(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a male genitalia tanning bed shield, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a male genitalia tanning bed shield showing our new design, with the opening shown in an expanded condition;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof, shown with the opening in a non-expanded condition;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

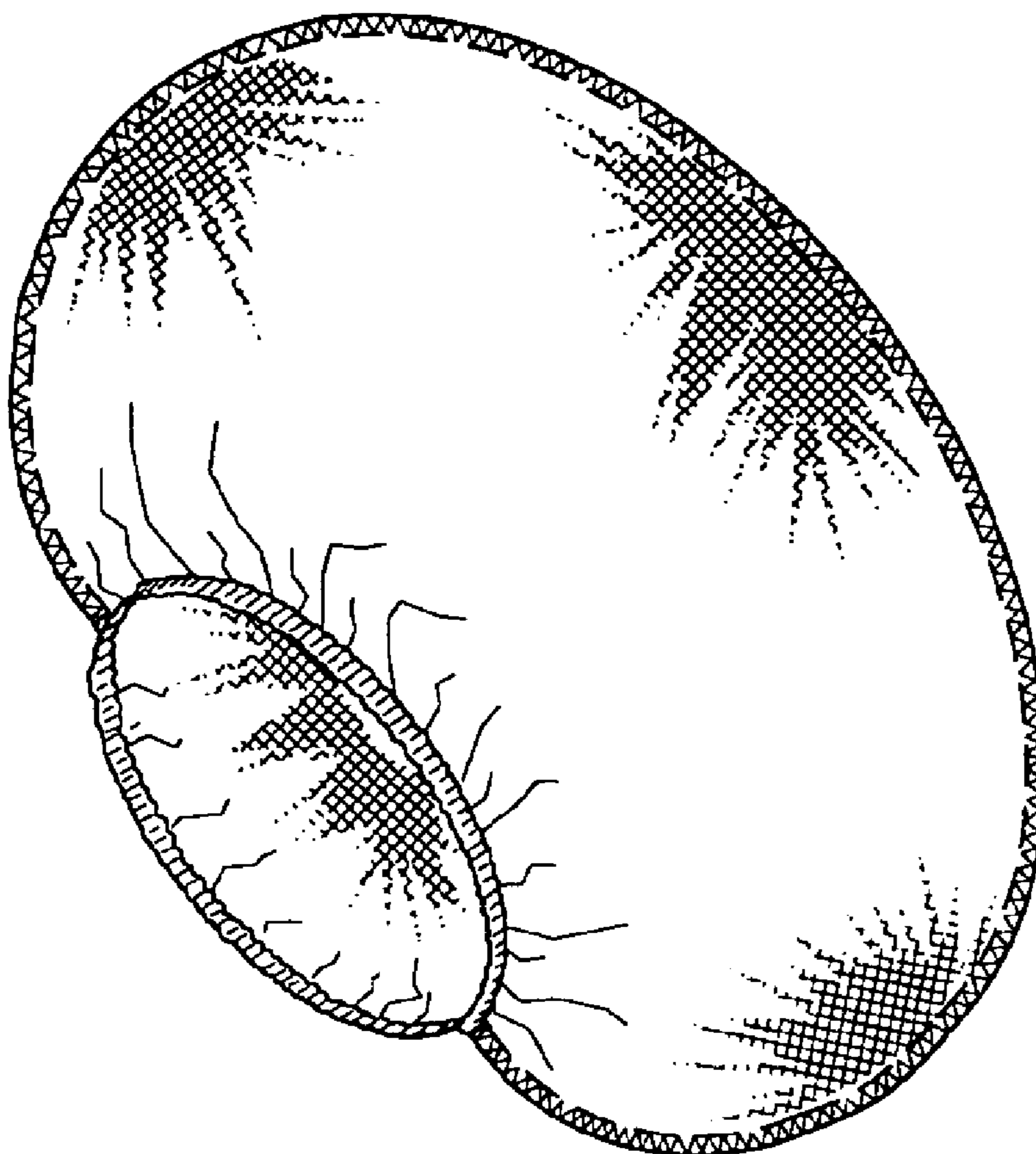
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

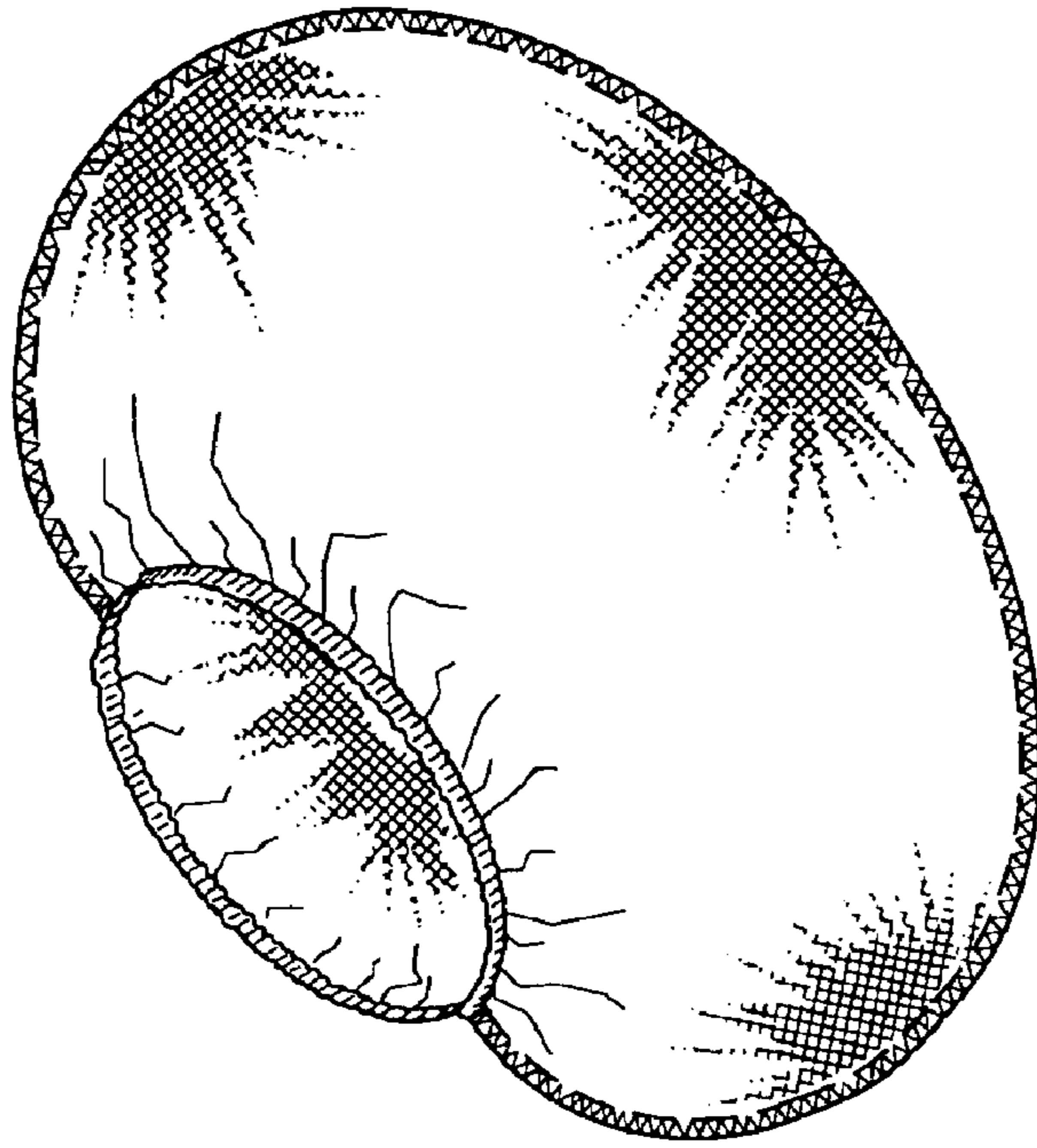

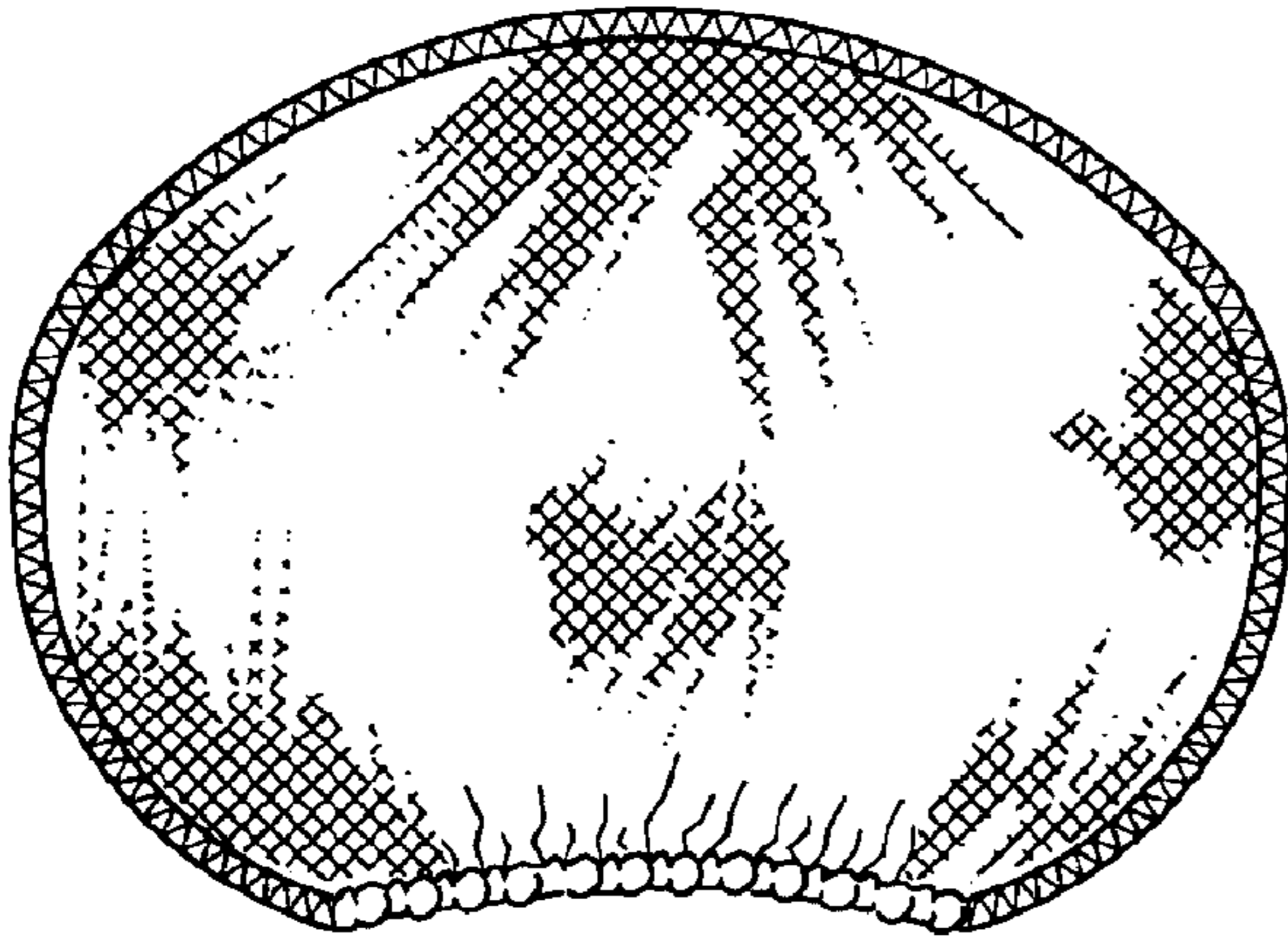

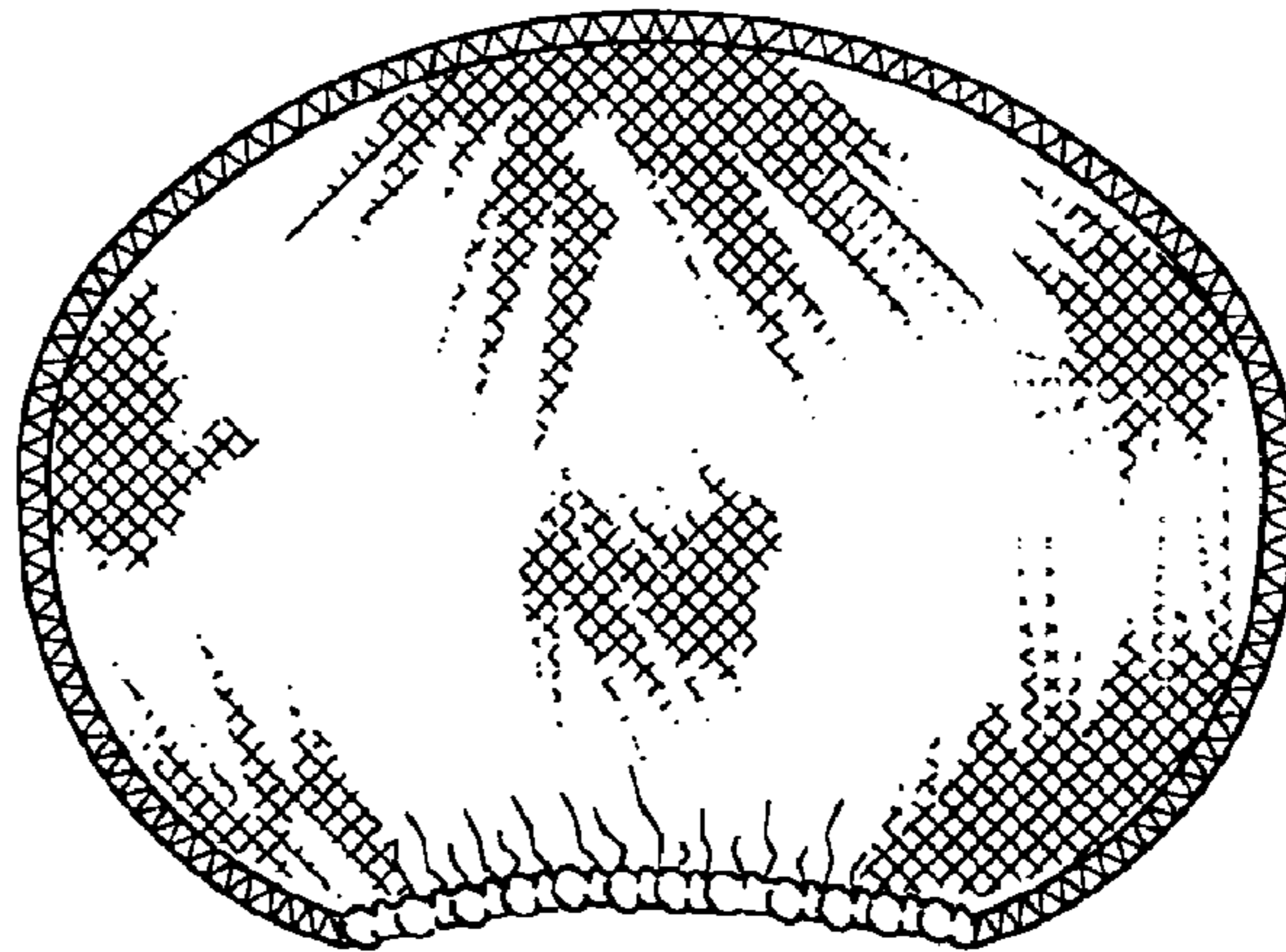

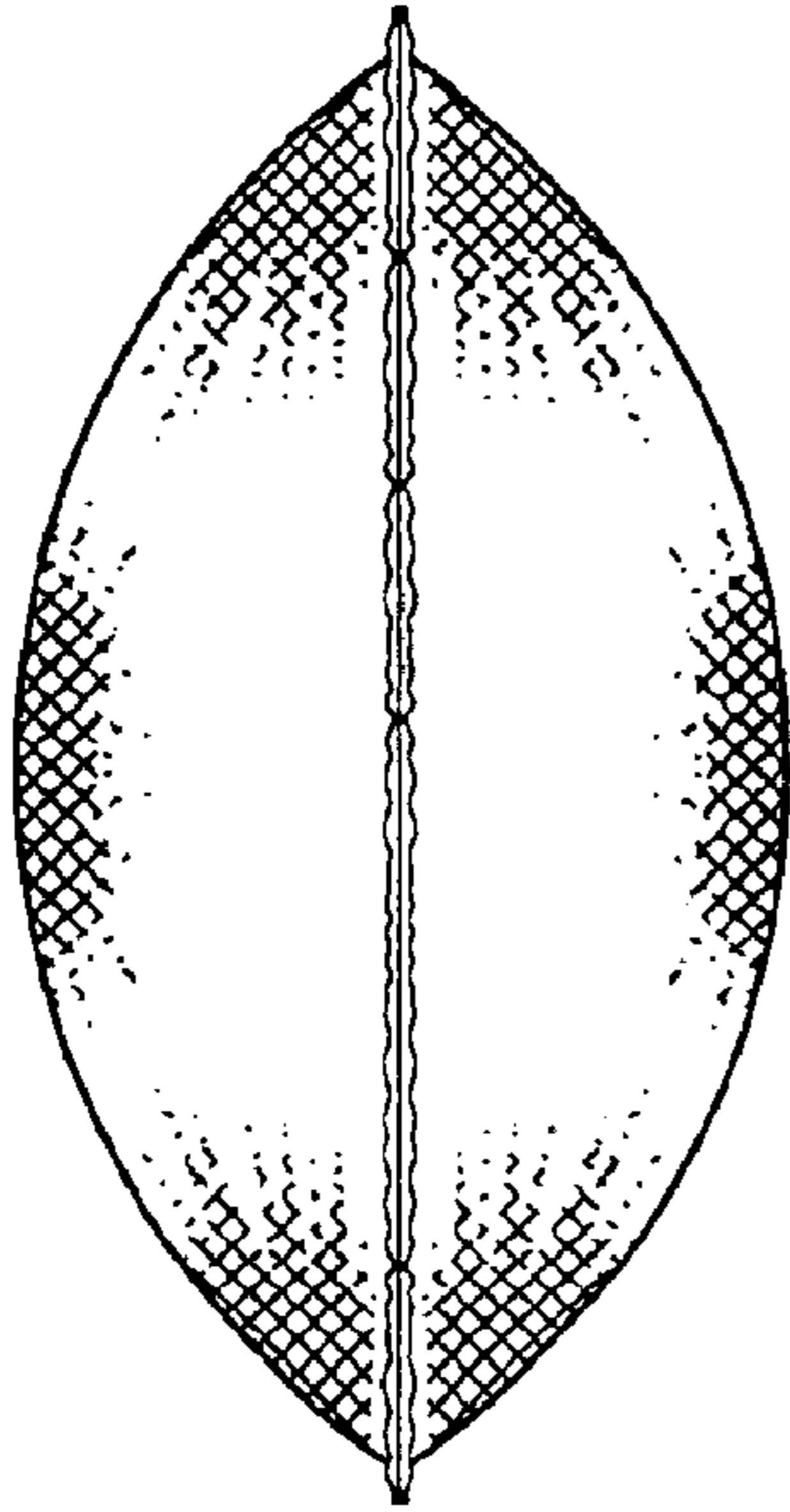

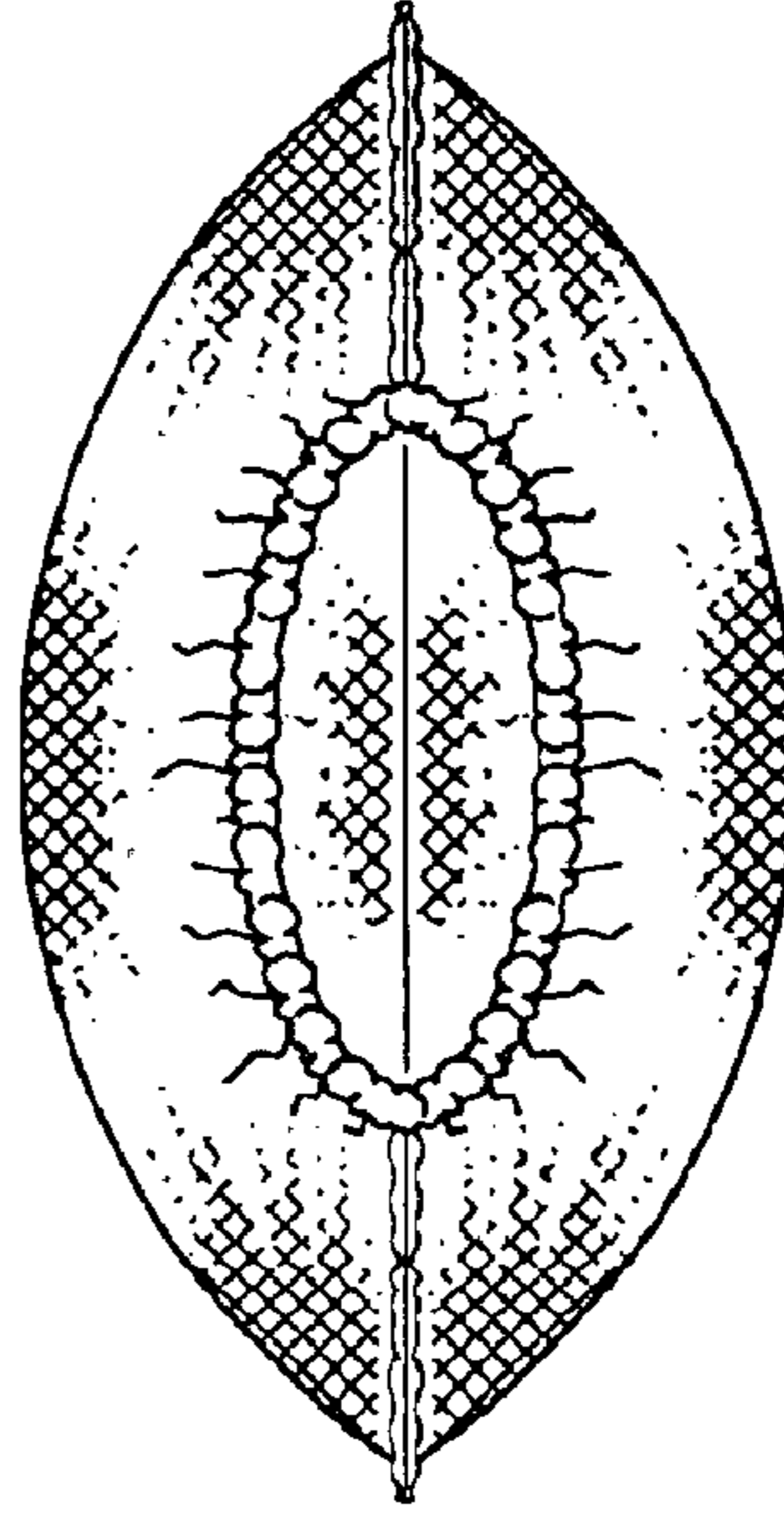

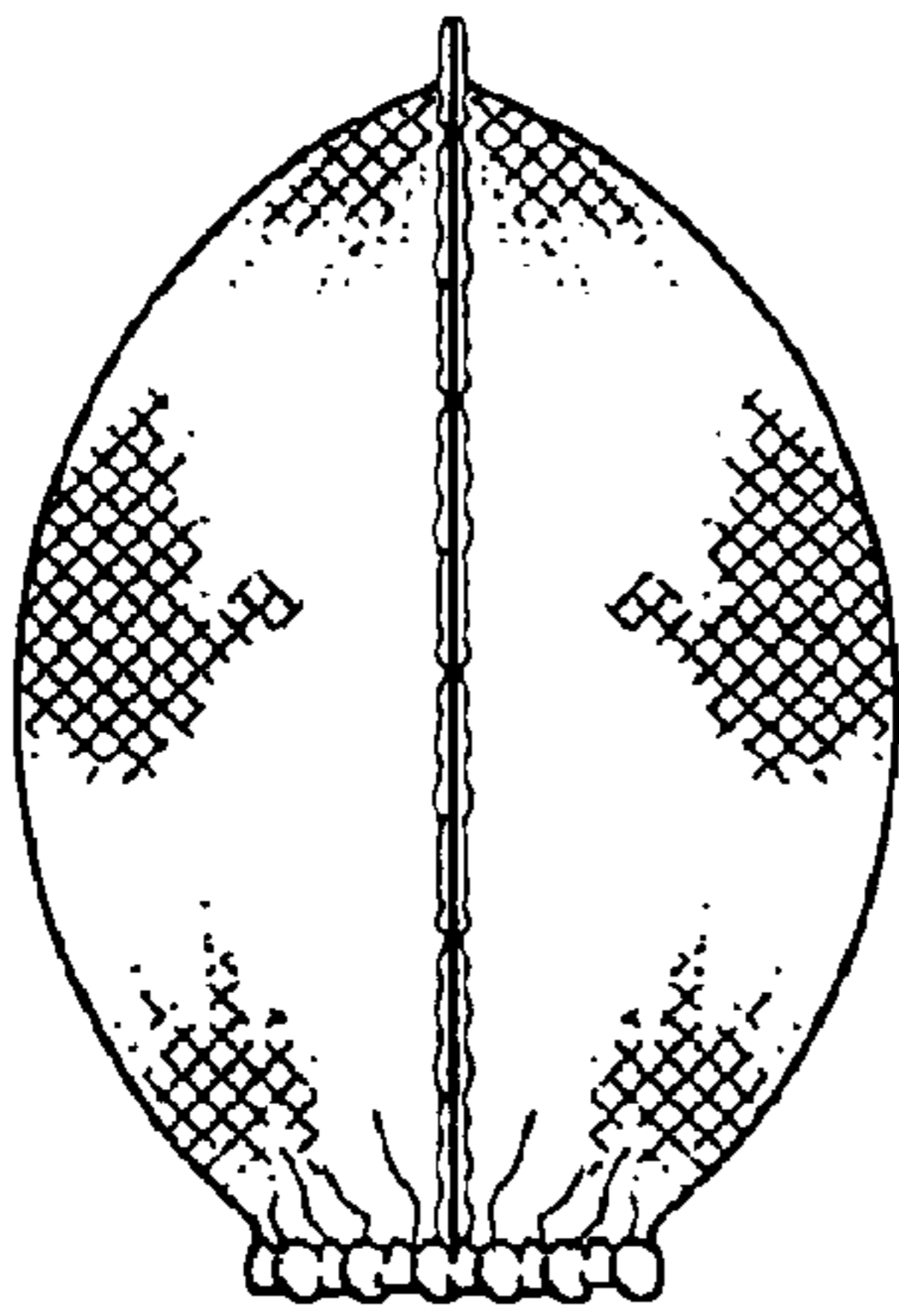

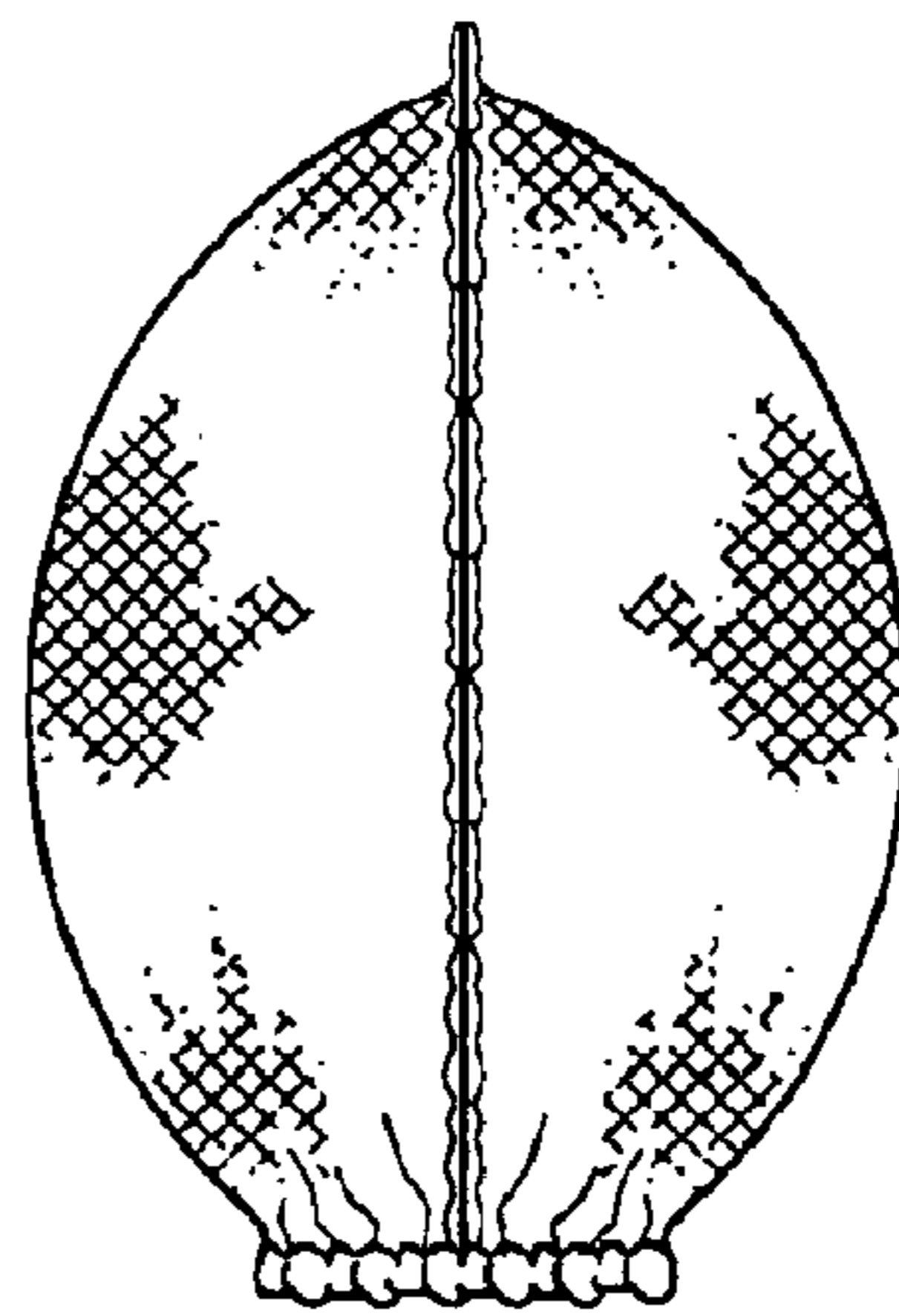
