DESCRIPTION

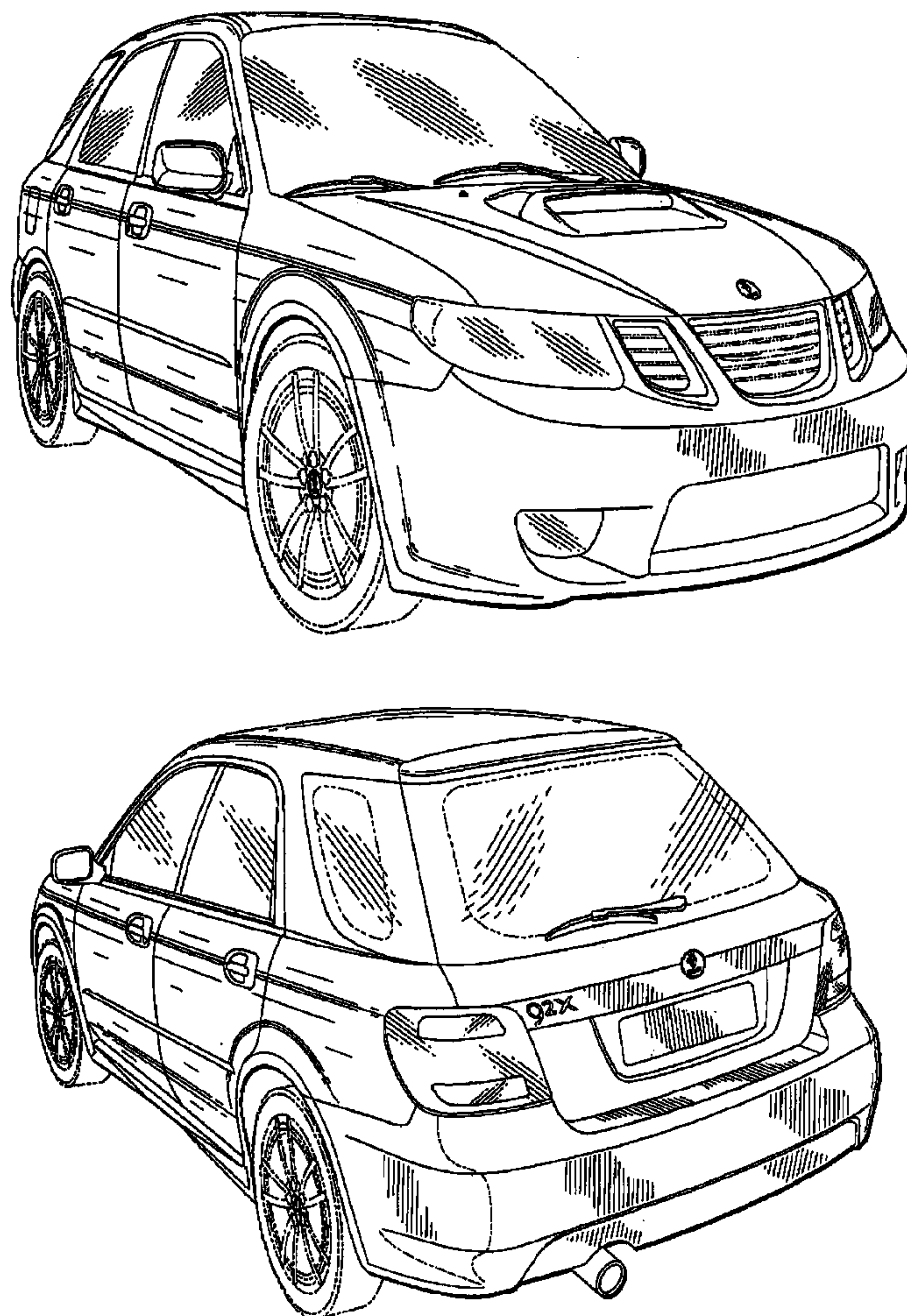
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a vehicle body showing the new design;

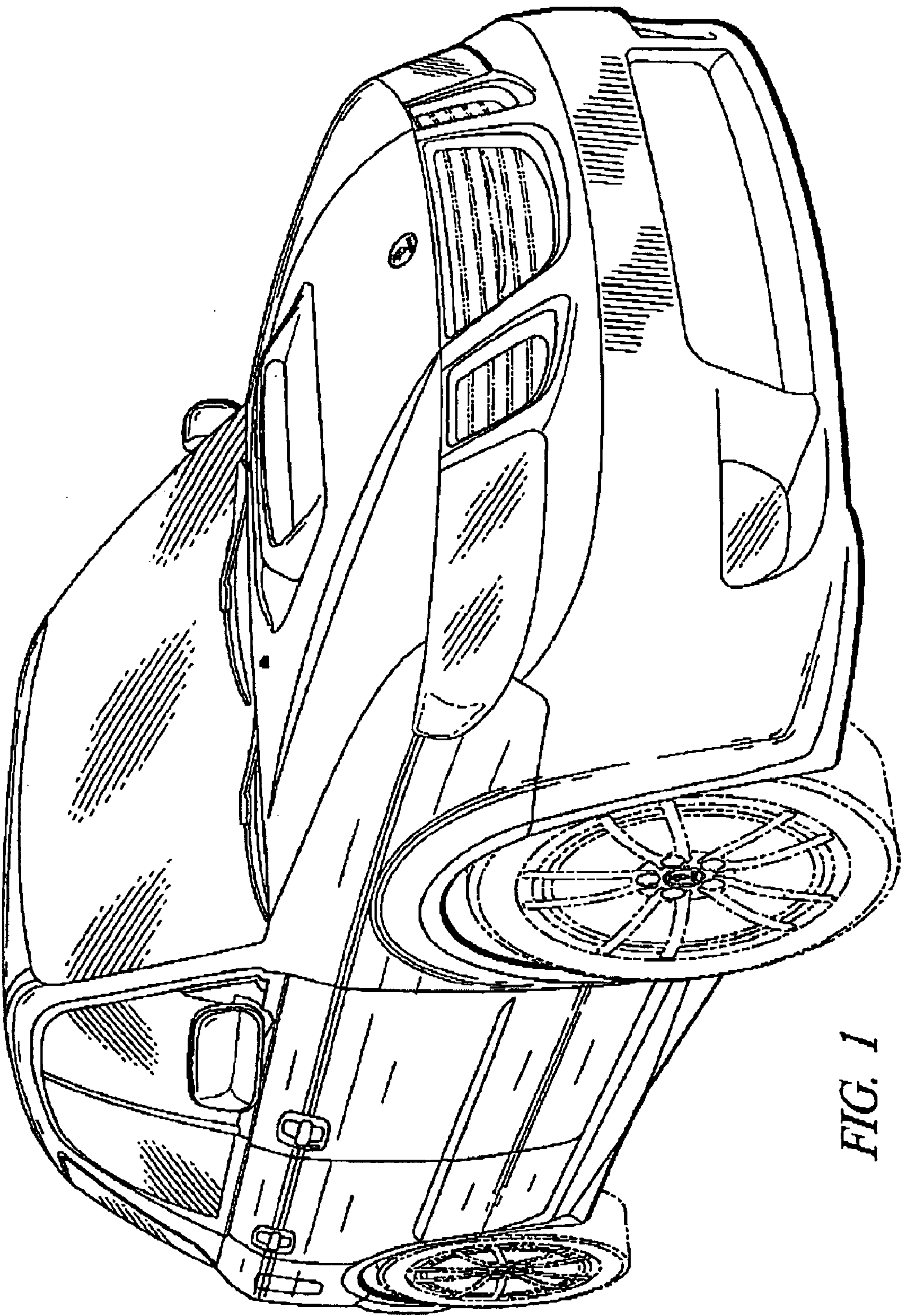

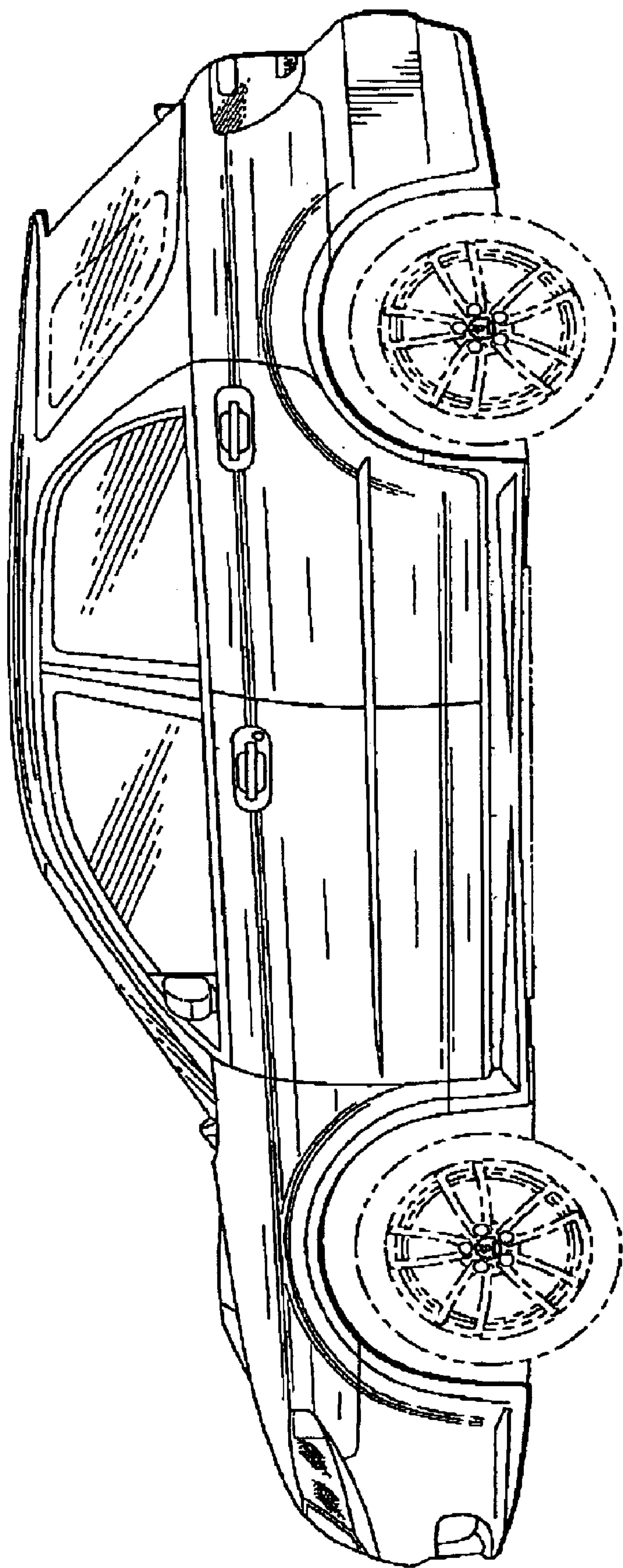

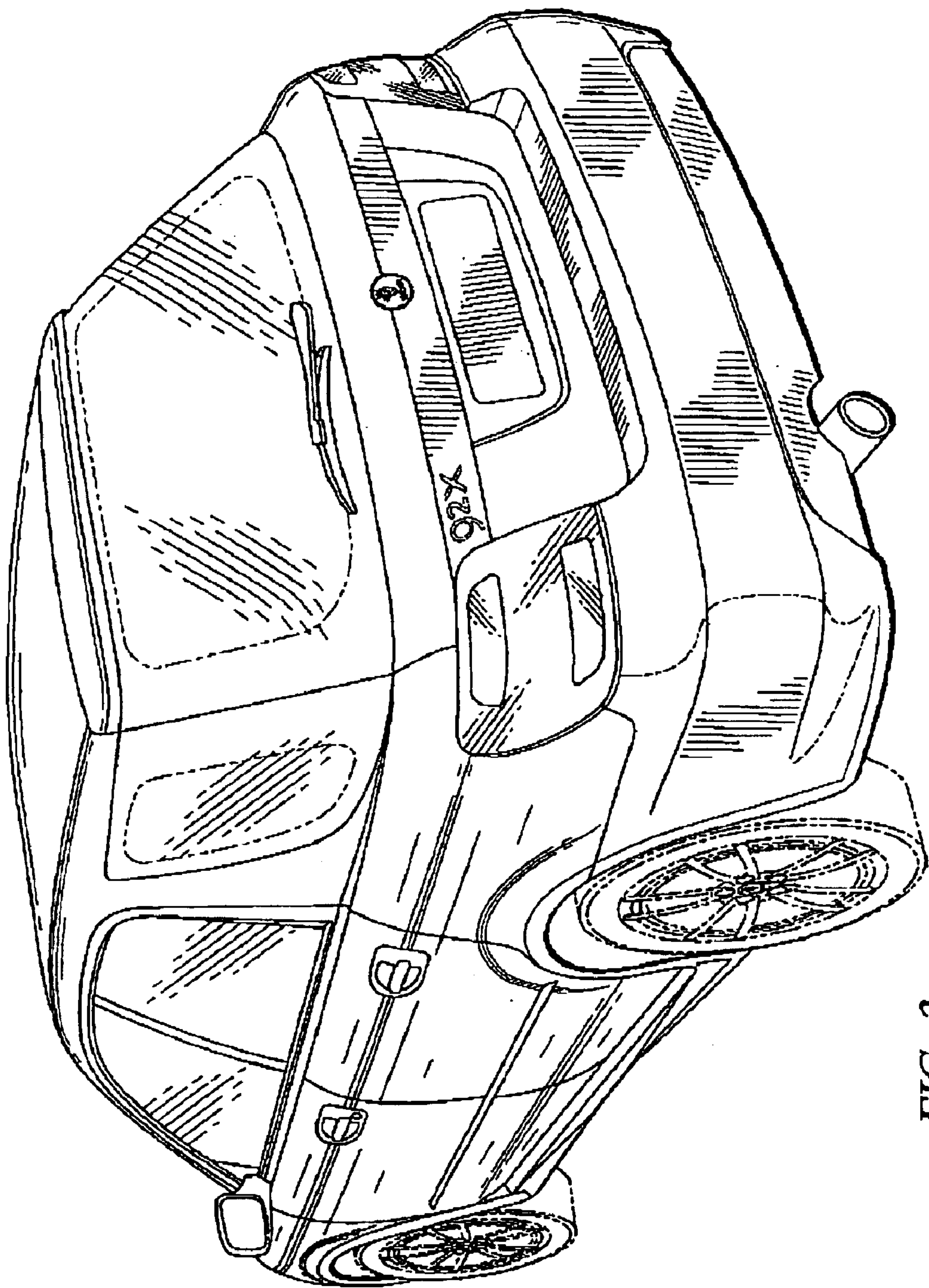
