(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ball-catching piece, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a ball-catching piece.
FIG. 2 is a rear view of the ball-catching piece.
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the ball-catching piece.
FIG. 4 is a right side view of the ball-catching piece.
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the ball-catching piece.
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the ball-catching piece.
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the ball-catching piece; and,
FIG. 8 is another perspective view of the ball-catching piece.
The broken lines in the drawing are understood to represent stitching.

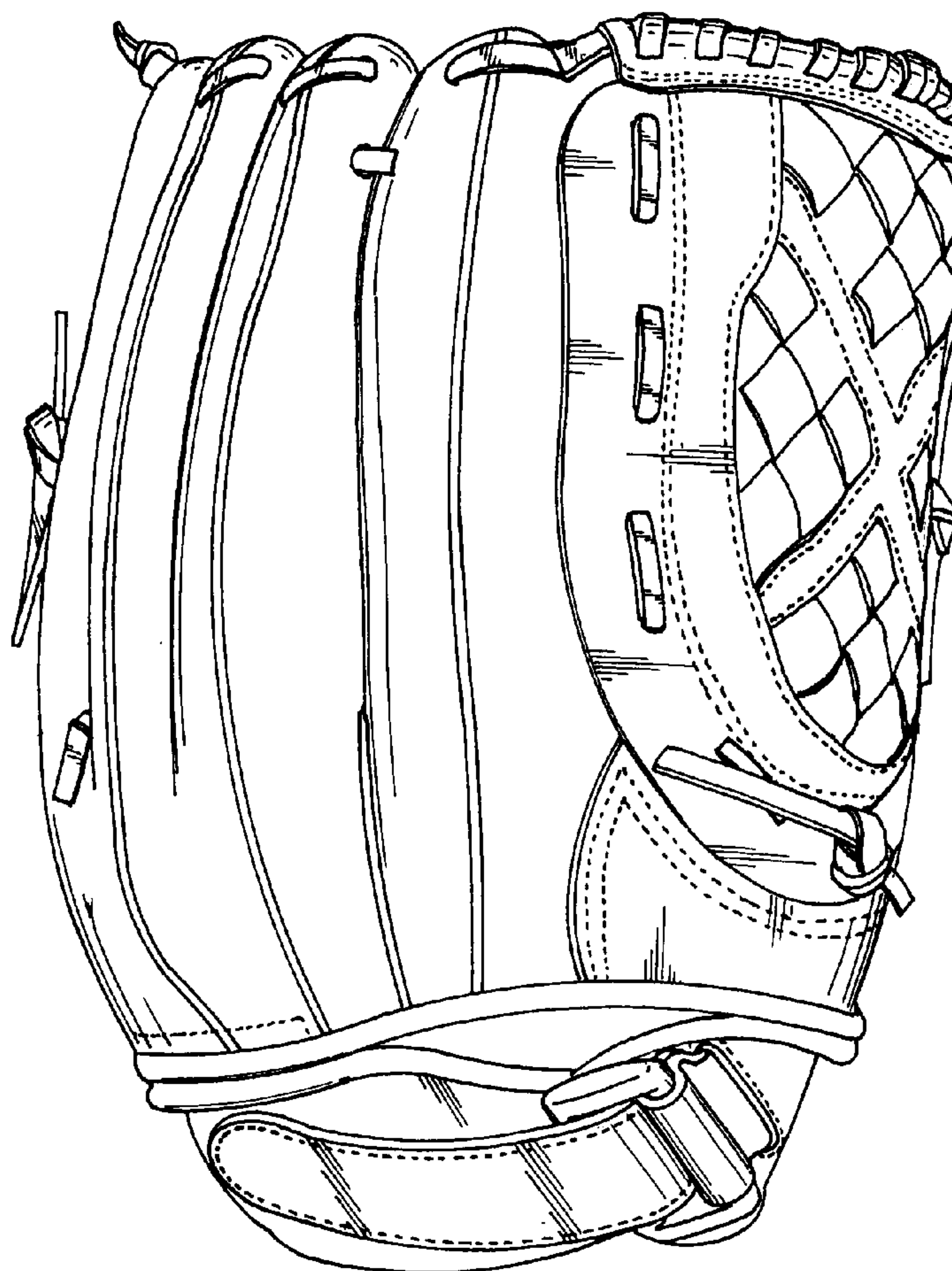

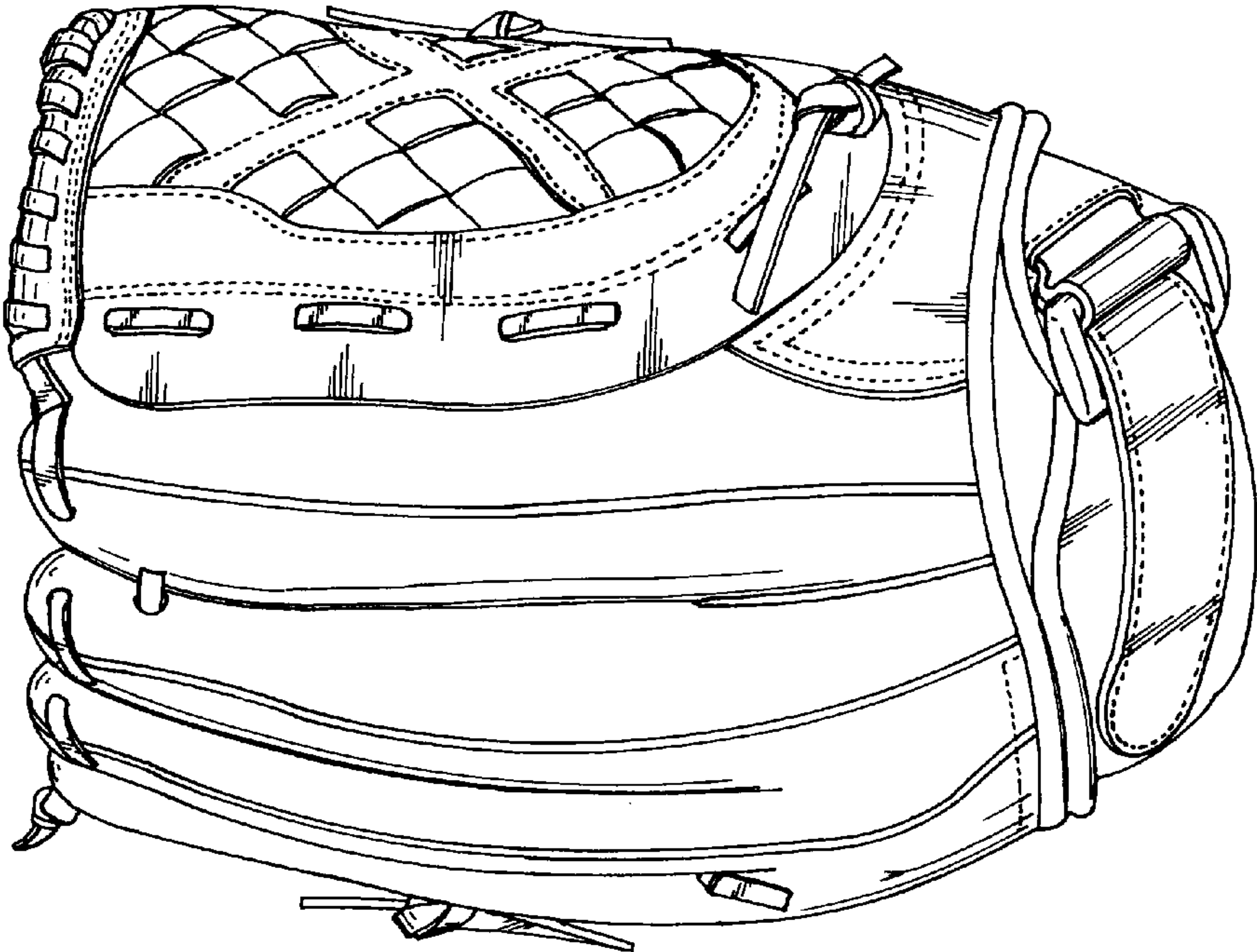

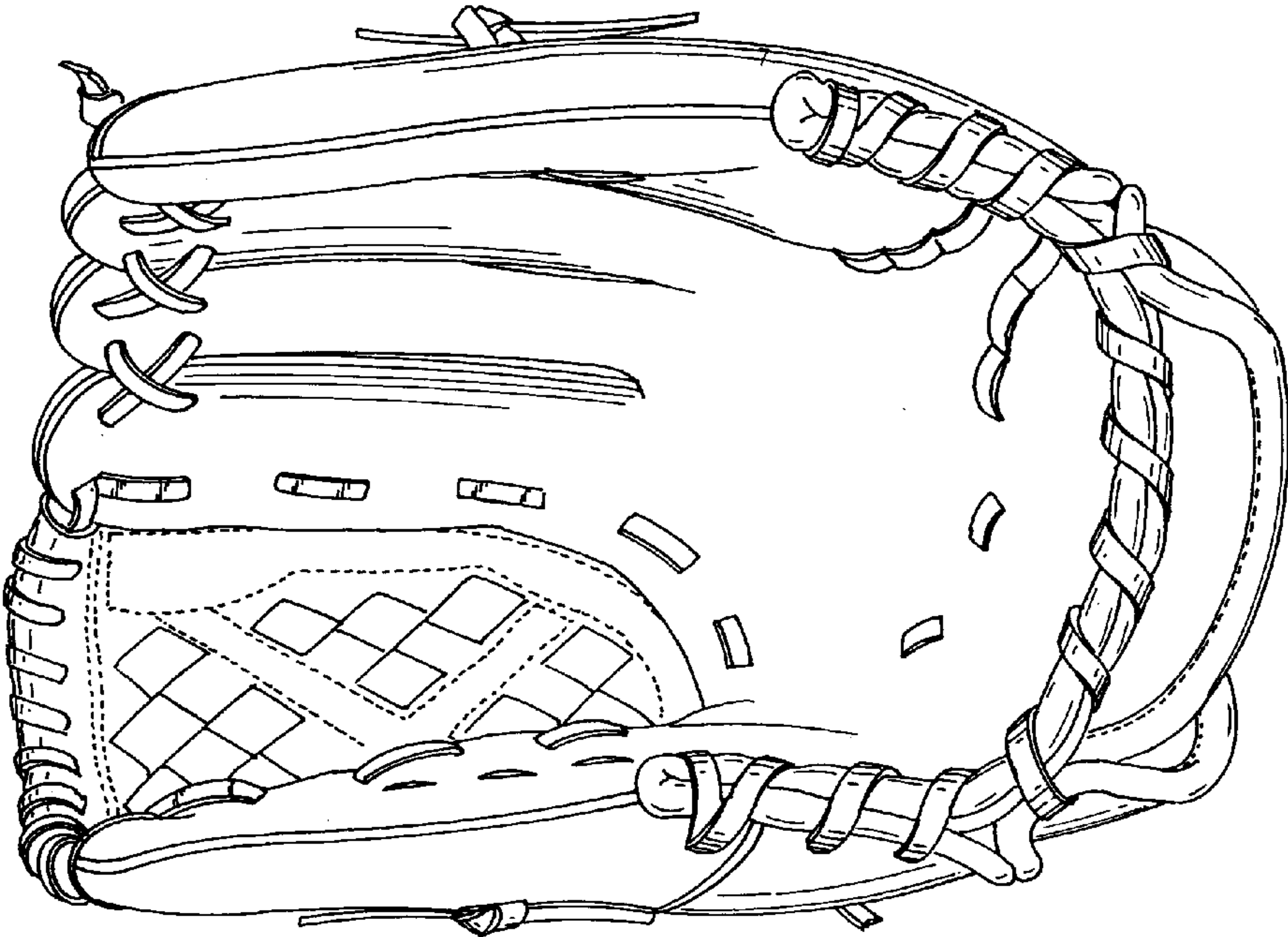

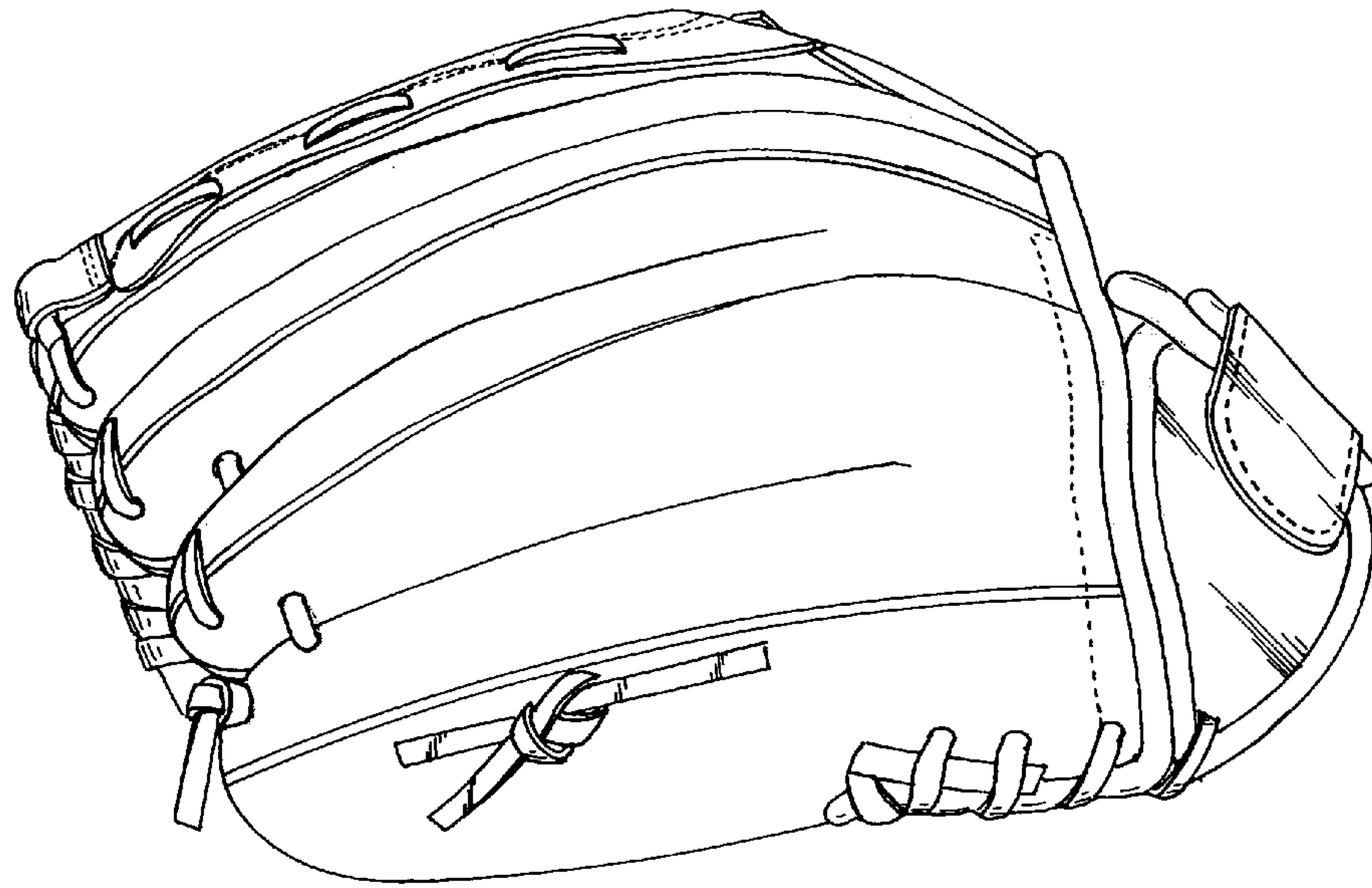

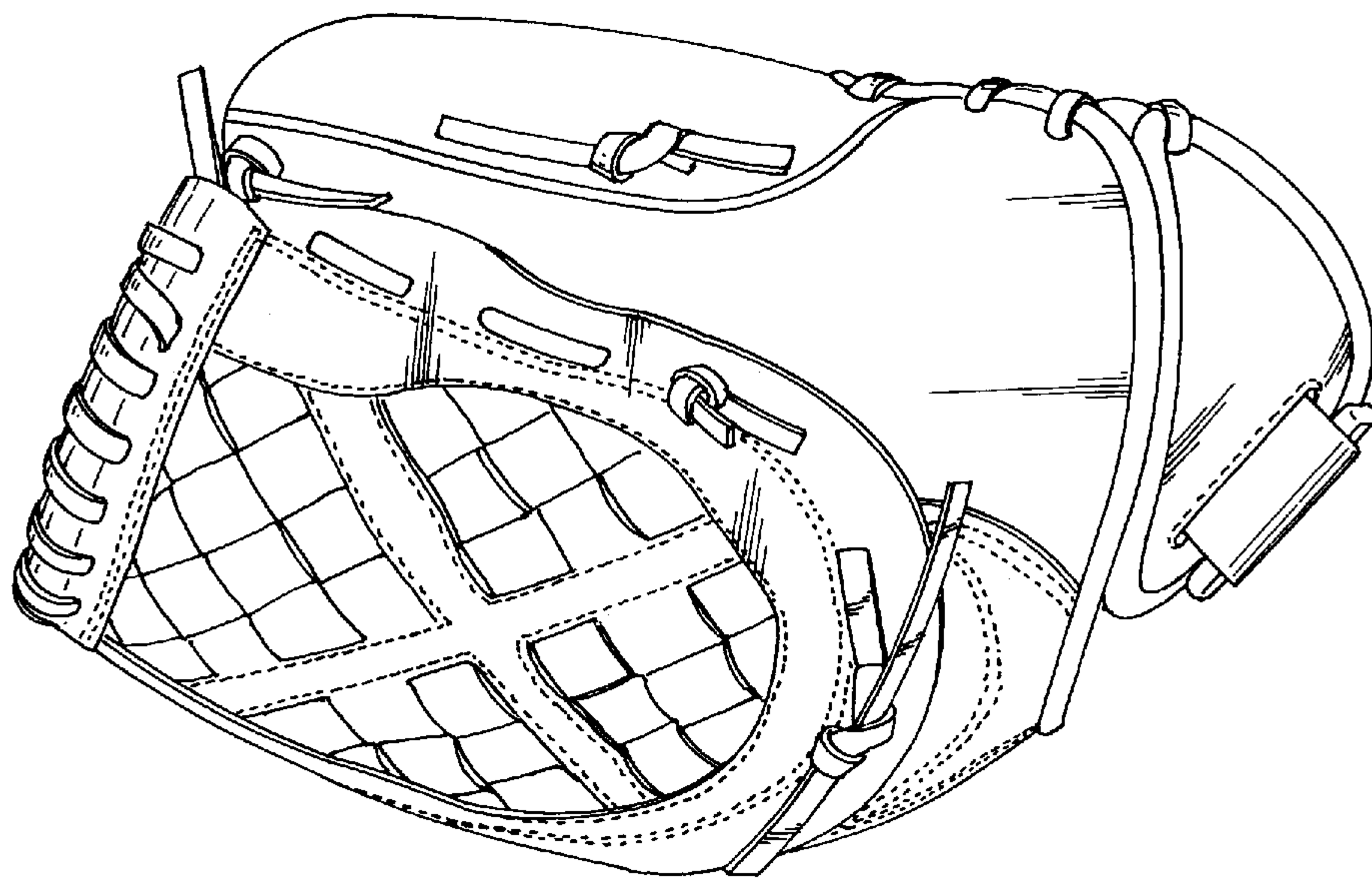

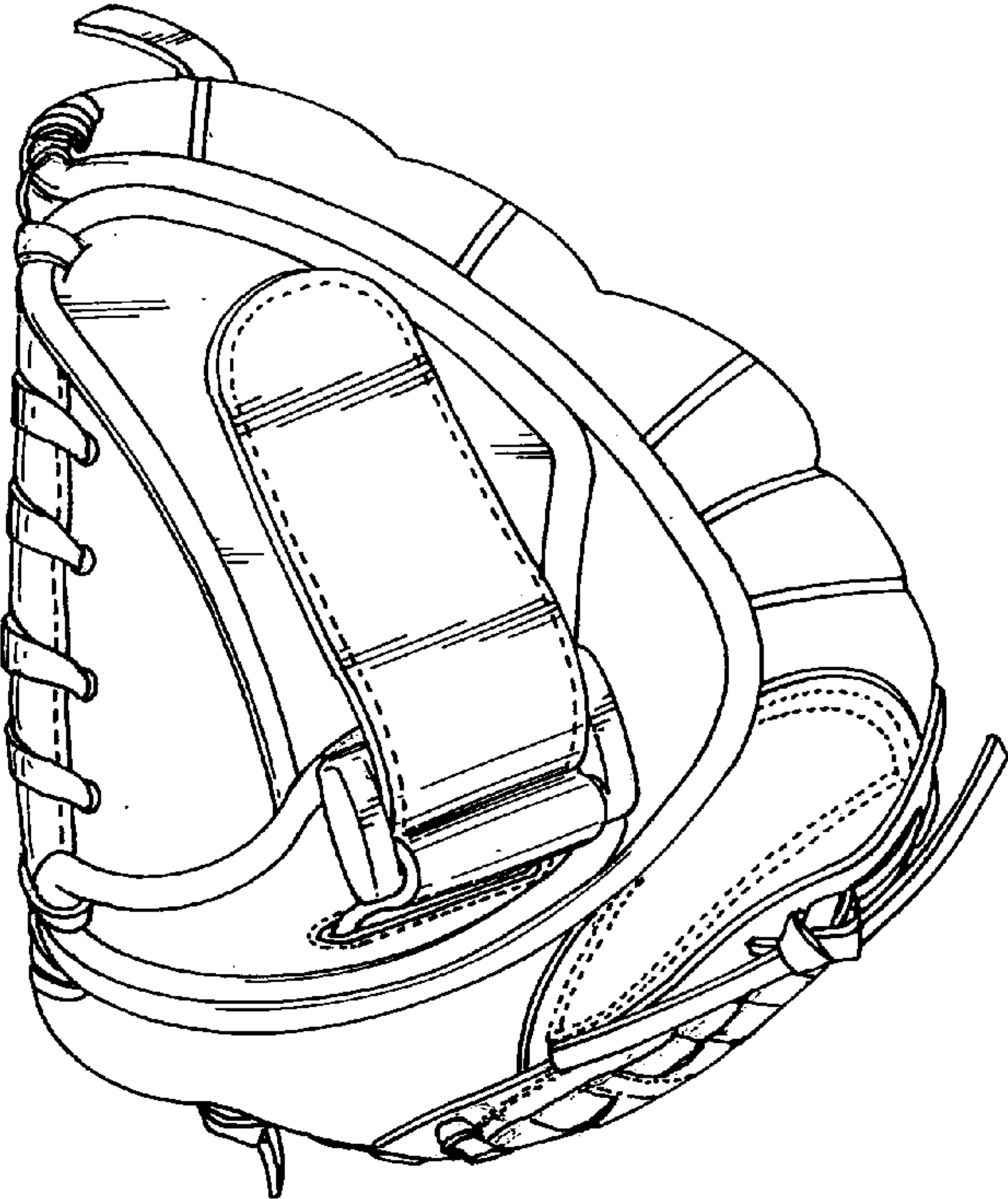

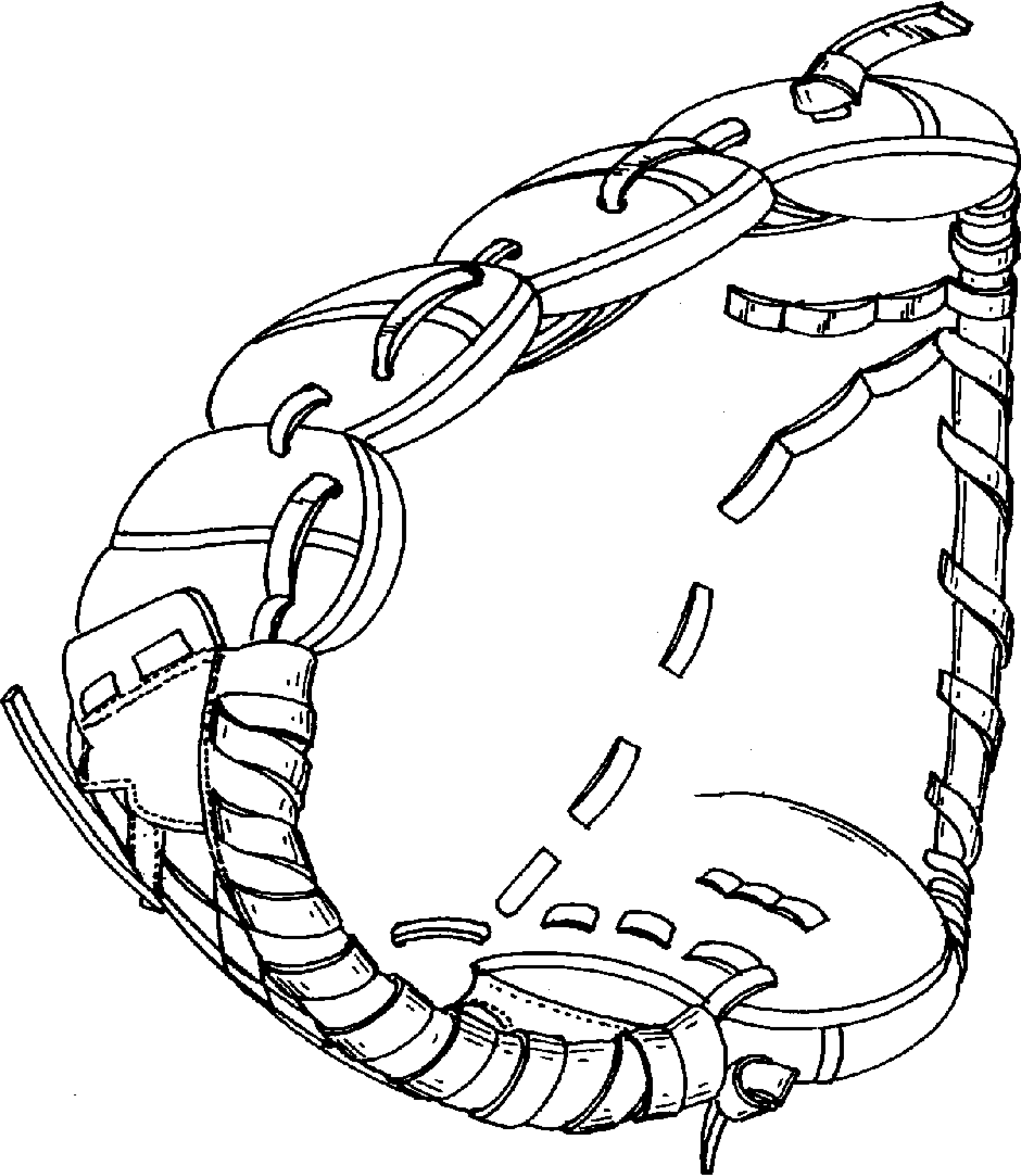

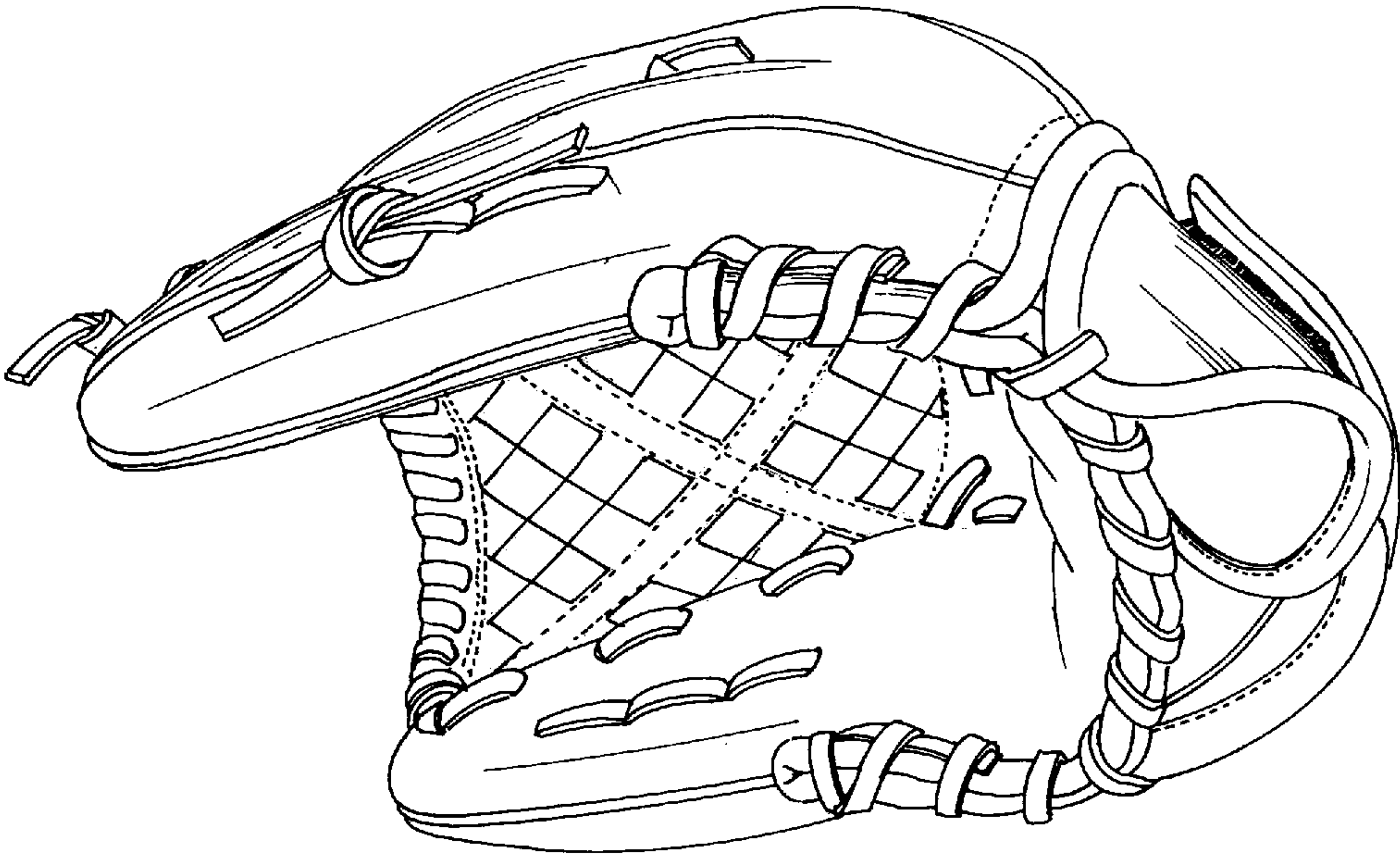
