FIG. 3 is a side view of the bed shown in FIG. 1.

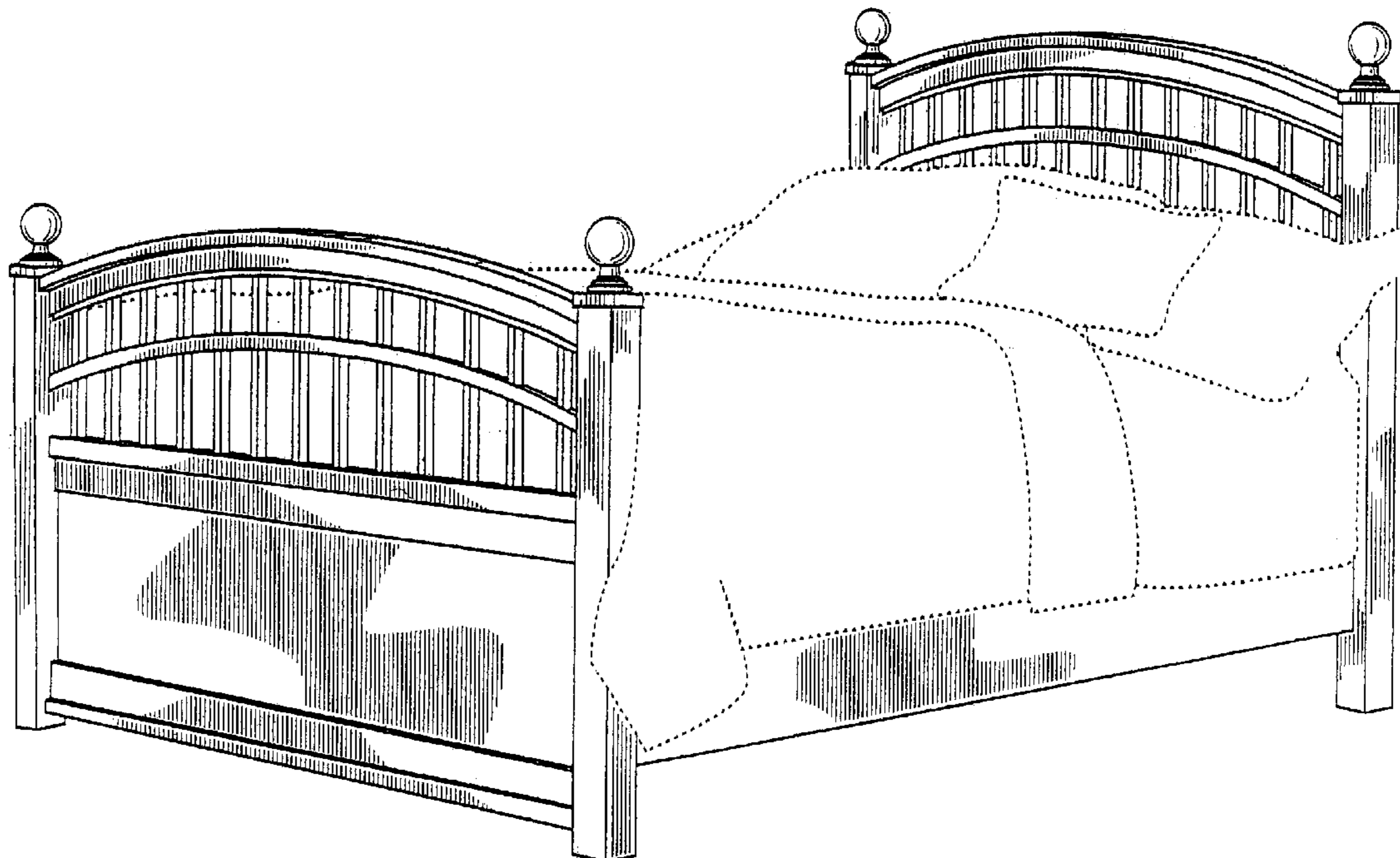
FIG. 4 is a top view of the bed shown in FIG. 1.

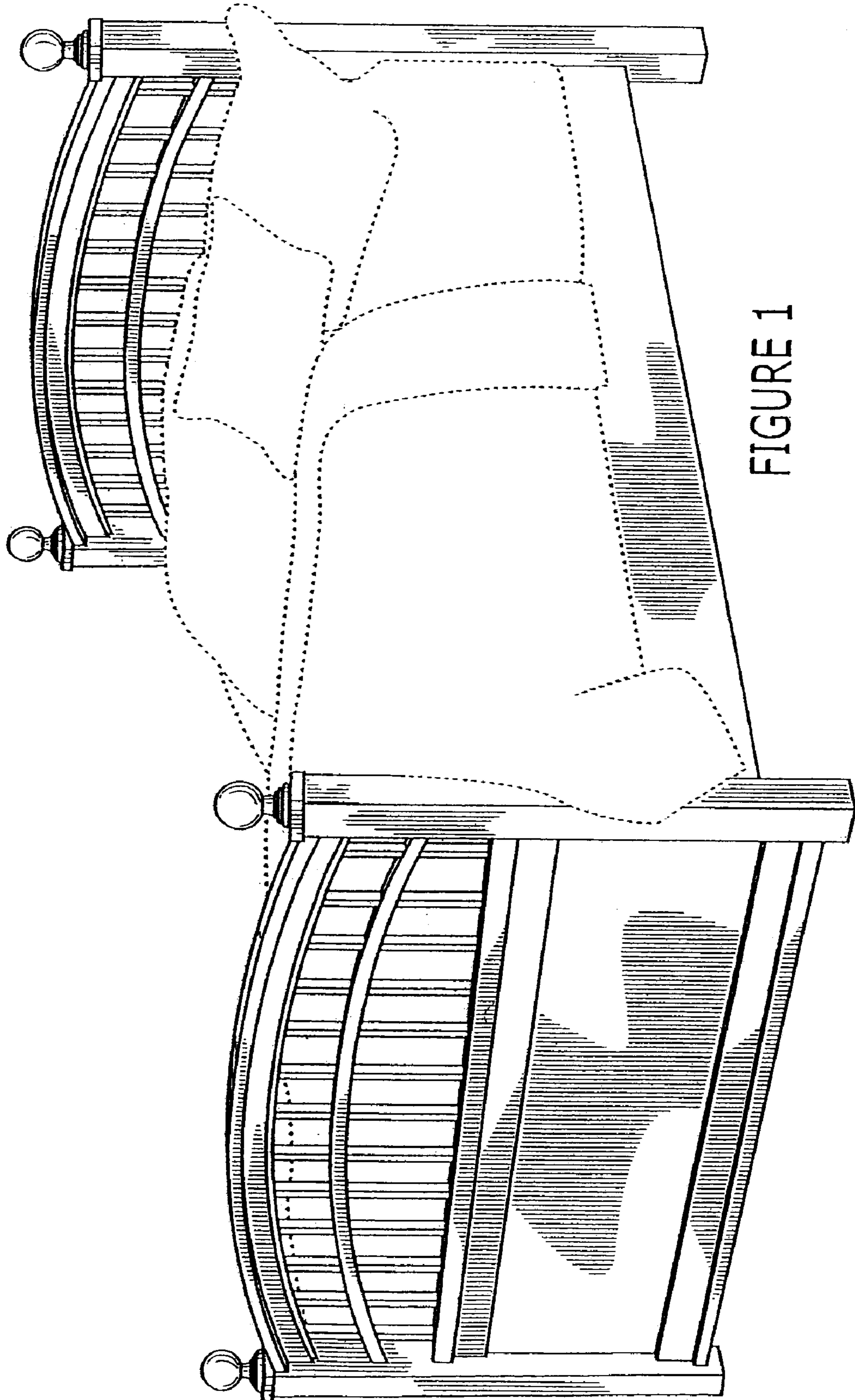

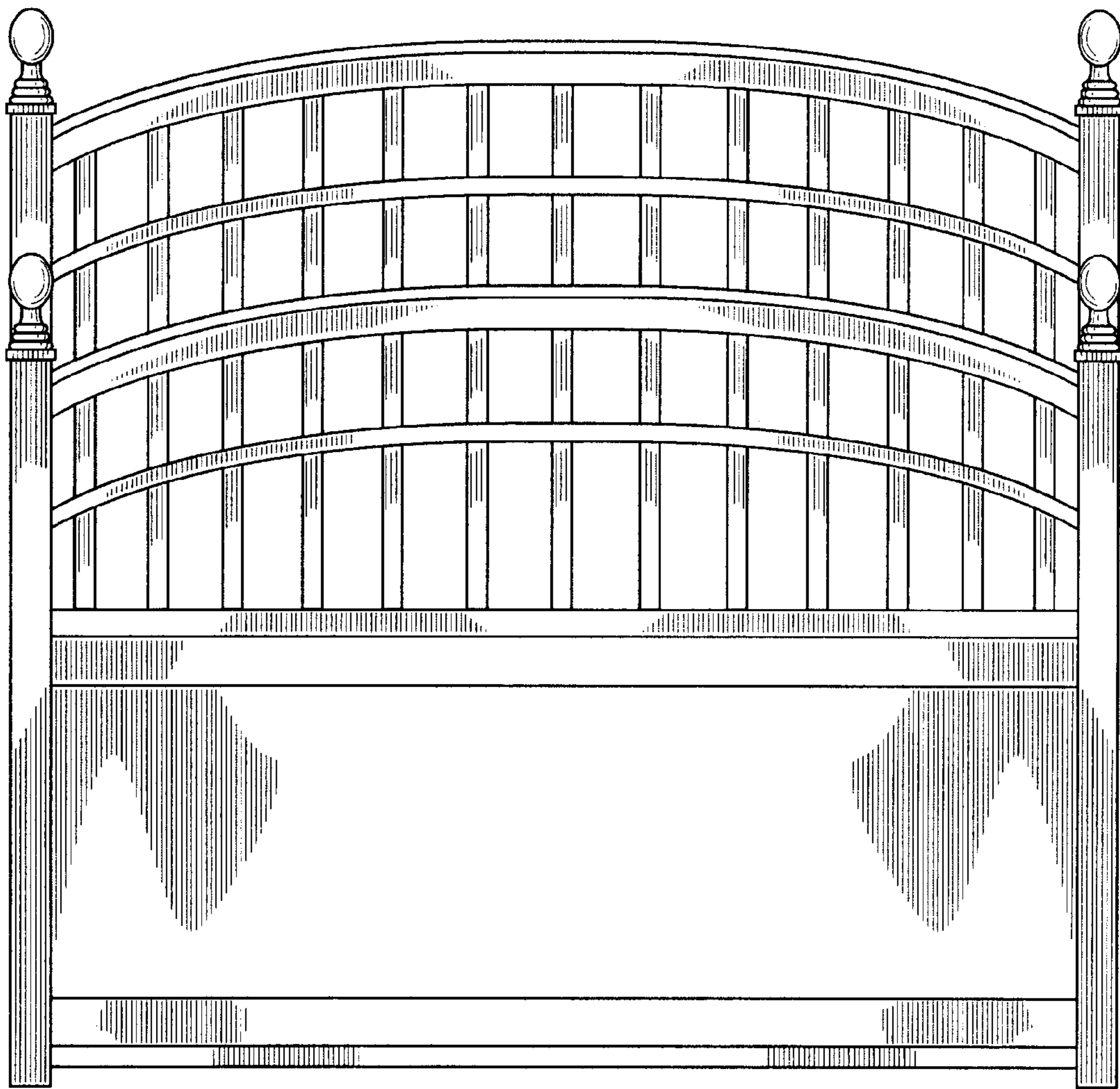

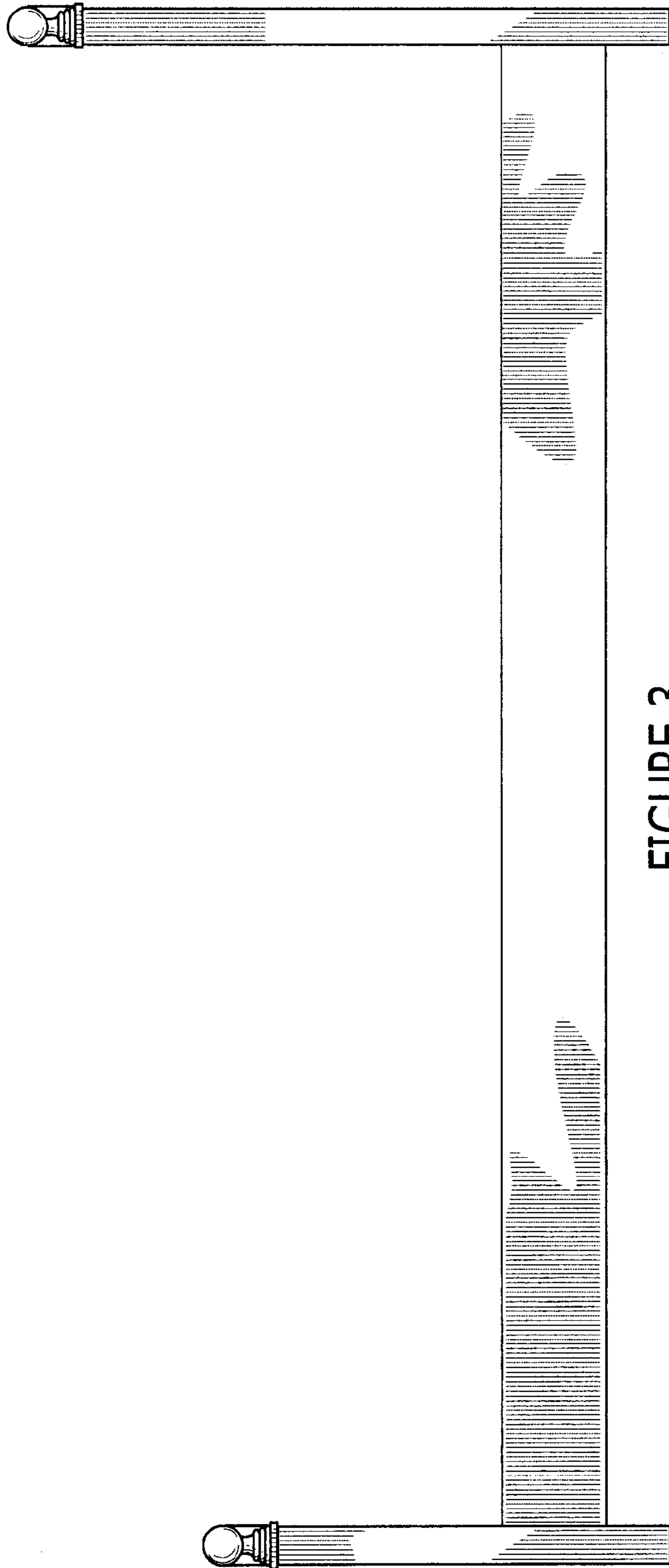

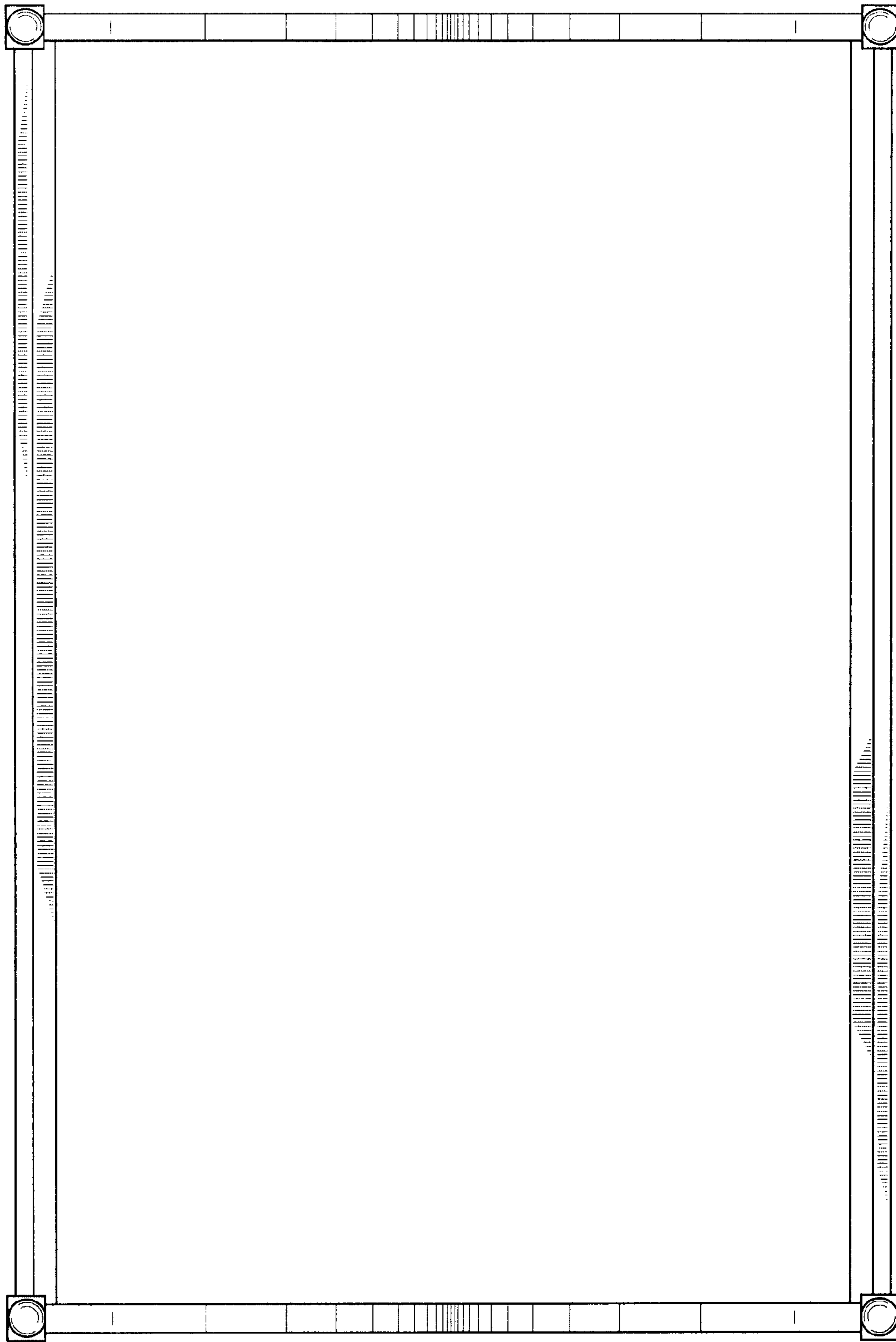

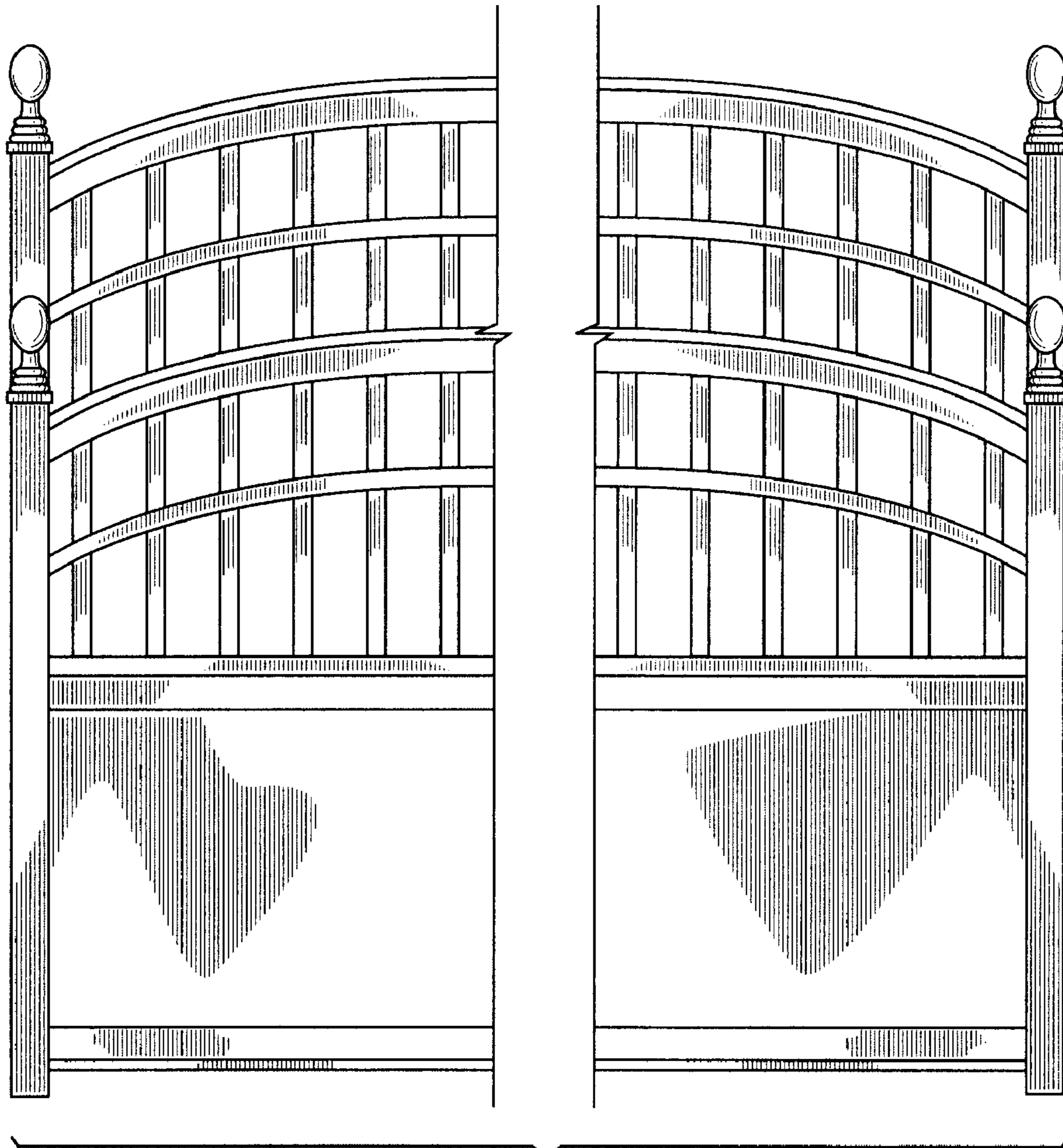

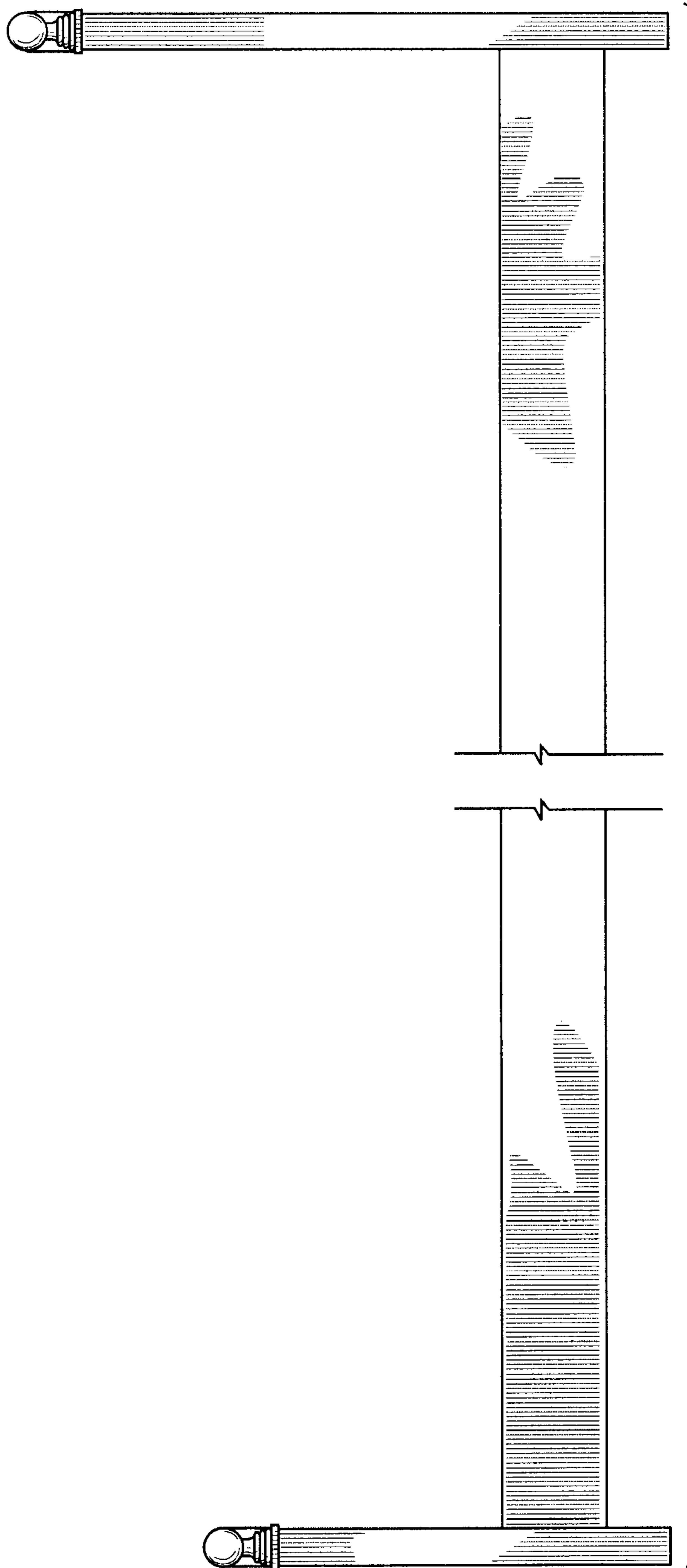
