(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a writing instrument cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of a writing instrument cap showing a portion of my new design as translucent;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is the left side elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged top plan view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 7 is an enlarged bottom plan view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 6.

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a writing instrument cap showing my new design as opaque;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 8;

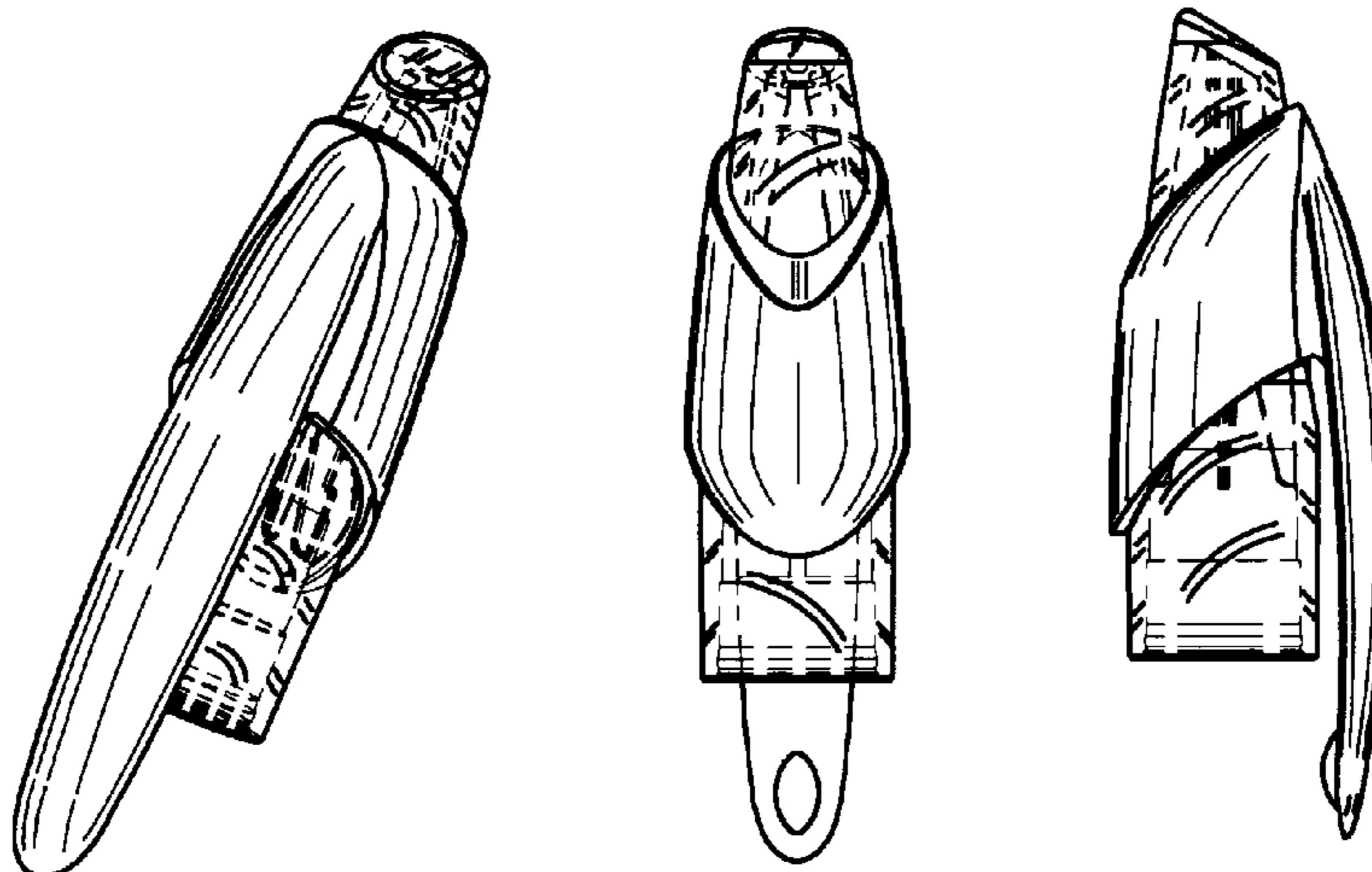
FIG. 12 the left side elevational view of the writing instrument cap of FIG. 8;

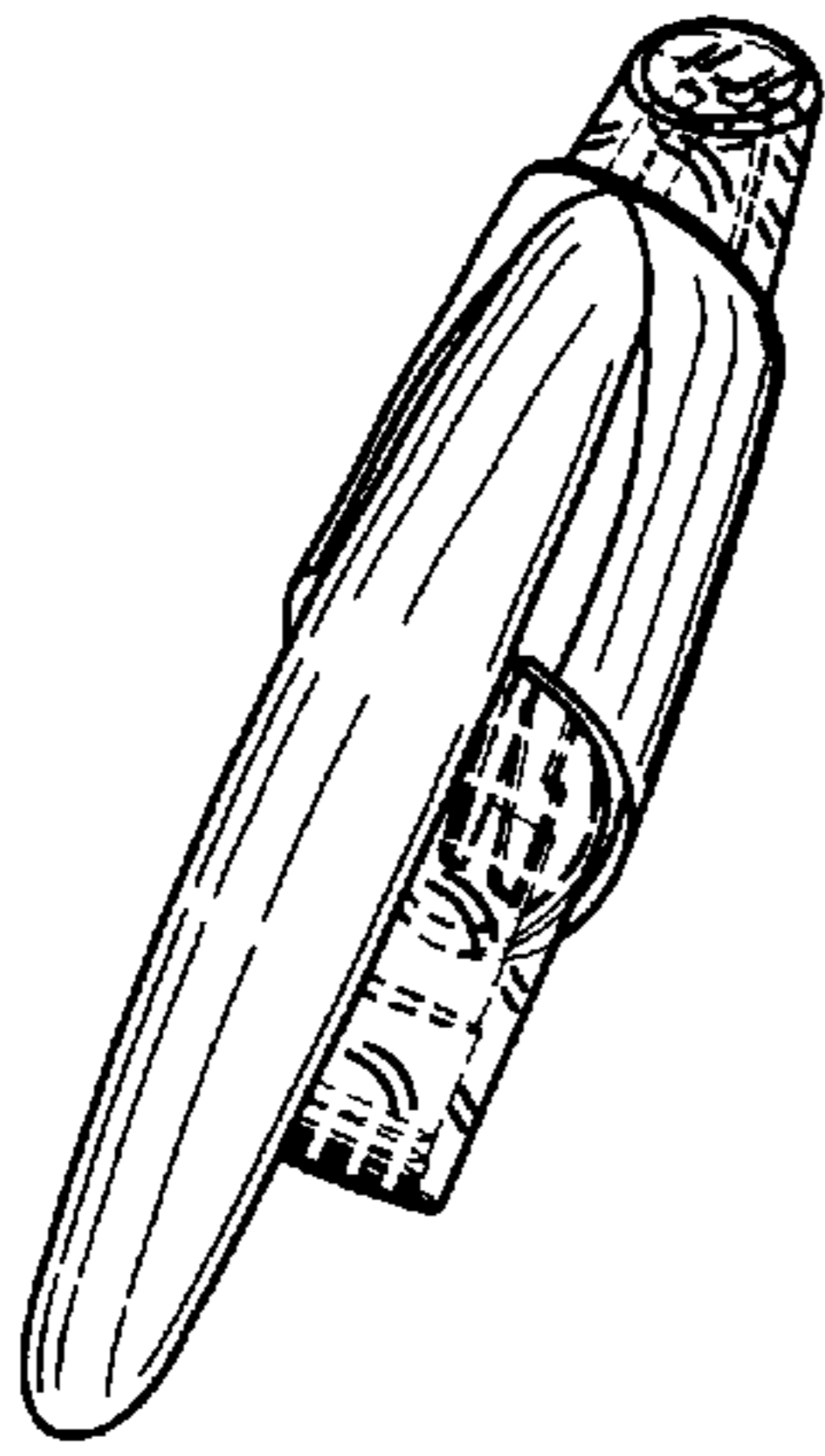

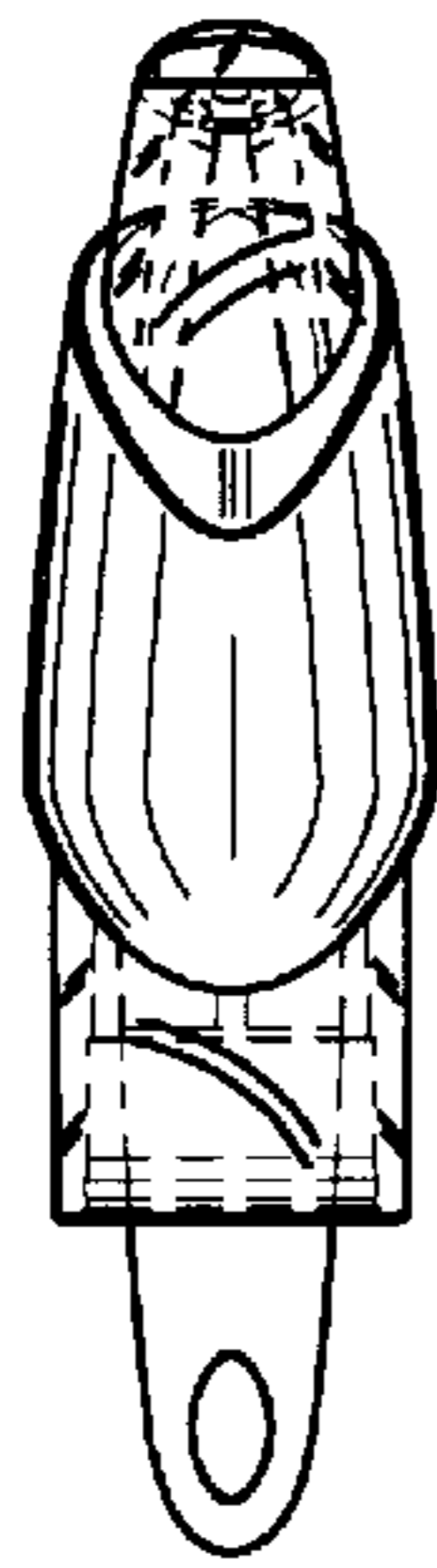

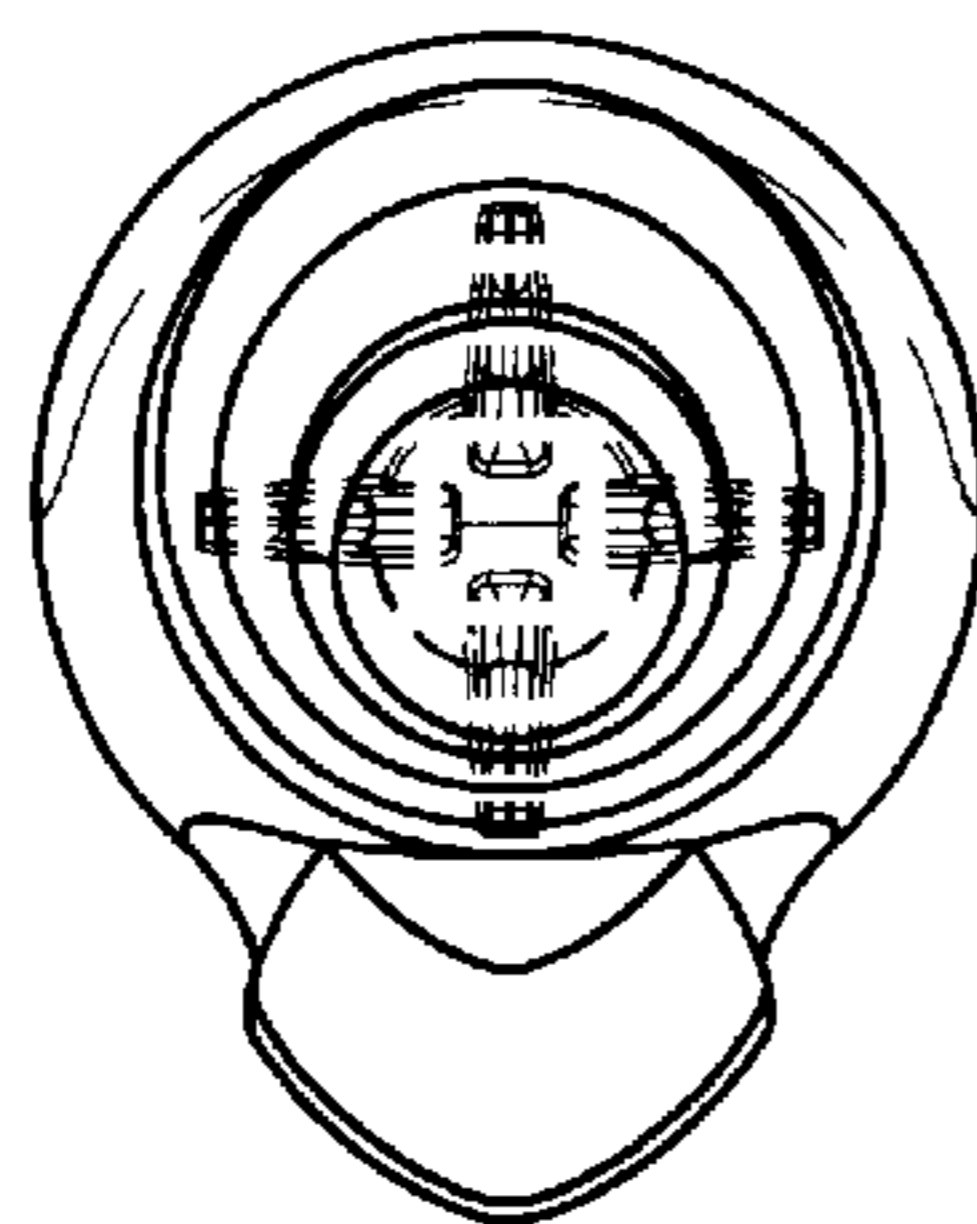

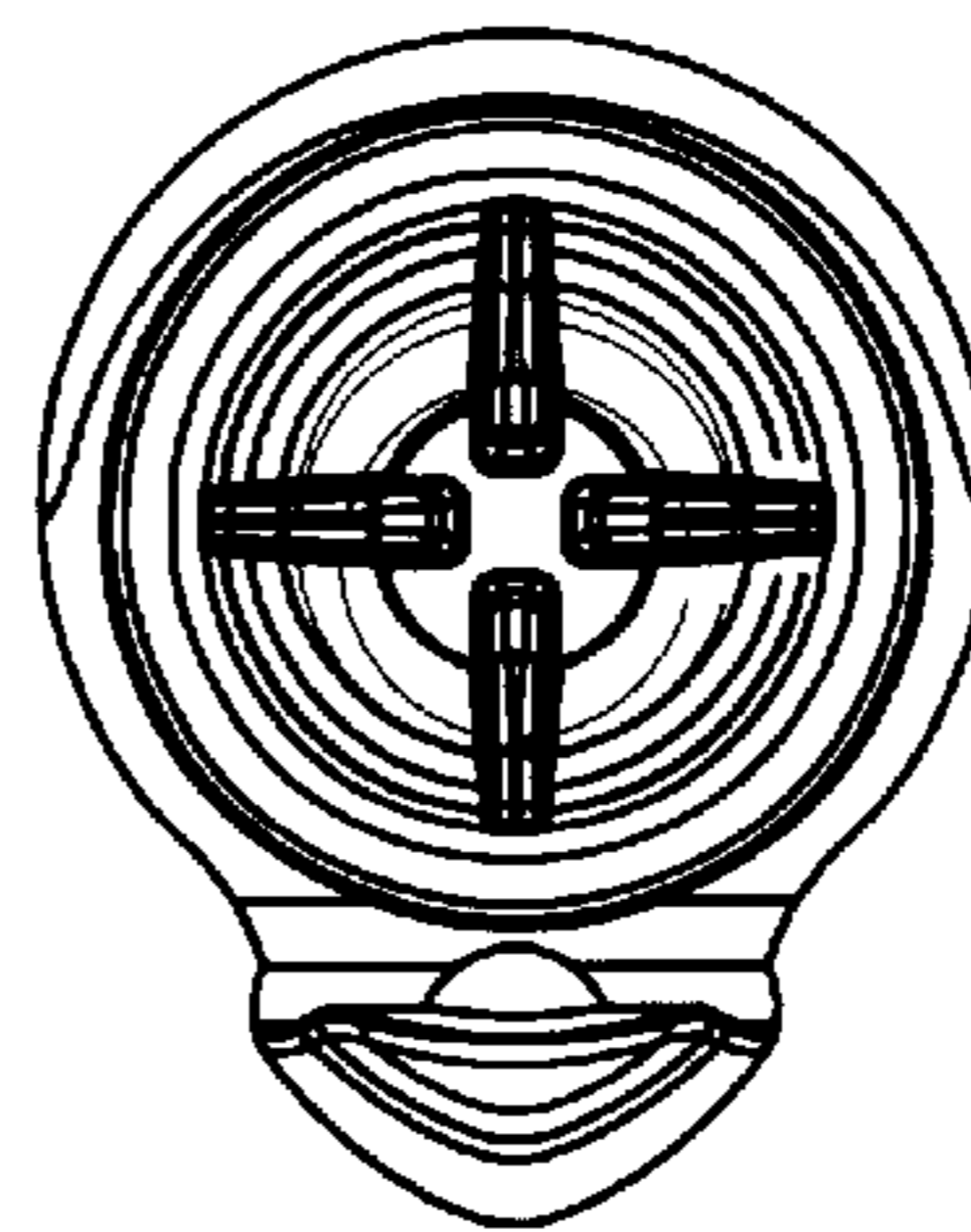

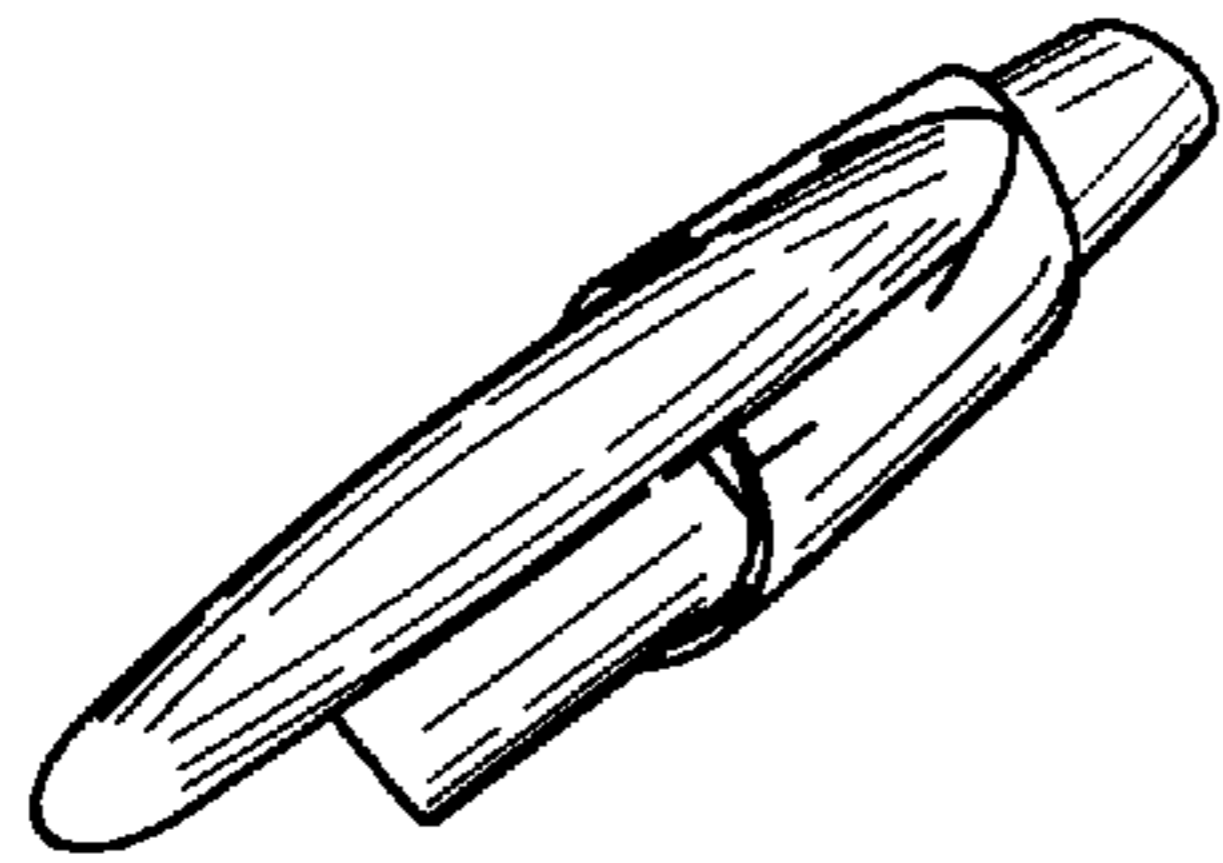

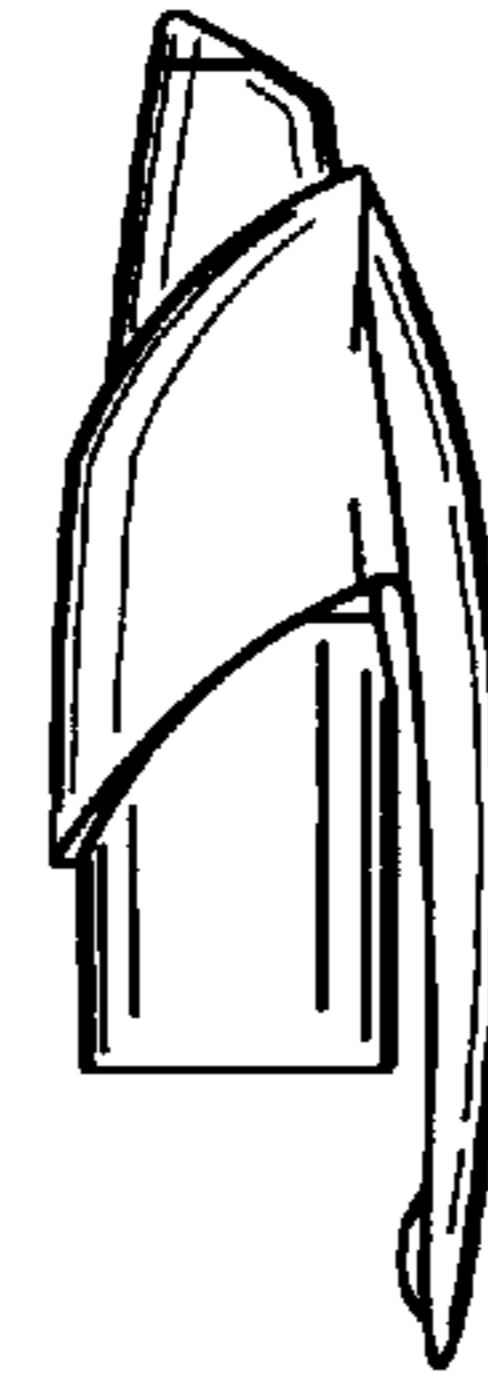
