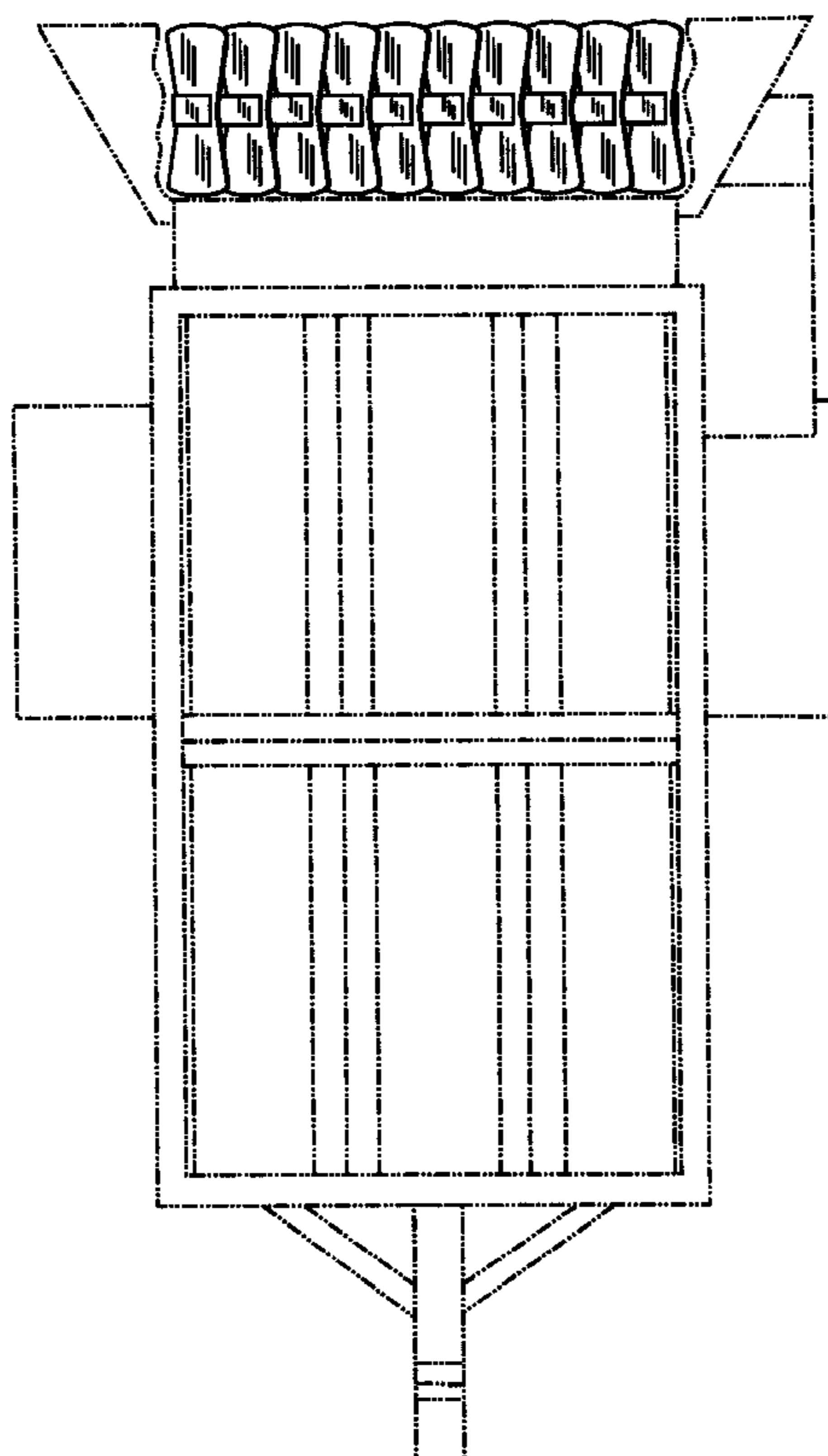
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a beater device for a material spreader, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a beater device for a material spreader showing my new design, the broken line showing of the material spreader is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, adjacent the forwardly positioned material spreader;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, opposite to that of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.

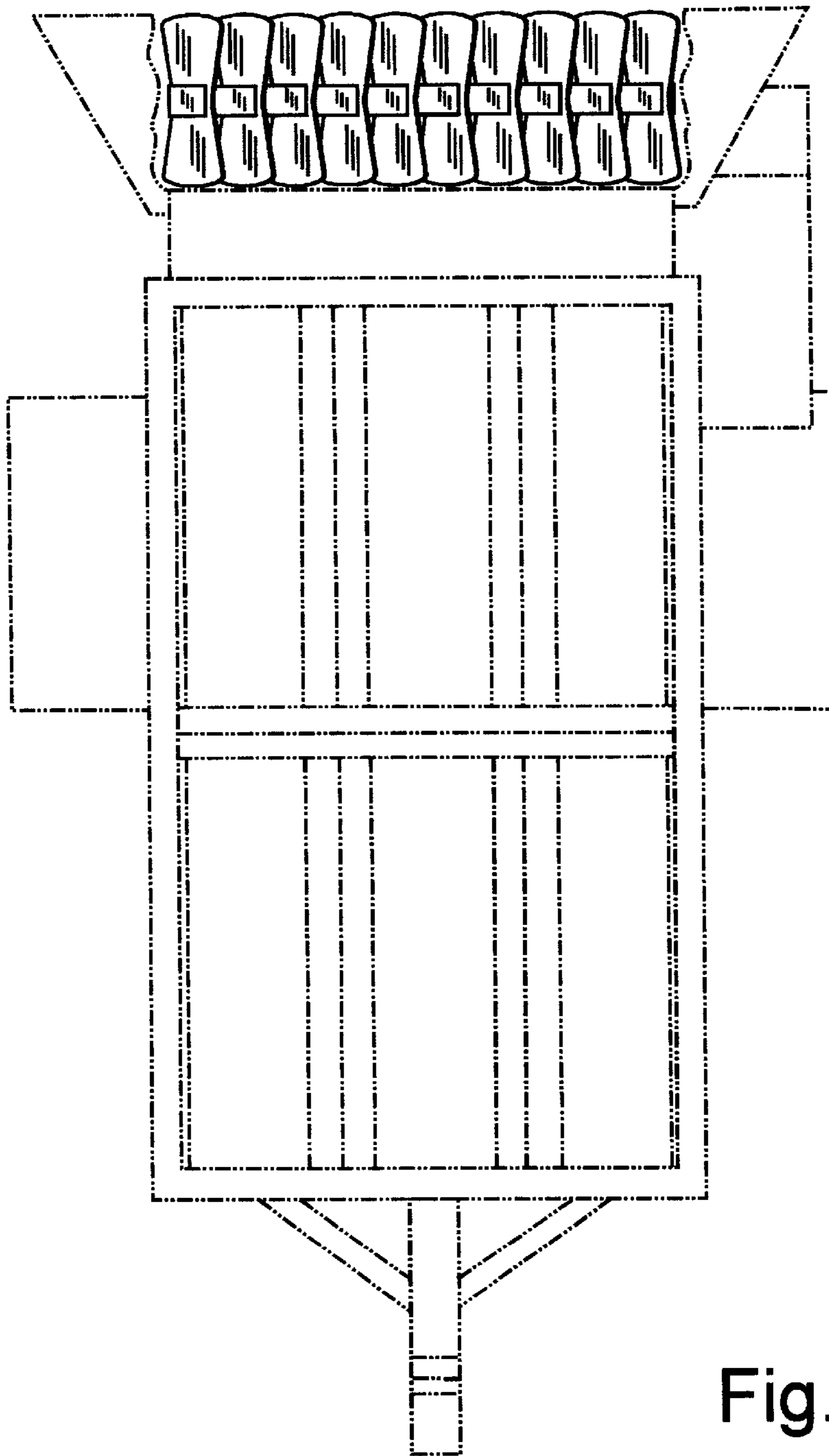

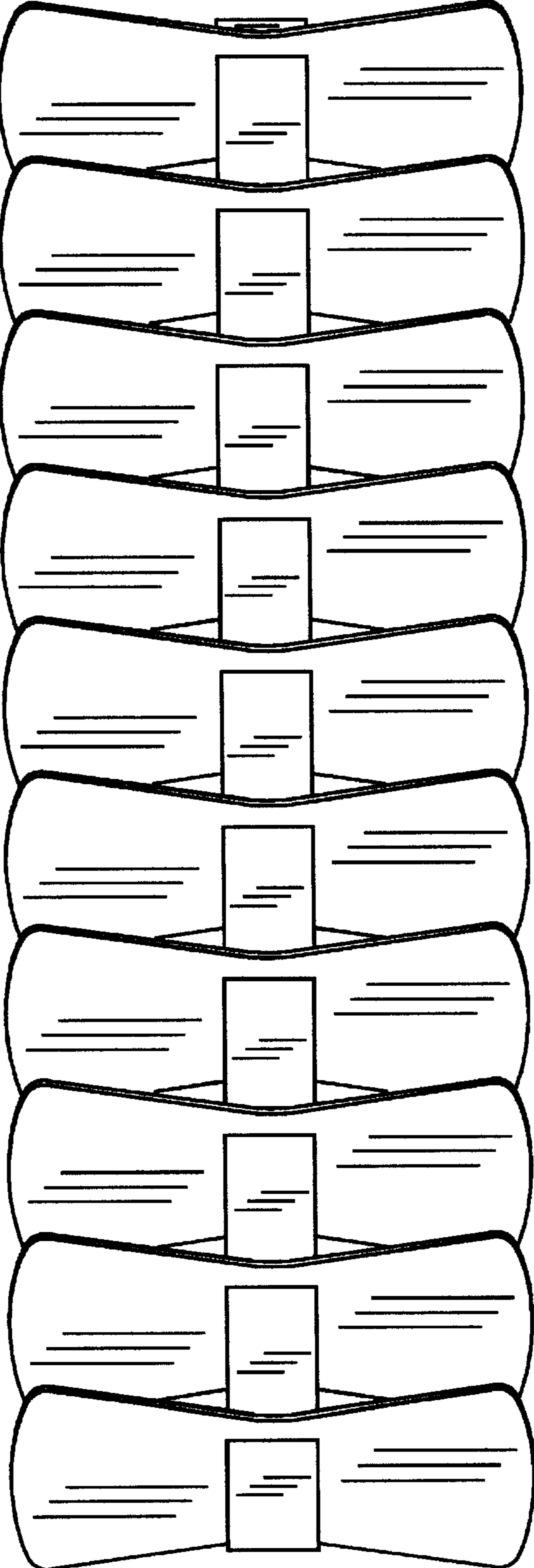

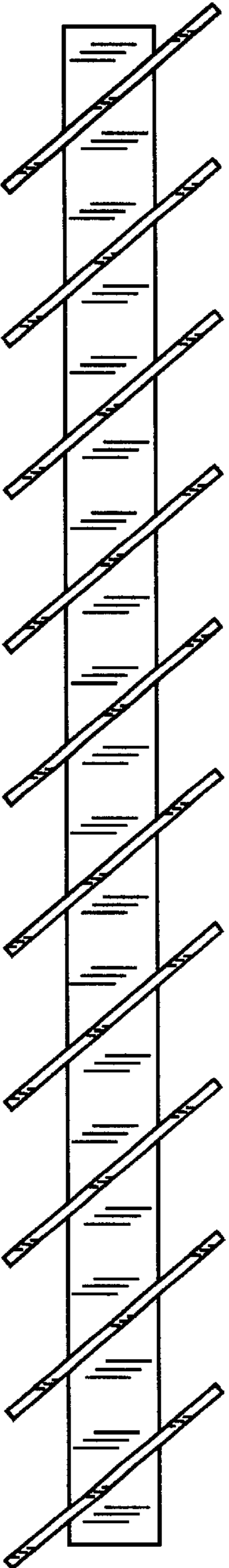
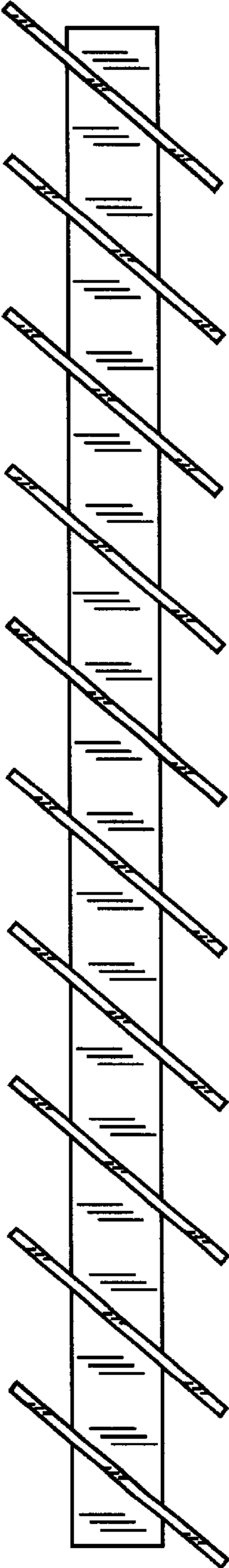

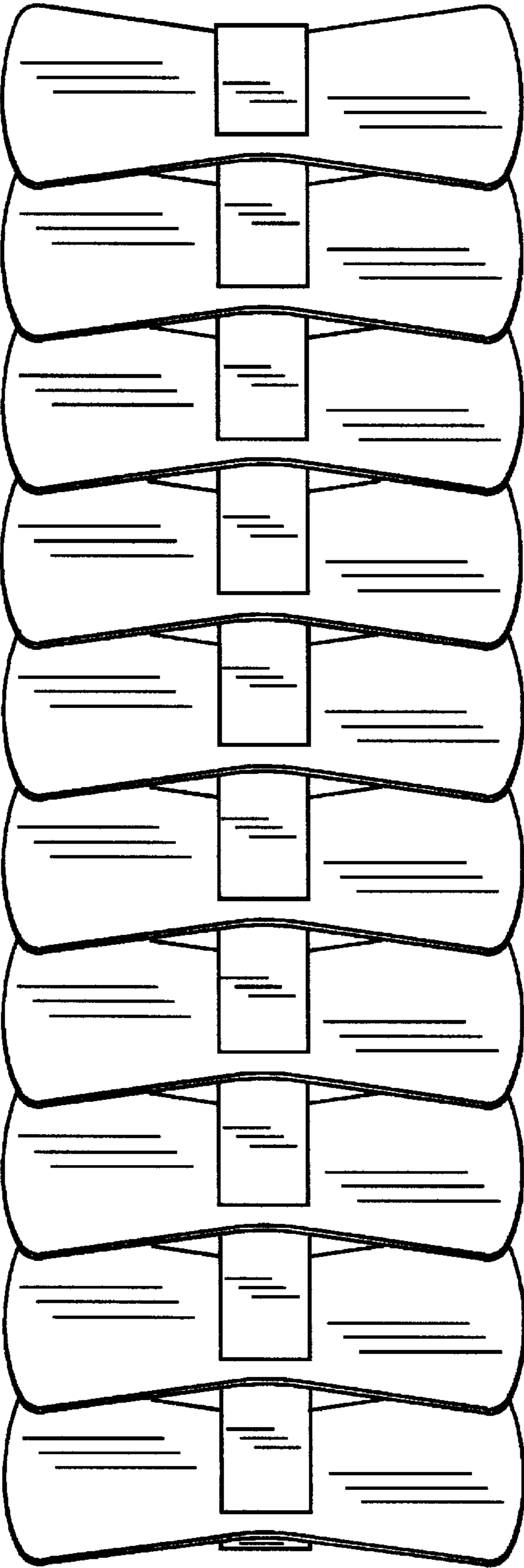

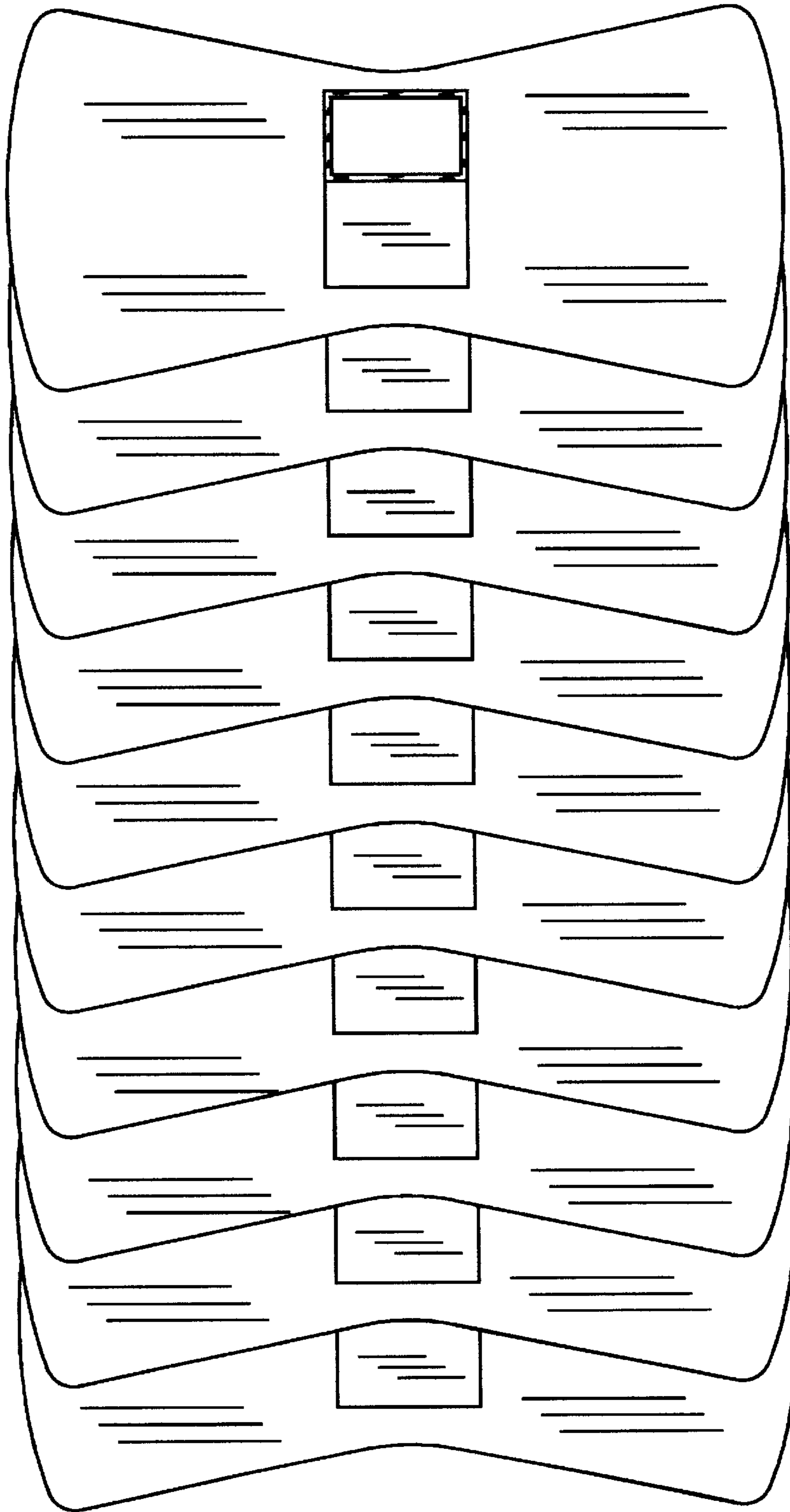
