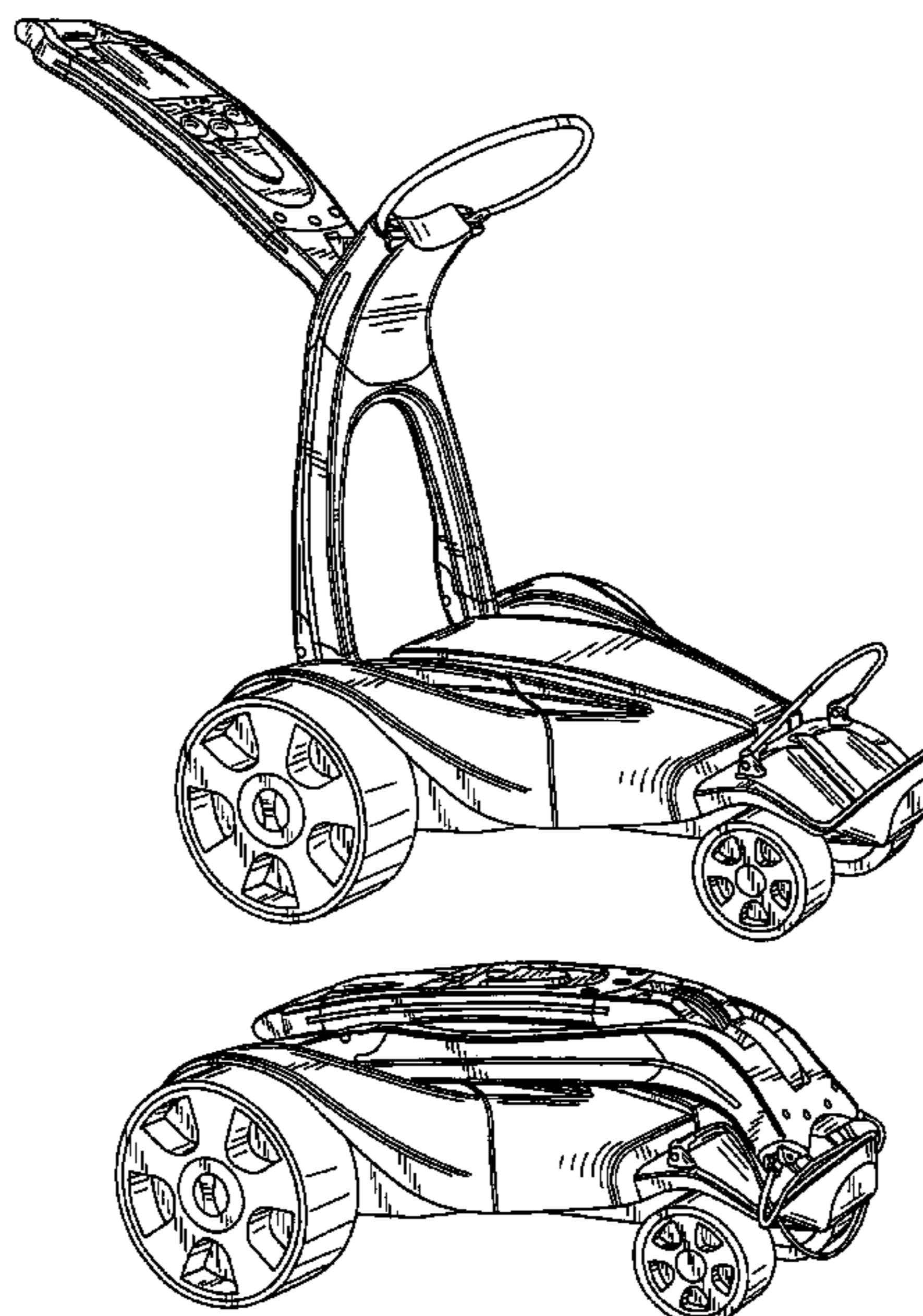
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the golf club caddie in a partially open form.

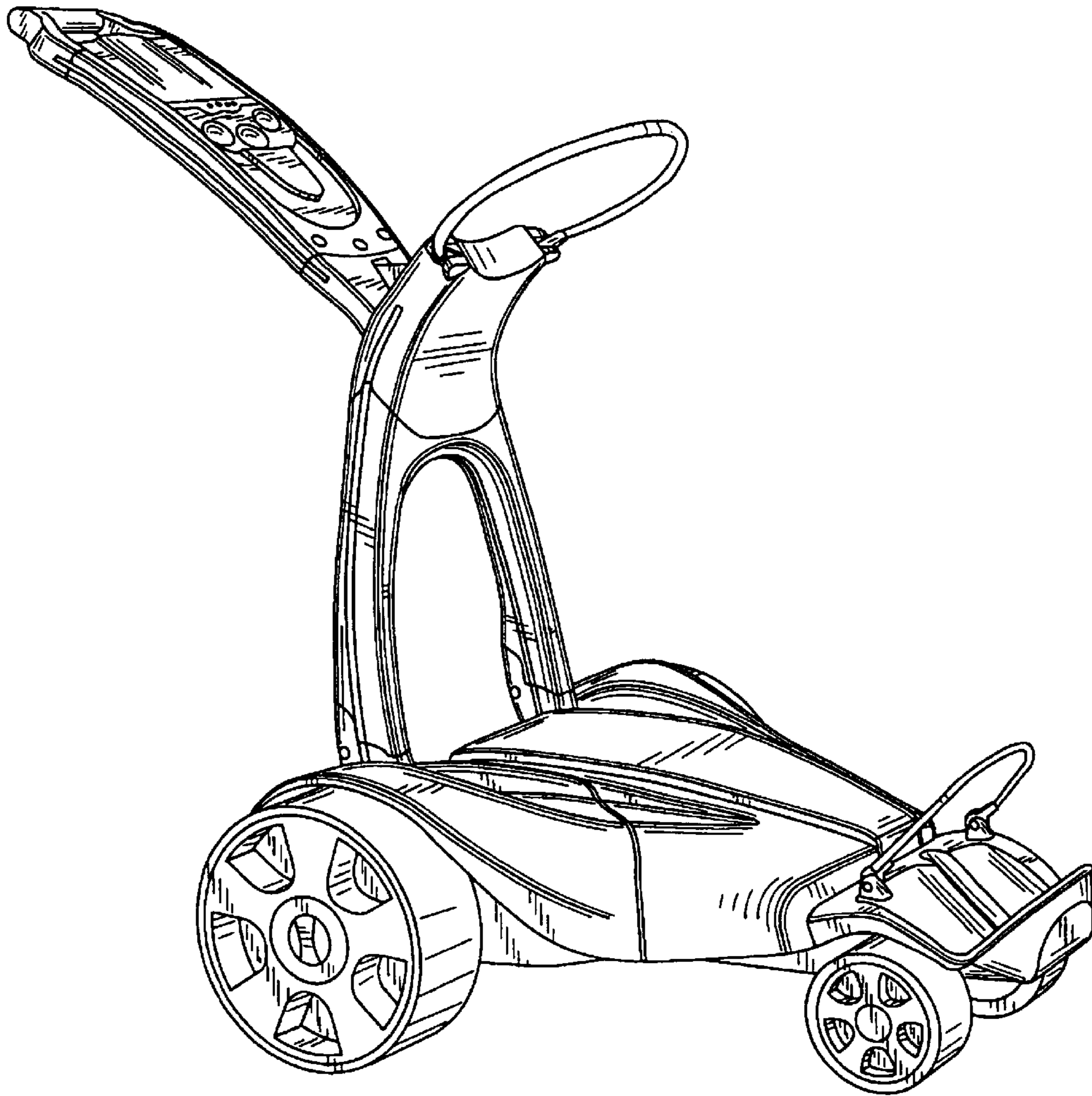

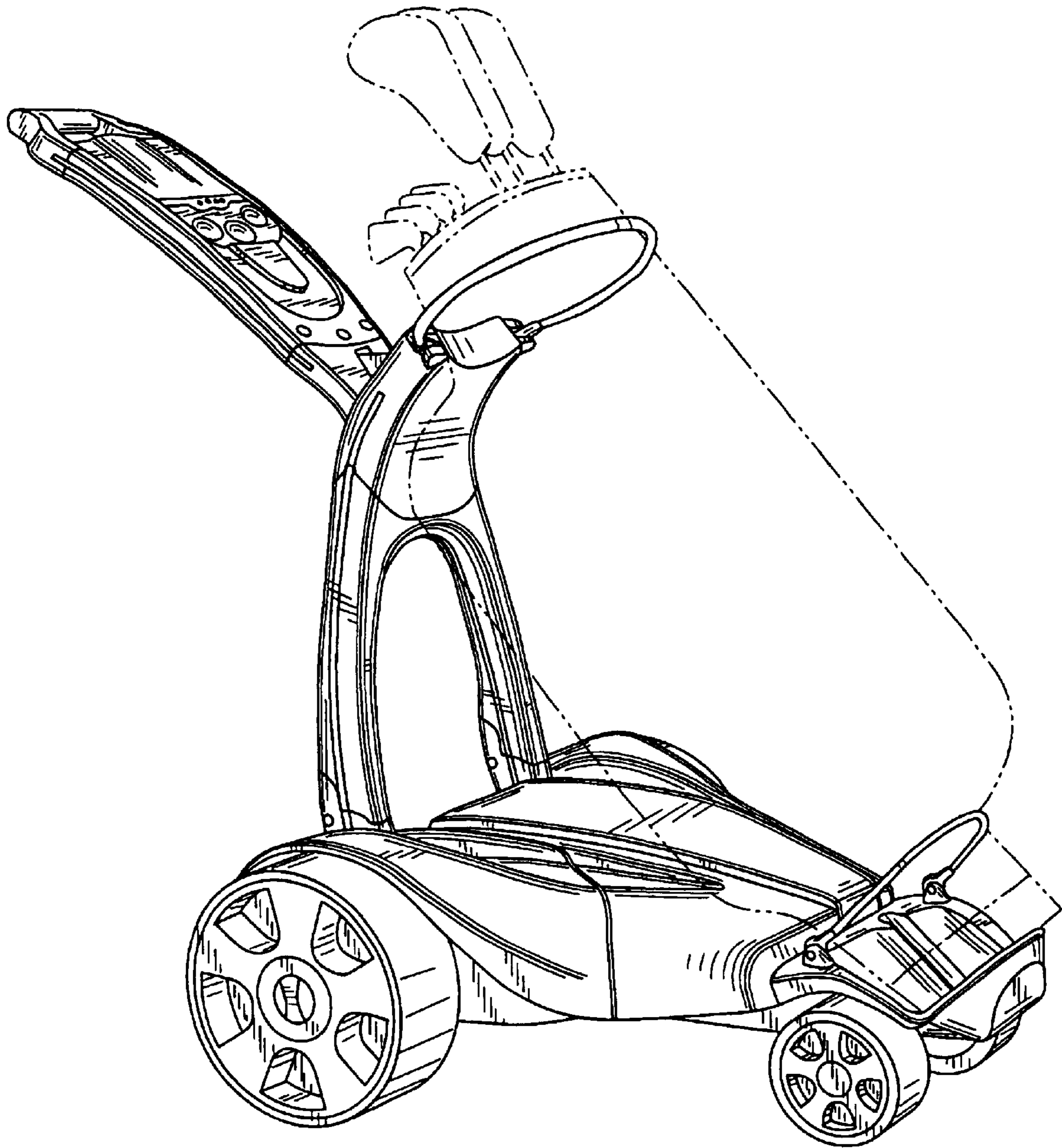

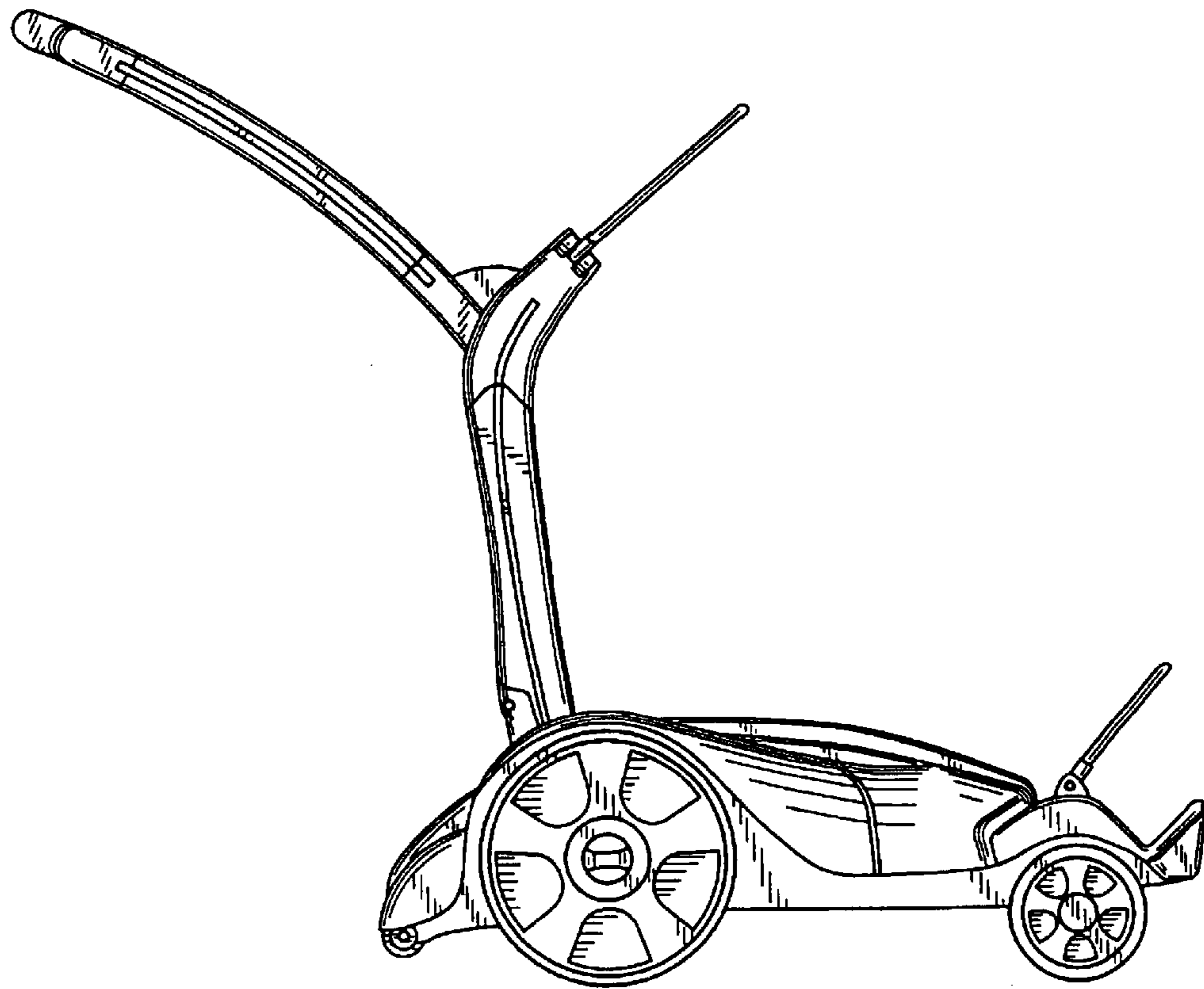

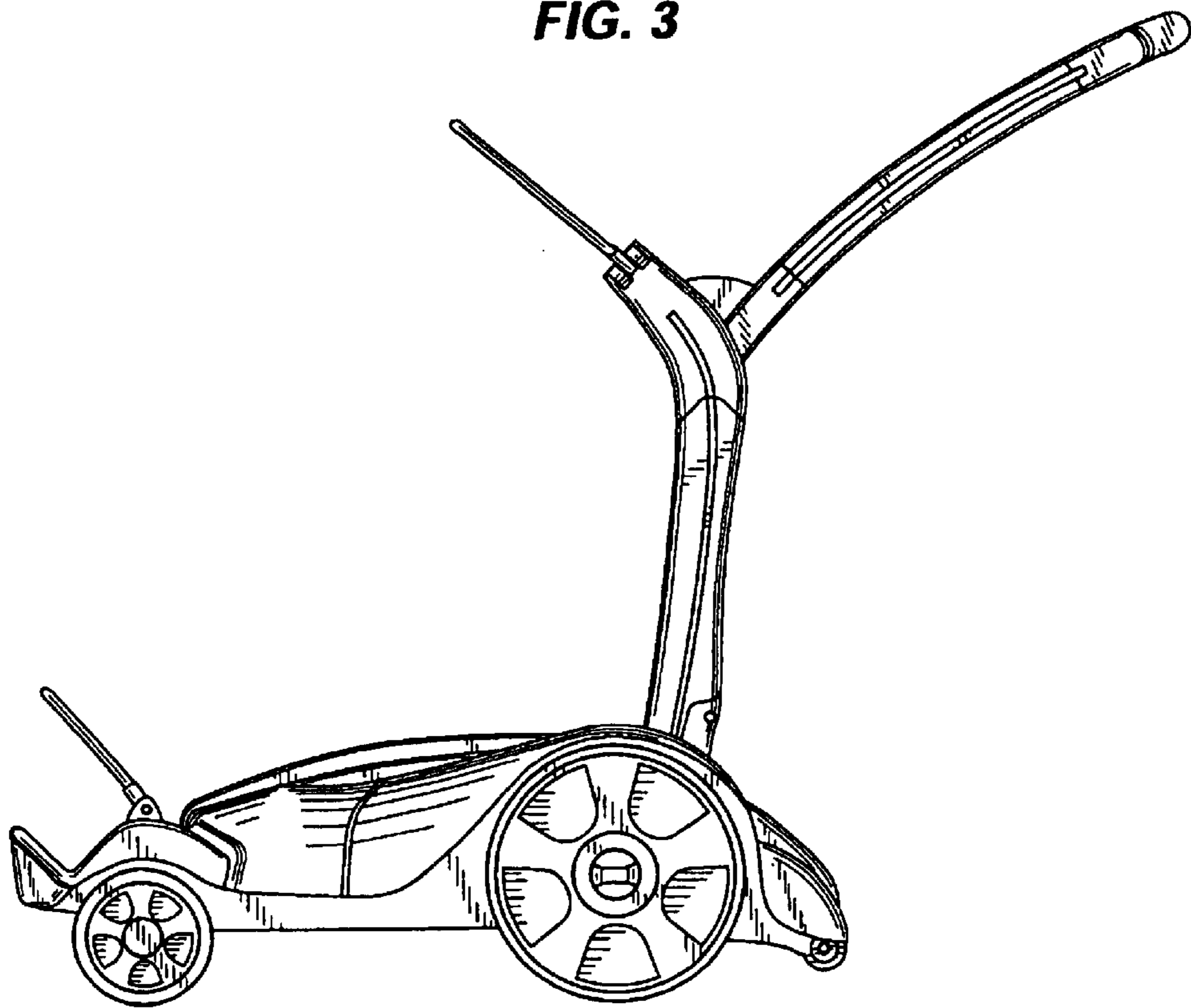

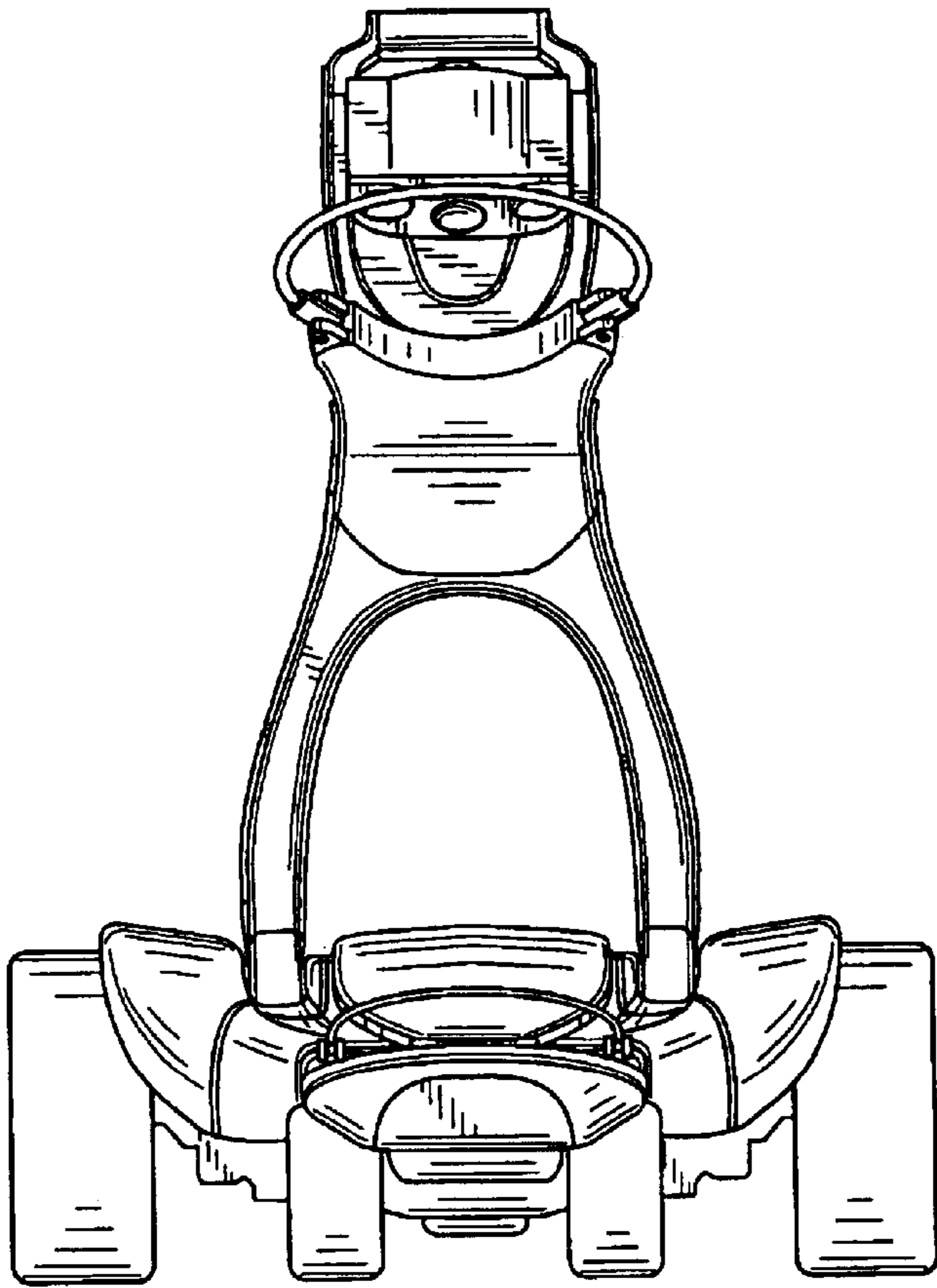

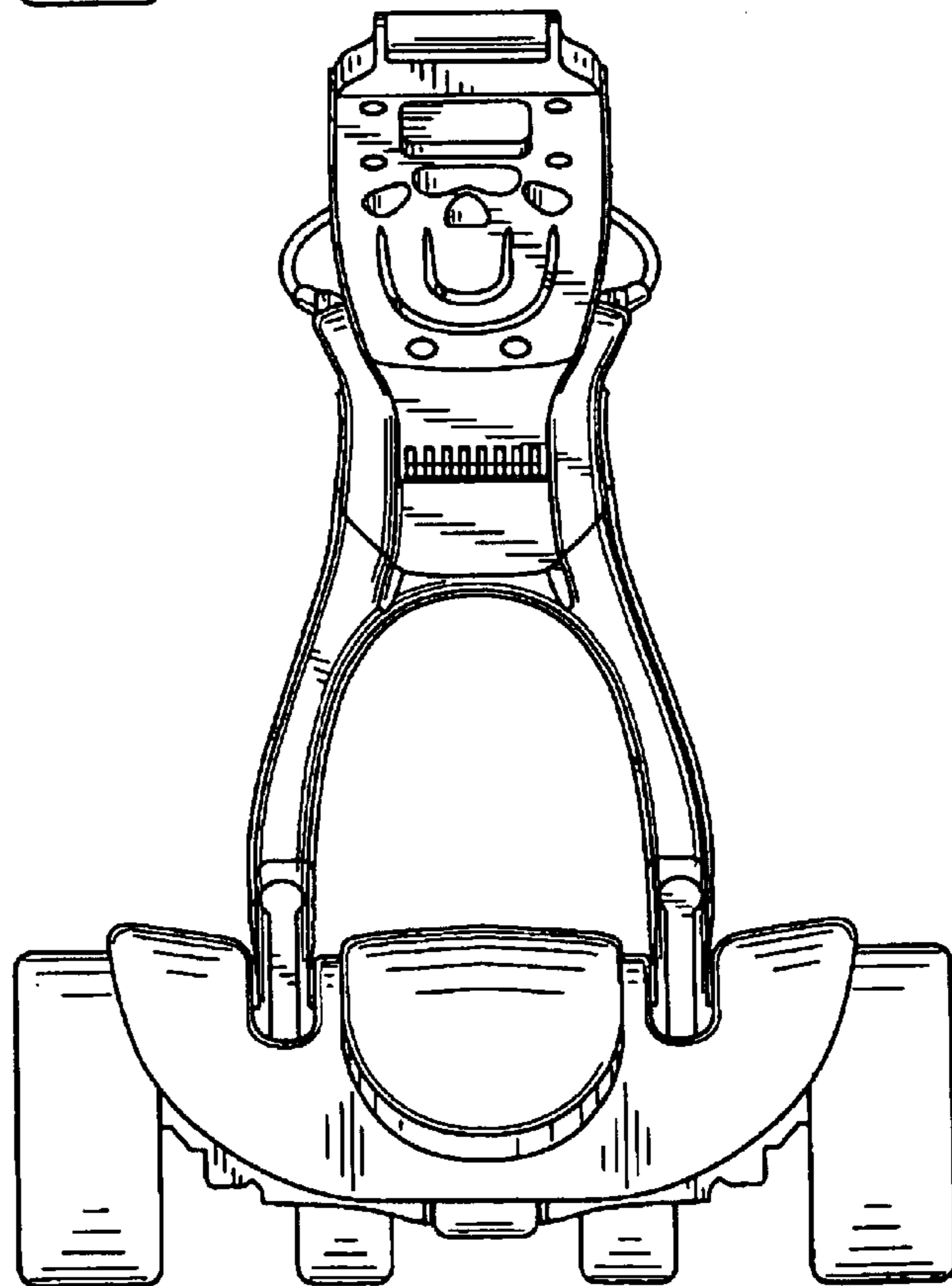

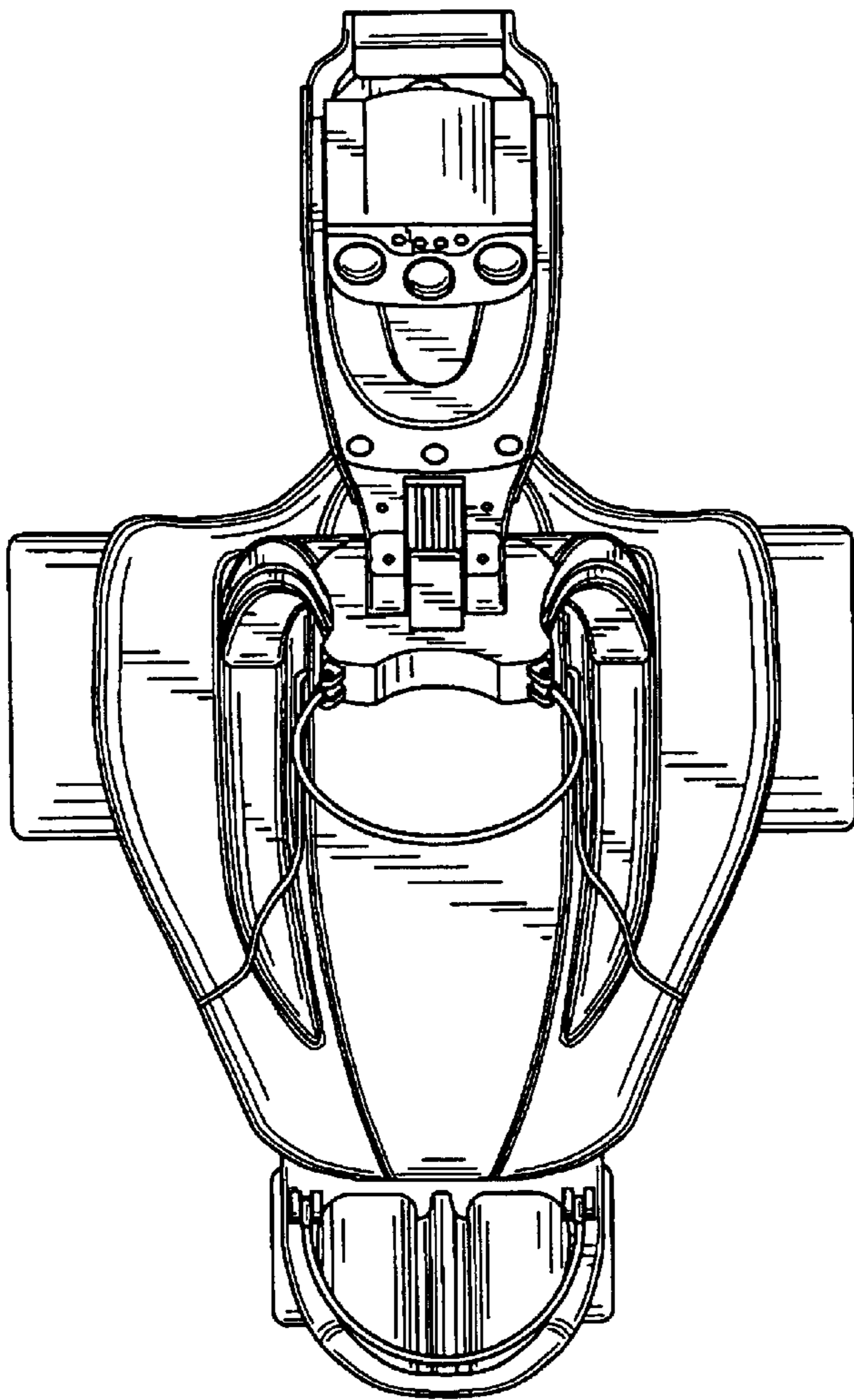

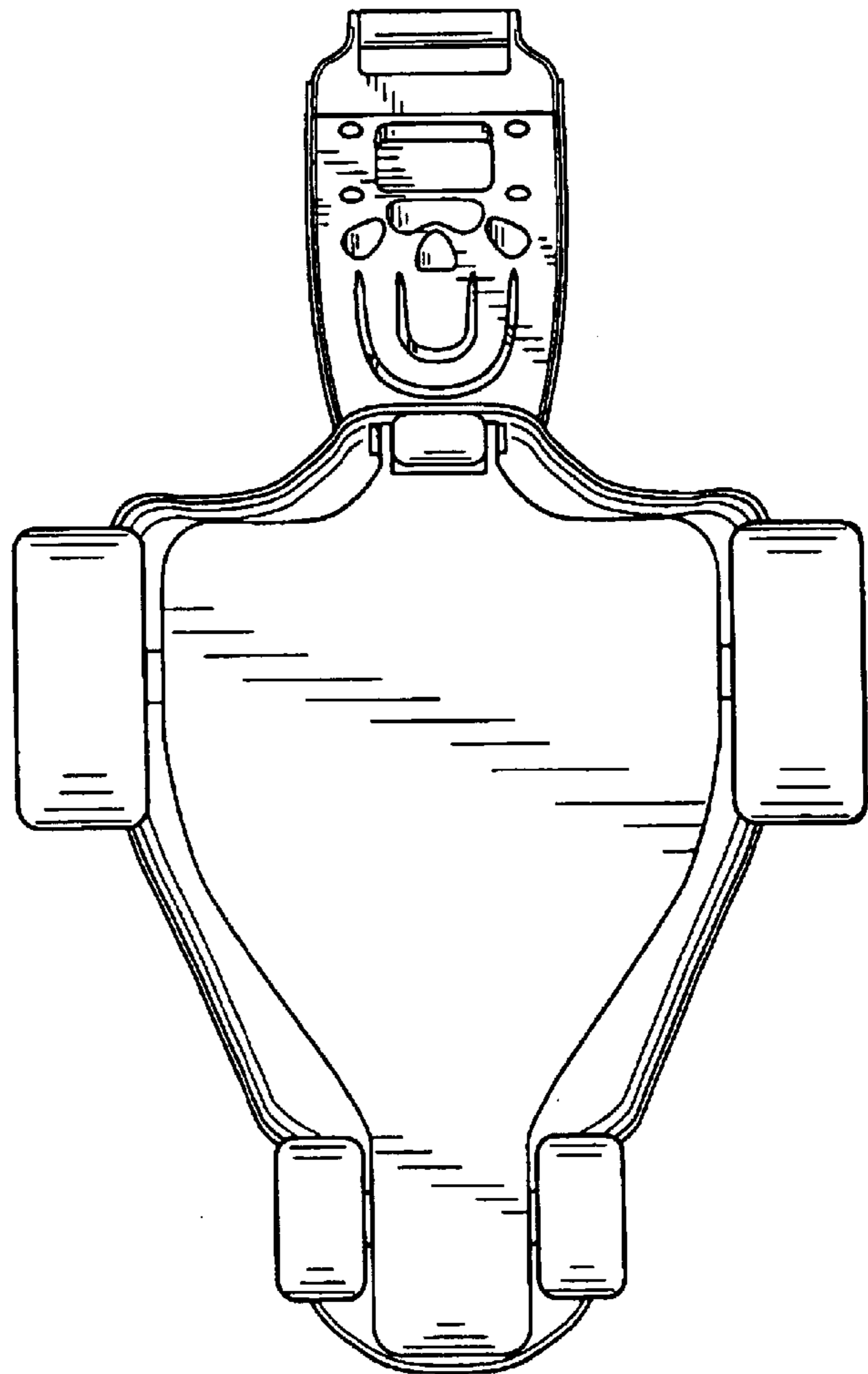

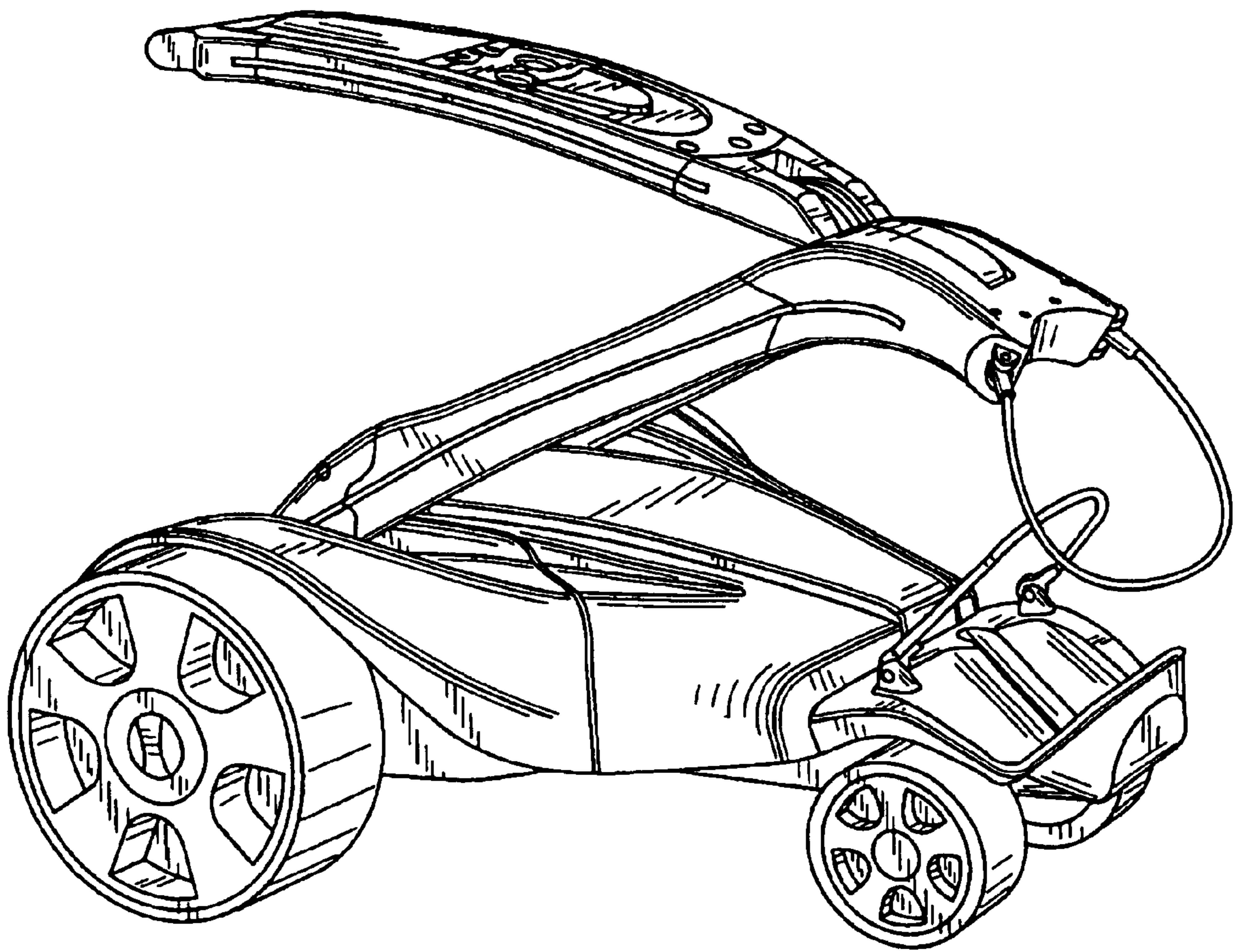

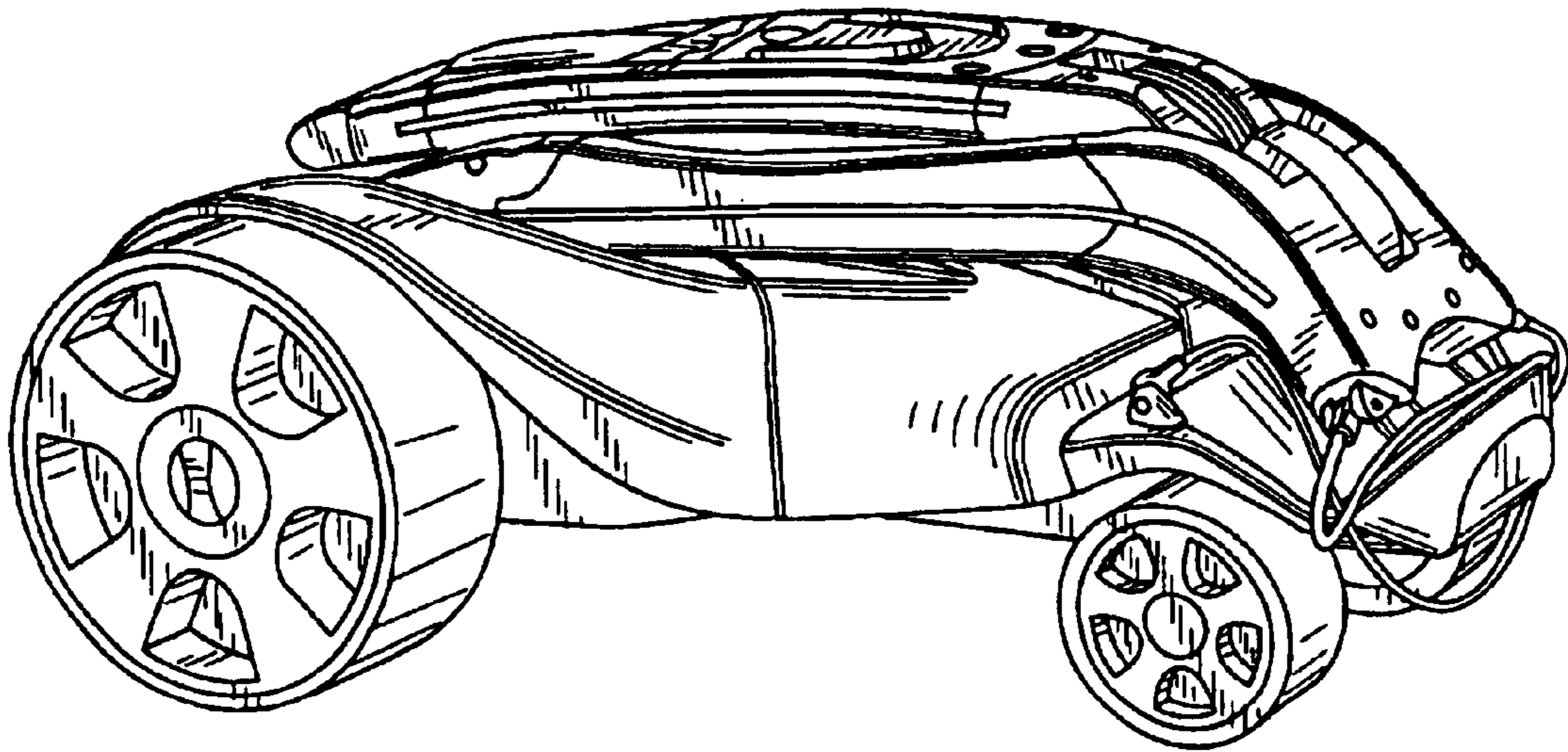

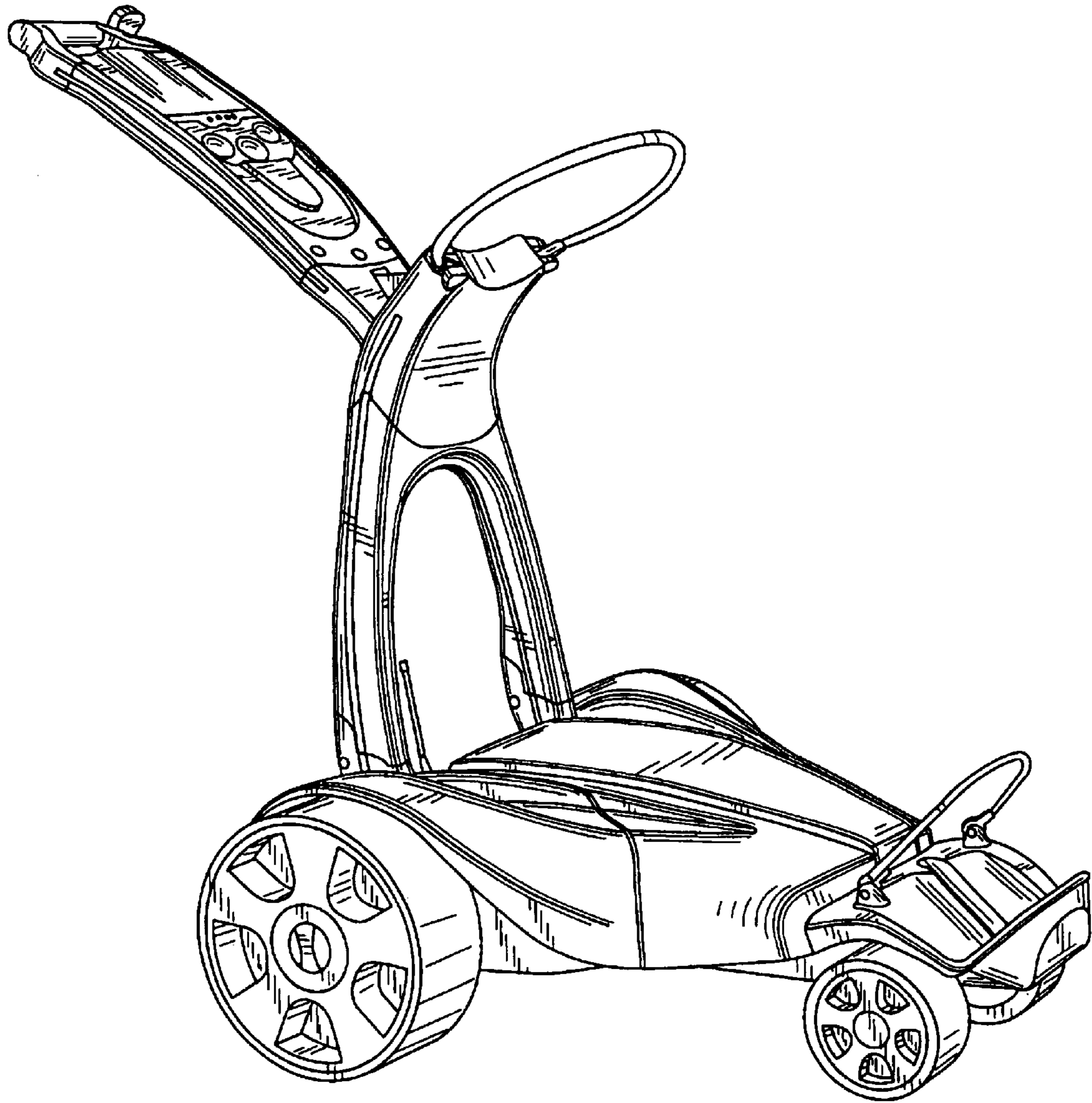

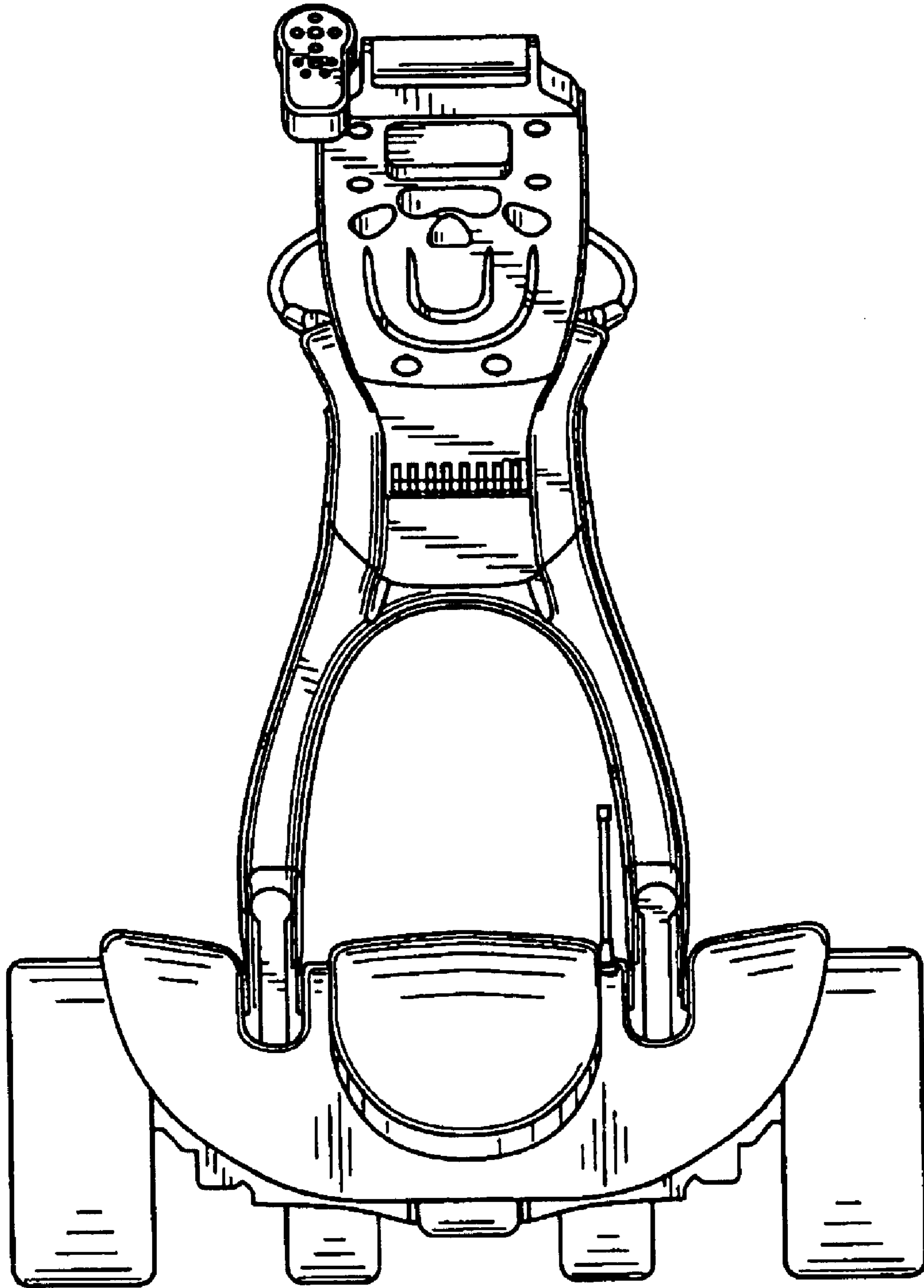
