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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a remote control for a toilet seat with bidet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a remote control for a toilet seat with bidet of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a partial enlarged view of the liquid crystal display portion shown separately for clarity;

FIG. 9 is a front view showing the article in a lighted state; and,

FIG. 10 is a partial enlarged view of the liquid crystal display portion in a lighted state shown separately for clarity.

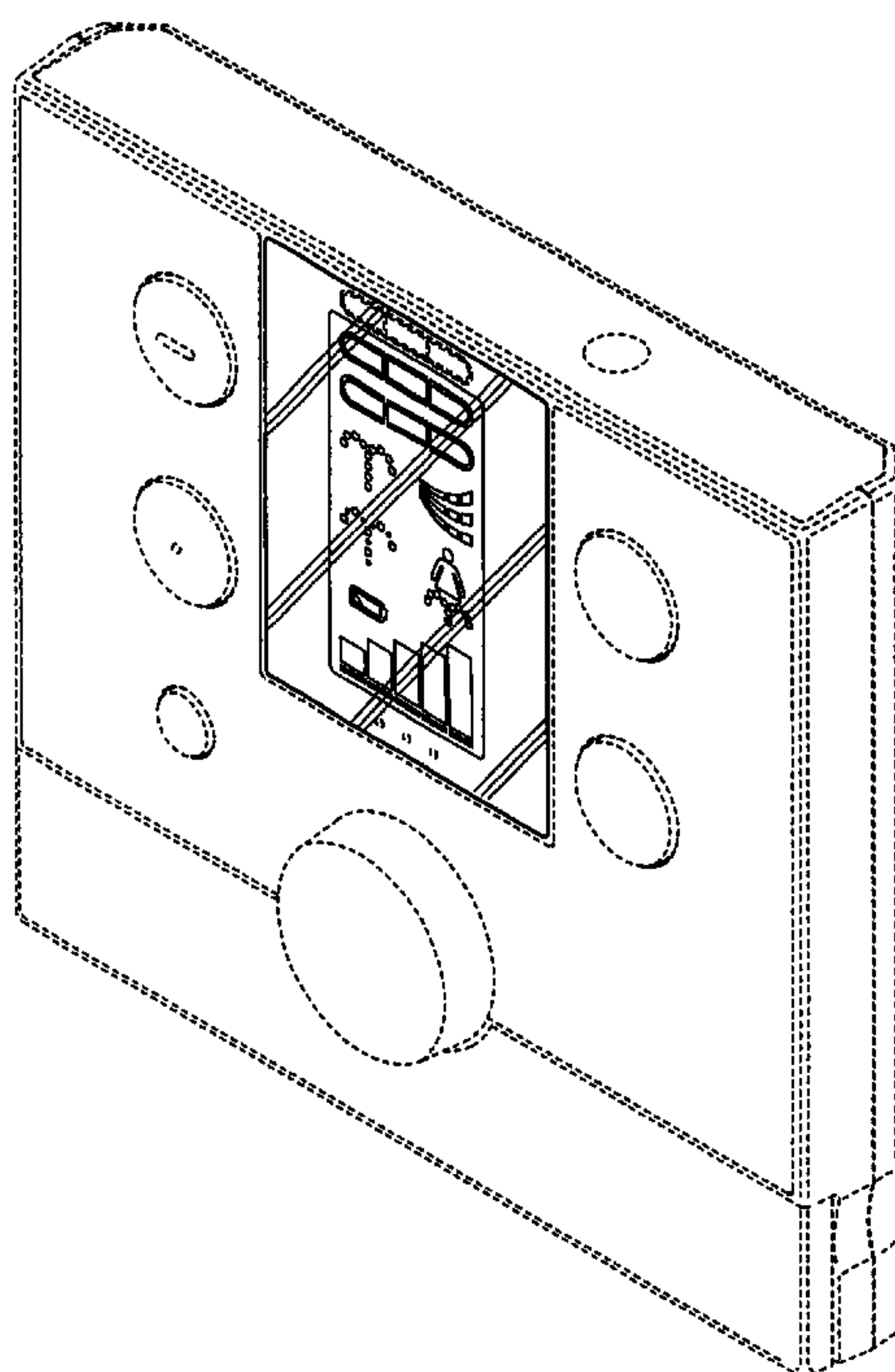

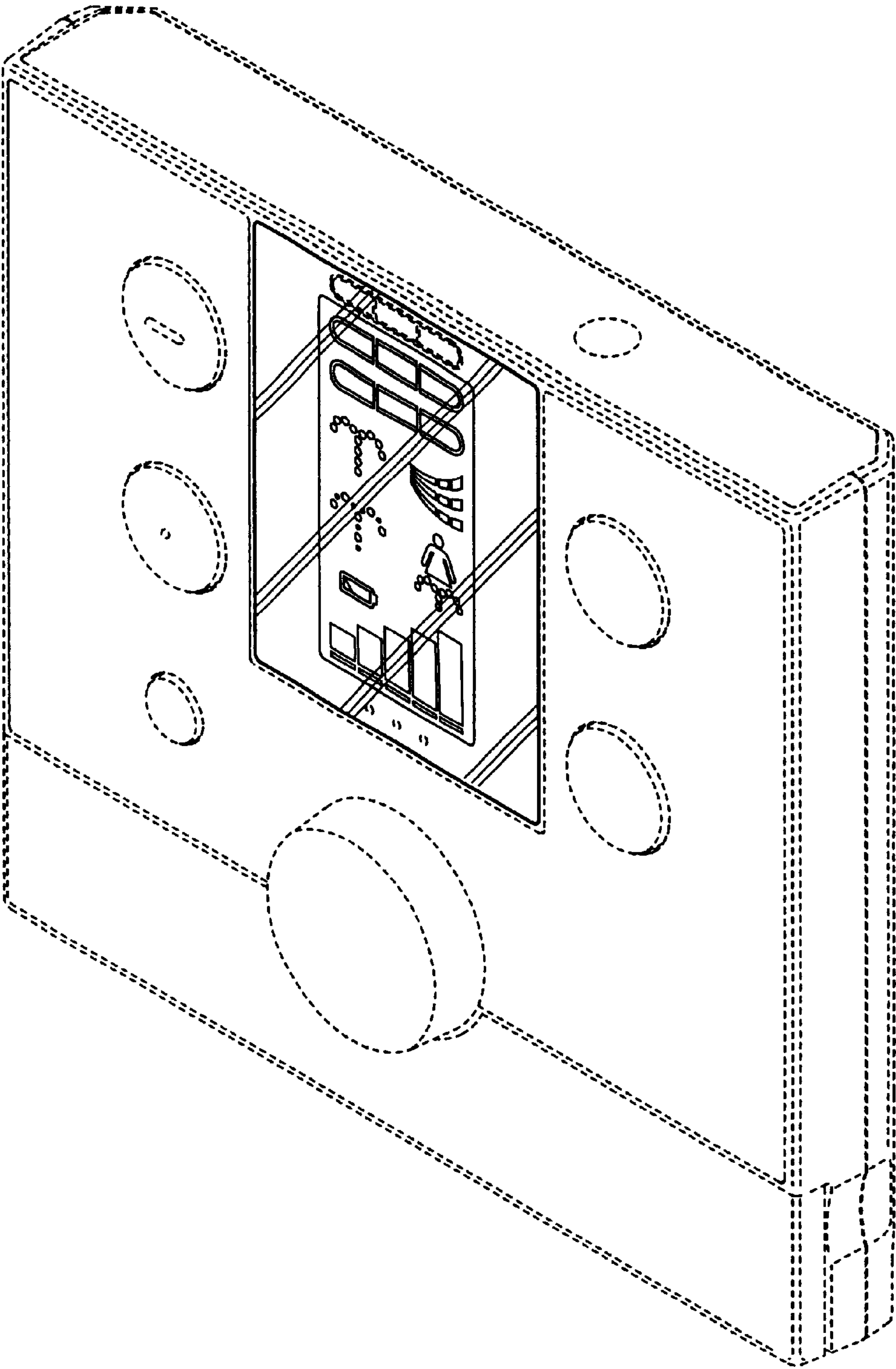

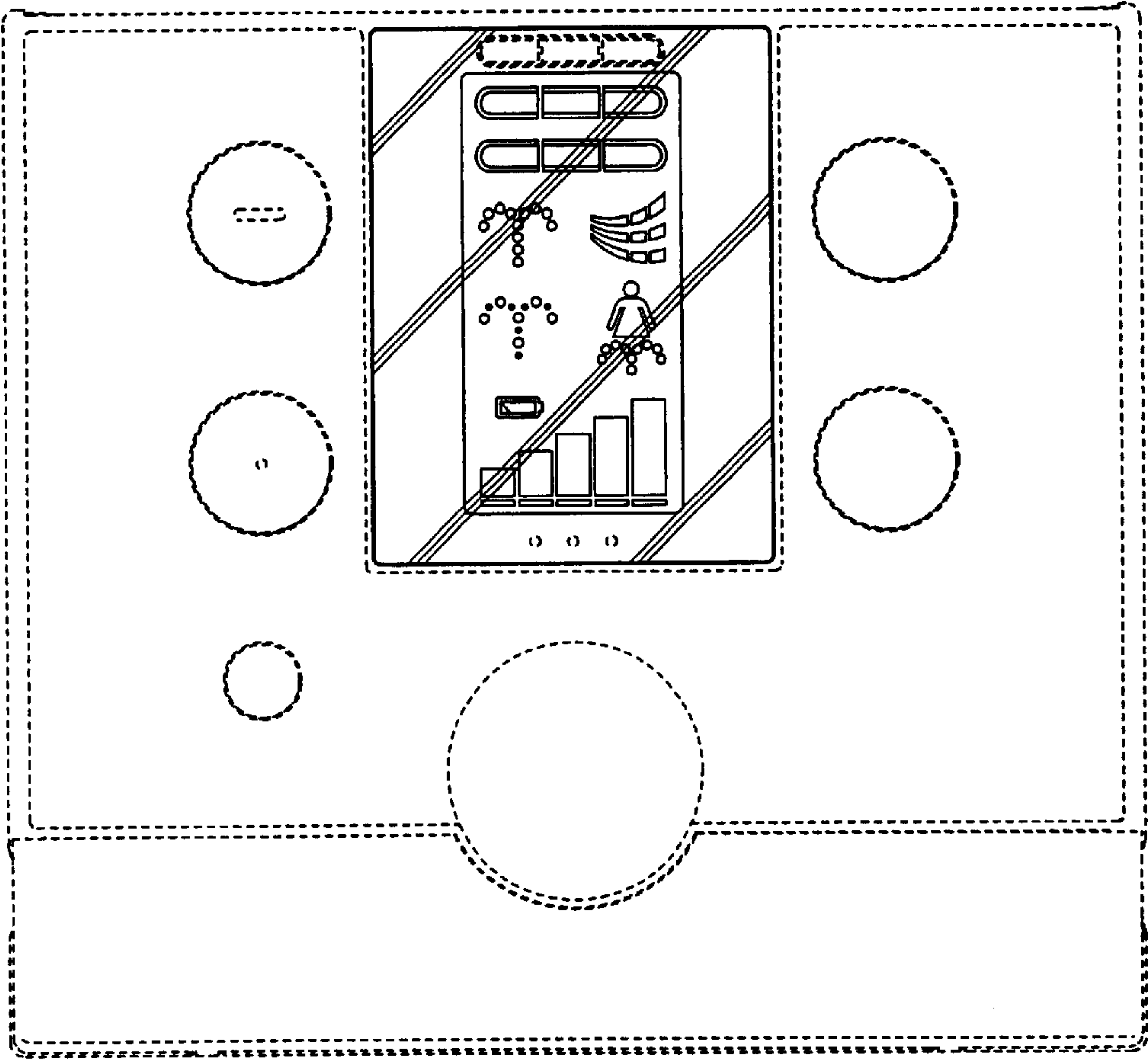

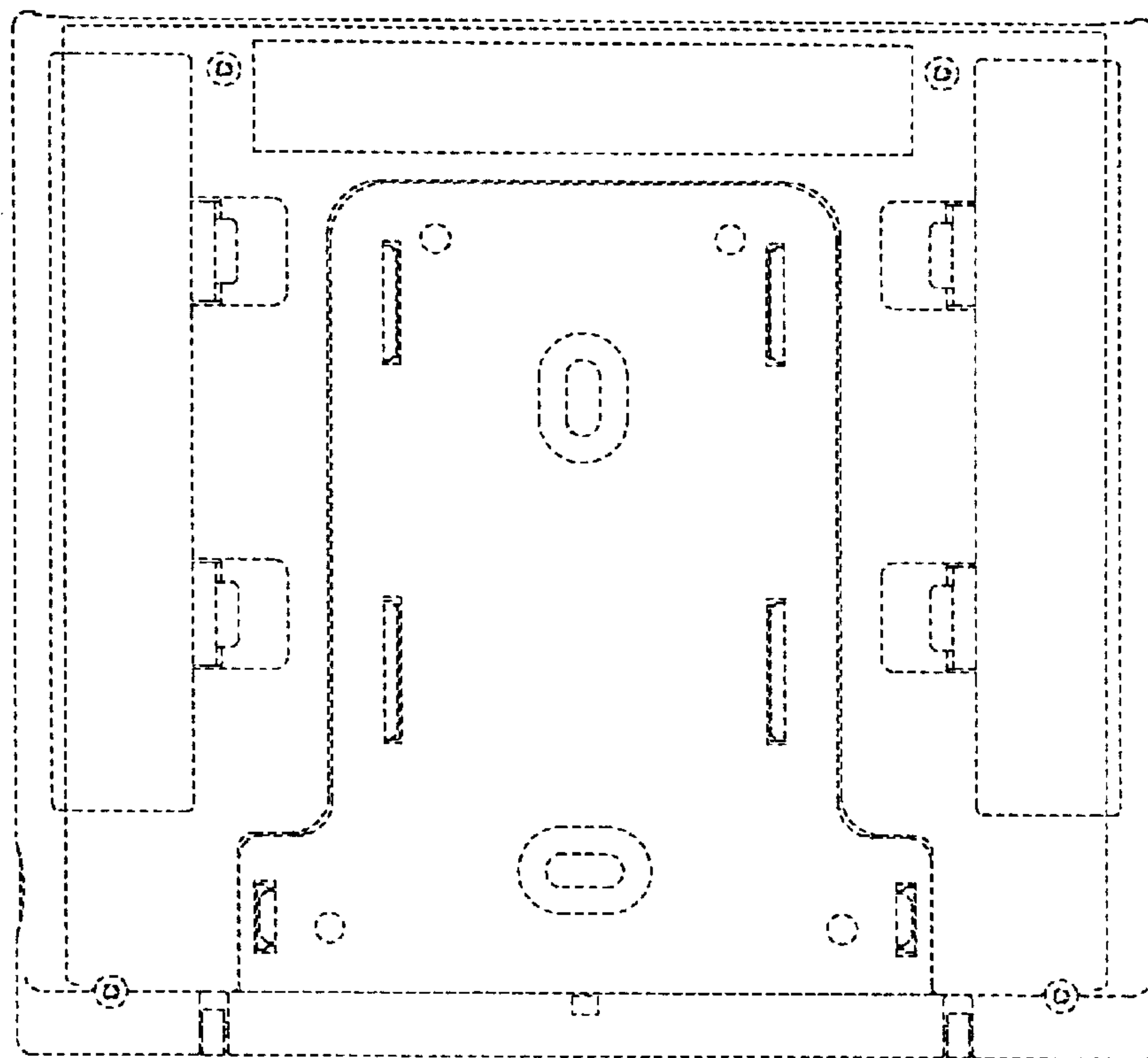

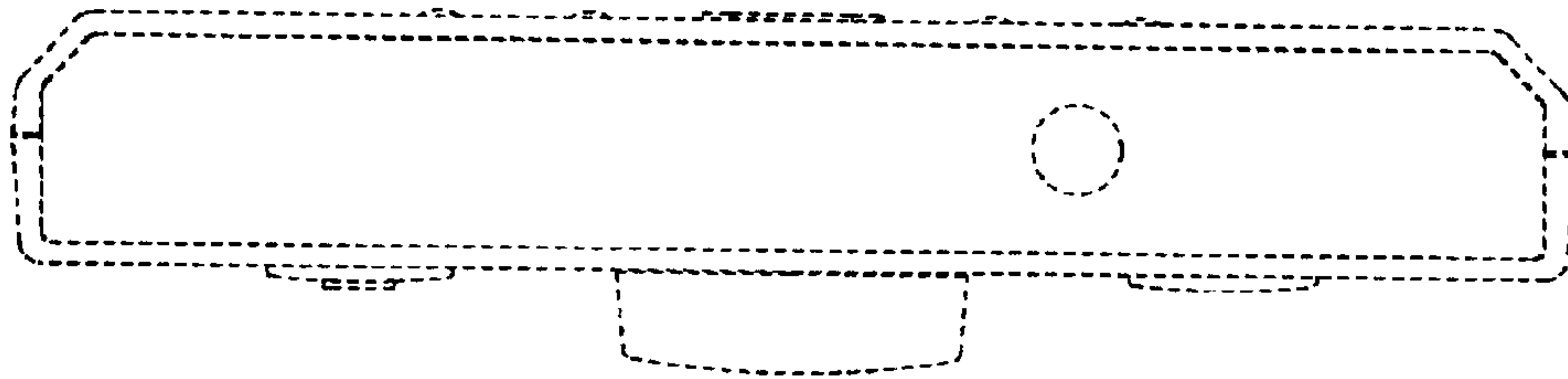

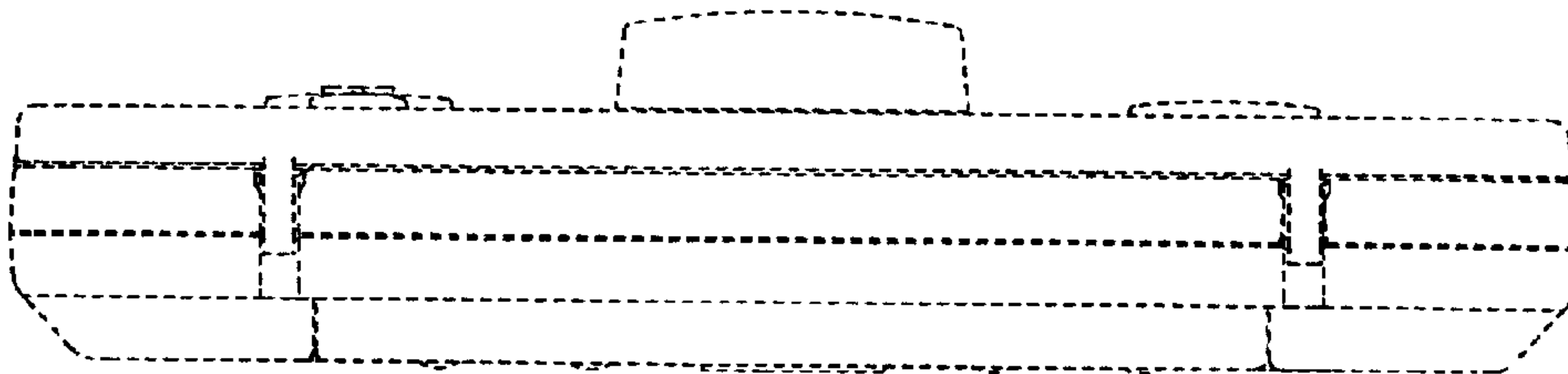

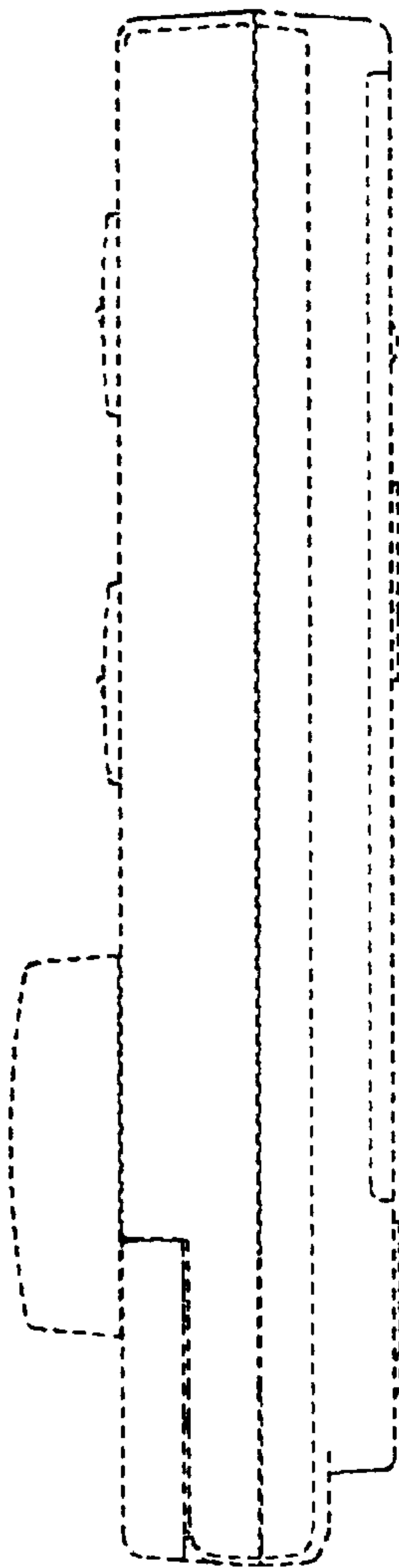

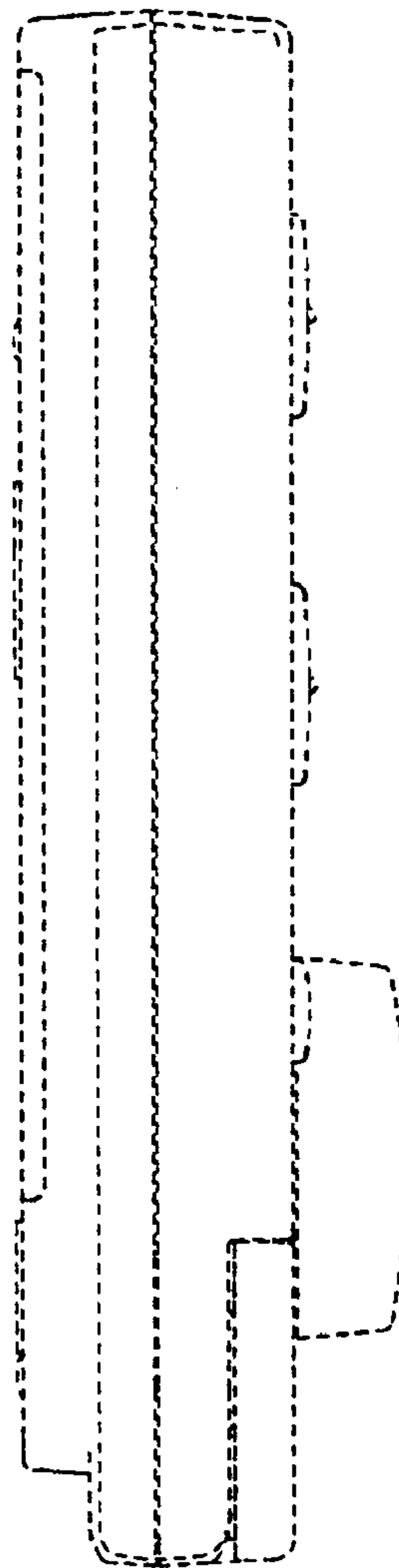

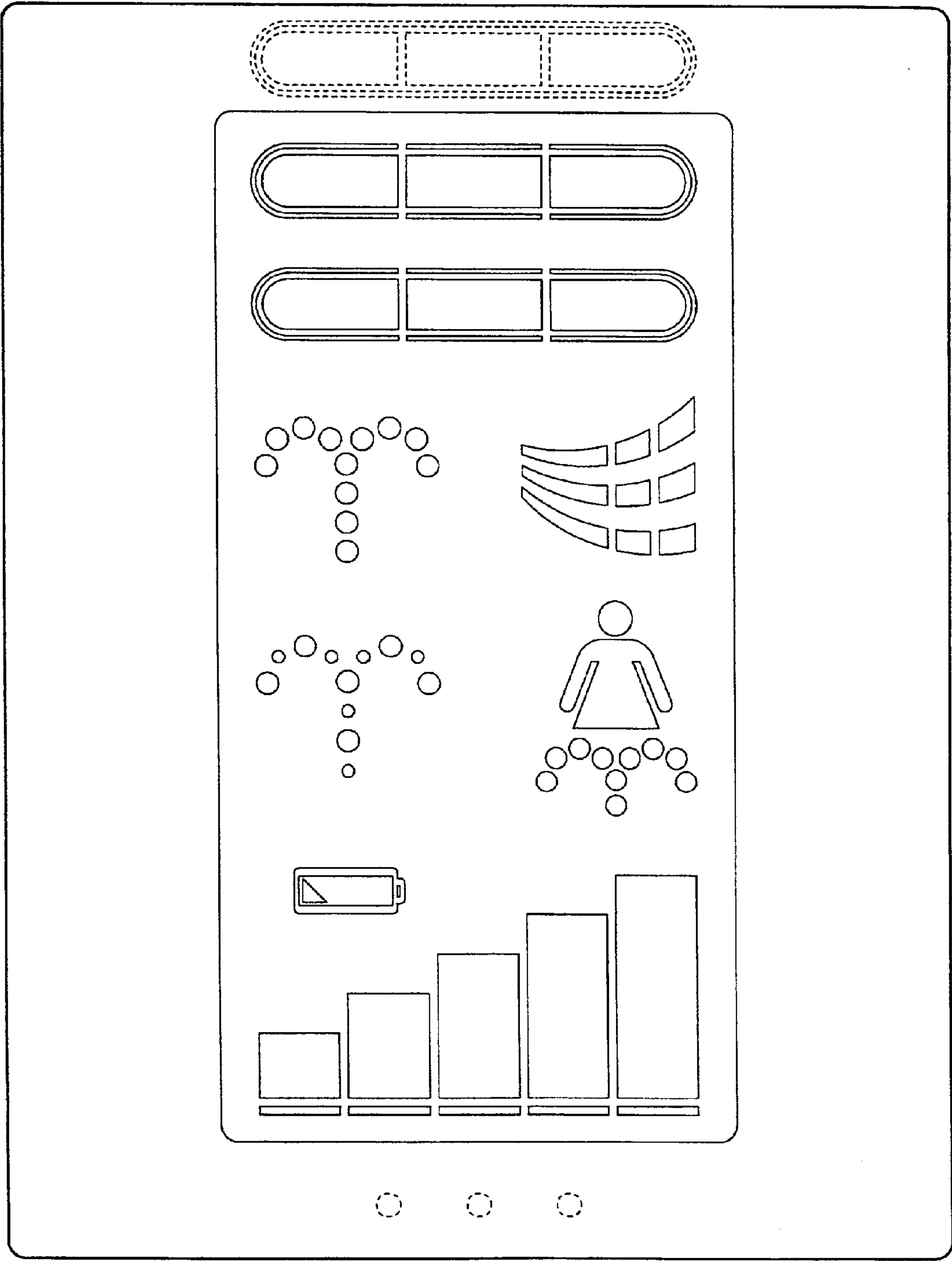

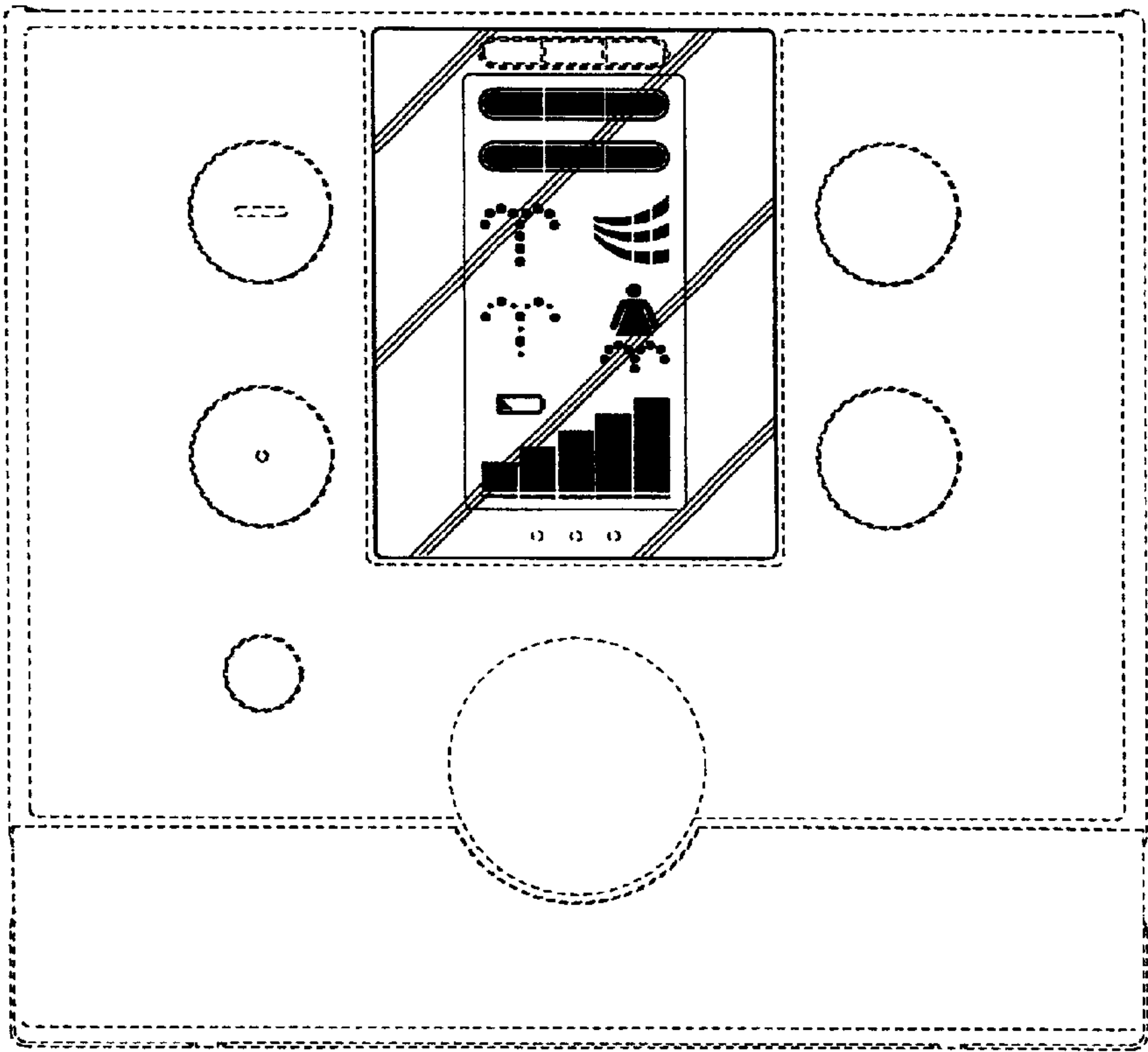
