The ornamental design of a G-clip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the preferred embodiment of my invention, in a closed configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the preferred embodiment of my invention, in an open configuration;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the preferred embodiment of my invention;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the preferred embodiment of my invention, showing the clip side;

FIG. 5 is another side view of the preferred embodiment of my invention, showing the non-clip side;

FIG. 6 is a front, environmental view of an embodiment of my invention;

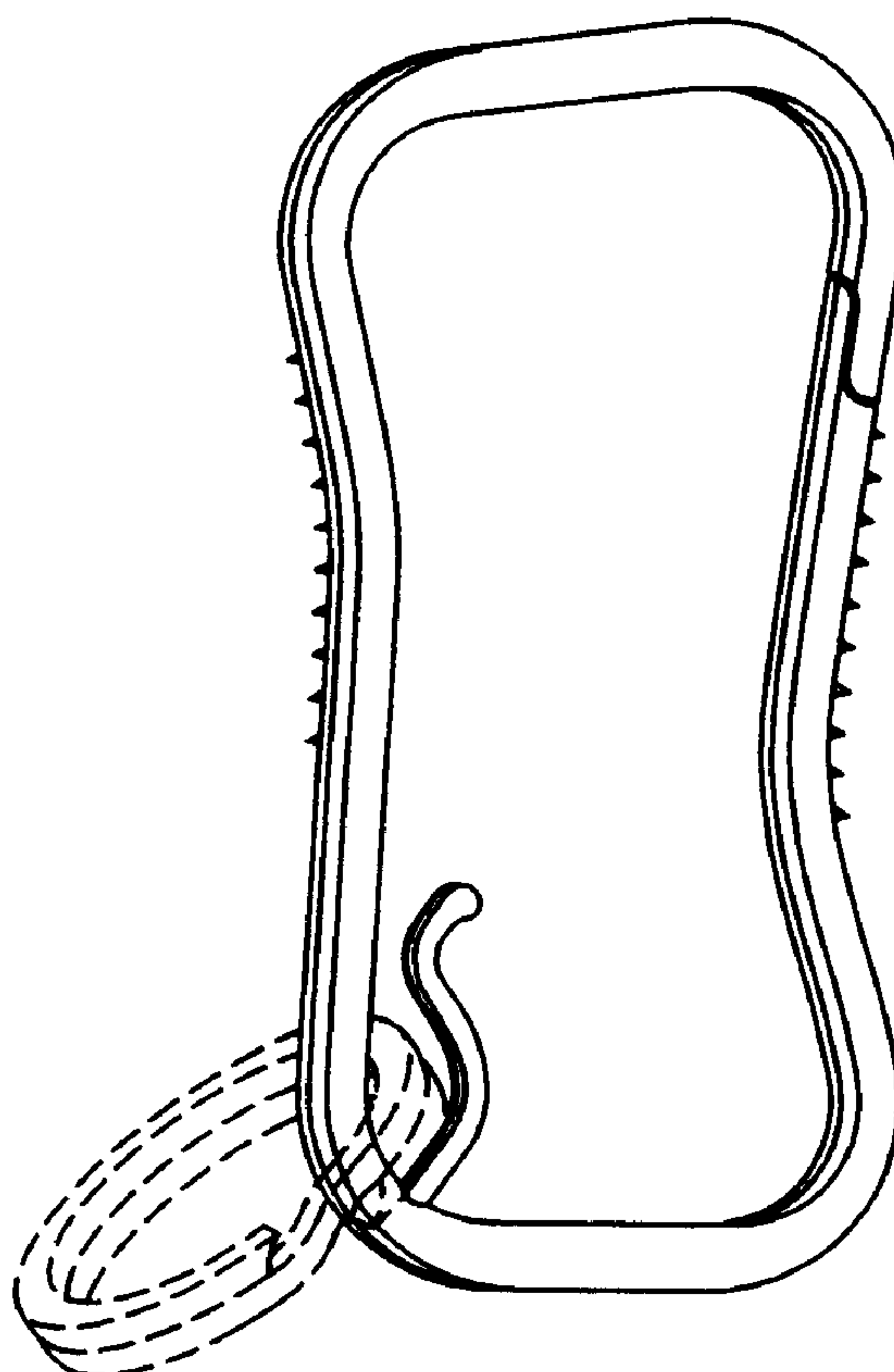
FIG. 7 is an enlarged, fragmented view of the mating ends;

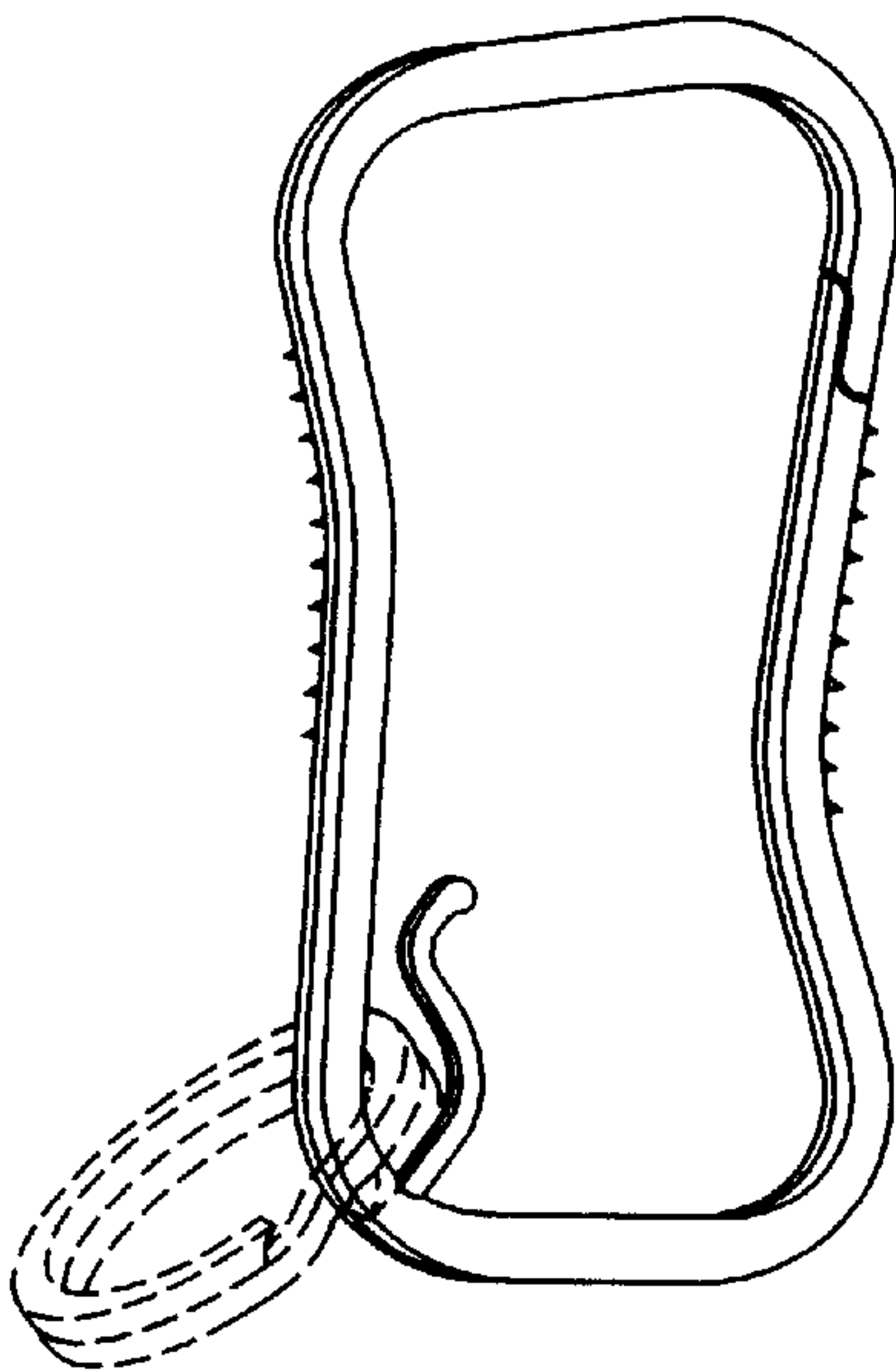

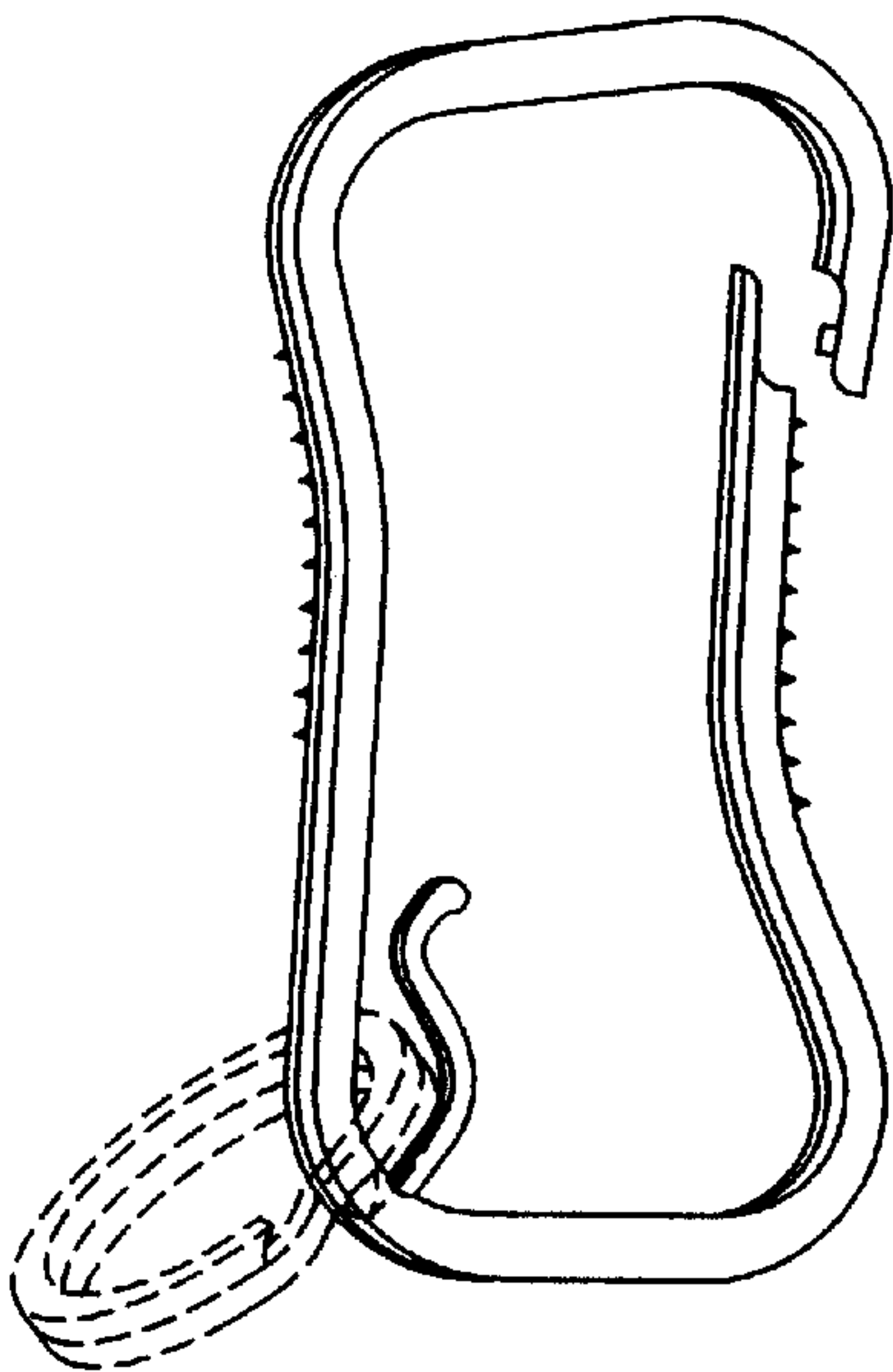

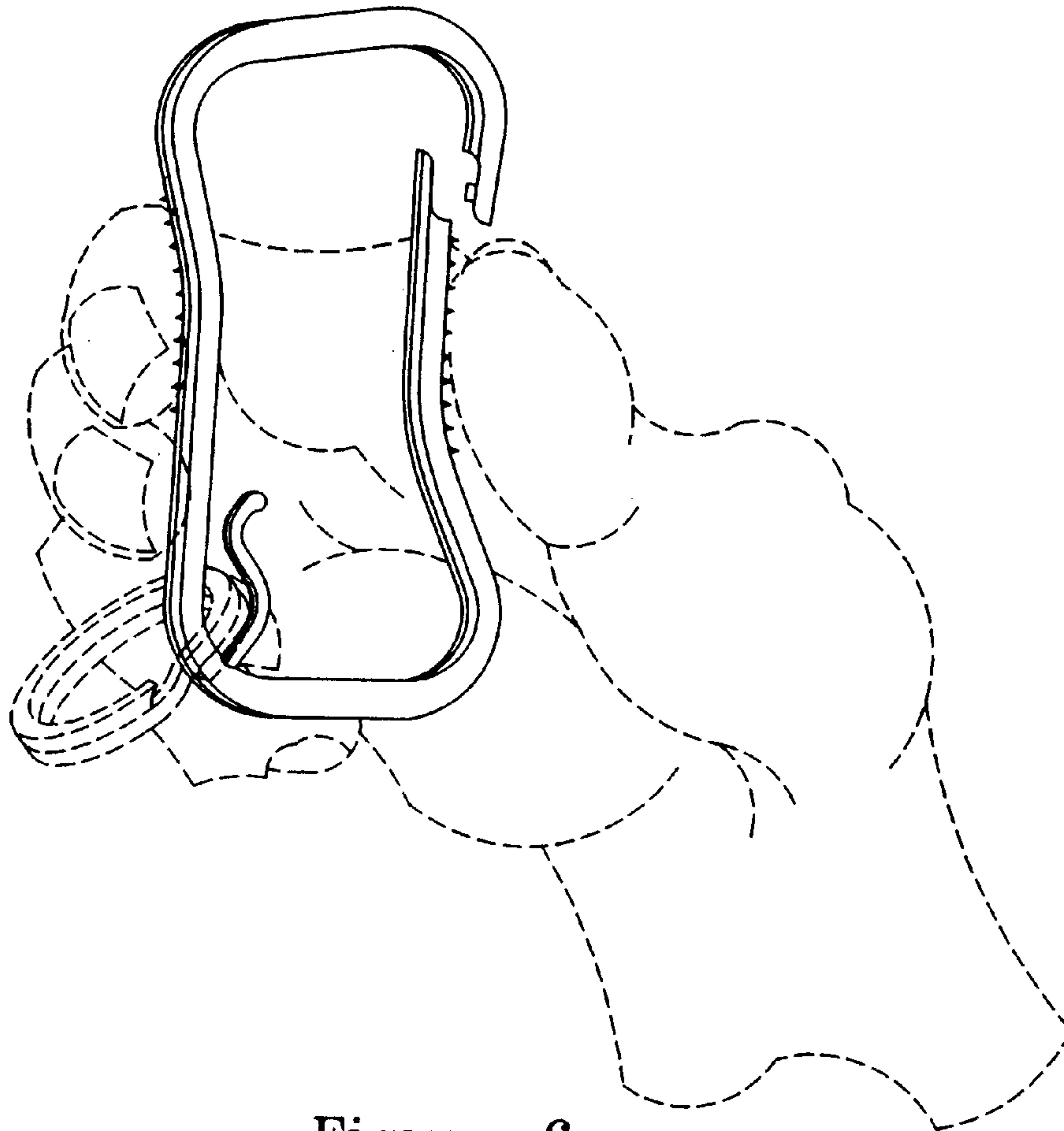

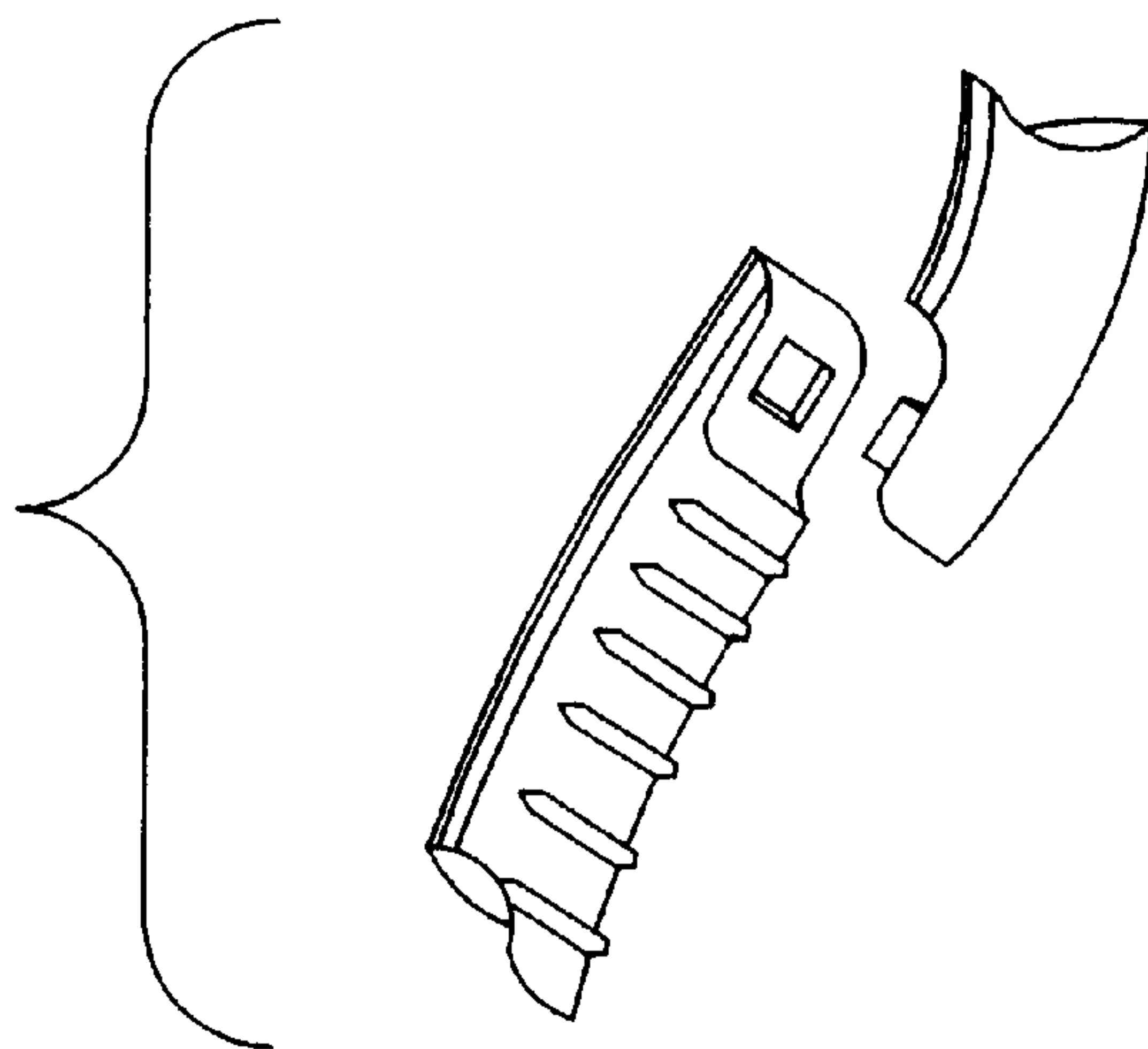

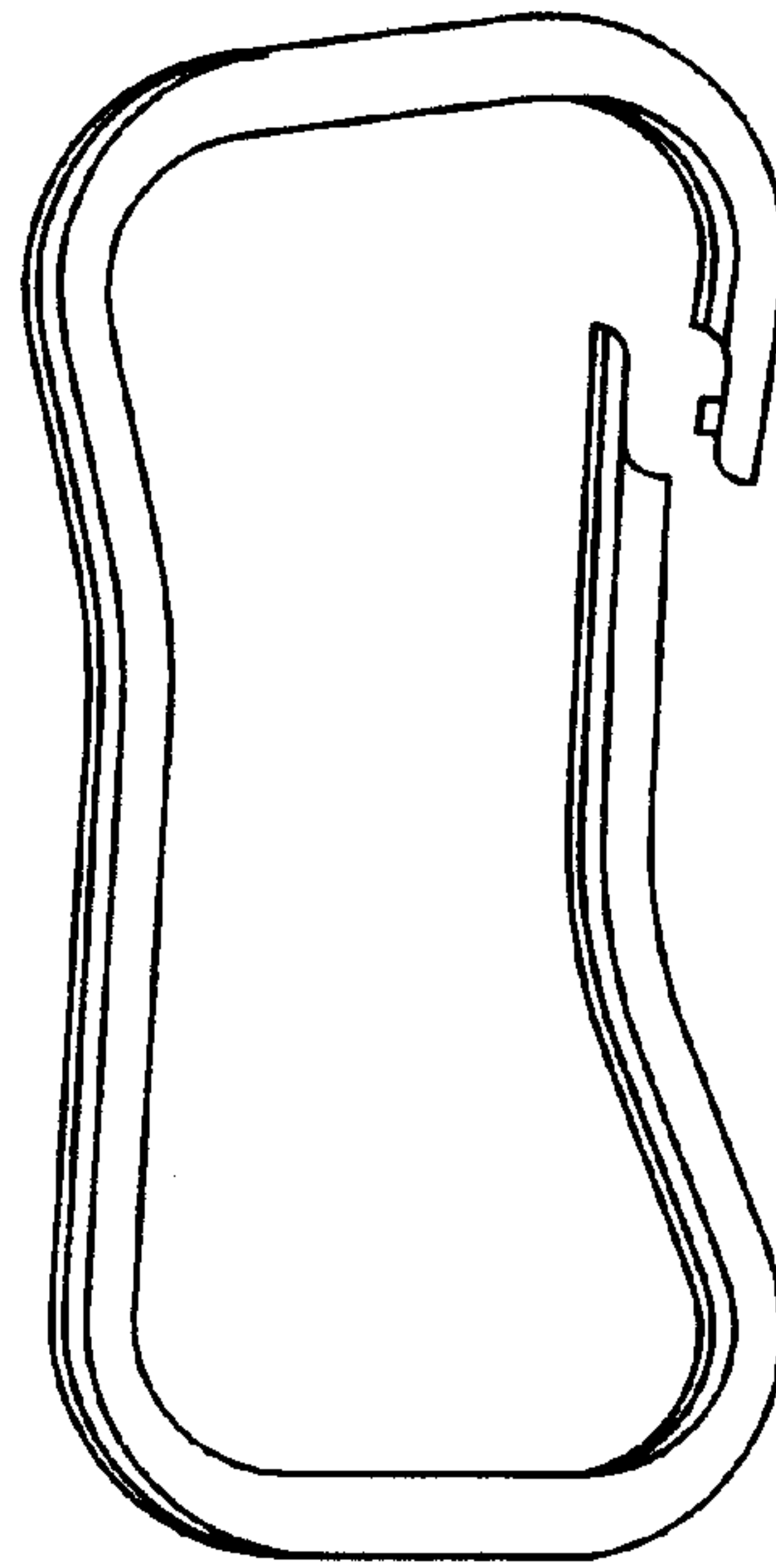

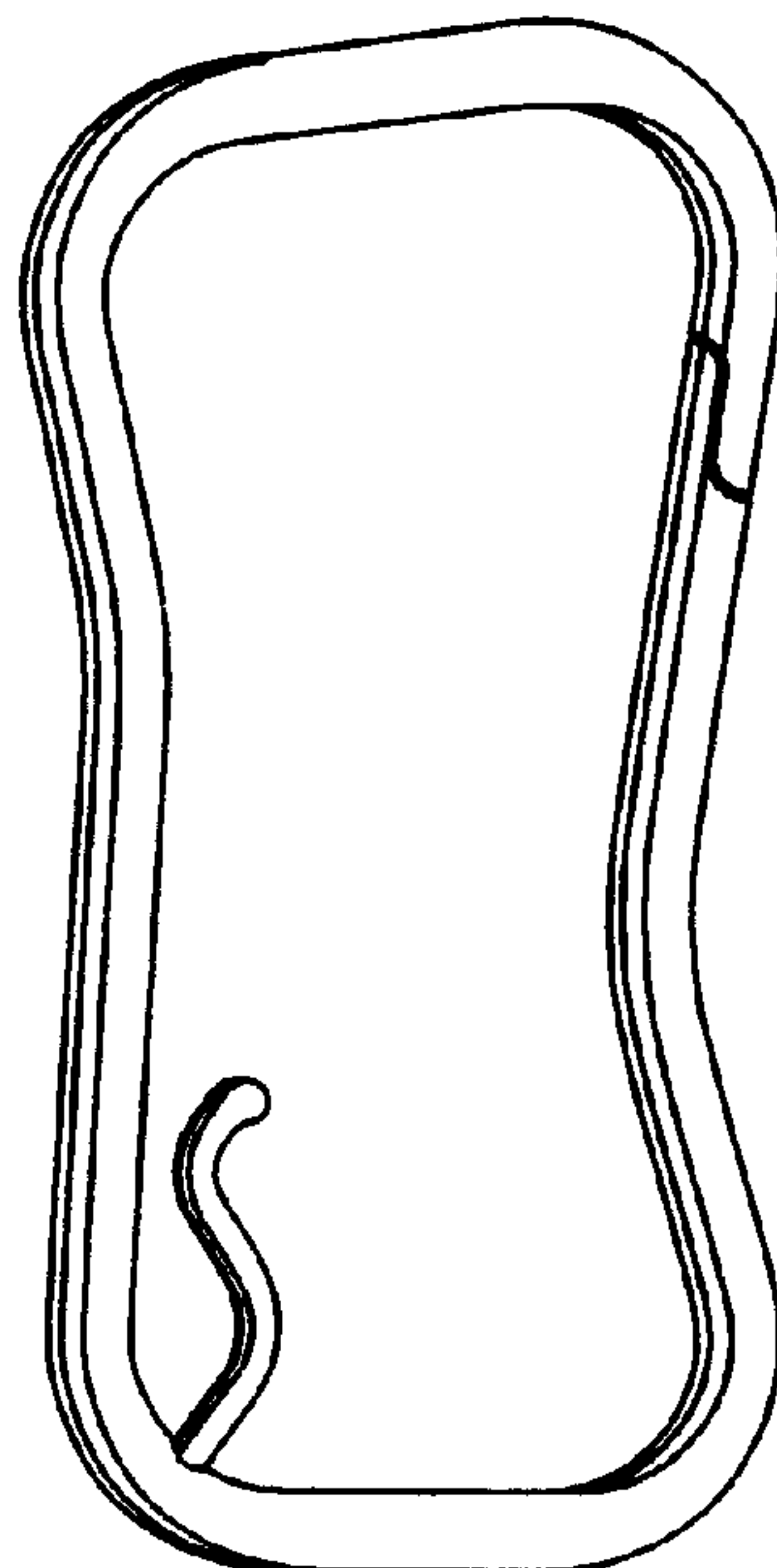
