(57) **CLAIM**

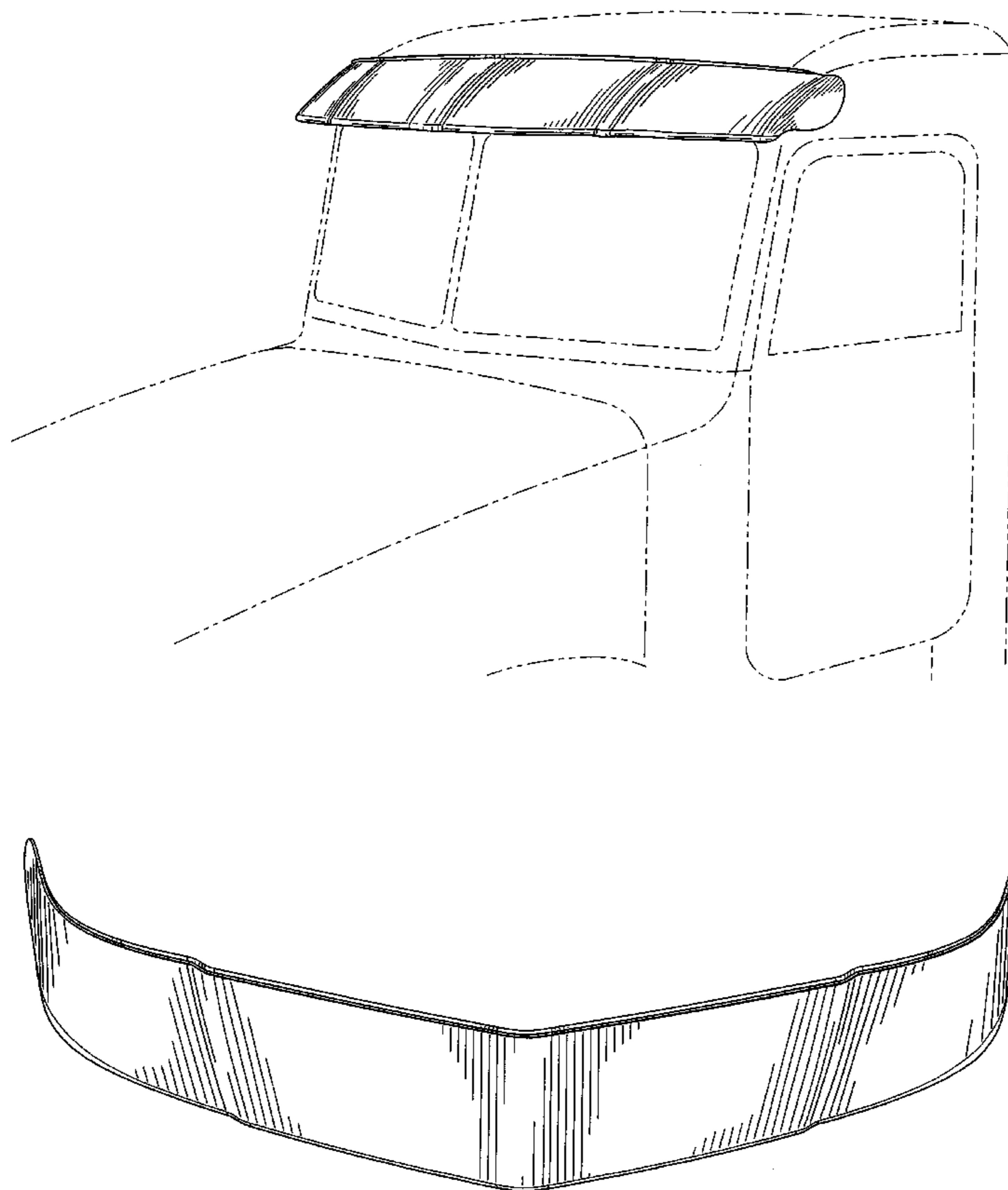
The ornamental design for a sun visor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 an oblique view of a sun visor showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view;
FIG. 3 is a top view;
FIG. 4 a right side view, the left side view being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 5 is a back view; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view.

The sun visor is shown on an enlarged scale in FIGS. 2-6. The broken line showing of environment is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

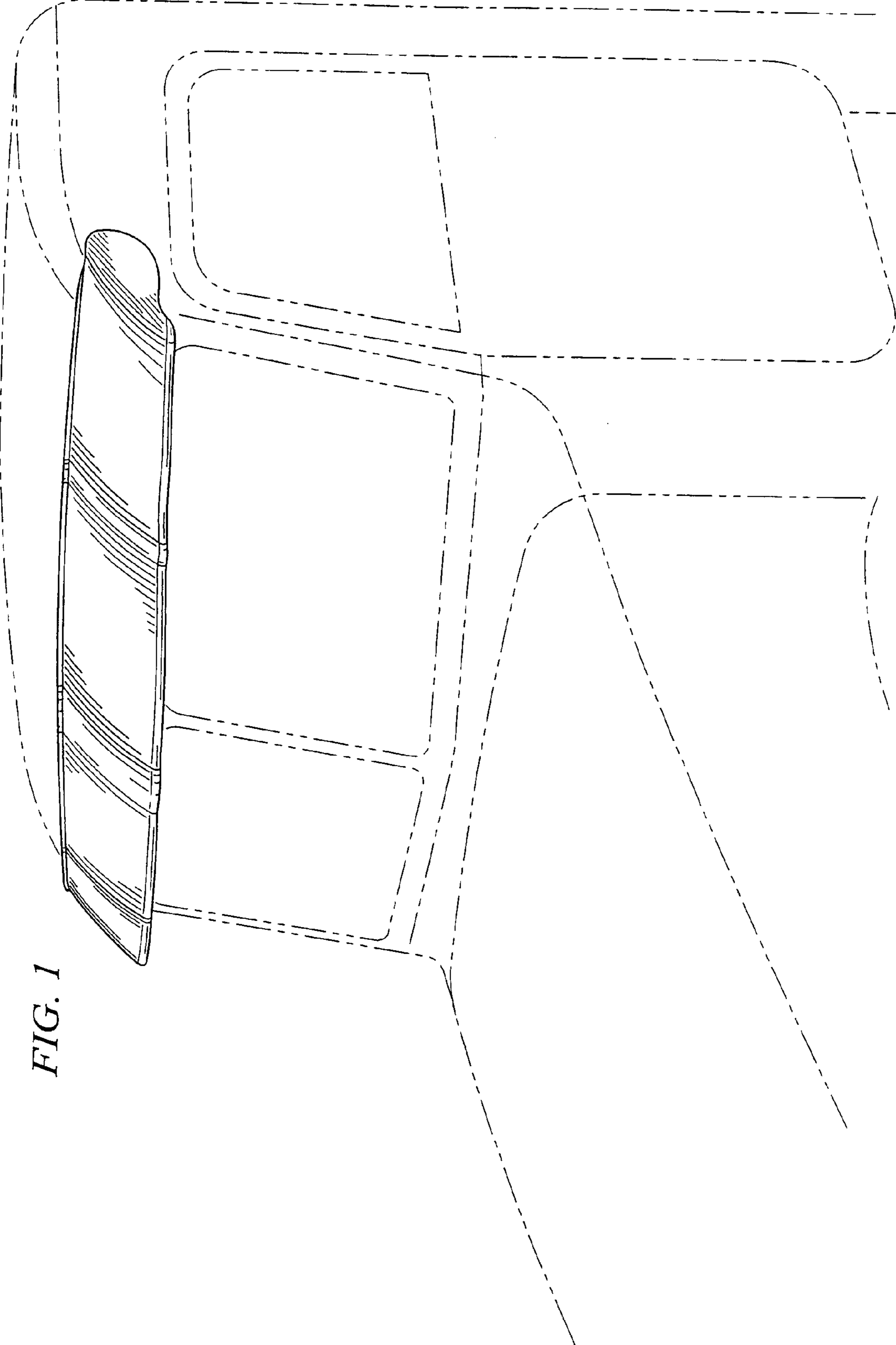

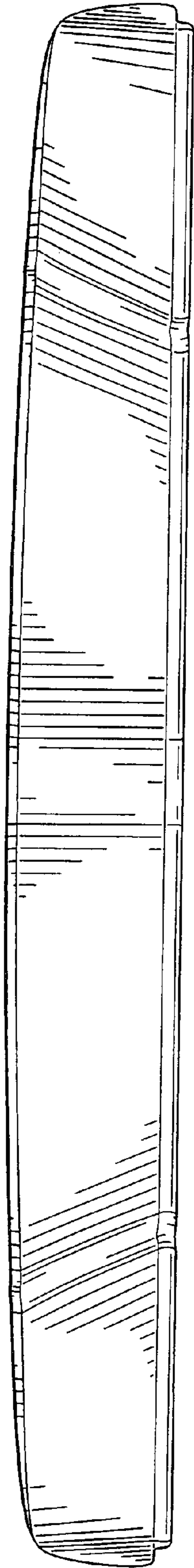

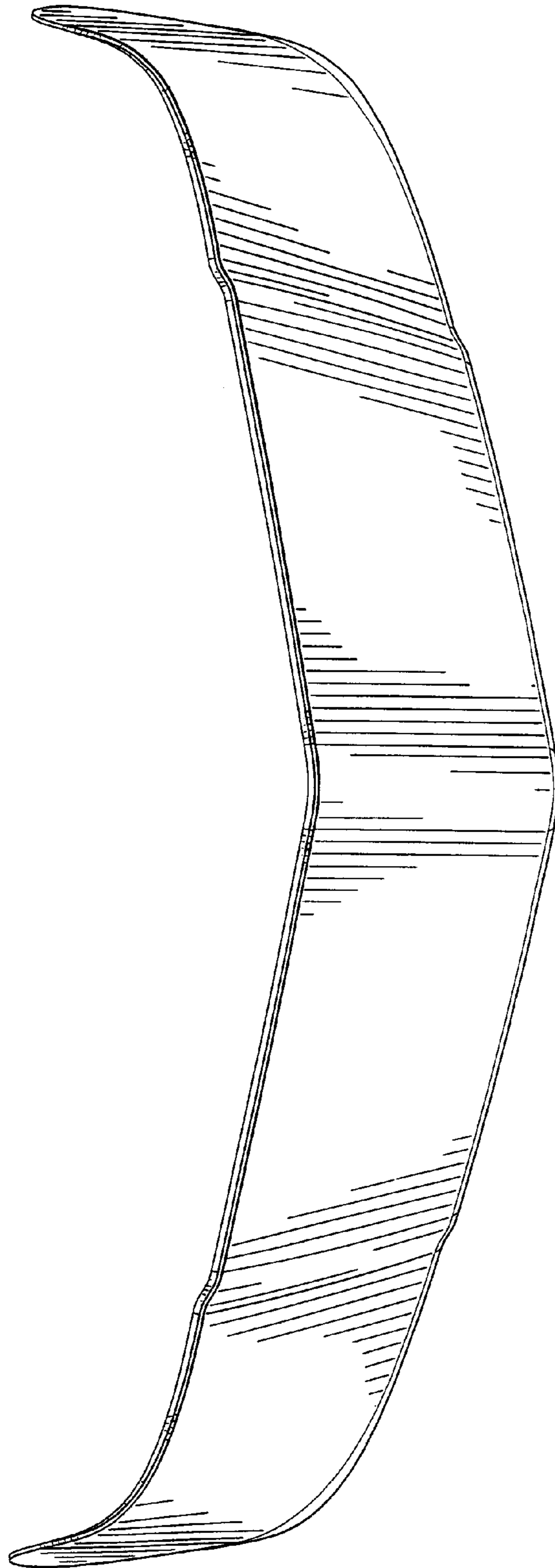

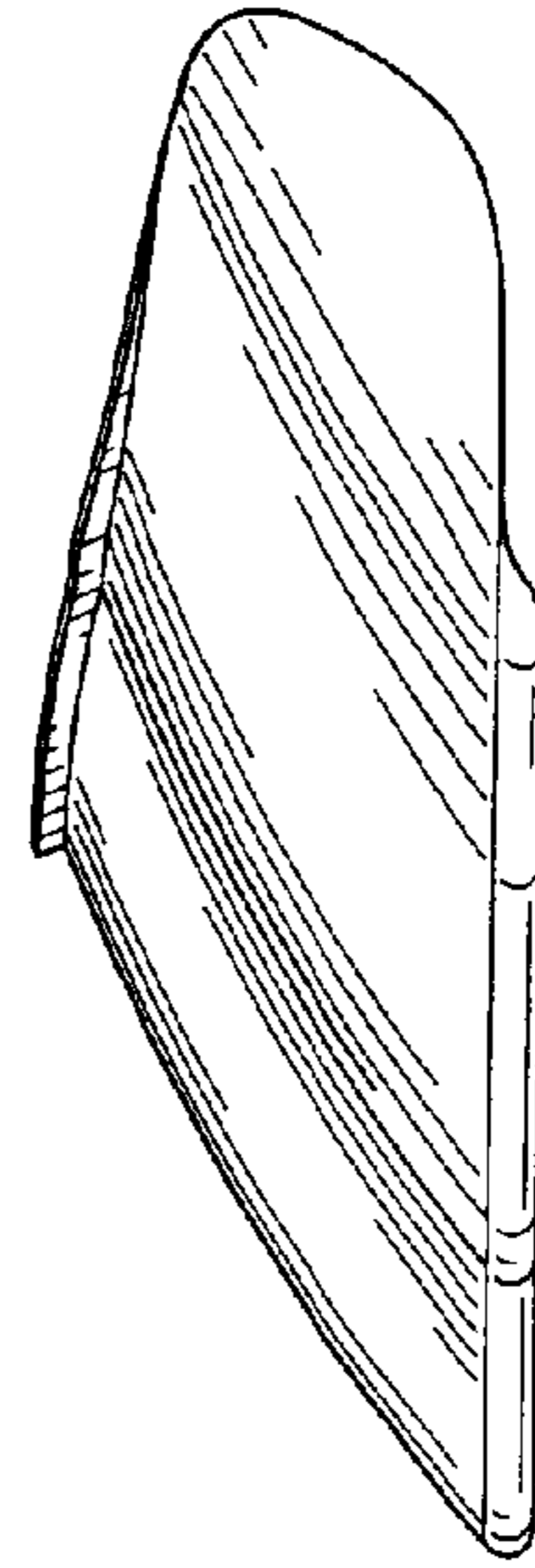

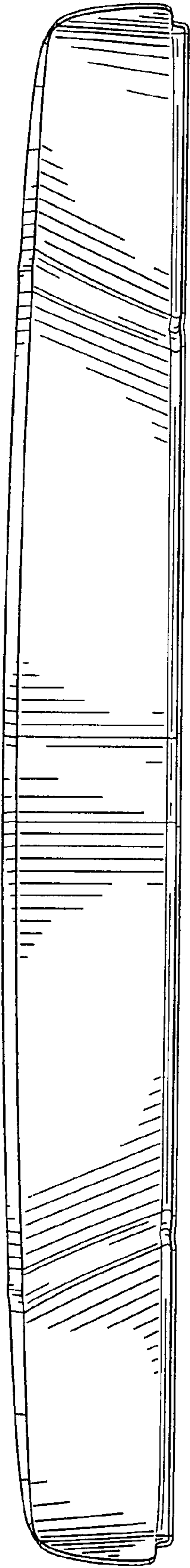

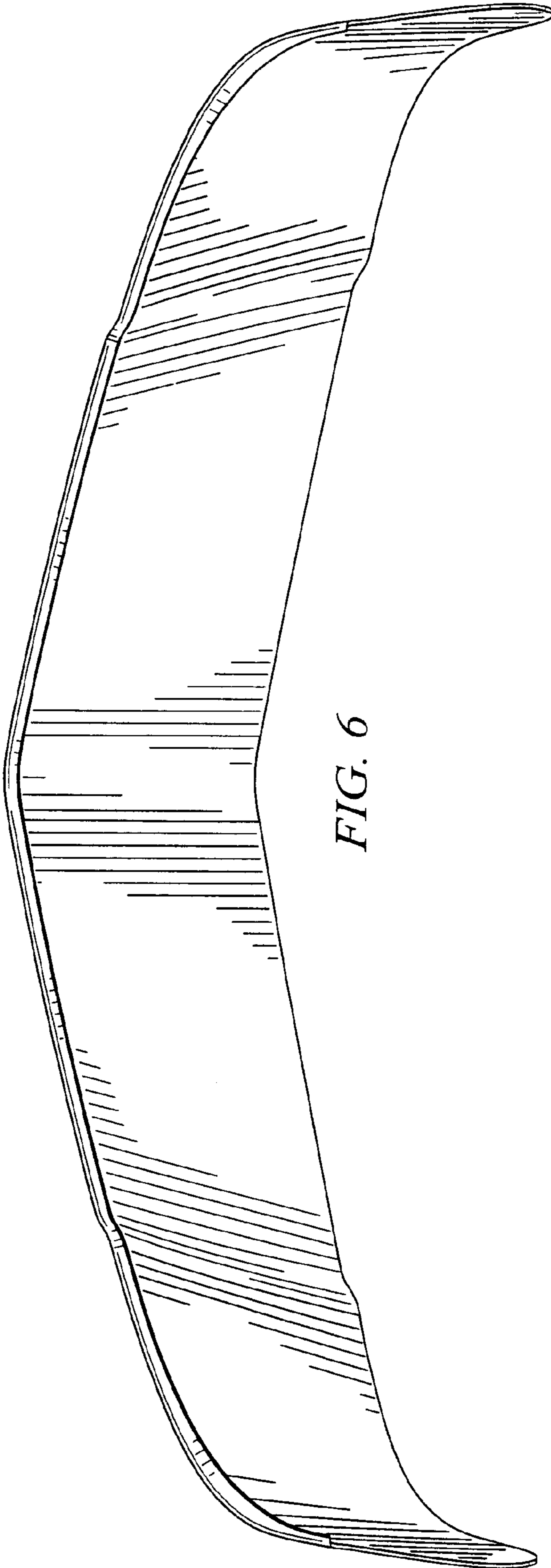
