(57) **CLAIM**

An ornamental design for a flower jewelry piece, as shown and described.

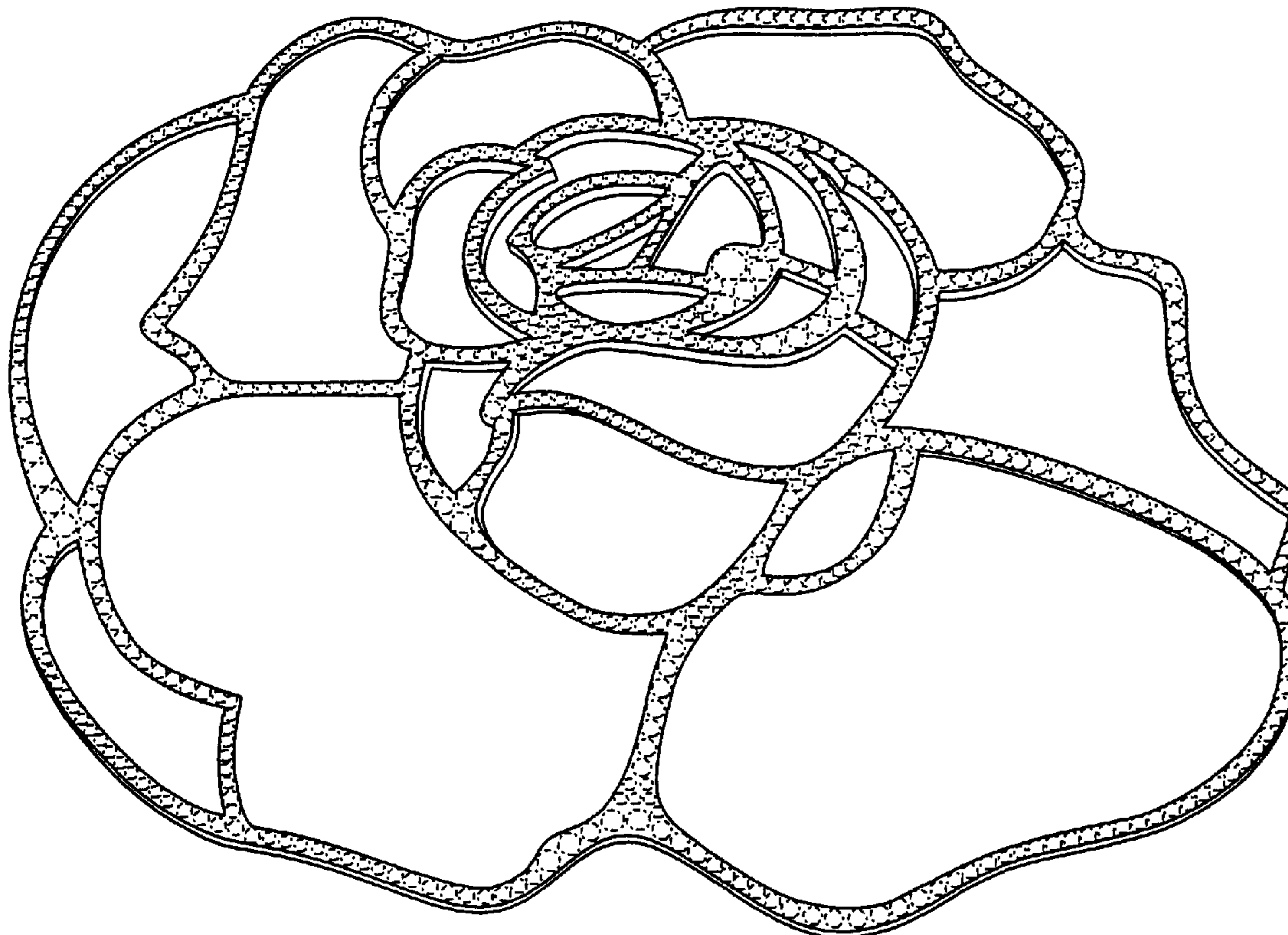
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a flower jewelry piece of the invention suitable for use as a pendant, the rear view being a mirror image thereof, with sides (both interior and exterior) being flat and unornamented; and,

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a flower jewelry piece of the invention suitable for use as a brooch, essentially the flower jewelry piece of FIG. 1 with the included clasp forming no portion of the claimed design.

It being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design, this includes the gemstones shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 and the attachment element in FIG. 2.

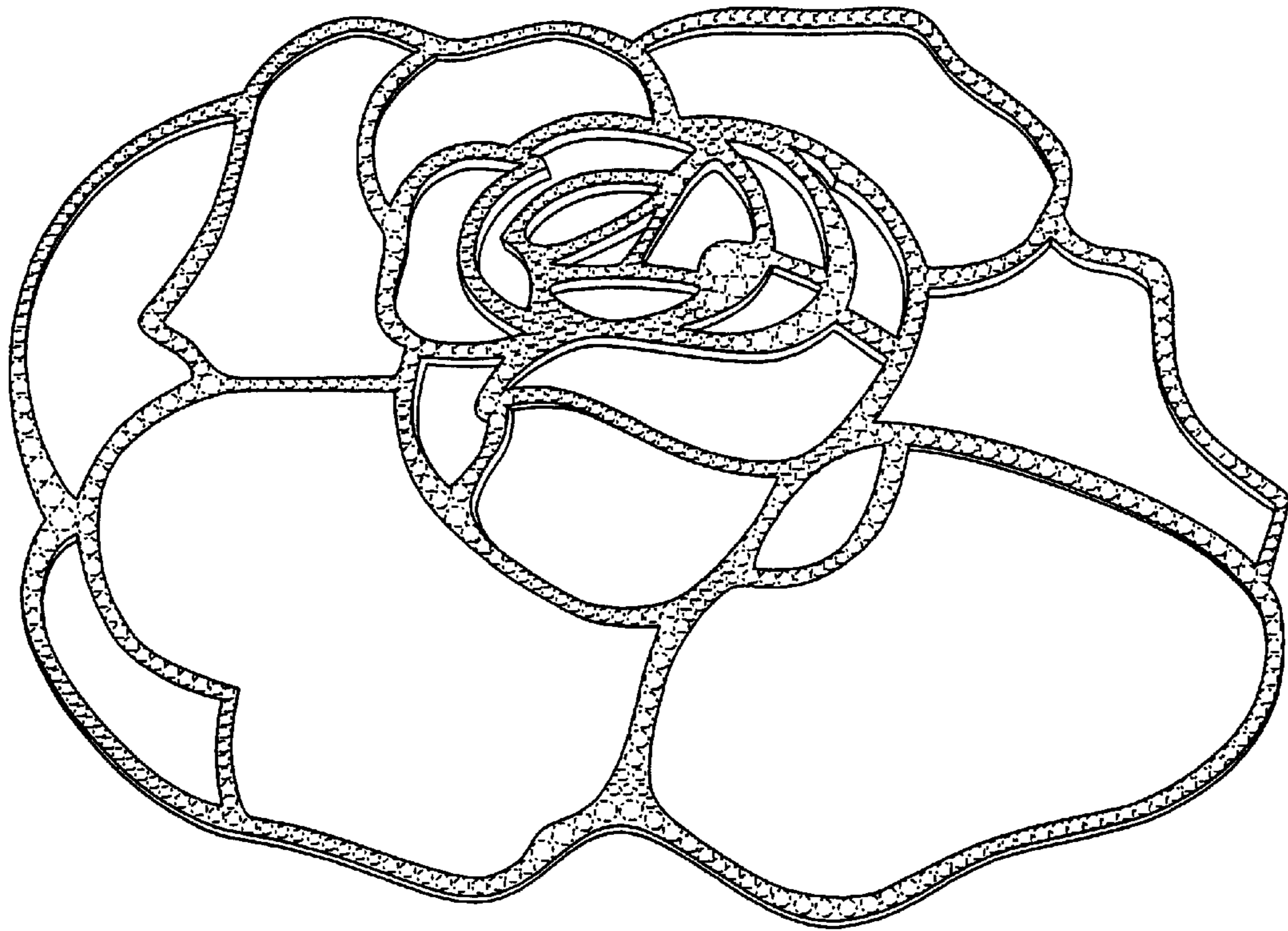

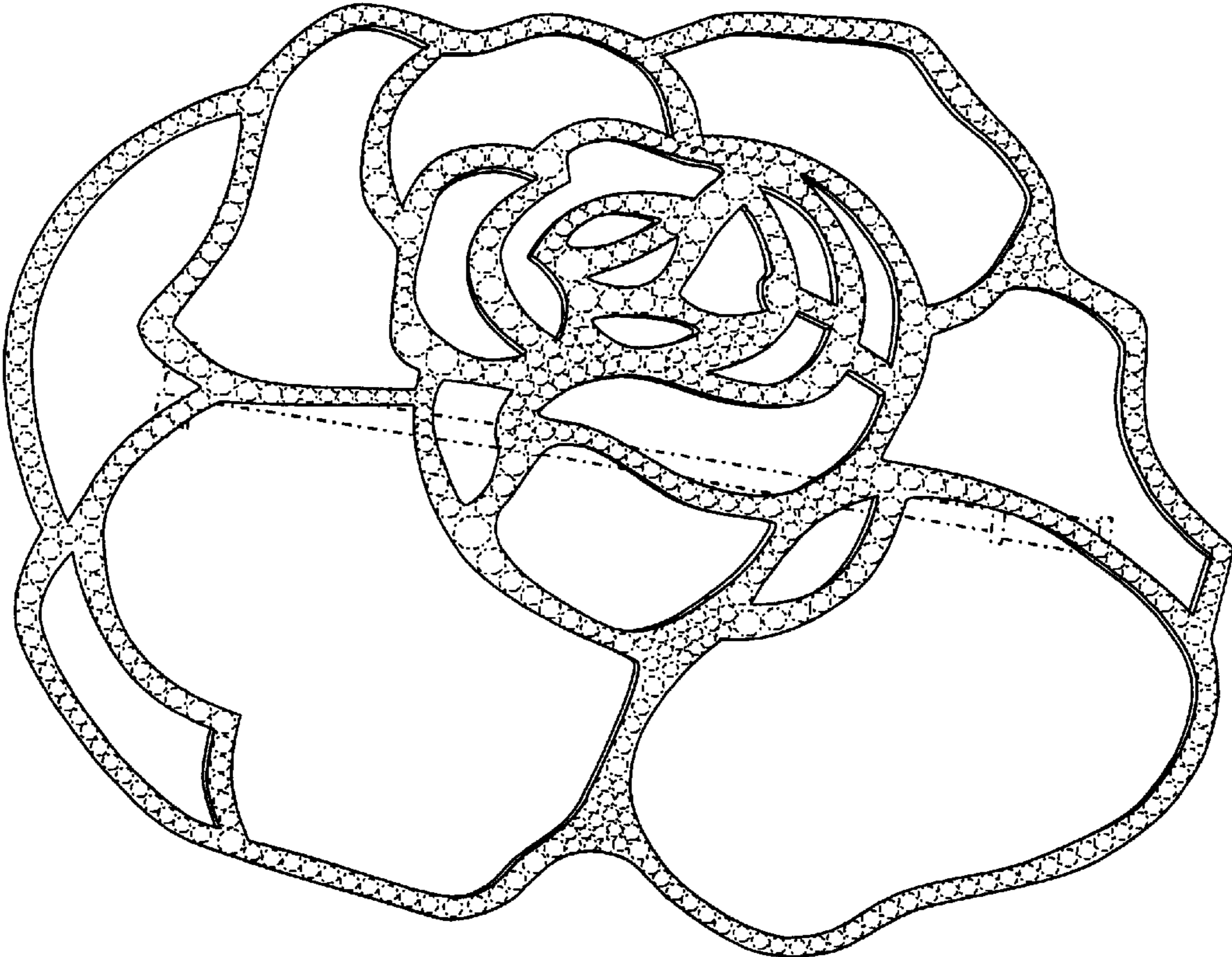
