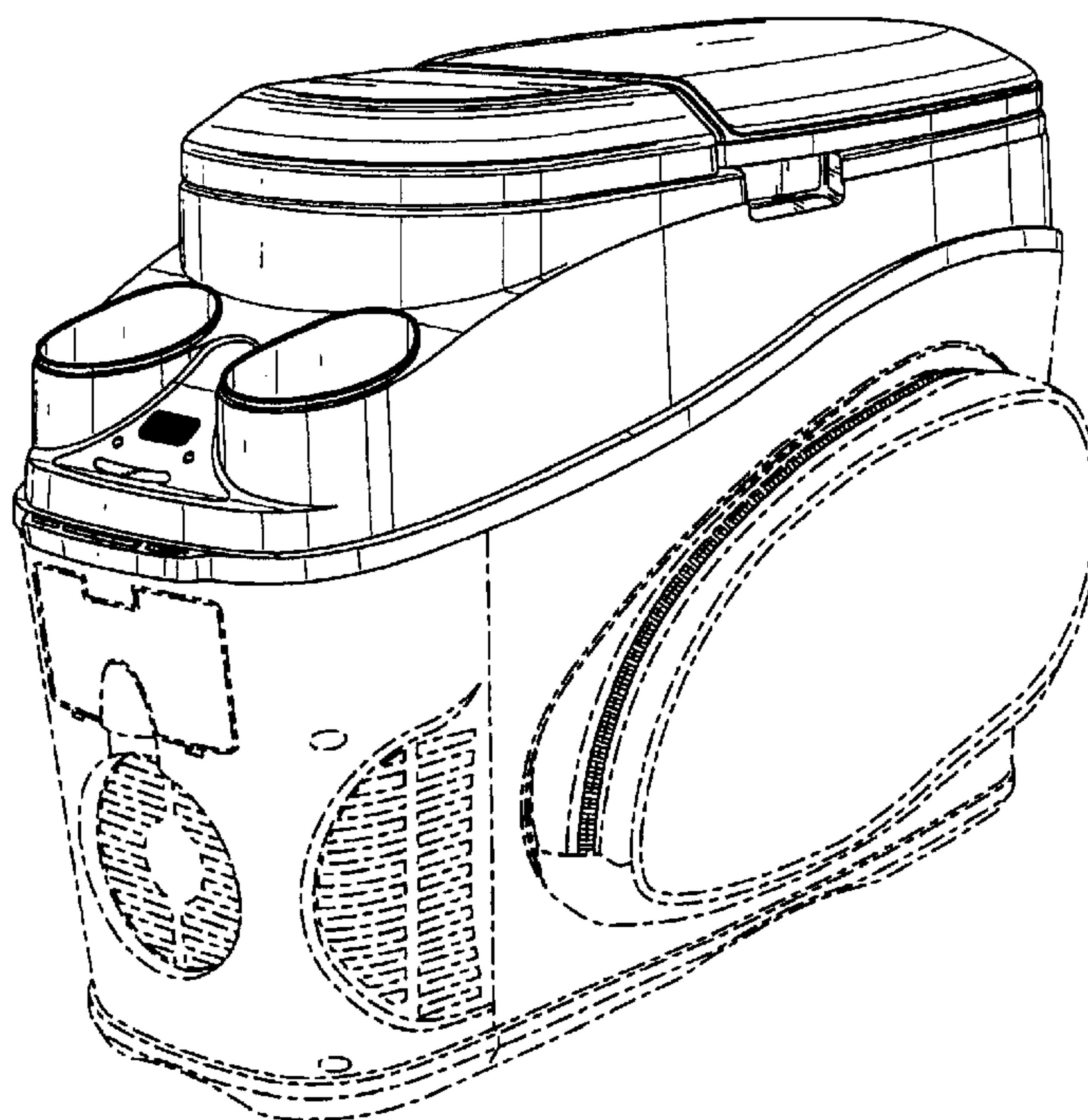
The ornamental design for a travel cooler/warmer top, as

DESCRIPTION

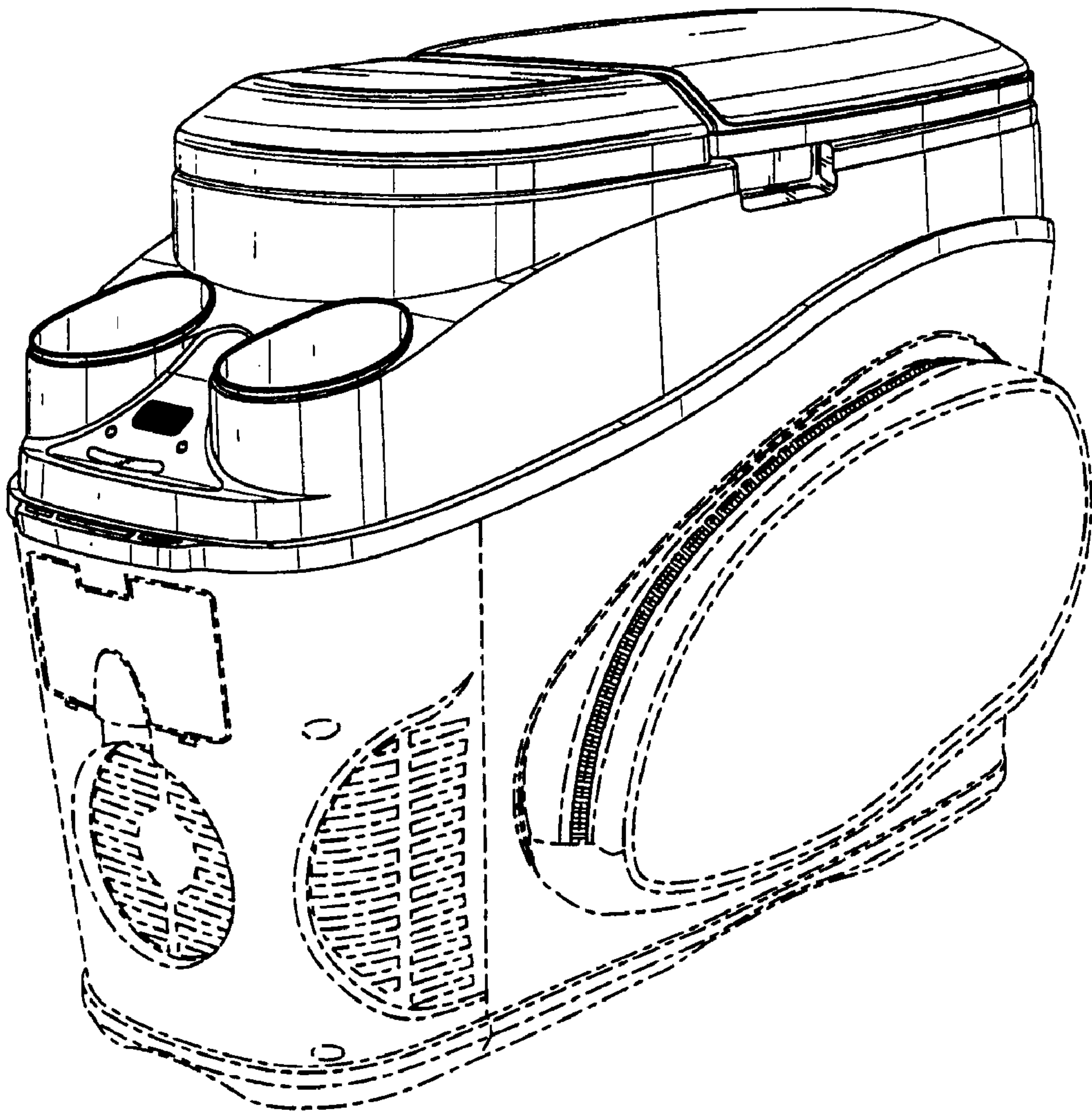

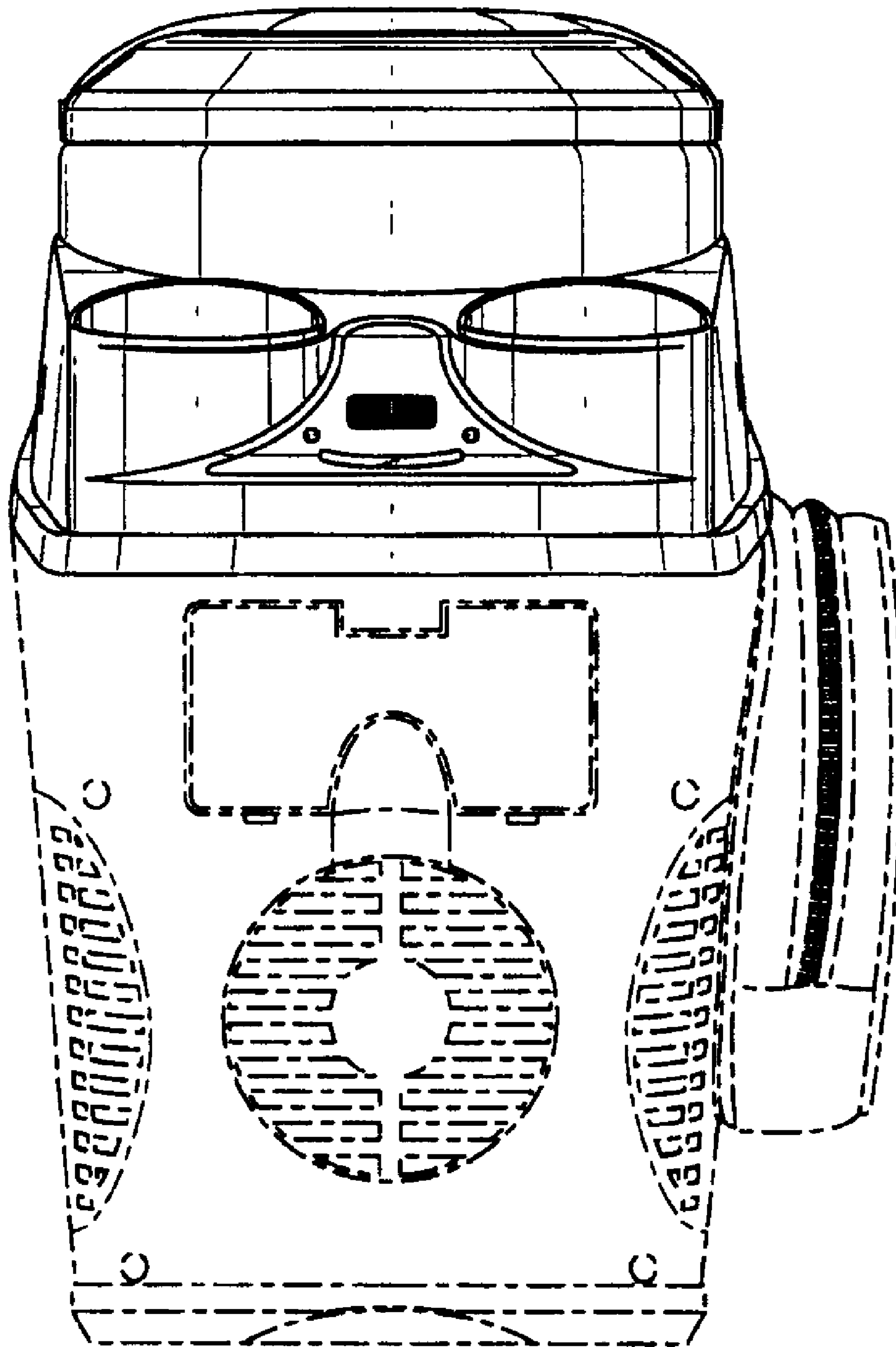

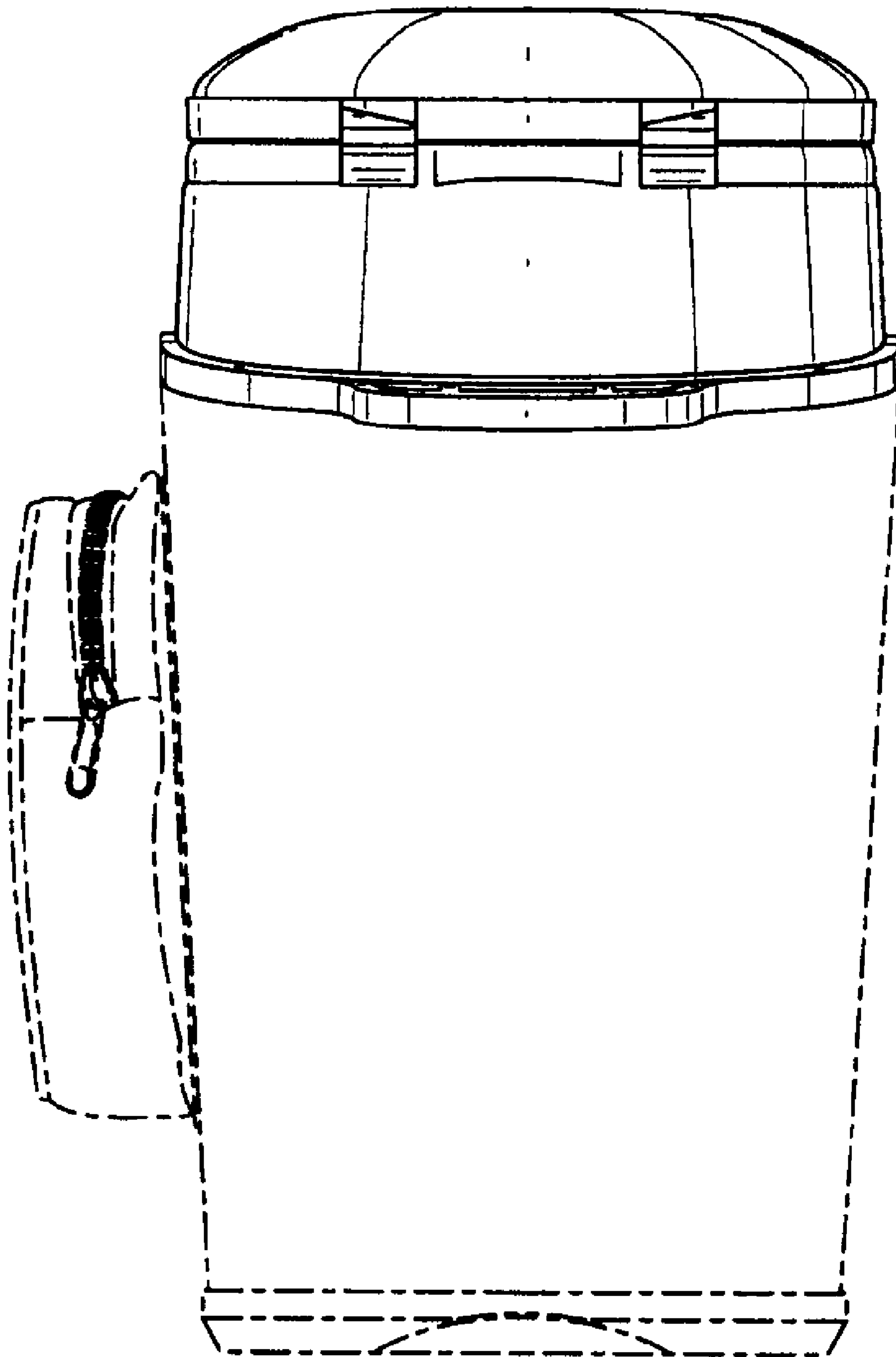

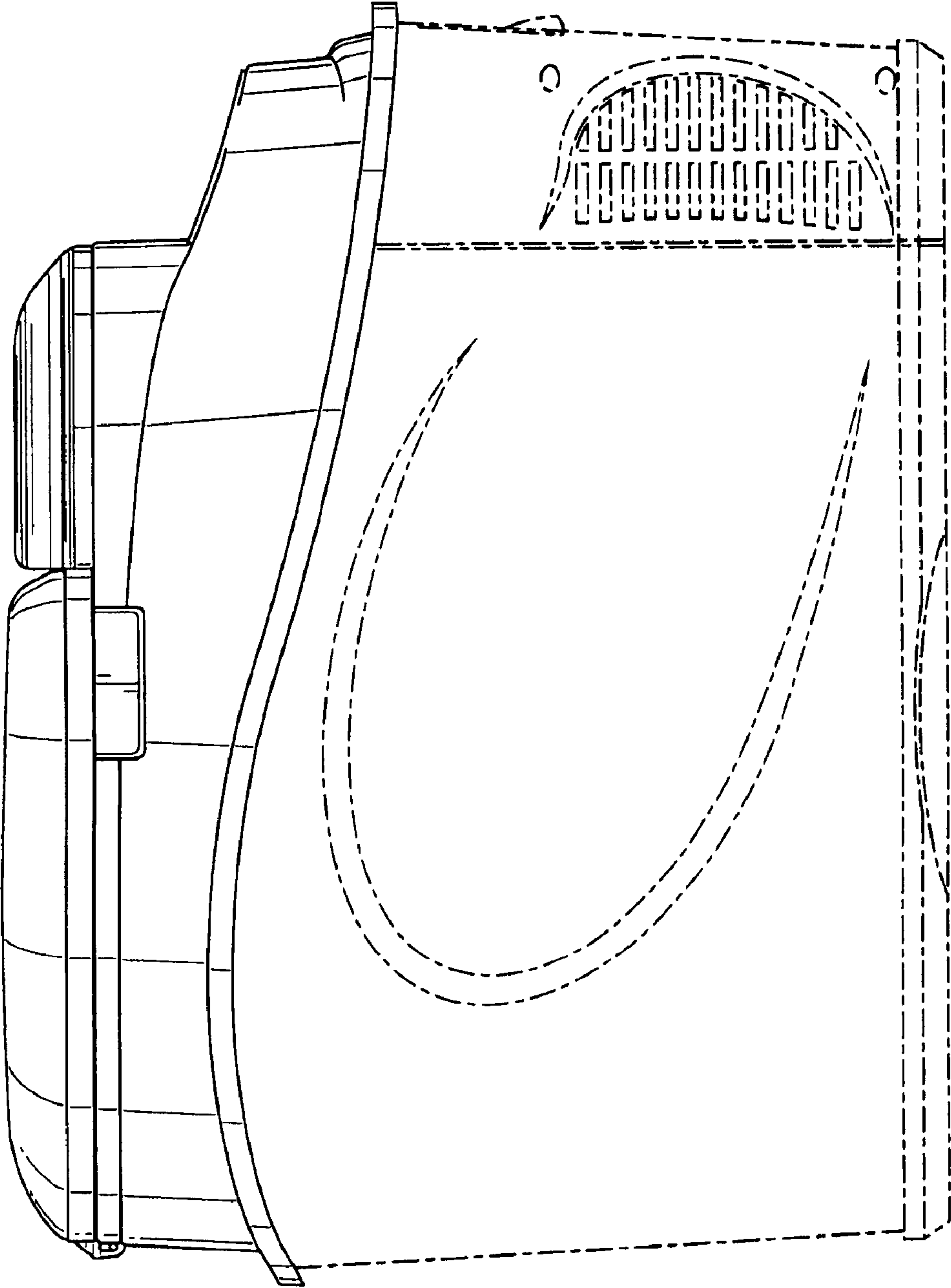

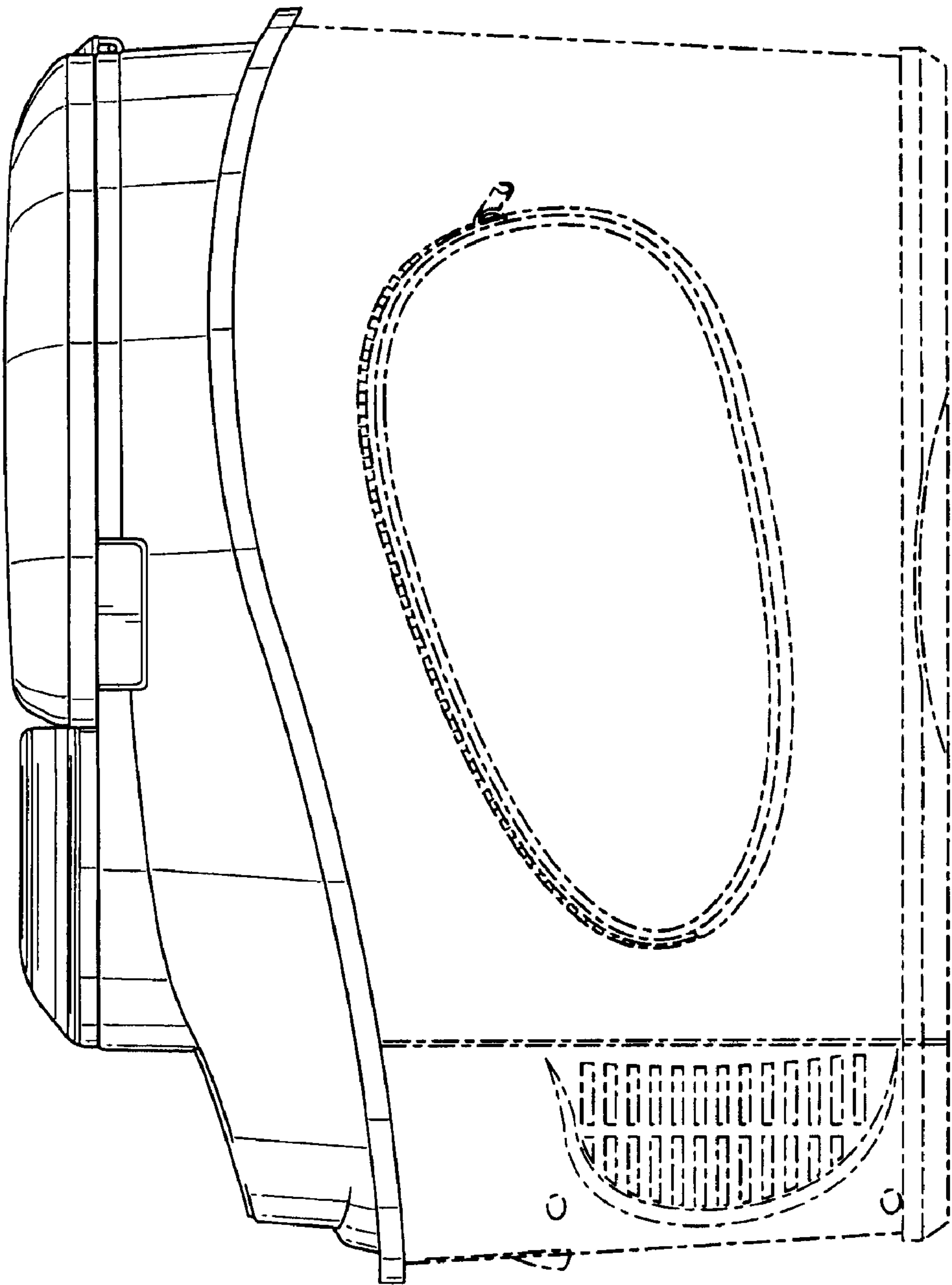

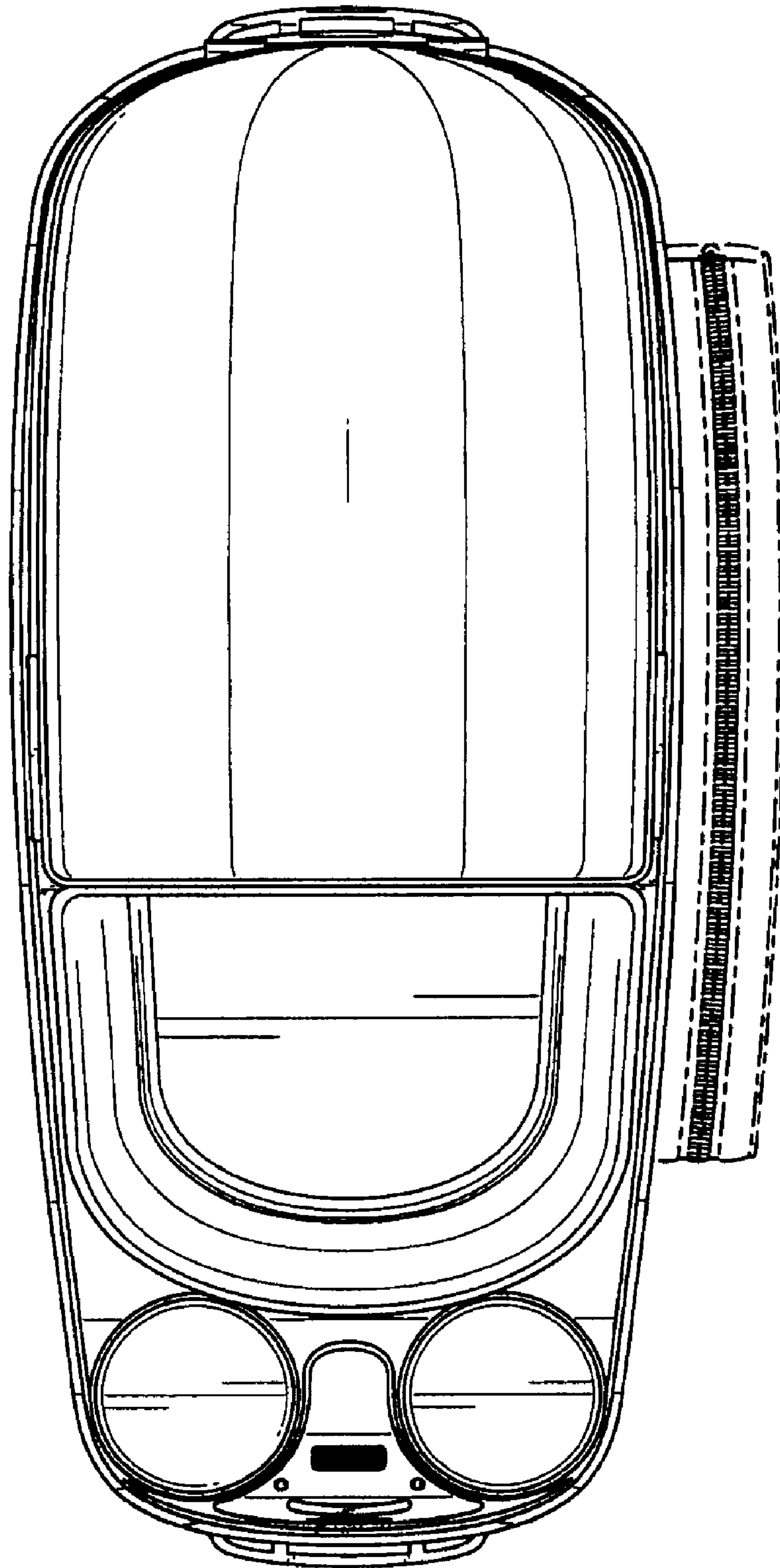

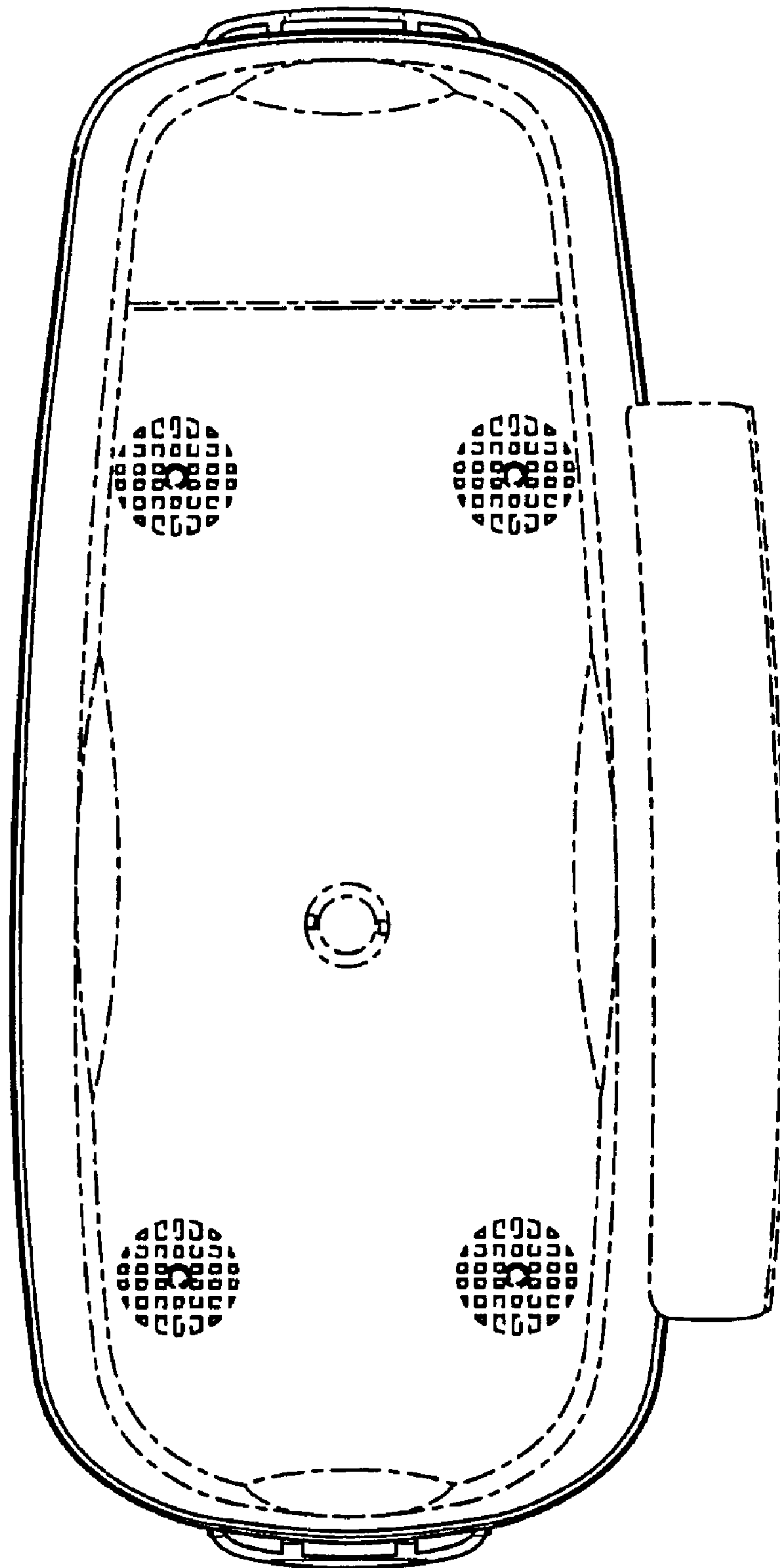
