FIG. 7 is a left side isometric view of a trash bag dispenser showing my new design.

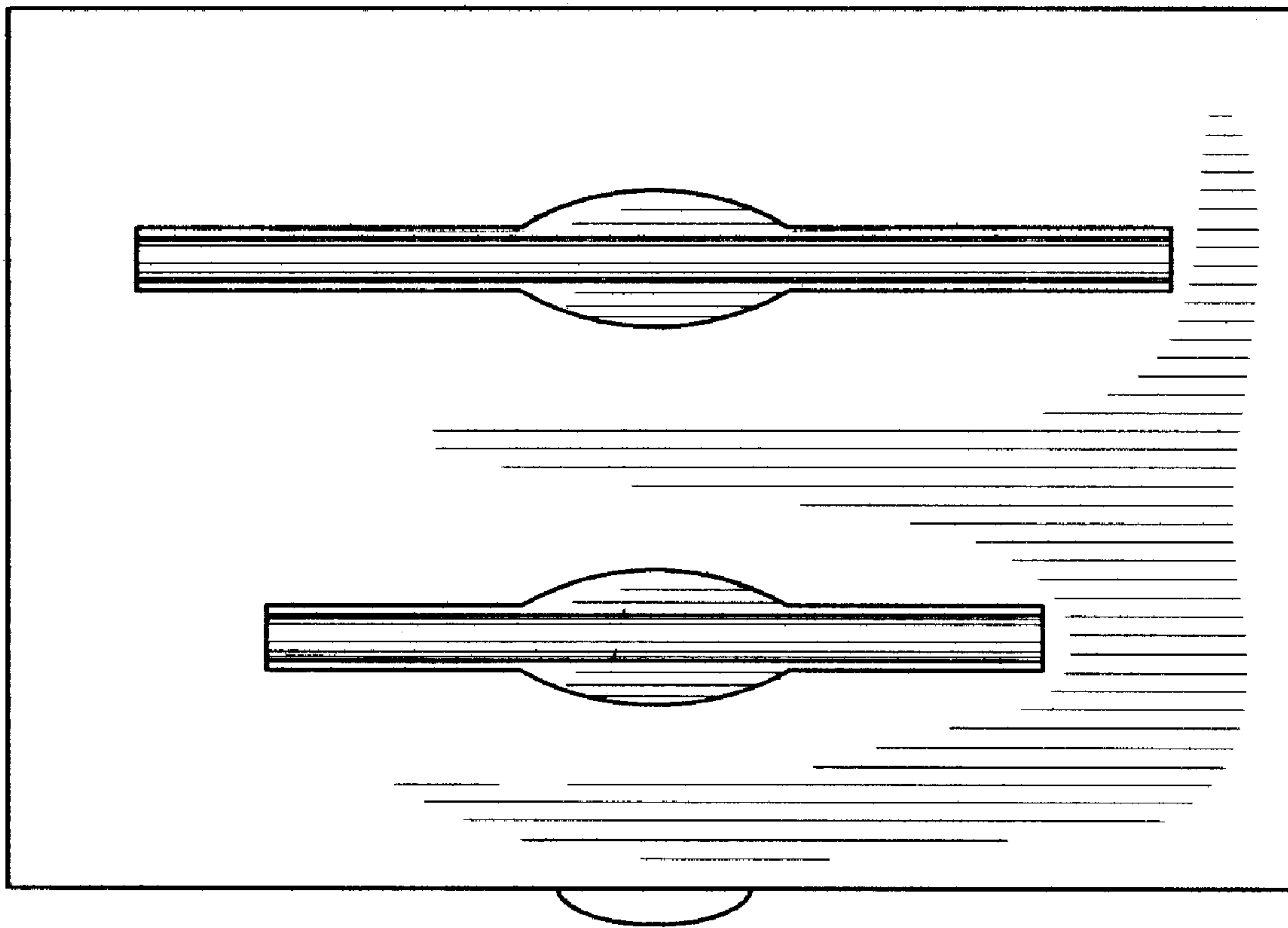

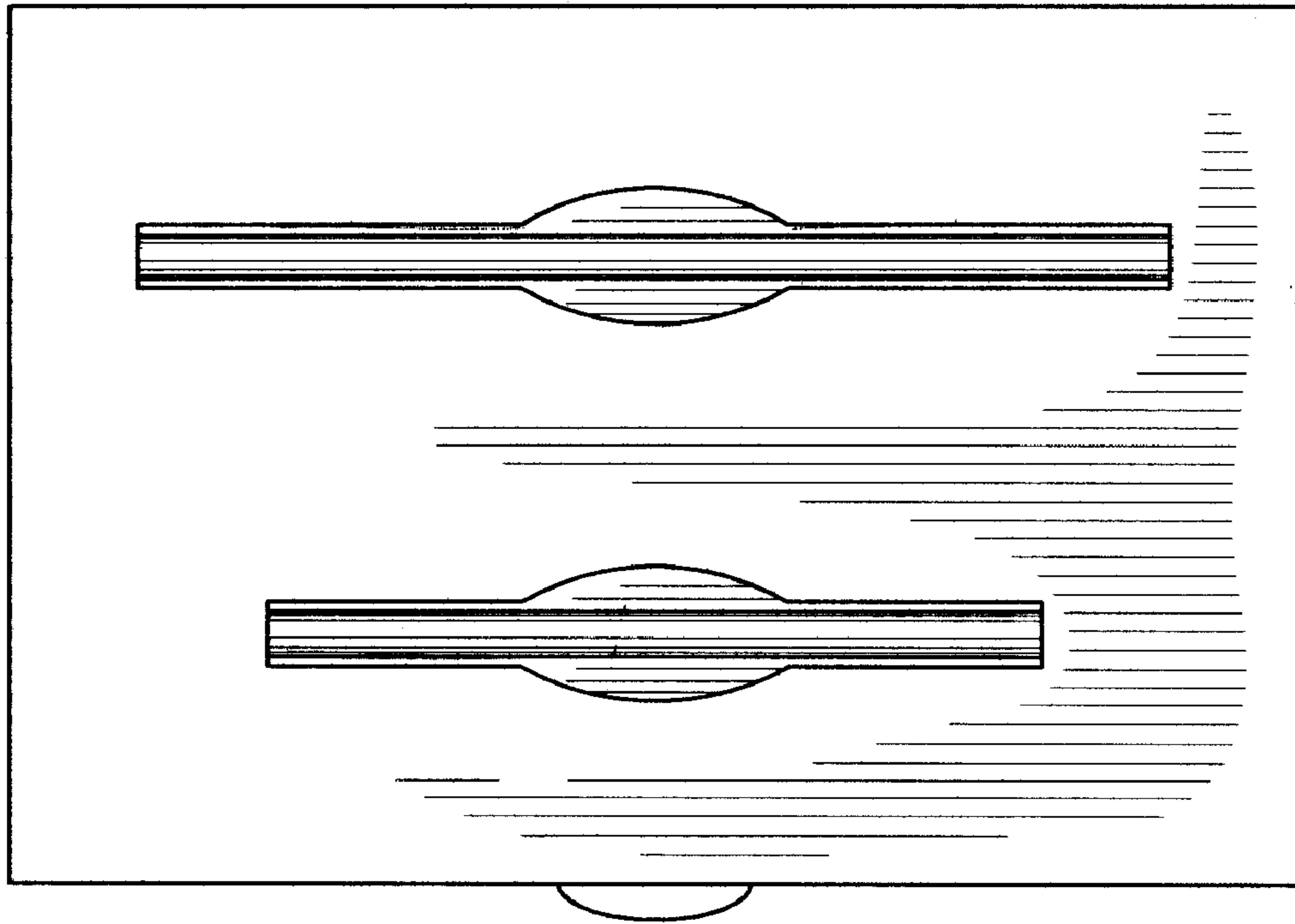

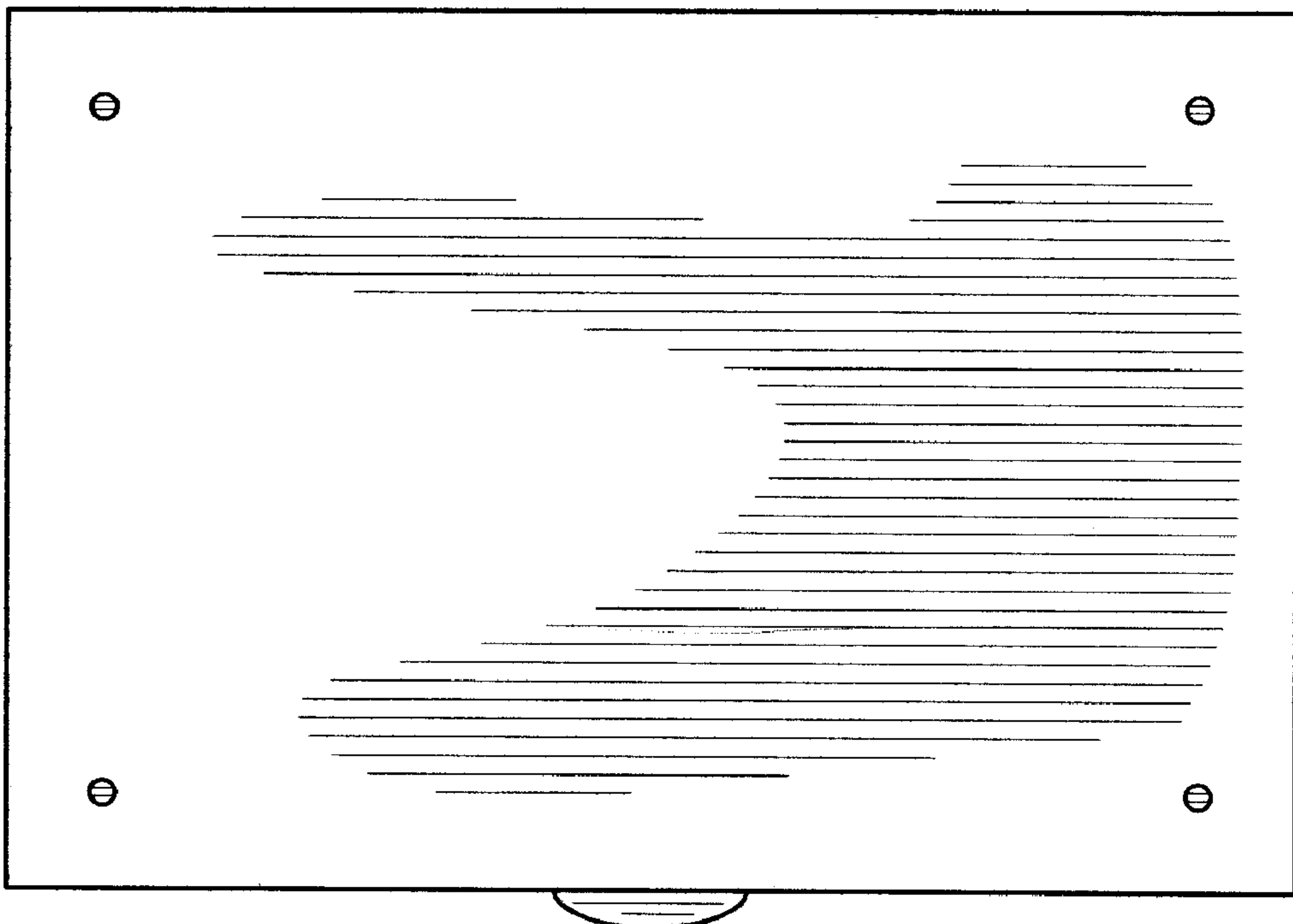

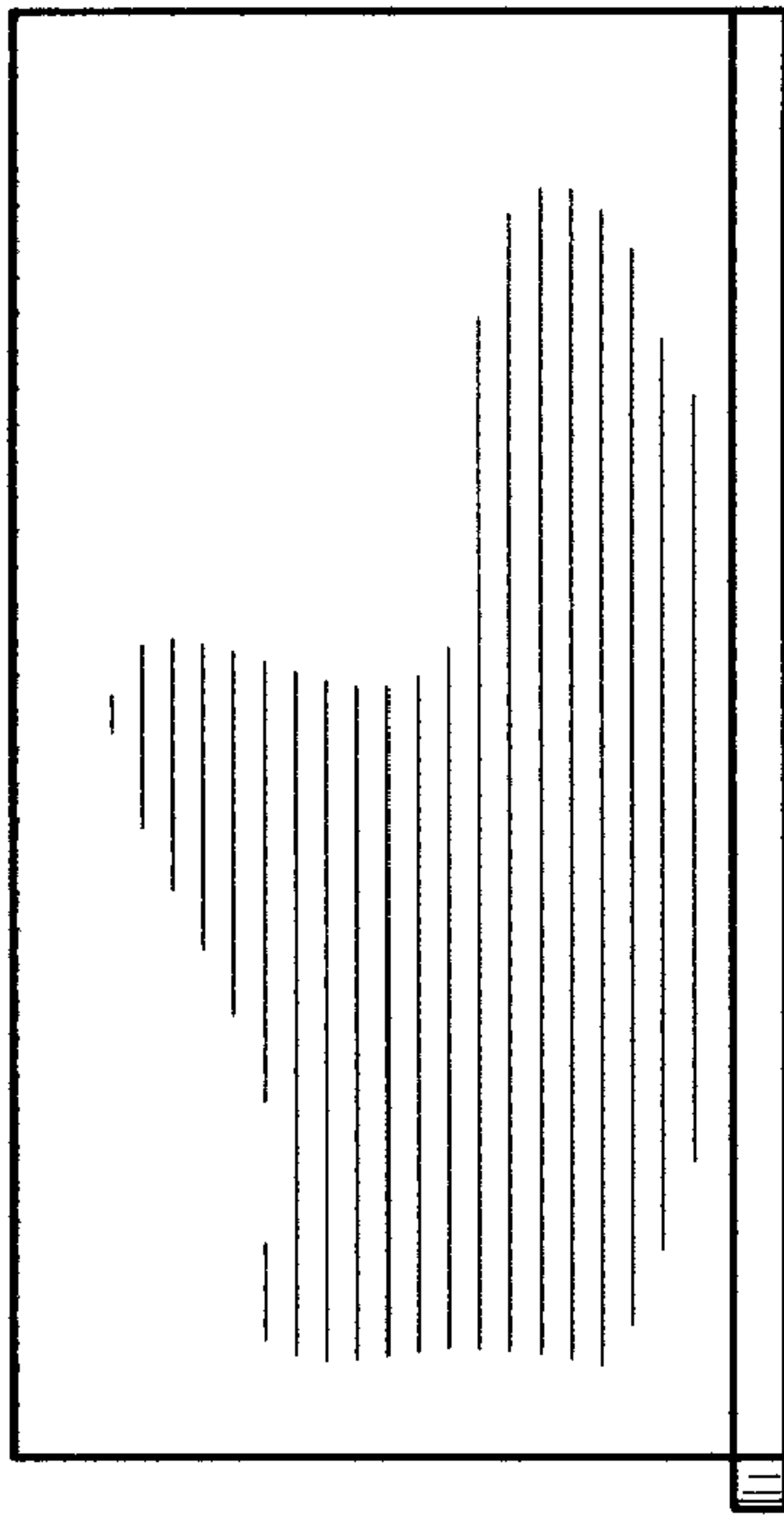

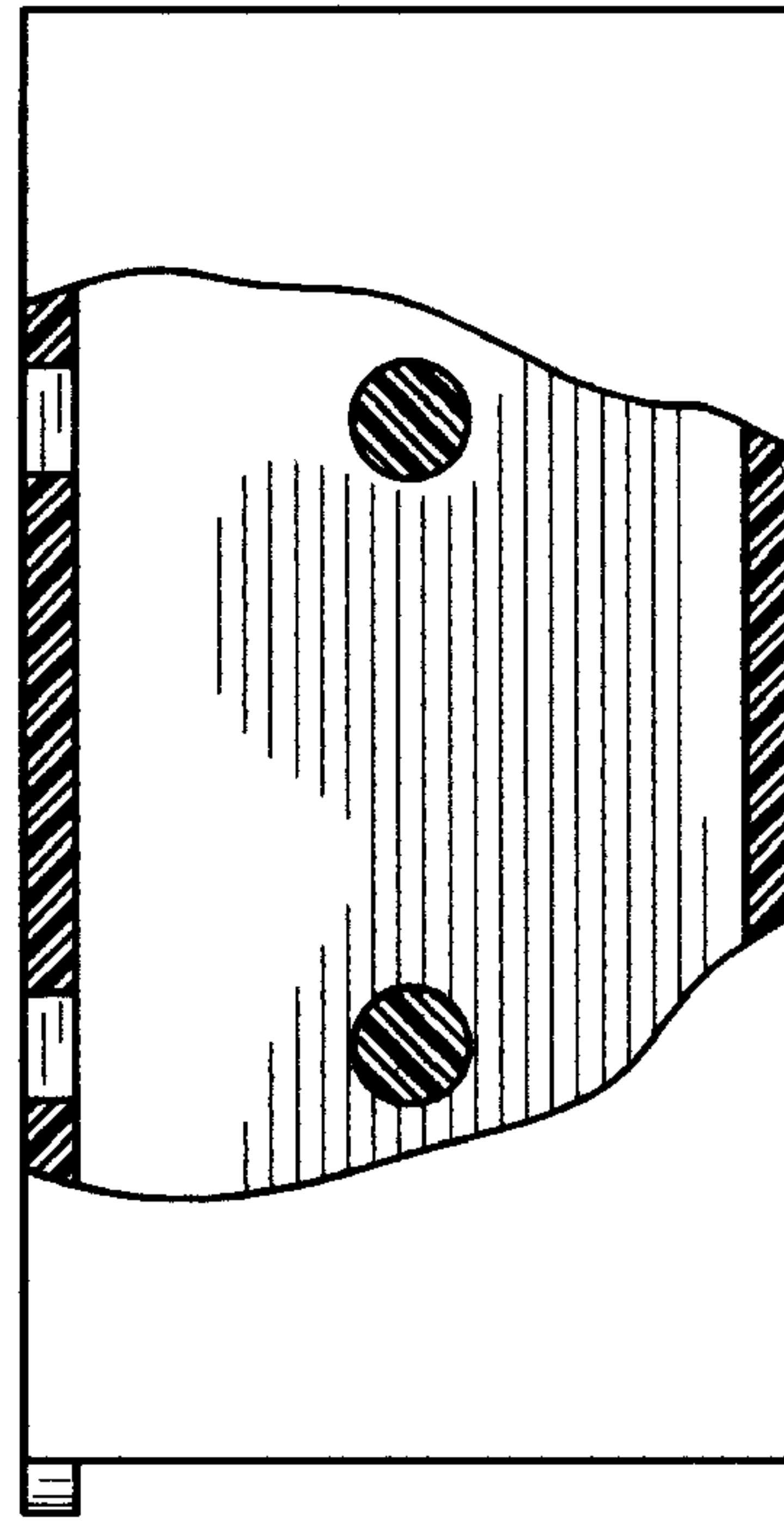

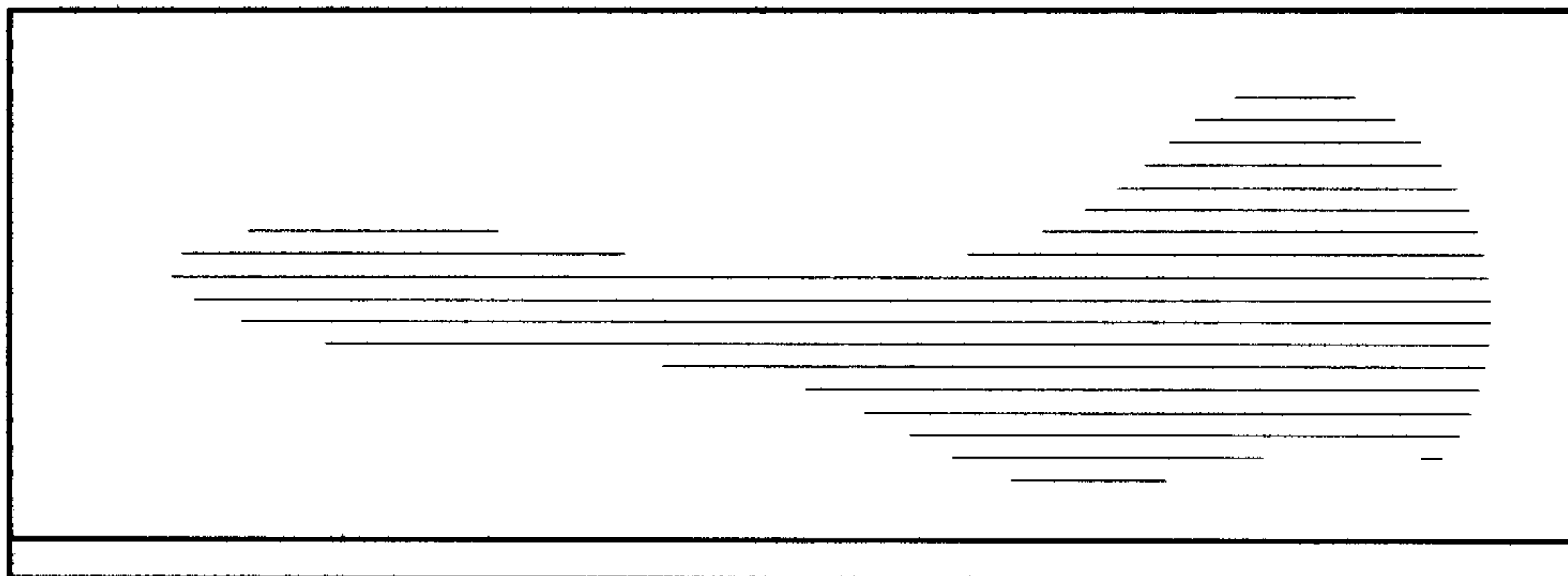

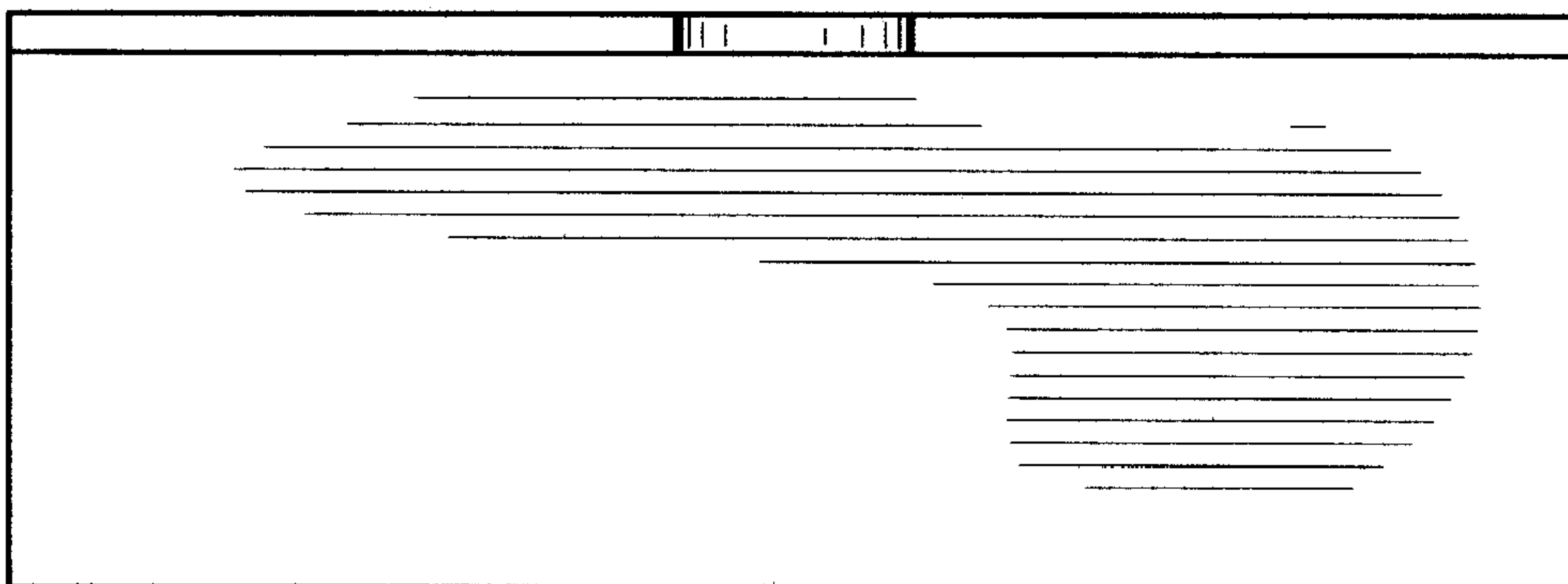

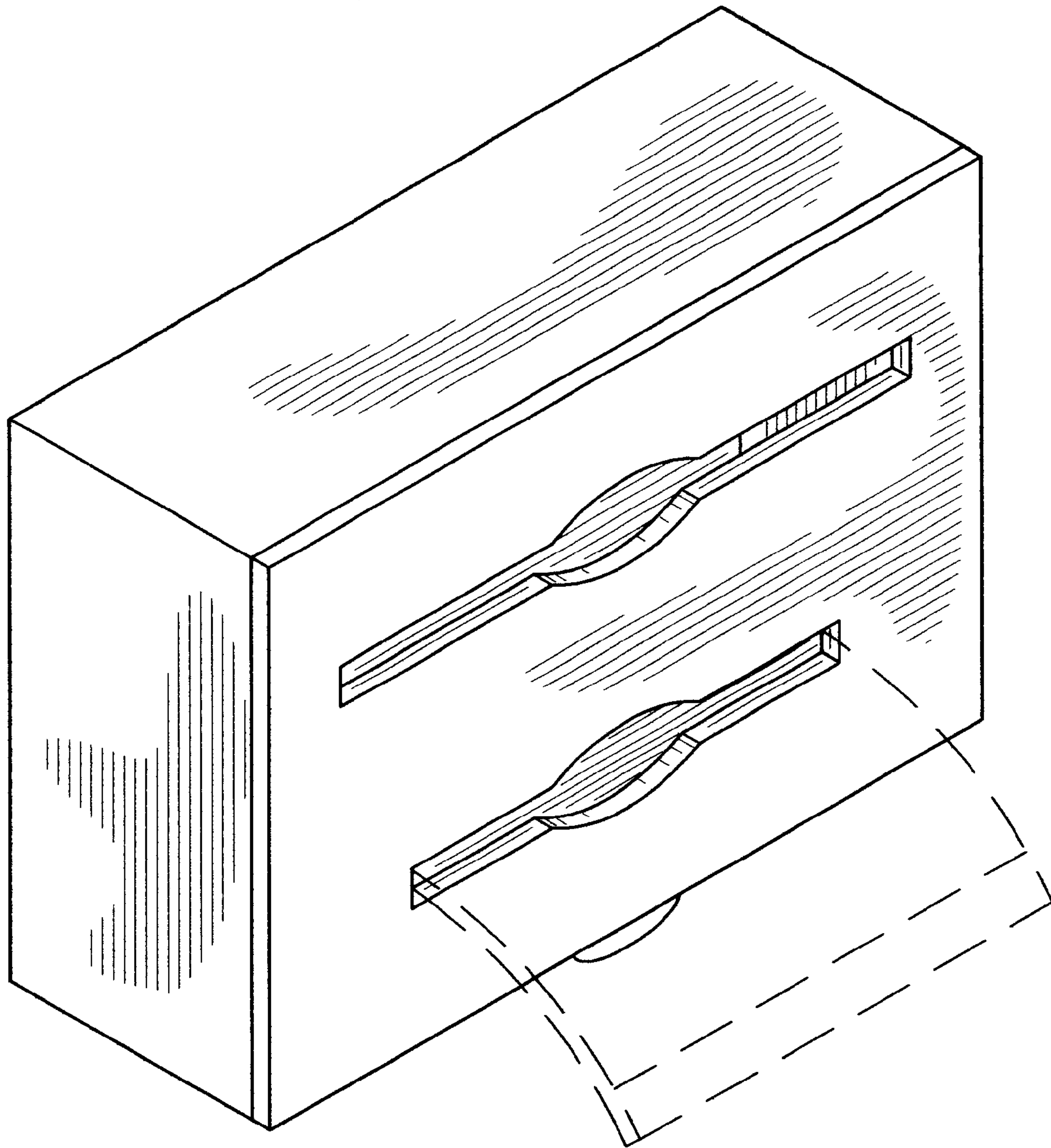
