(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a swimming pool ladder, as shown  
and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a swimming pool ladder with  
a security system in place.

FIG. 2 shows a front elevational view of the swimming pool  
ladder with the security system in place.

FIG. 3 shows a rear elevational view of the swimming pool  
ladder with the security system in place.

FIG. 4 shows a right elevational view of the swimming pool  
ladder with the security system in place. The left elevational  
view is essentially a mirror image of the right elevational  
view.

FIG. 5 shows a top plan view of the swimming pool ladder  
with the security system in place.

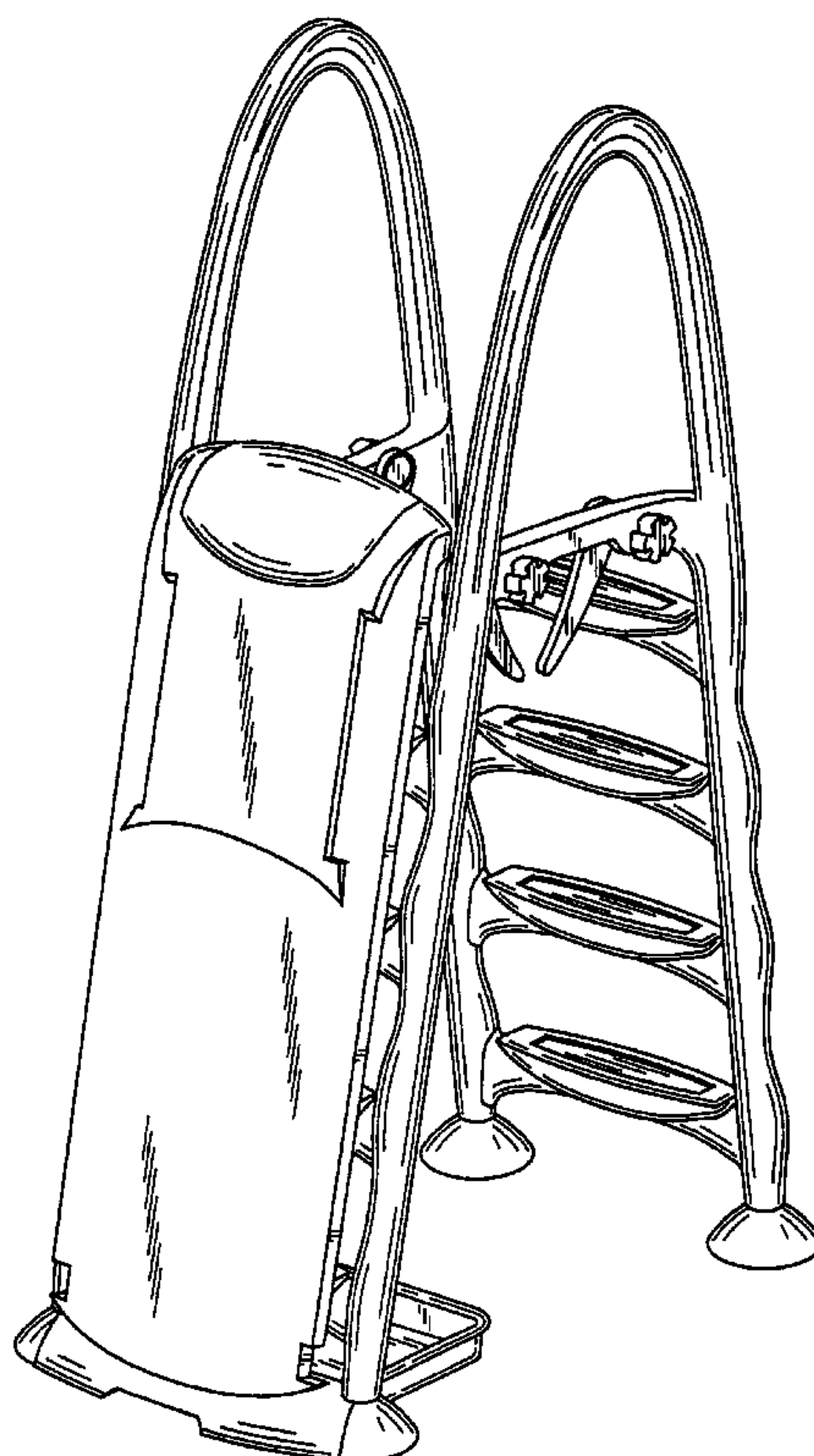
FIG. 6 shows a bottom plan view of the swimming pool  
ladder with the security system in place.

FIG. 7 shows a front perspective view of a swimming pool  
ladder, with the security system in a folded position.

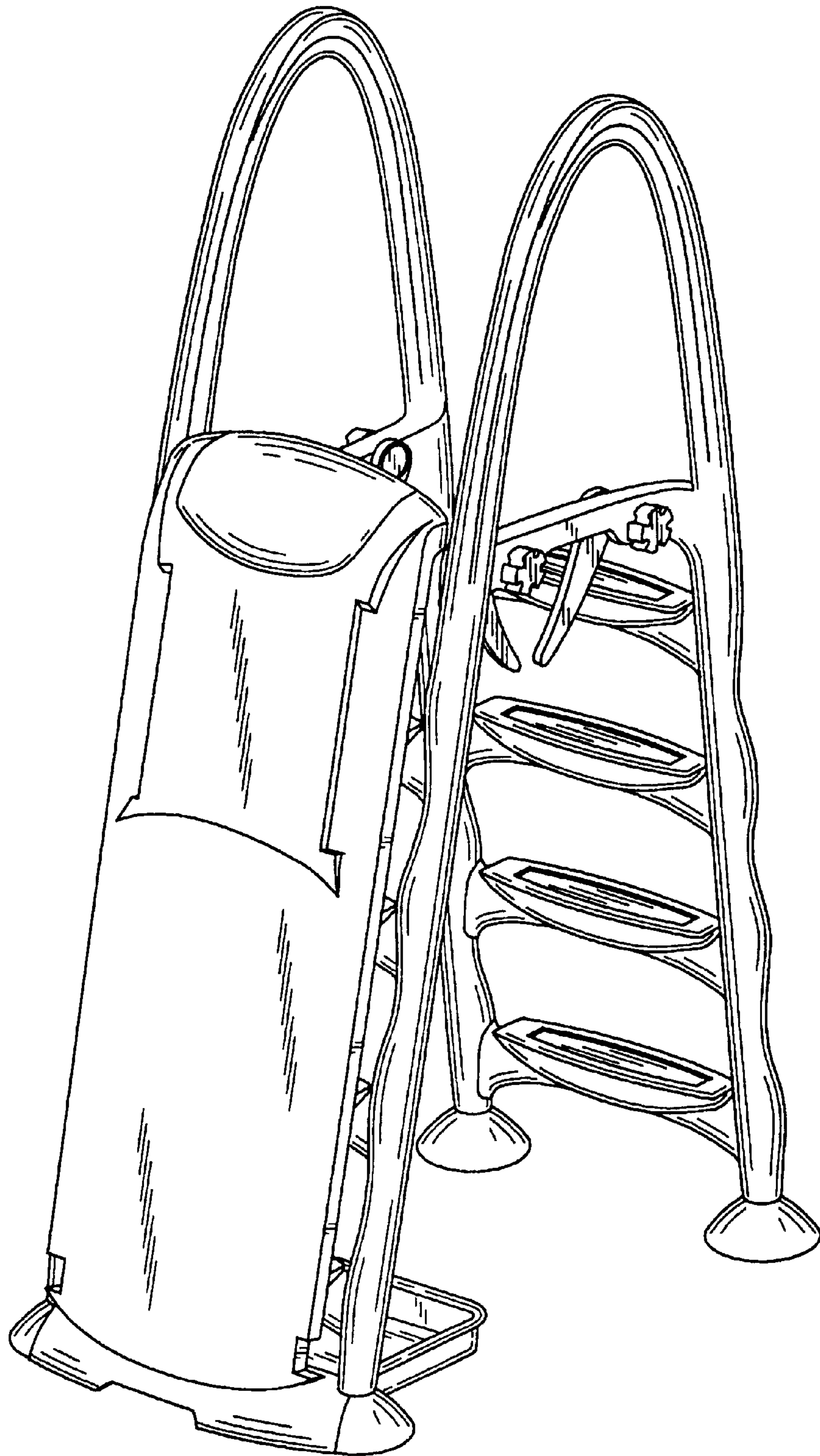
FIG. 8 shows a front elevational view of the swimming pool

elevational view.

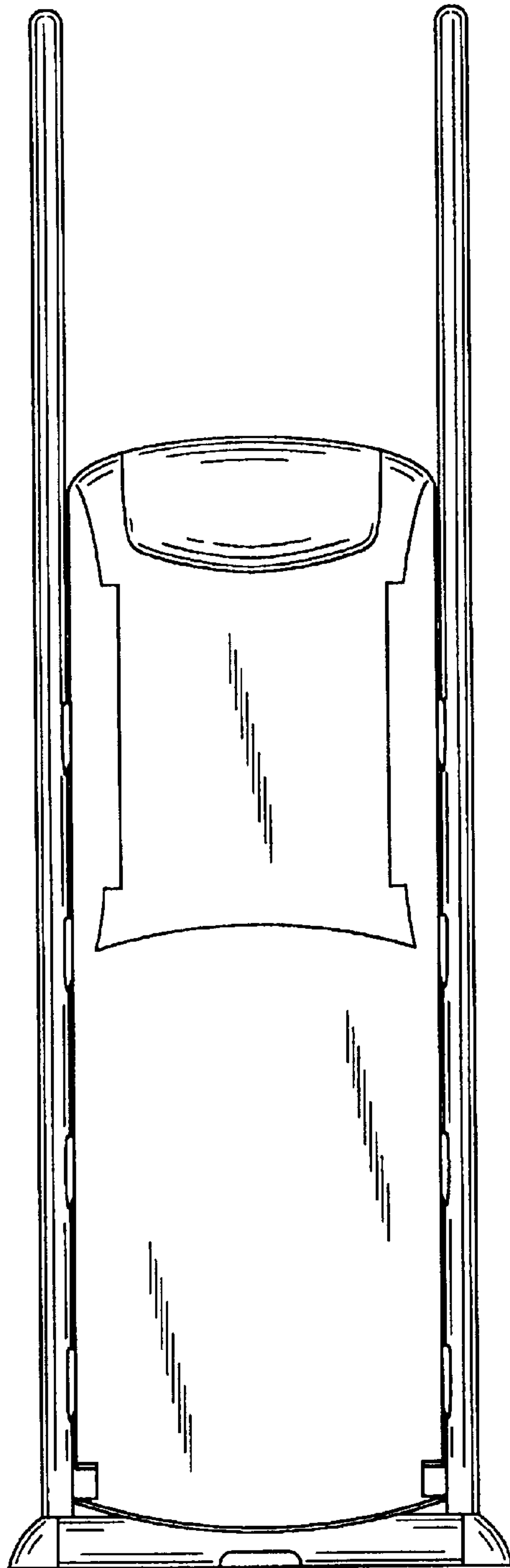

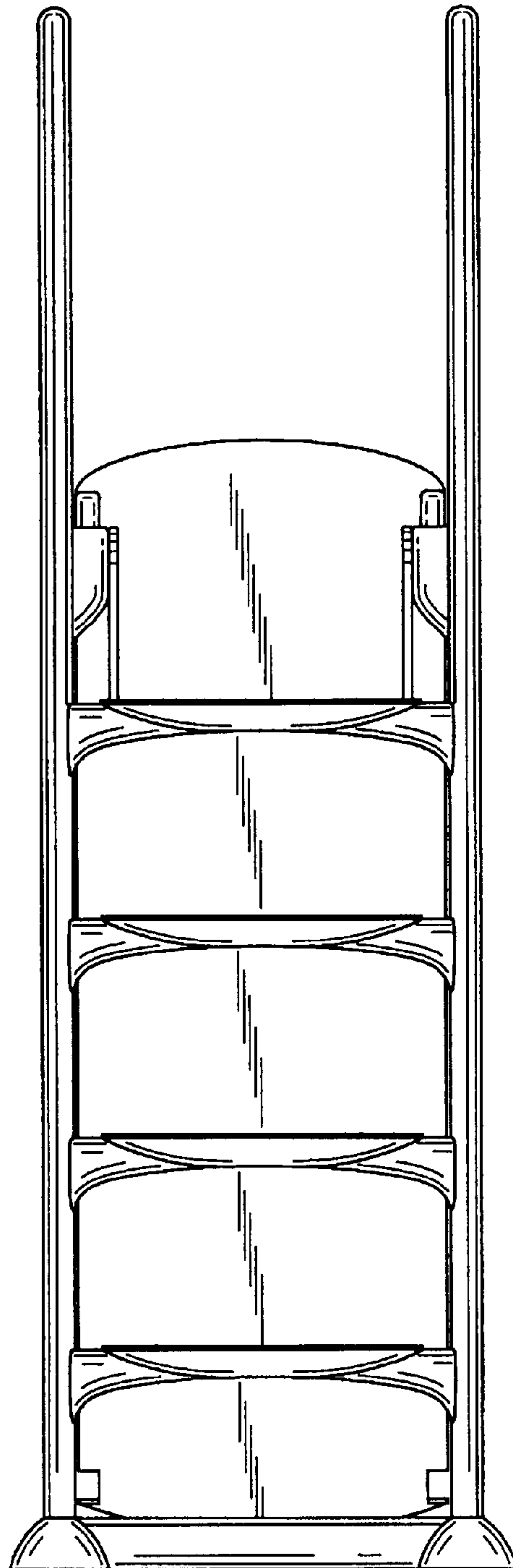

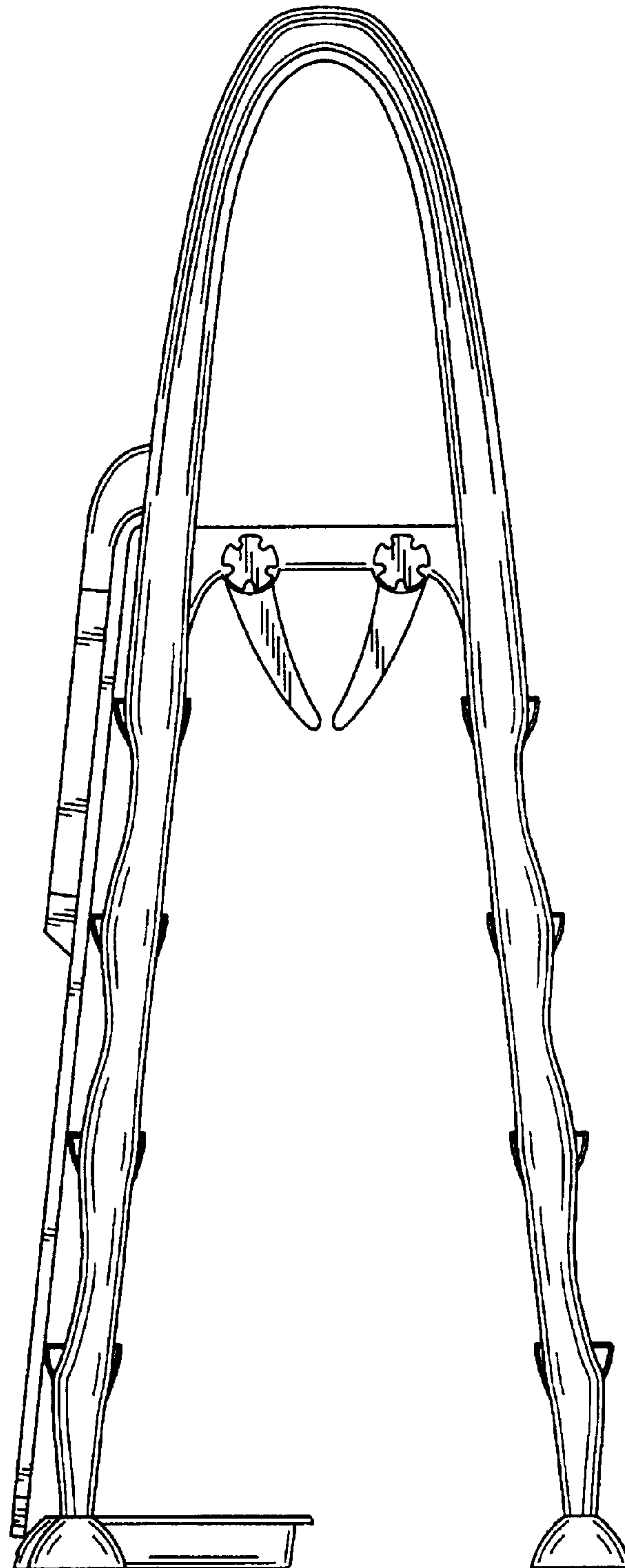

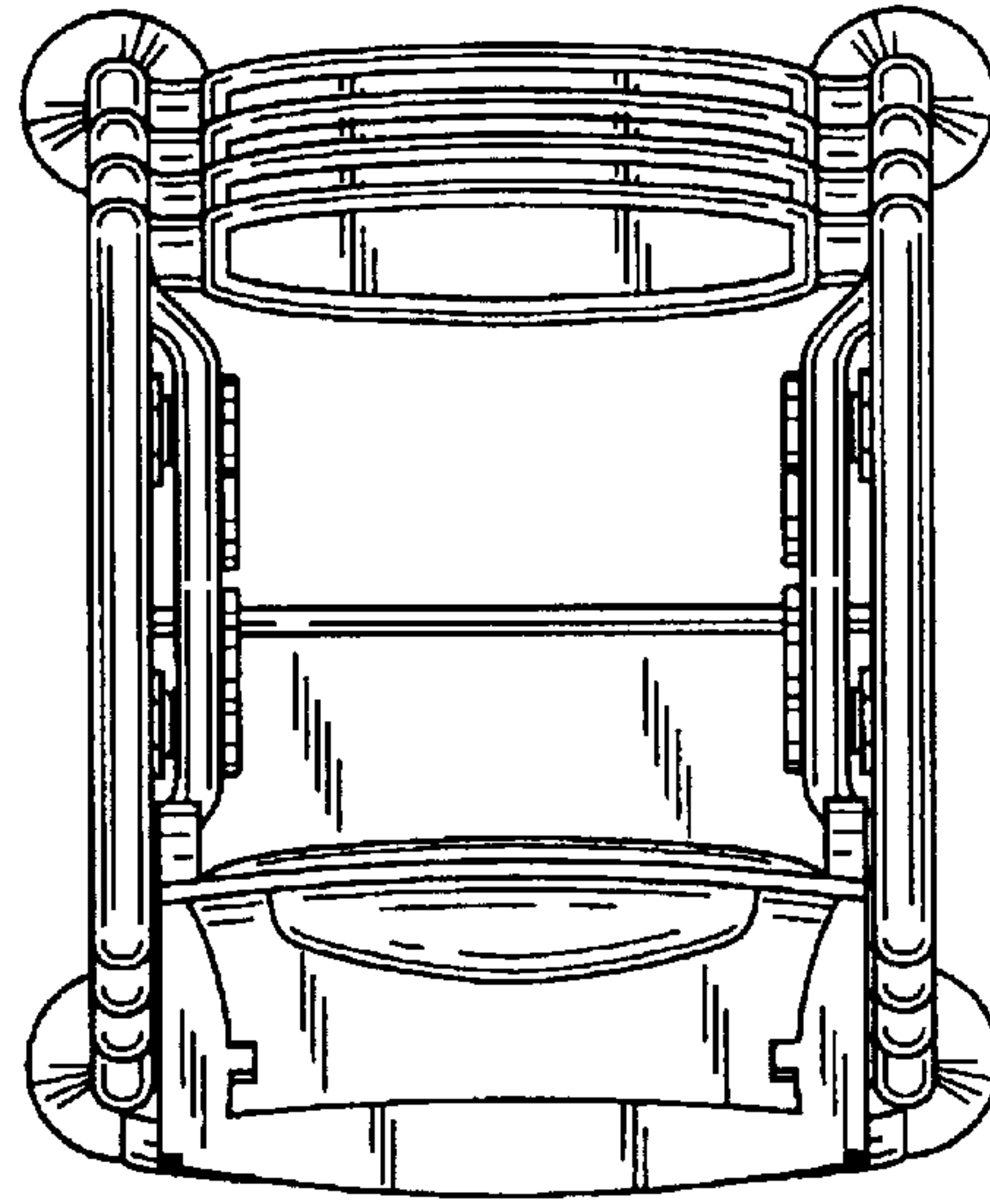

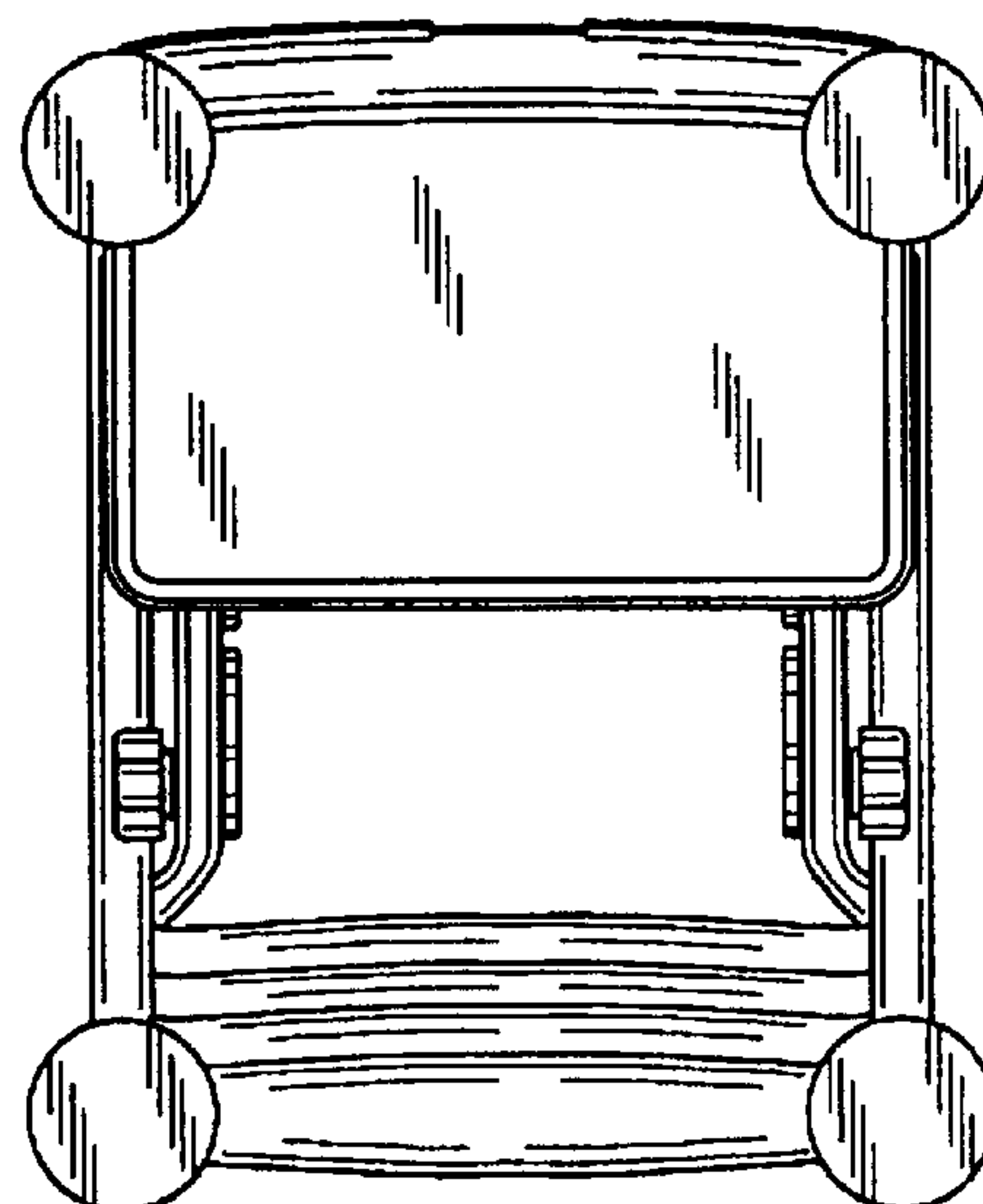




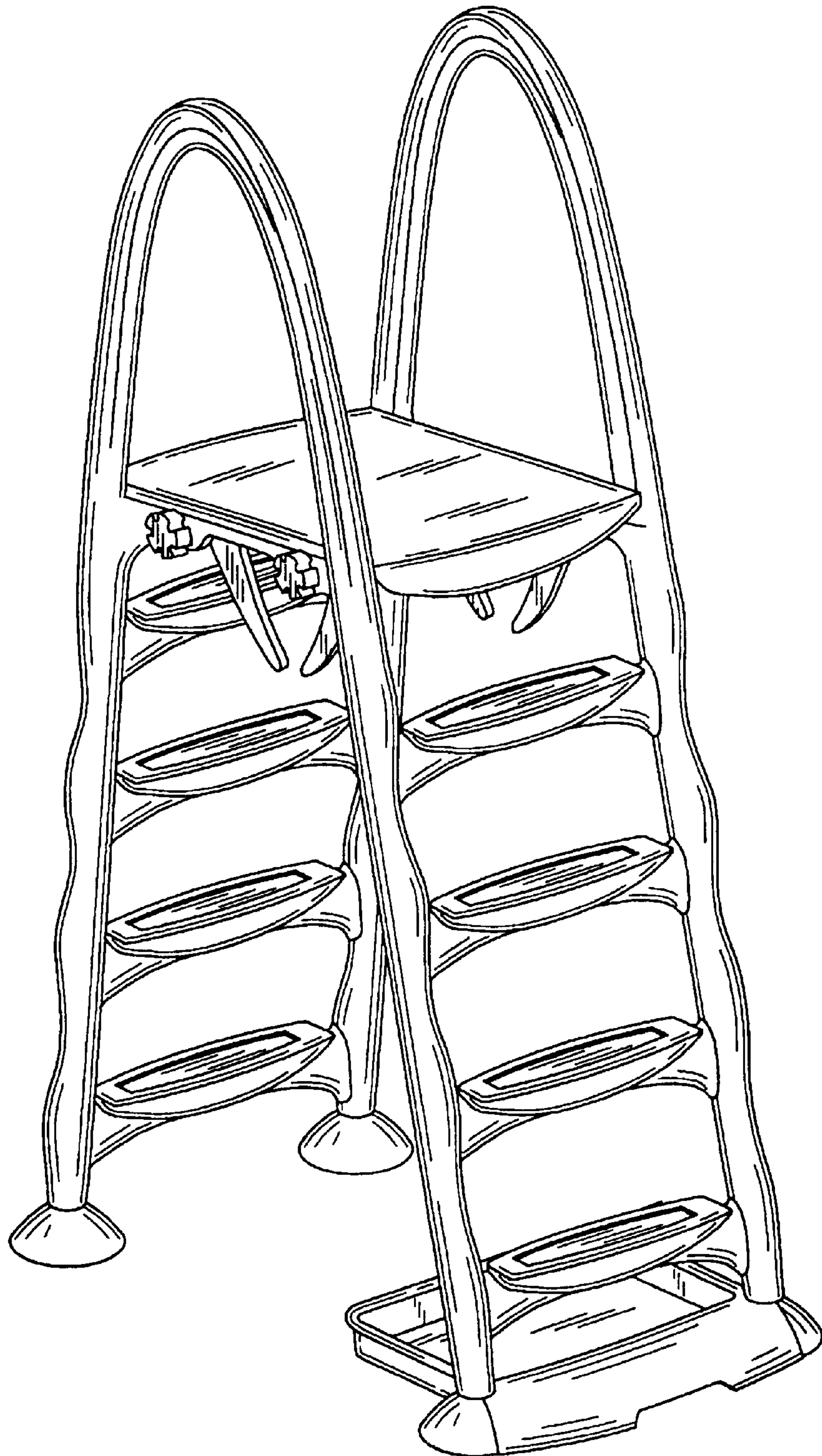

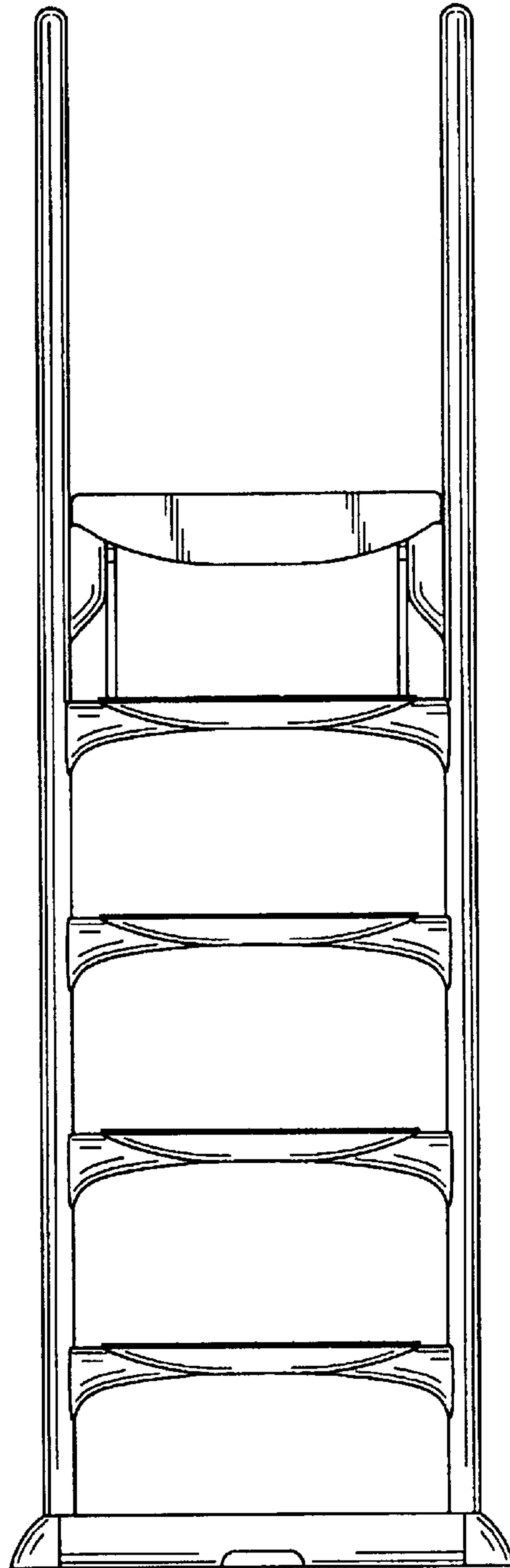
