(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pattern for absorbent paper product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE is a plan view of the pattern for absorbent paper product. The broken line boundaries are for illustrative purposes only, forming no part of the claimed design, and indicate that the design repeats uniformly throughout the length and width of the absorbent paper.
