FIG. 4 is a rear view of the surface configuration of a handle for kitchen gadgets according to our novel design;

FIG. 5 is right side view of a surface configuration of a handle for kitchen gadgets according to our novel design, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the surface configuration of a handle for kitchen gadgets according to our novel design; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the surface configuration of a handle for kitchen gadgets according to our novel design.

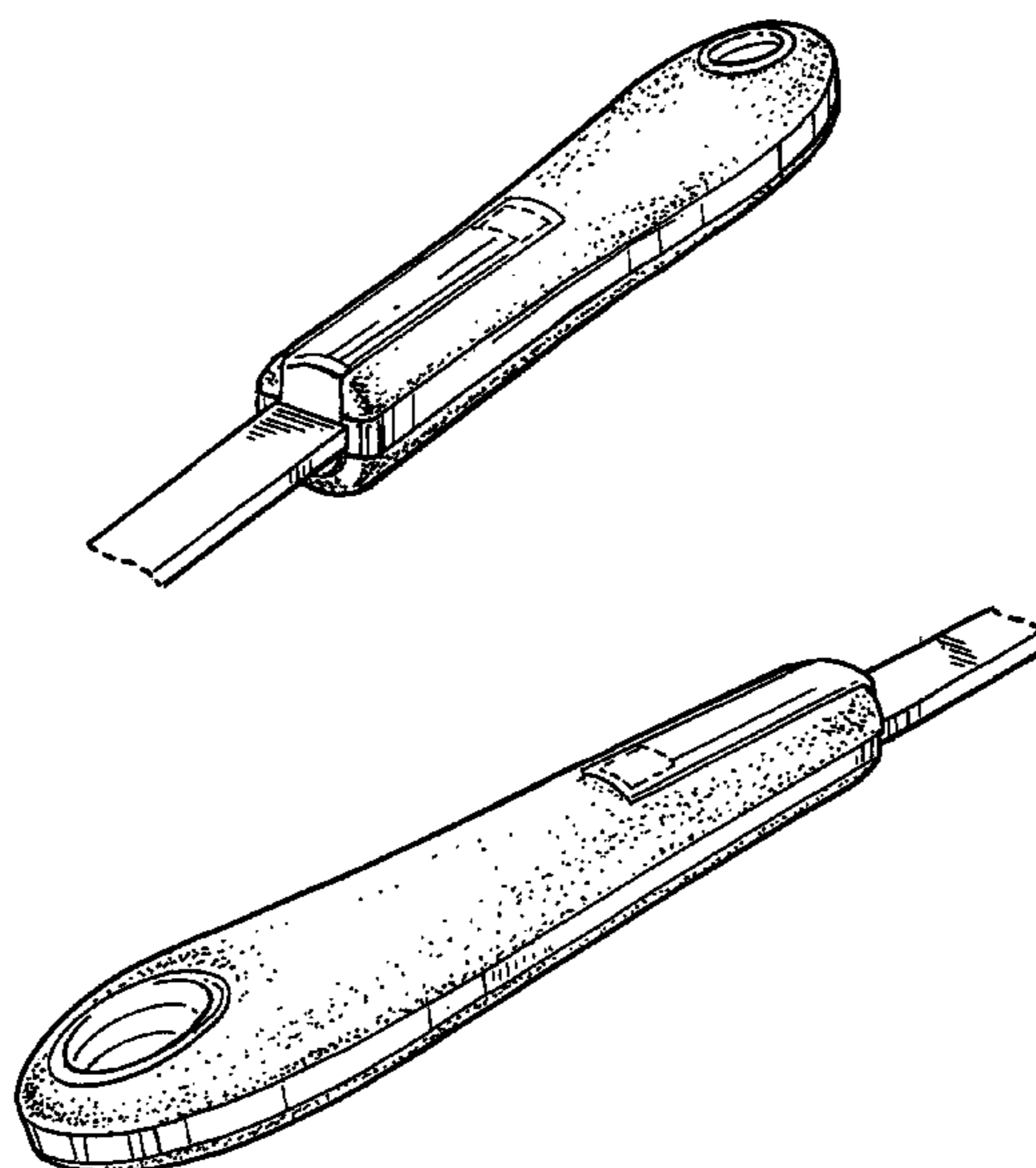
The broken lines immediately adjacent the shaded areas represent the bounds of the claim and form no part of the claimed design.

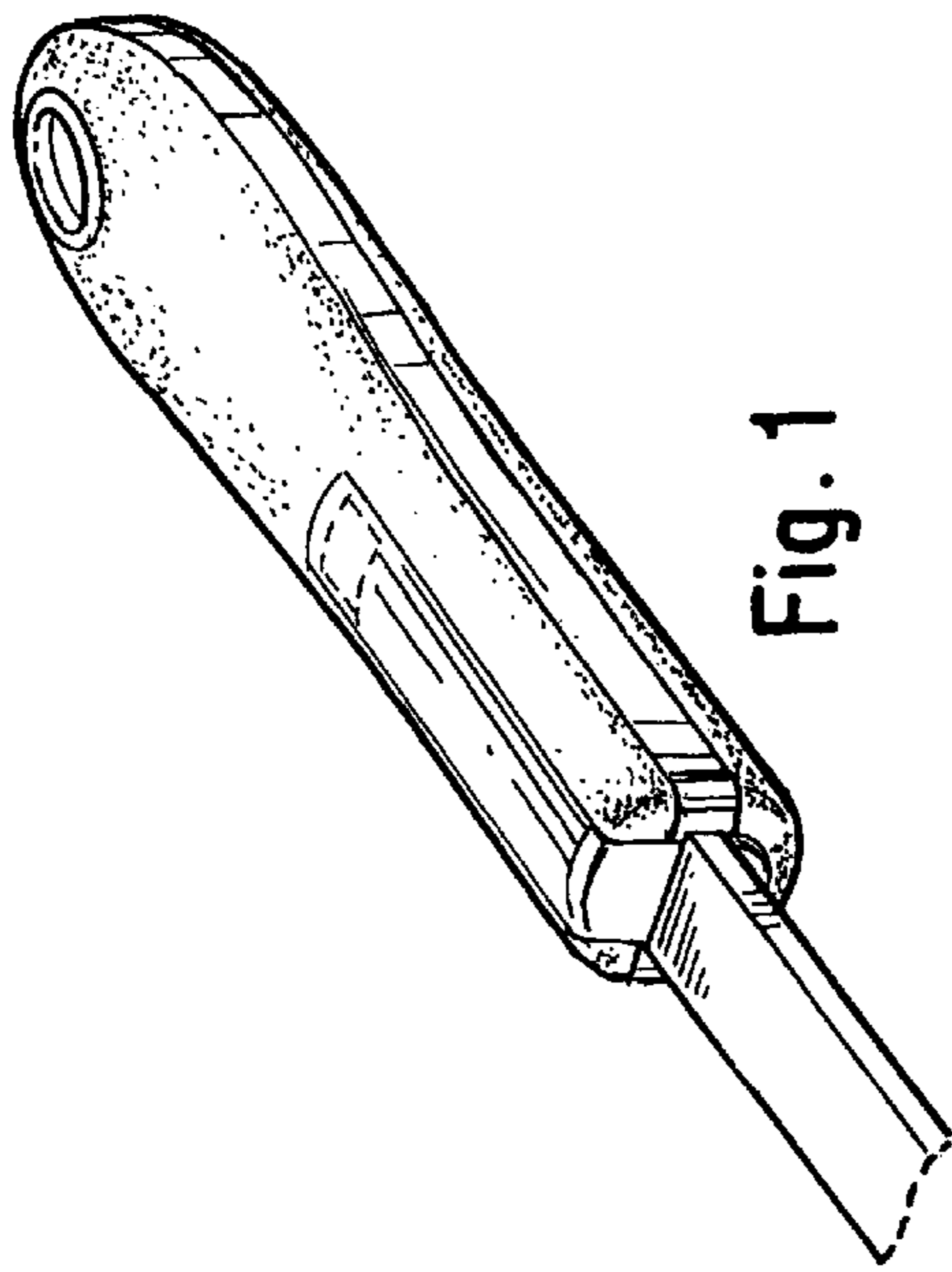

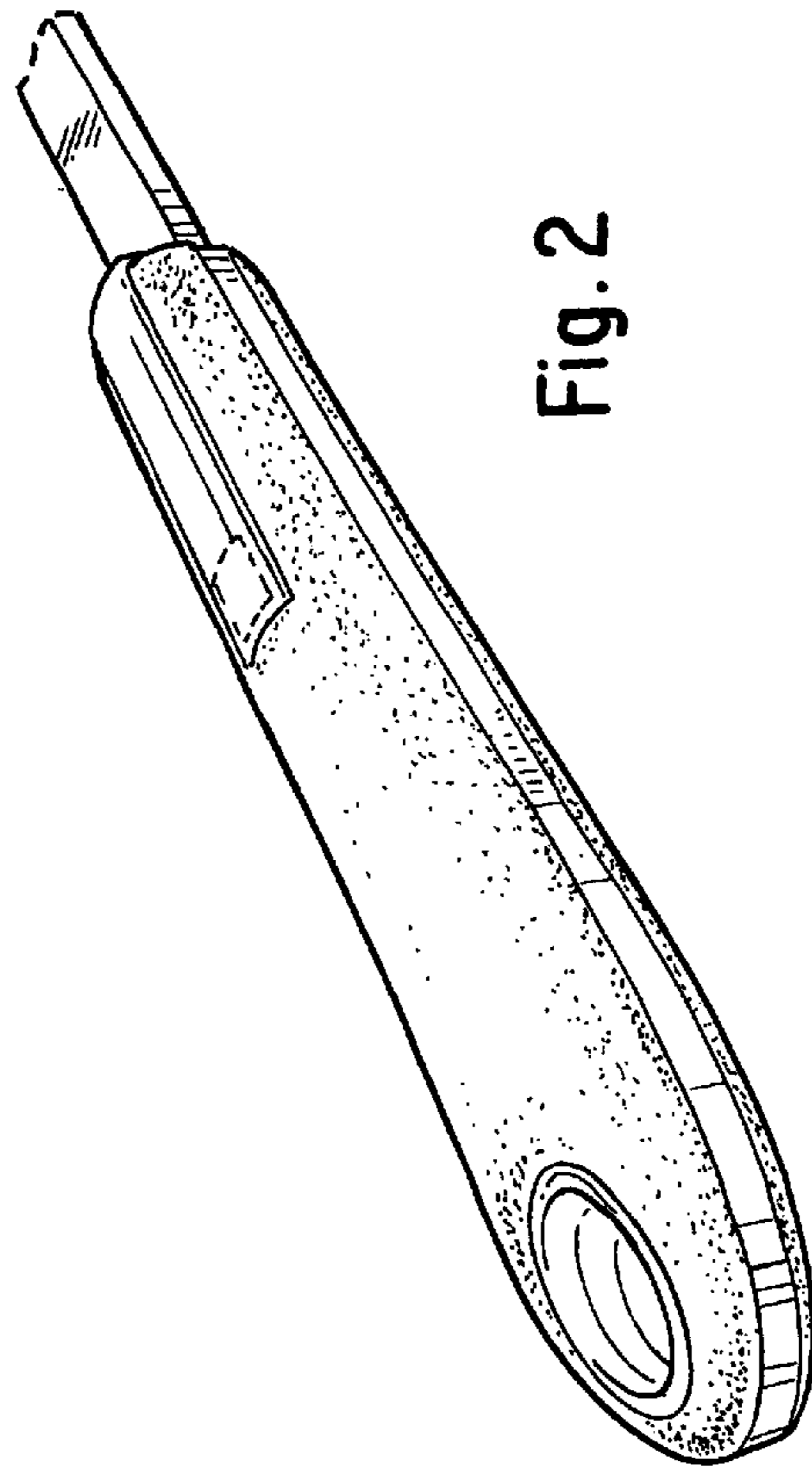

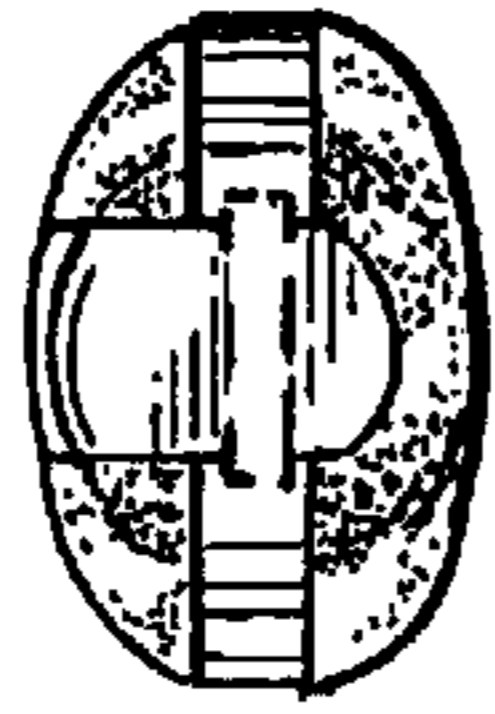

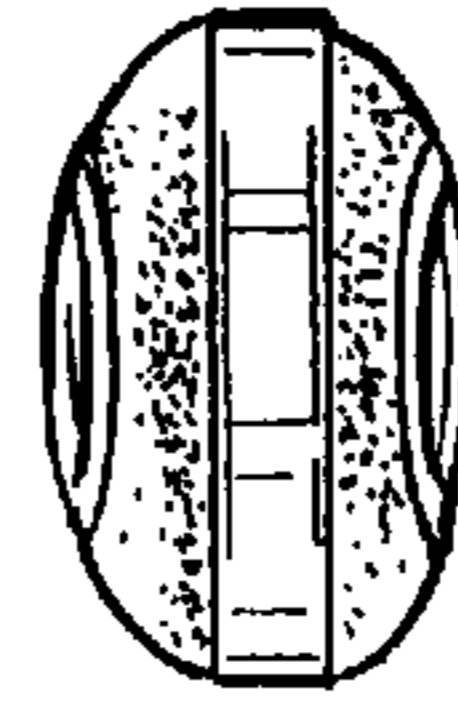

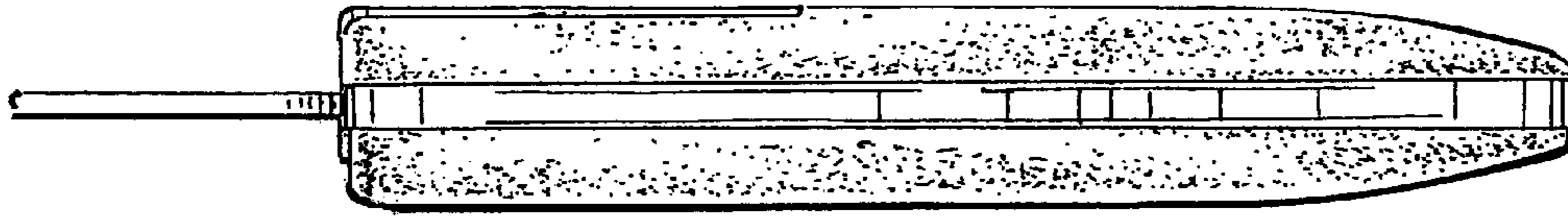

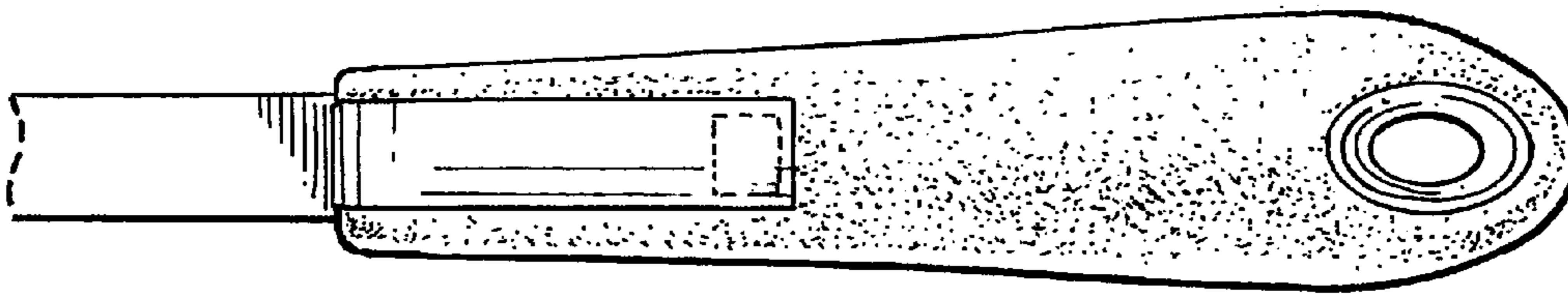

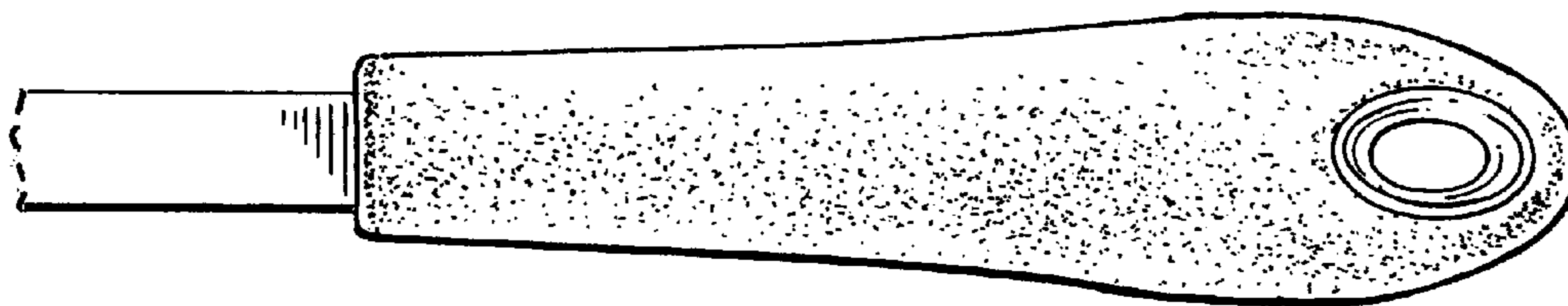
