(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a novelty noisemaker incorporating inflated stick and pennant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view showing my new design for a novelty noisemaker incorporating inflated stick and pennant, which is a mirror image of the rear elevational view;

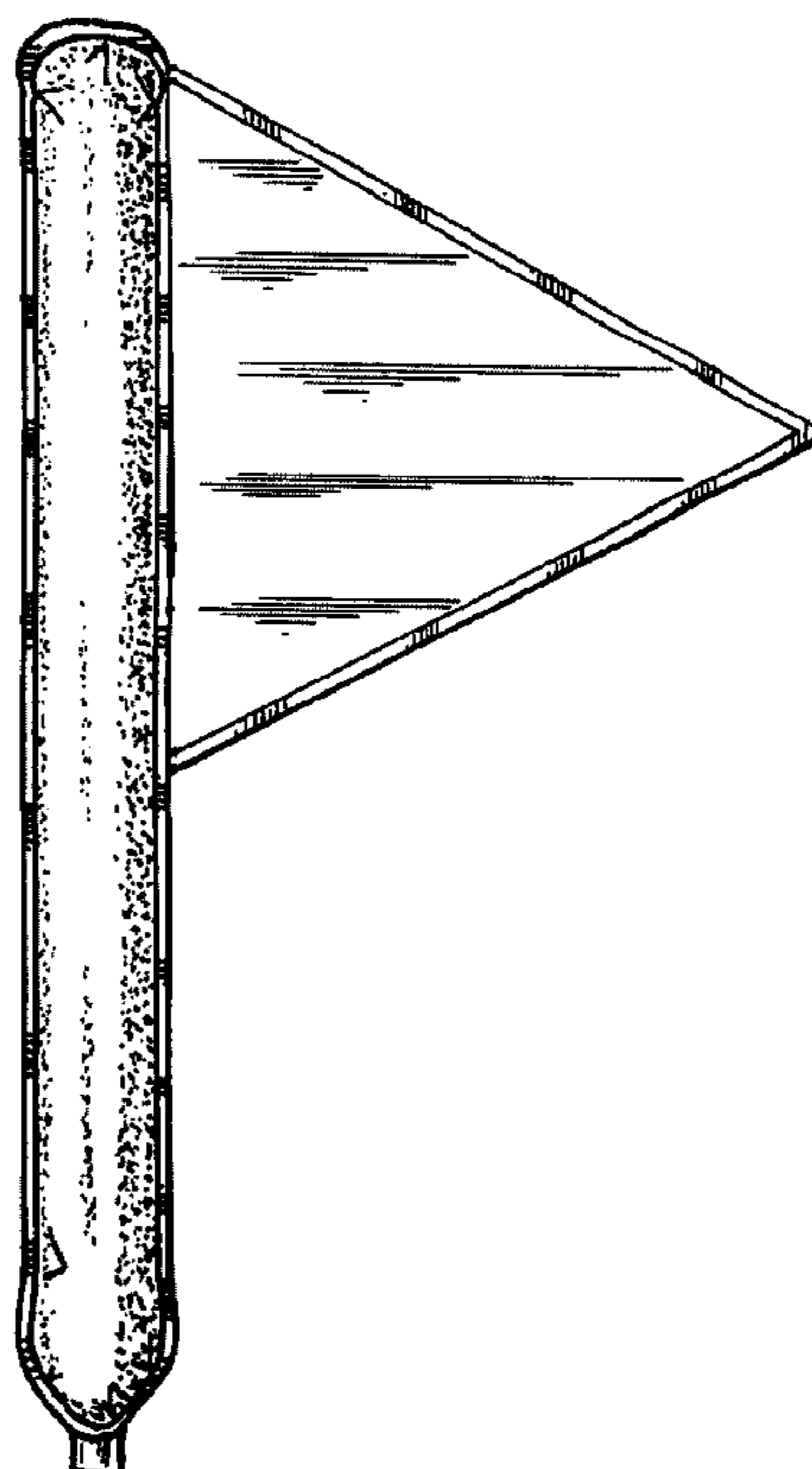
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

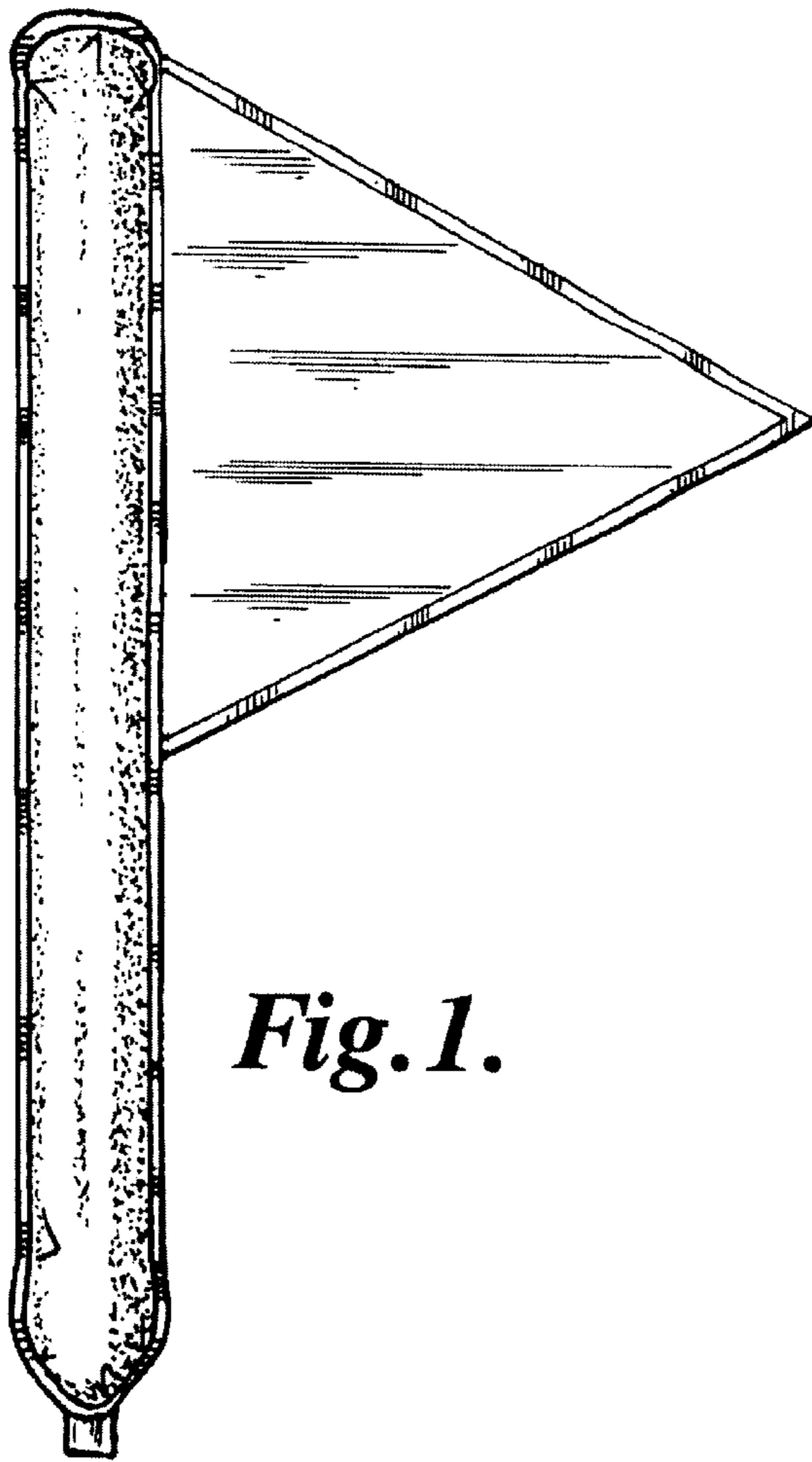

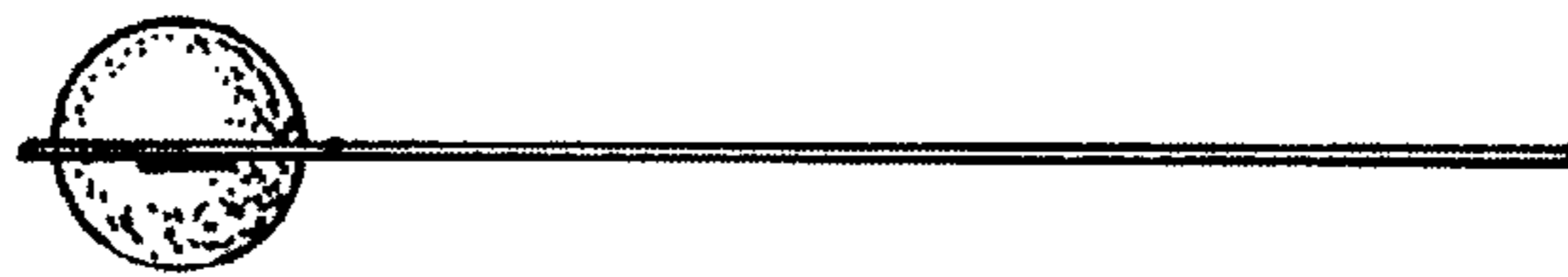
