(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cocktail table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a cocktail table showing my new design, the rear being identical.

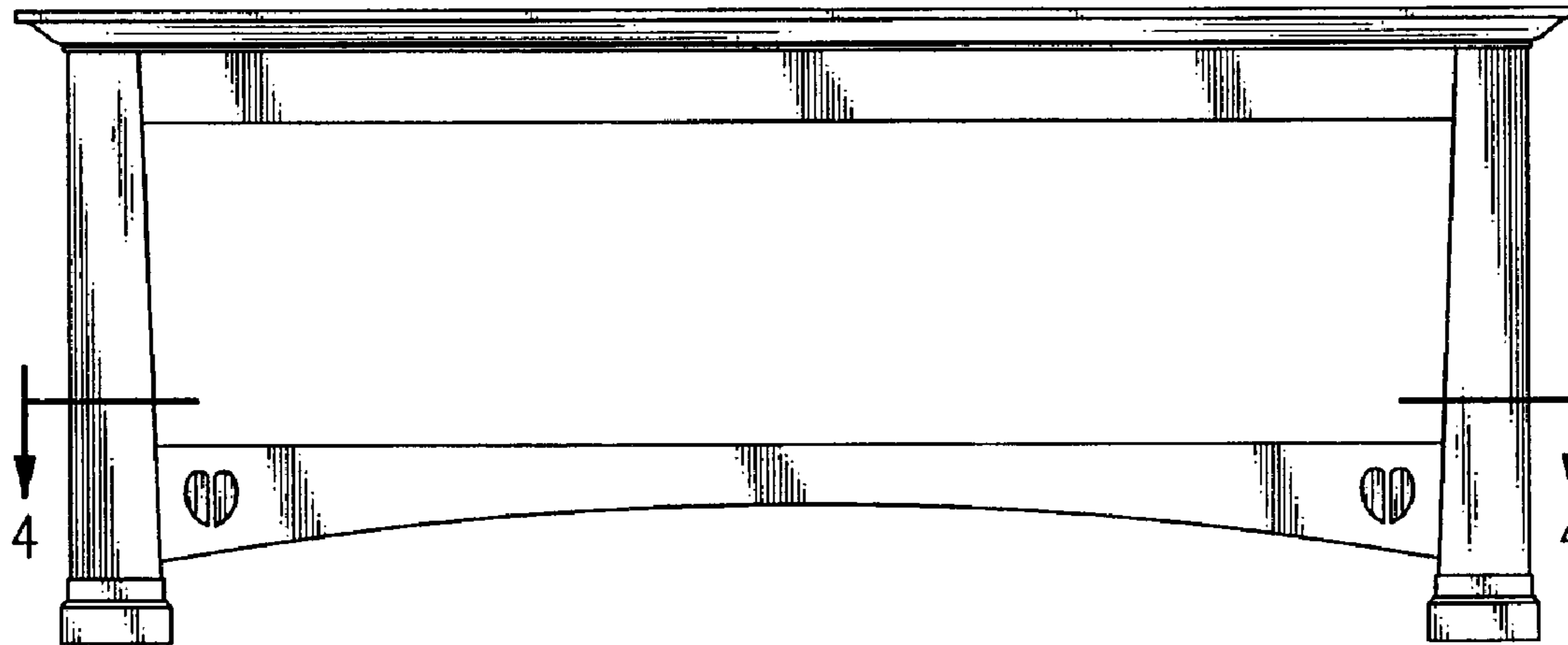
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof with a lattice shelf visible through the framed glass top; and,

FIG. 4 is a plan view taken at line 4—4 in FIG. 1, and showing the lattice shelf.

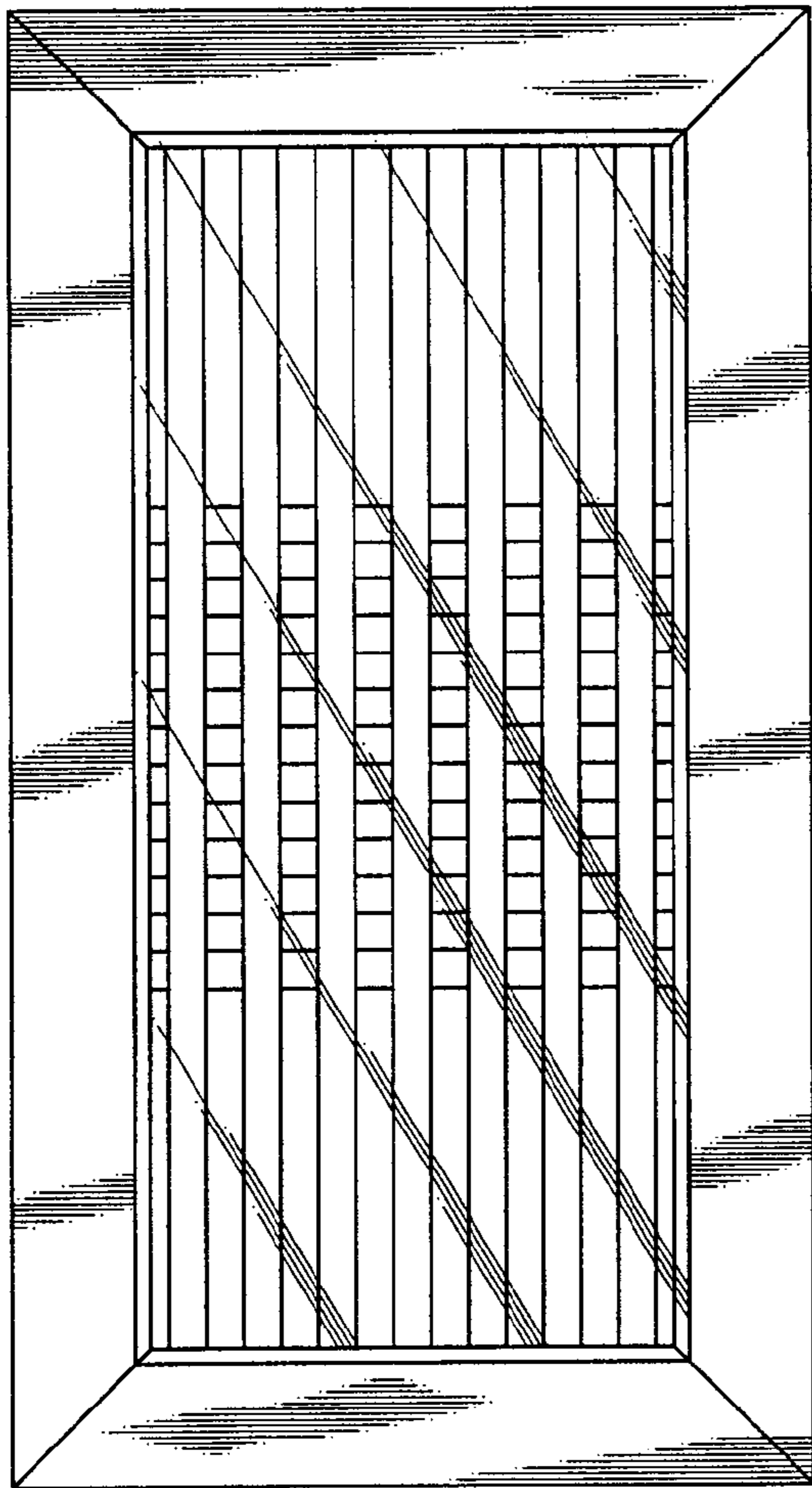

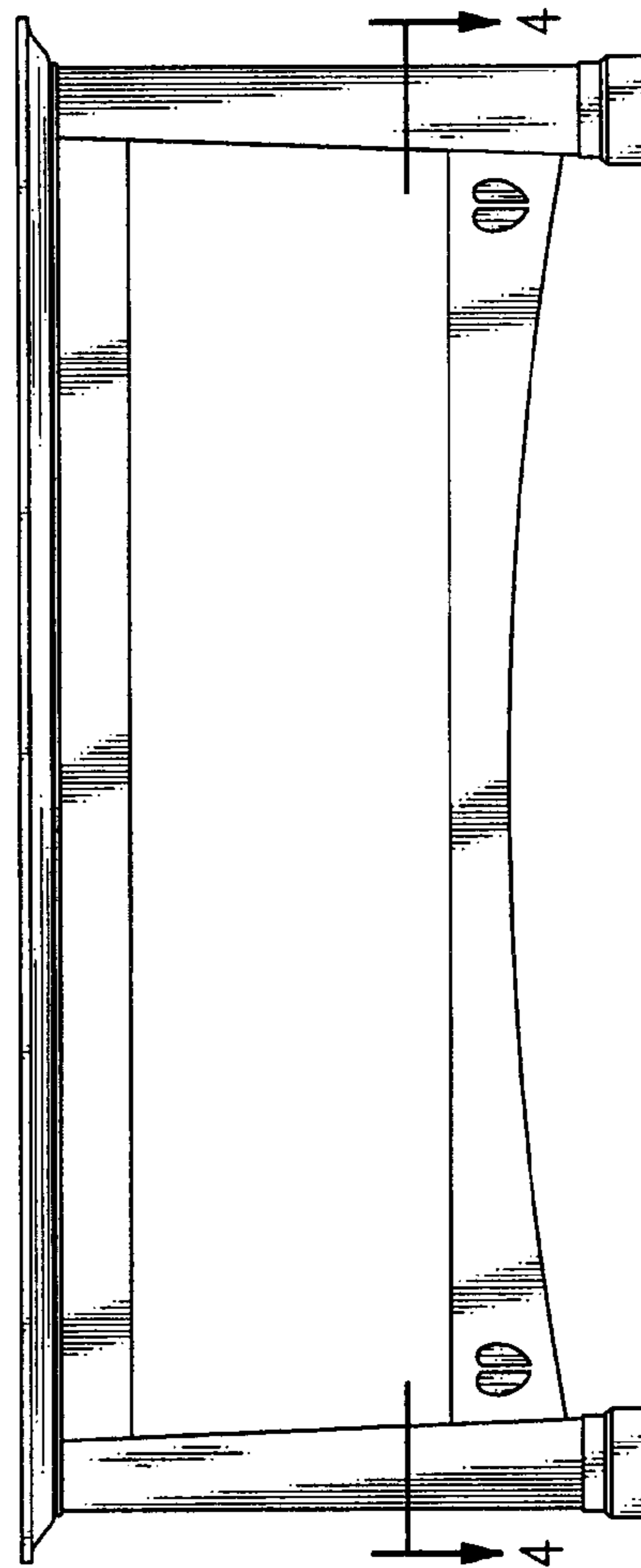

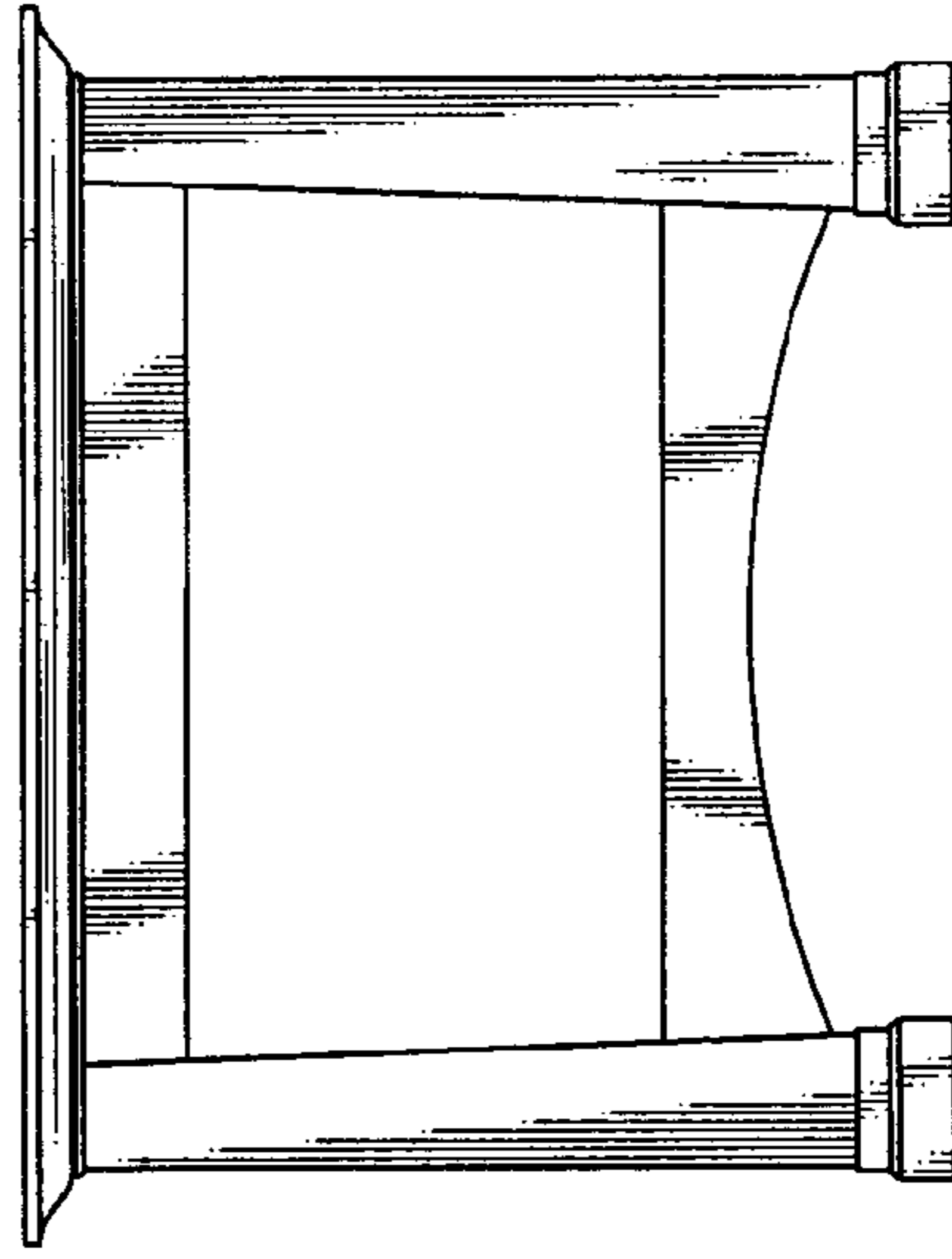

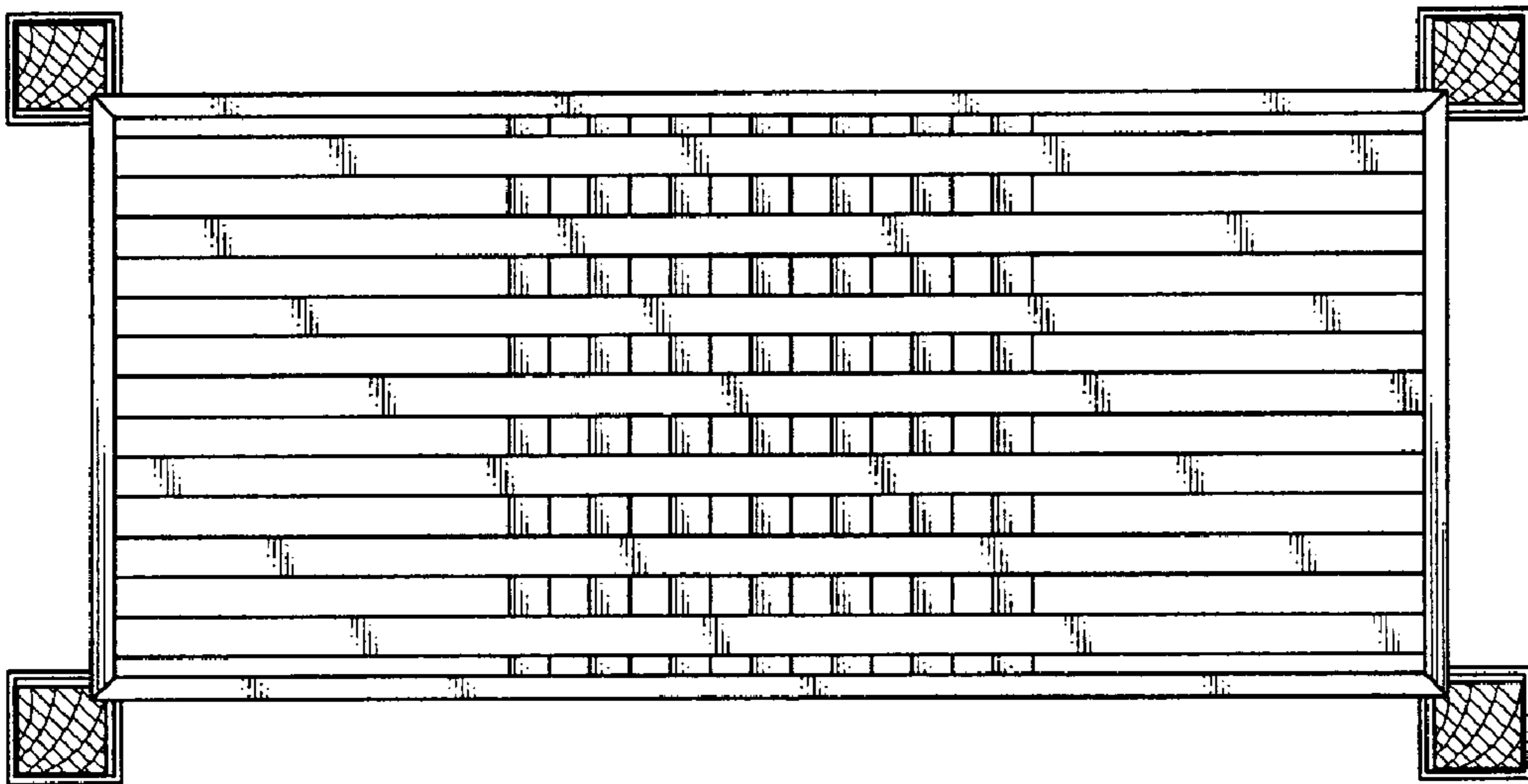
