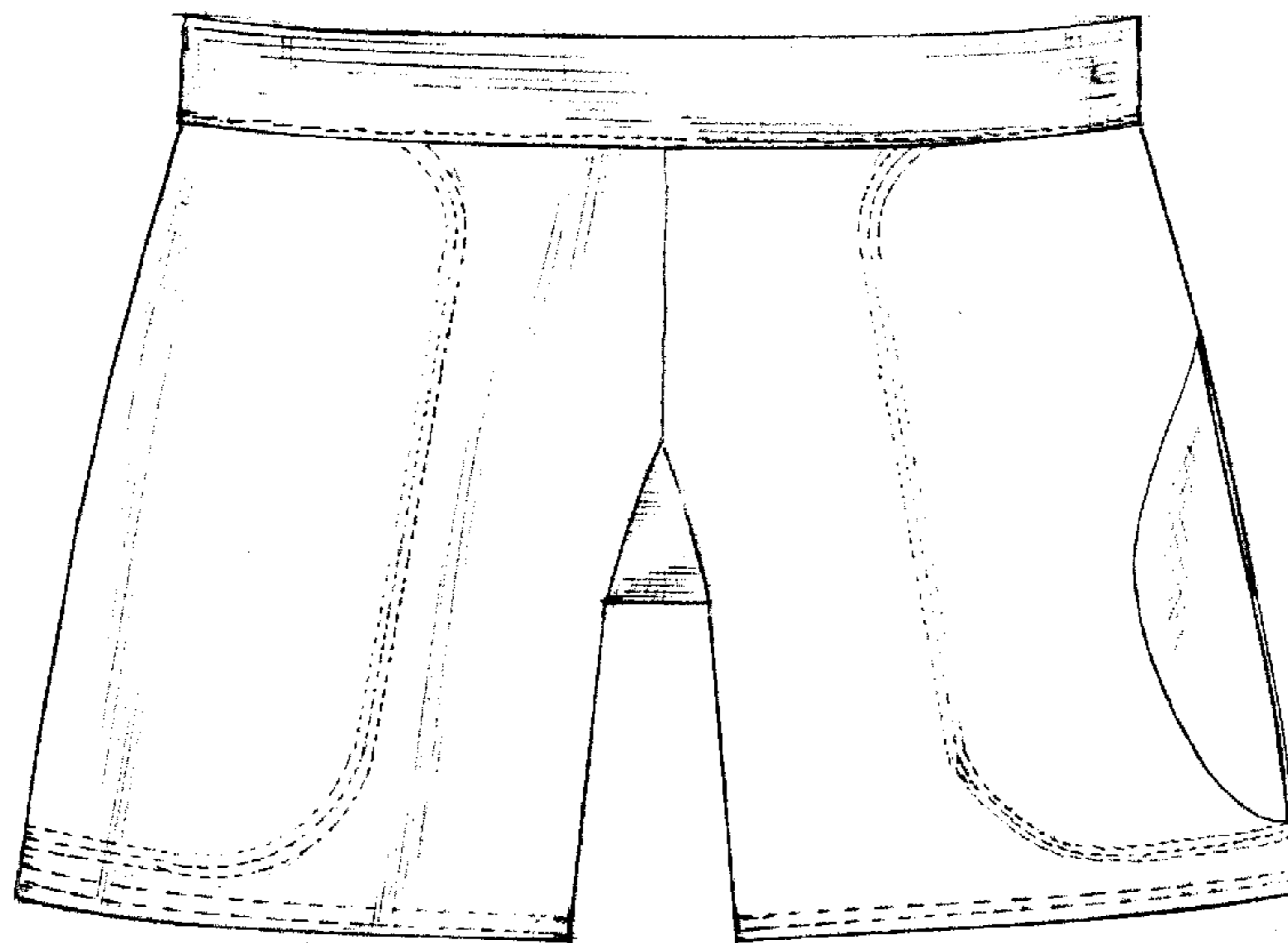

The broken lines showing the outline of a wearer are for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design. The rear view is a mirror image of the front view. The shorter broken lines shown in FIGS. 1–3 represent conventional stitching.

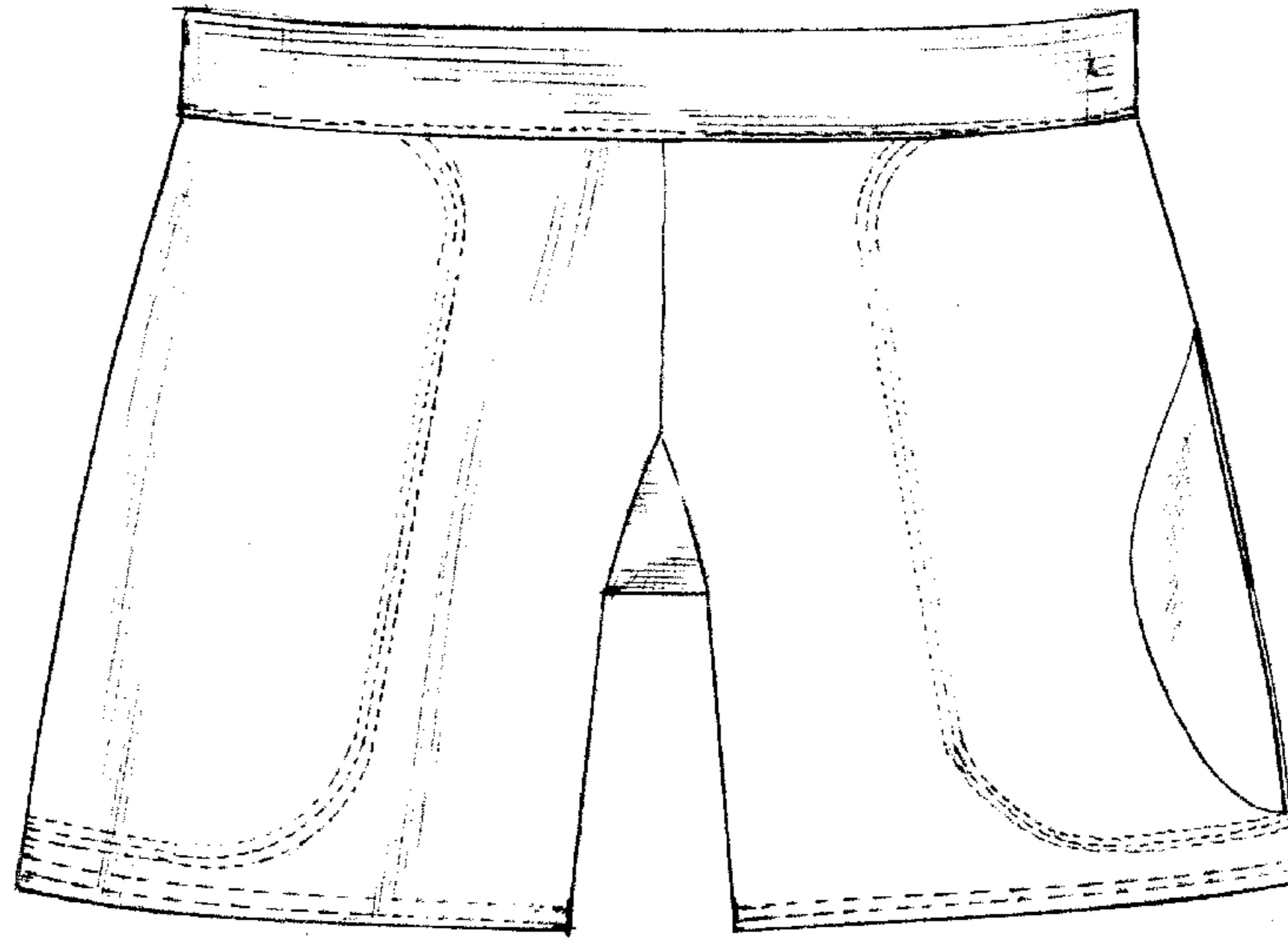

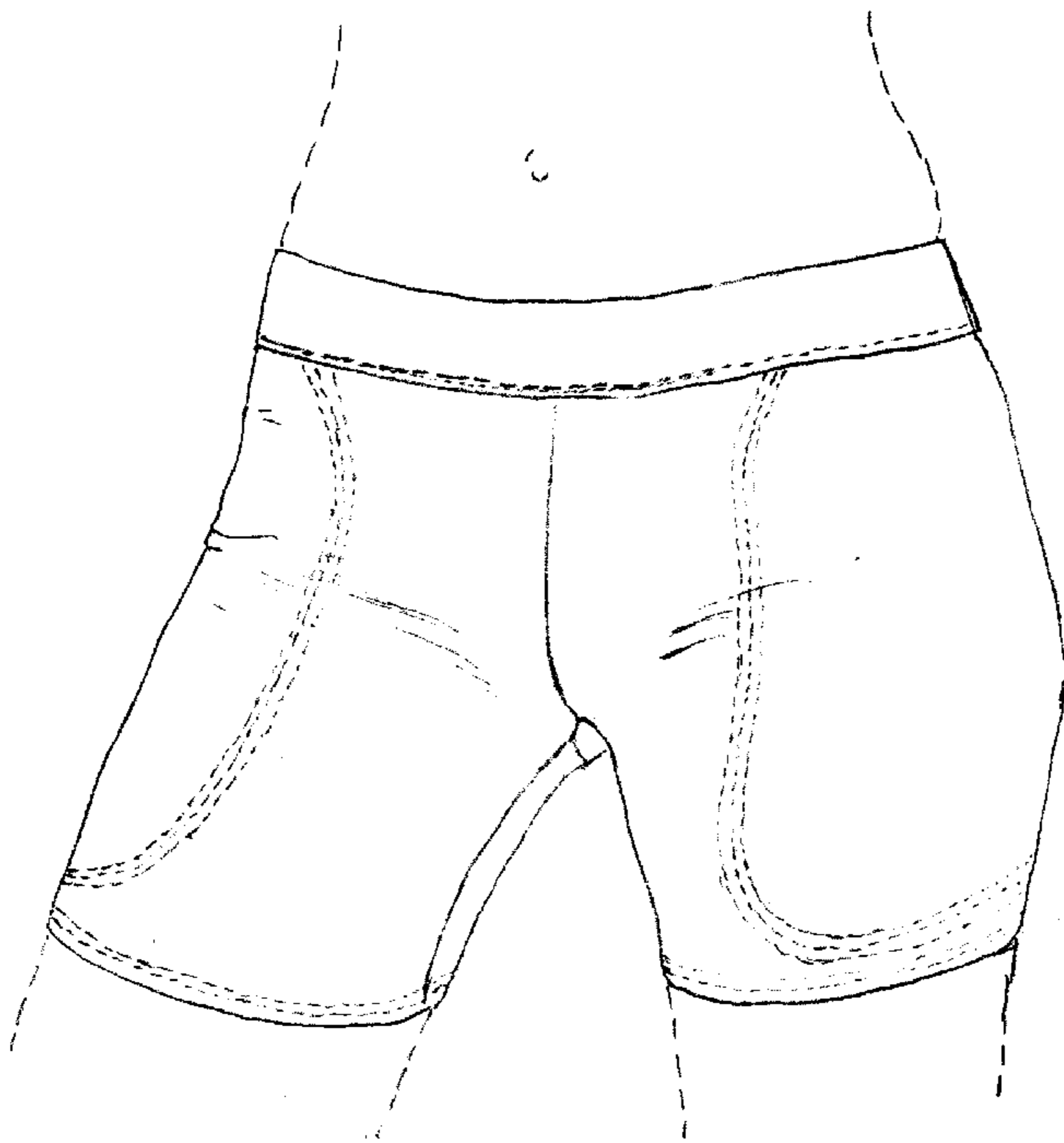

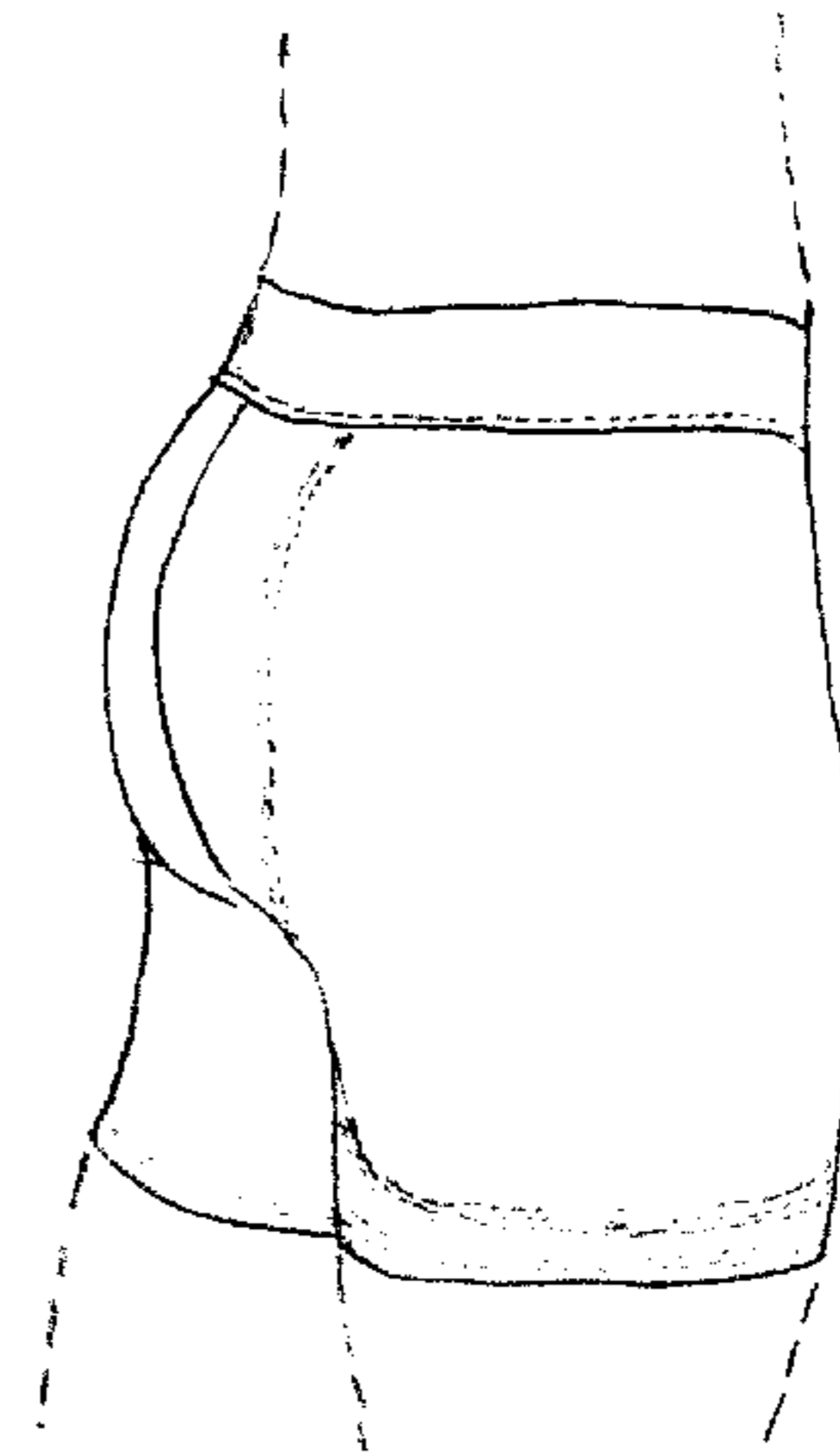

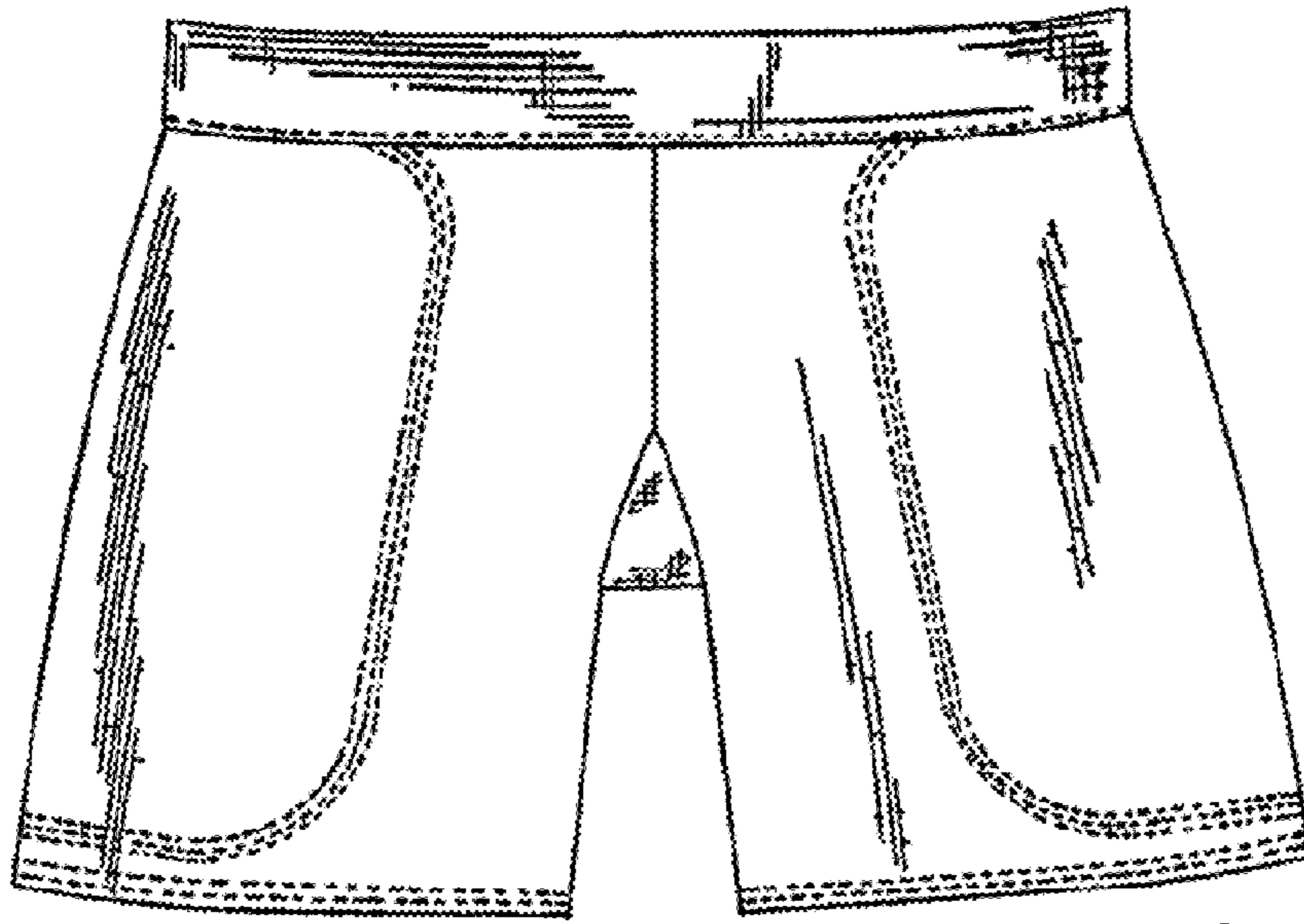

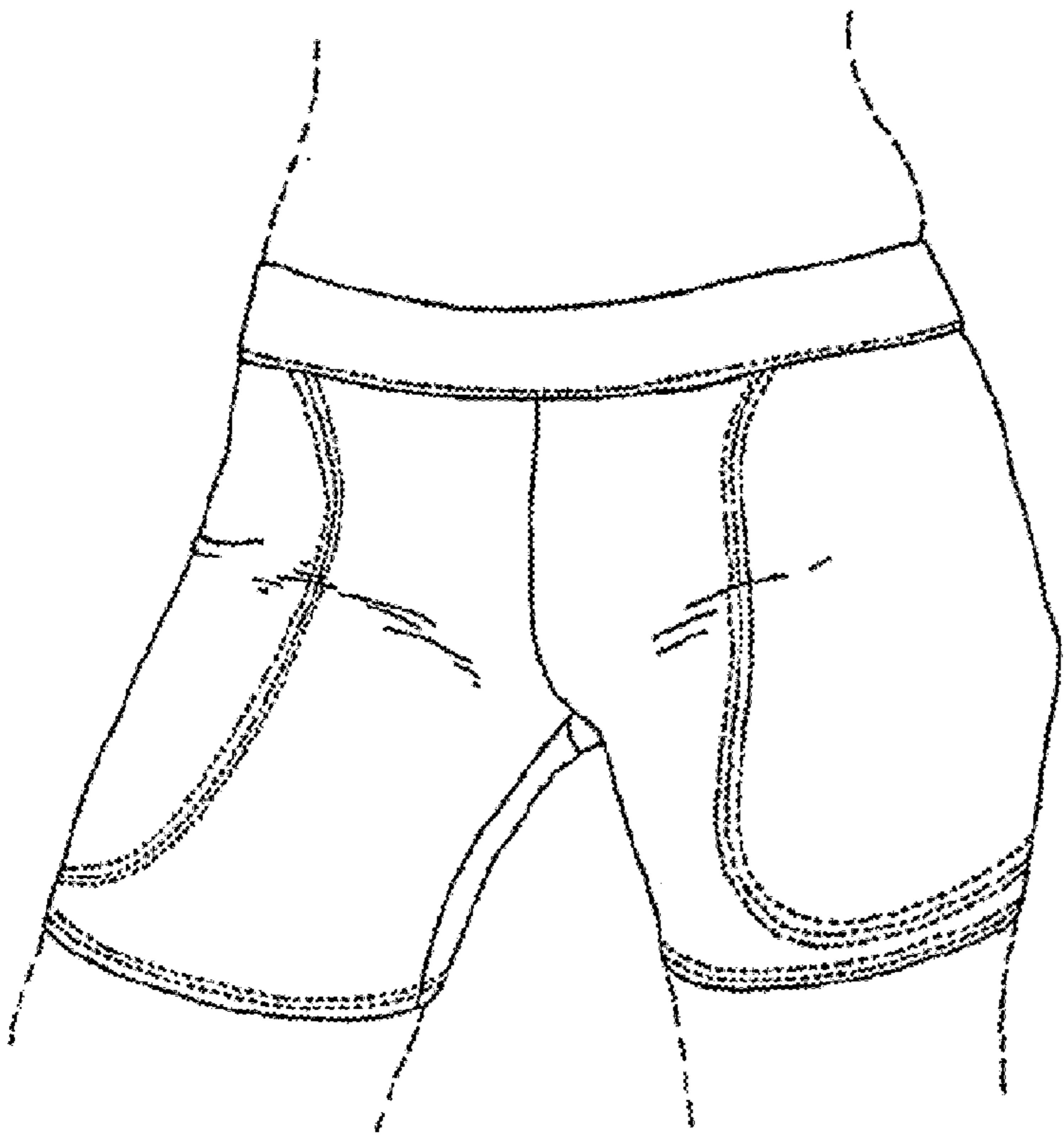

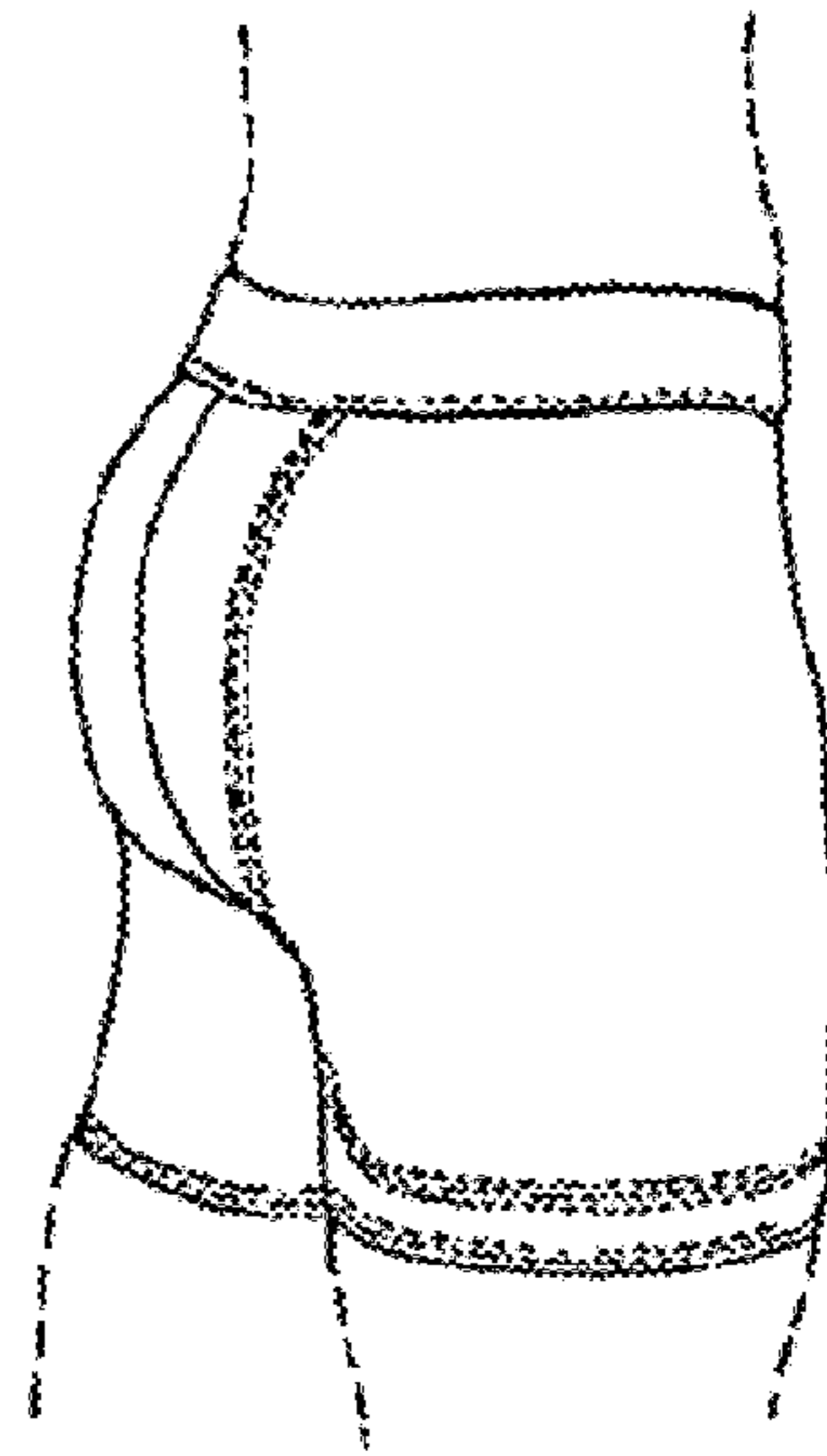
