FIG. 5 is a front plan view, the rear plan view being identical.

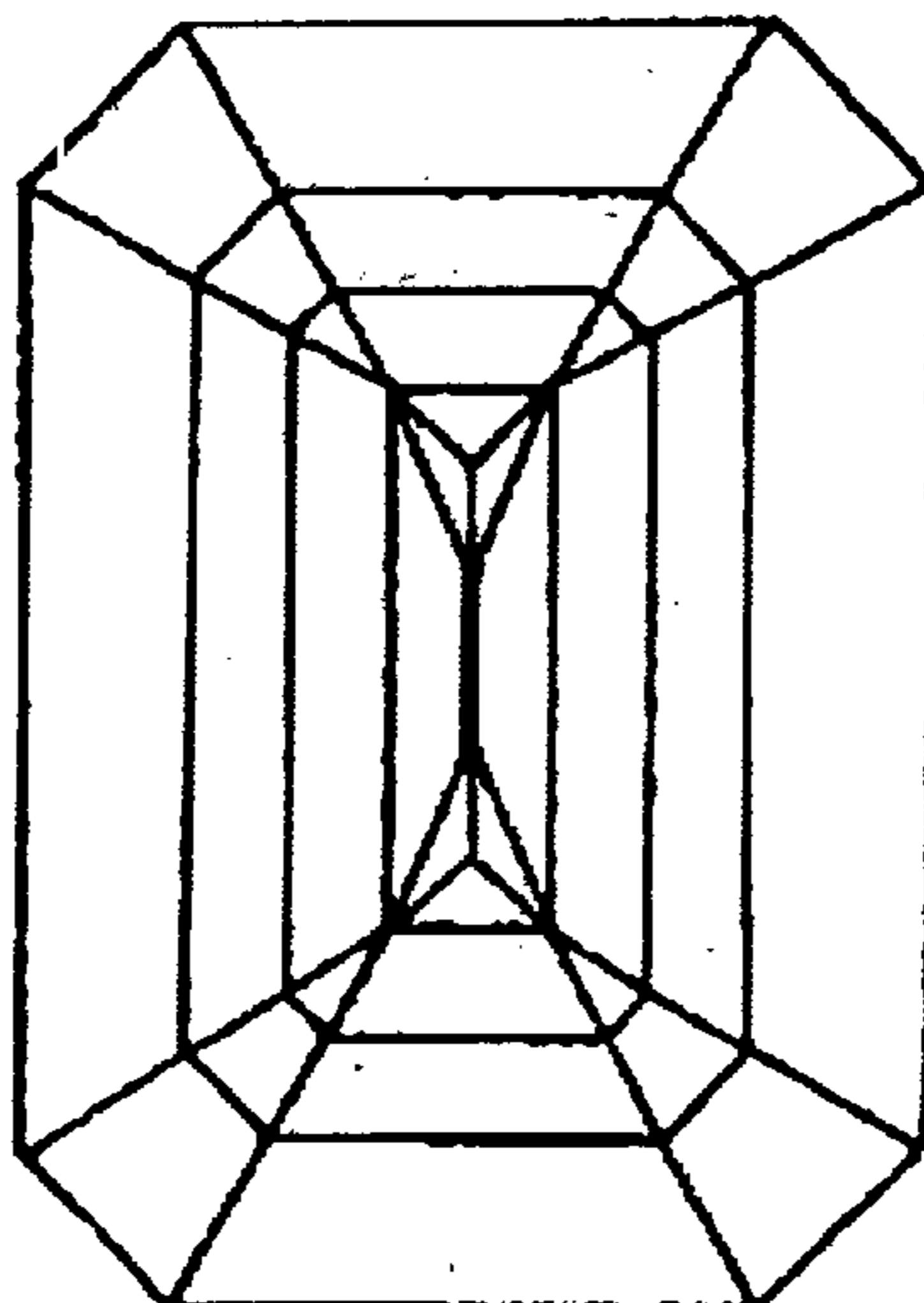
The portions of the stone shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1-5 are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

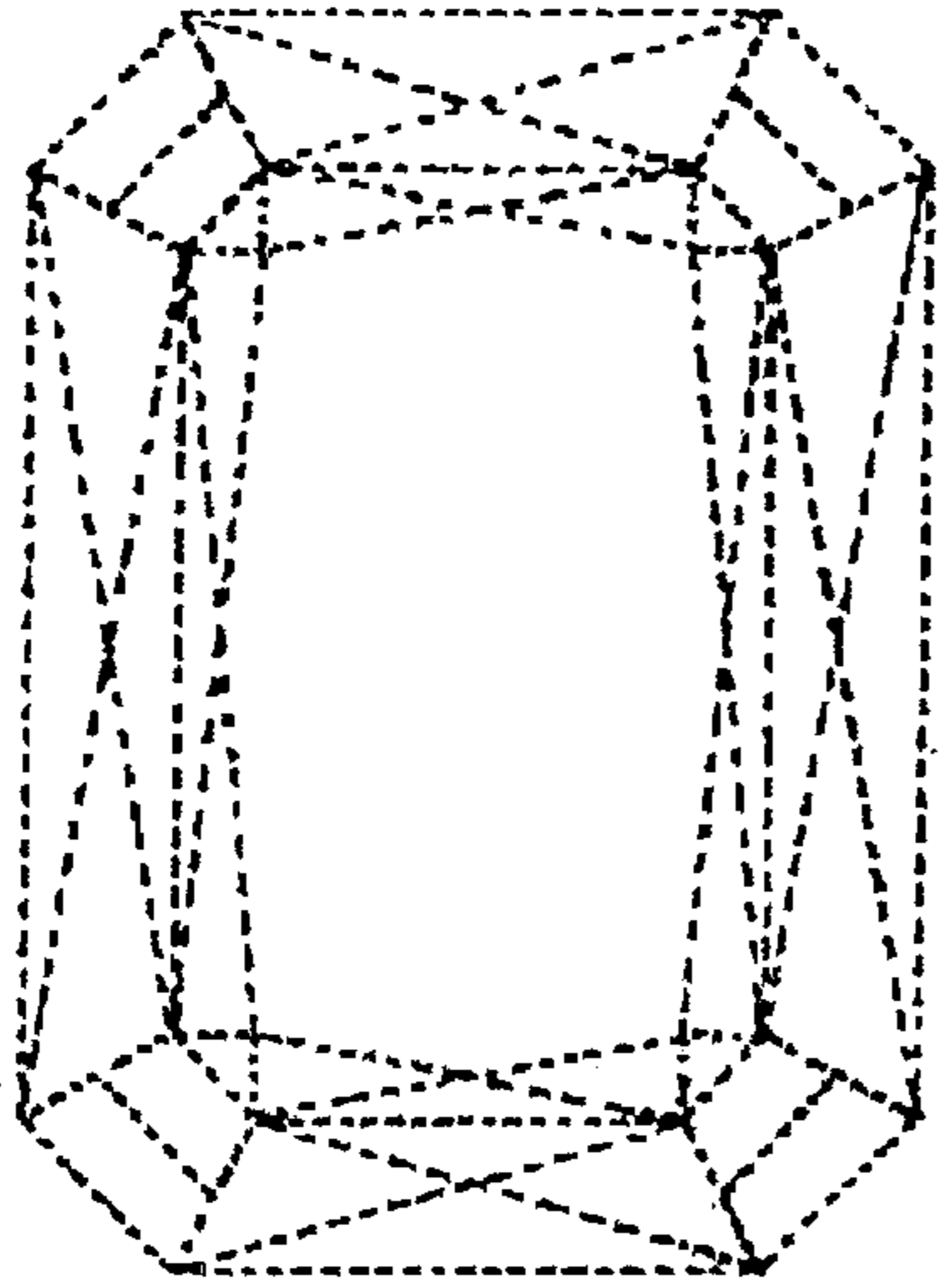

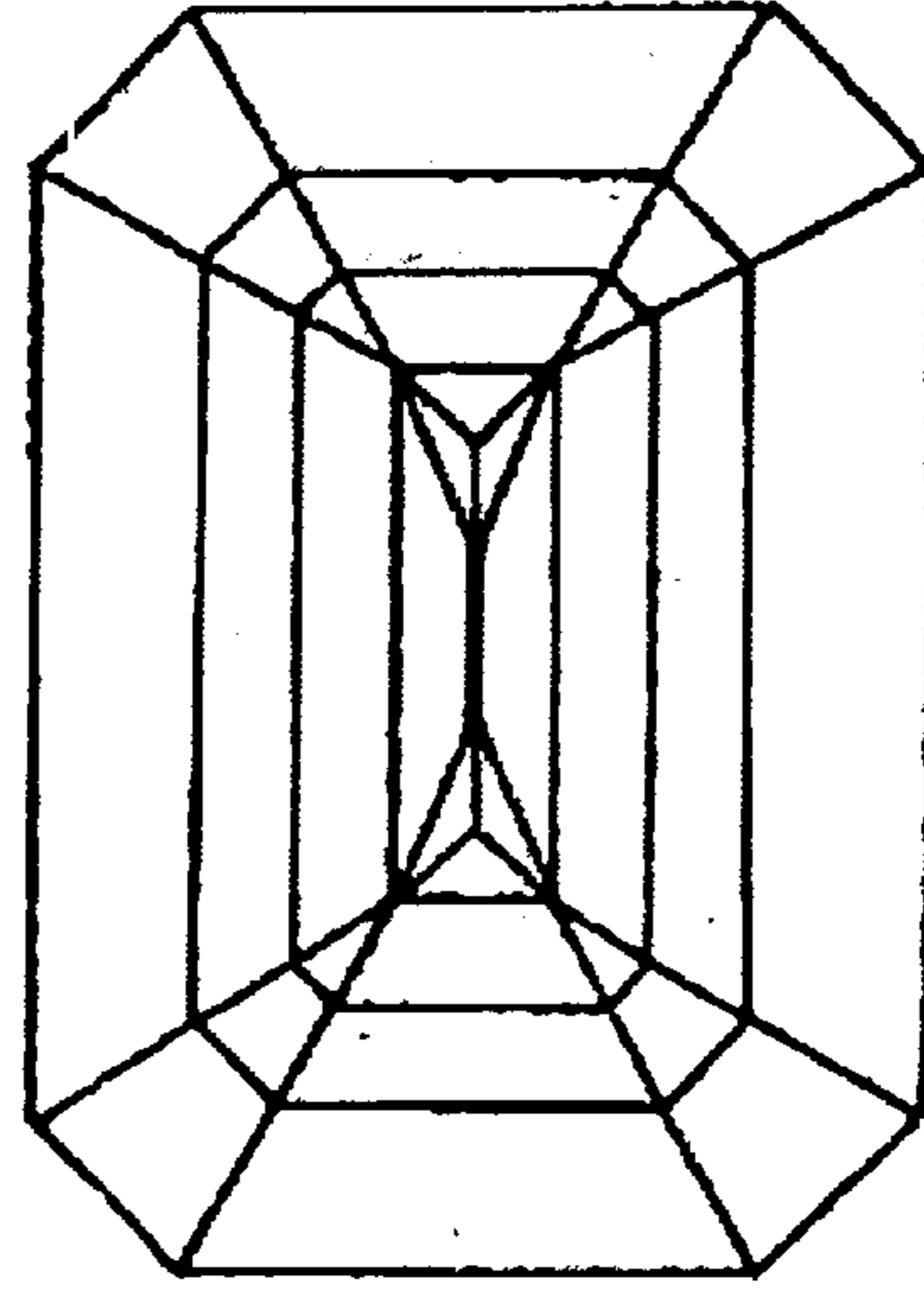

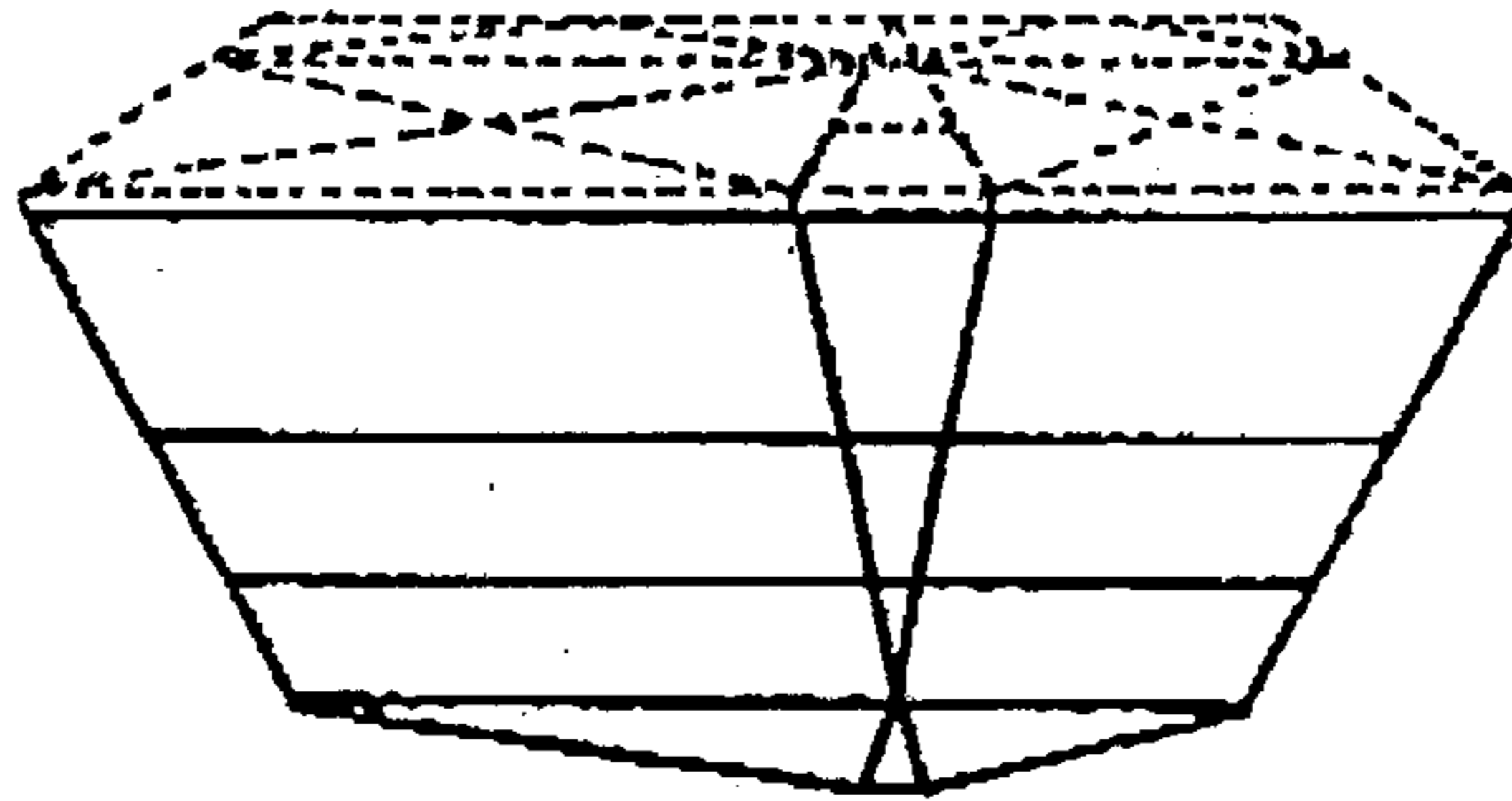

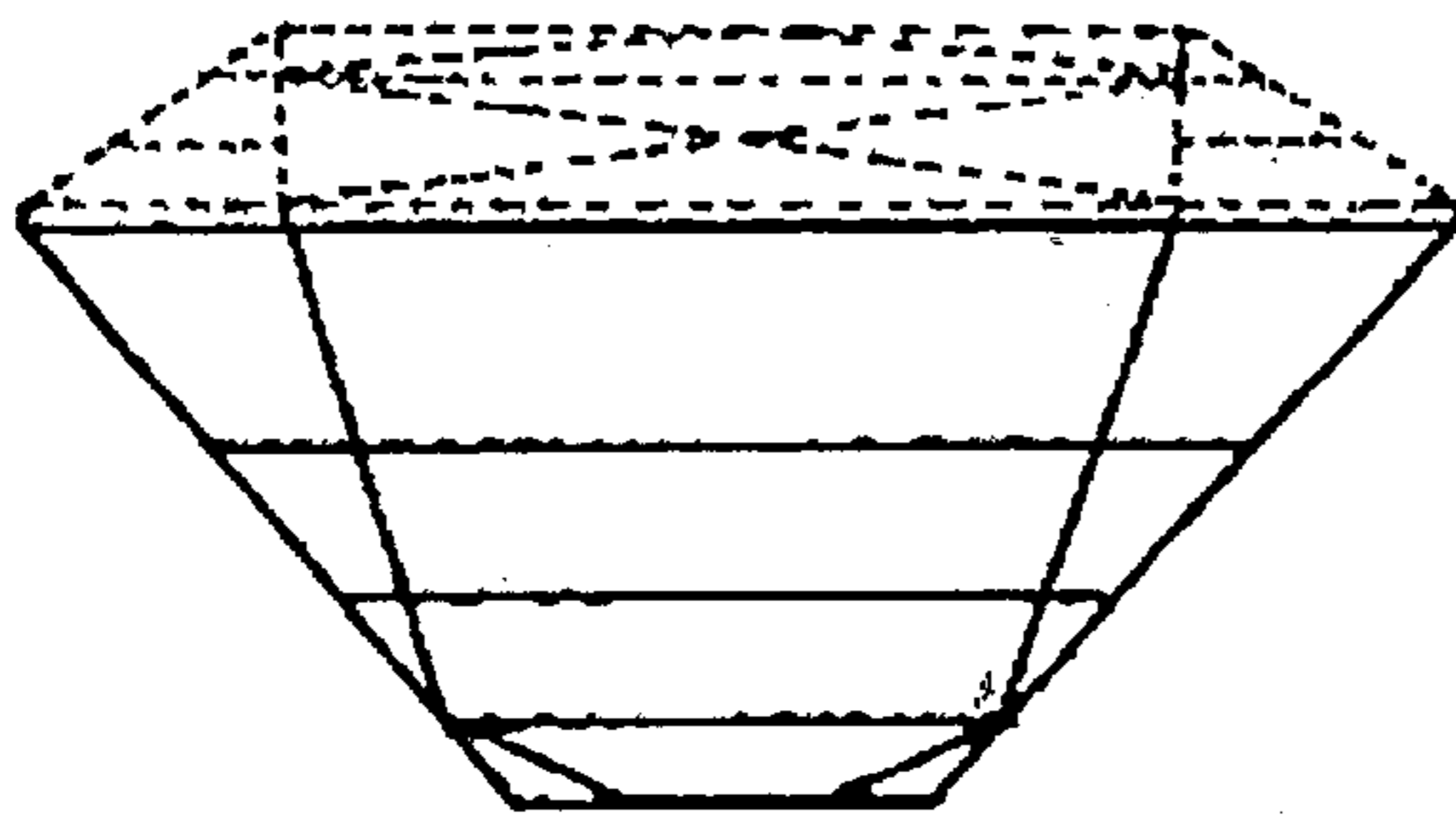

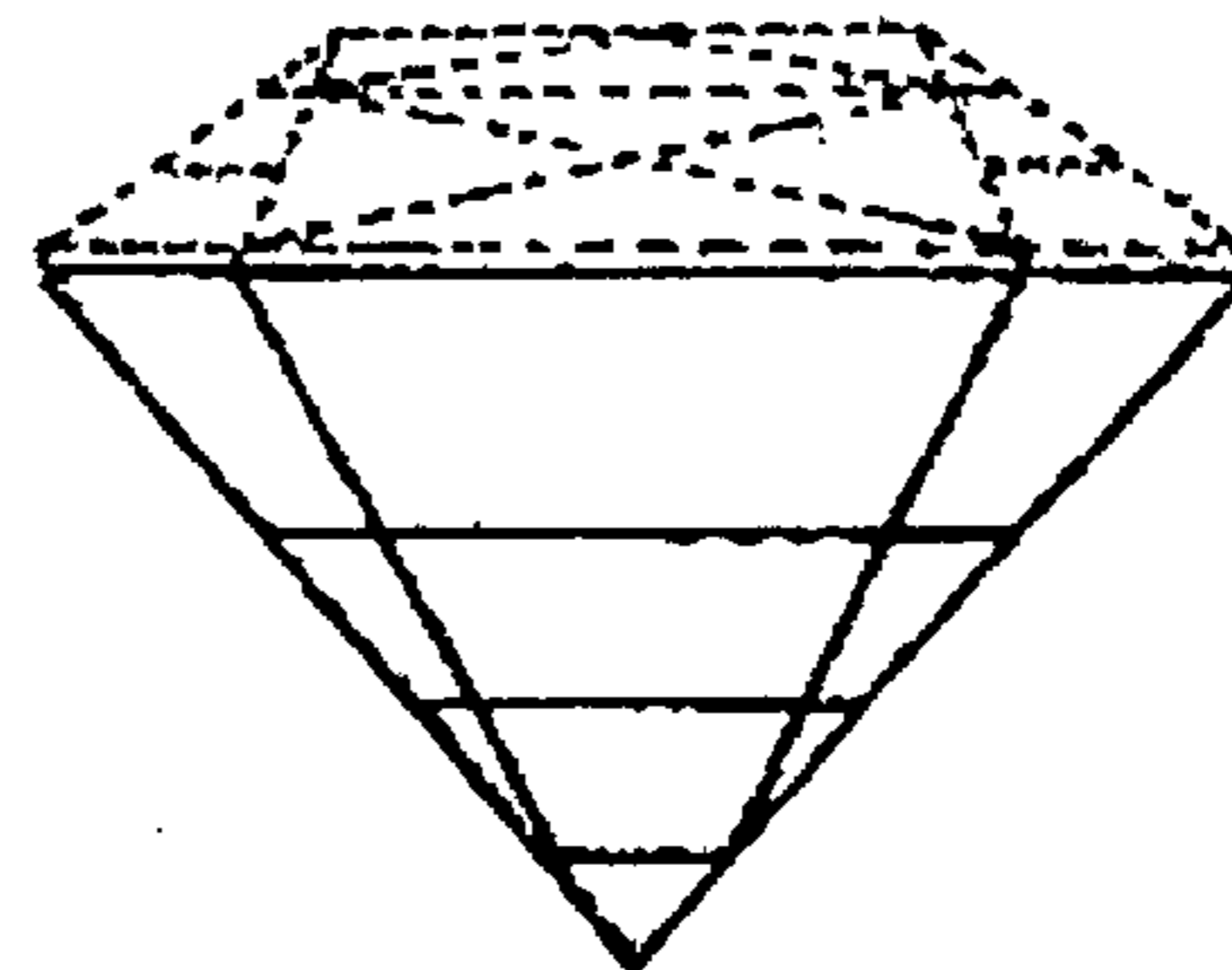
