We claim the ornamental design for a wine cabinet, as shown and described.

### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective elevational view of a wine cabinet according to an embodiment of the invention.


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a wine cabinet according to an embodiment of the invention.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of a wine cabinet according to an embodiment of the invention, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a wine cabinet according to an embodiment of the invention.








