(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a side cover for a motorcycle transmission, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a side cover for a motorcycle transmission embodying the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the side cover for a motorcycle transmission shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the side cover for a motorcycle transmission shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a side view of the side cover for a motorcycle transmission shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is an opposite side view of the side cover for a motorcycle transmission shown in FIG. 1.

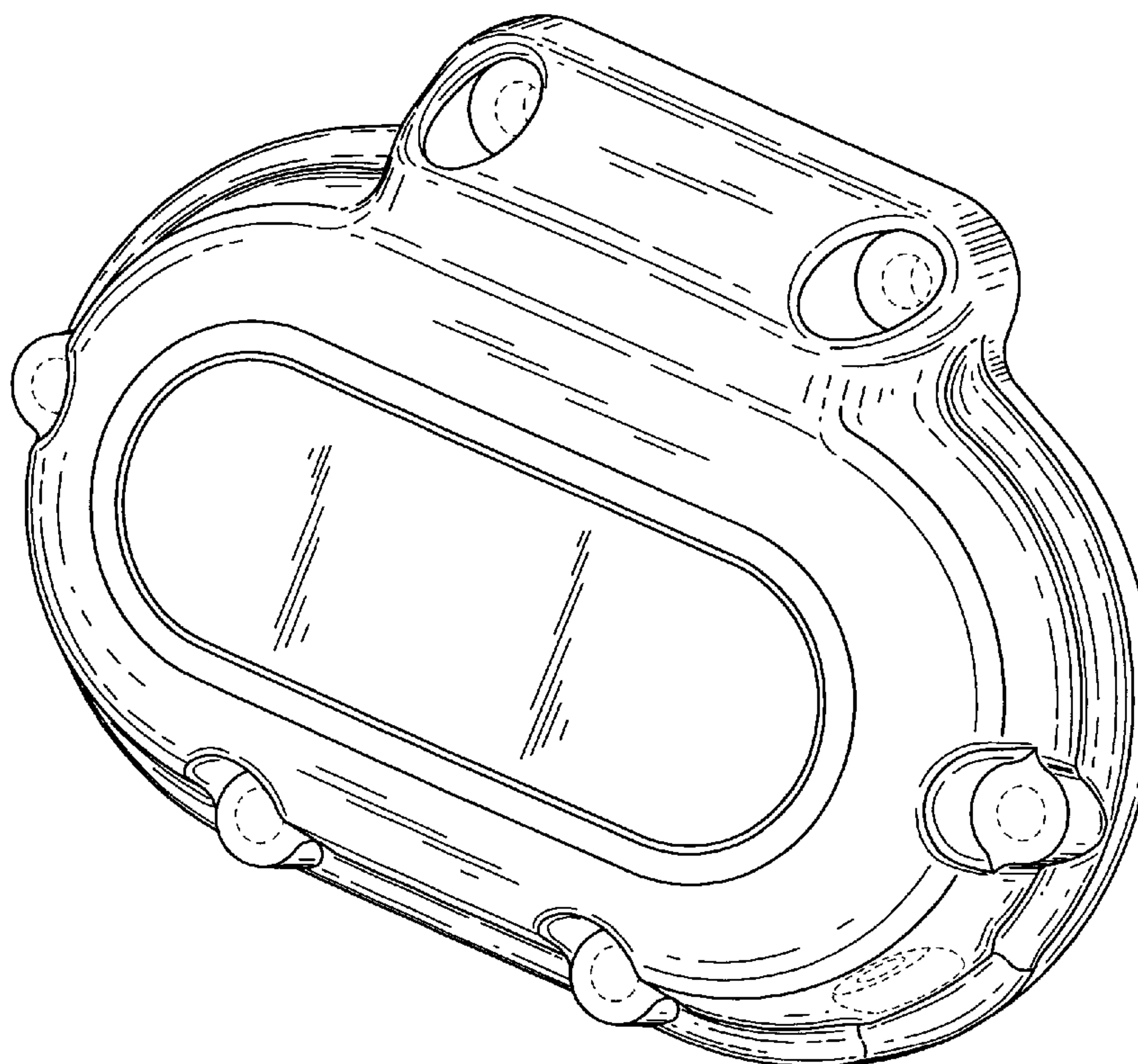
FIG. 6 is a top view of the side cover for a motorcycle transmission shown in FIG. 1; and,

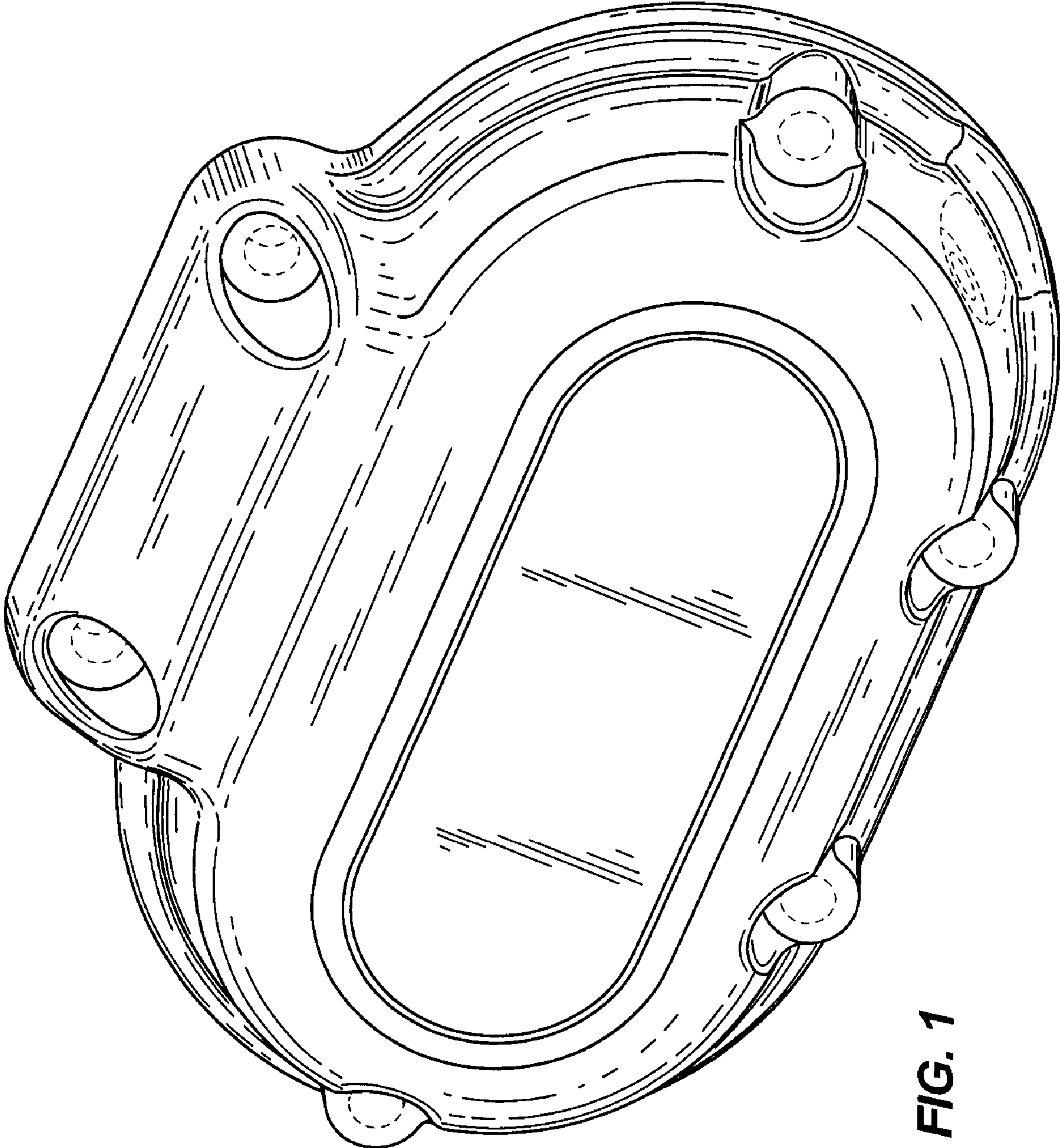
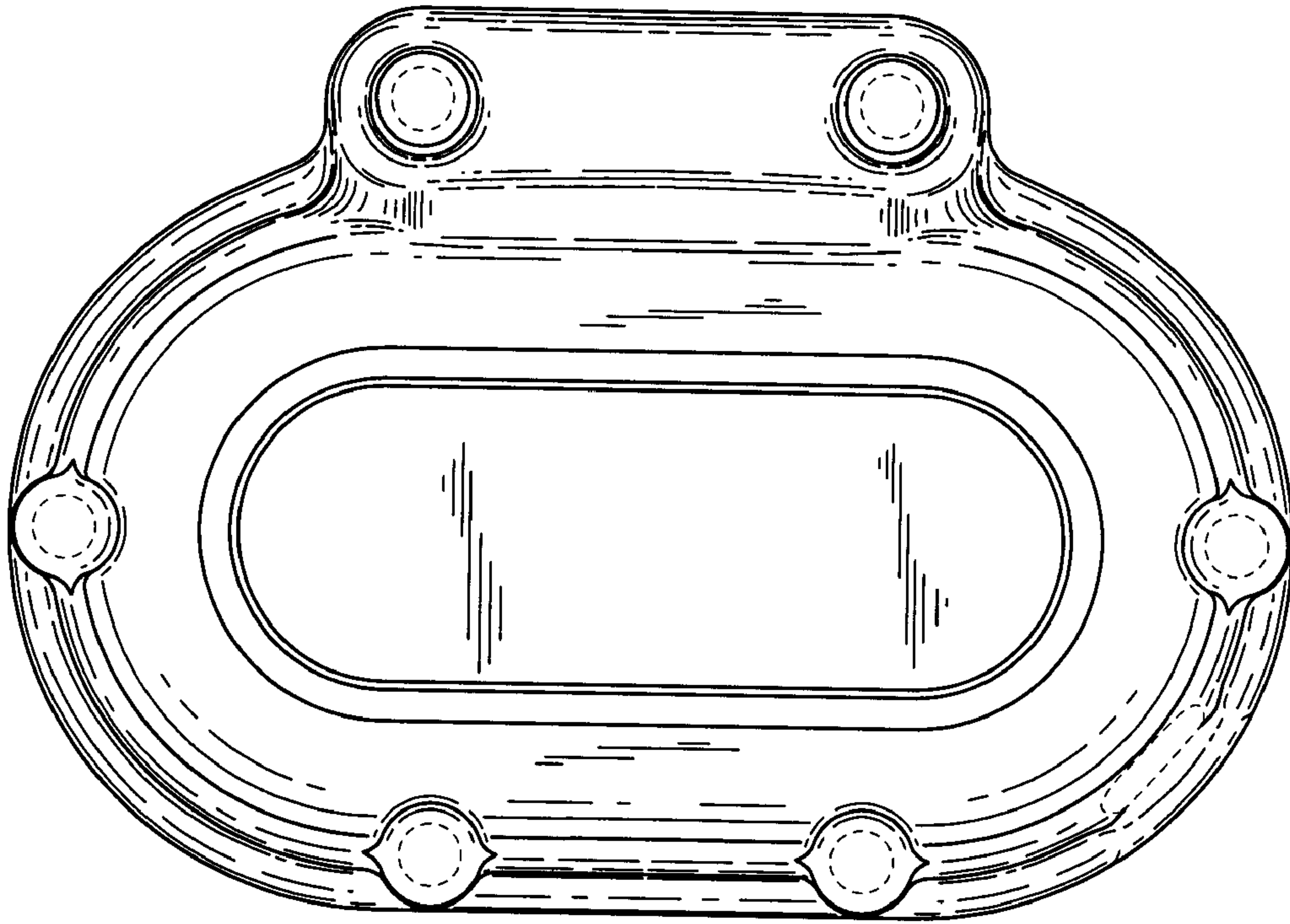
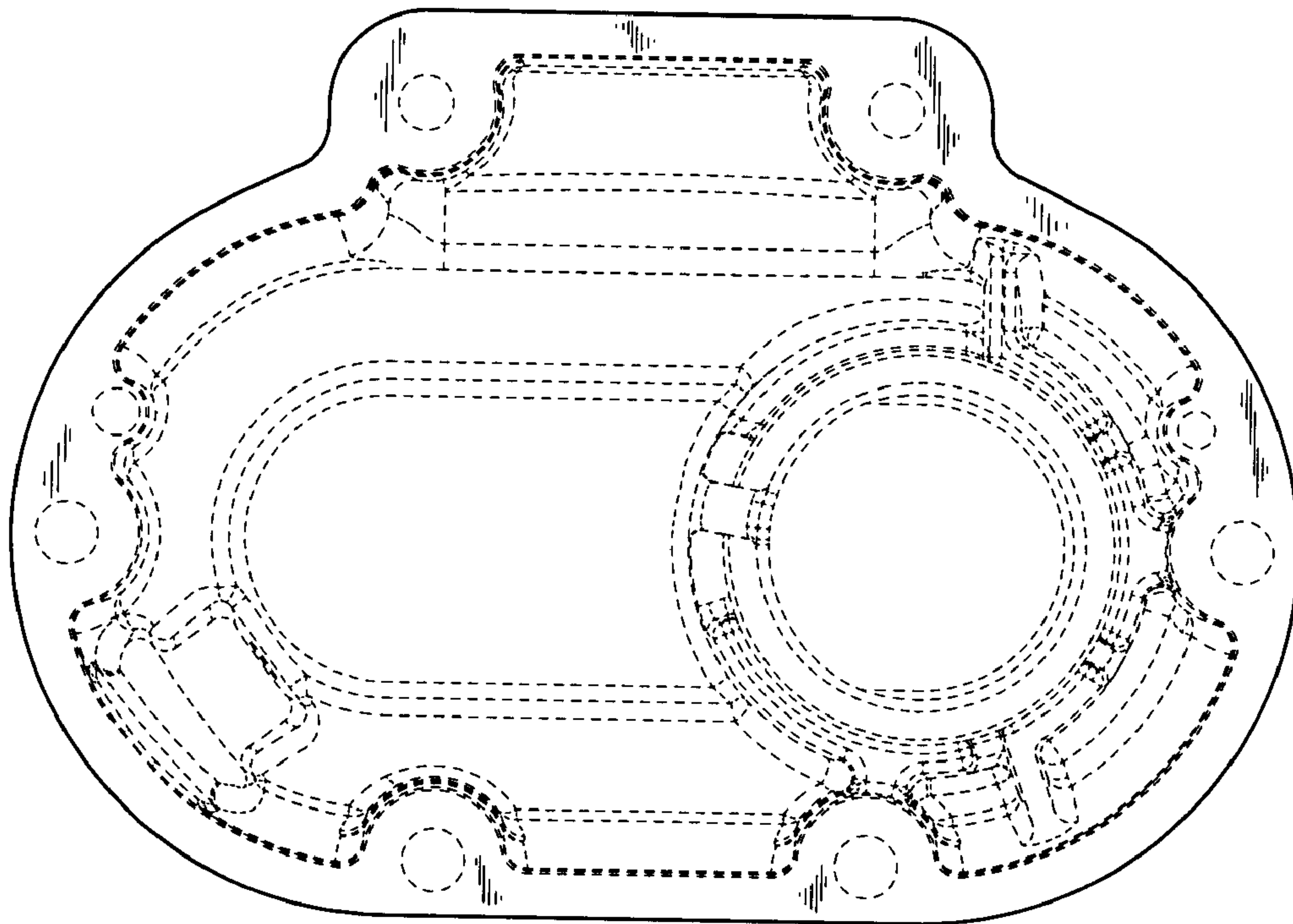

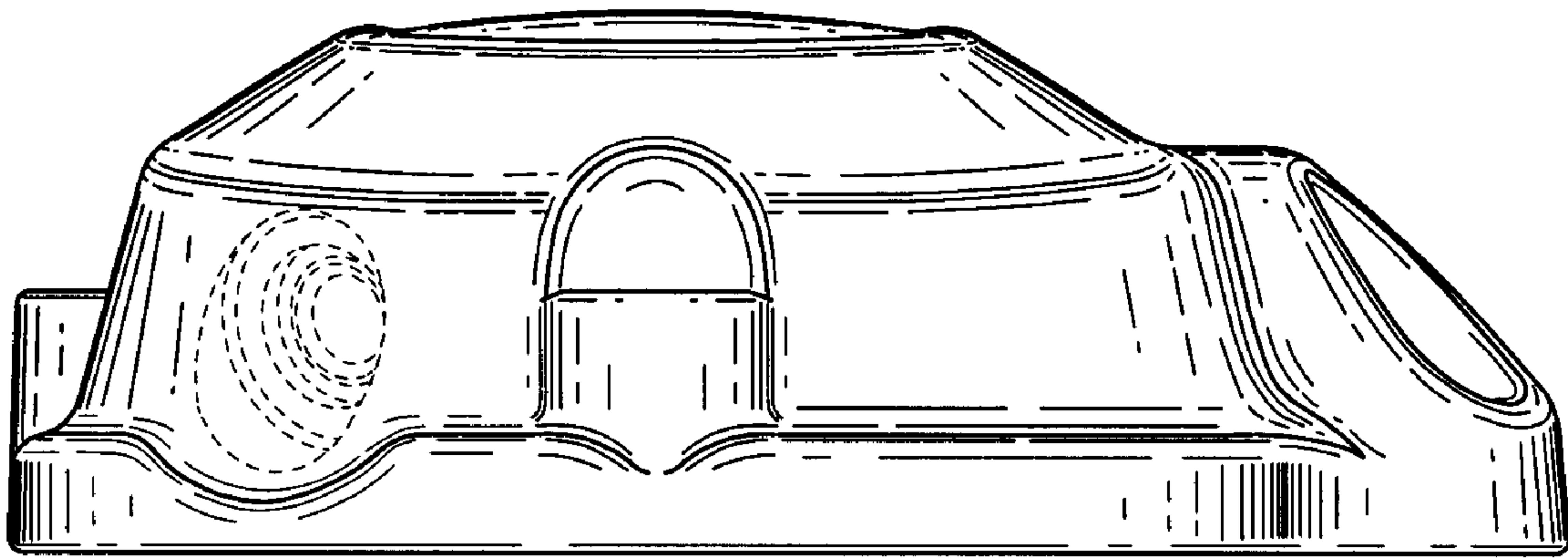




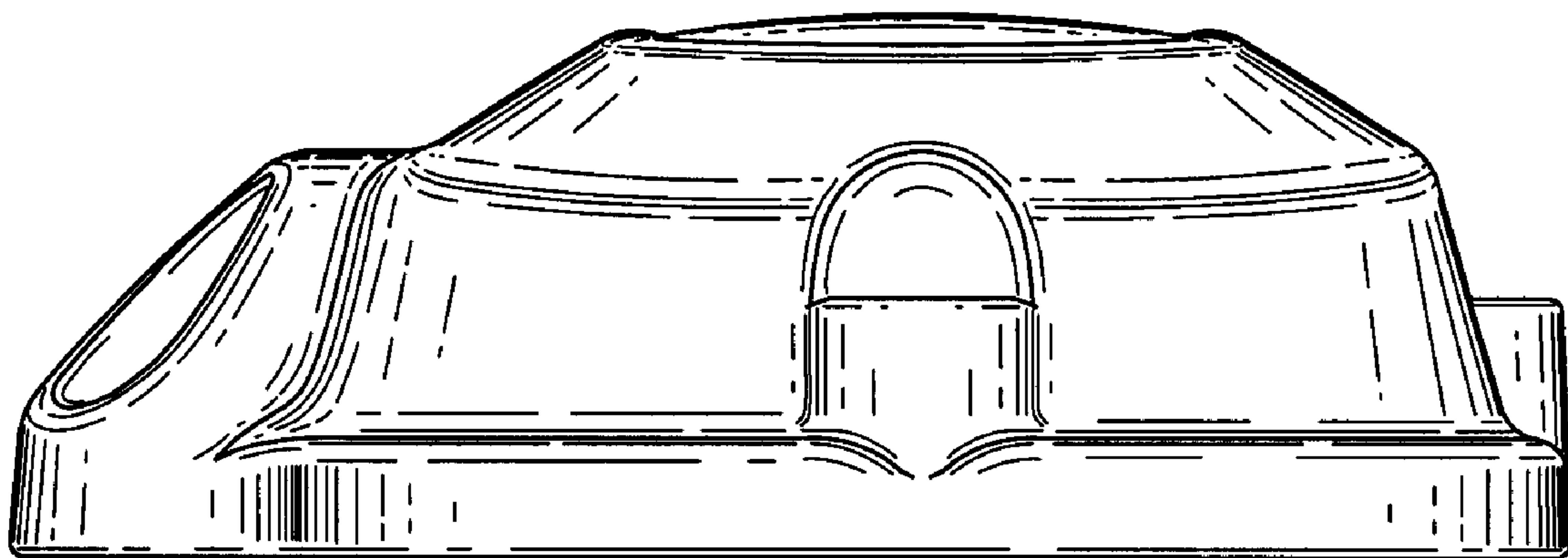

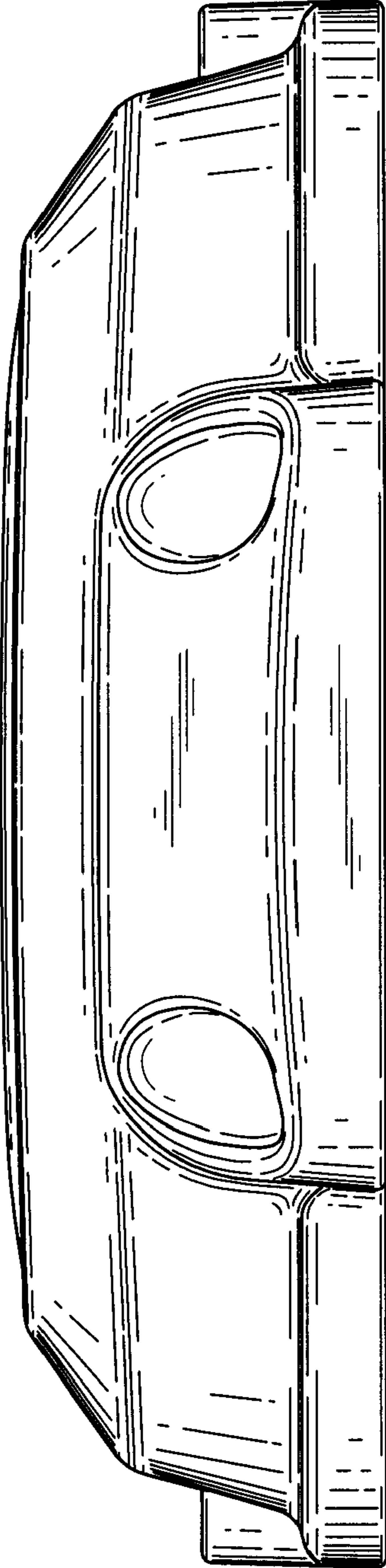

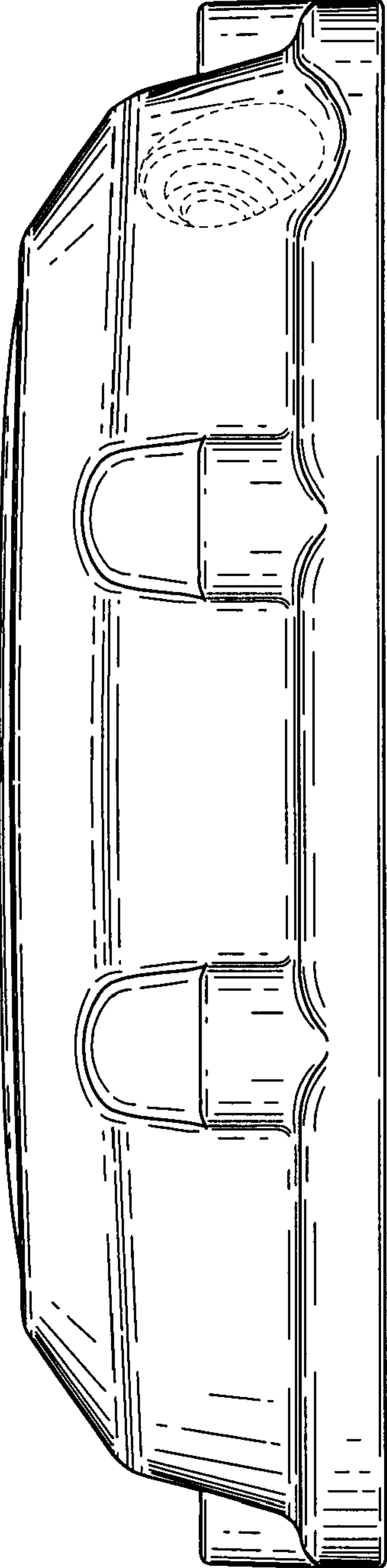
