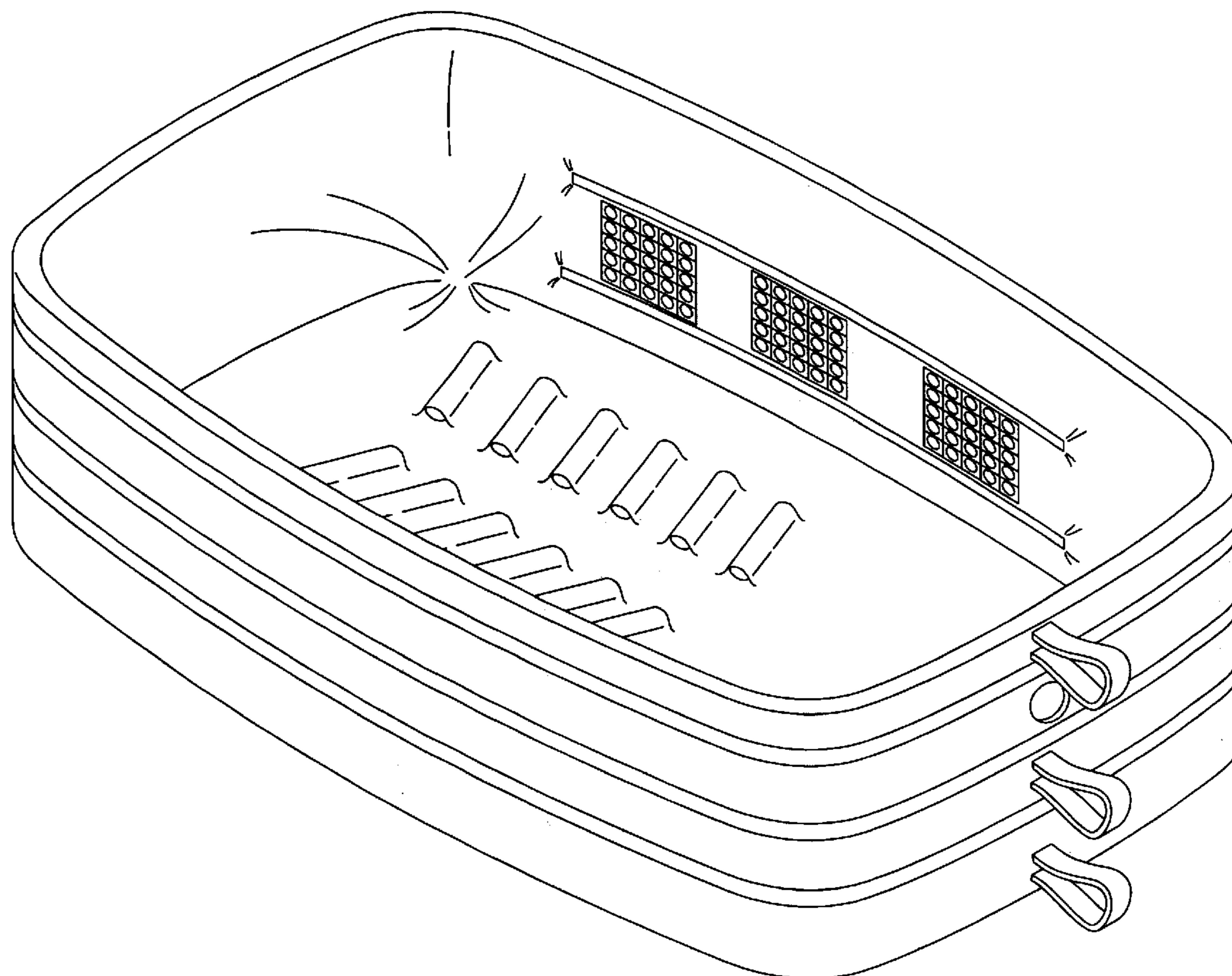

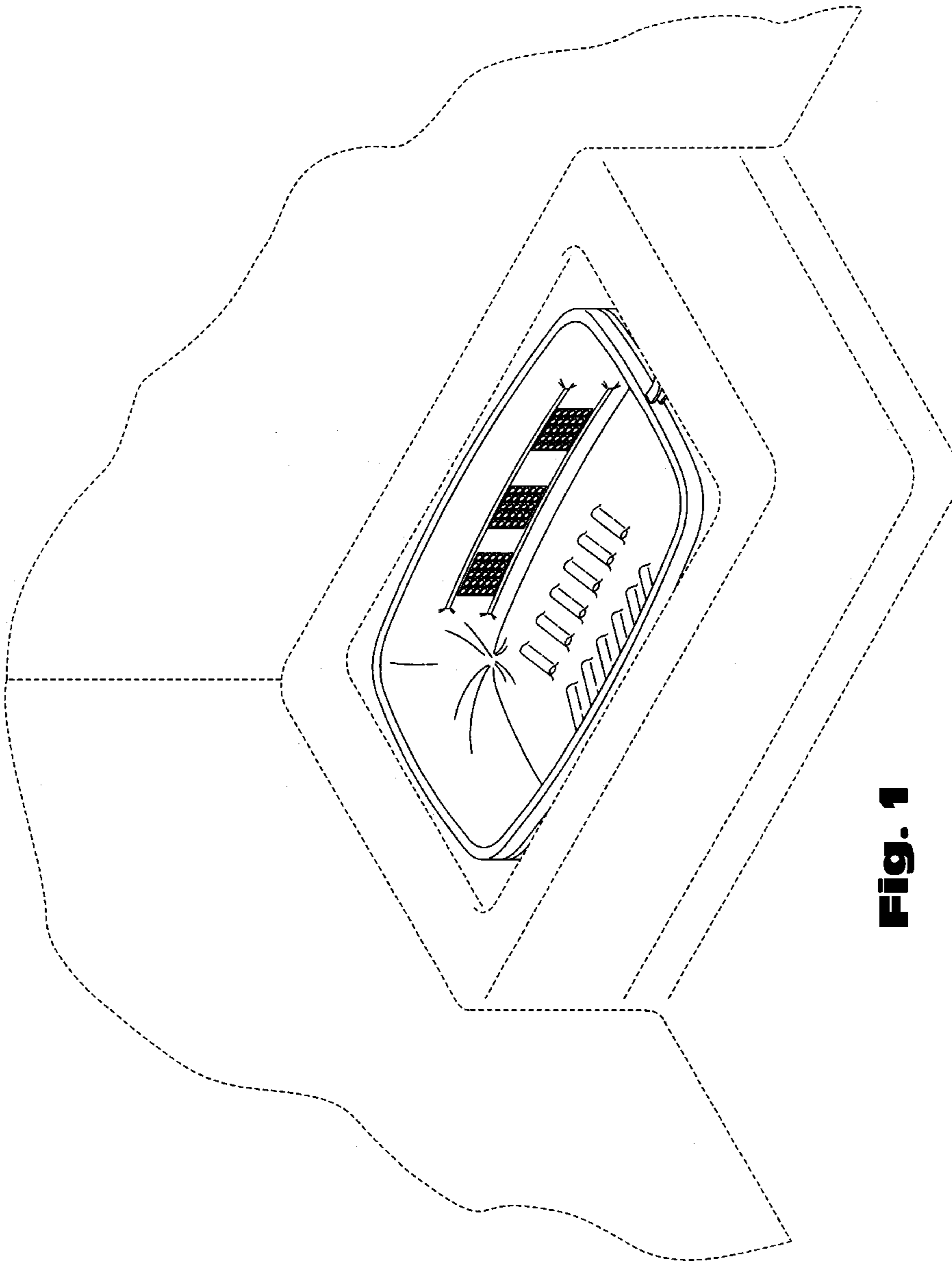
The ornamental design for the removable bathtub liner, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

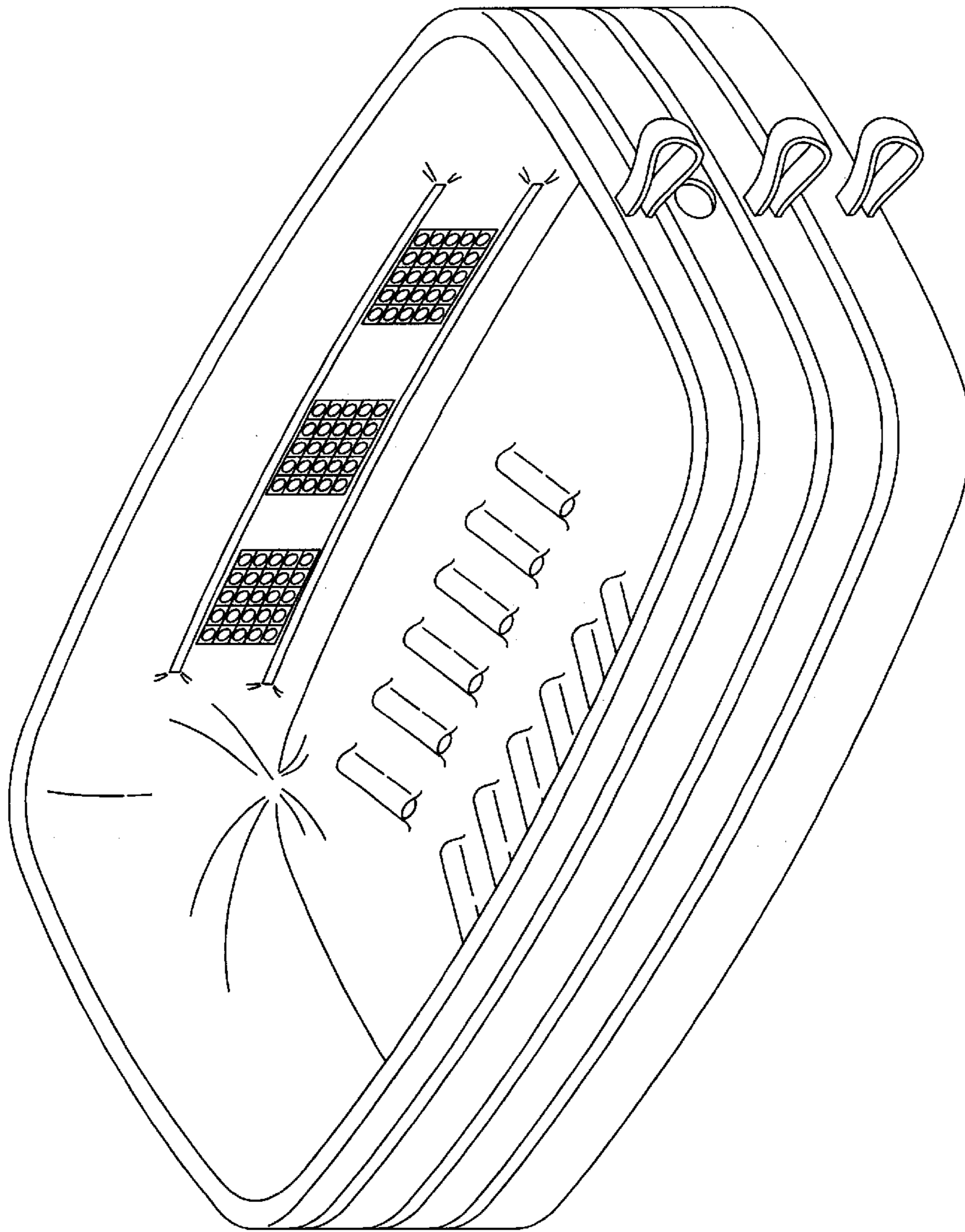
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the removable bathtub liner, showing my invention inside the bathtub;

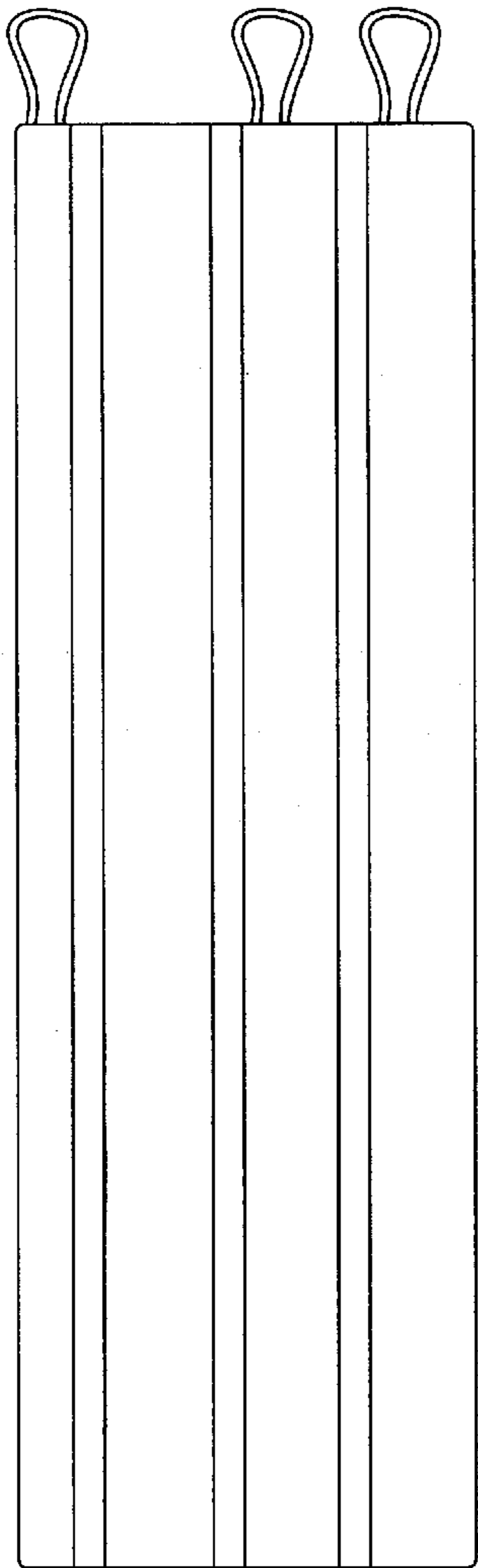




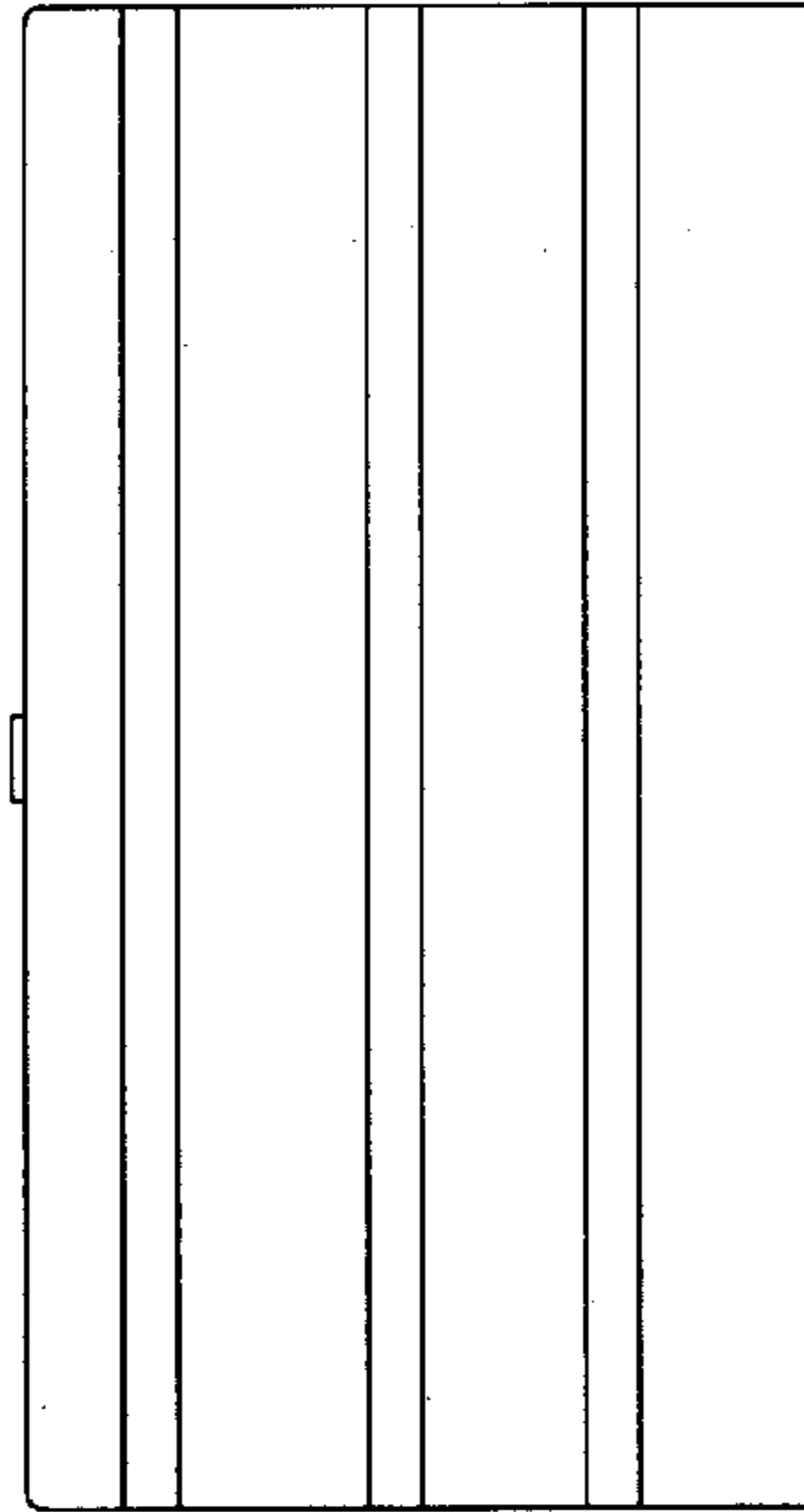

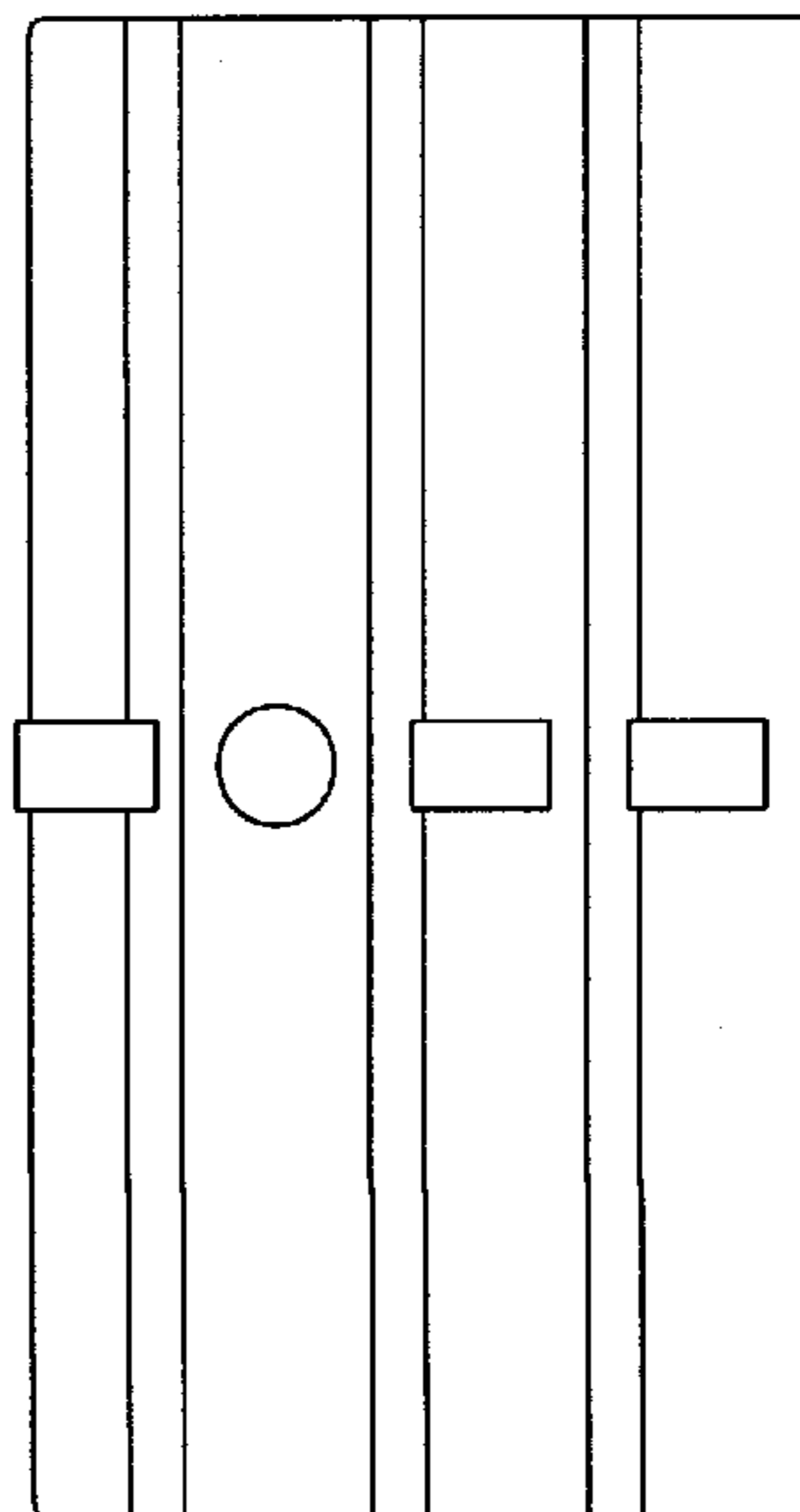

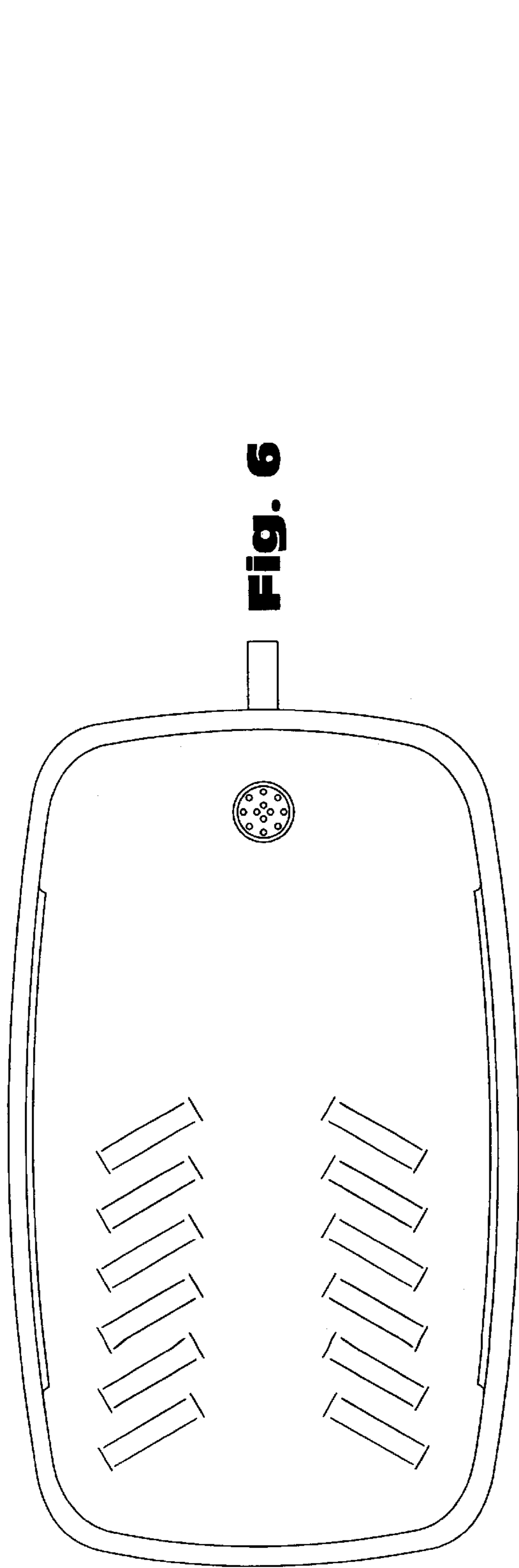

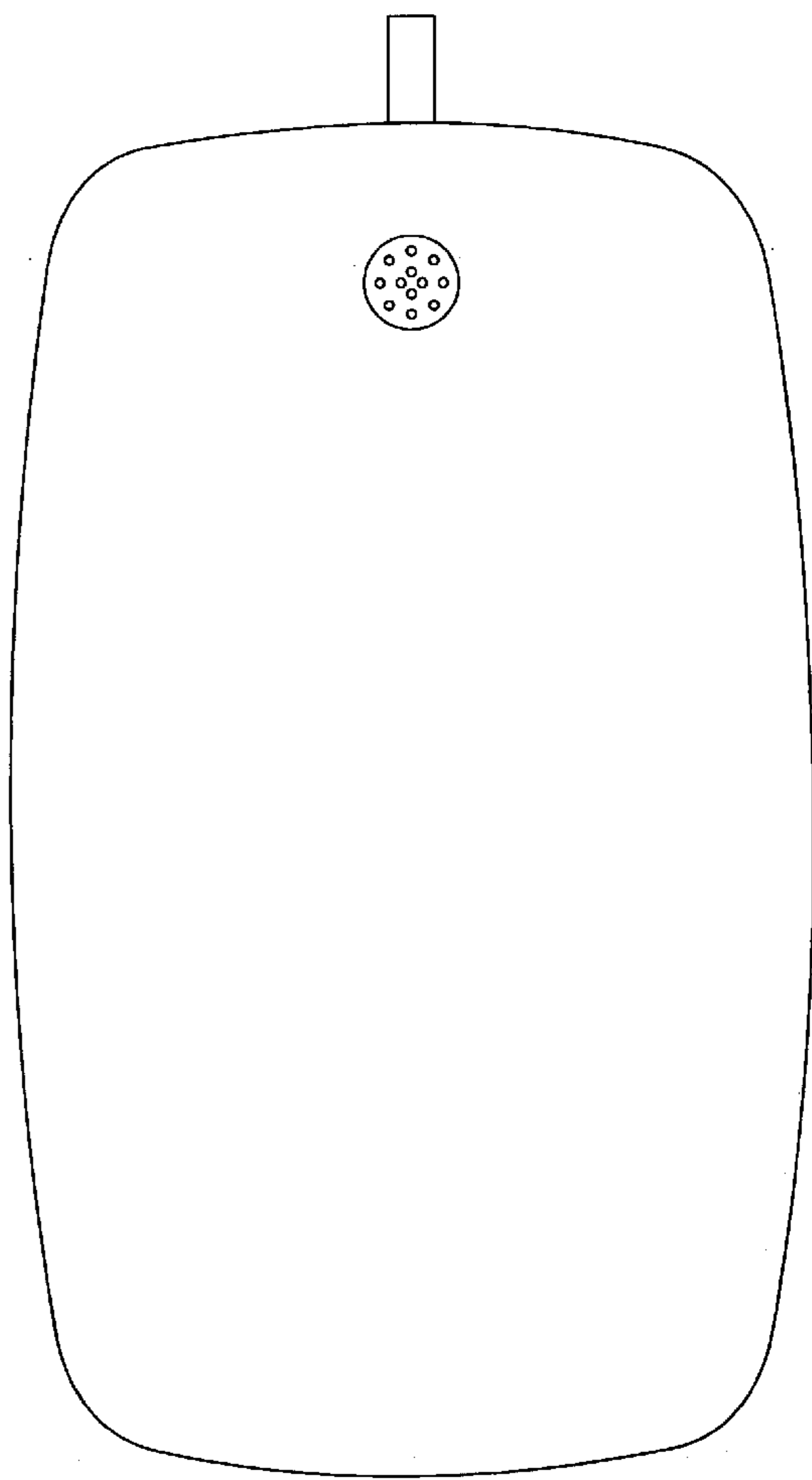
