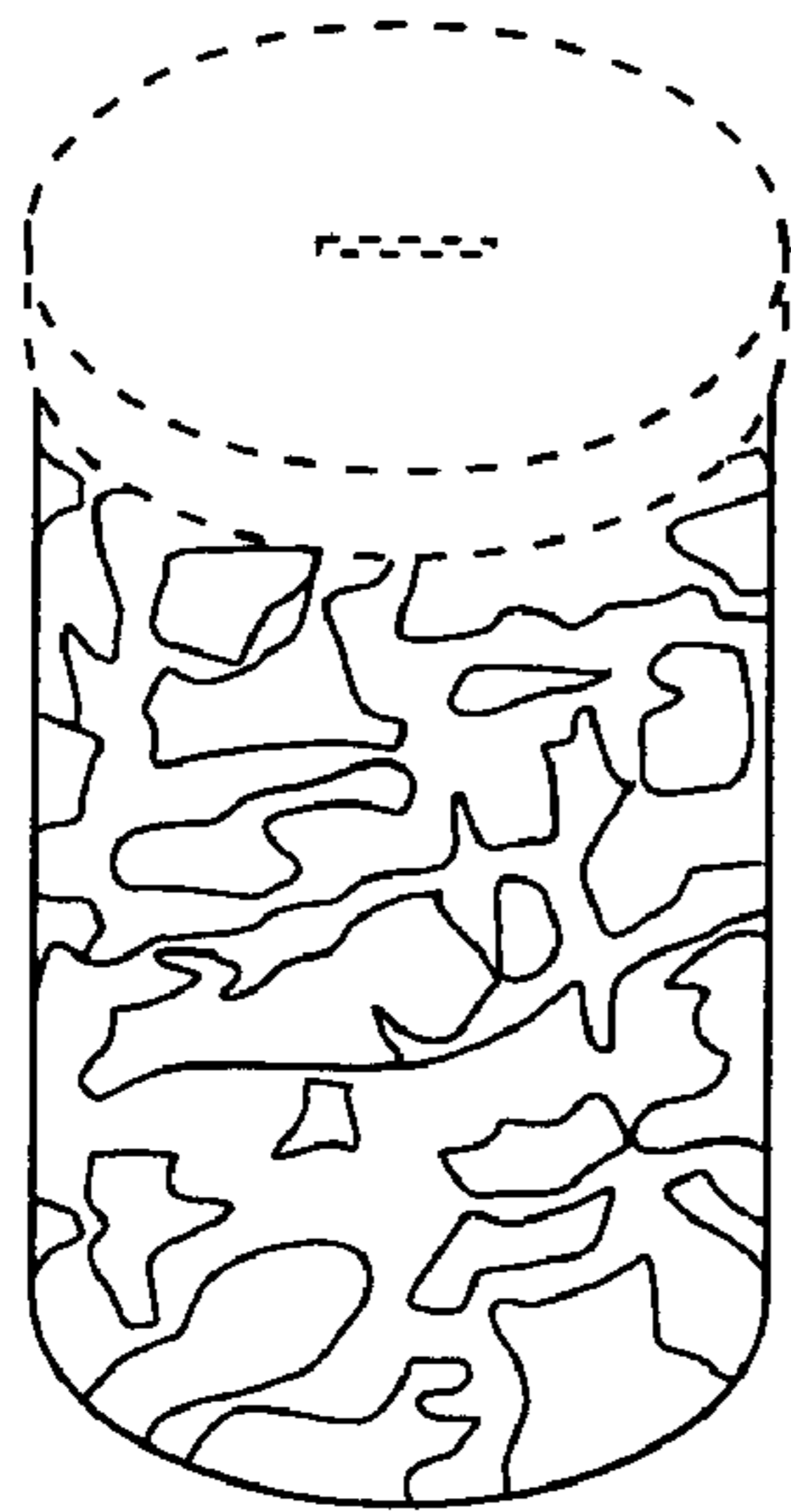

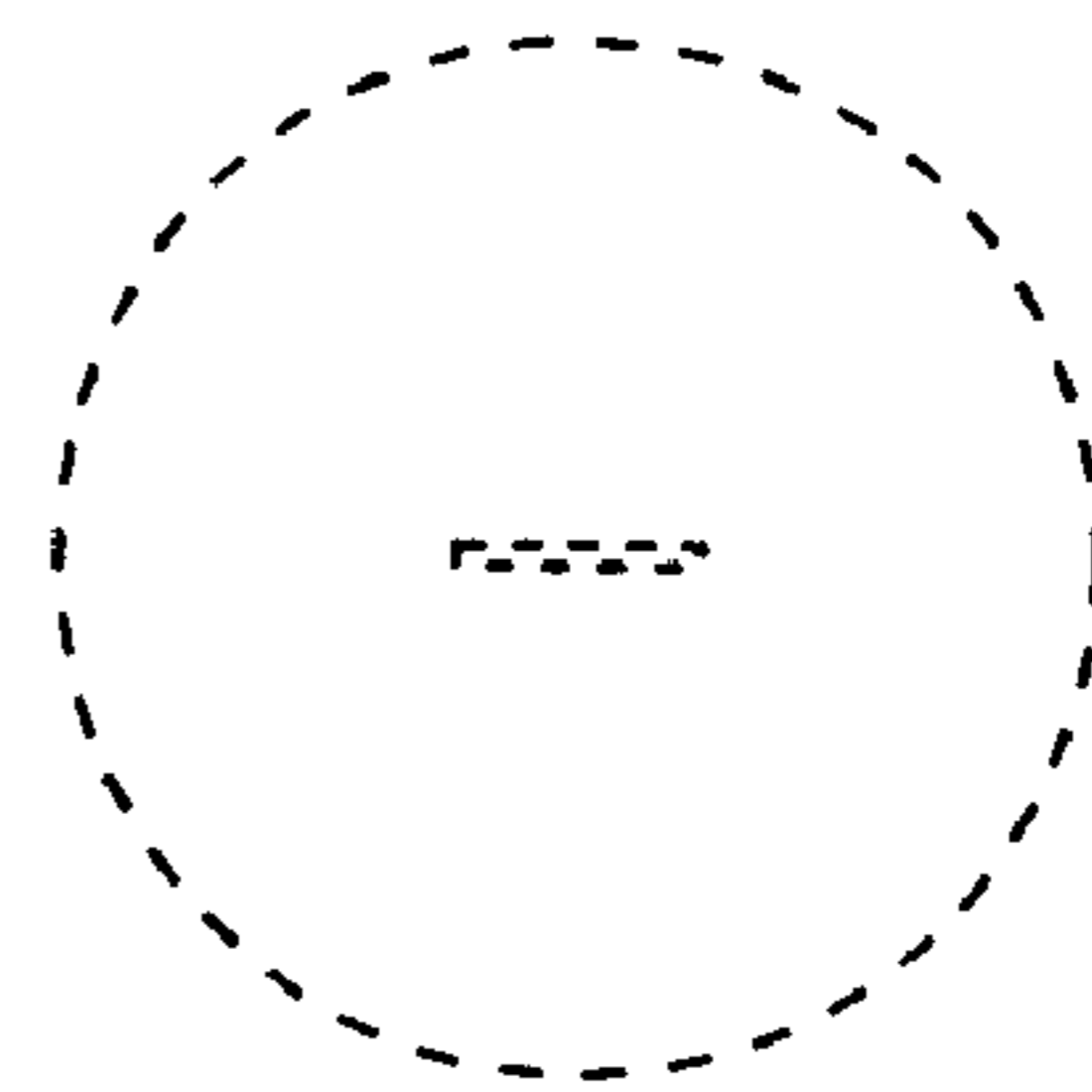

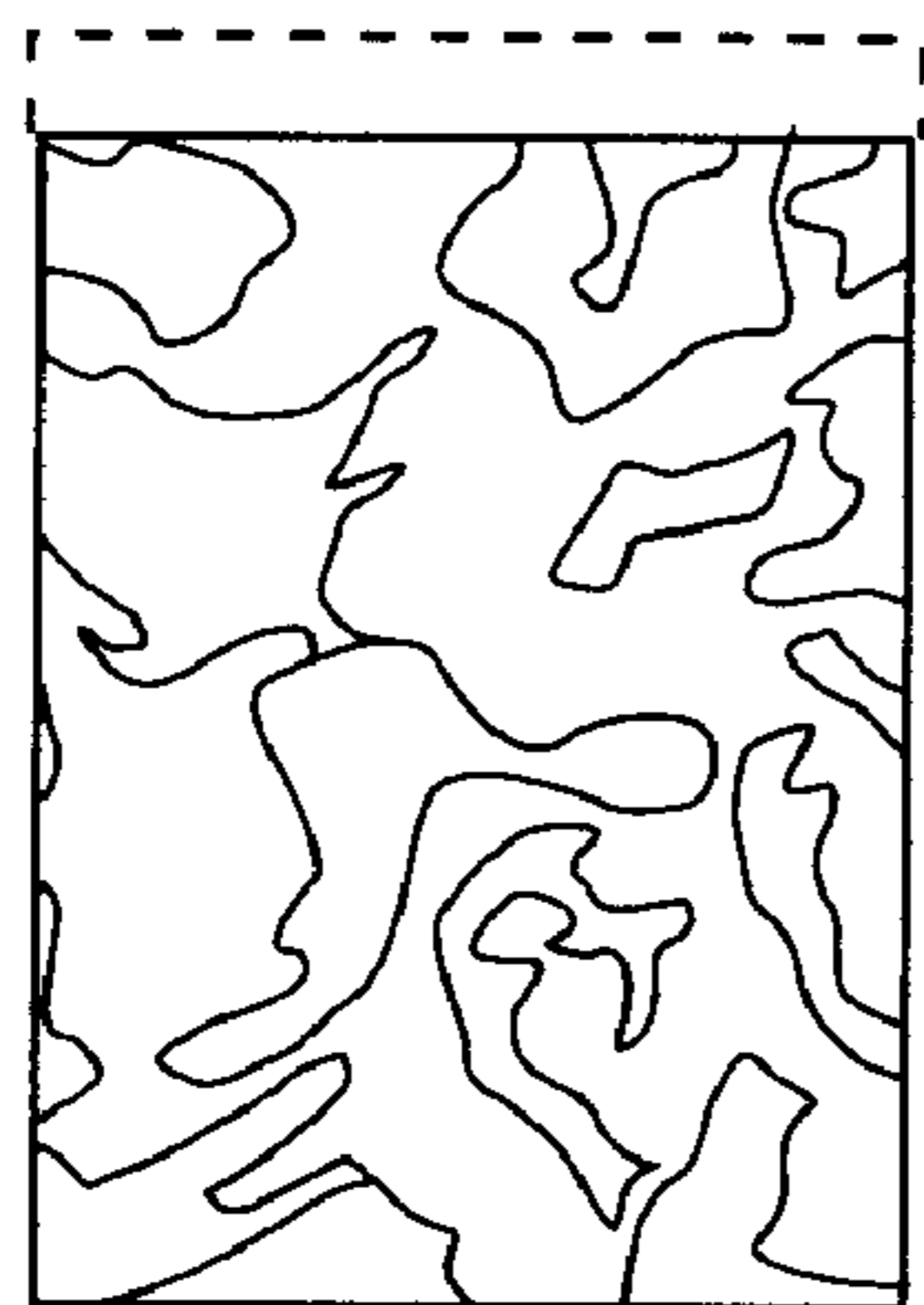

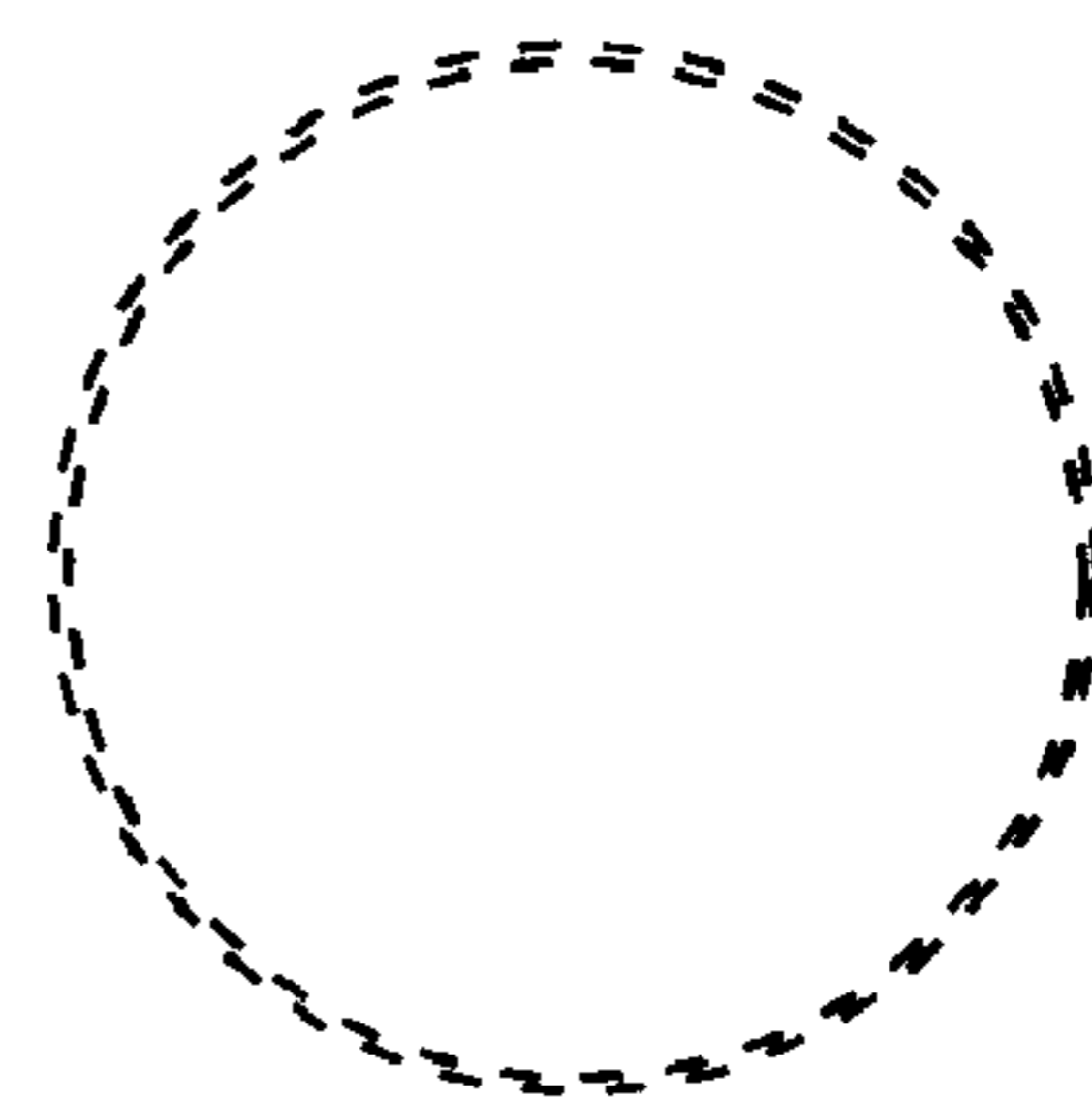
