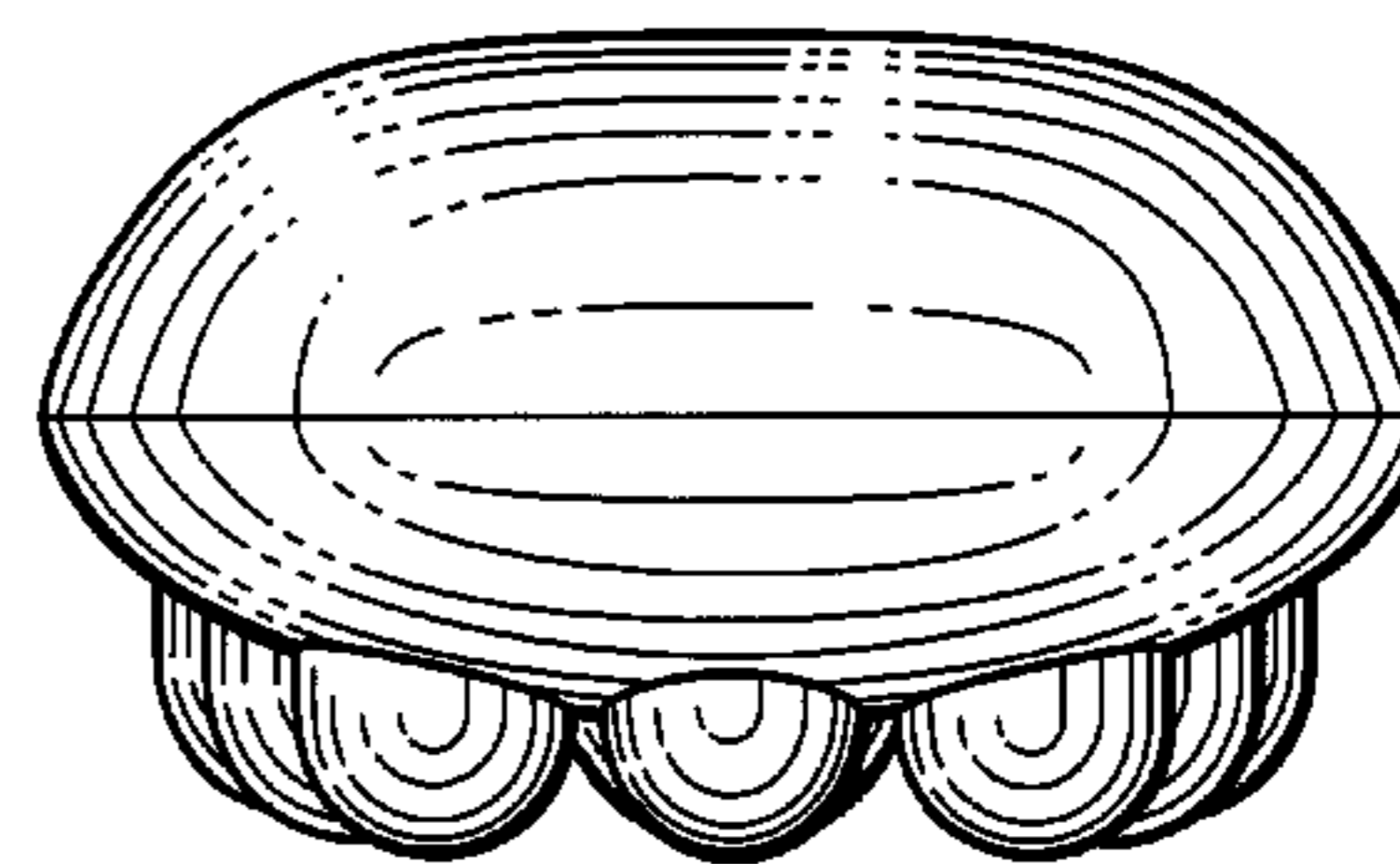
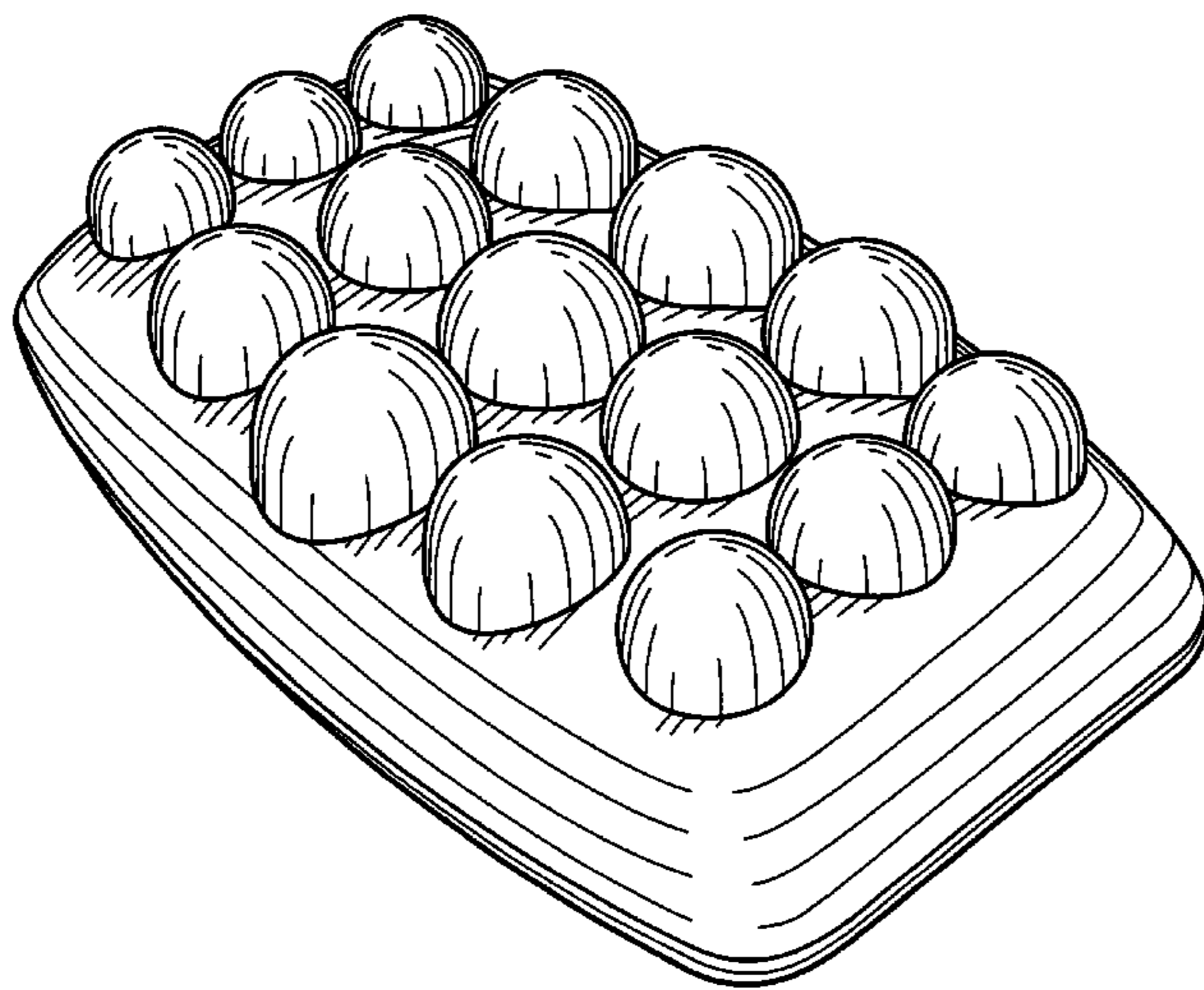
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a massage soap bar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the massage soap bar of our design in an inverted orientation;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

 FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof.

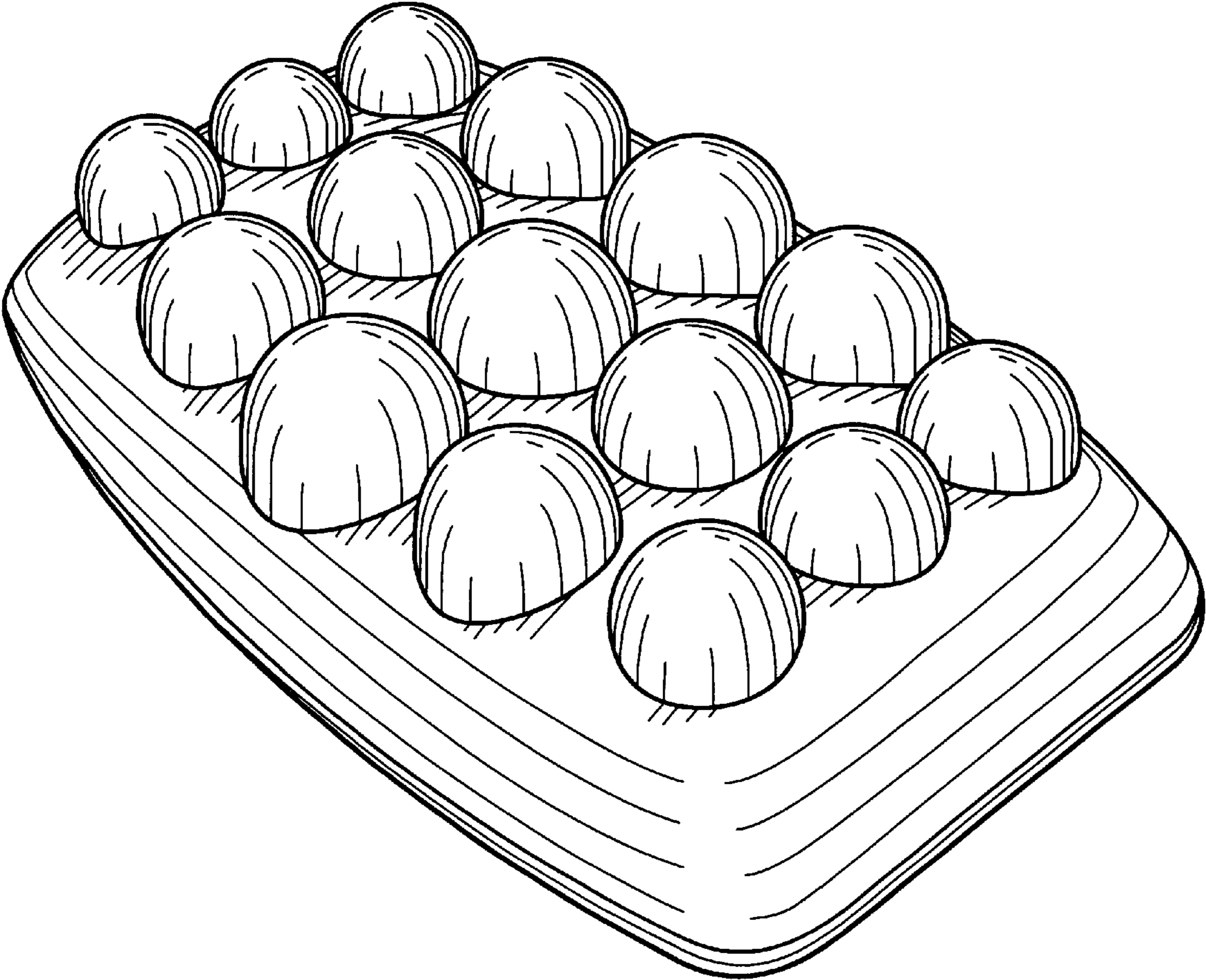

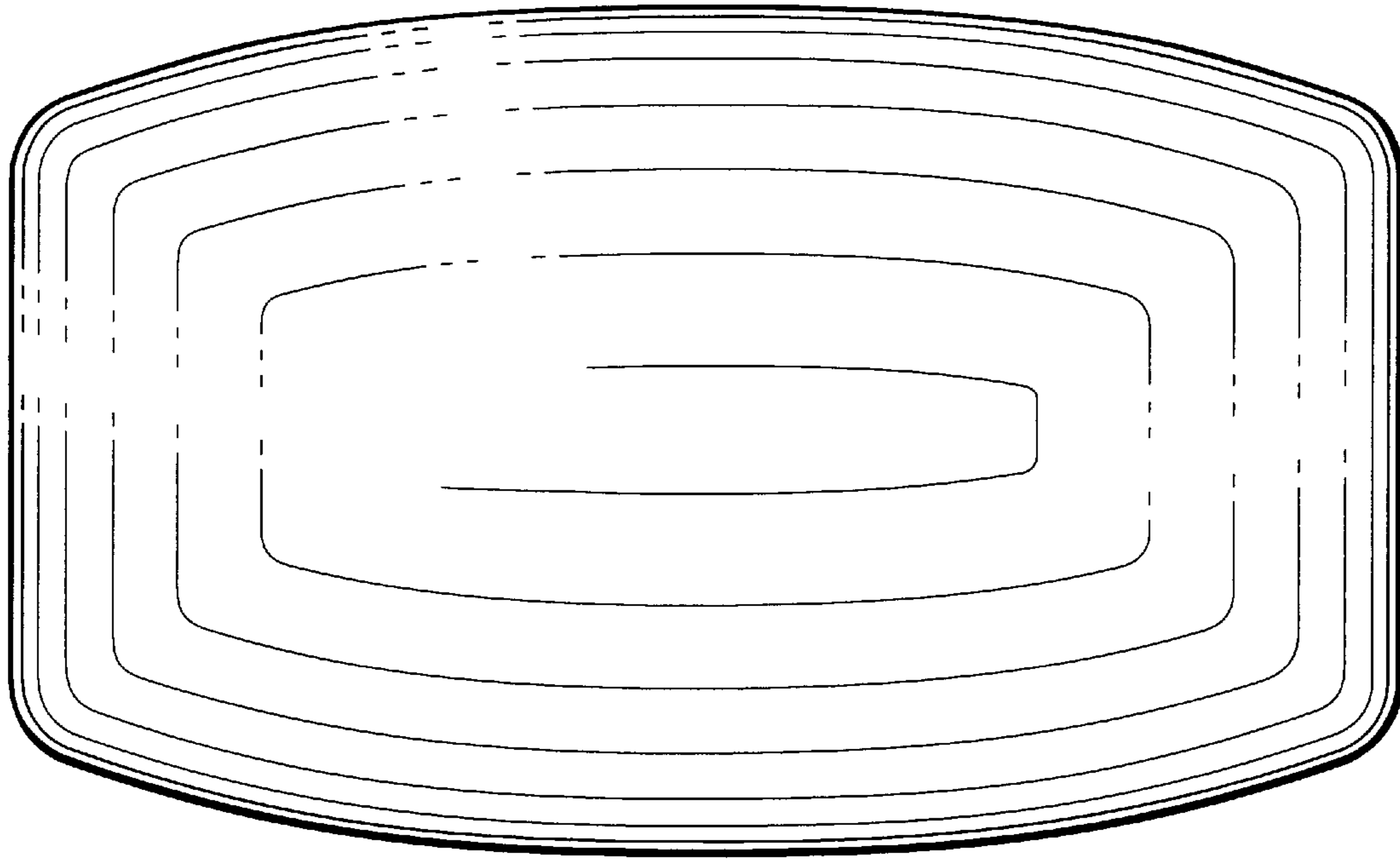

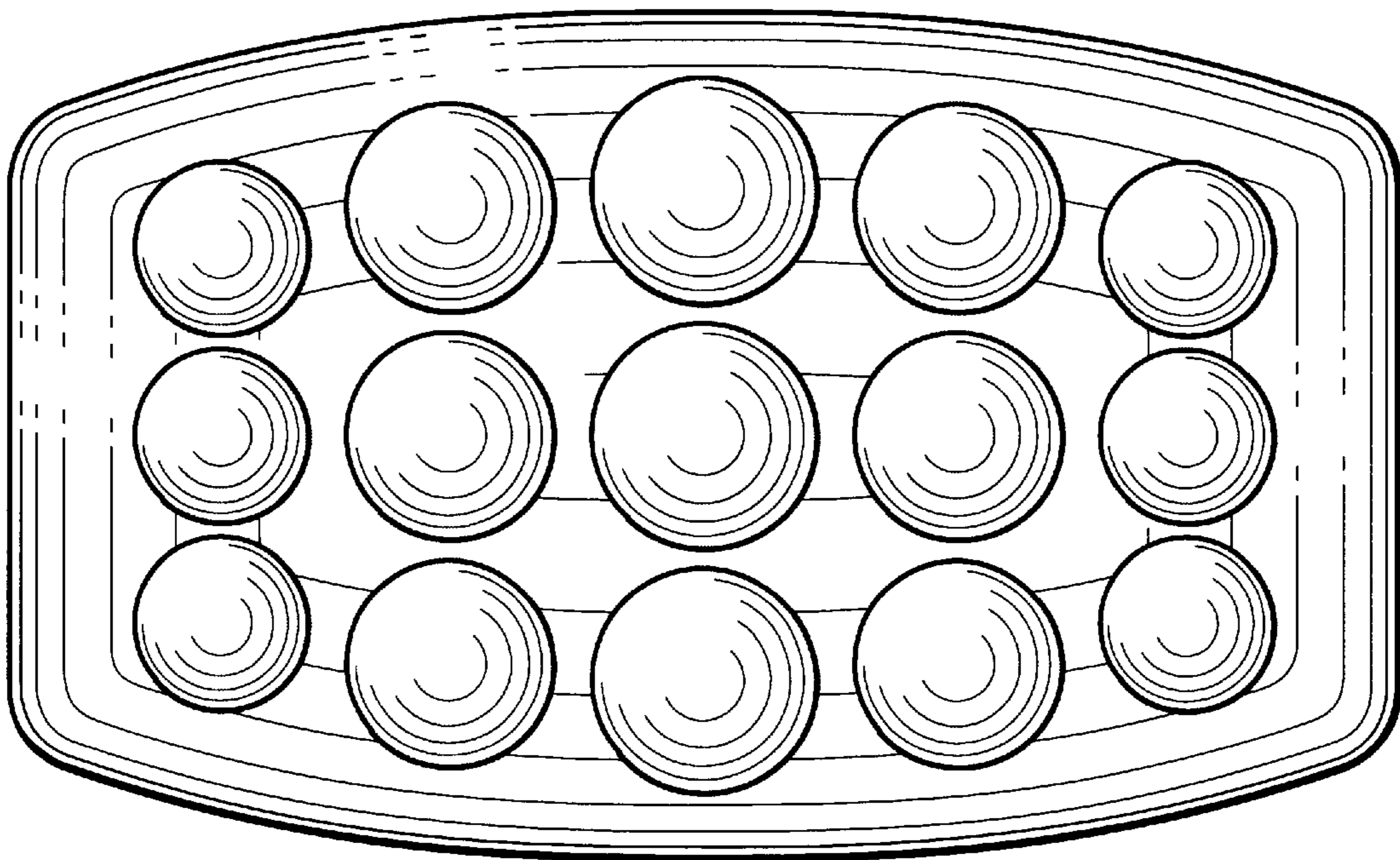

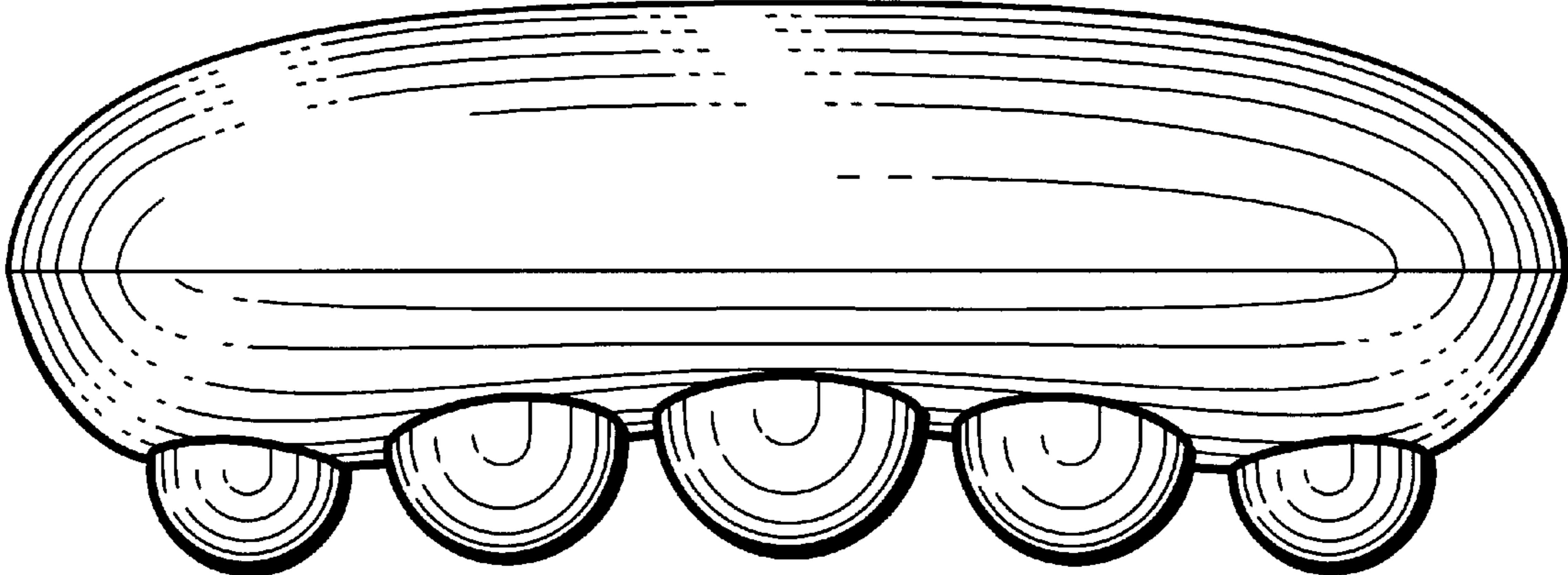

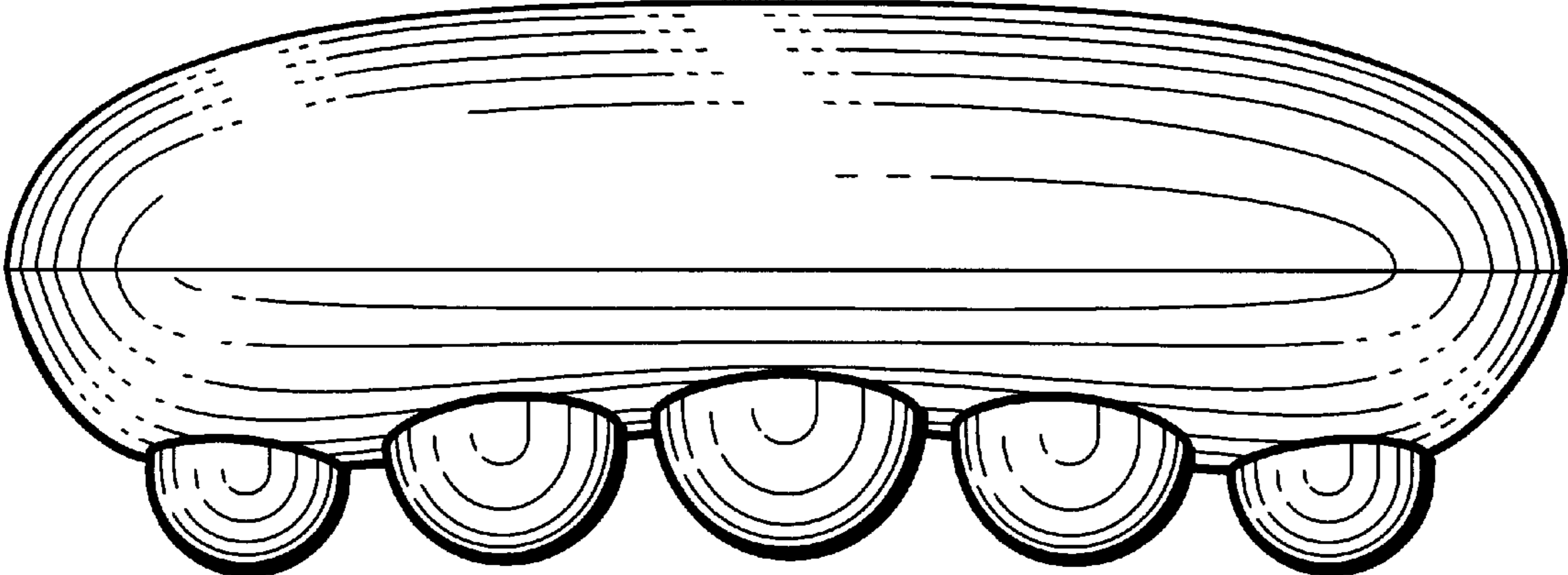

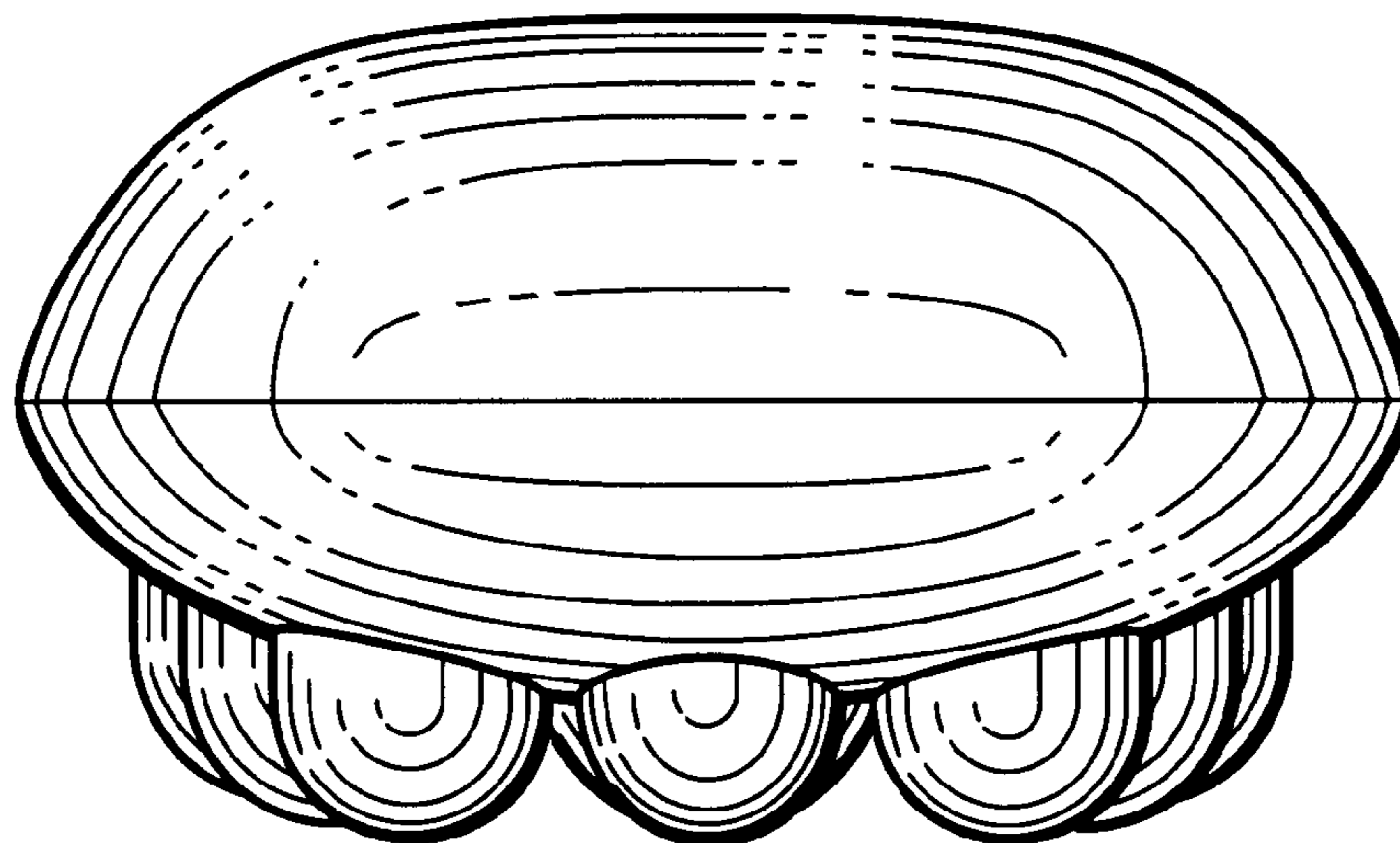

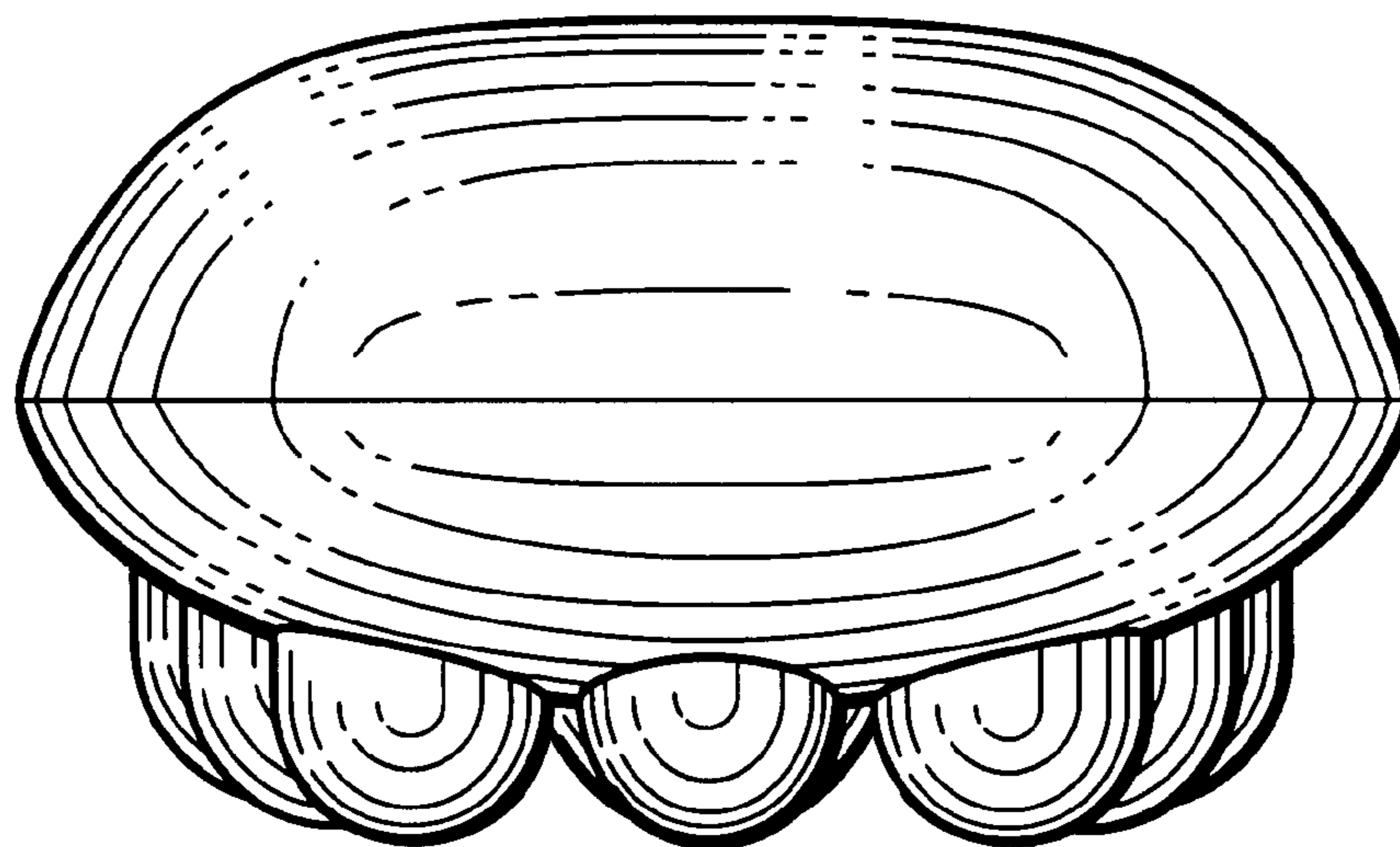

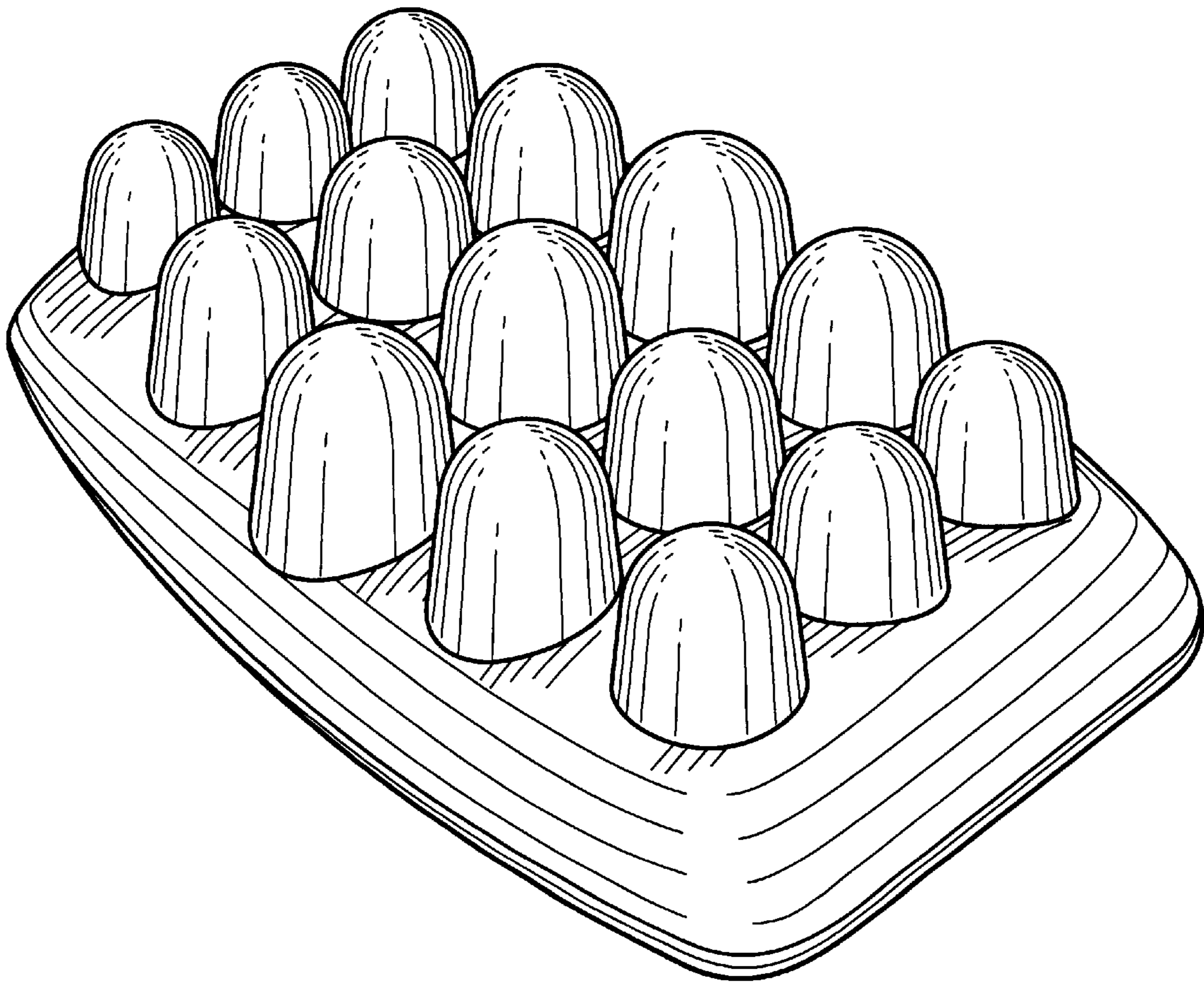

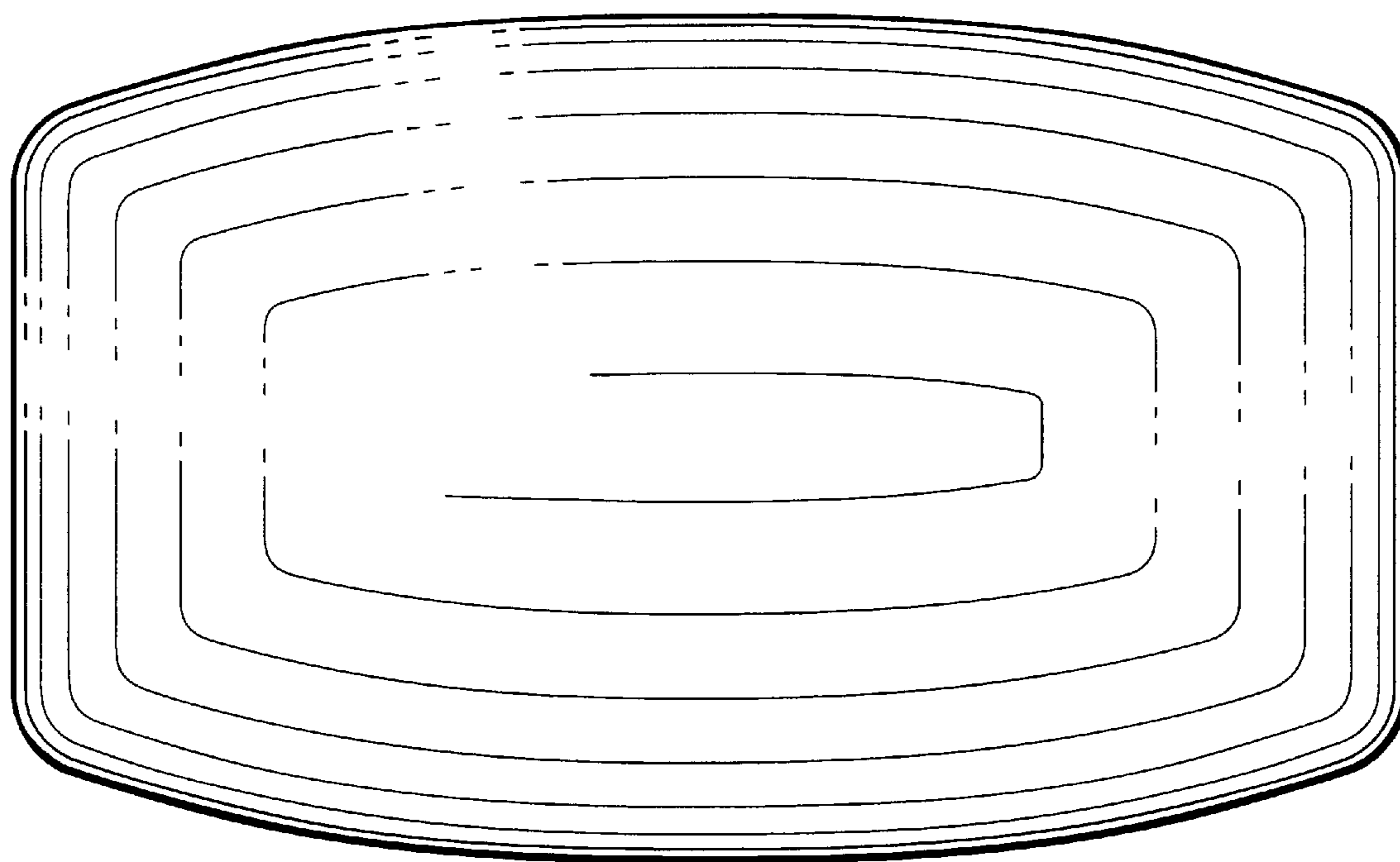

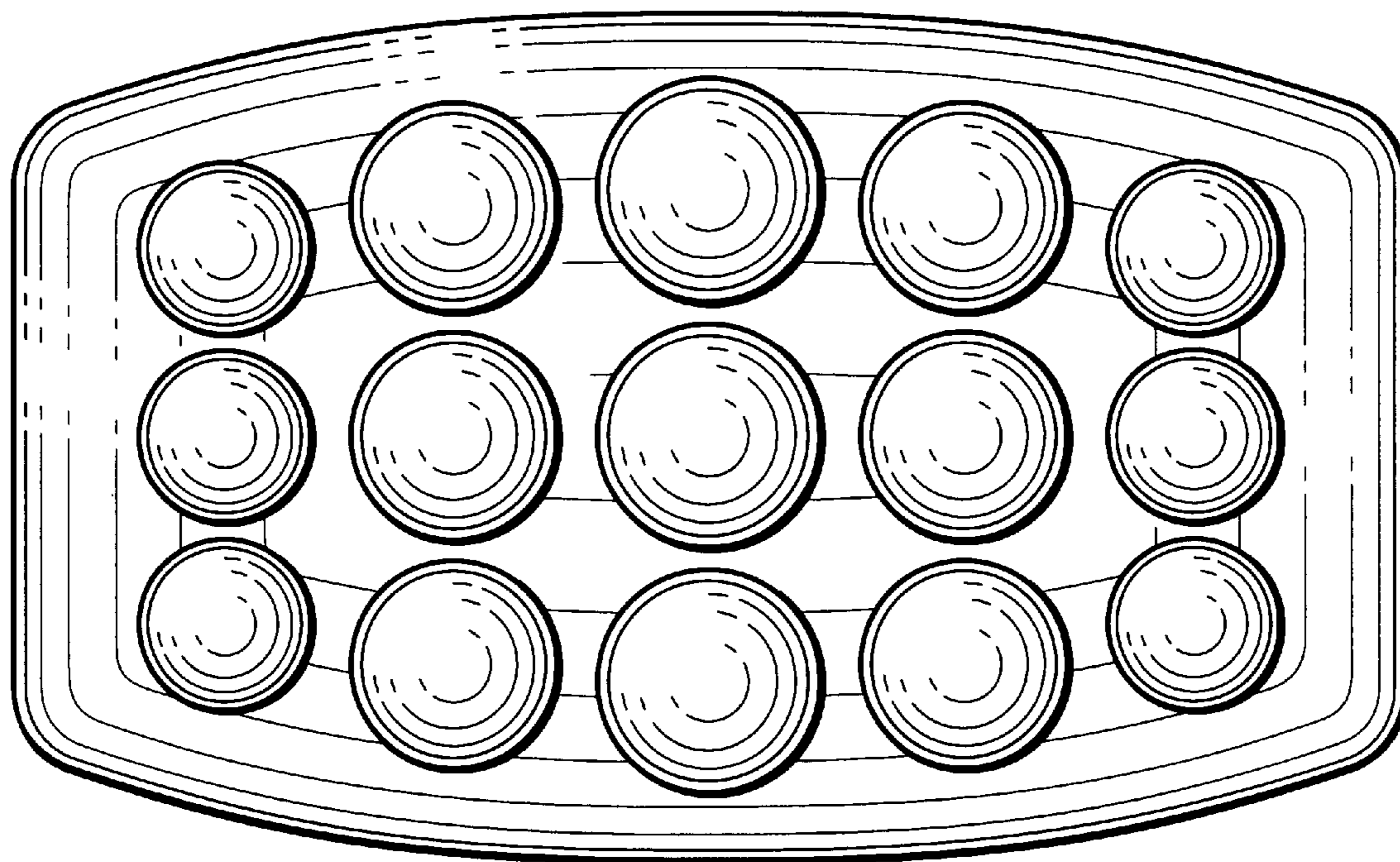

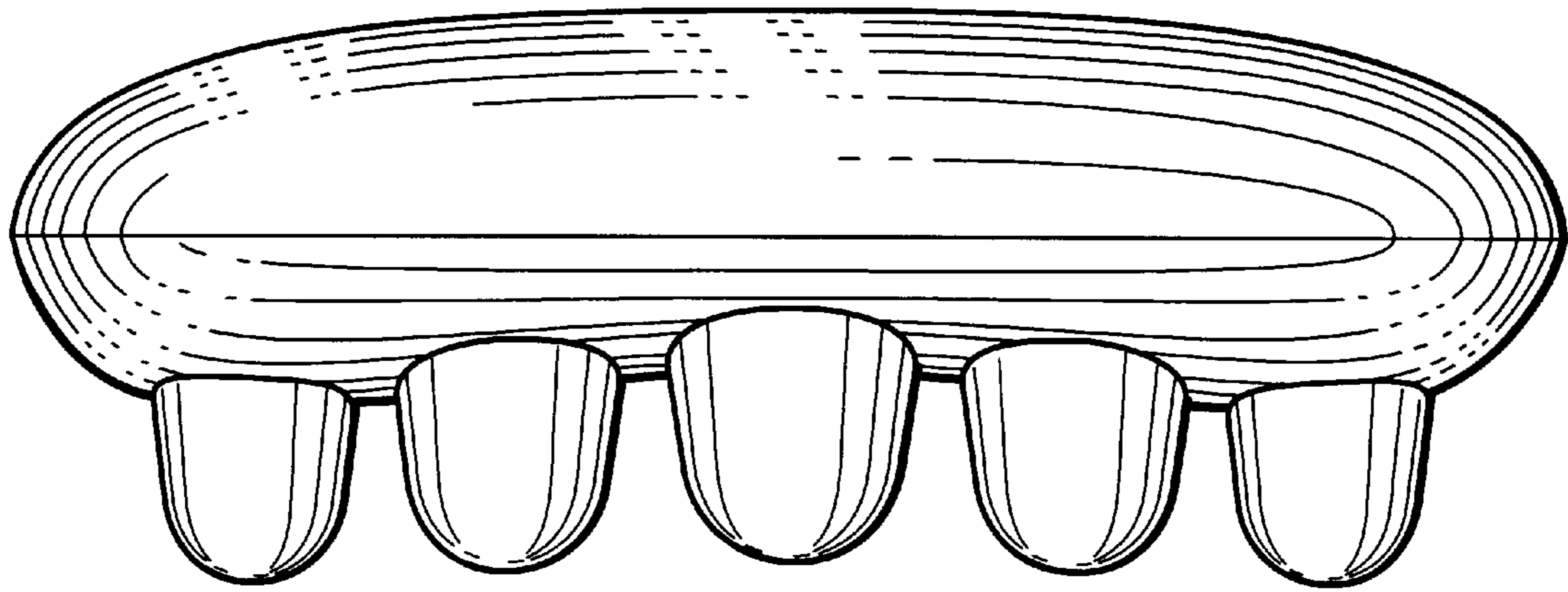

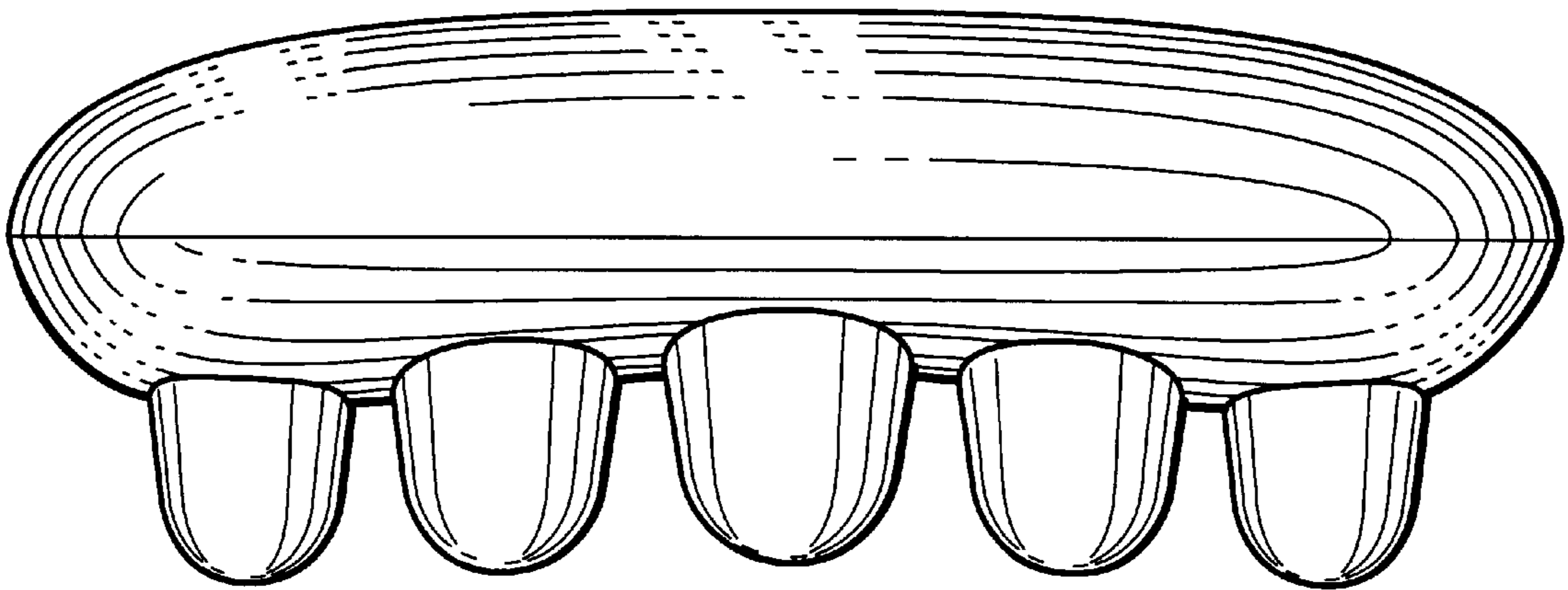

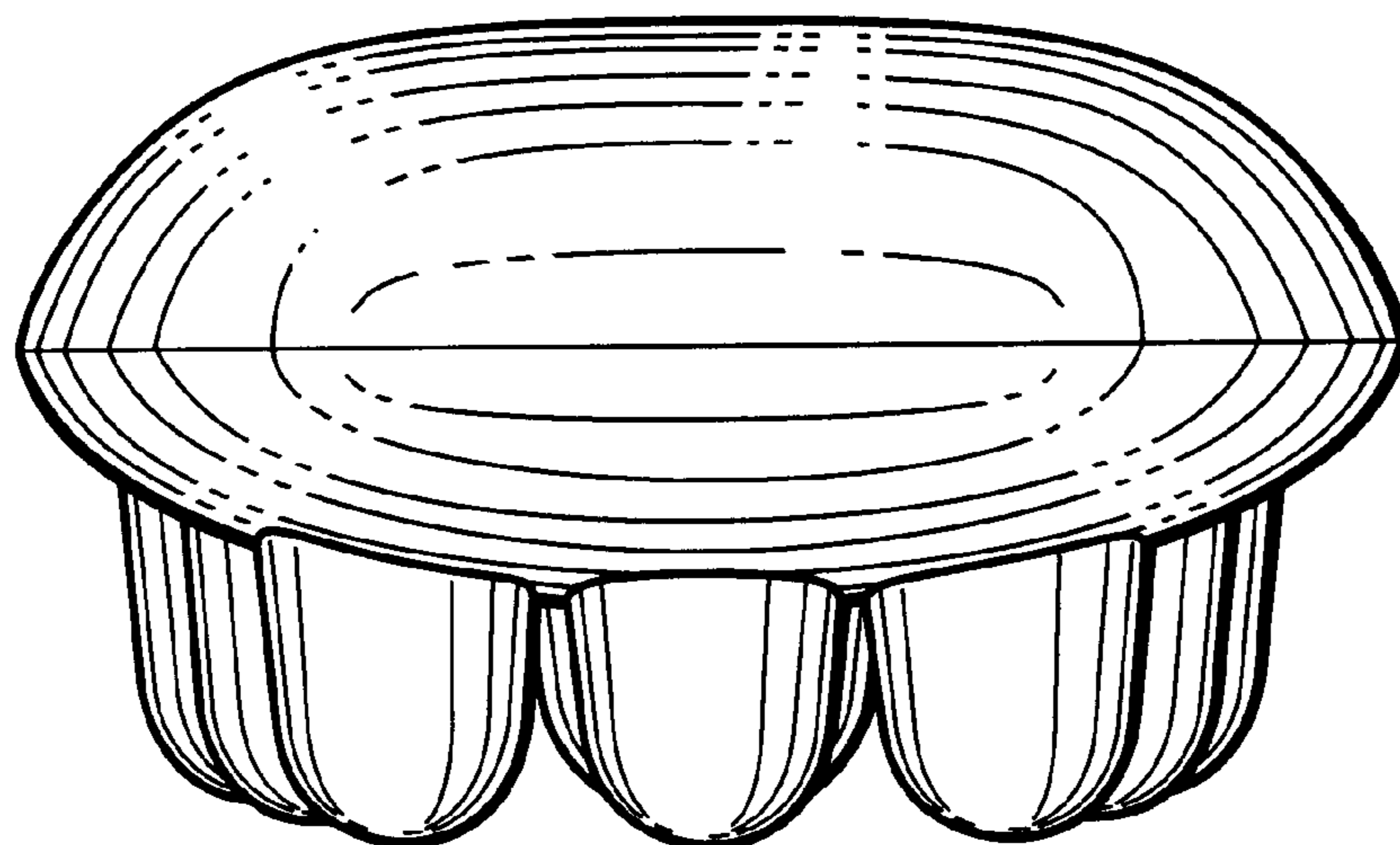

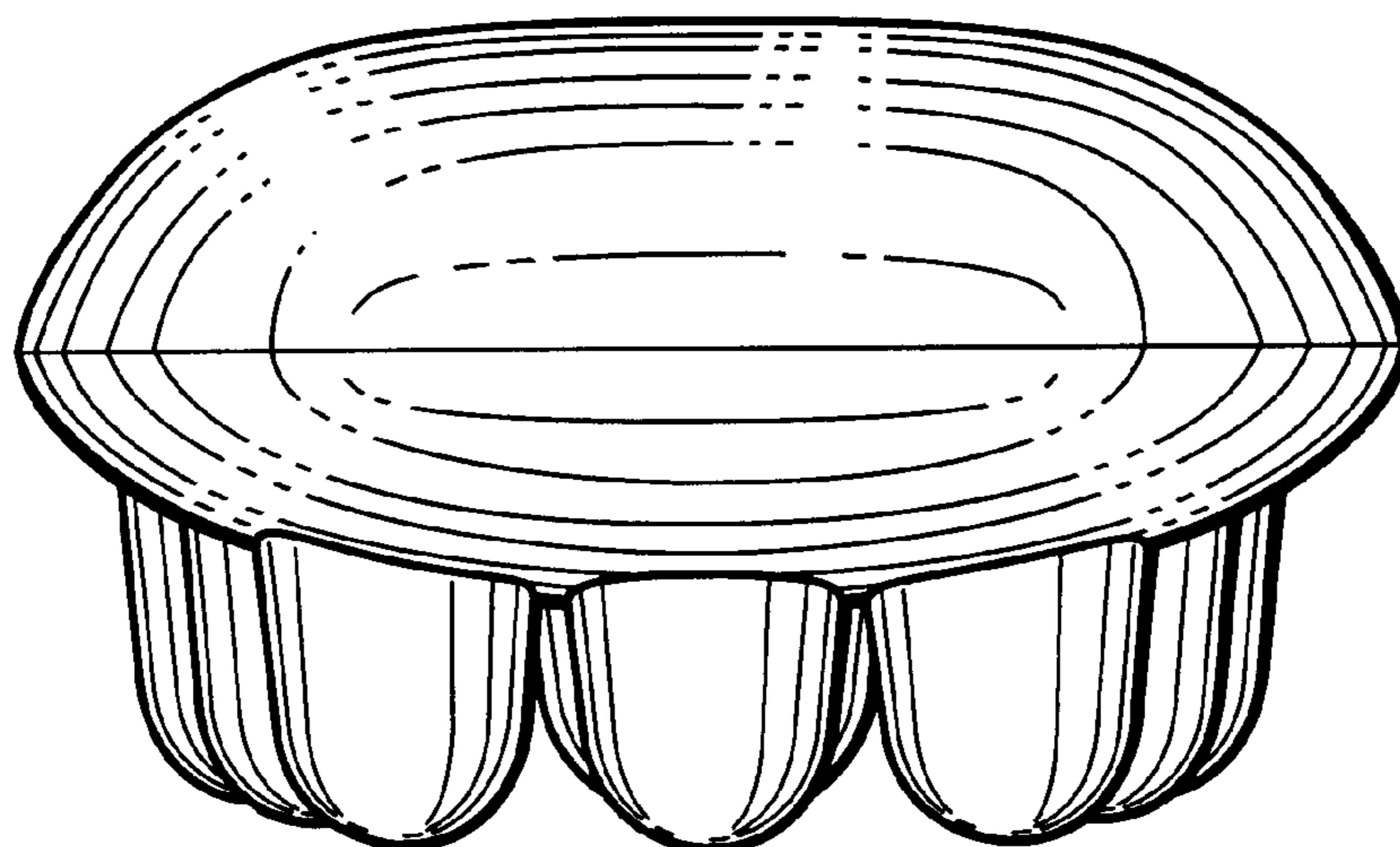
