FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.

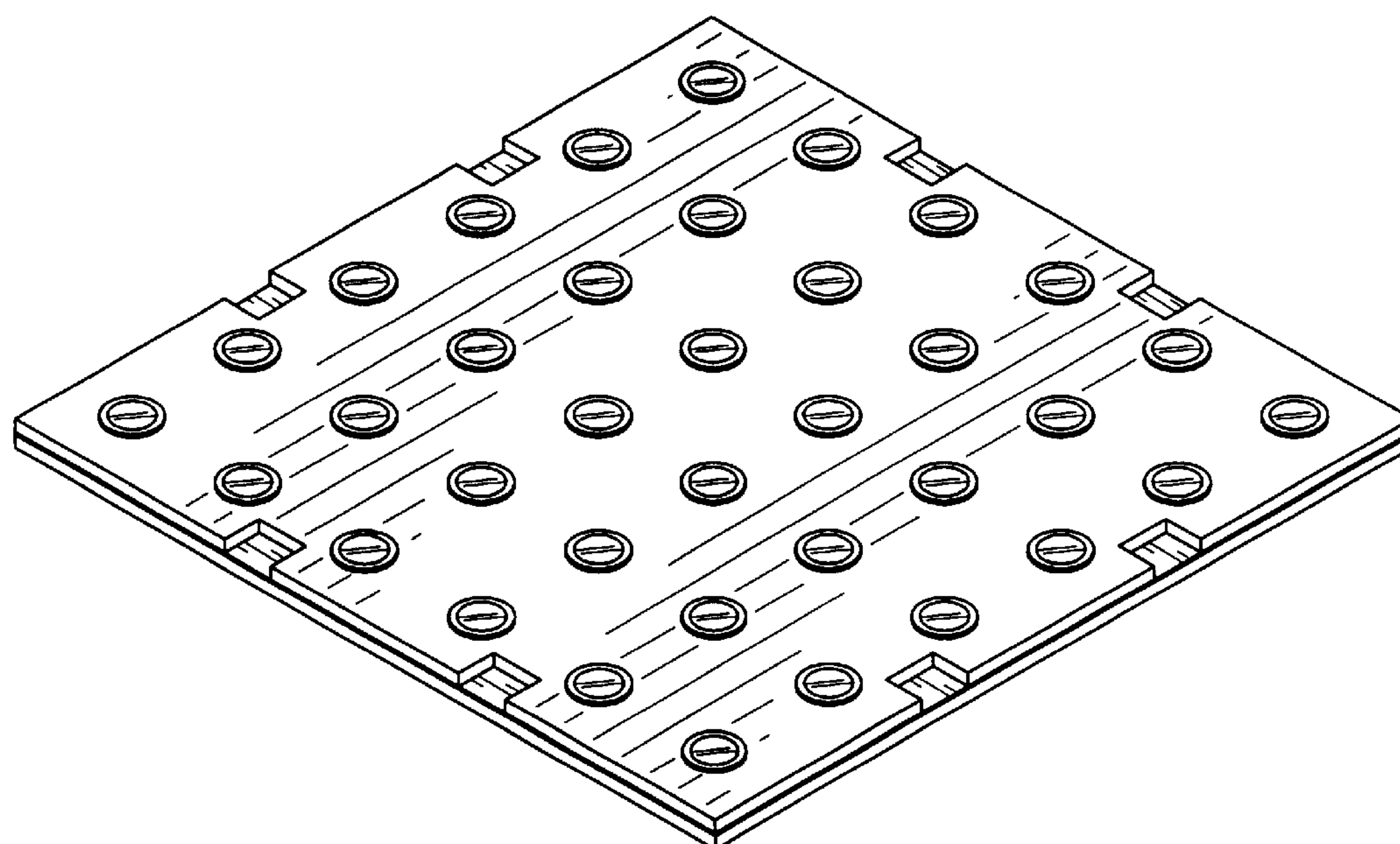
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof.

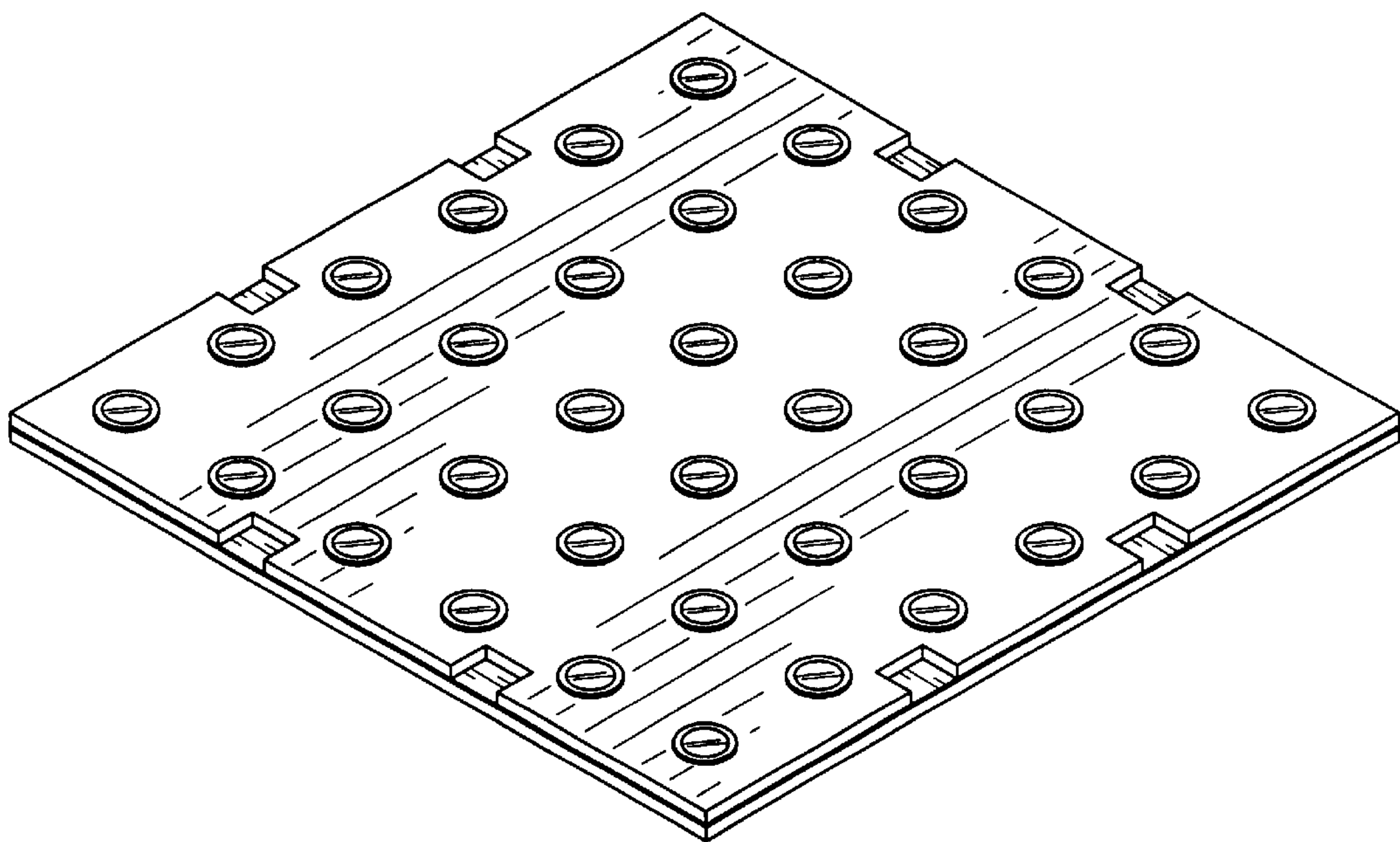

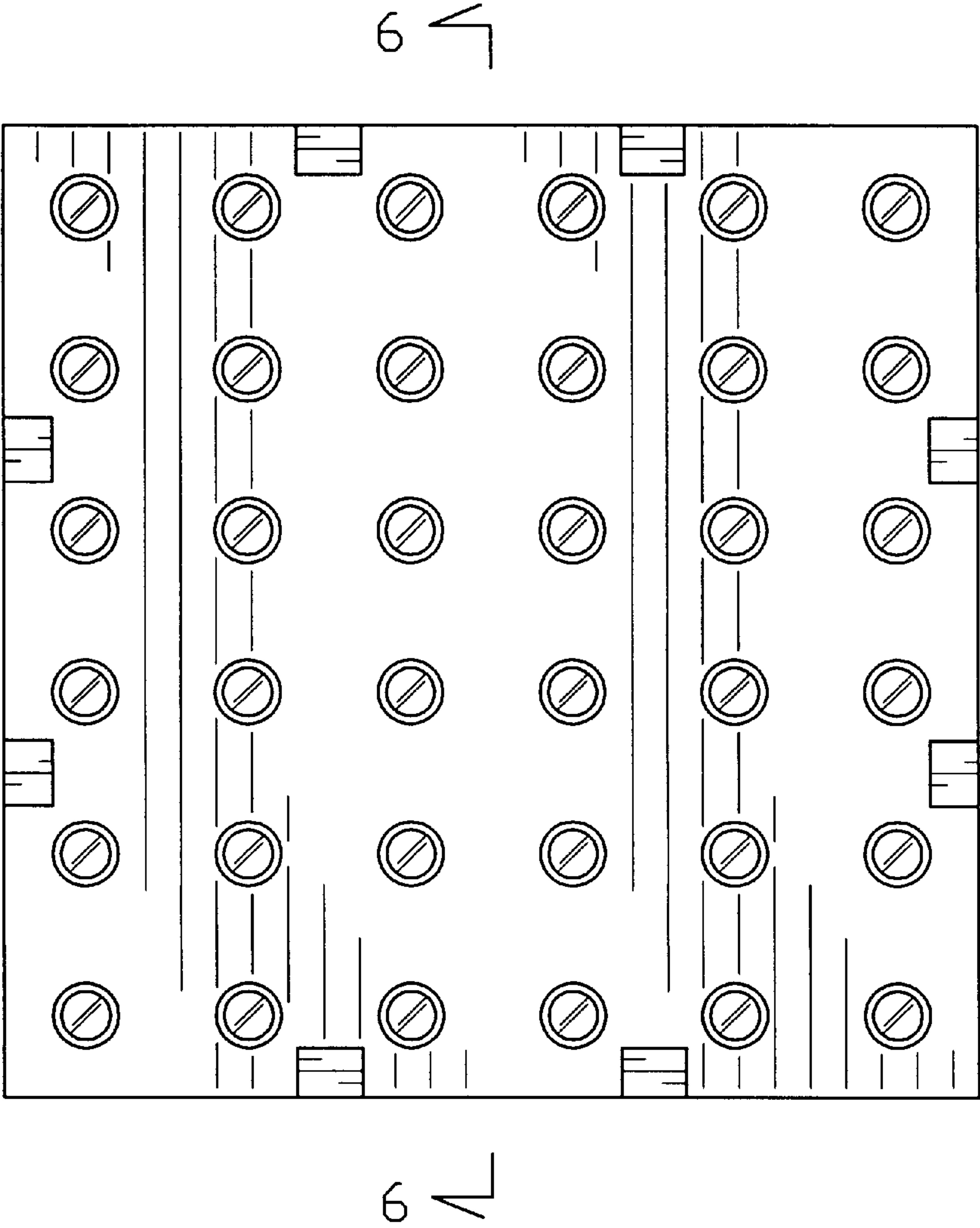

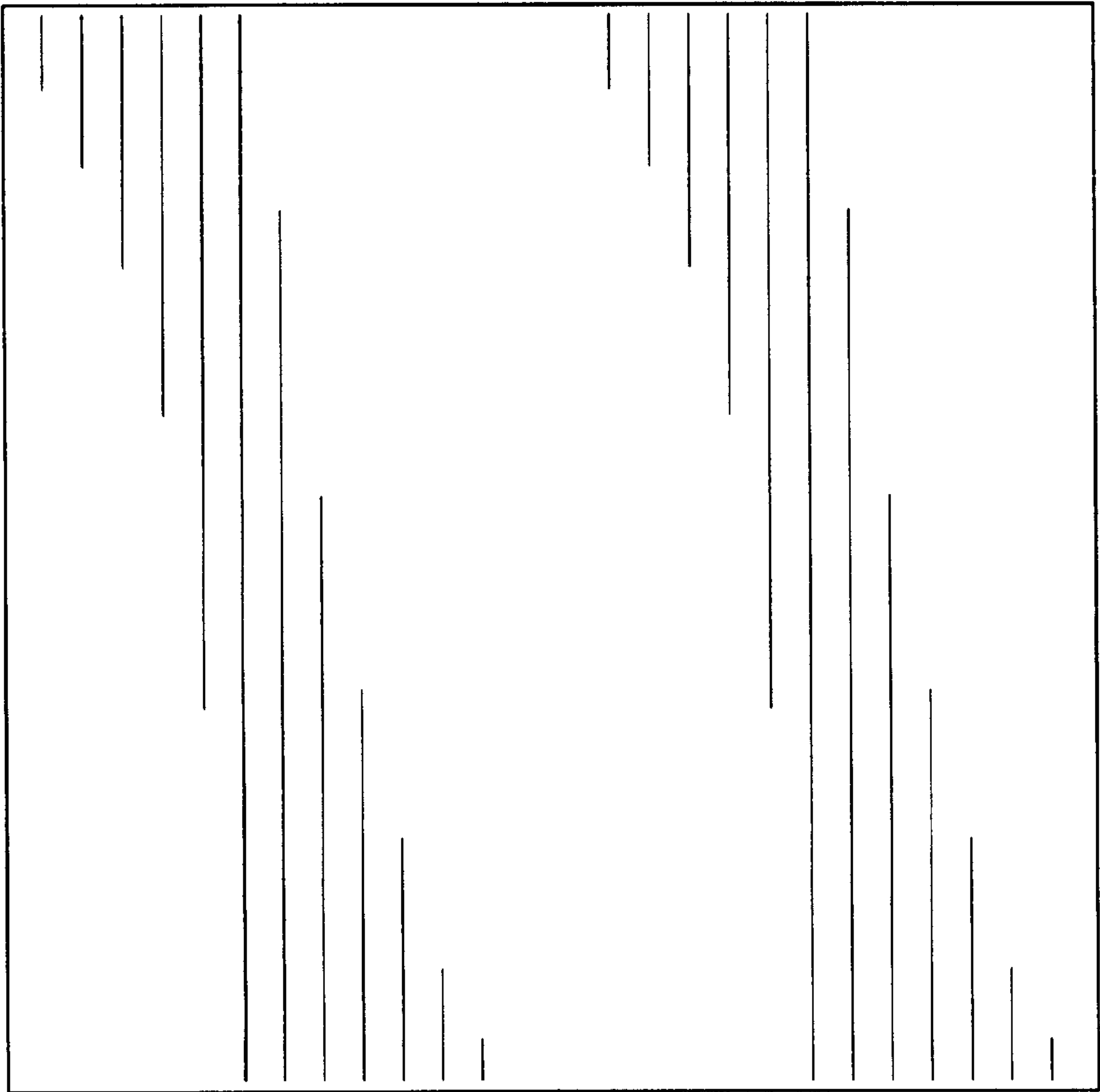

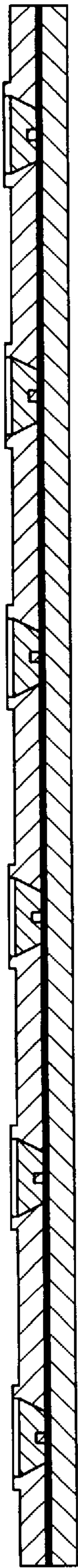
