DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pillow constructed in accordance with one embodiment of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a top view of the pillow shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the pillow shown in FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the pillow shown in FIGS. 1–3;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the pillow shown in FIGS. 1–4;

FIG. 6 is a left side view of the pillow shown in FIGS. 1–5;

FIG. 7 is a right side view of the pillow shown in FIGS. 1–6;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the pillow according to the present invention;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the embodiment of the pillow shown in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the embodiment of the pillow shown in FIGS. 8 and 9;

FIG. 11 is a front view of the embodiment of the pillow shown in FIGS. 8–10;

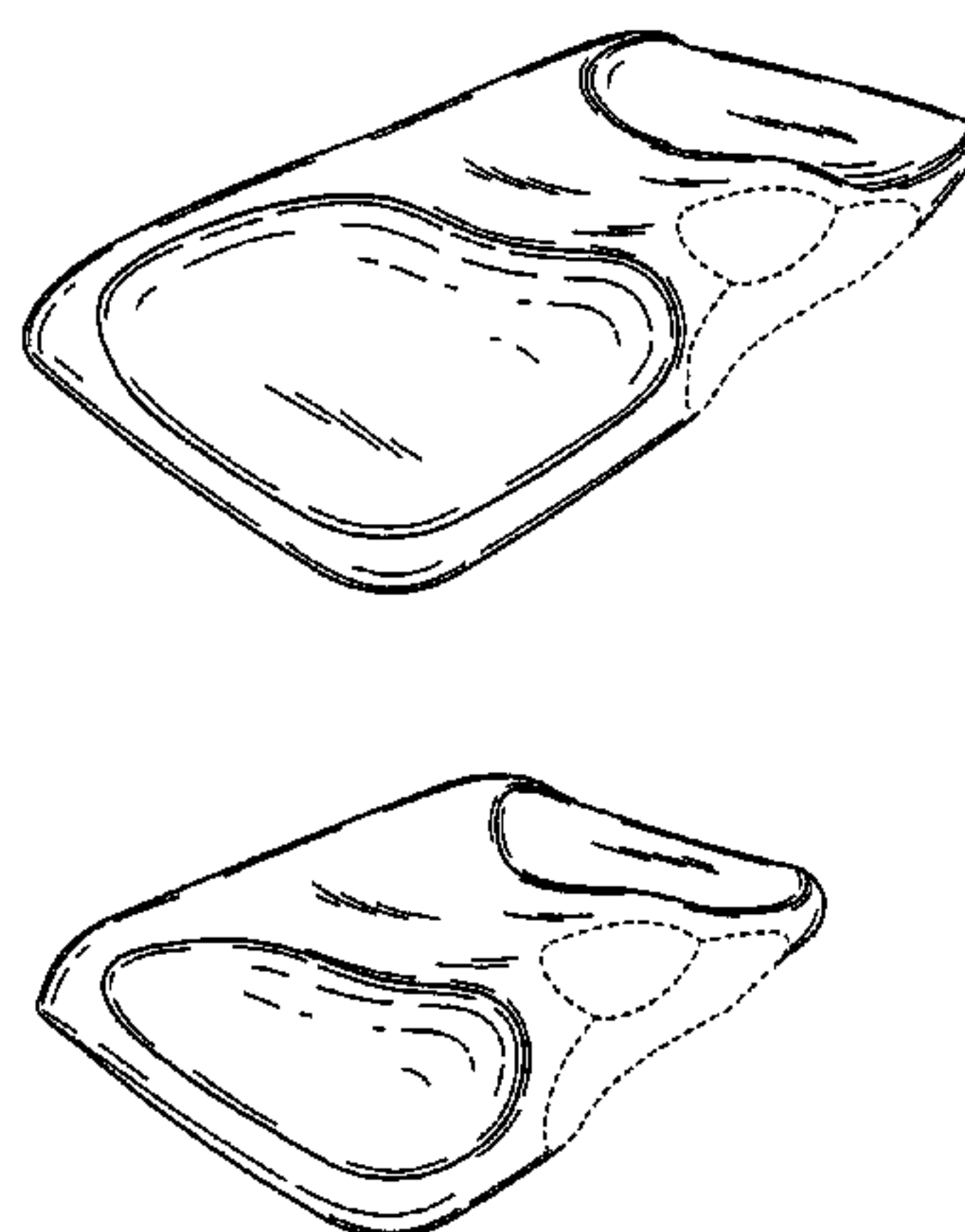
FIG. 12 is a rear view of the embodiment of the pillow shown in FIGS. 8–11;

FIG. 13 is a left side view of the embodiment of the pillow shown in FIGS. 8–12; and,

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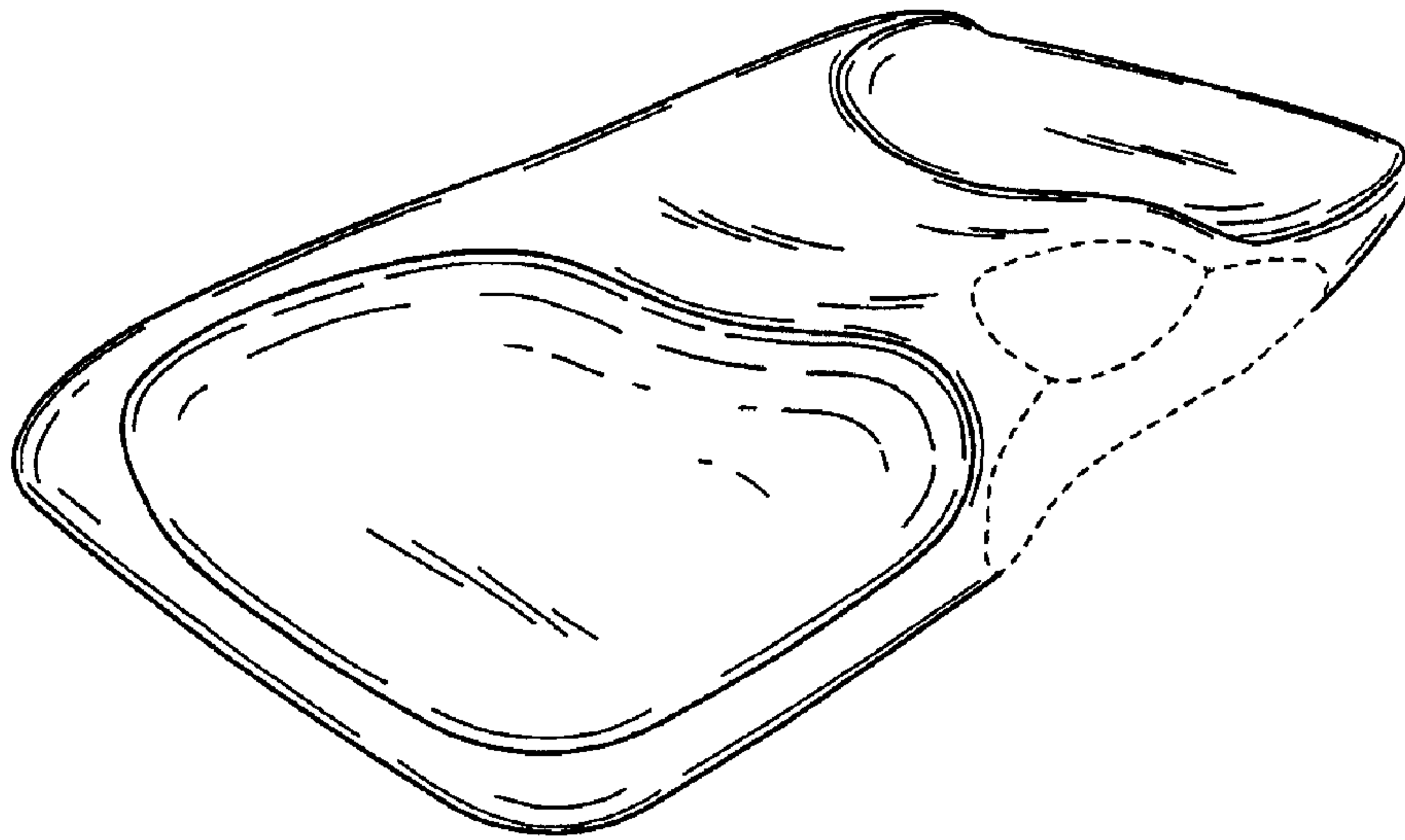

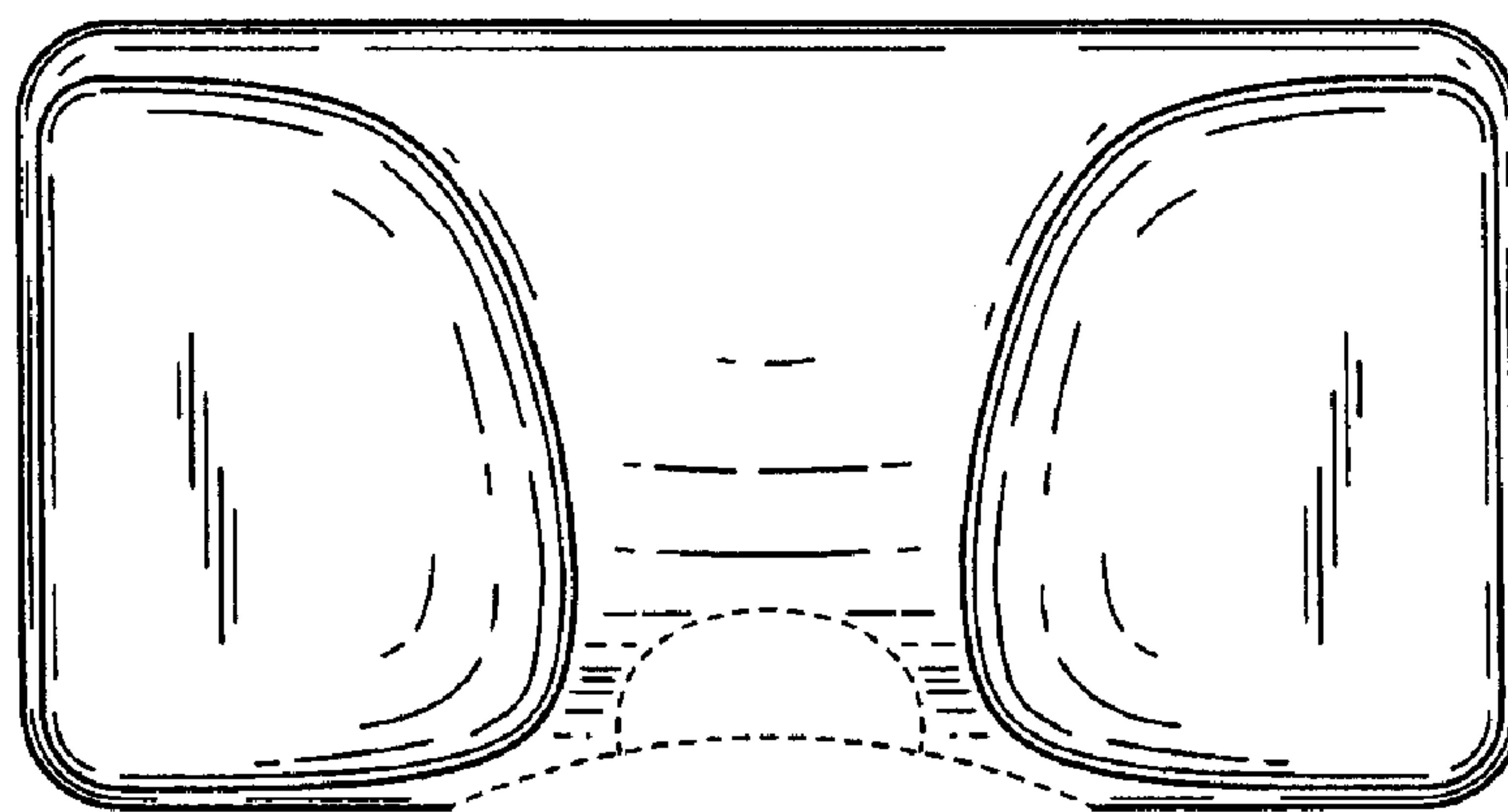

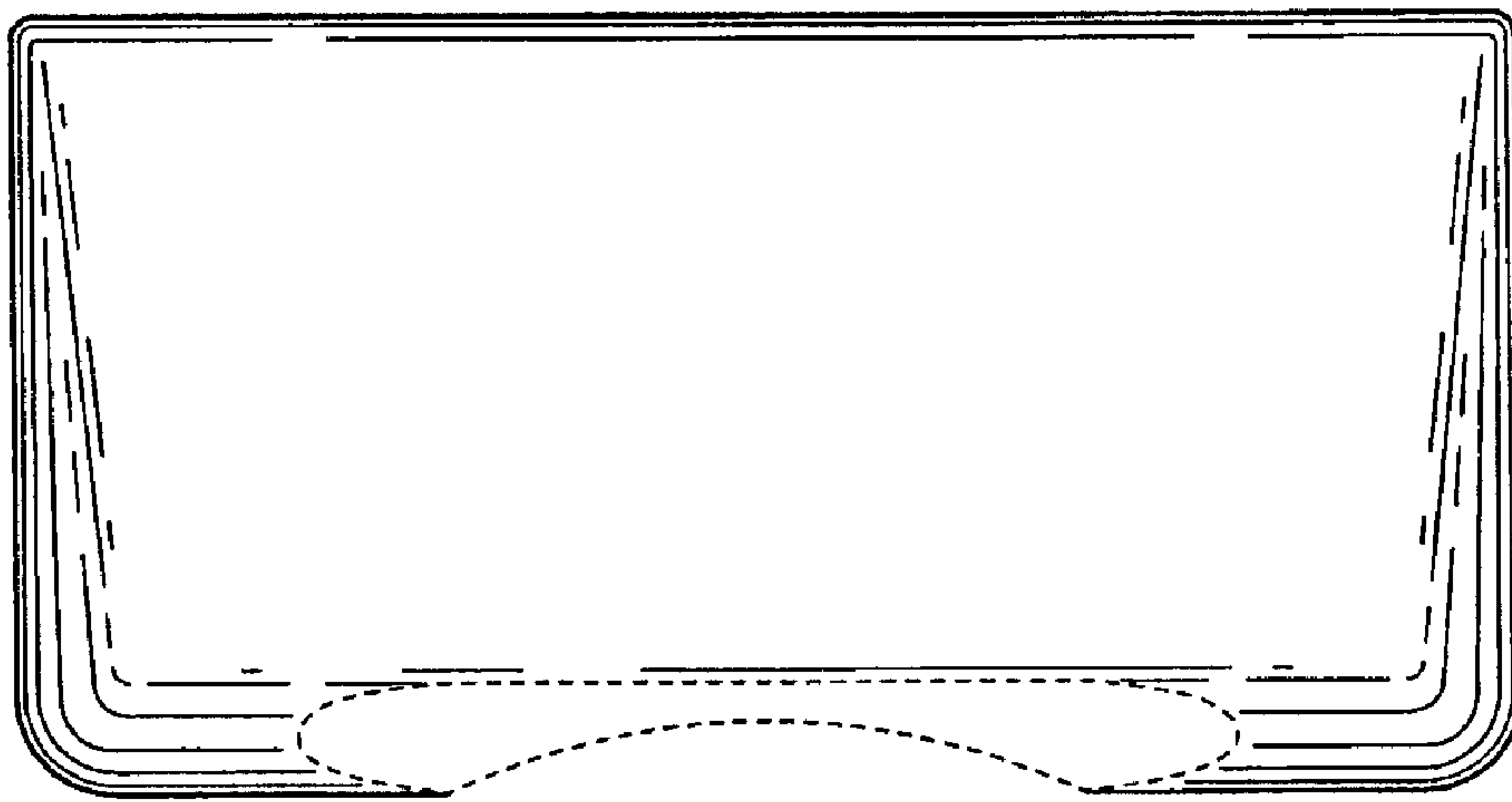

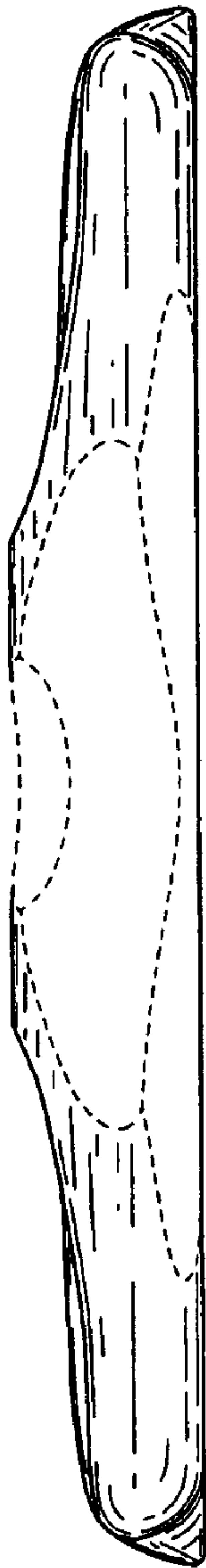

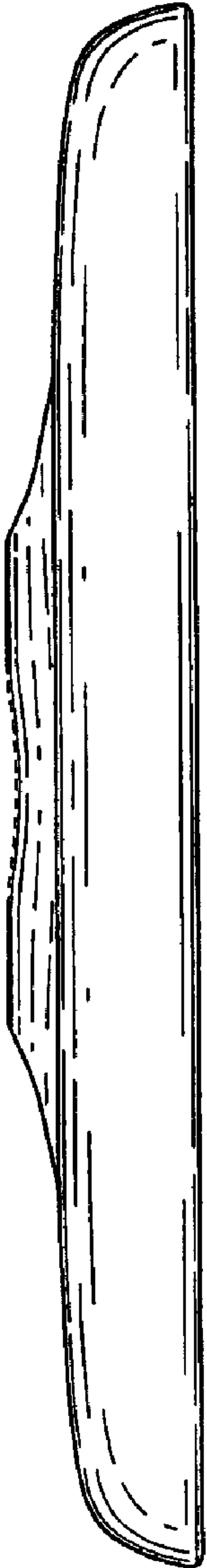

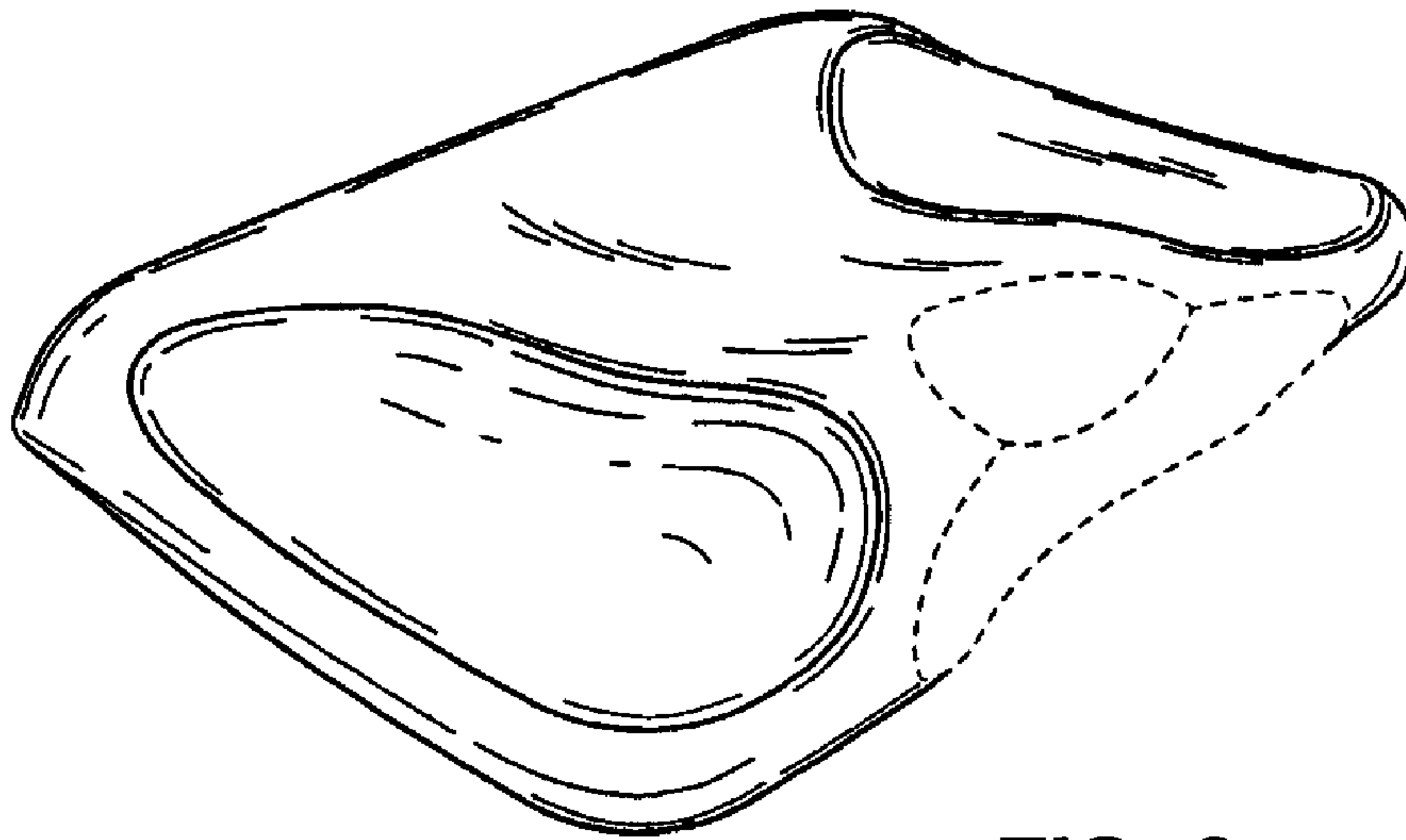

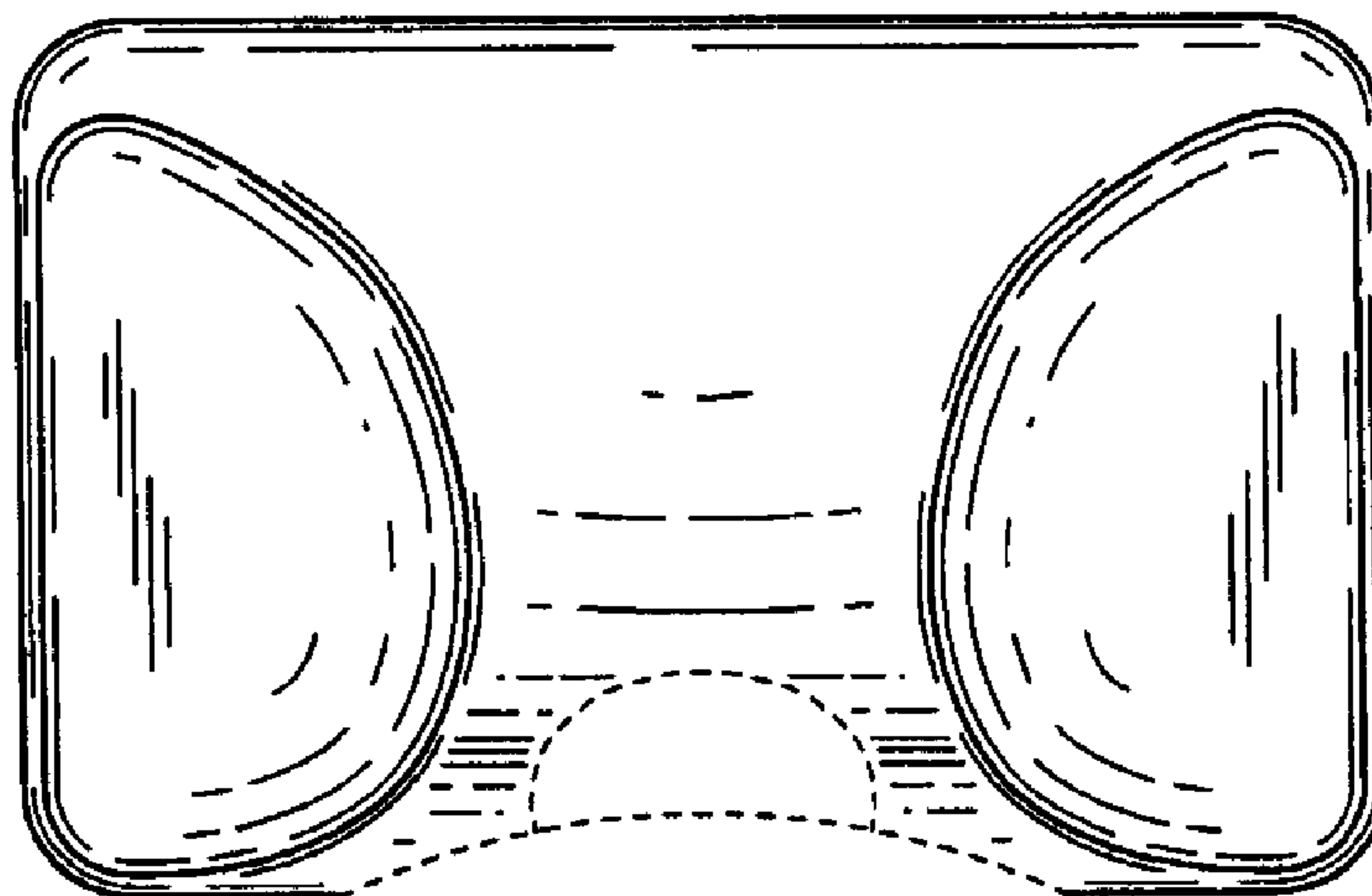

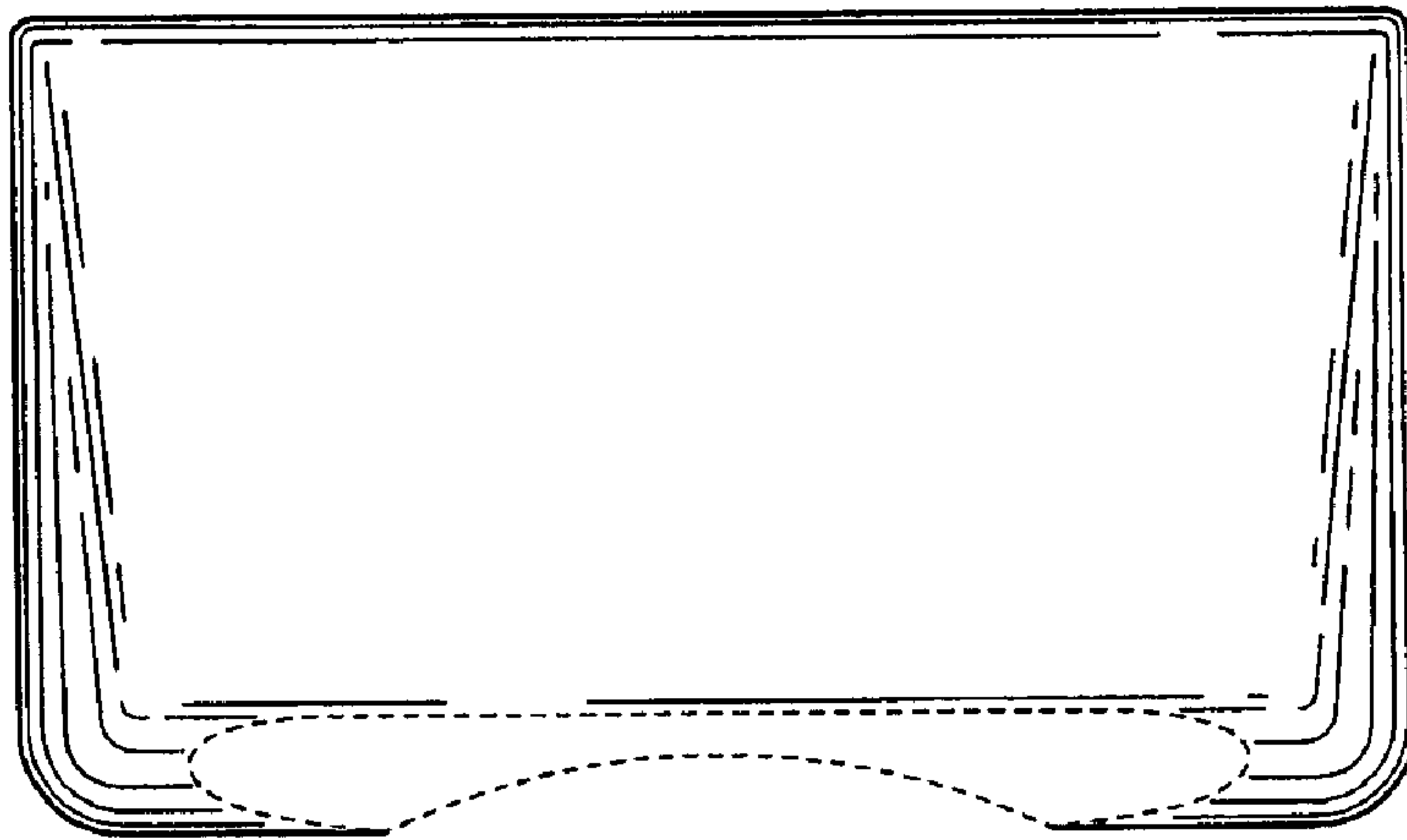

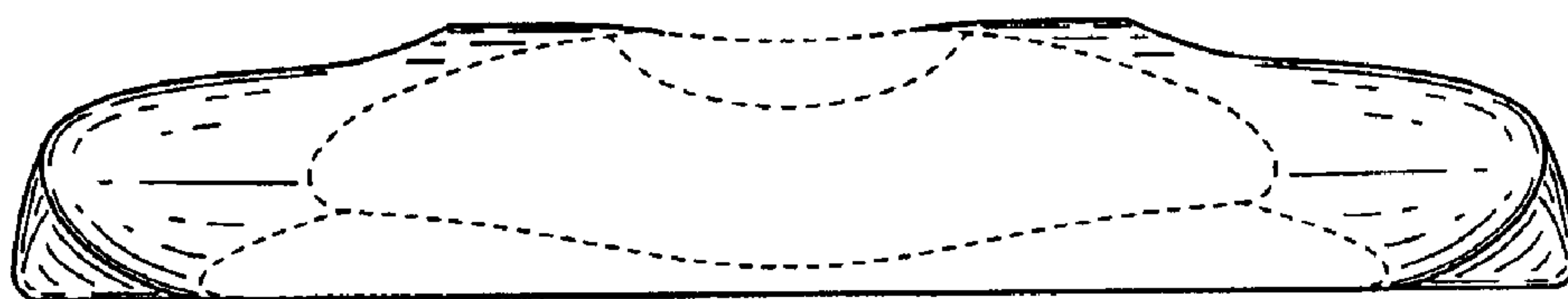

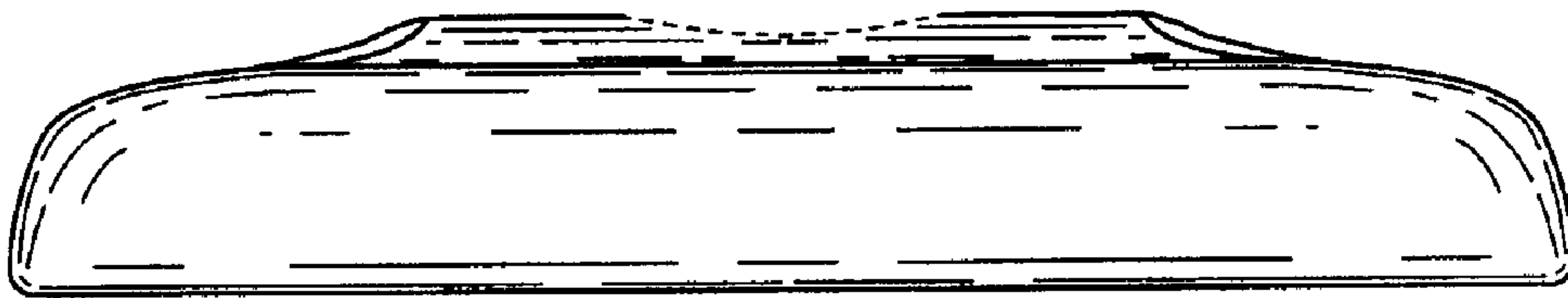

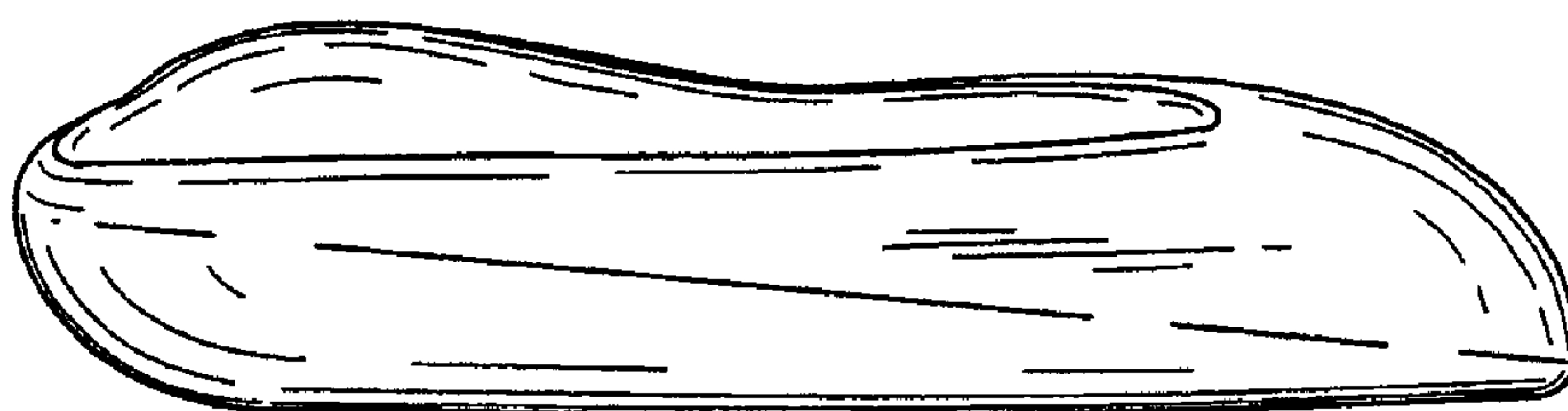
