

#### **CLAIM** (57)

The ornamental design for a baseball glove, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the baseball glove of the present invention, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the baseball glove of FIG. 1, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the baseball glove of FIG. 1, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the baseball glove of FIG. 1, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the baseball glove of FIG. 1, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the baseball glove of FIG. 1, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of another embodiment of the baseball glove of the present invention, the left side view being the same as that shown in FIG. 3 and the bottom plan view being the same as that shown in FIG. 6, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;


FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the baseball glove of FIG. 7, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view of the baseball glove of FIG. 7, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of yet another embodiment of the baseball glove of the present invention, the rear elevational, left side, right side, top plan and bottom plan views being the same as that shown in FIGS. 2-6, the portions shown in dashed lines forming no part of the invention




















