DESCRIPTION

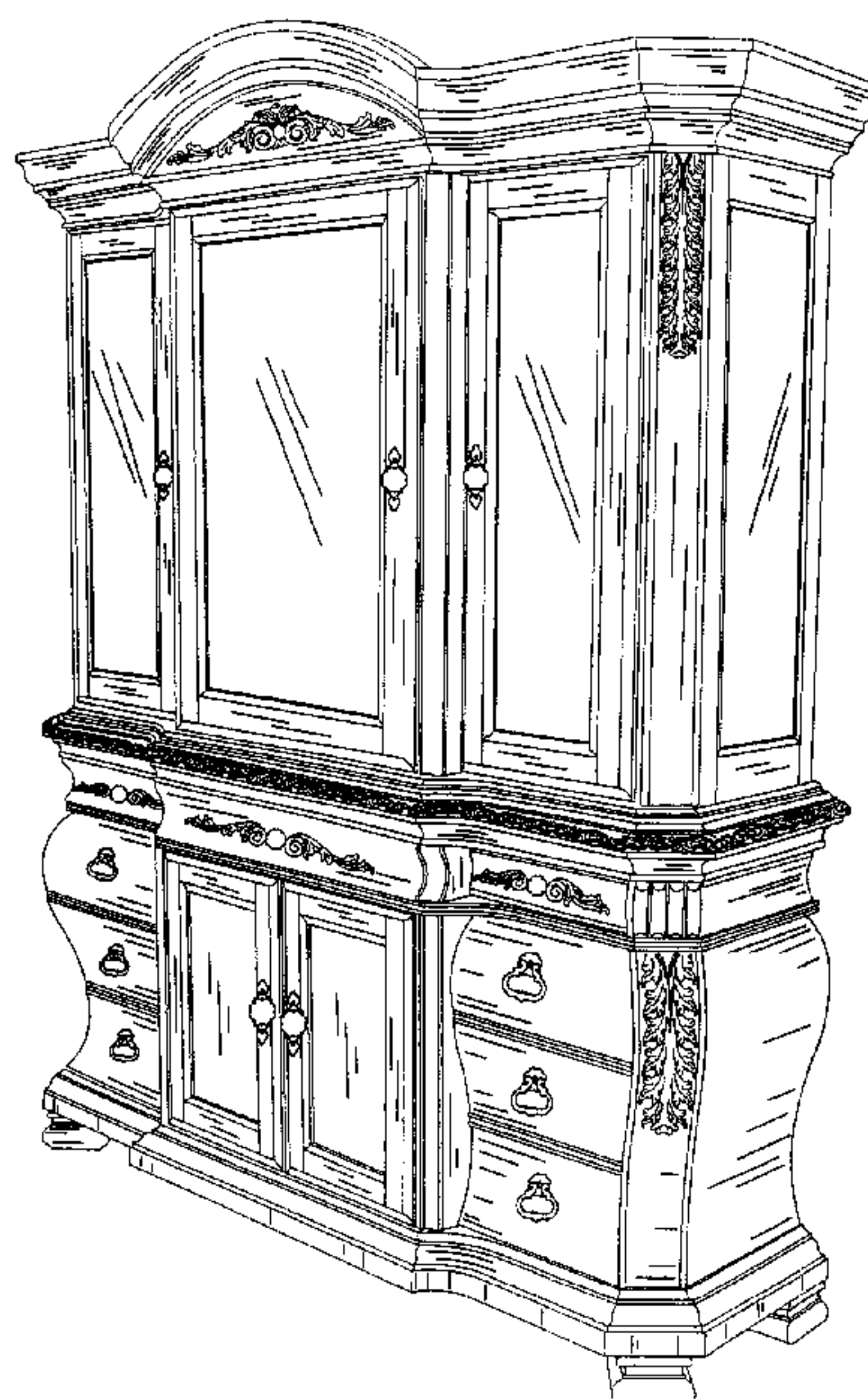
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a china cabinet and buffet

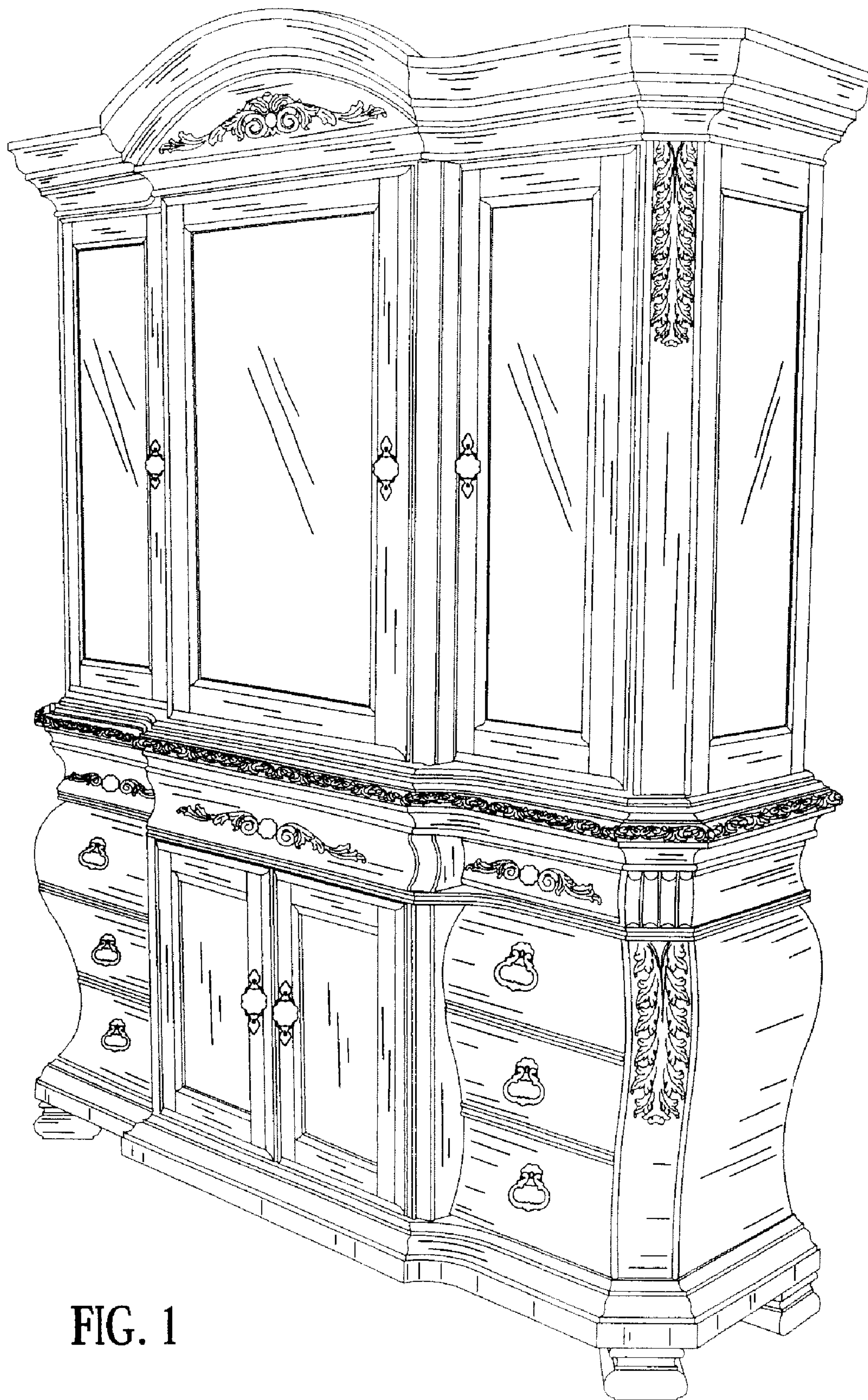

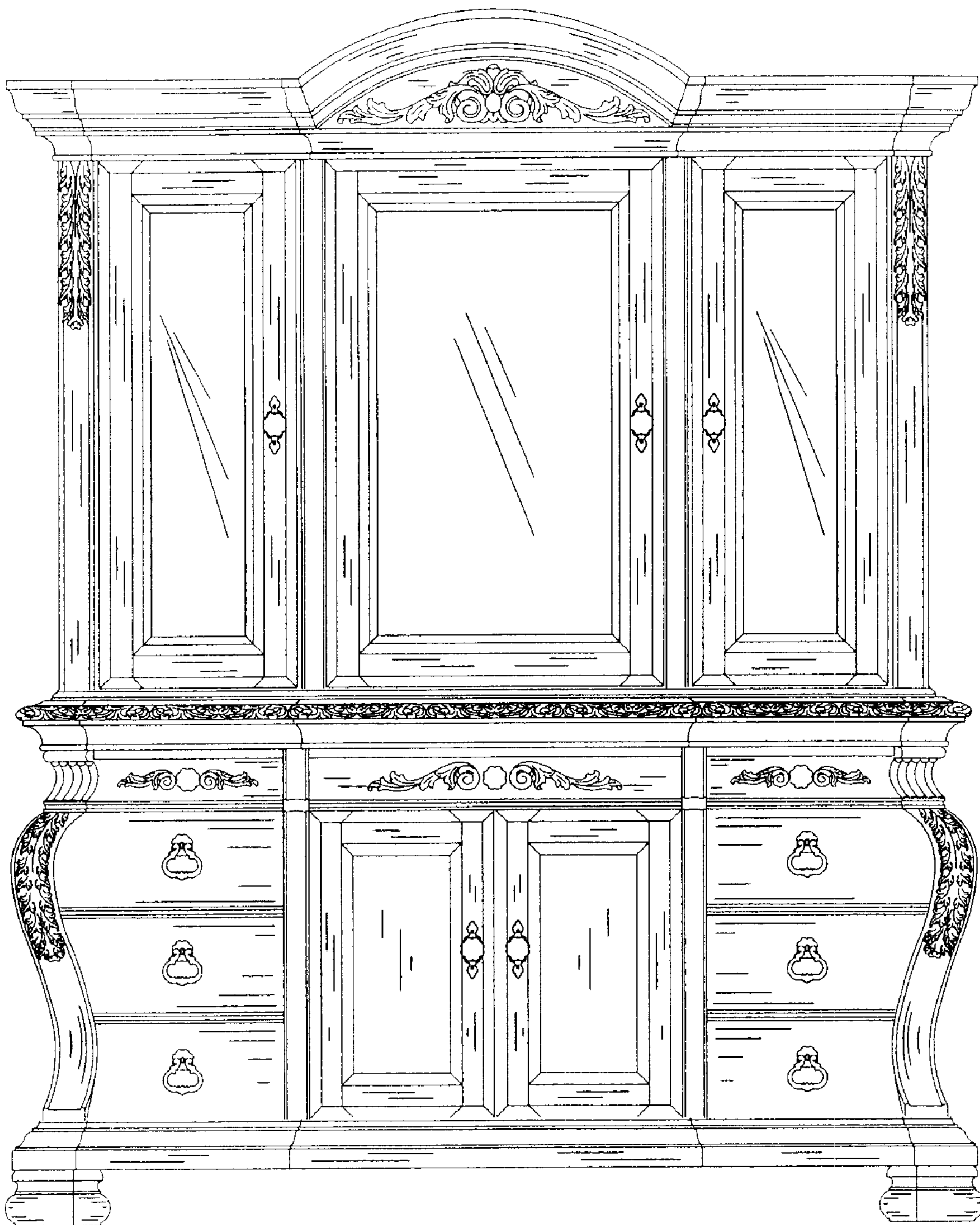

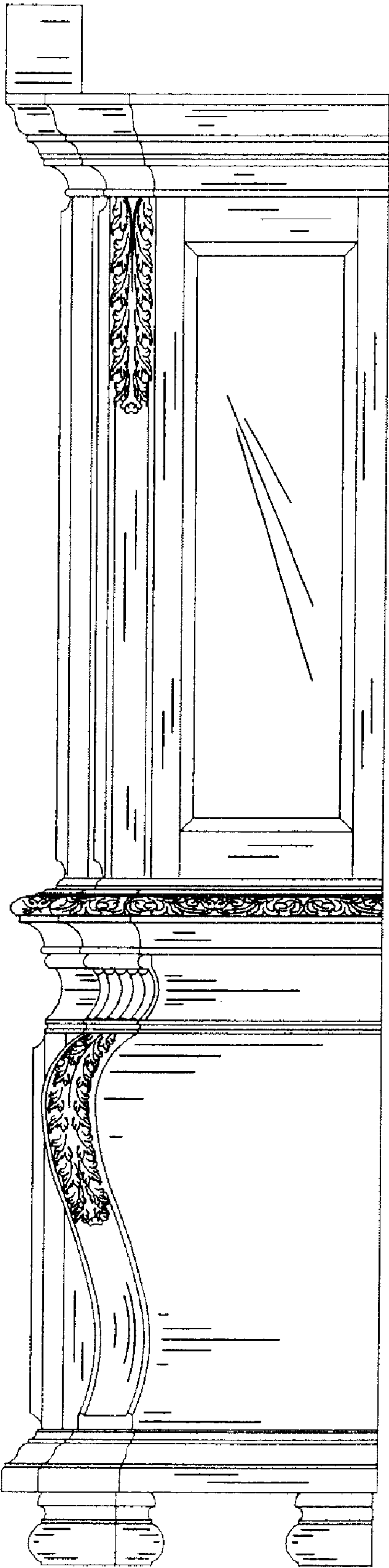
