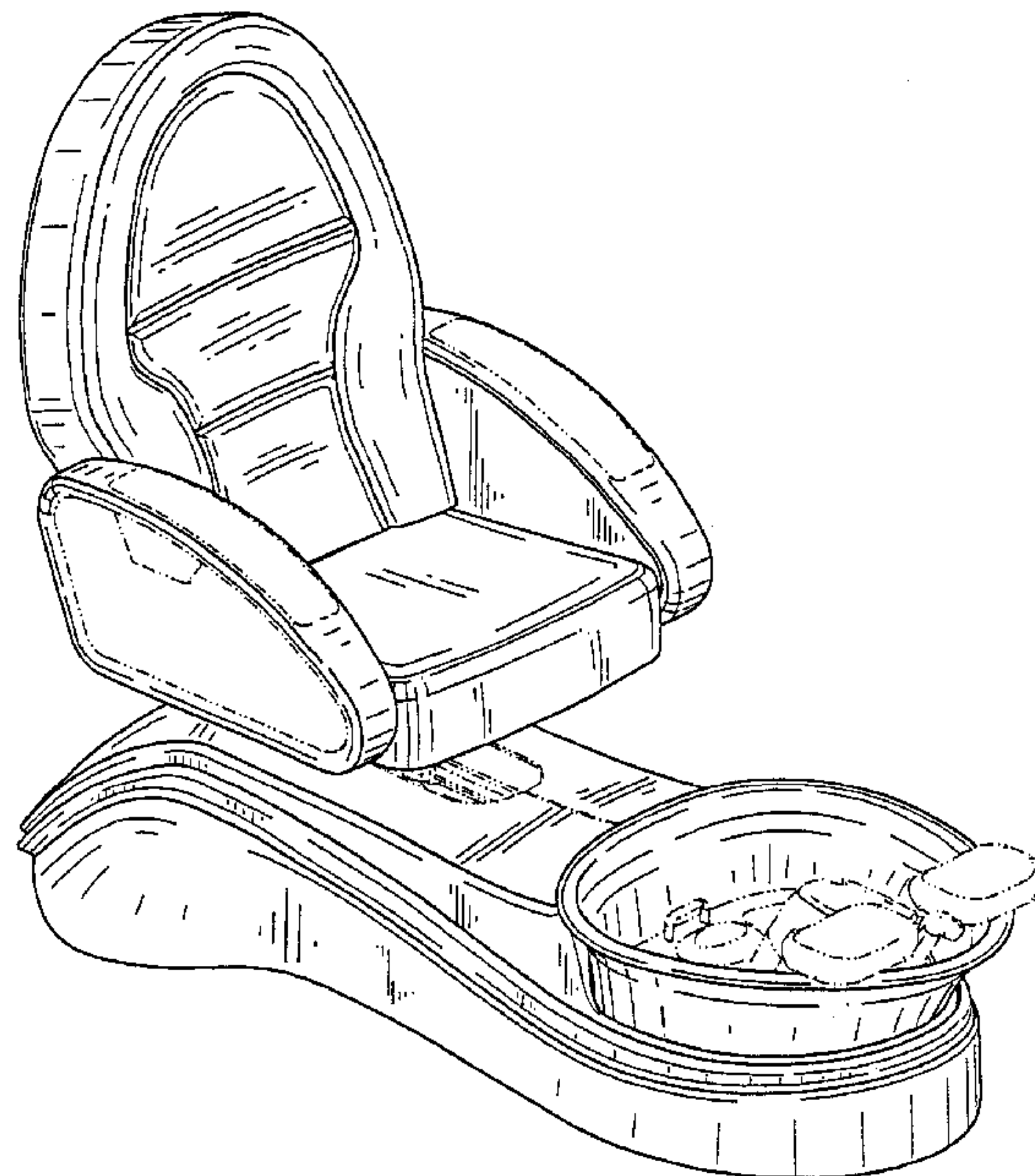
We claim the ornamental design for a spa apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the spa apparatus; FIG. 2 is a right side view of the design of FIG. 1, the left view being a mirror image of the right view; FIG. 3 is a front view of the spa apparatus; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the spa apparatus; and, FIG. 5 is a top view of the spa apparatus.

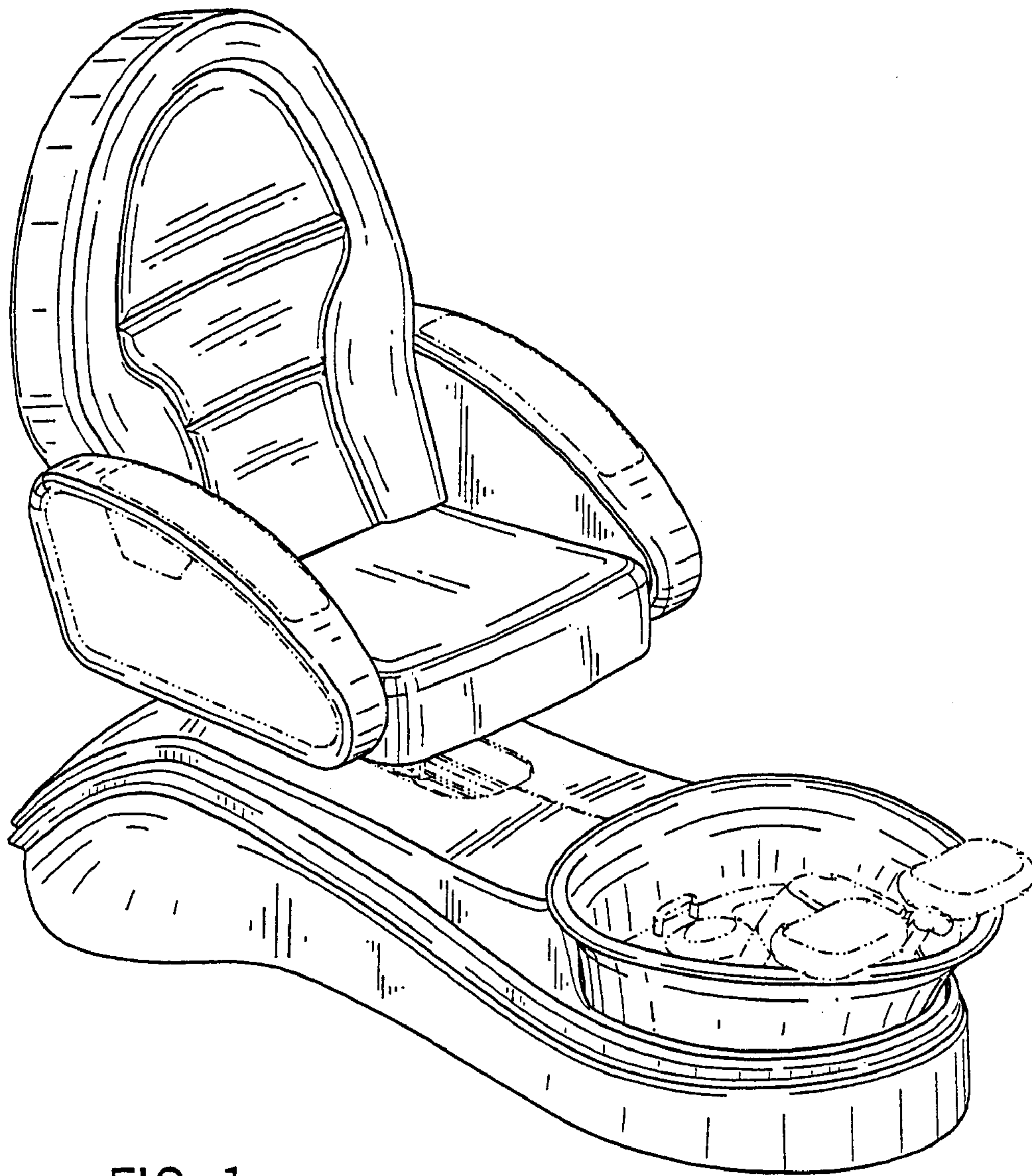
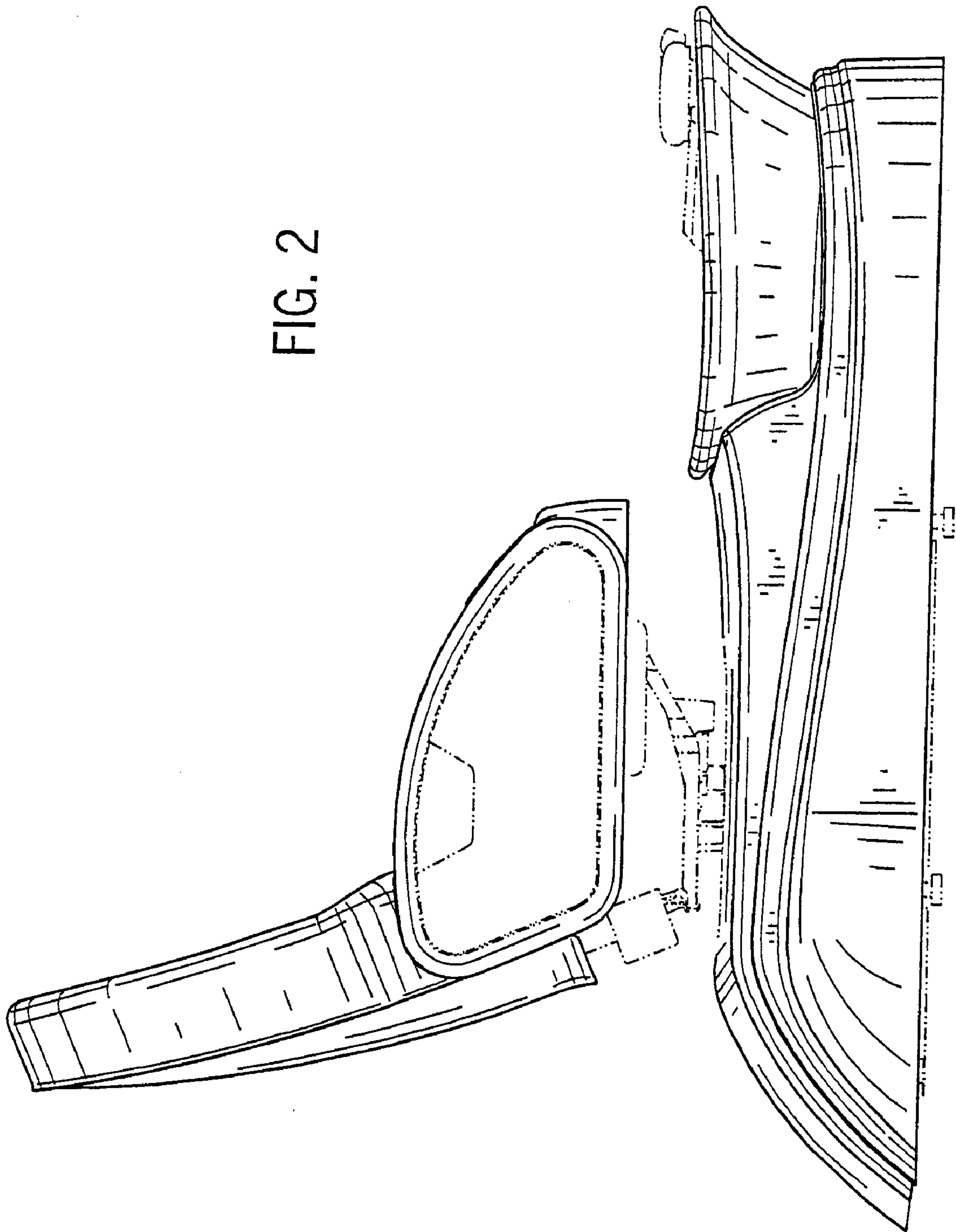

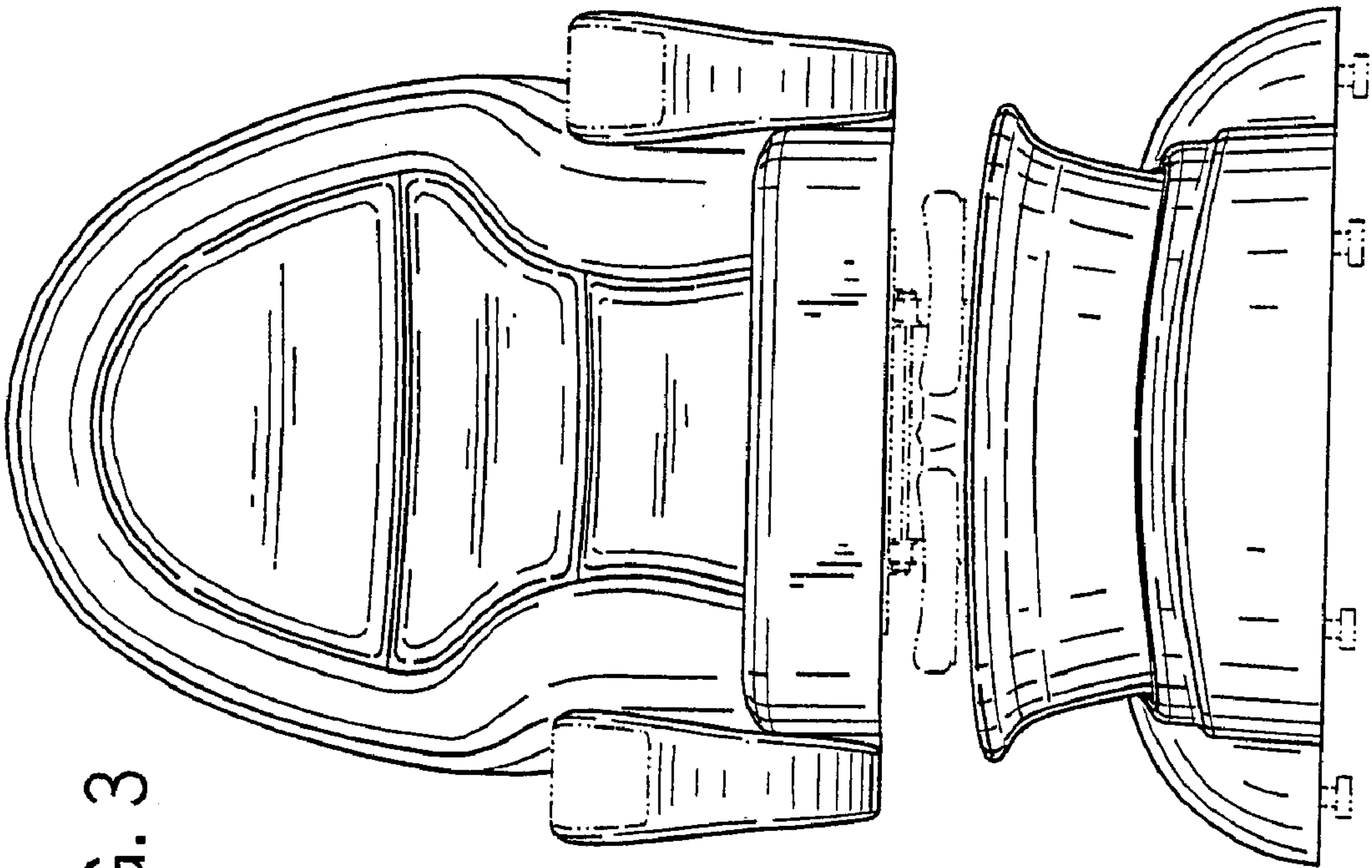

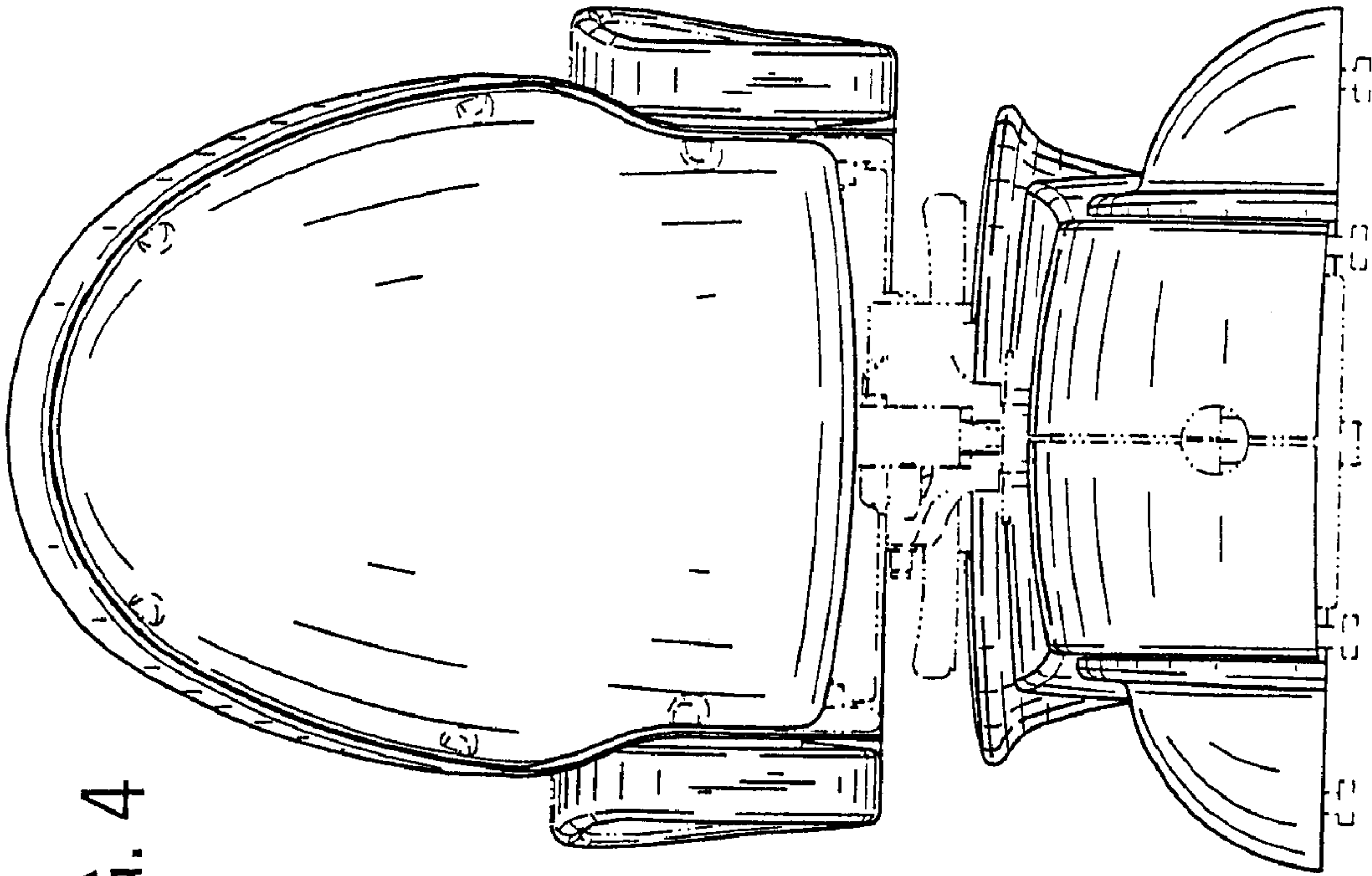

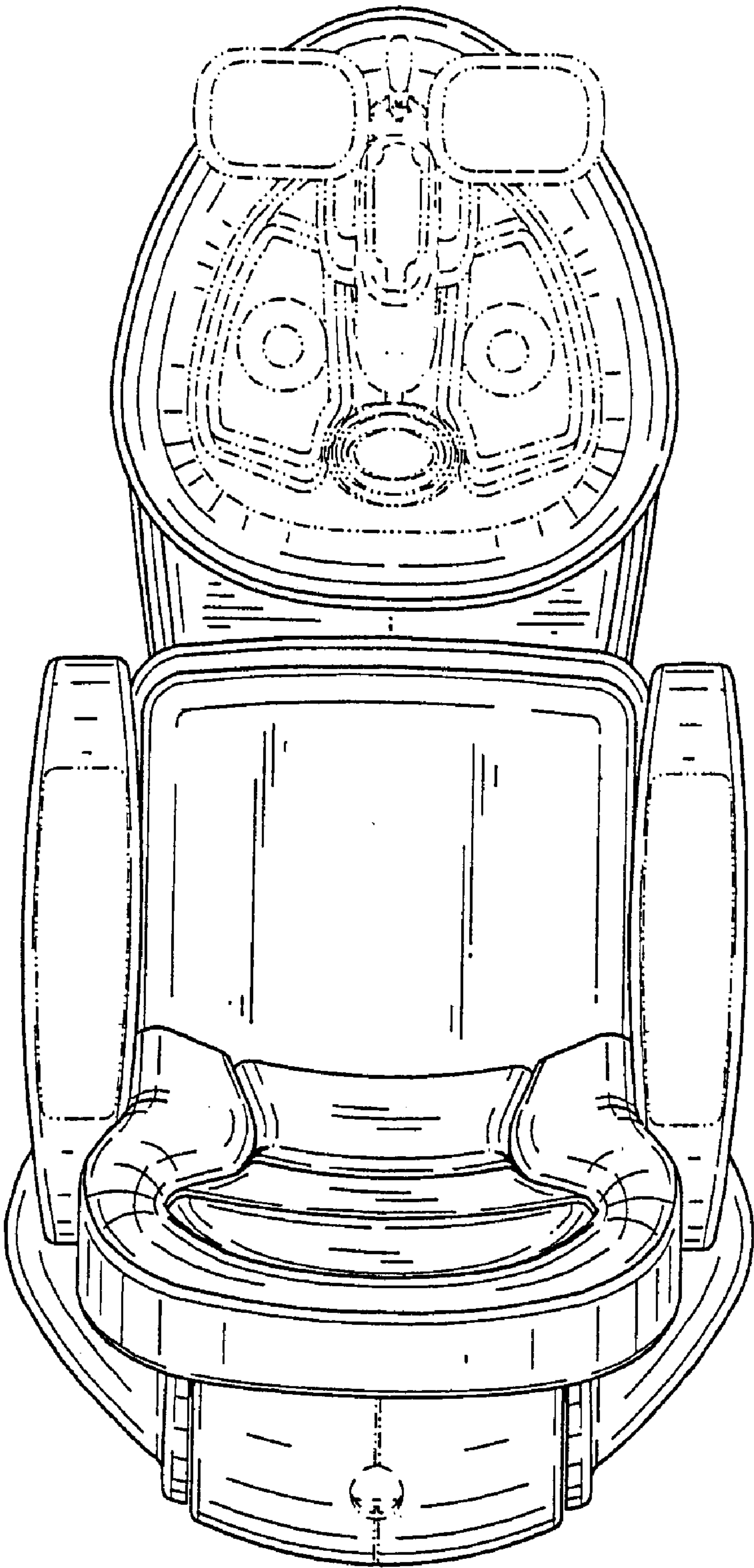
