(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a face shield for use with headgear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front quartering perspective view of a face shield for use with headgear, with broken lines that depict a use of the face shield with headgear;

FIG. 2 is a rear quartering prospective view of the face shield for use with headgear as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the face shield for use with headgear of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front quartering perspective view of the face shield for use with headgear alone for clarity, without depicting its environment of use;

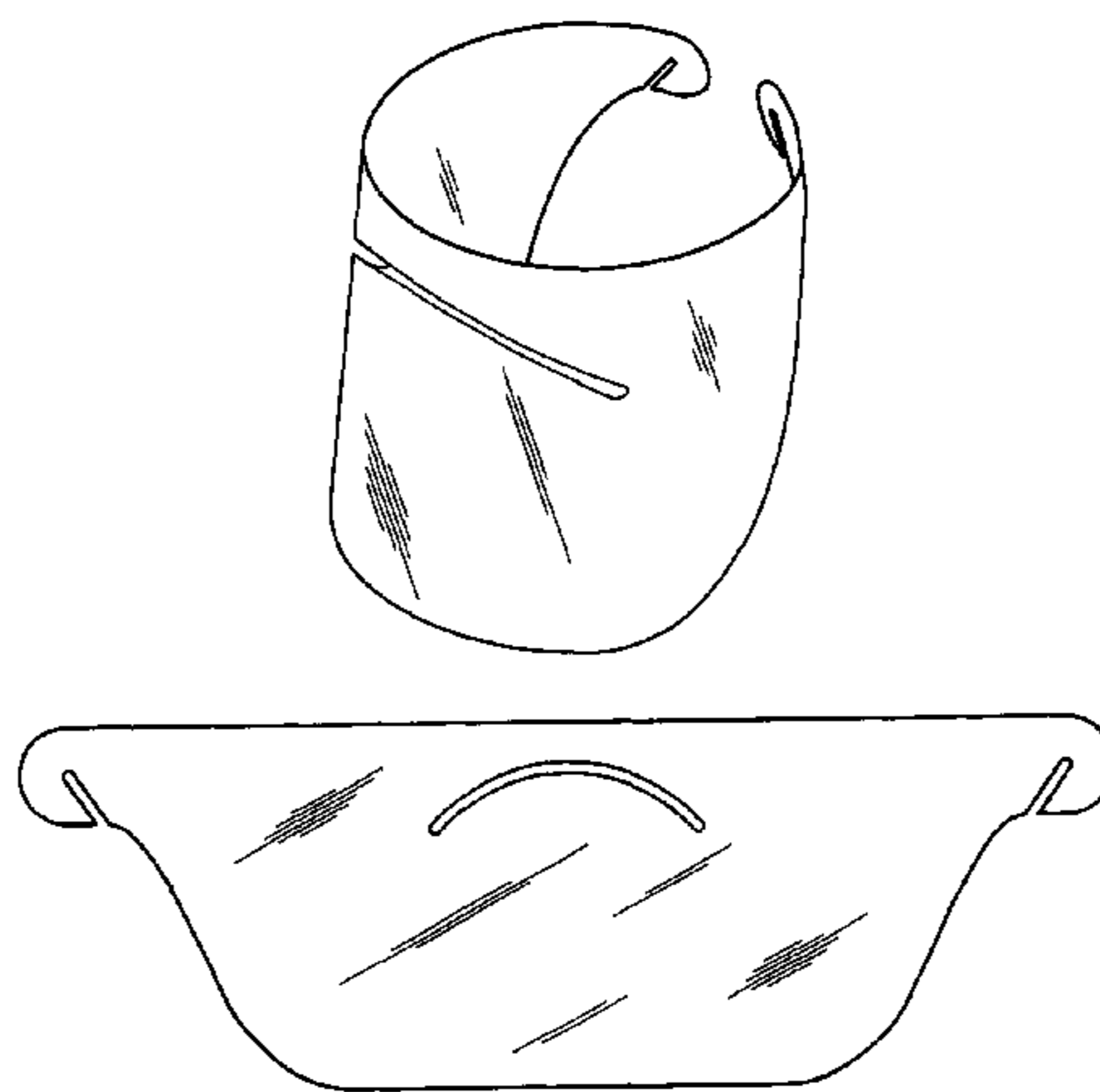
FIG. 12 is a top plan view of the face sheet deployed in the form of a flat sheet;

FIG. 10 is a right side view of the face shield for use with headgear in the form of a flat sheet (FIG. 12) before deployment;

FIG. 11 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a side view of the top face of the form depicted in FIG. 12; and,

FIG. 14 is a side view of the bottom face of the form depicted in FIG. 12.

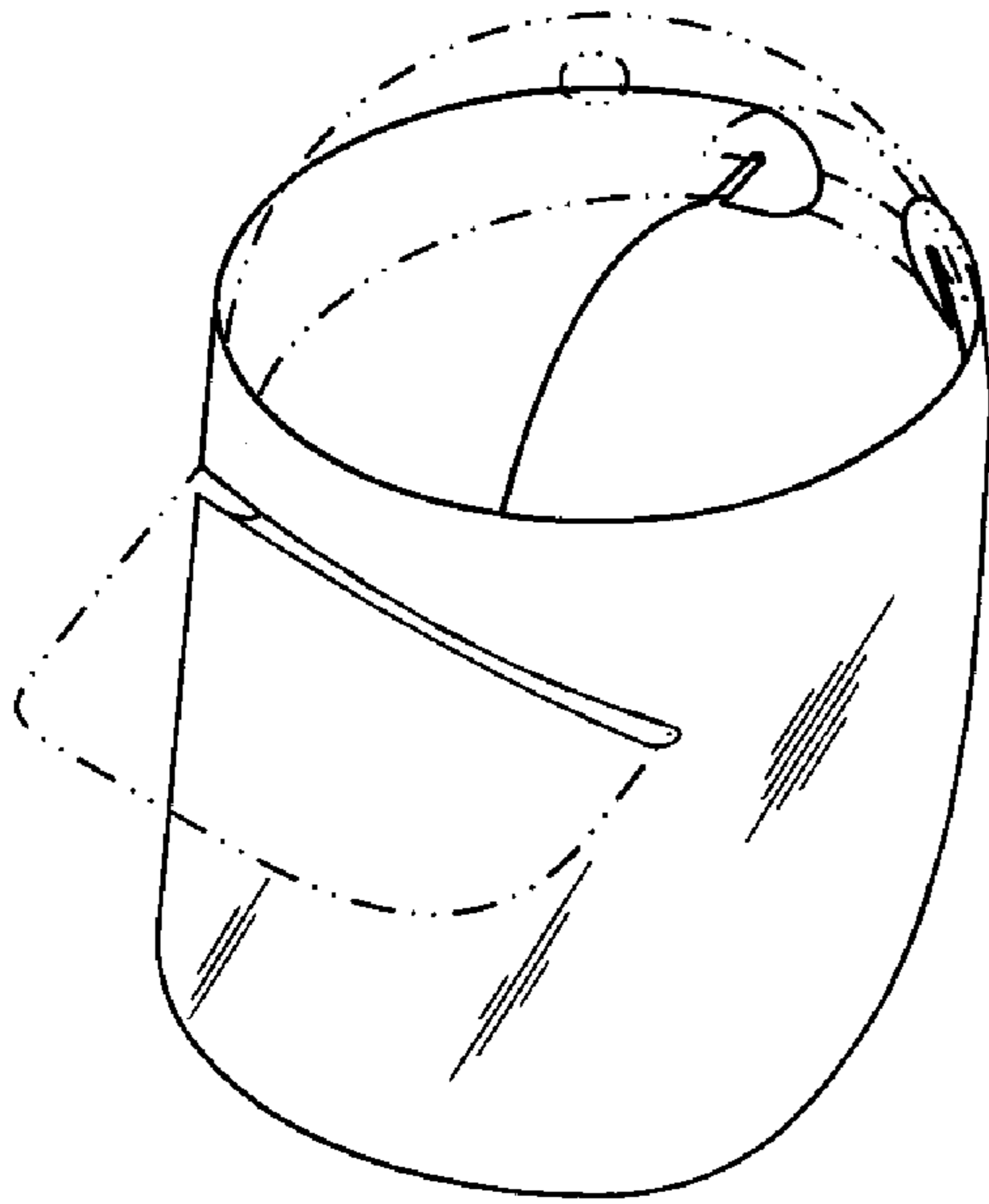

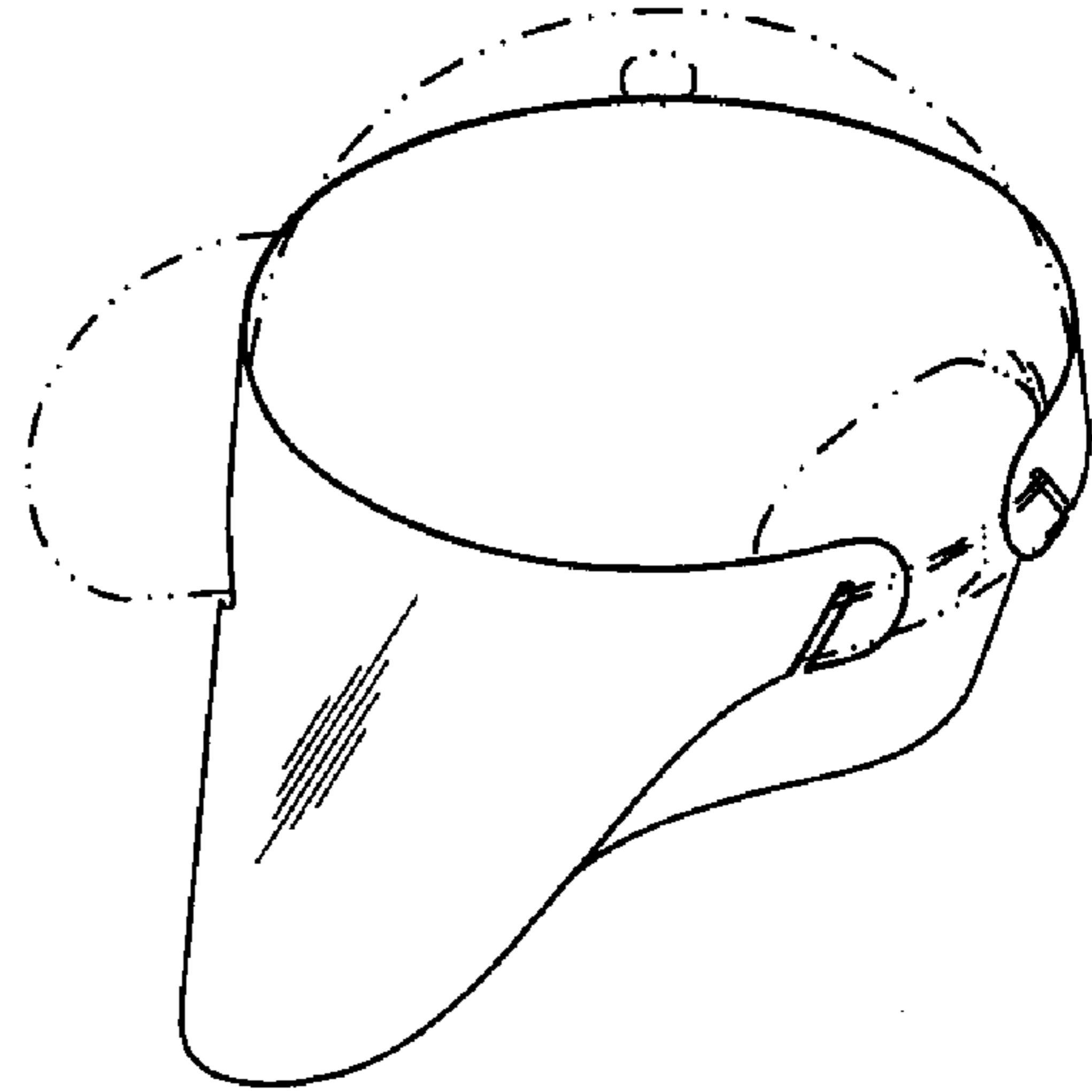

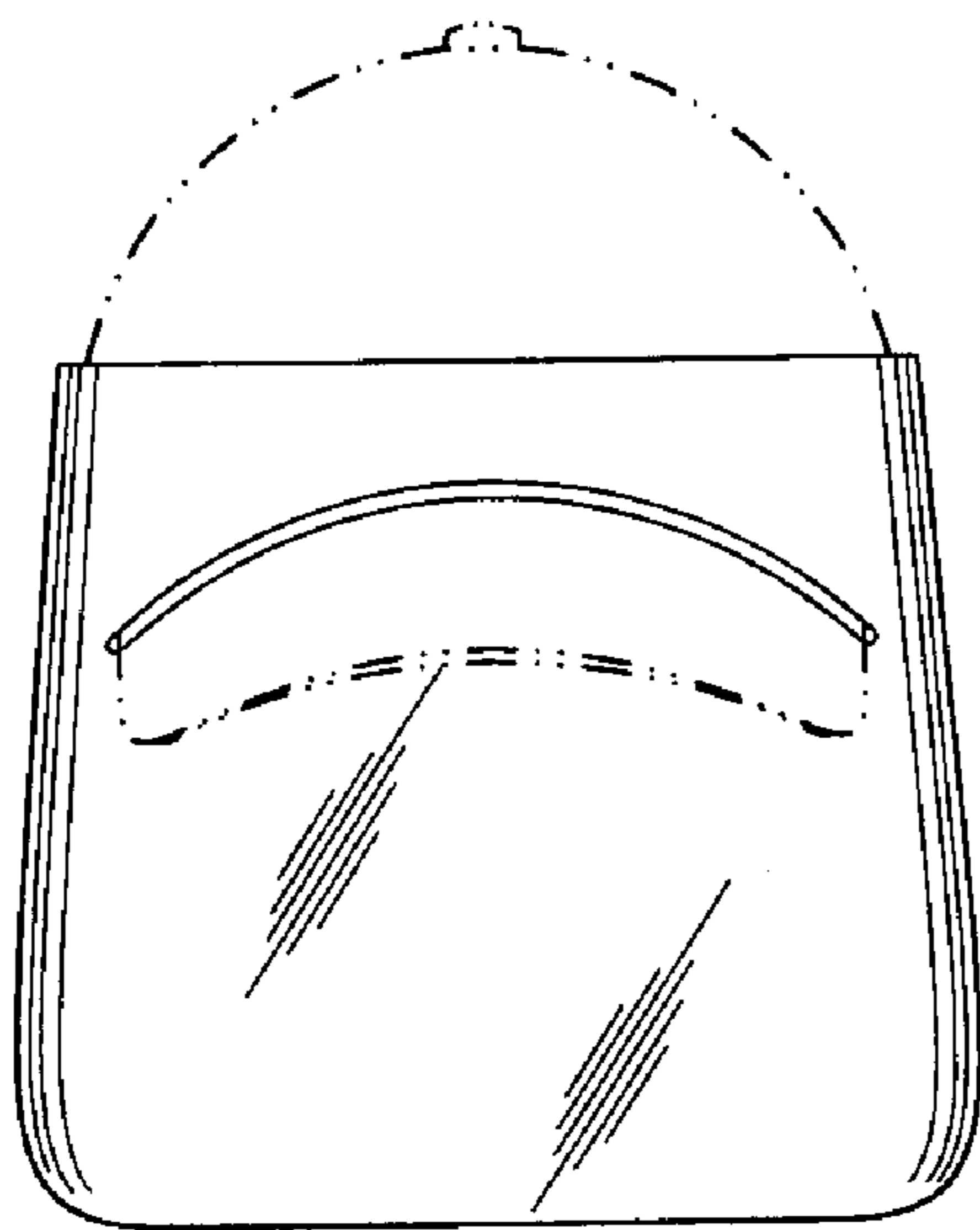

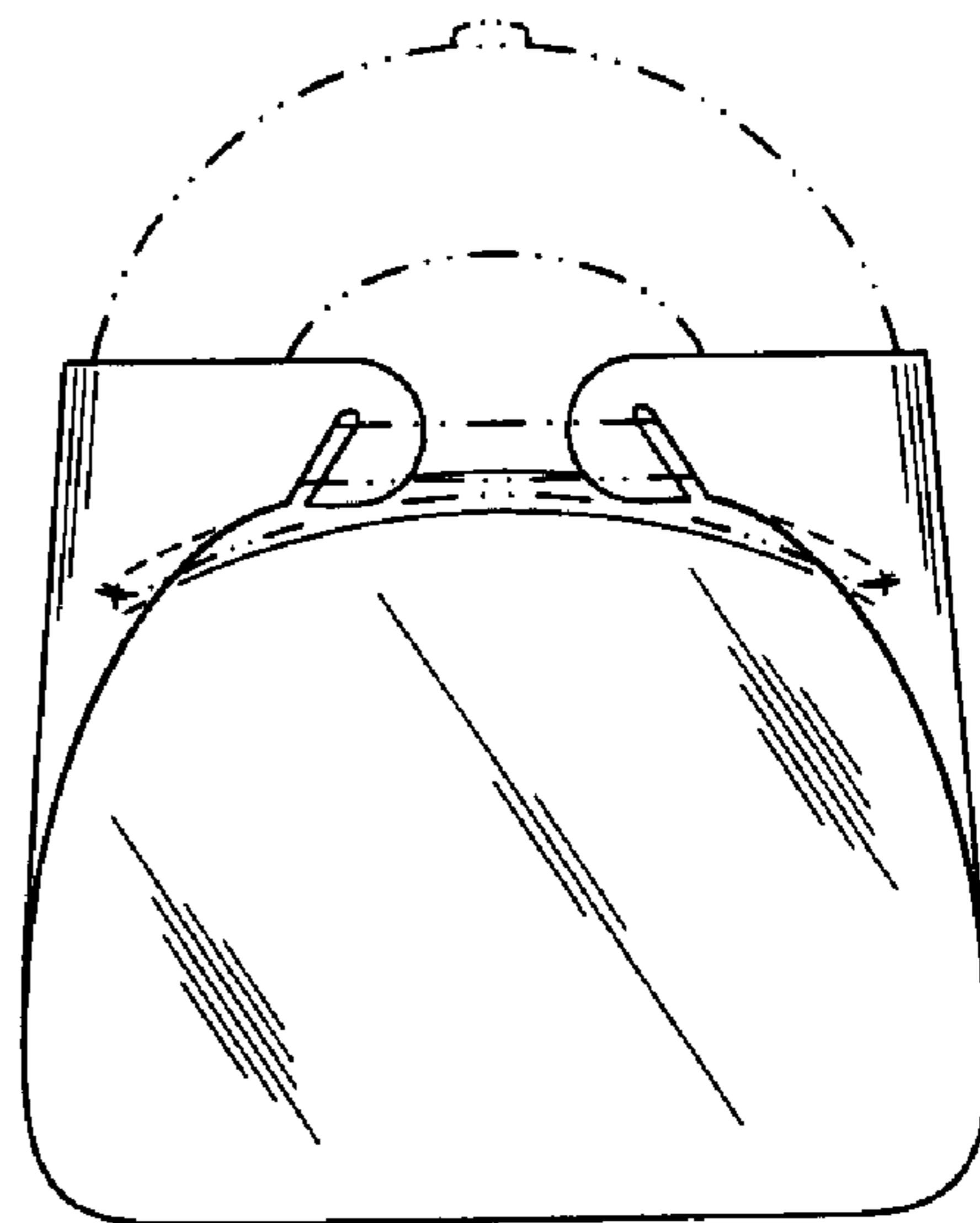

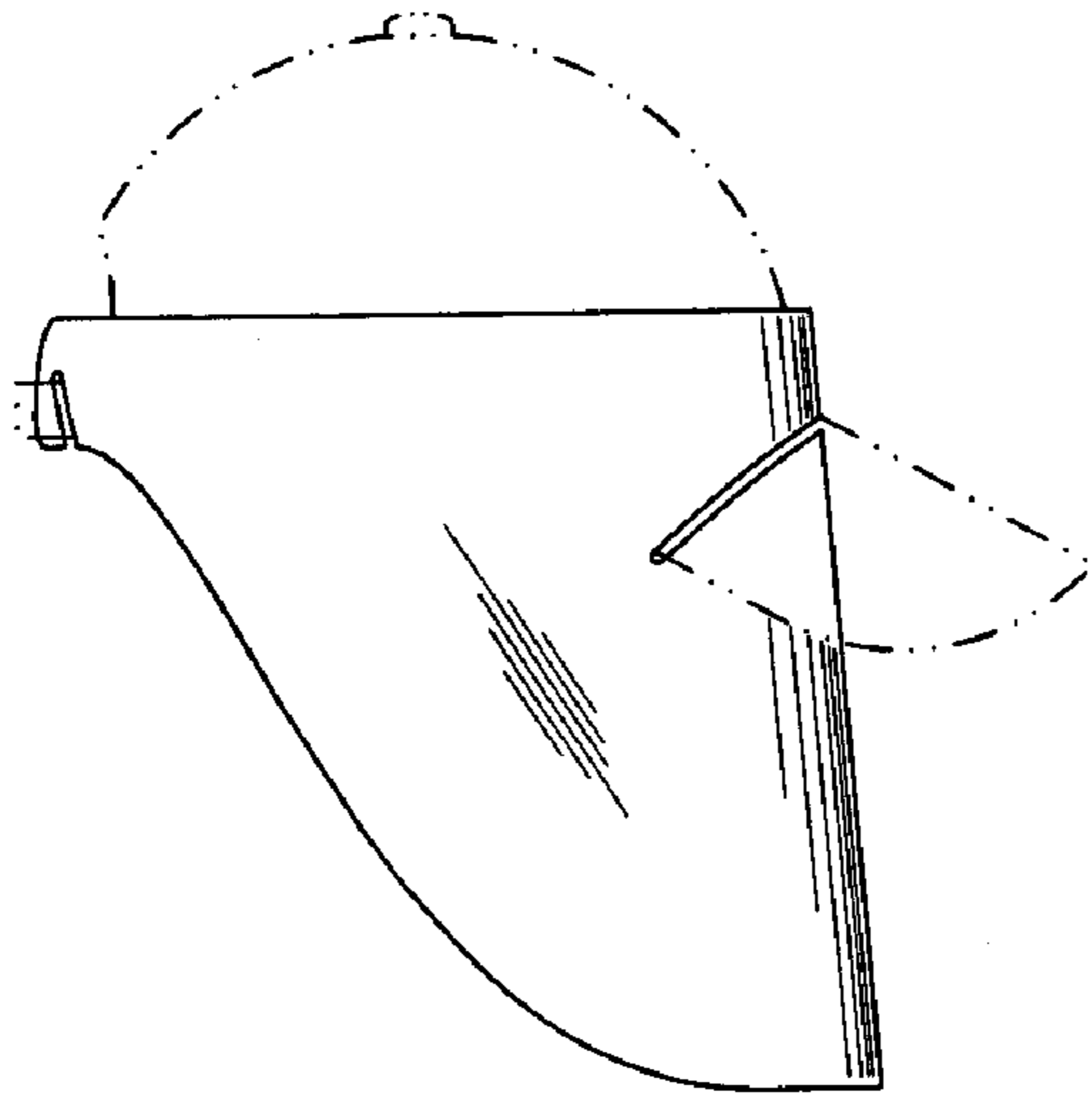

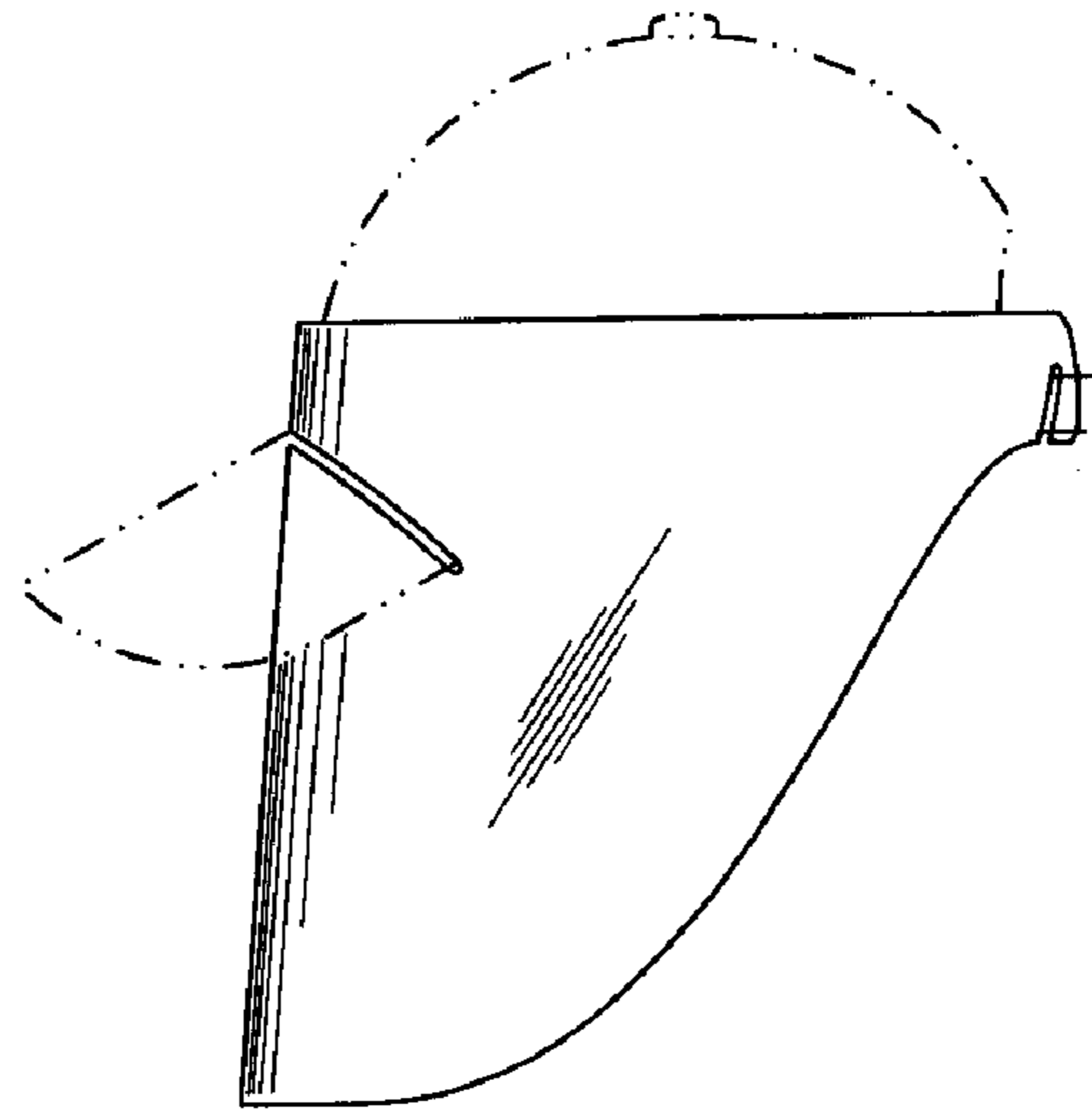

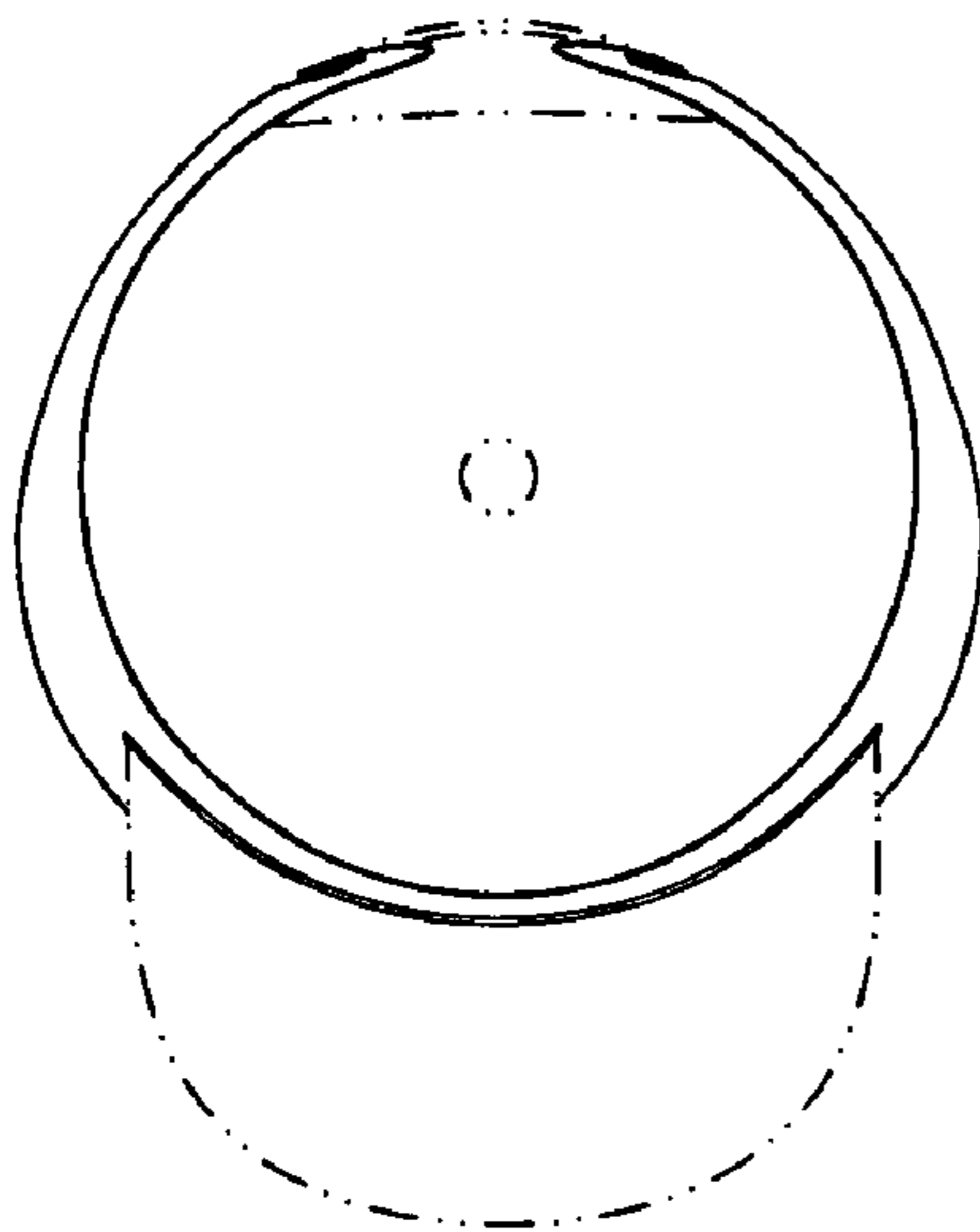

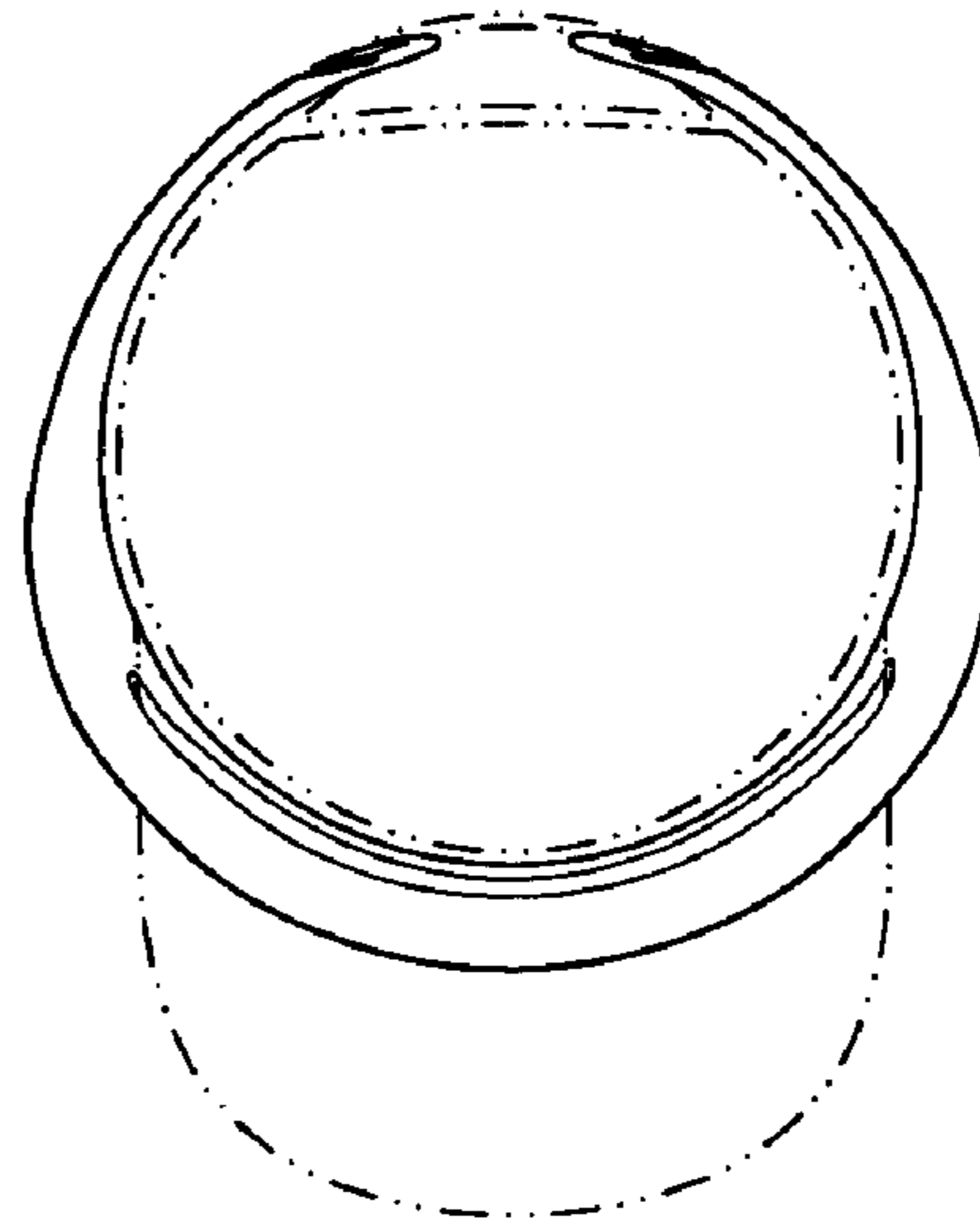

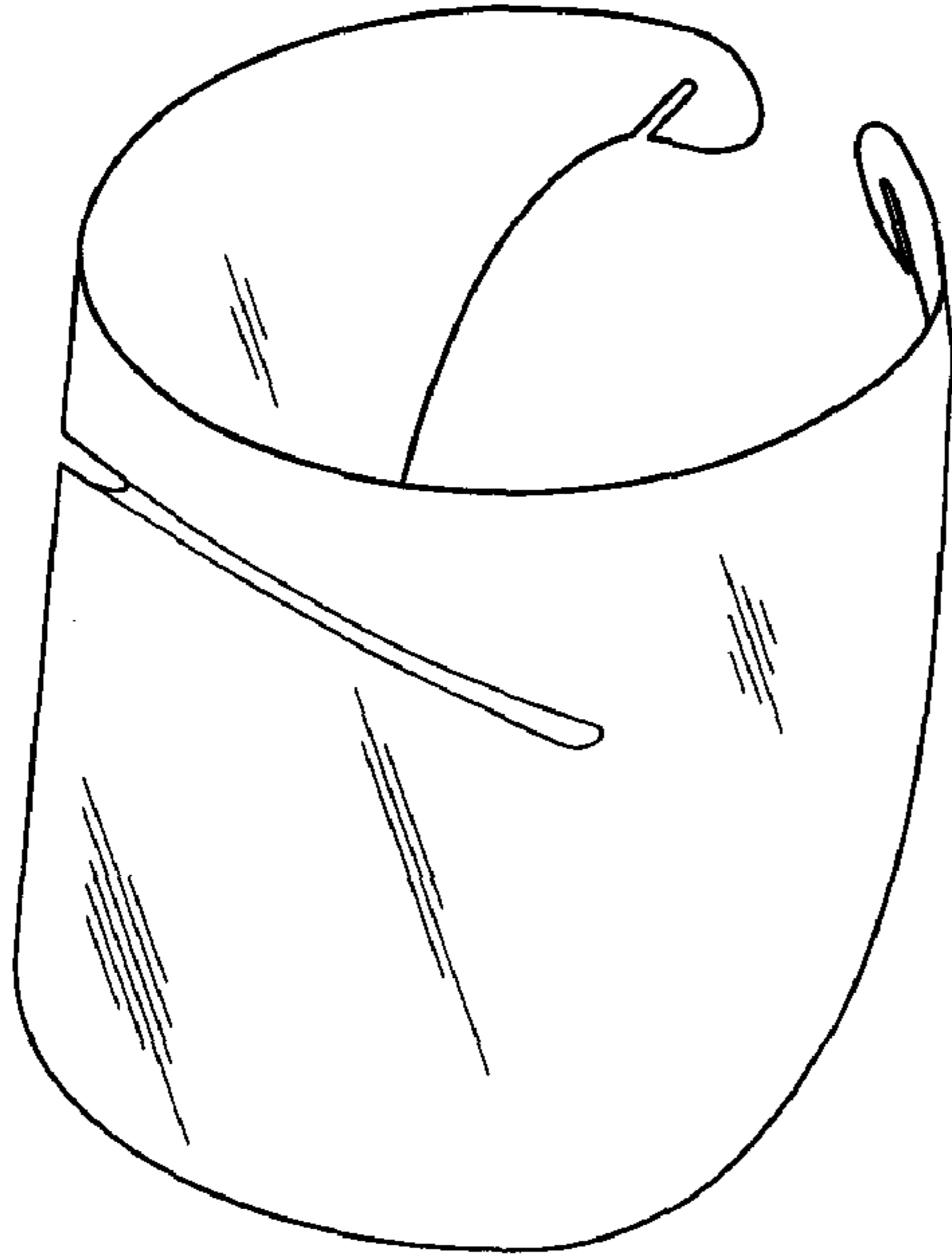

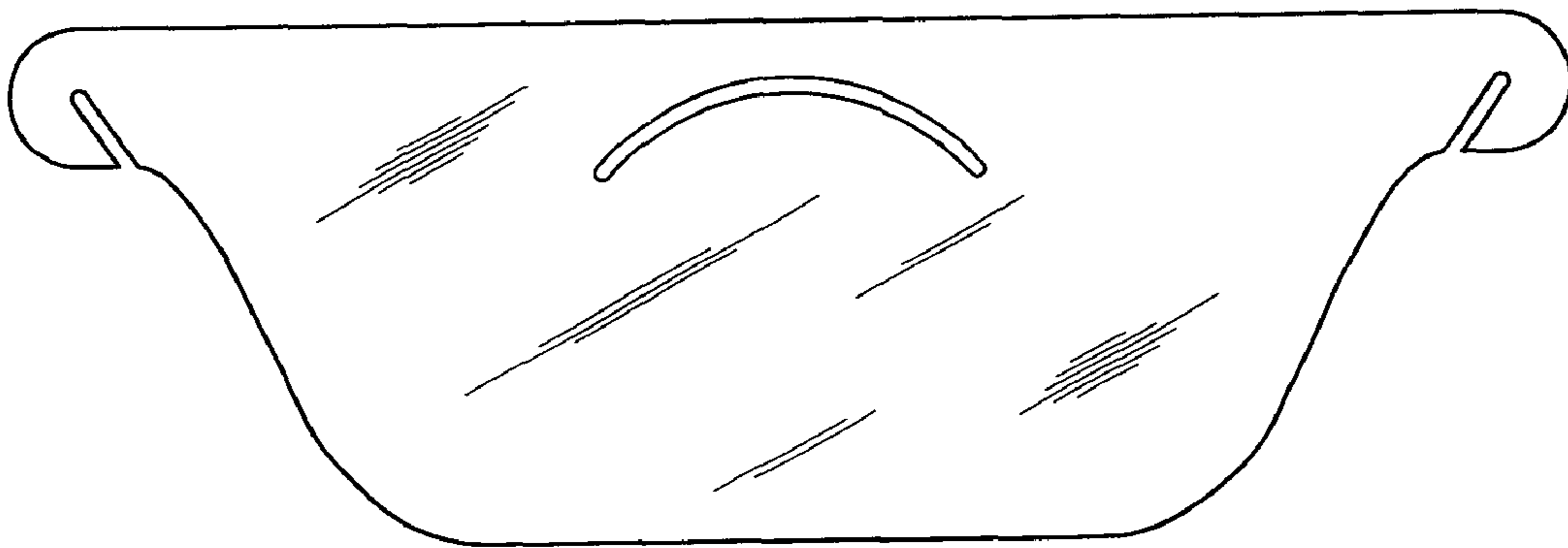
