DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left-side perspective view showing the new bottle design;

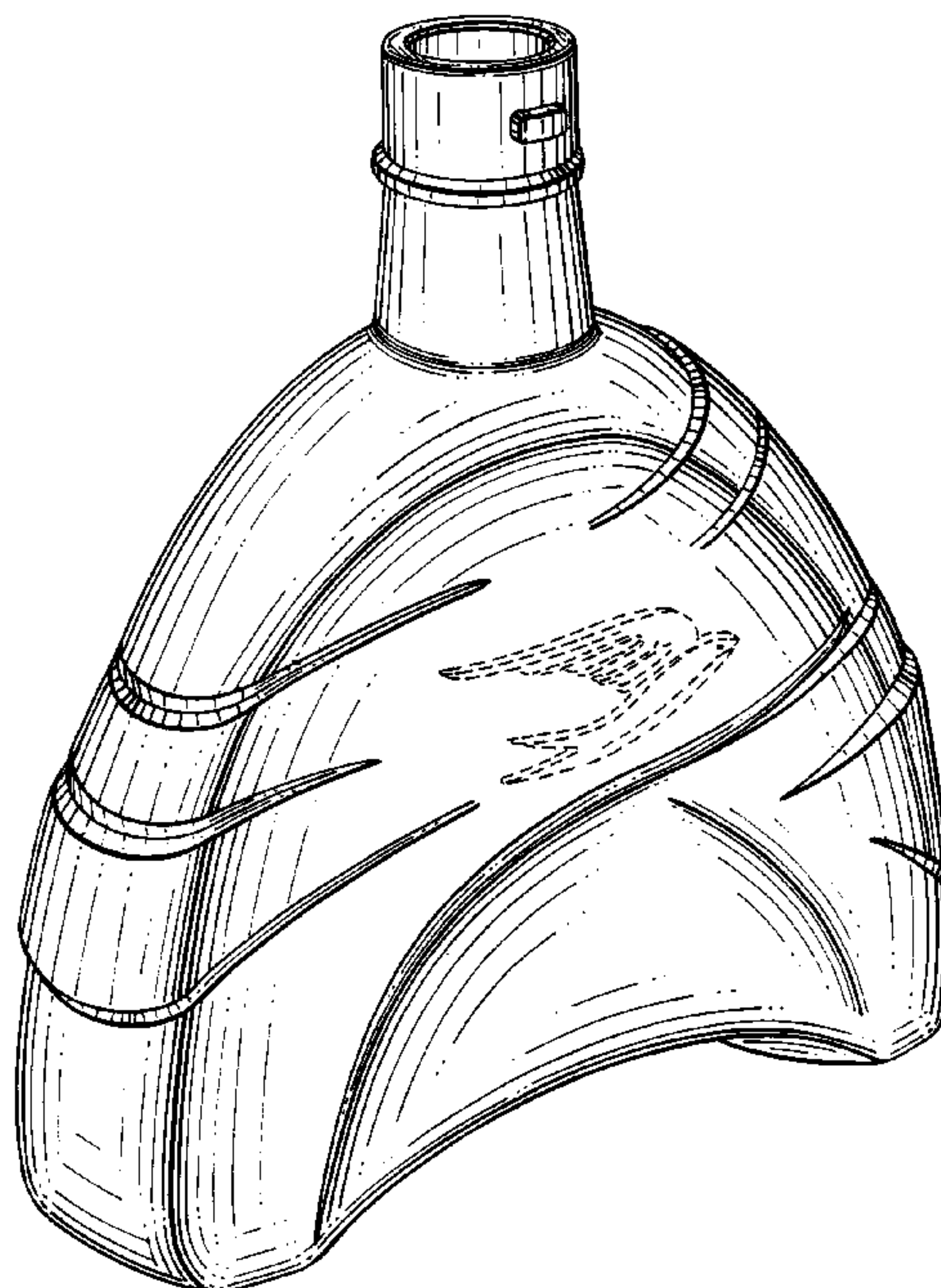

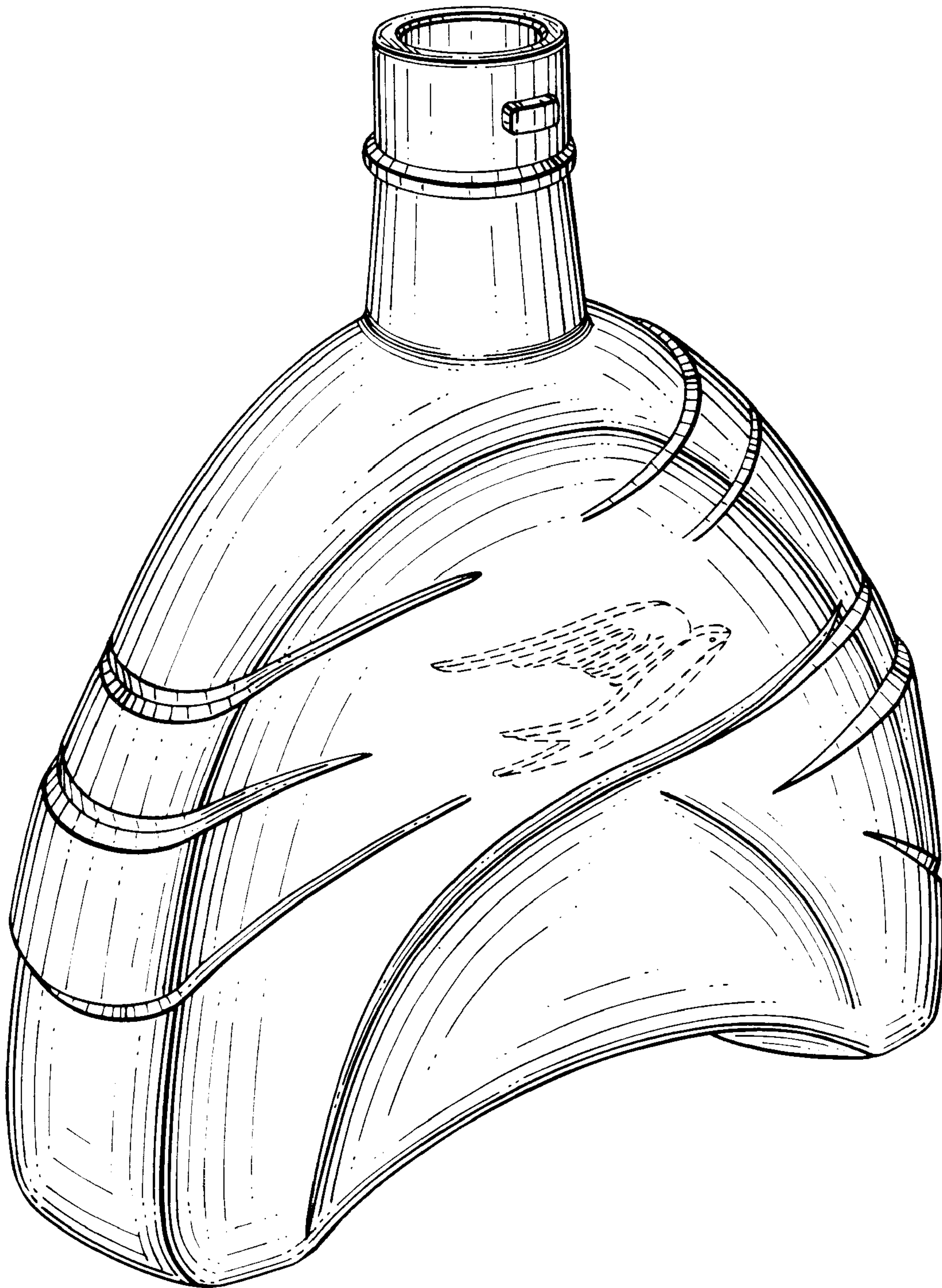

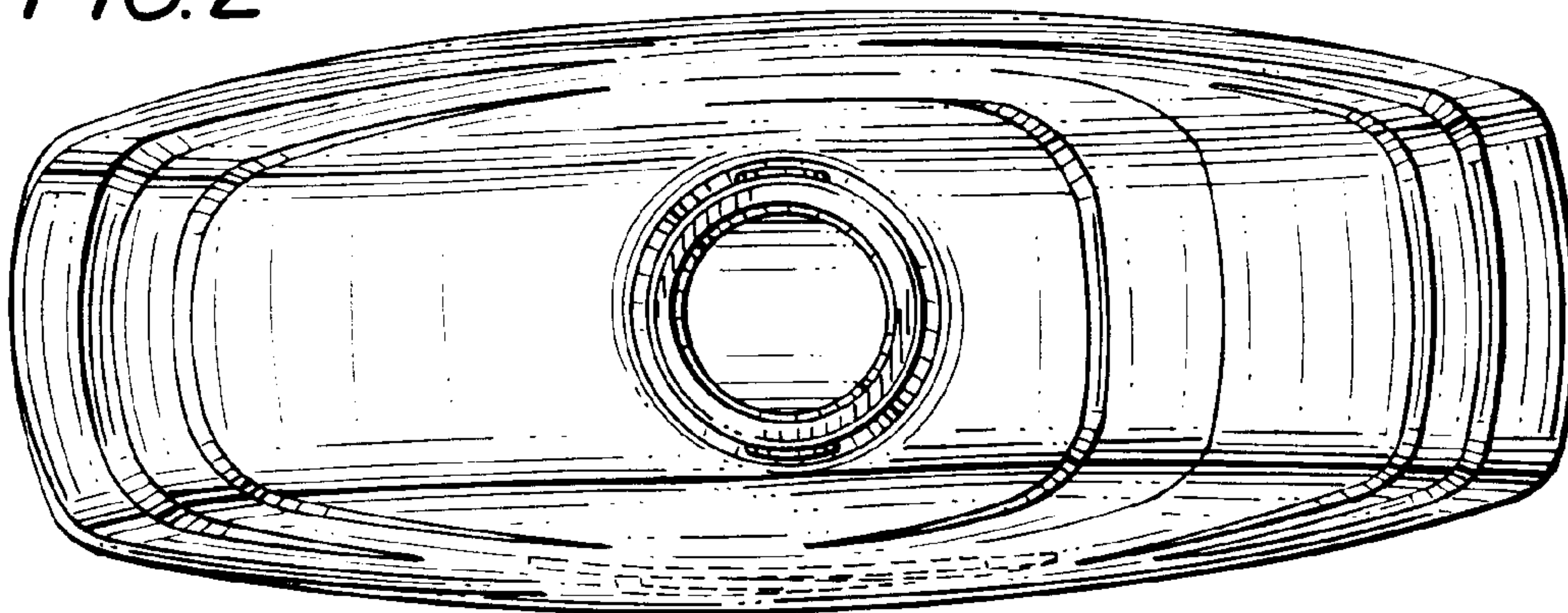
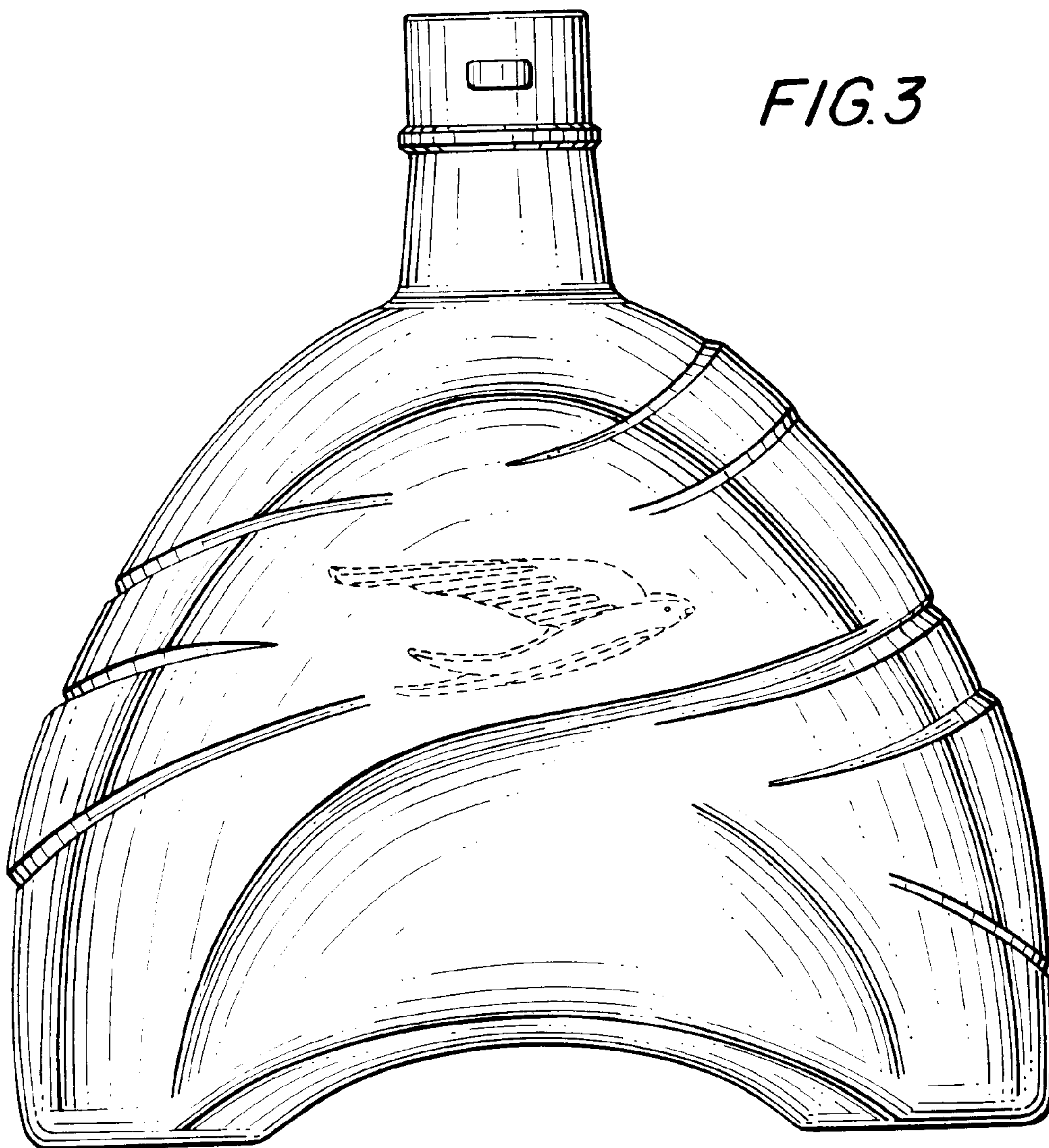

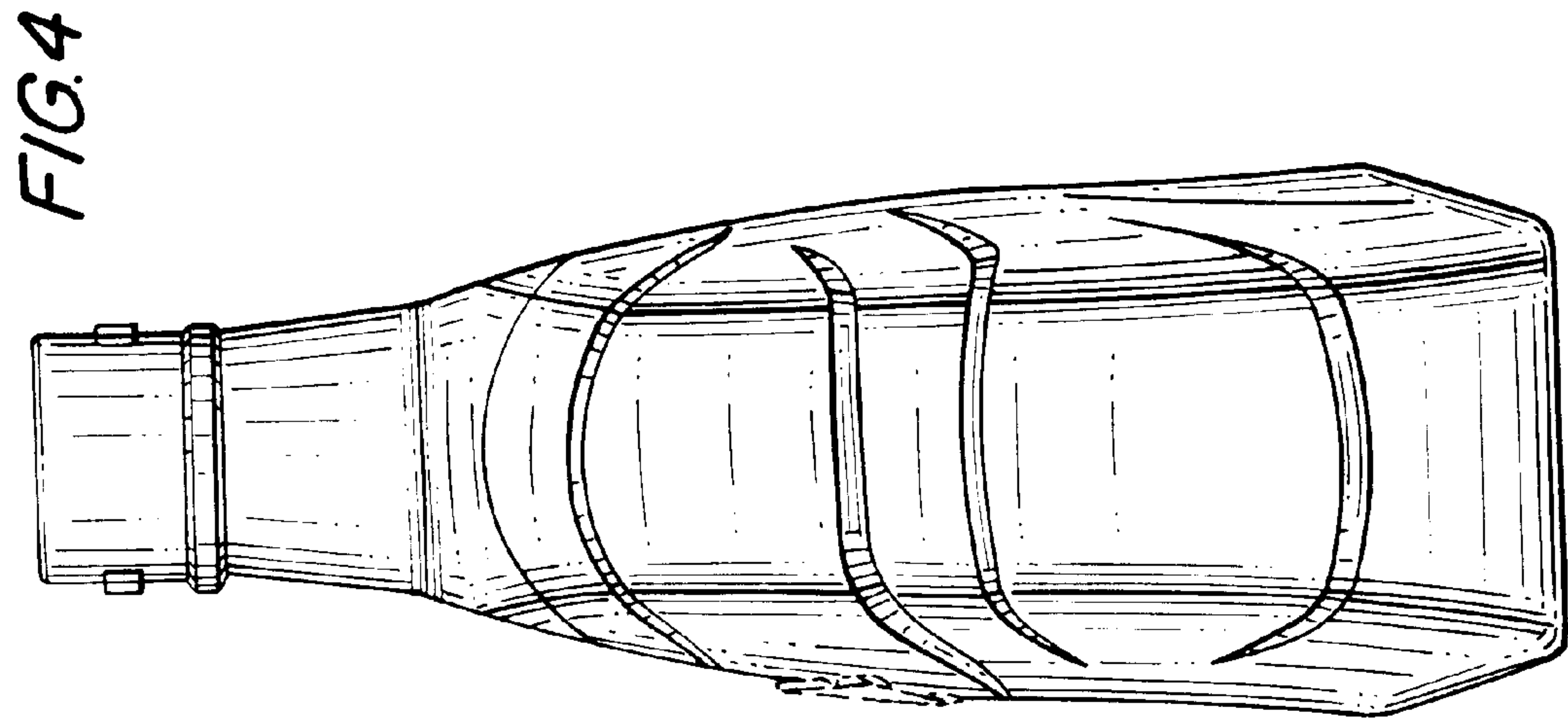
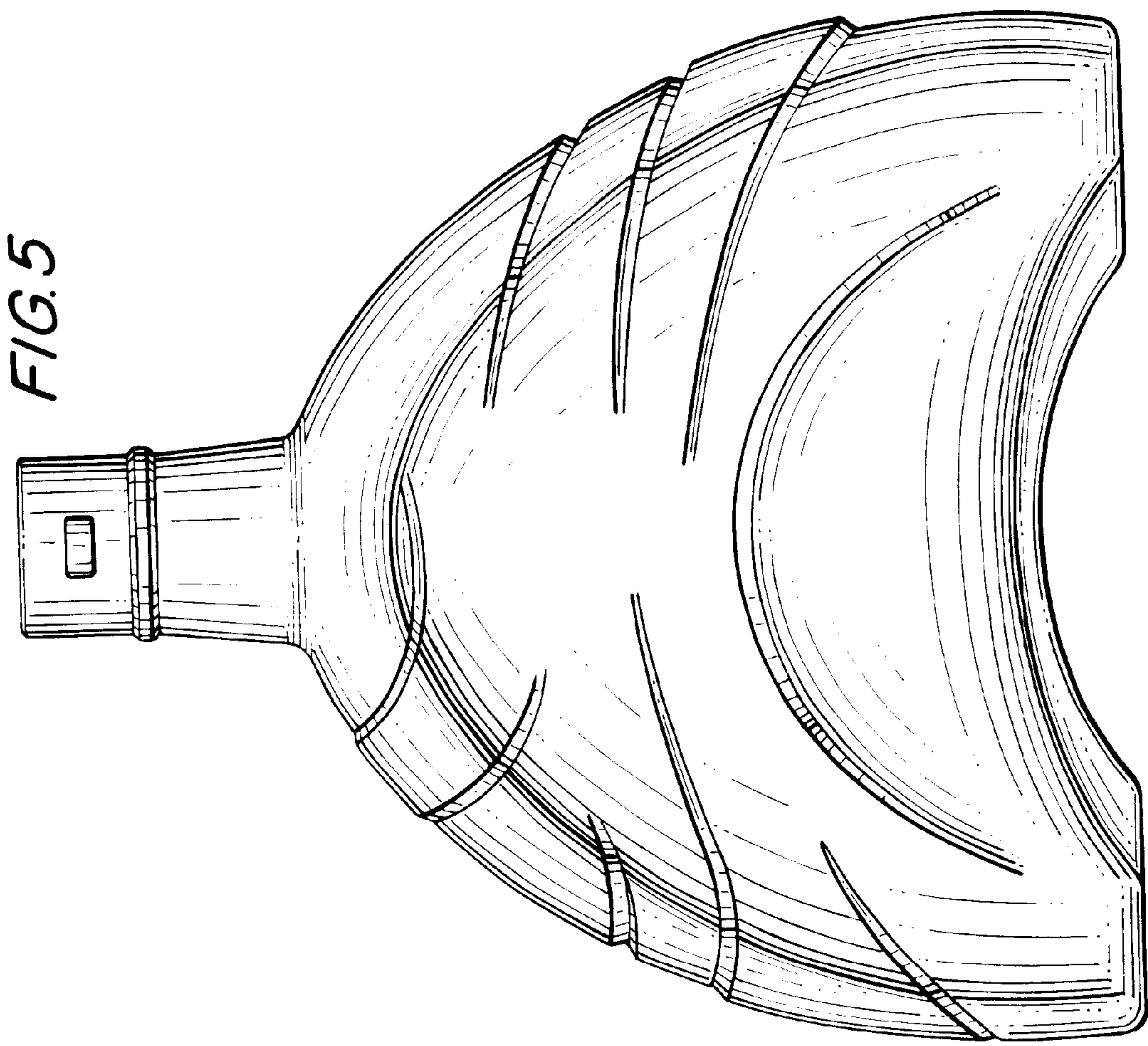

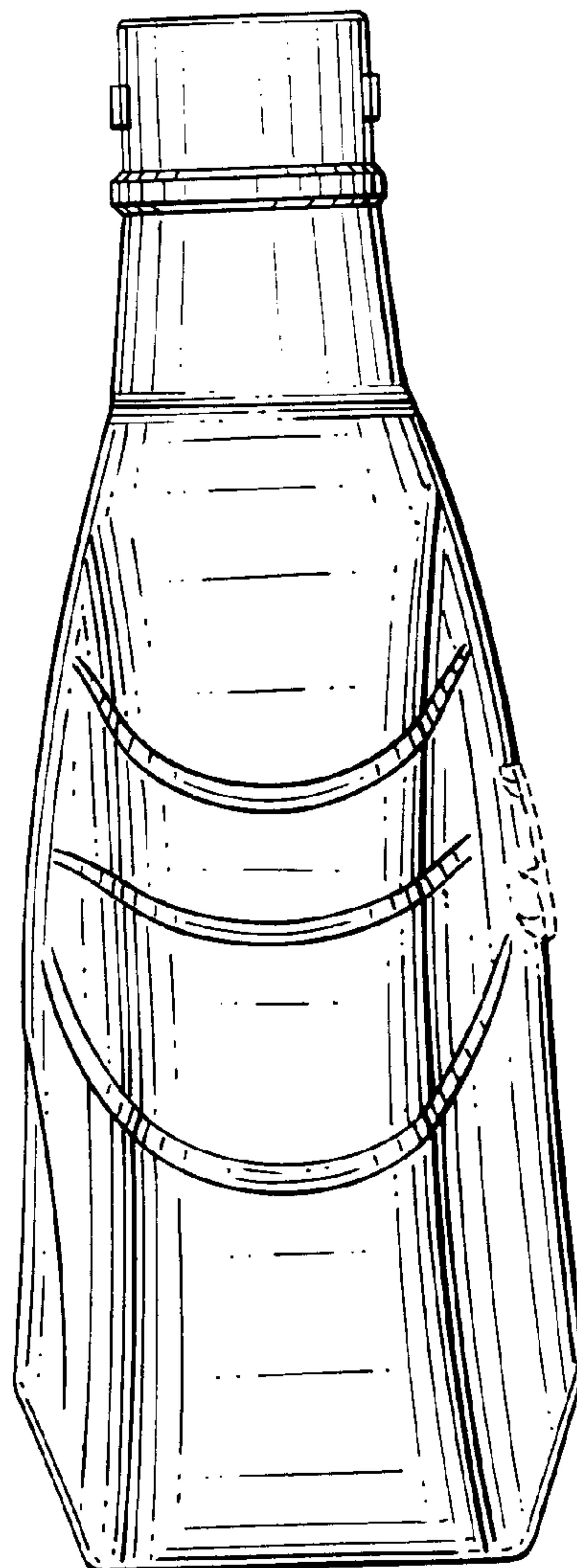
