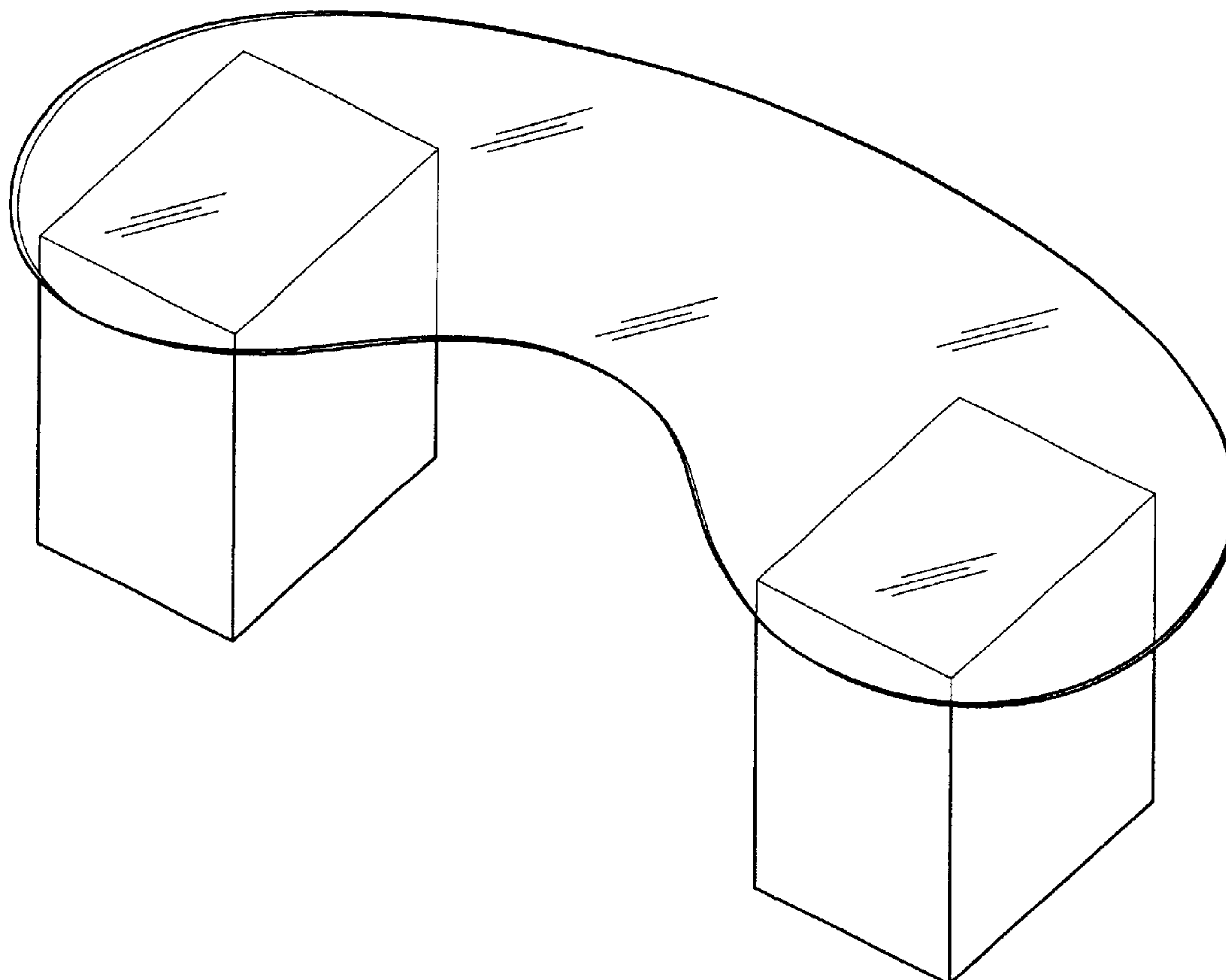
The left side elevational view of the desk is a mirror image of the right side elevational view of FIG. 4.

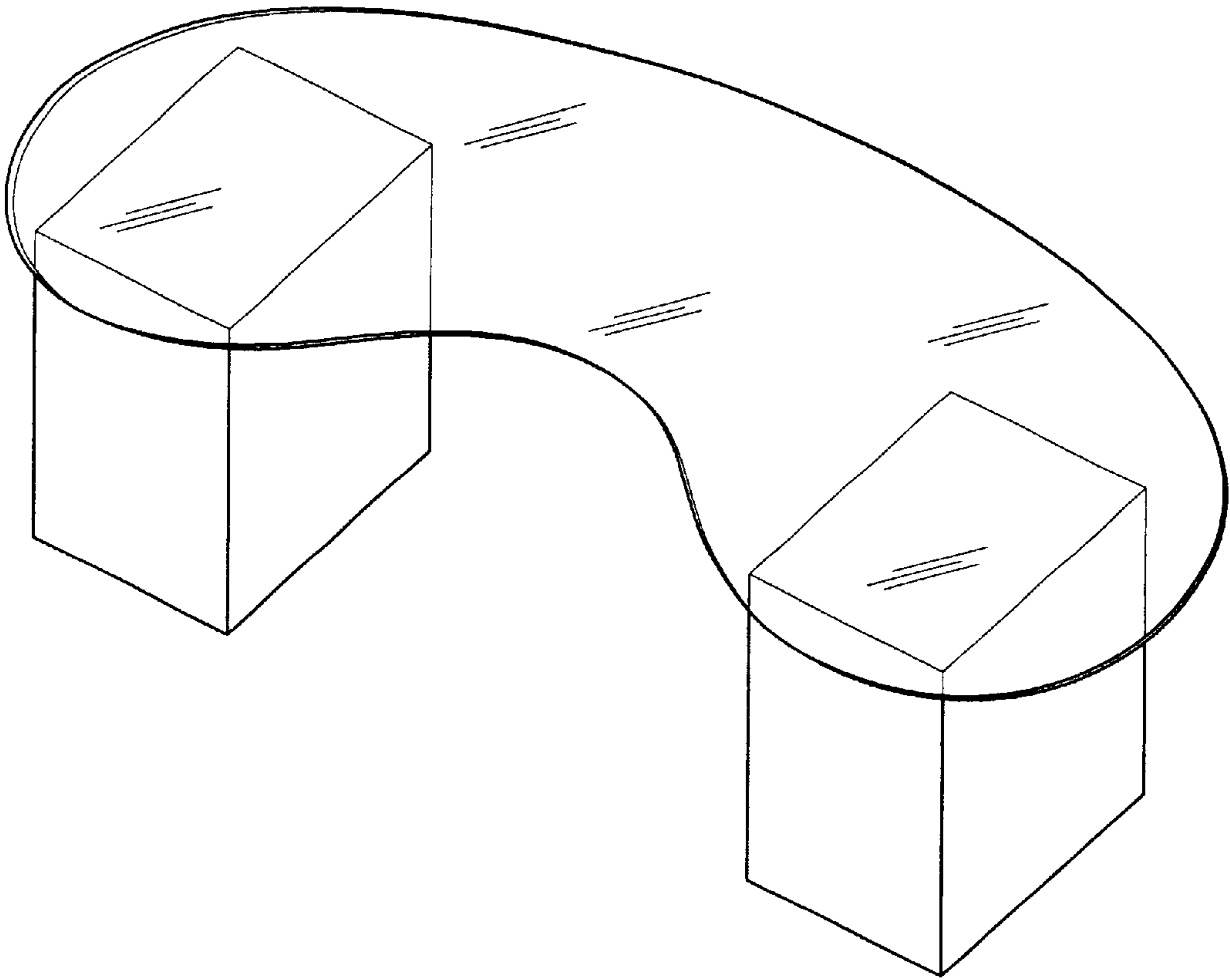

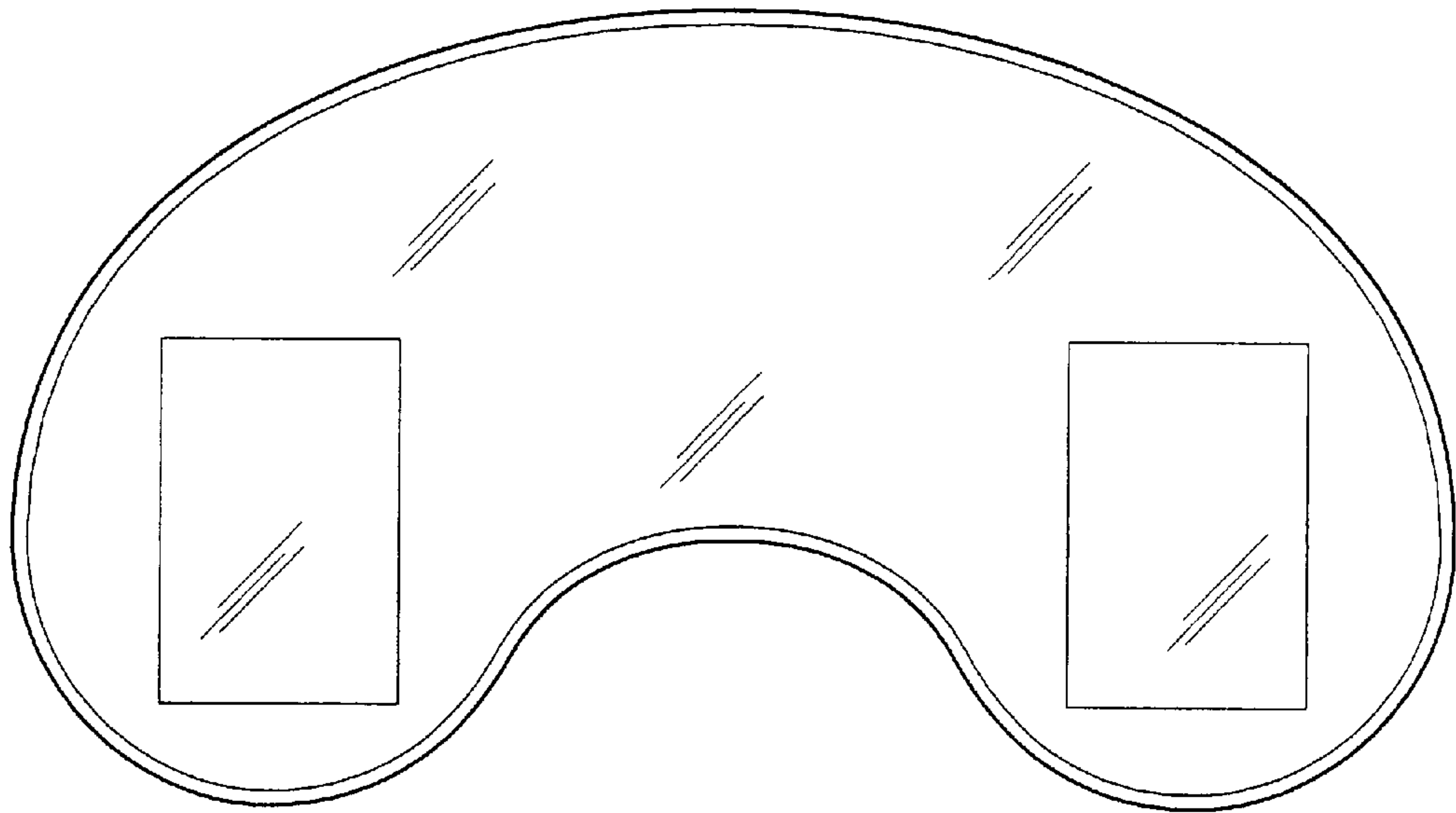

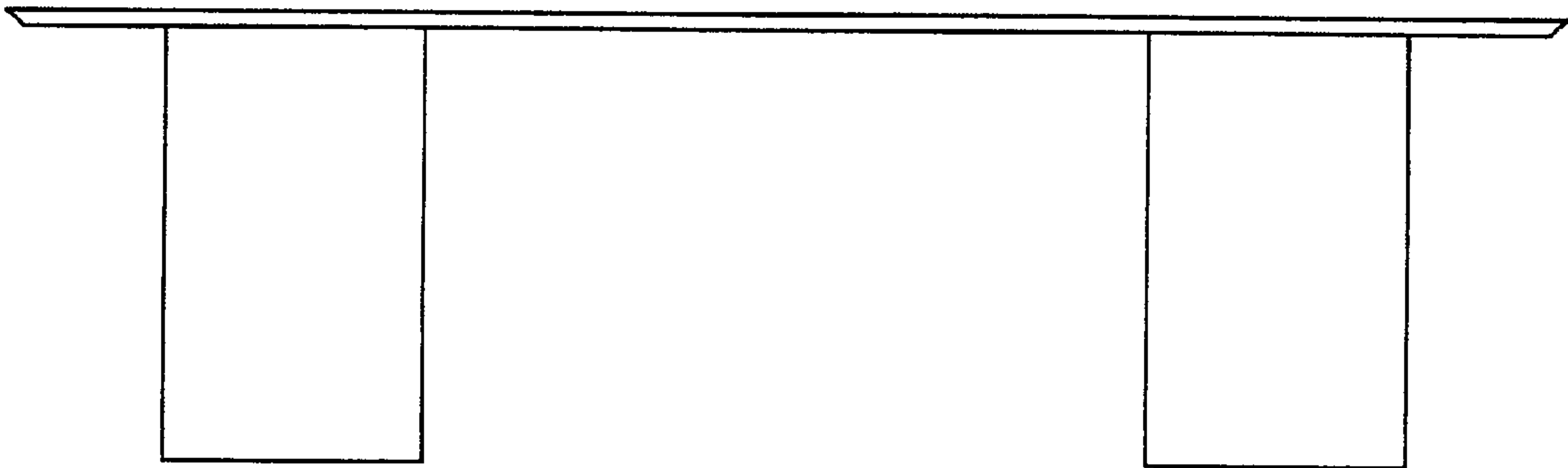

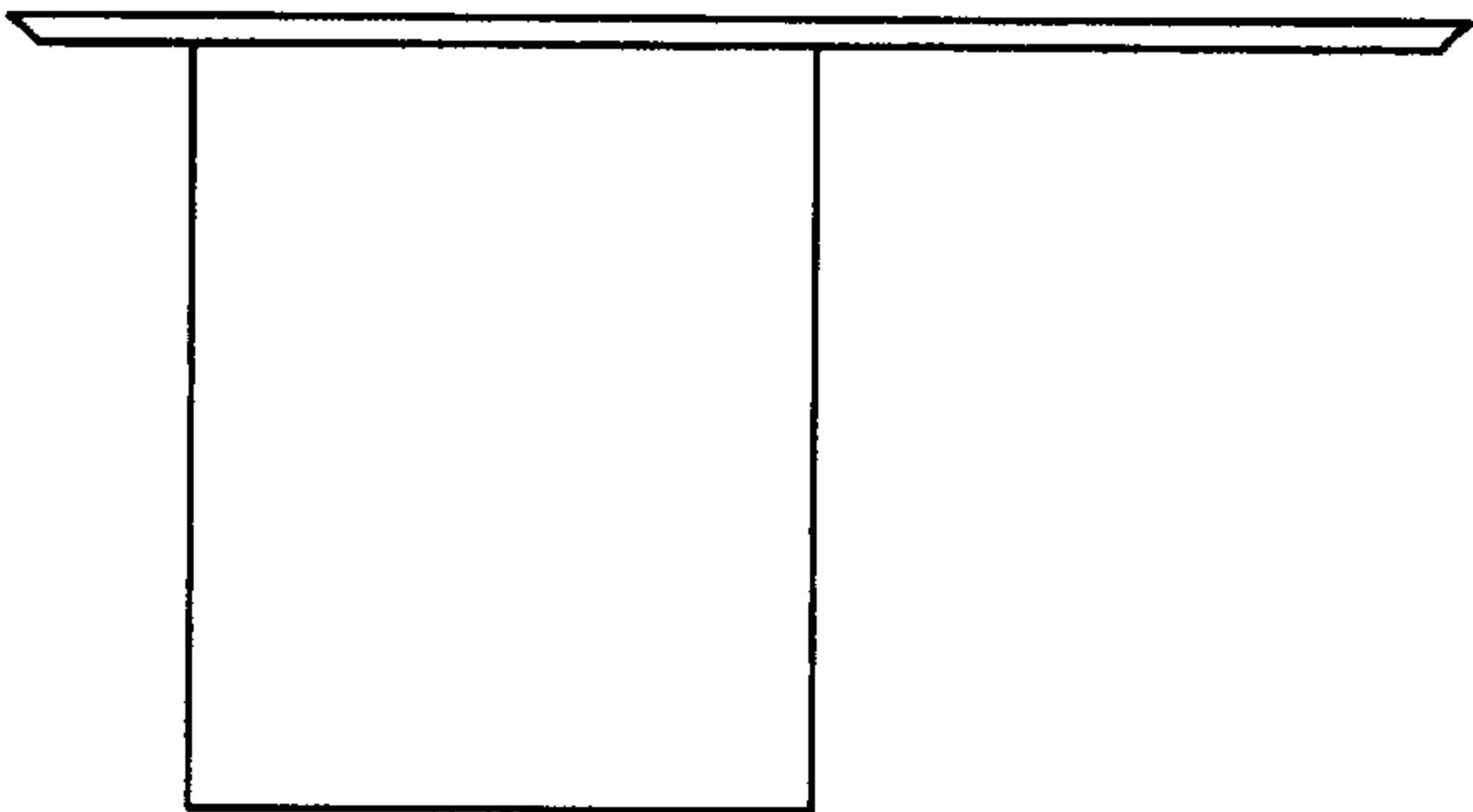
