FIG. 3 is a view as seen from the right side of FIG. 1;

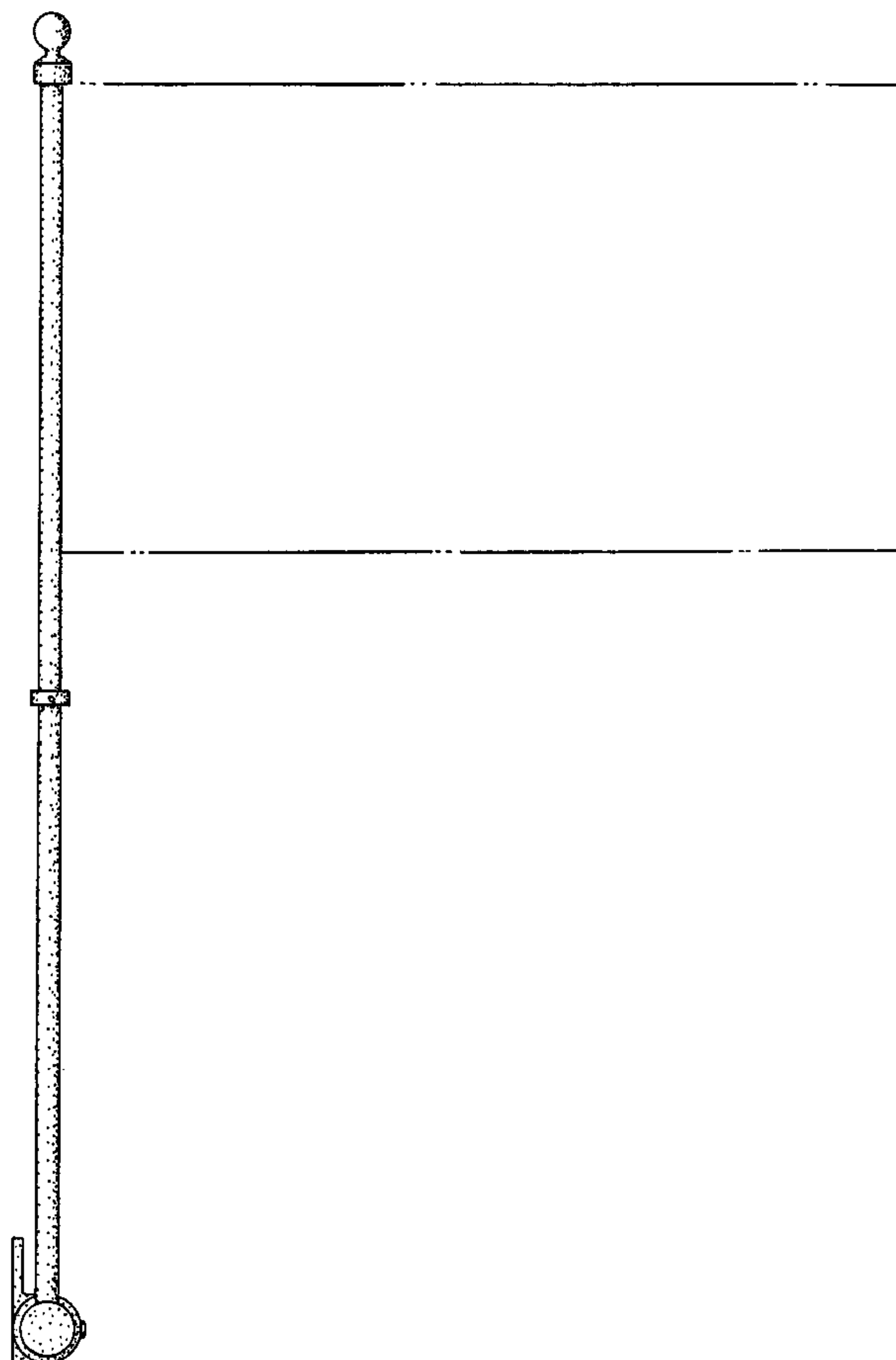
FIG. 4 is a view as seen from the left side of FIG. 1;

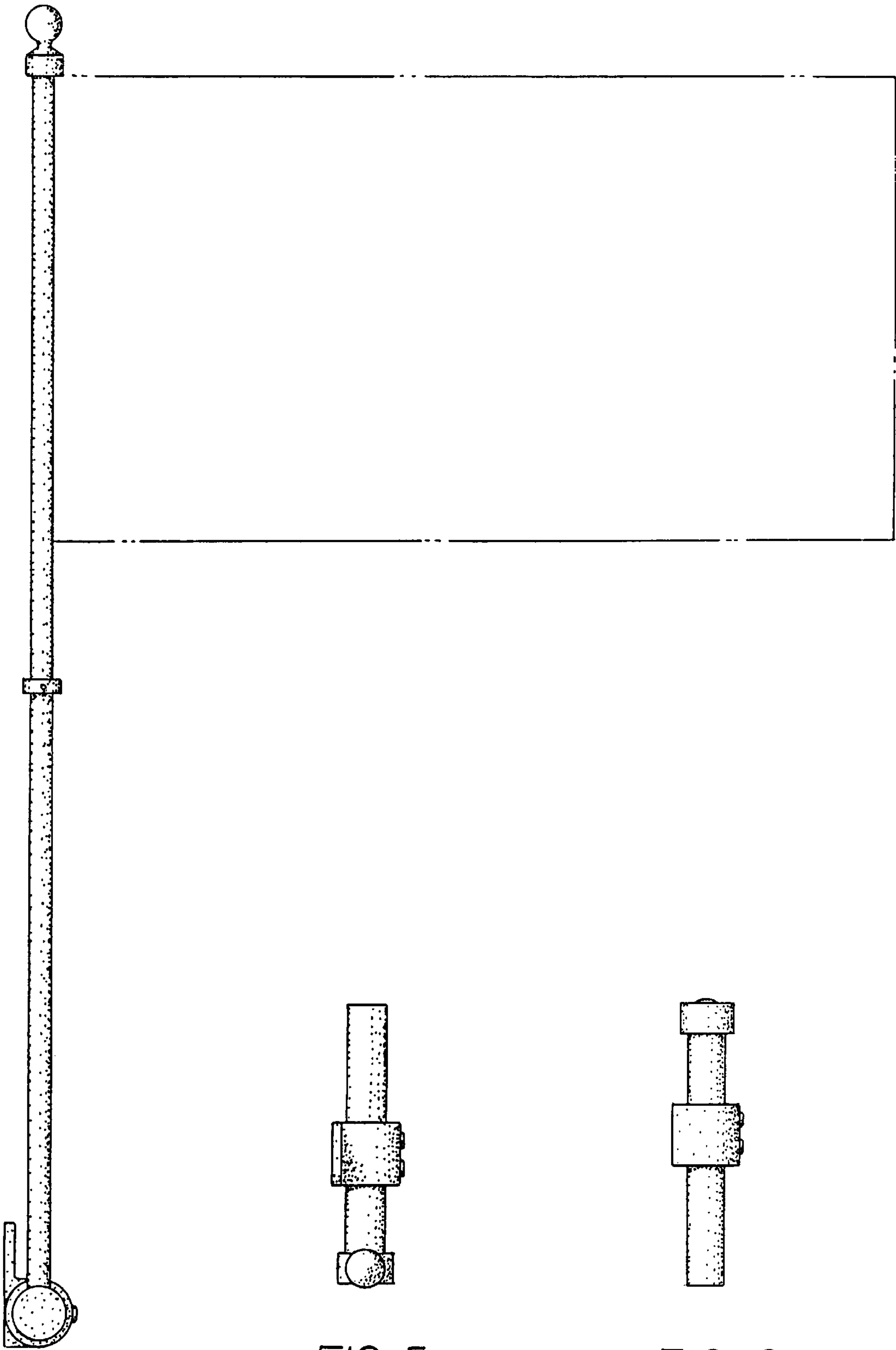

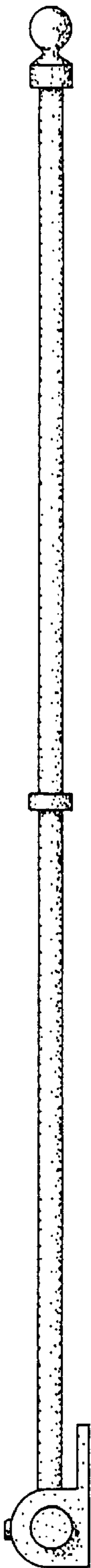

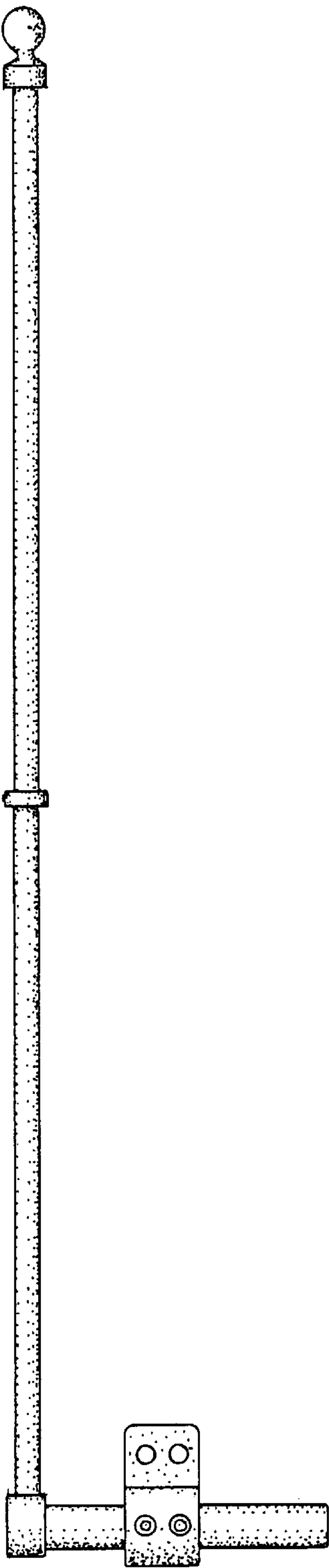

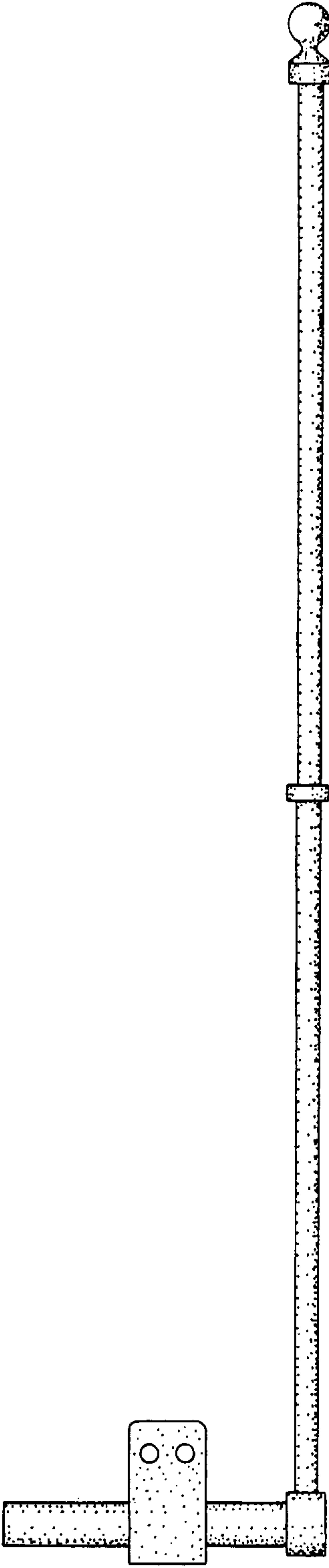
