FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a flower web showing our new design;

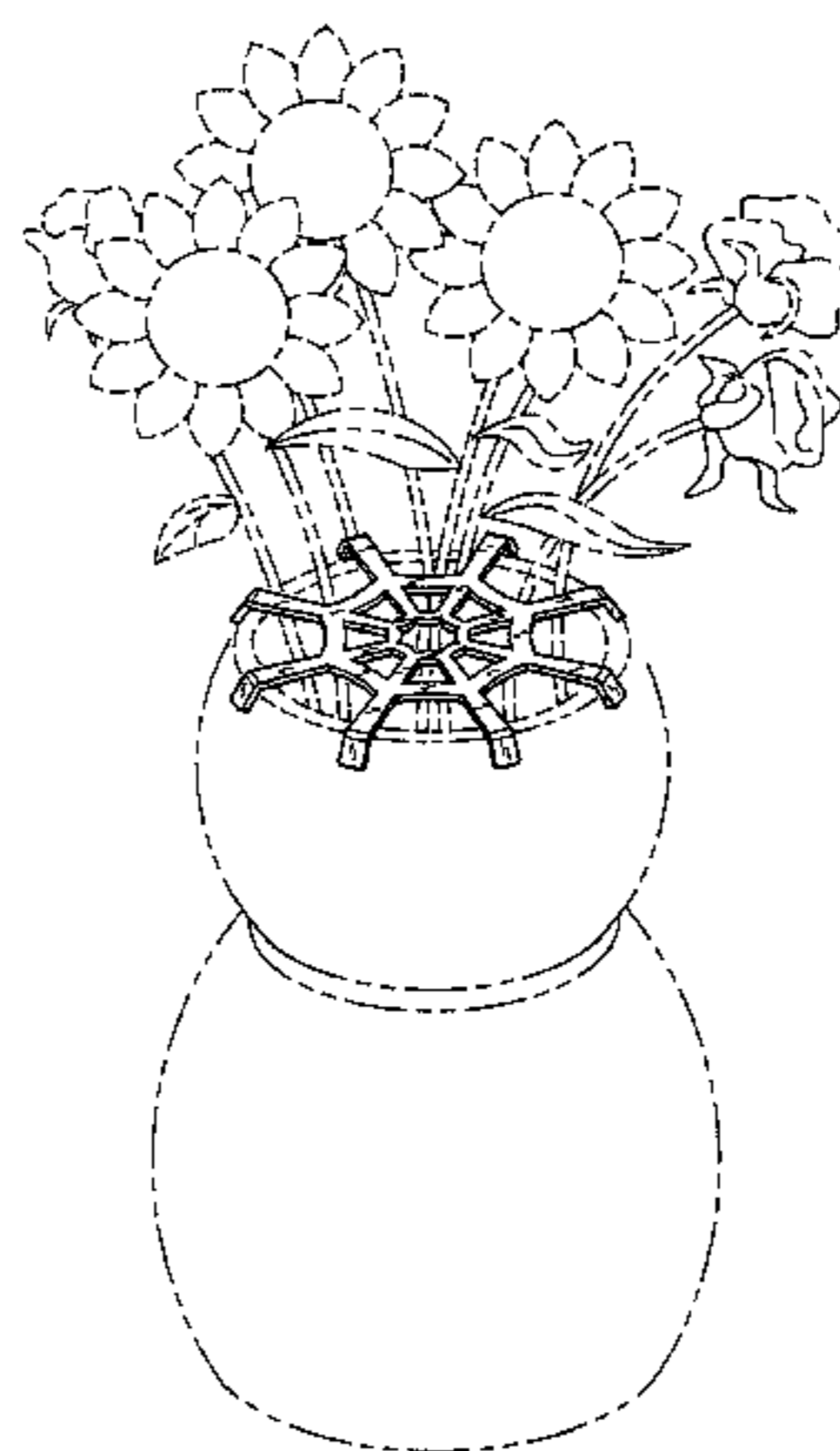
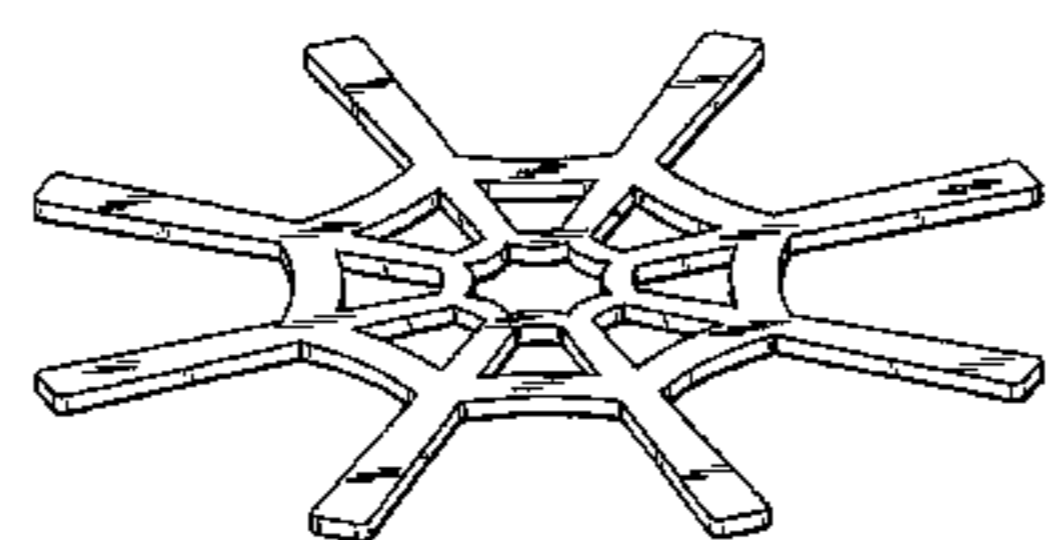
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image;

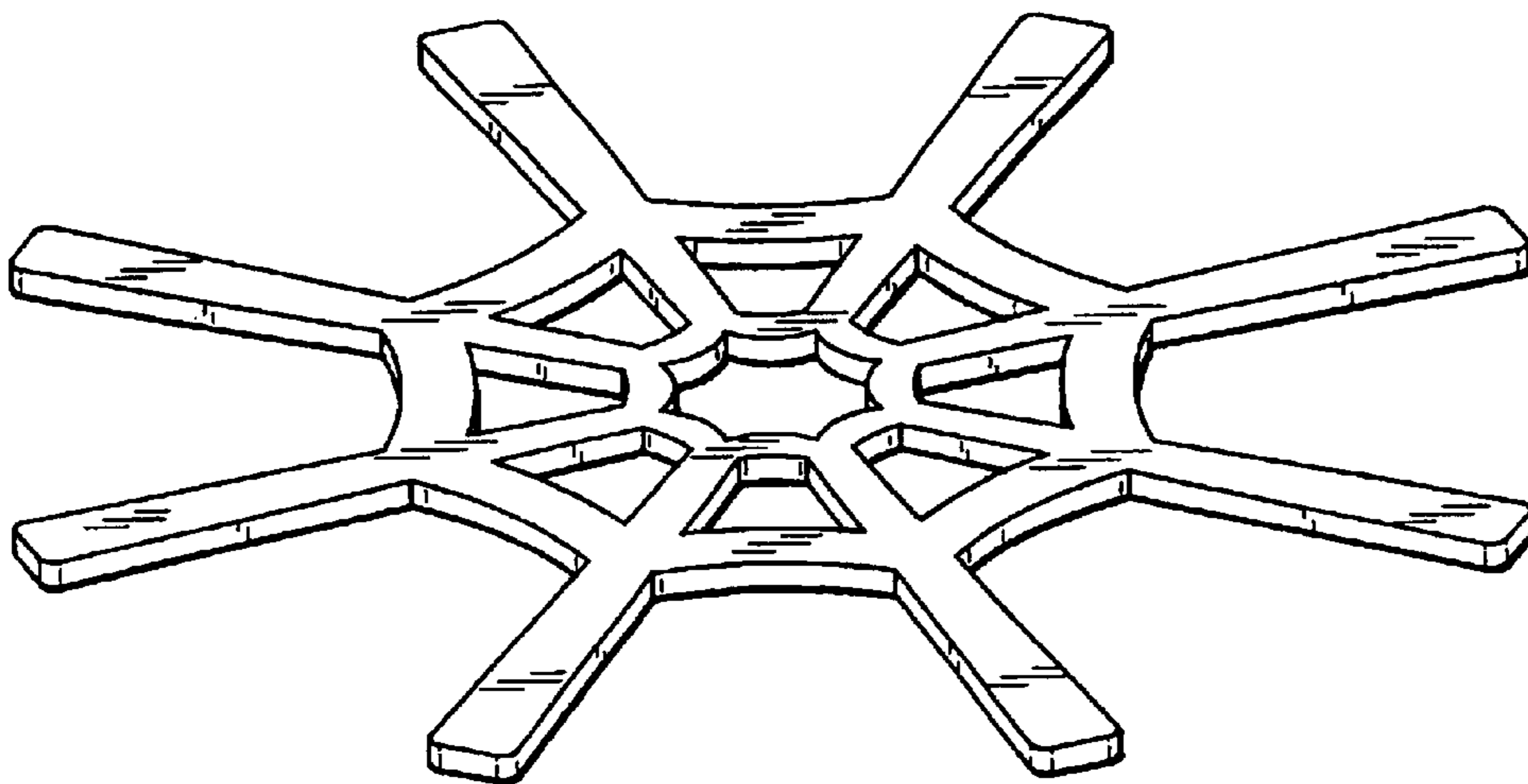

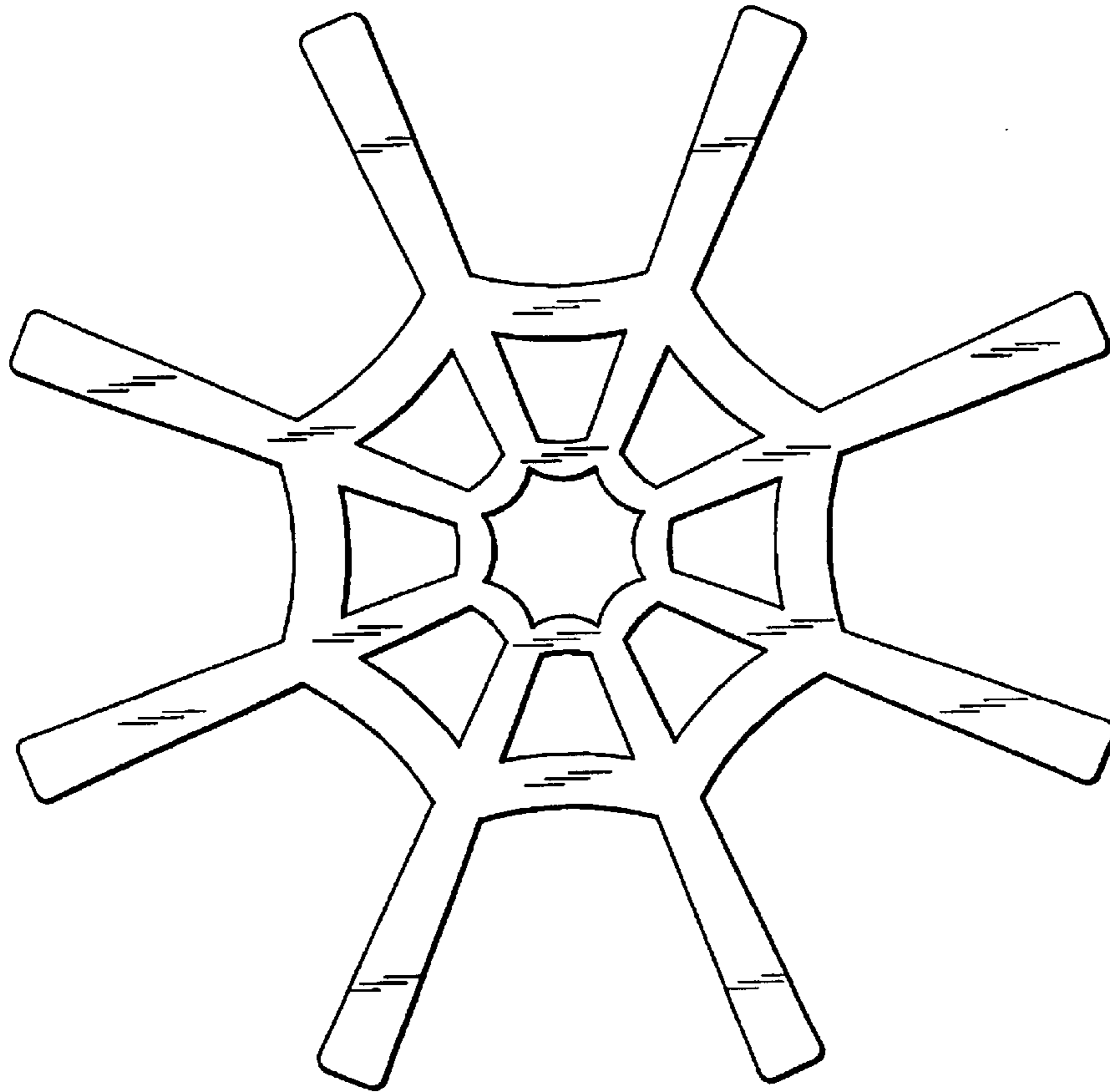

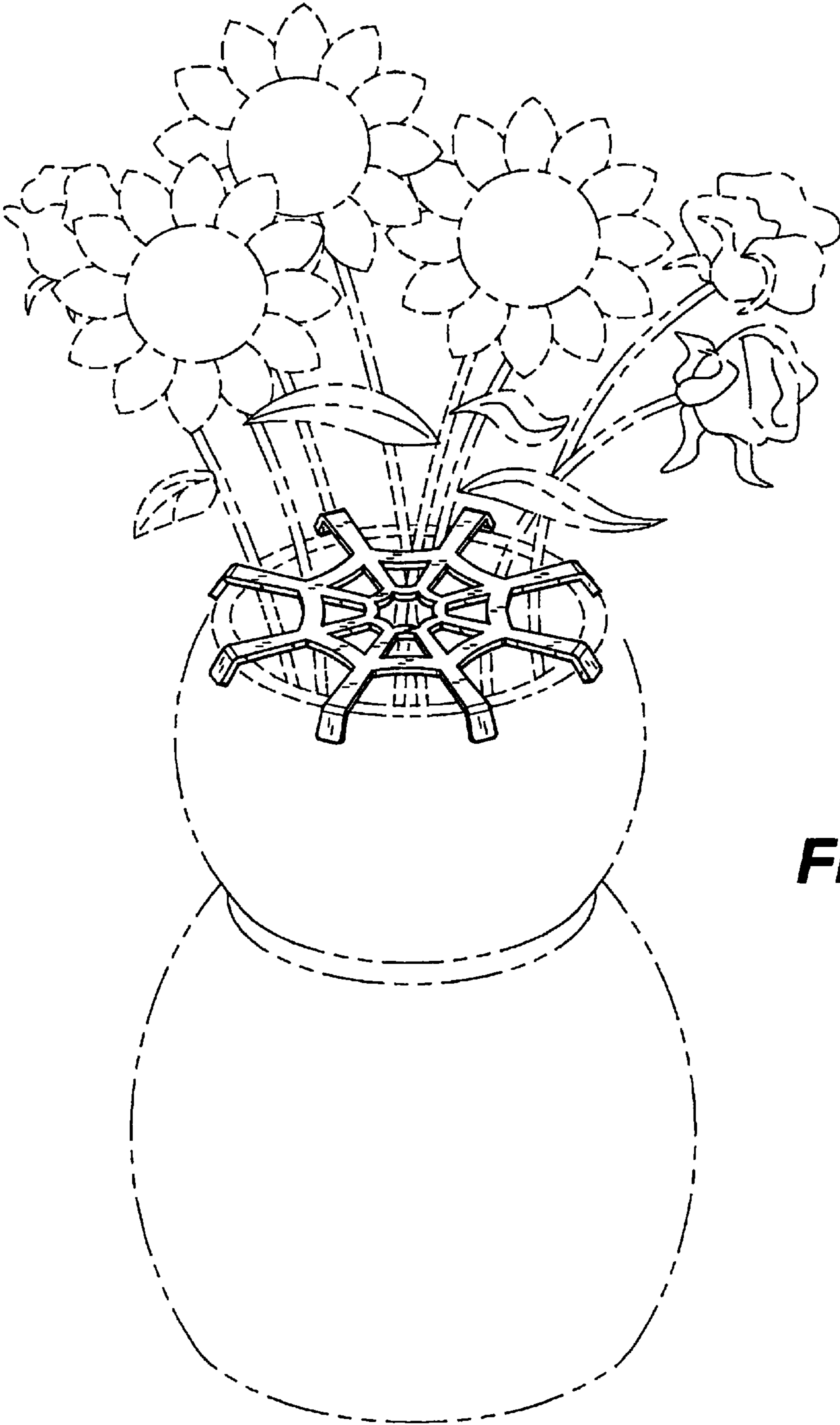
