The ornamental design for a “modular hat shaped shelving unit”, as shown and described.

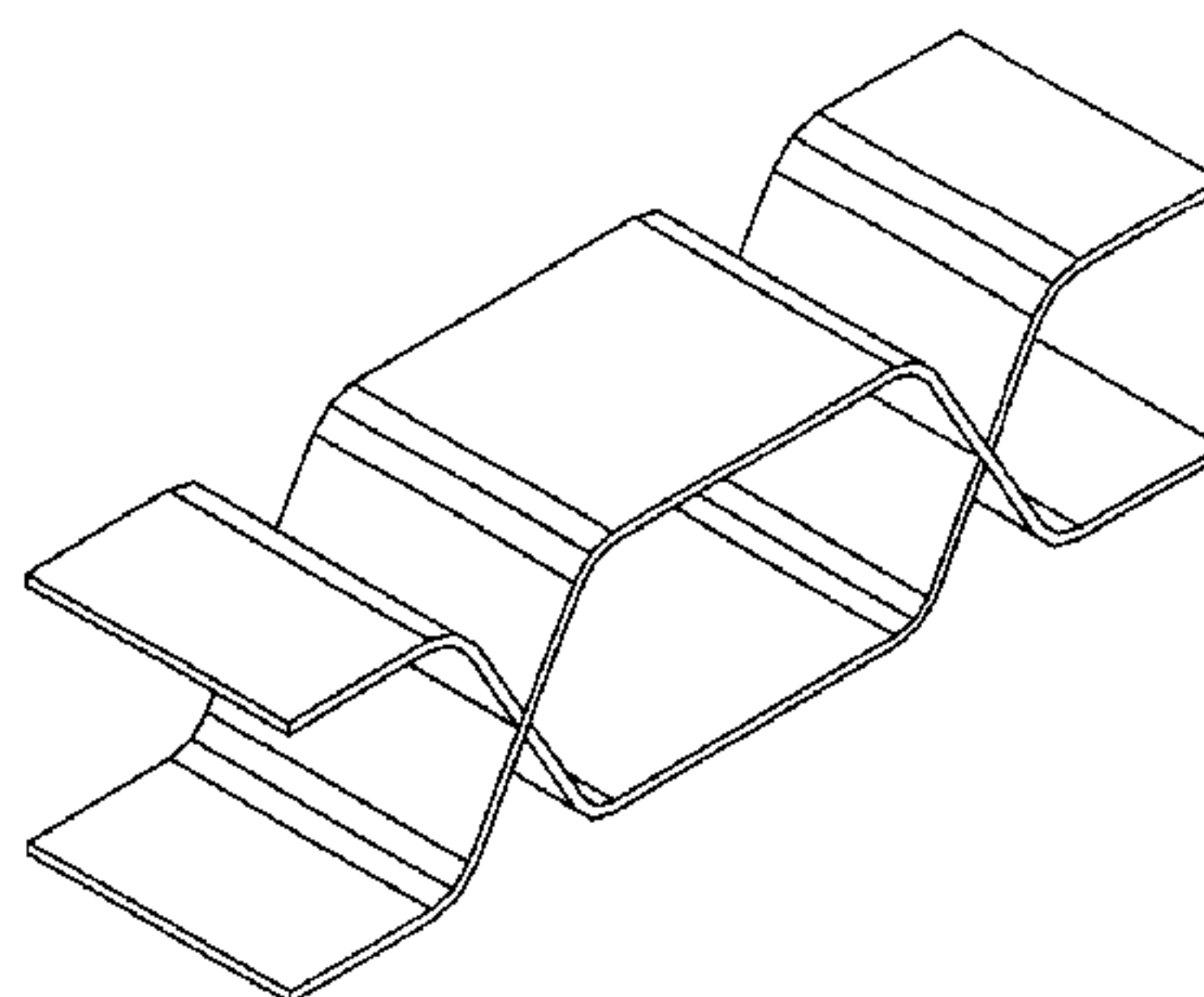
DESCRIPTION

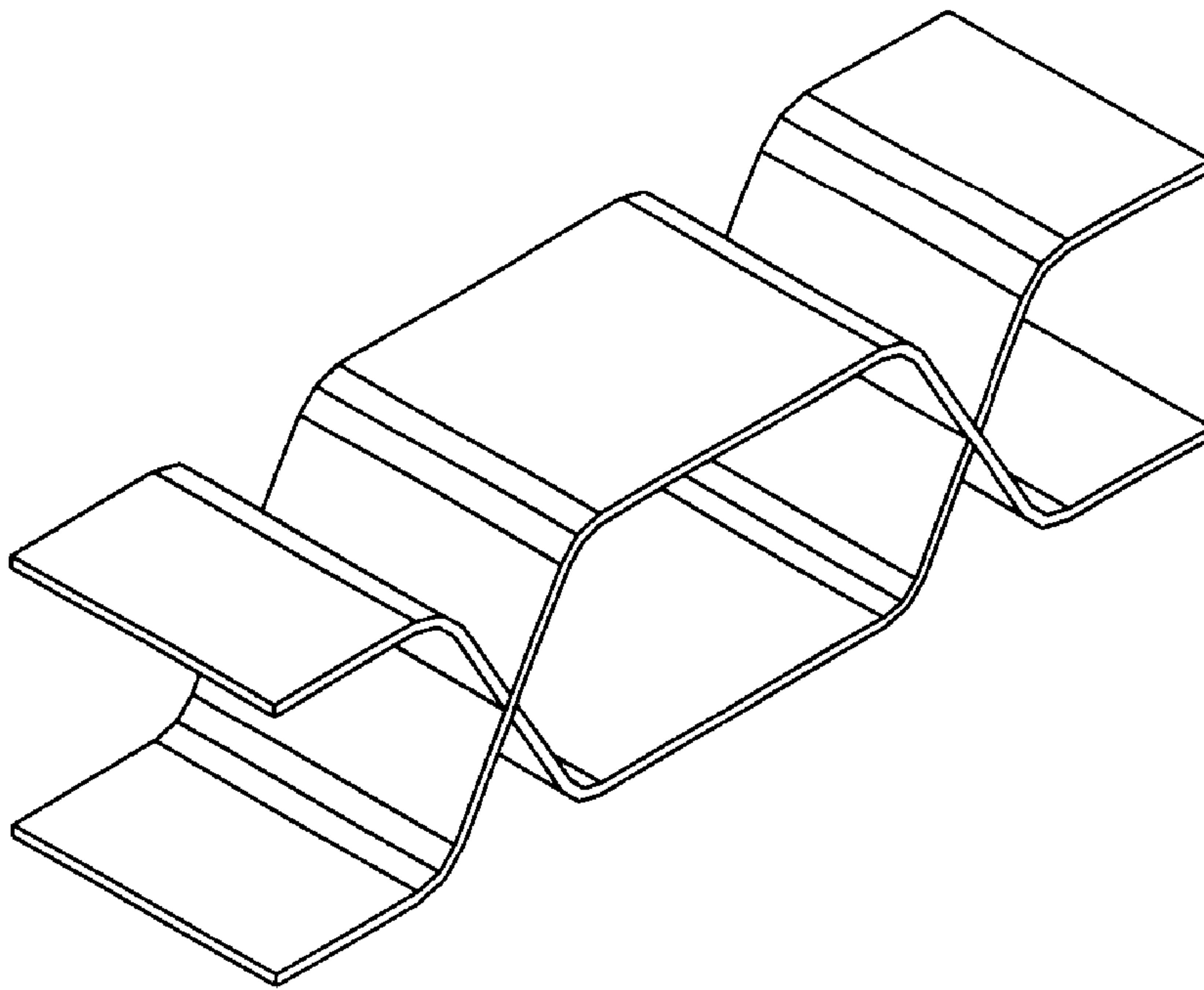

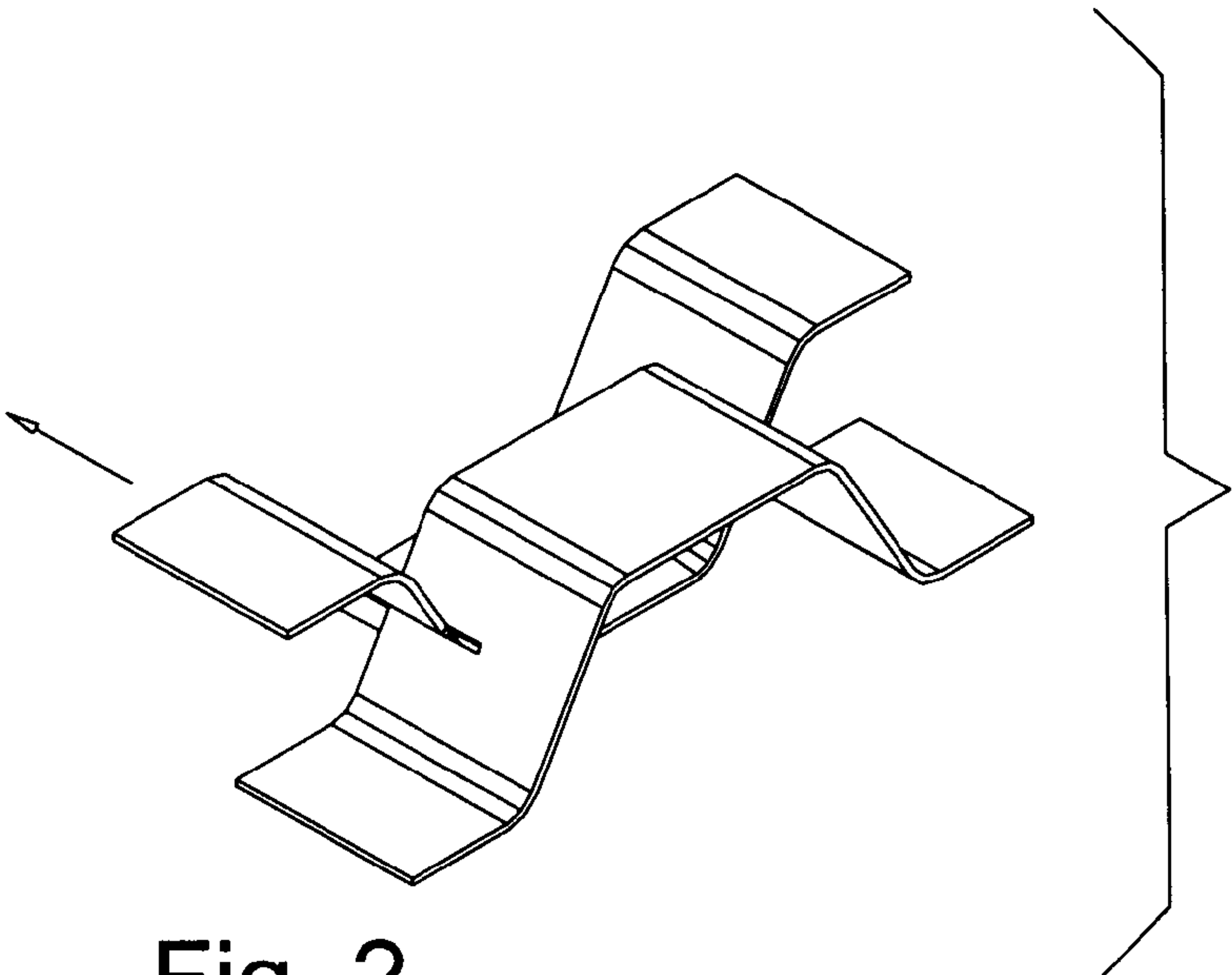

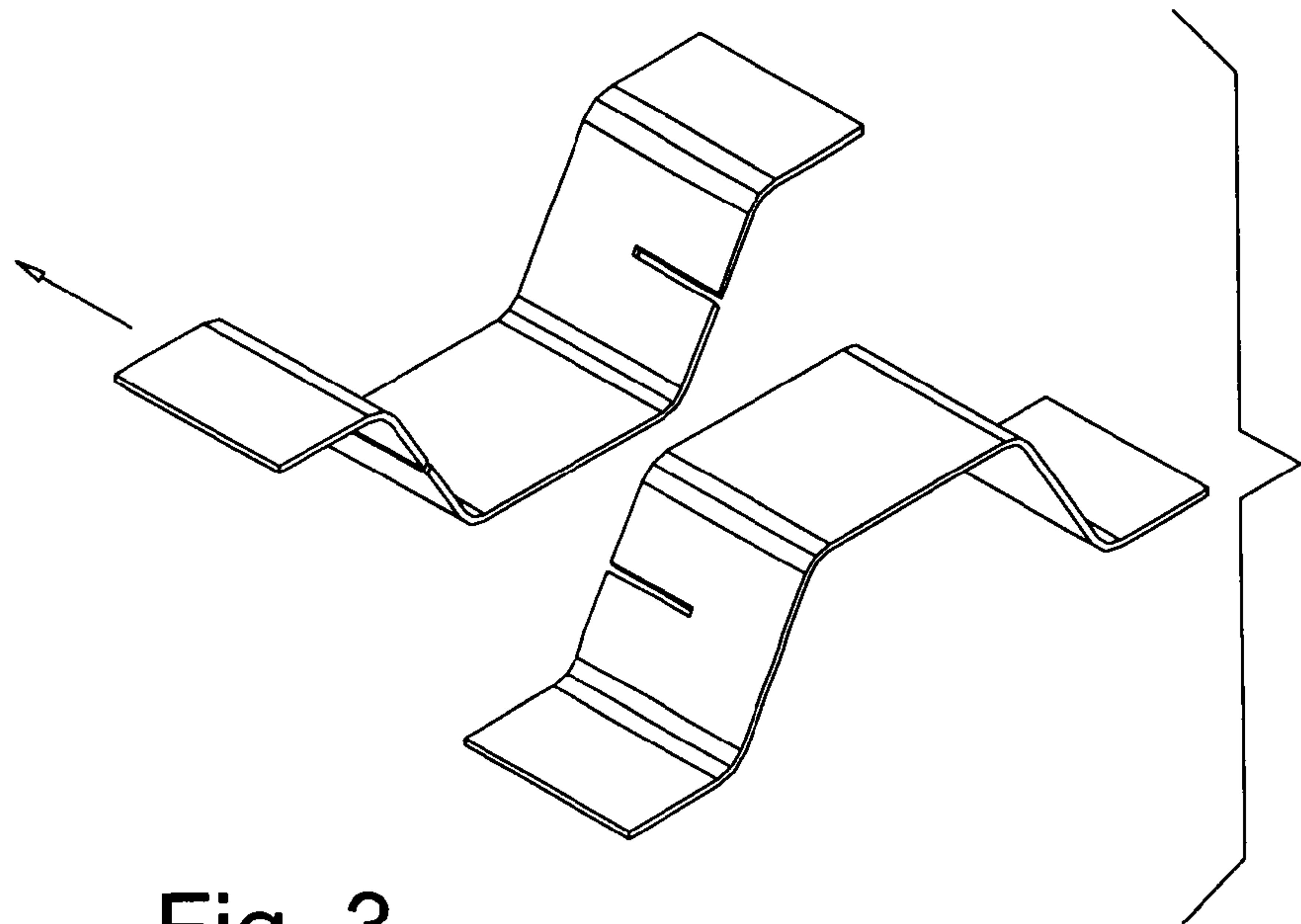
