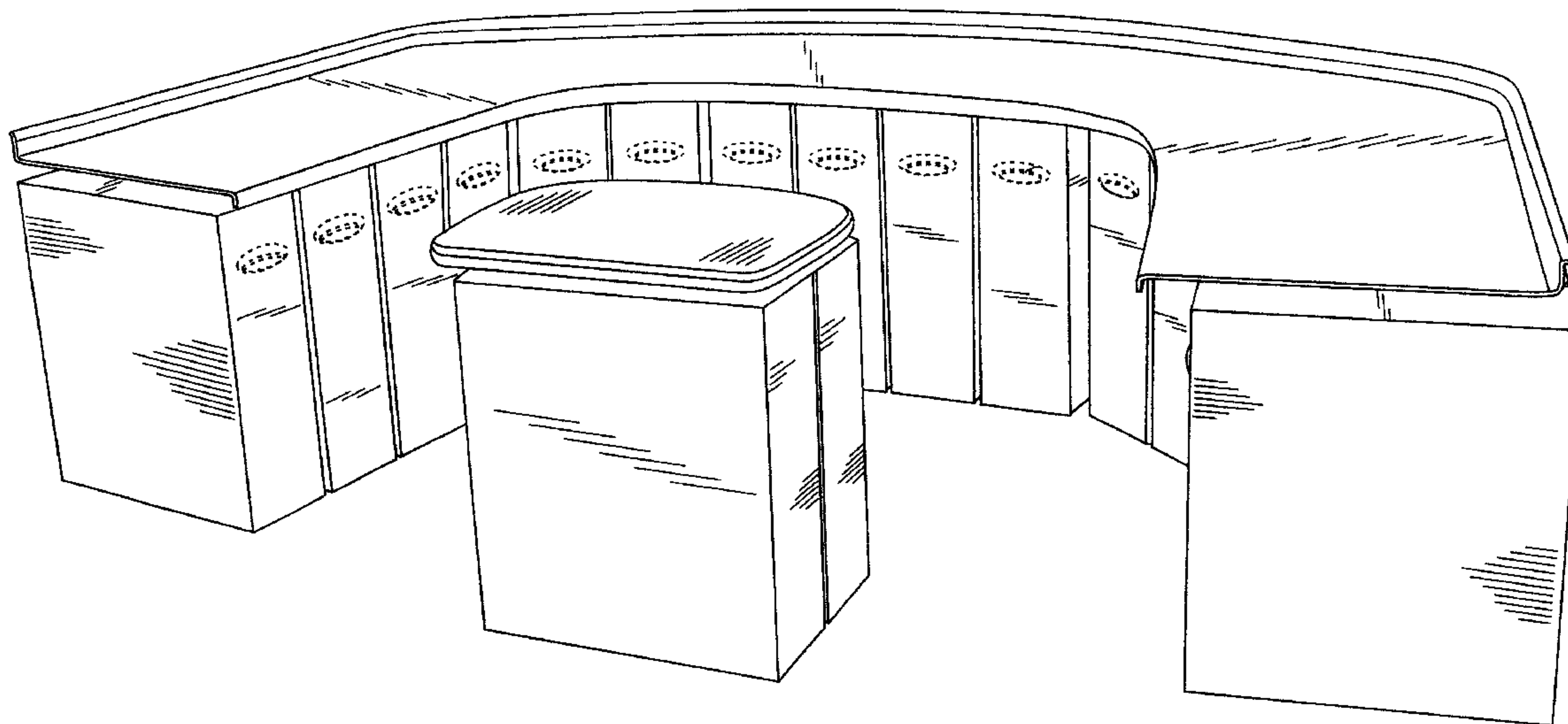
The ornamental design for an aircraft galley, as shown and described.

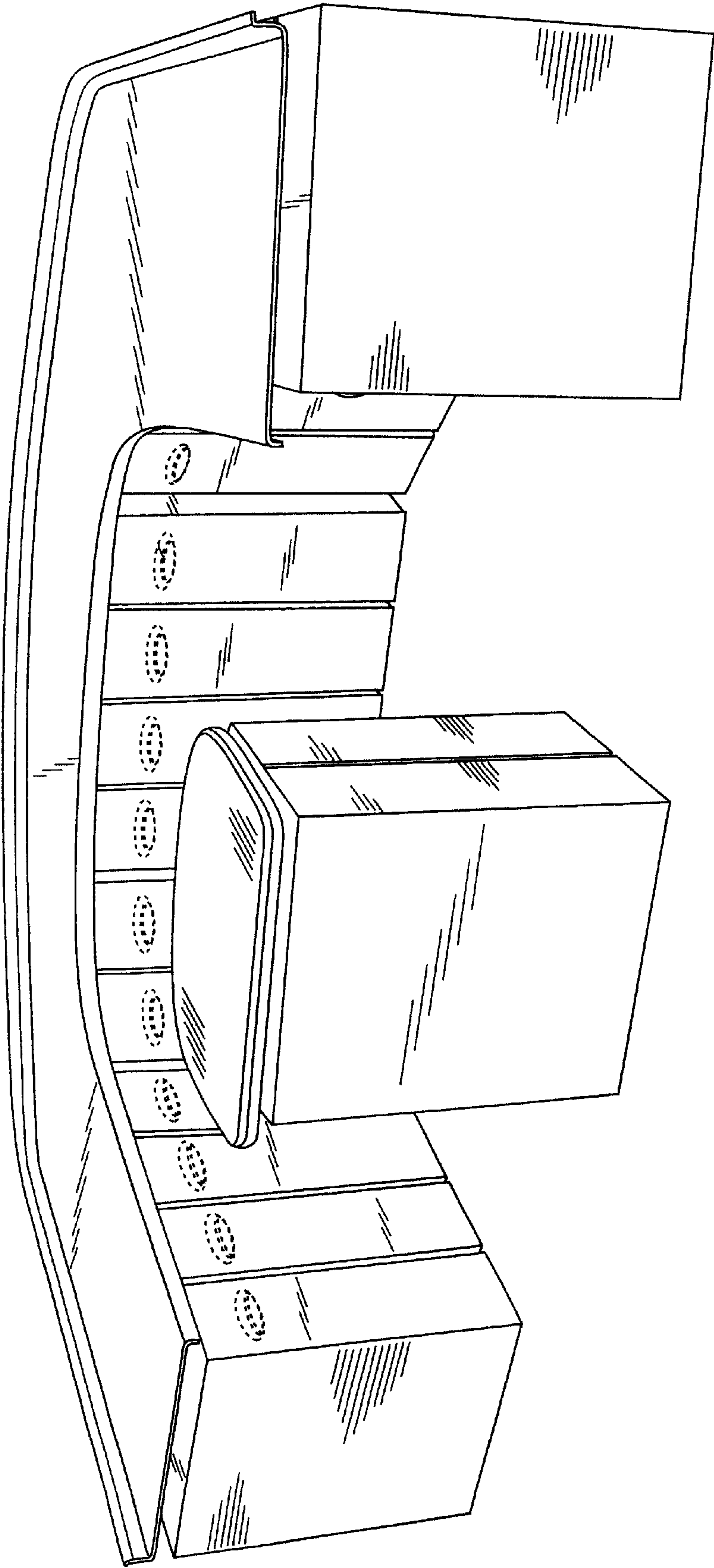

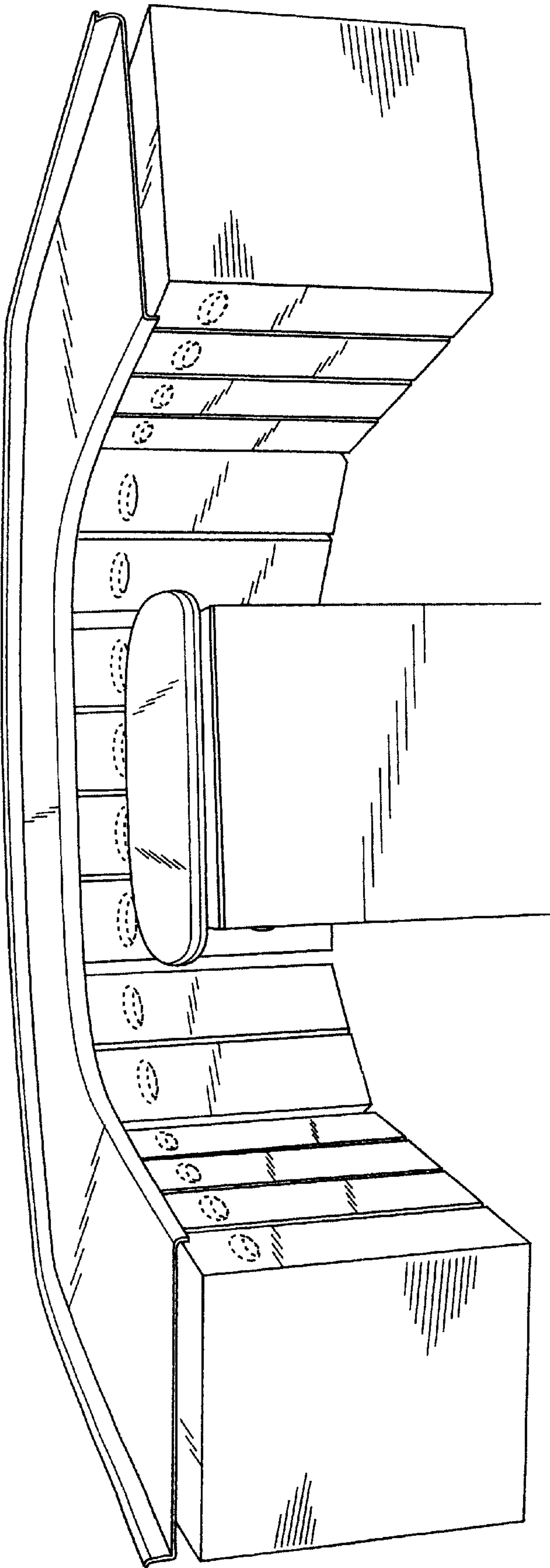
