shown in FIG. 1.

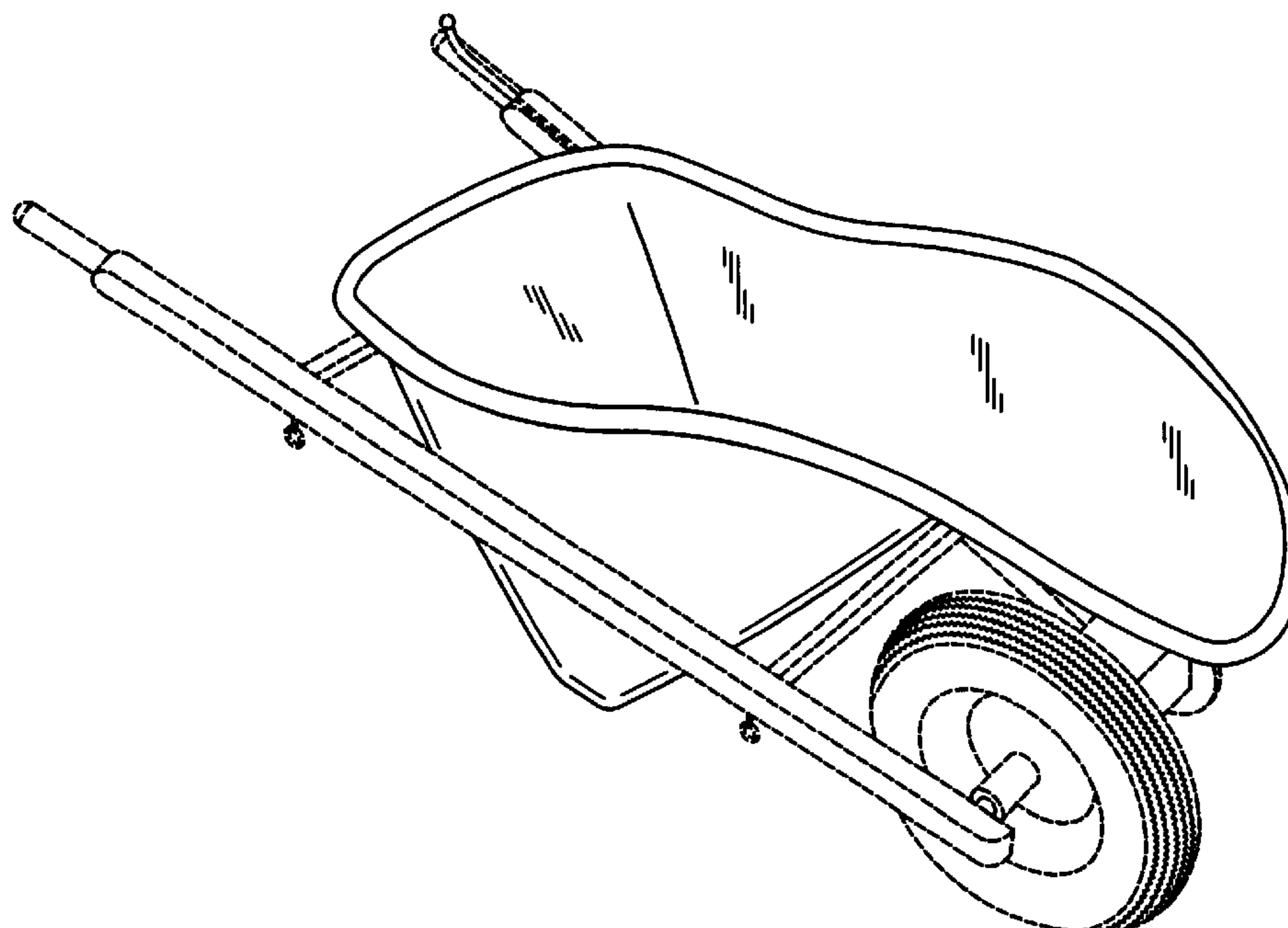
FIG. 4 is a top perspective view of the embodiment shown

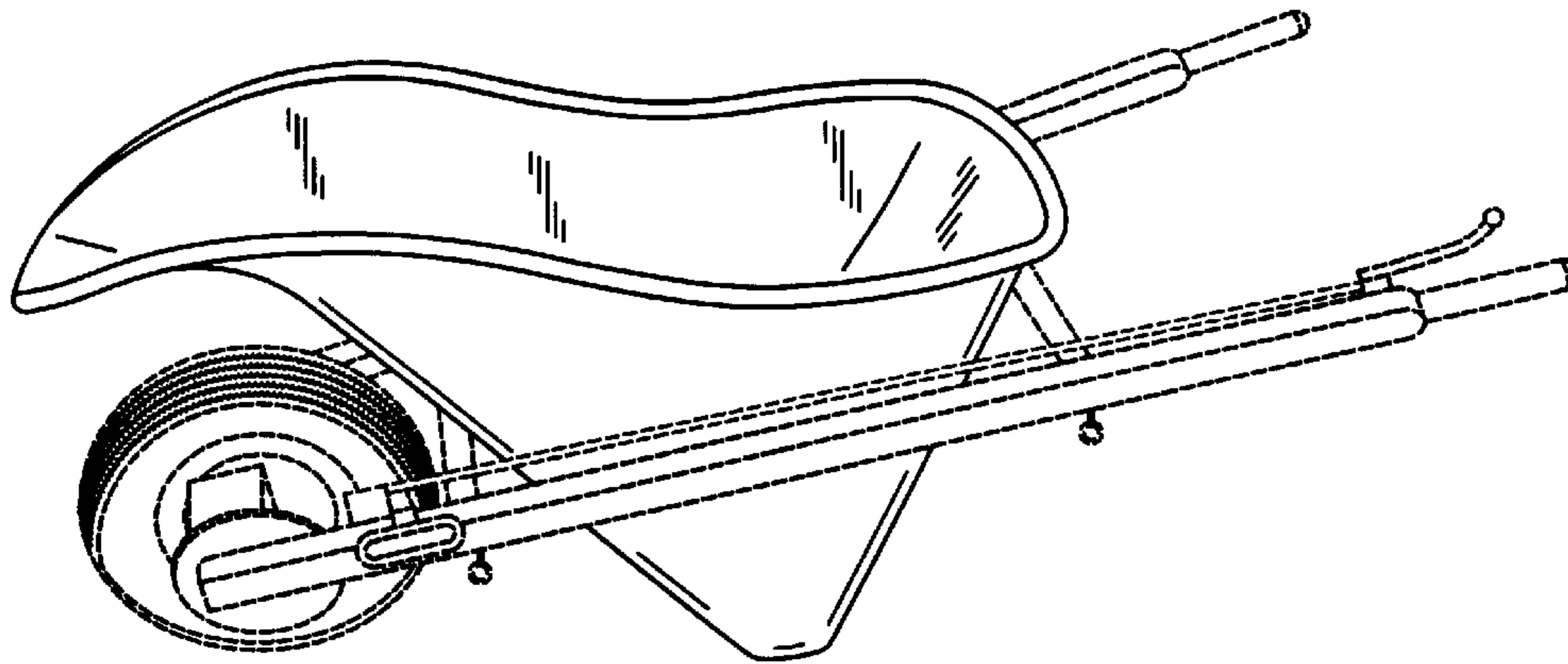

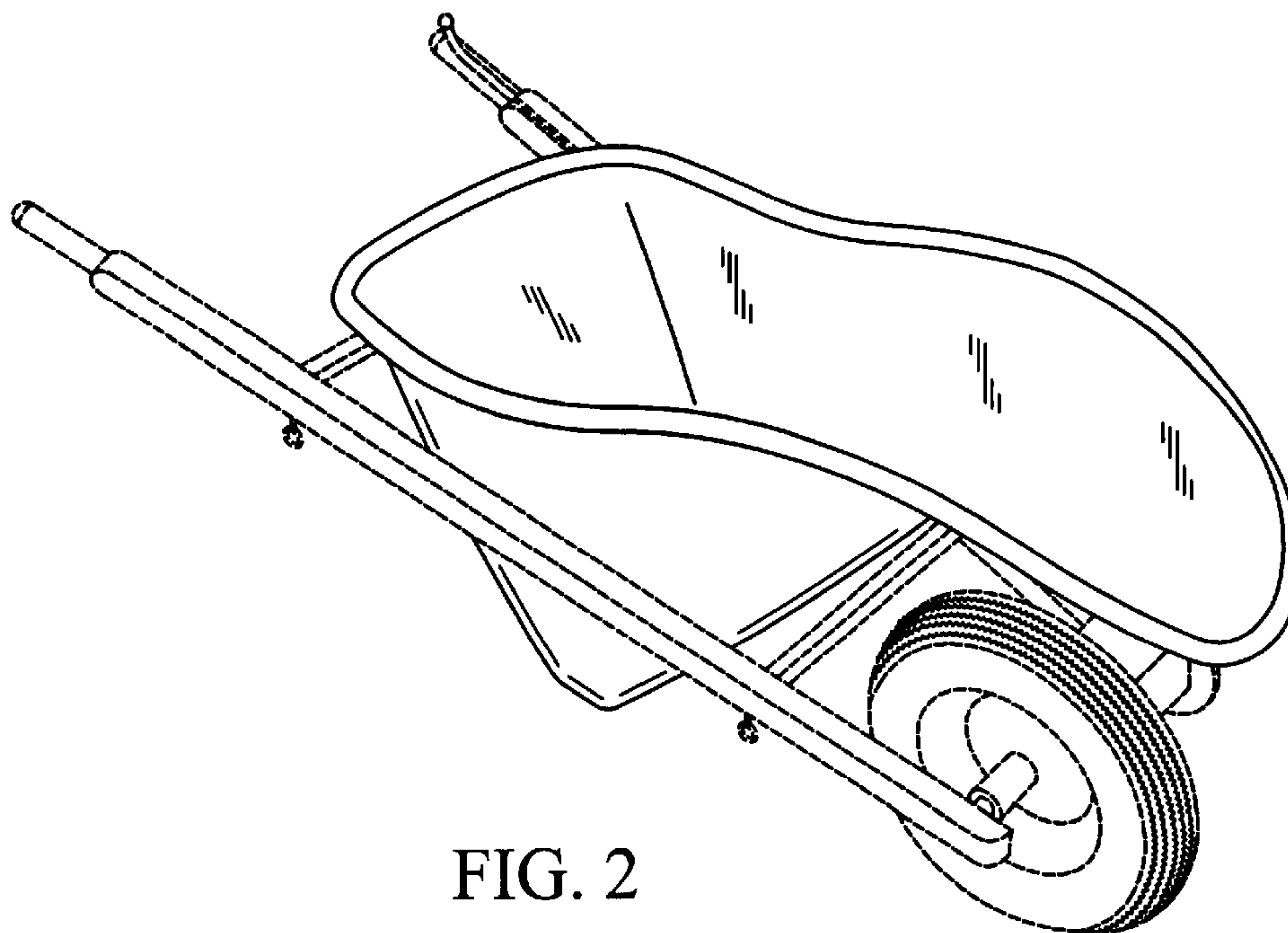

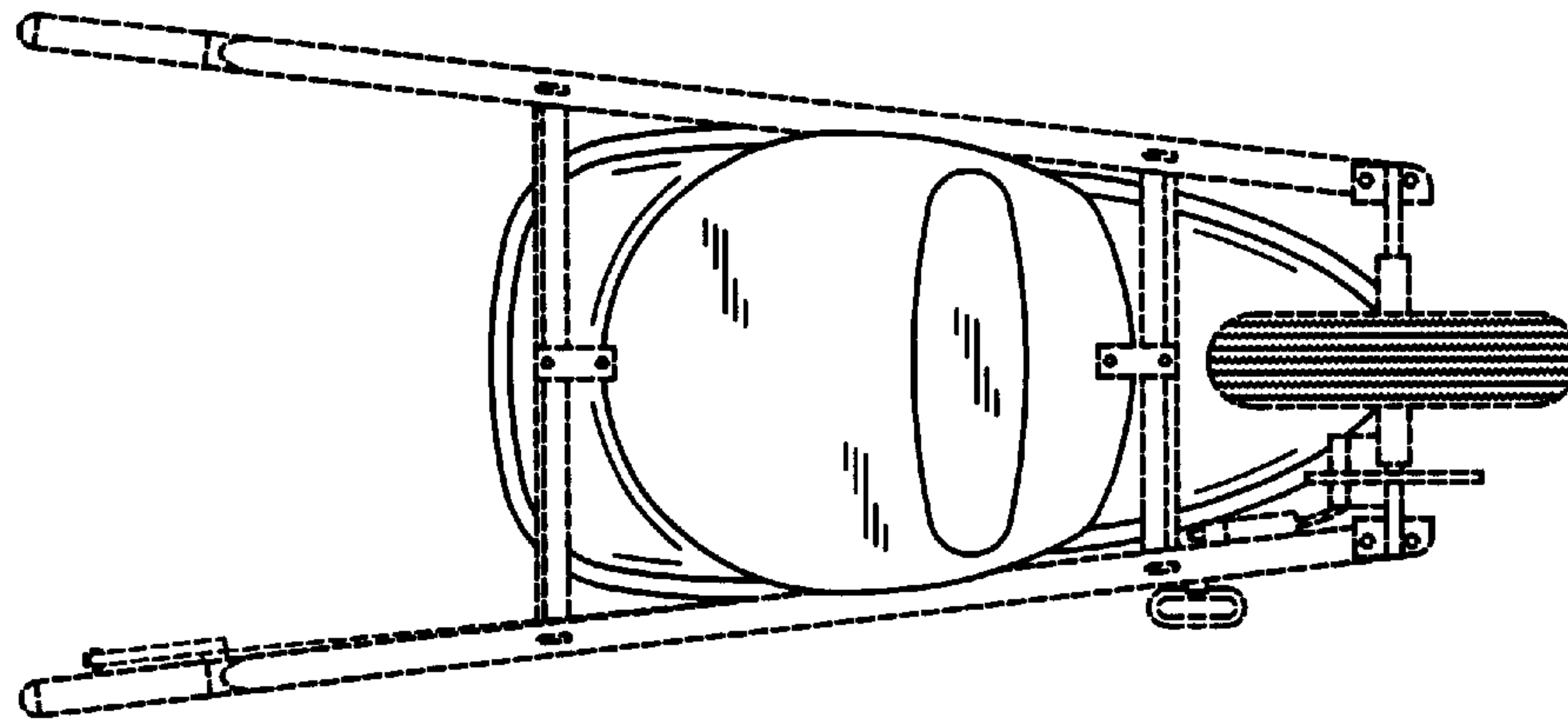

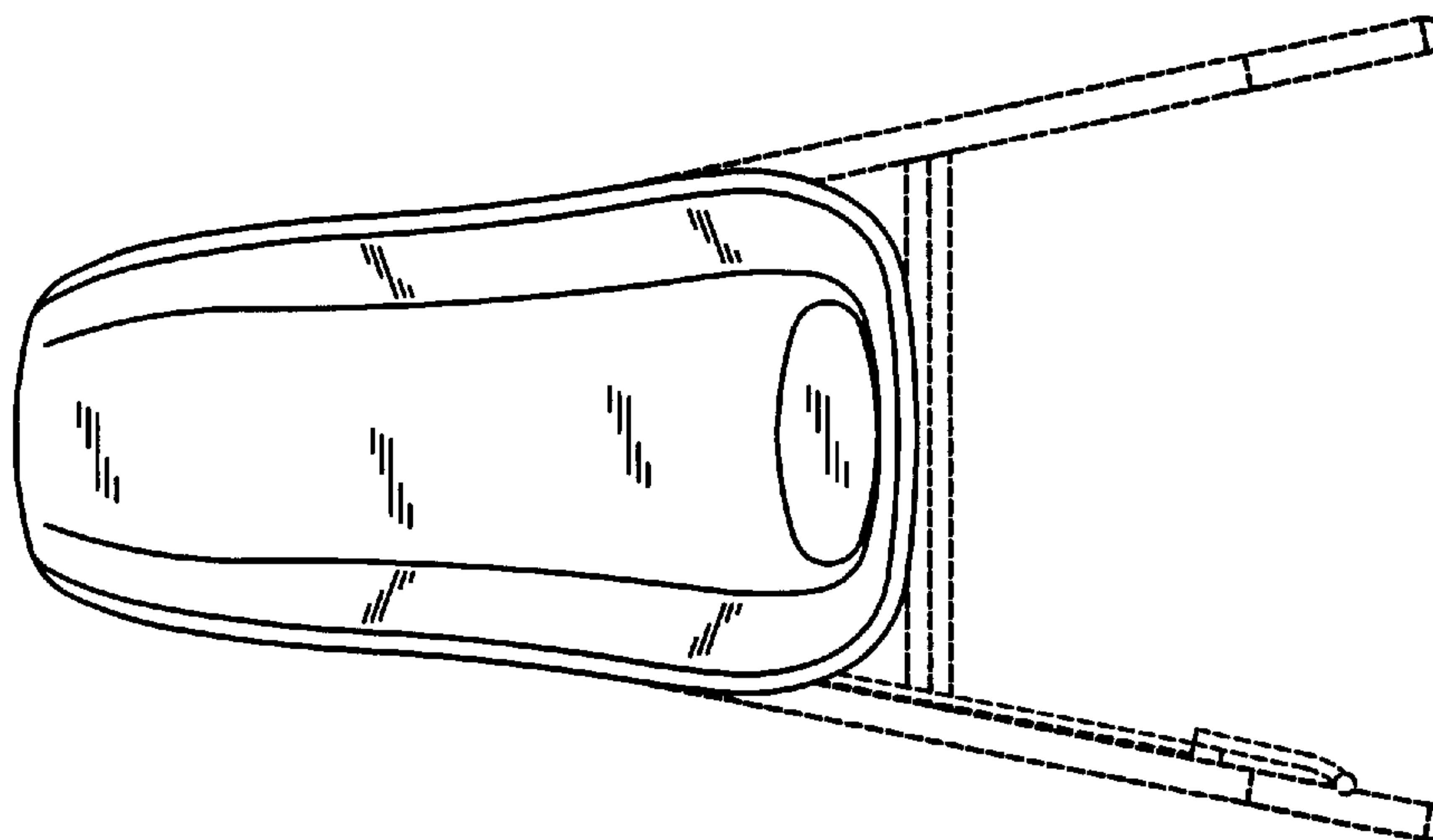

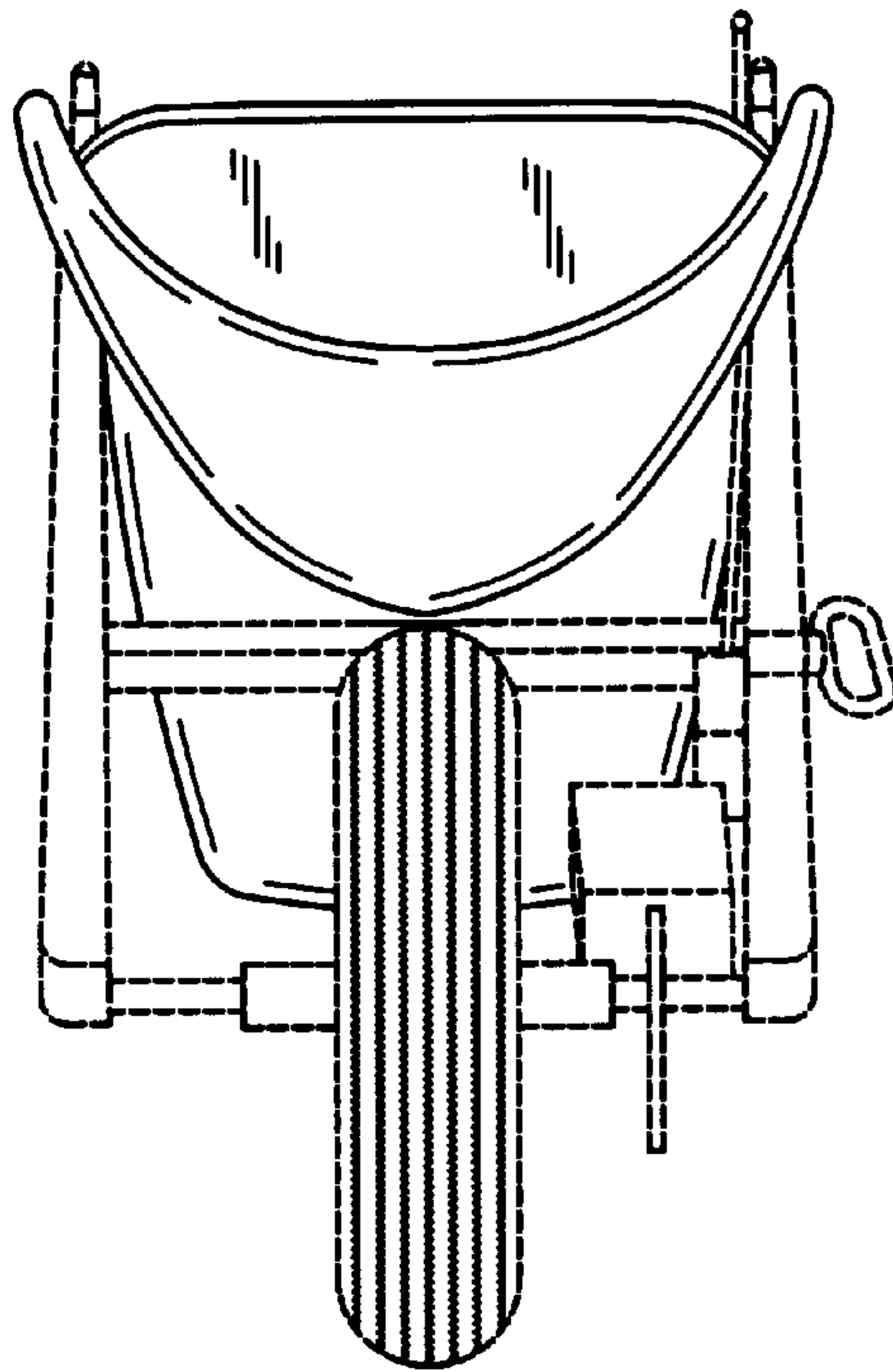

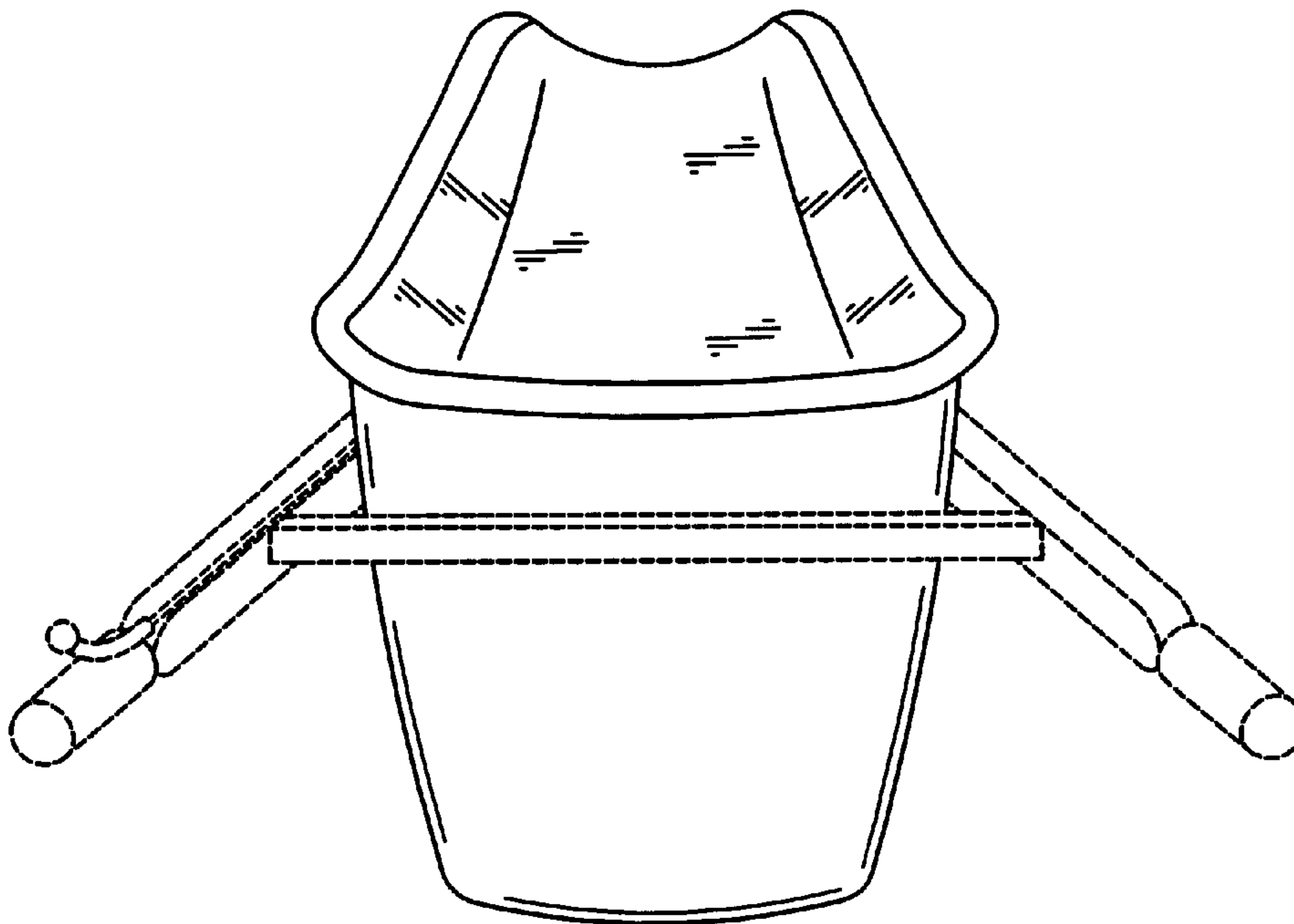
