FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

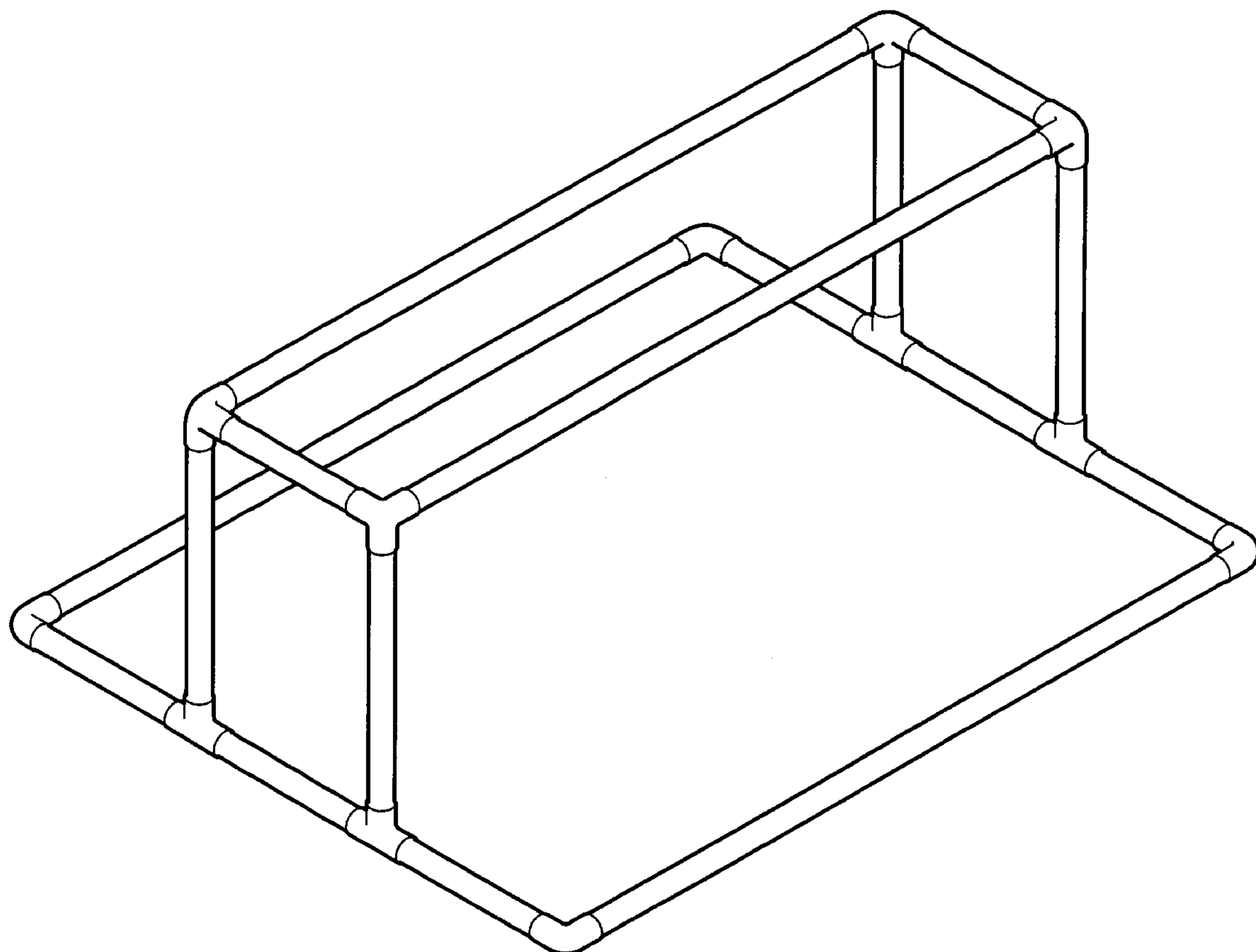
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof (and also a mirror image of the opposite end);

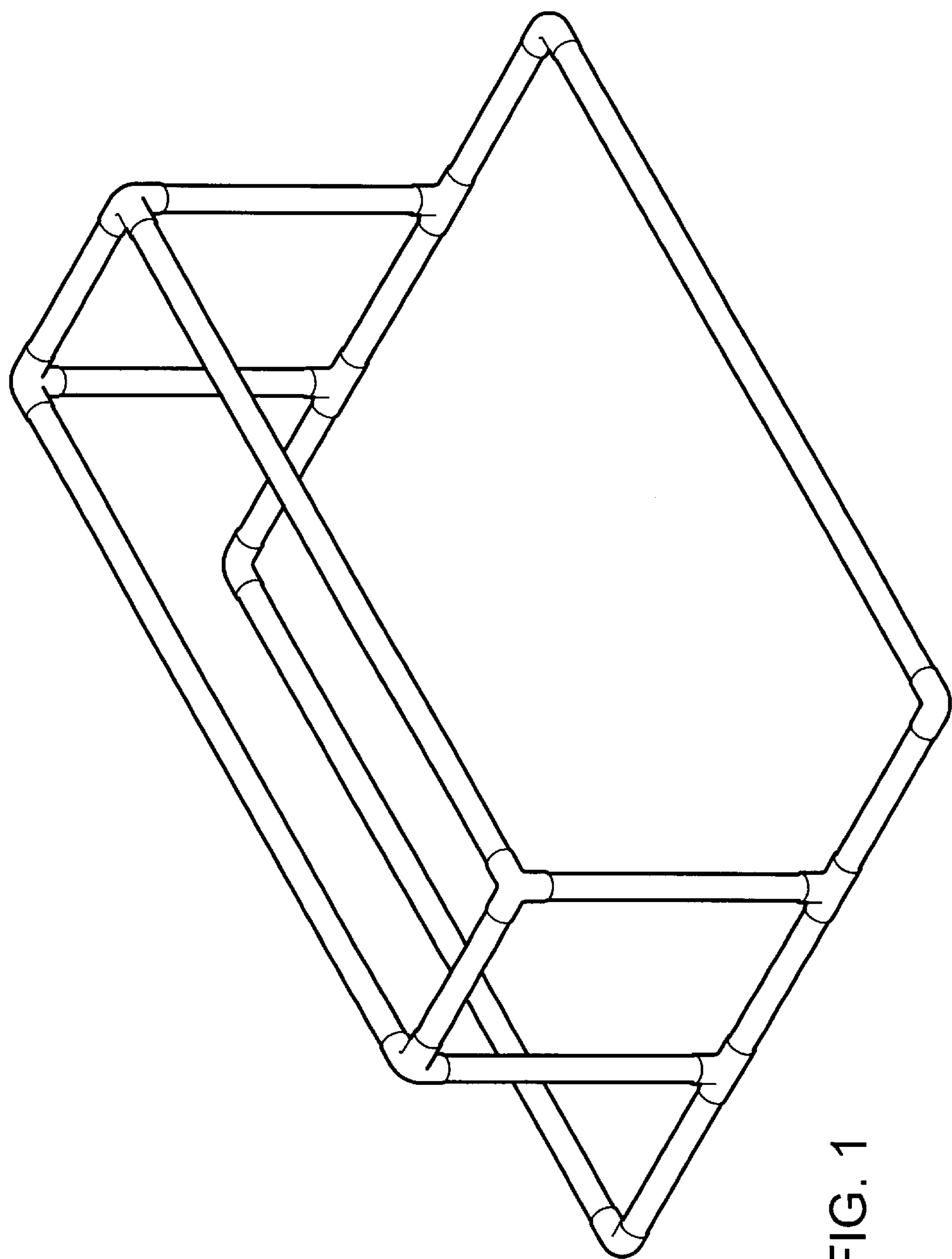

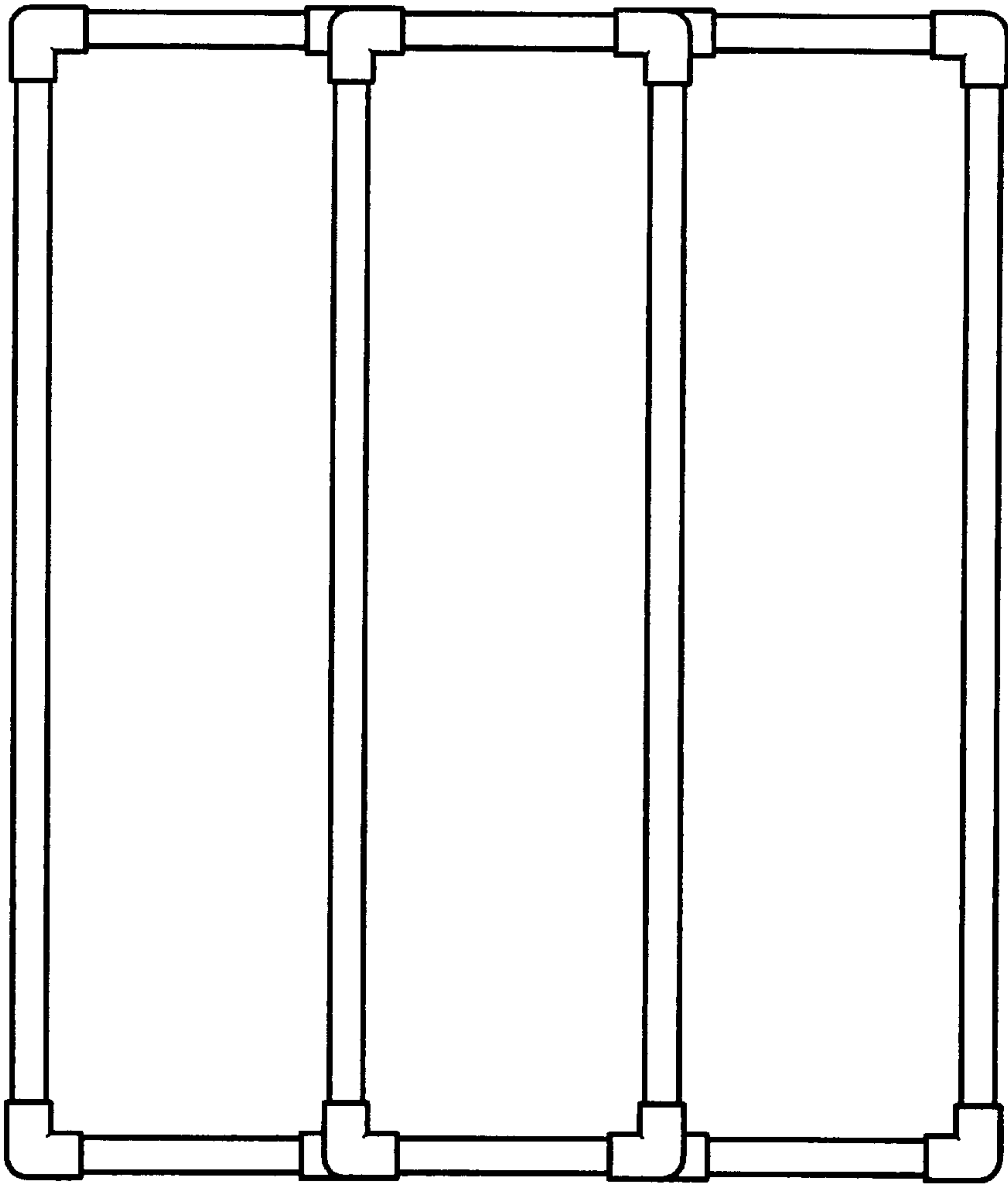

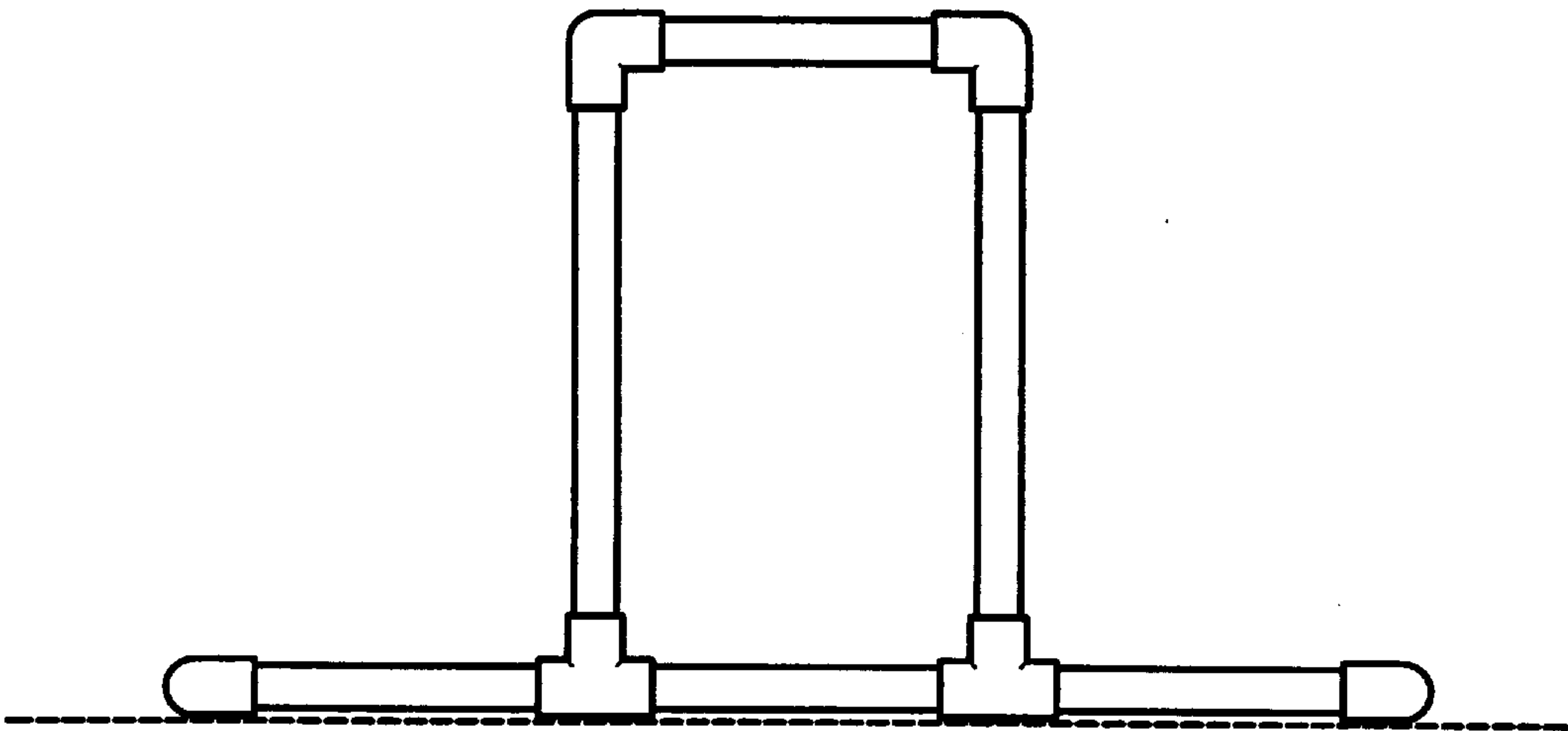

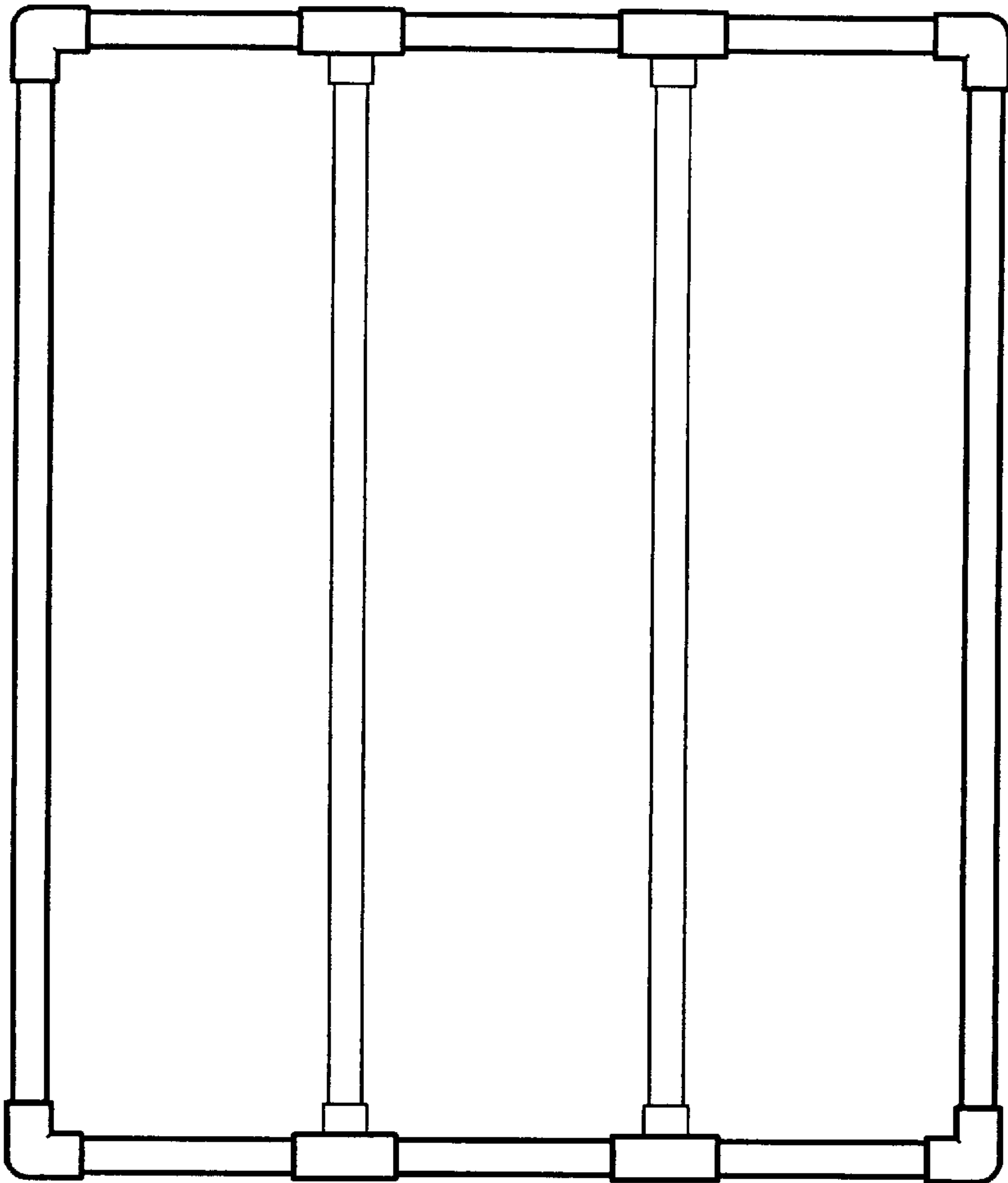

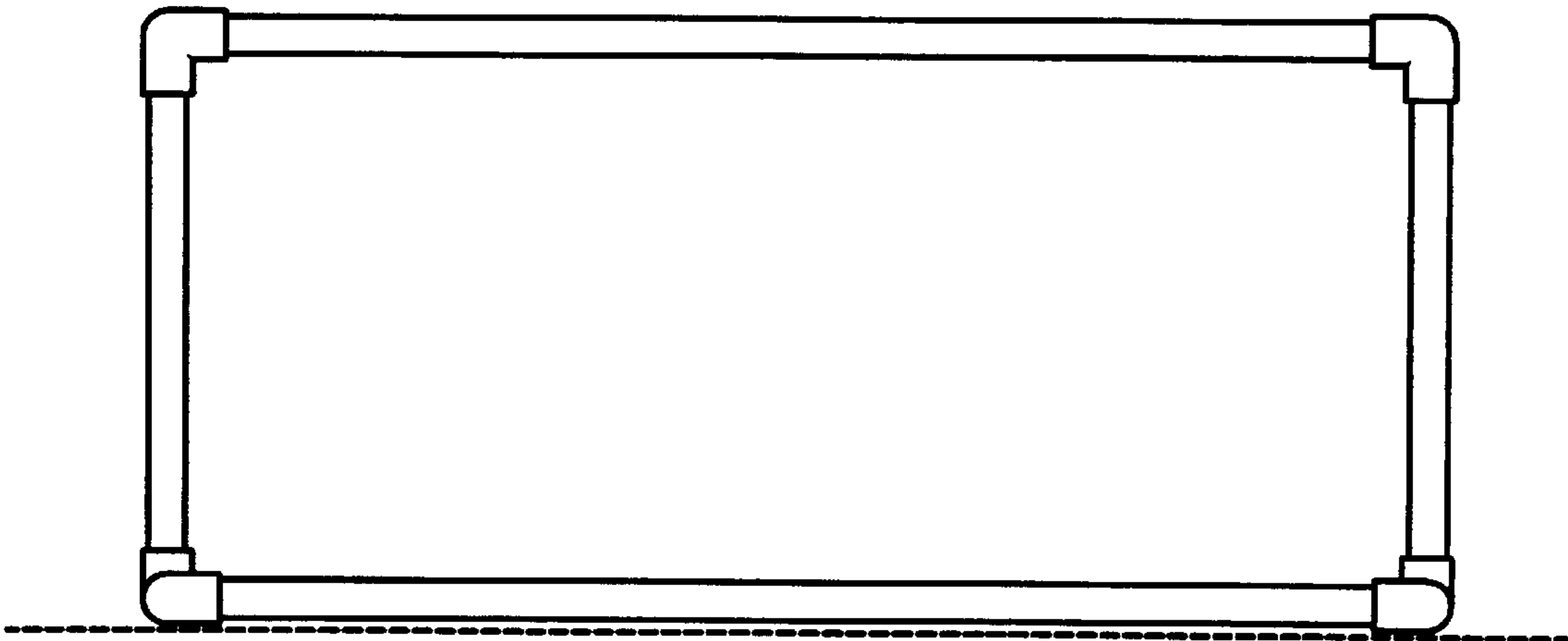
