The ornamental design for a golf ball placement and retrieval device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf ball placement and retrieval device;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the design illustrated in FIG. 1;

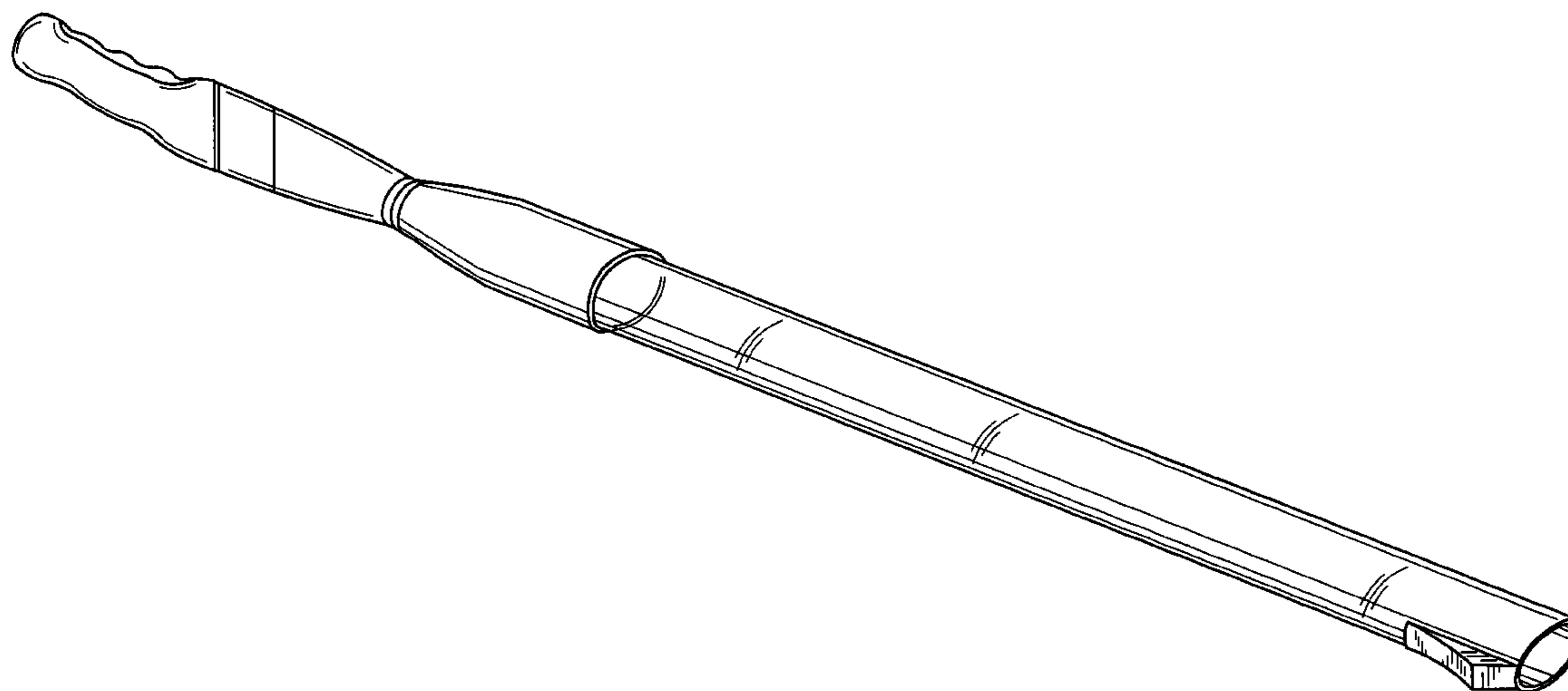
FIG. 3 is a left elevation view of the design illustrated in FIG. 1;

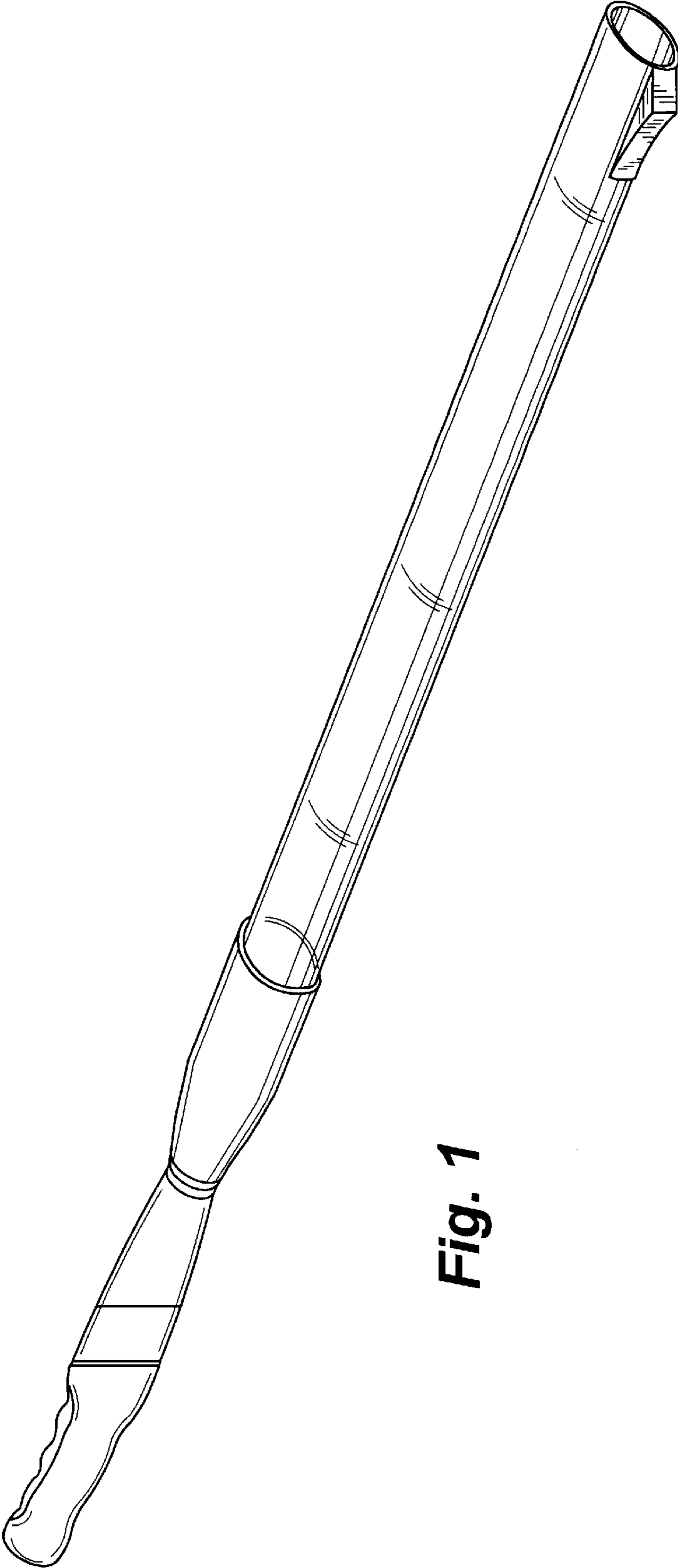

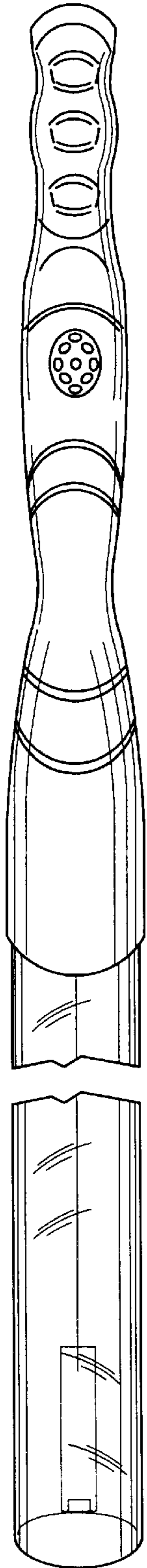

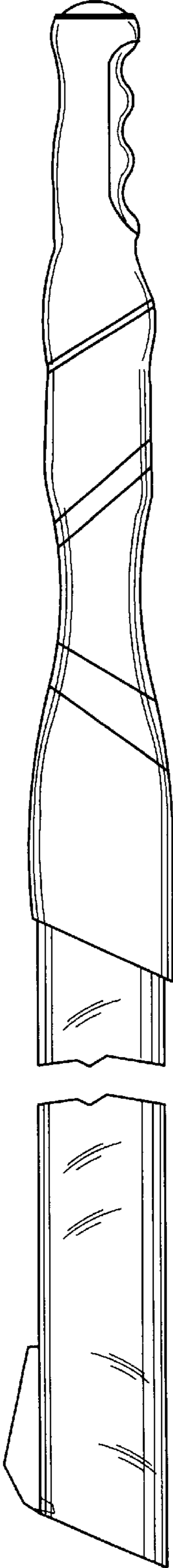

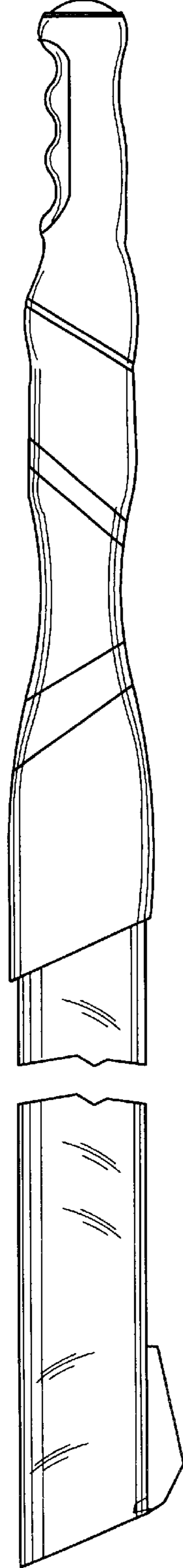

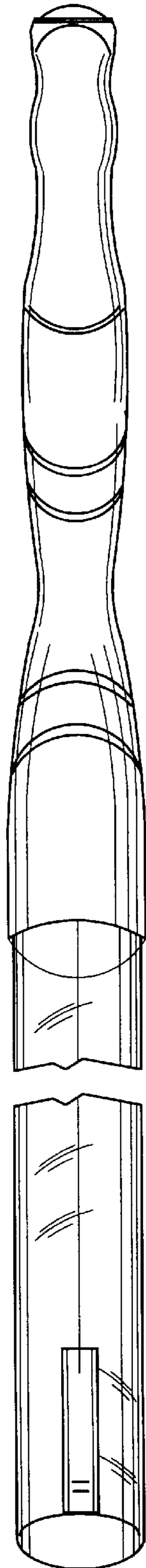
