The ornamental design for a hockey stick appliqué, as shown and described.

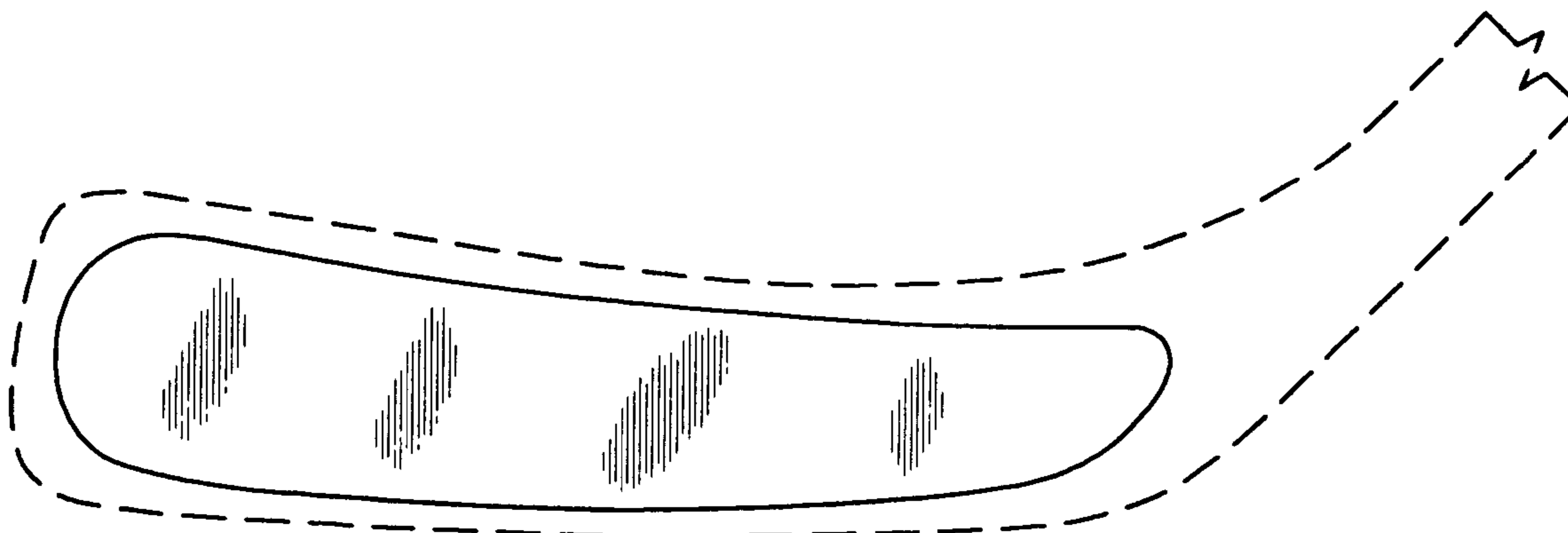
**DESCRIPTION**

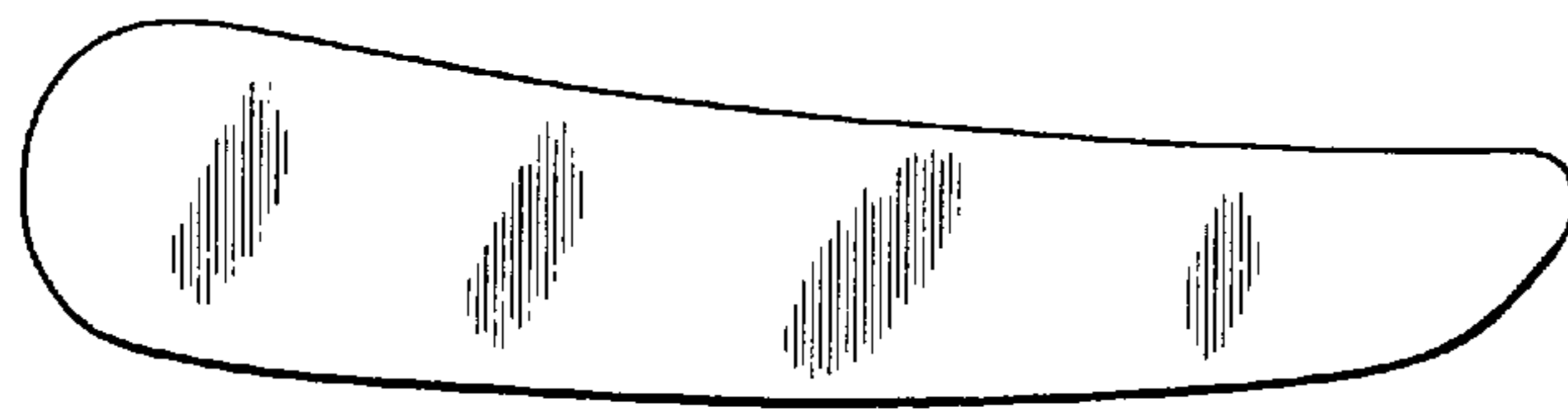
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a hockey stick appliqué, the undisclosed opposite side being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 2 is an elevation view applied to the left face of a hockey stick blade;

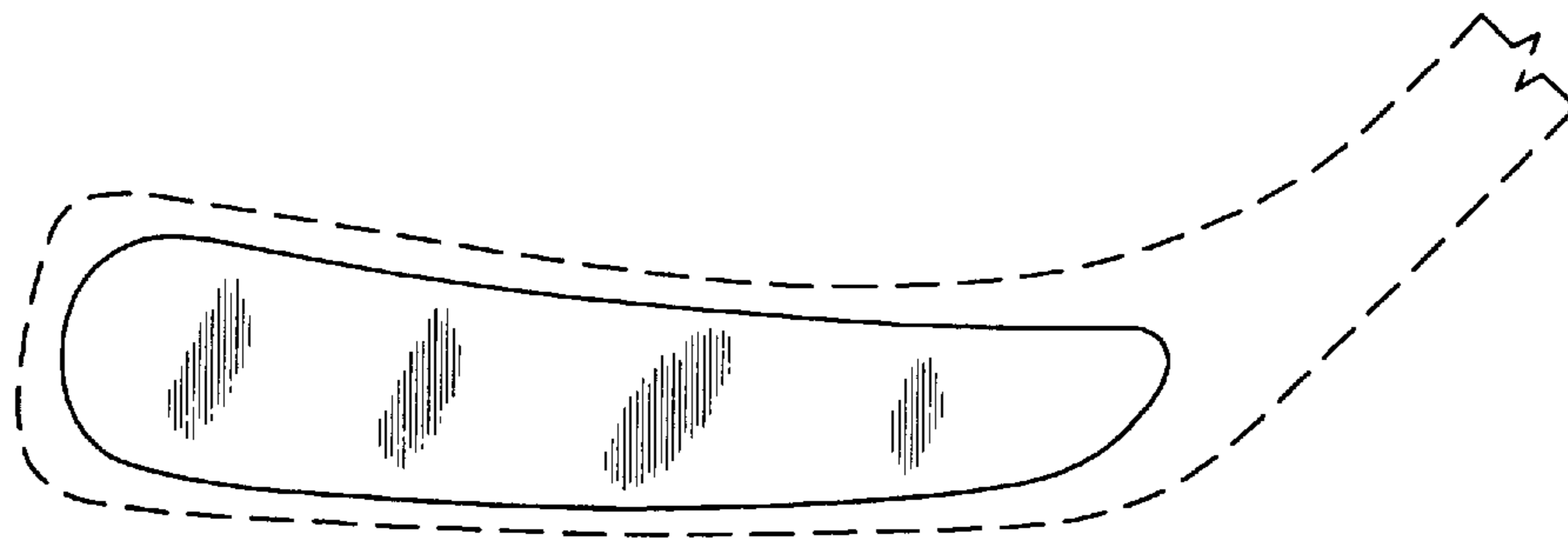
FIGS. 1 through 10 illustrate a hockey stick applique incorporating the new design. The broken line illustrations of the hockey stick blade shown in FIGS. 2, 4, 6, 8–10 are for environment illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. The logotype of FIGS. 5–8 may be, for example, of a hockey league, hockey franchise, hockey club, the manufacturer's trademark, or other logotype(s) appropriate to the environment of a particular player's team.

 FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of a second embodiment of the hockey stick appliqué of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is an elevation view applied to the right face of a hockey stick blade;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of a third embodiment of the hockey stick appliqué of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 6 is an elevation view applied to the right face of a hockey stick blade;  
 FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of a fourth embodiment of the hockey stick appliqué of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 8 is an elevation view applied to the right face of a hockey stick blade;  
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the hockey stick appliqué disclosed in FIGS. 1–8 applied to both sides of a hockey stick blade; and,  
 FIG. 10 is a front edge view of the hockey stick applique and hockey stick blade of FIG. 9.

The broken line showing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

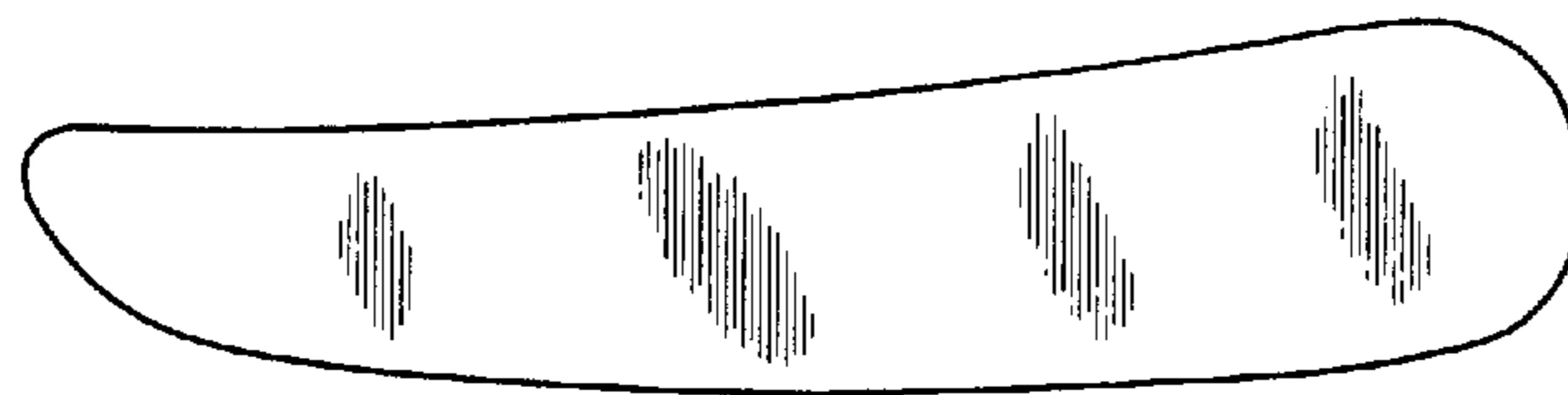




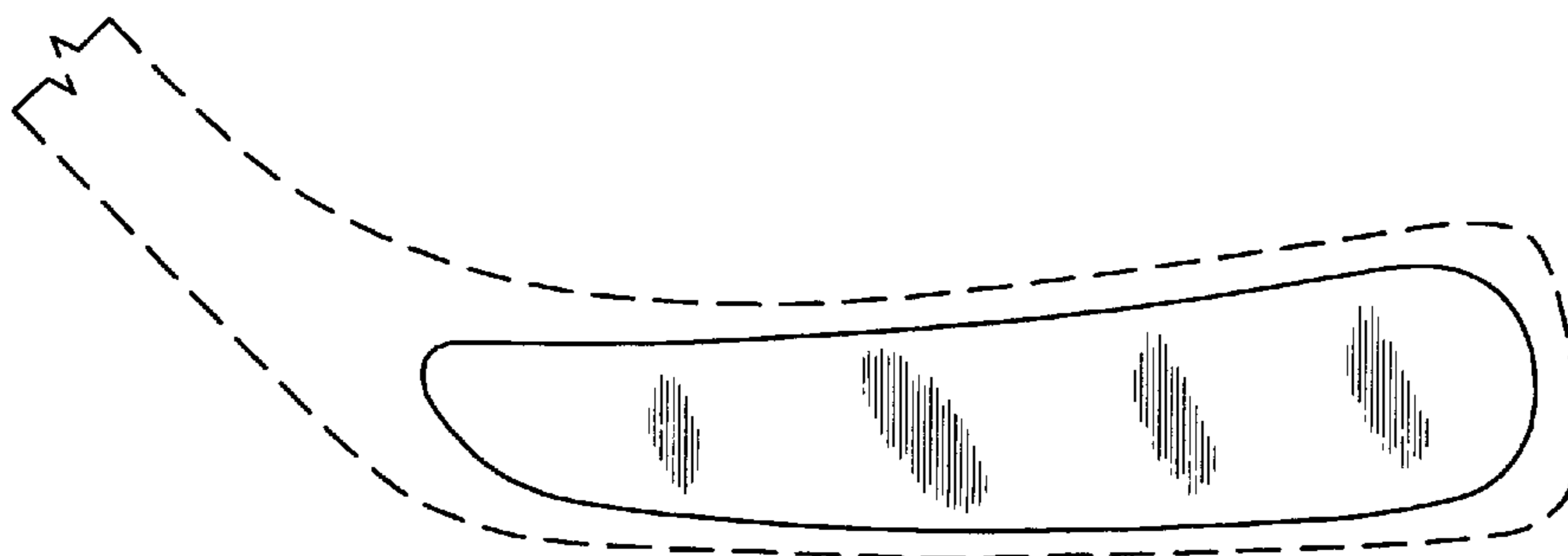

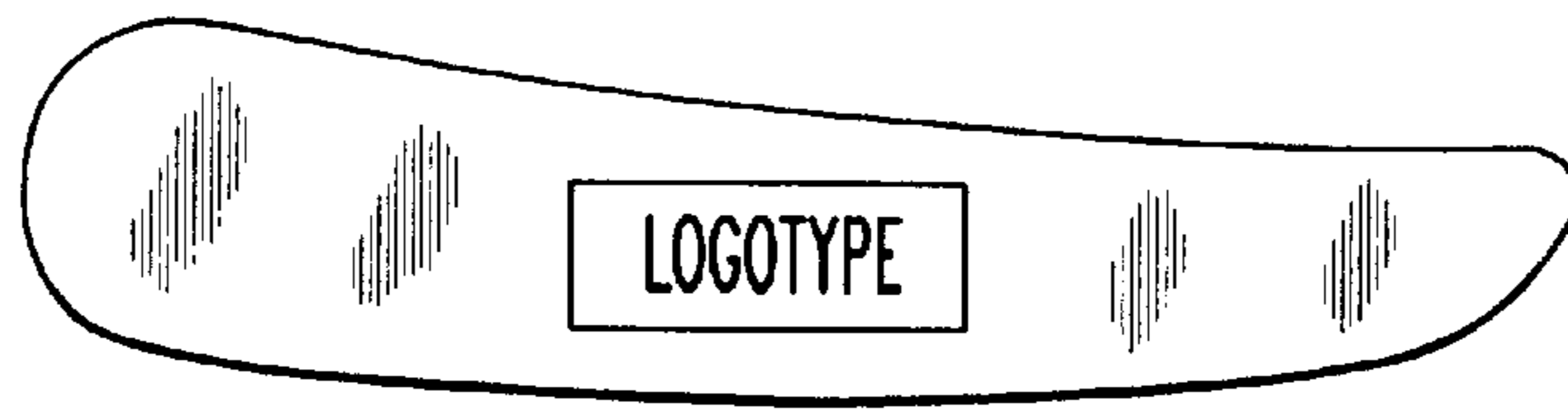

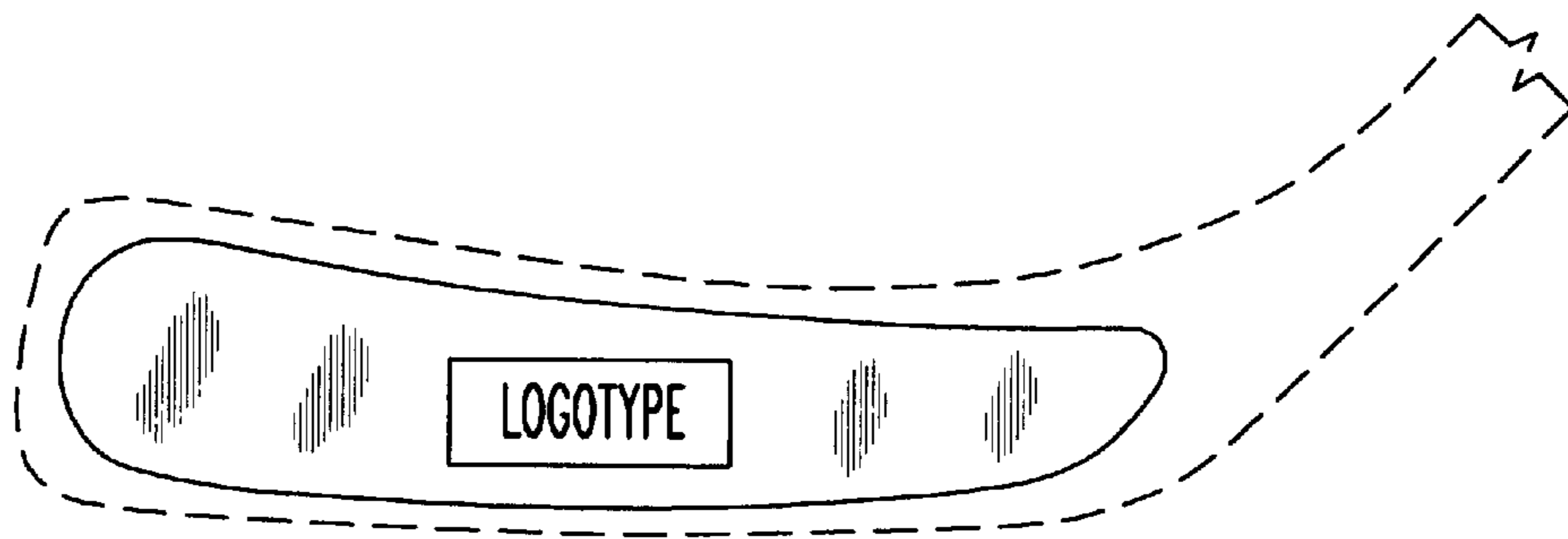

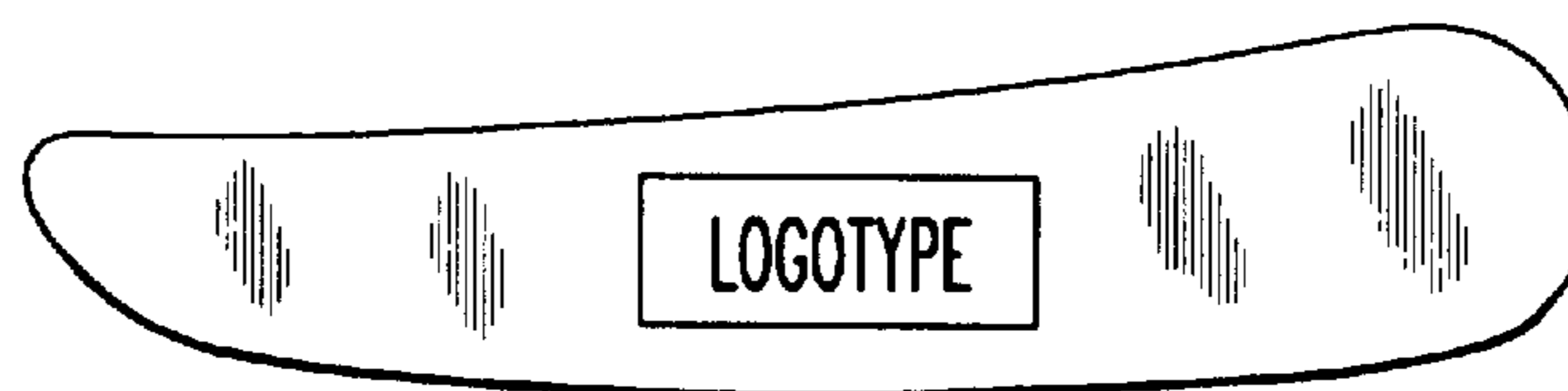

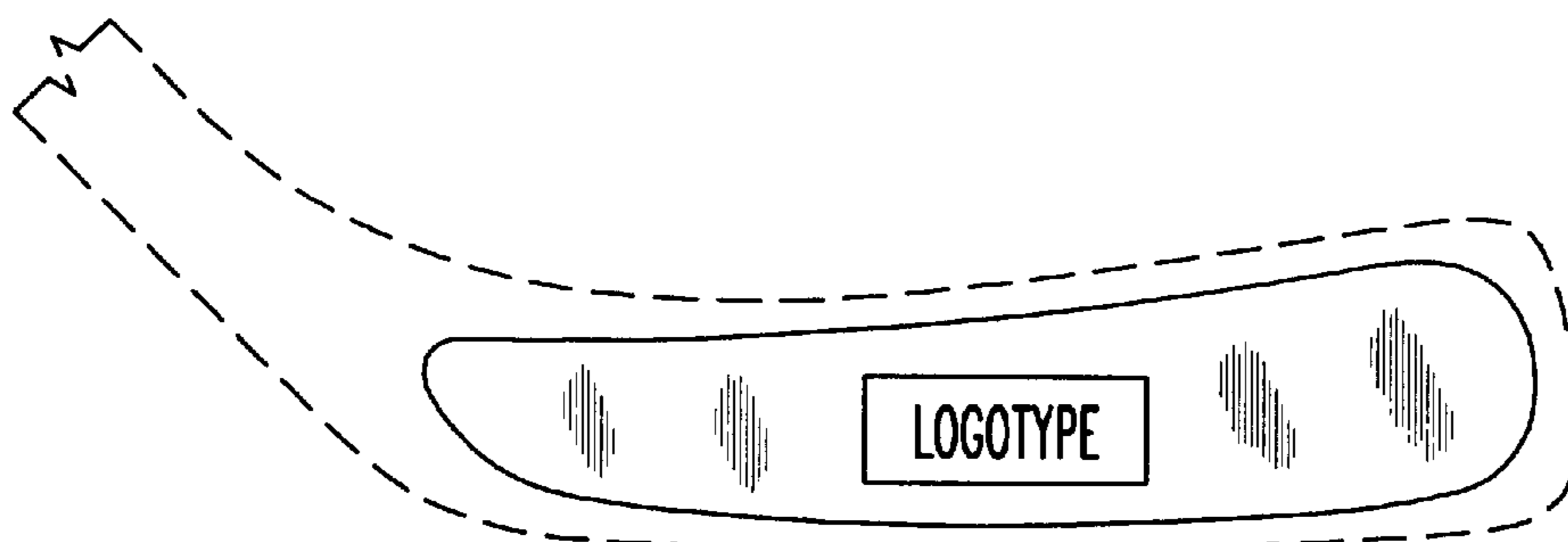

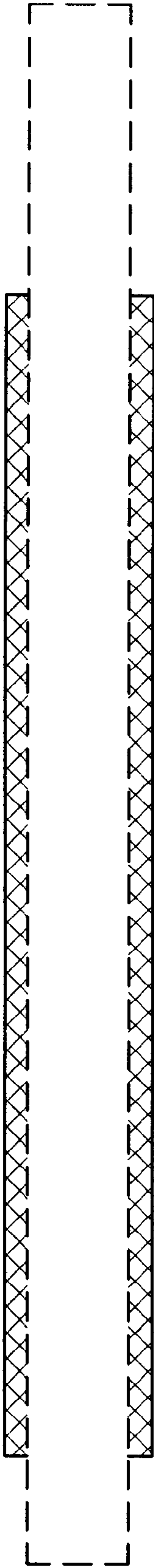

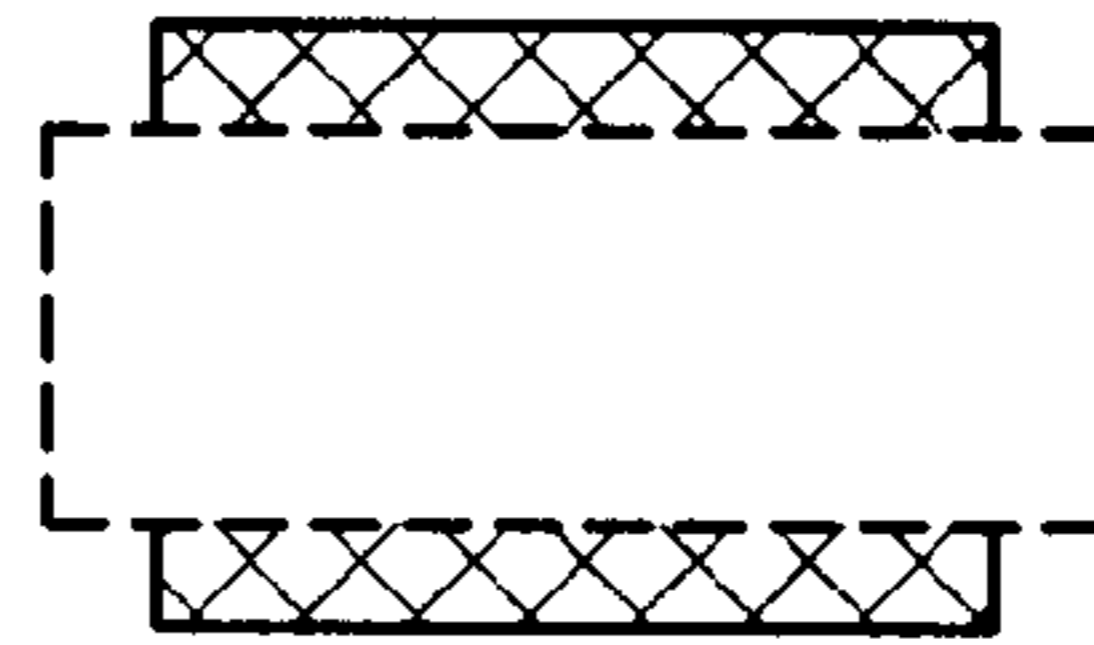
