FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the moisture sensor of FIG. 1.


FIG. **5** is a left side elevation view of the moisture sensor of FIG. **1**;


FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the moisture sensor of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of the moisture sensor of FIG. 1.


