FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the ball-catching piece.


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the ball-catching piece.


FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the ball-catching piece; and,


FIG. 8 is another perspective view of the ball-catching piece.

The broken lines in the drawing are understood to represent stitching.






