FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the new design;

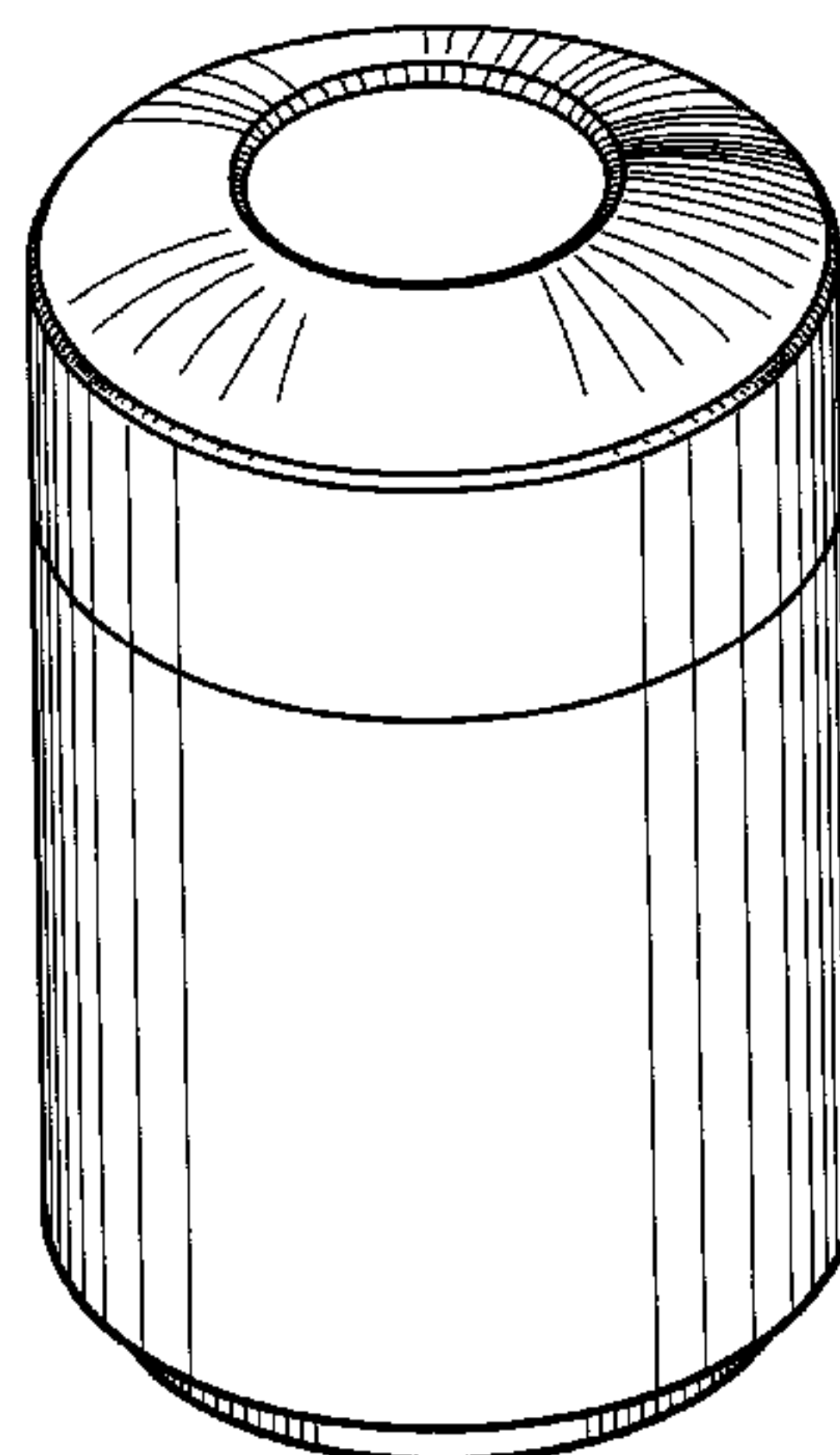
FIG. 2 is a side view of the new design;

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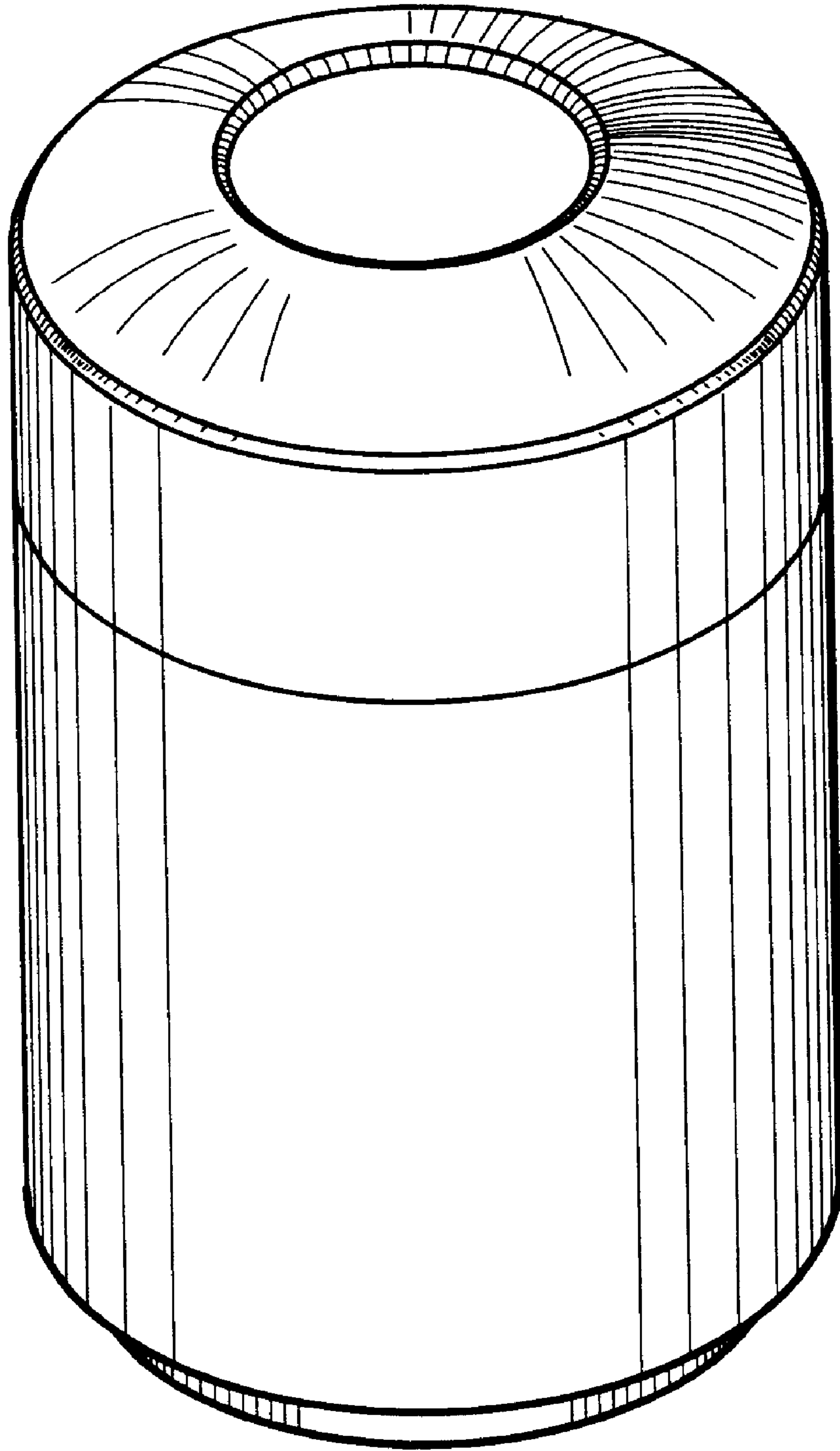

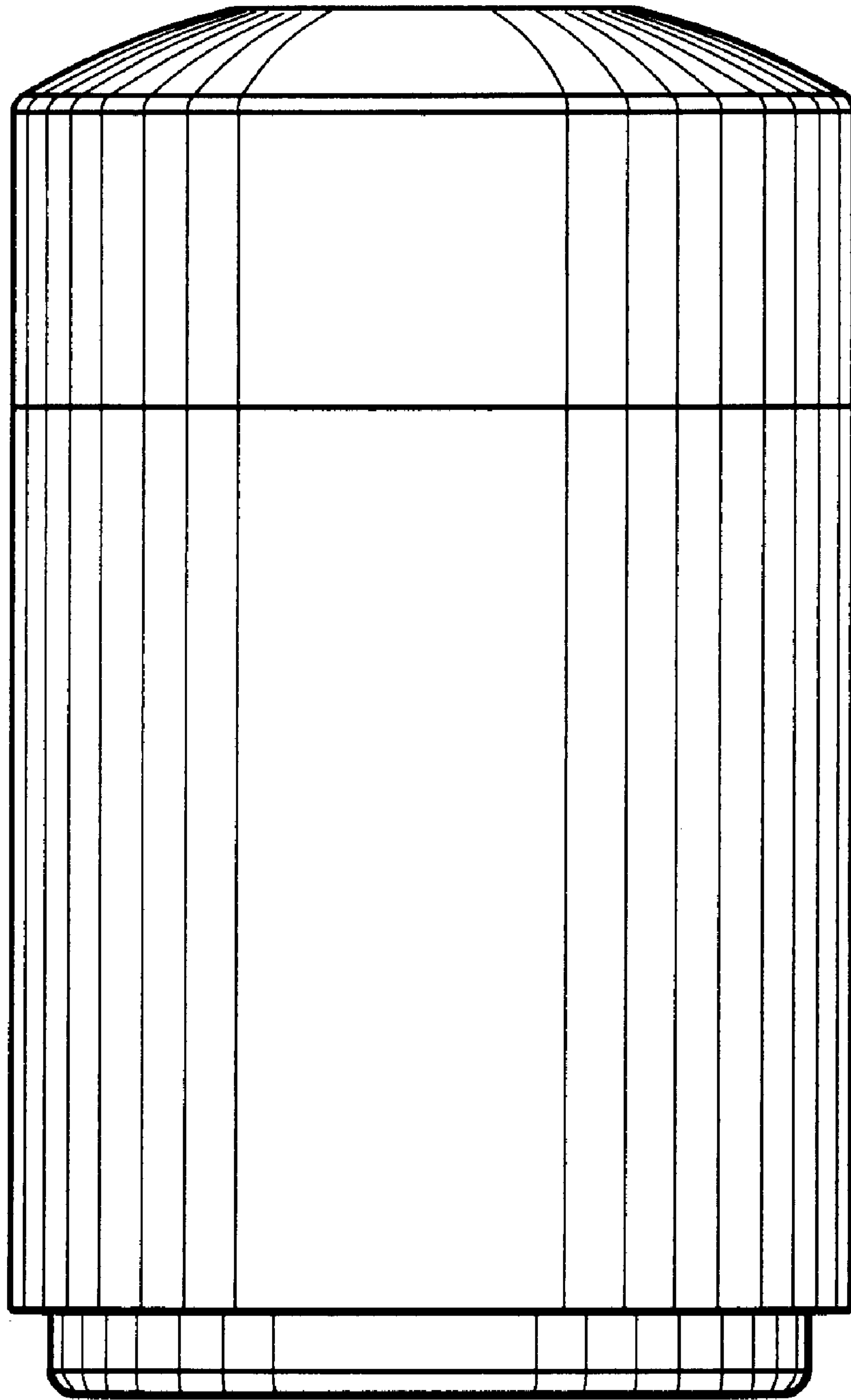

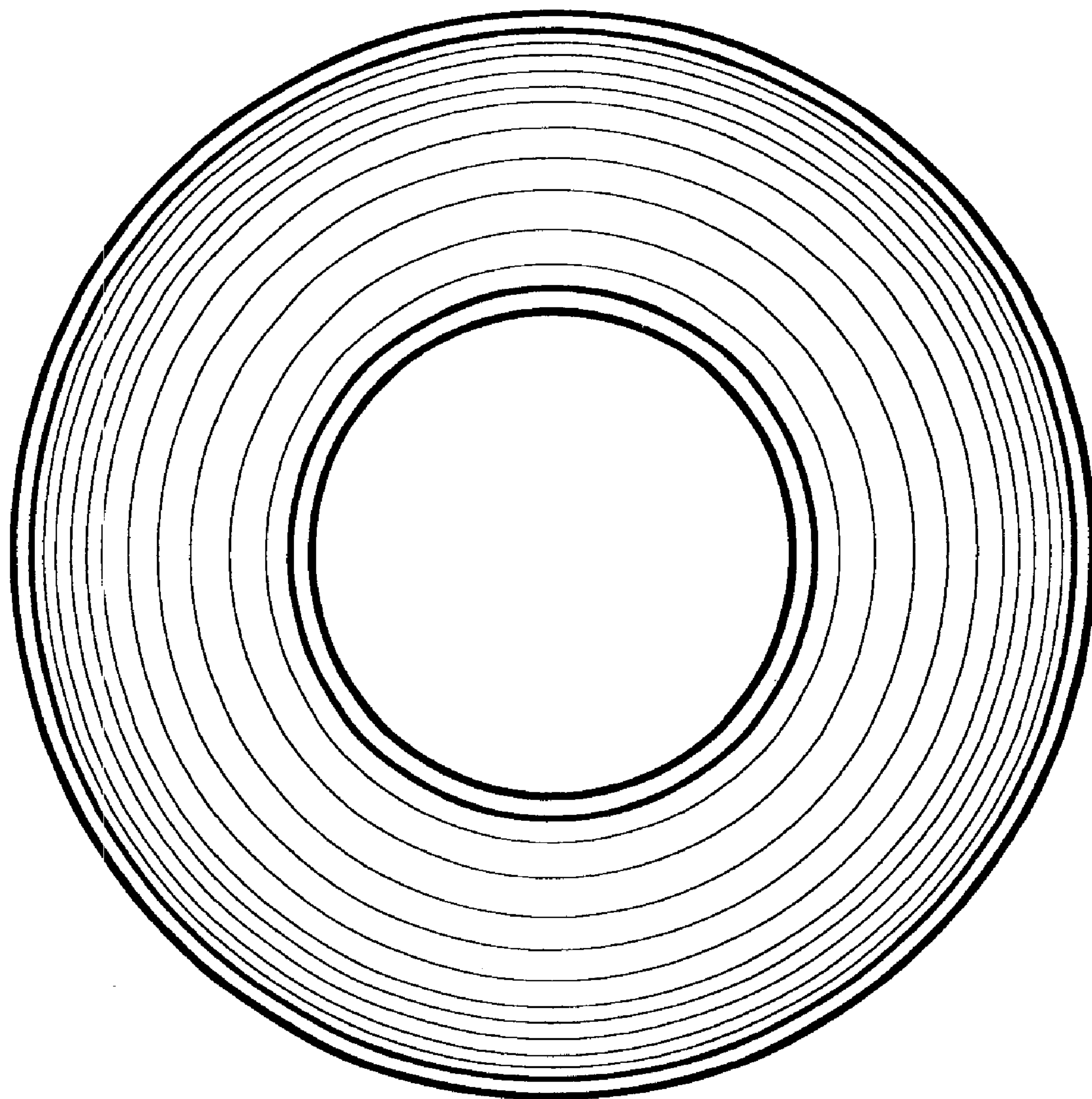

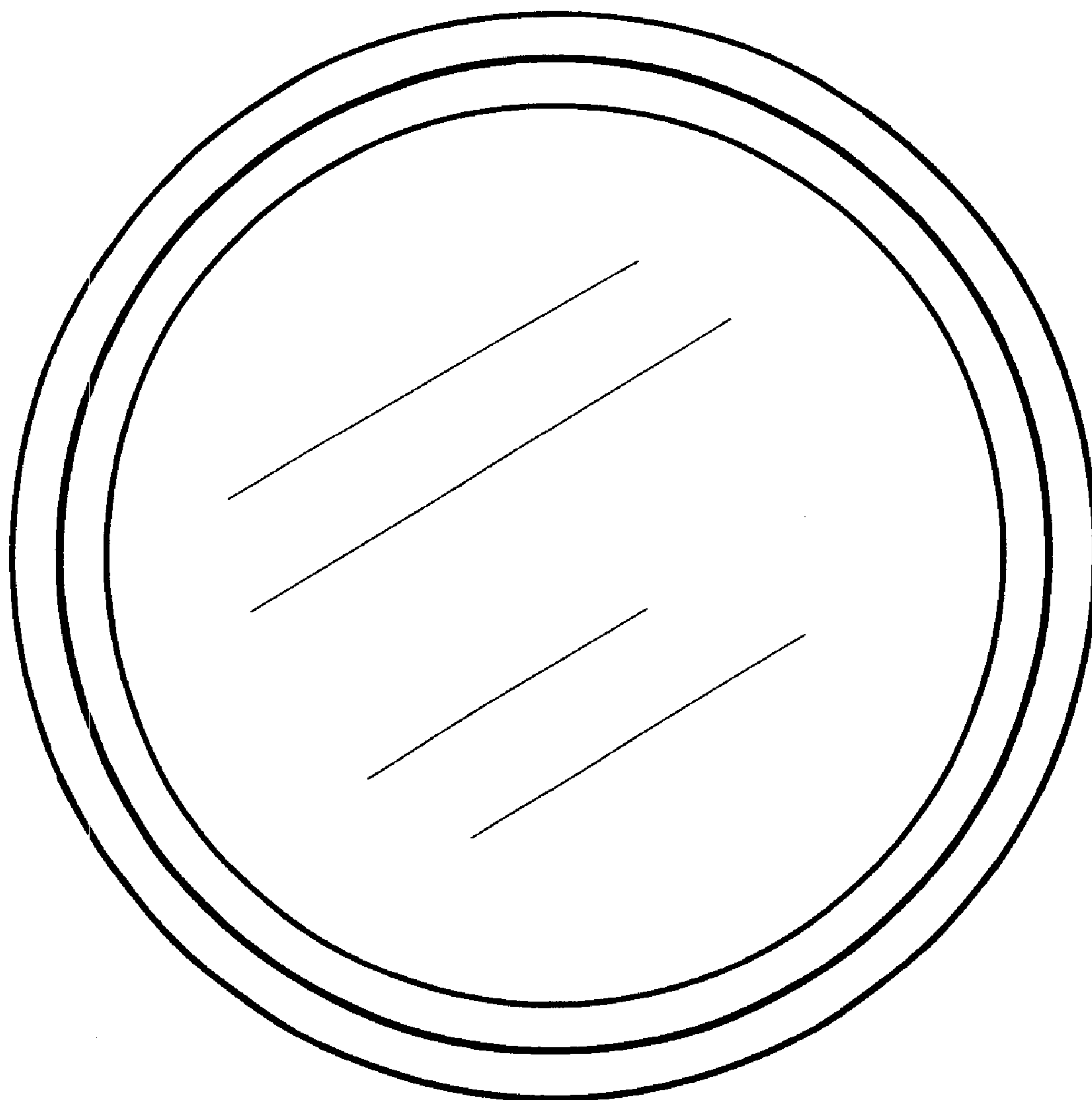
