The back and external sides of the vehicle mat or liner into which my design is incorporated are unadorned and form no portion of the claimed design.

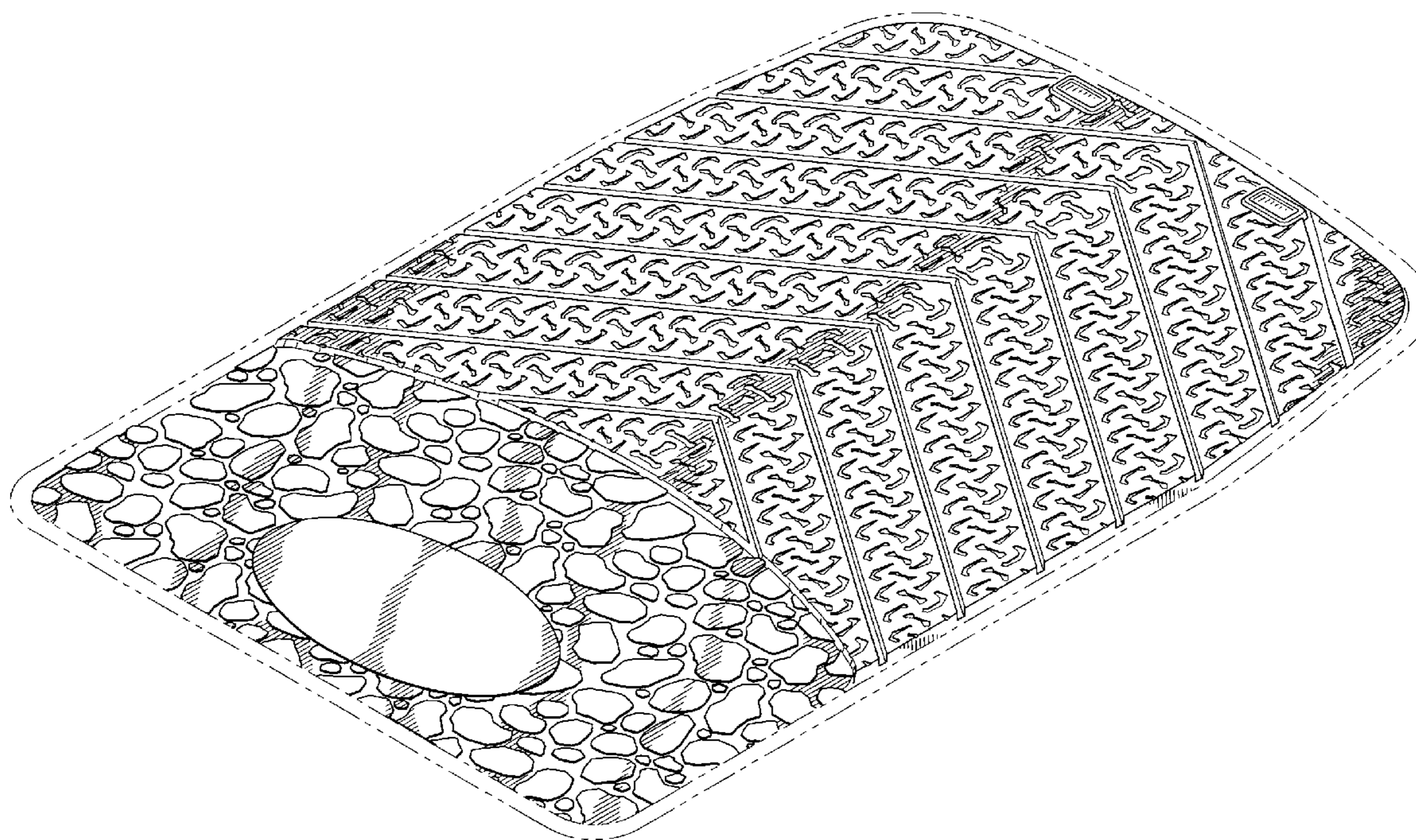

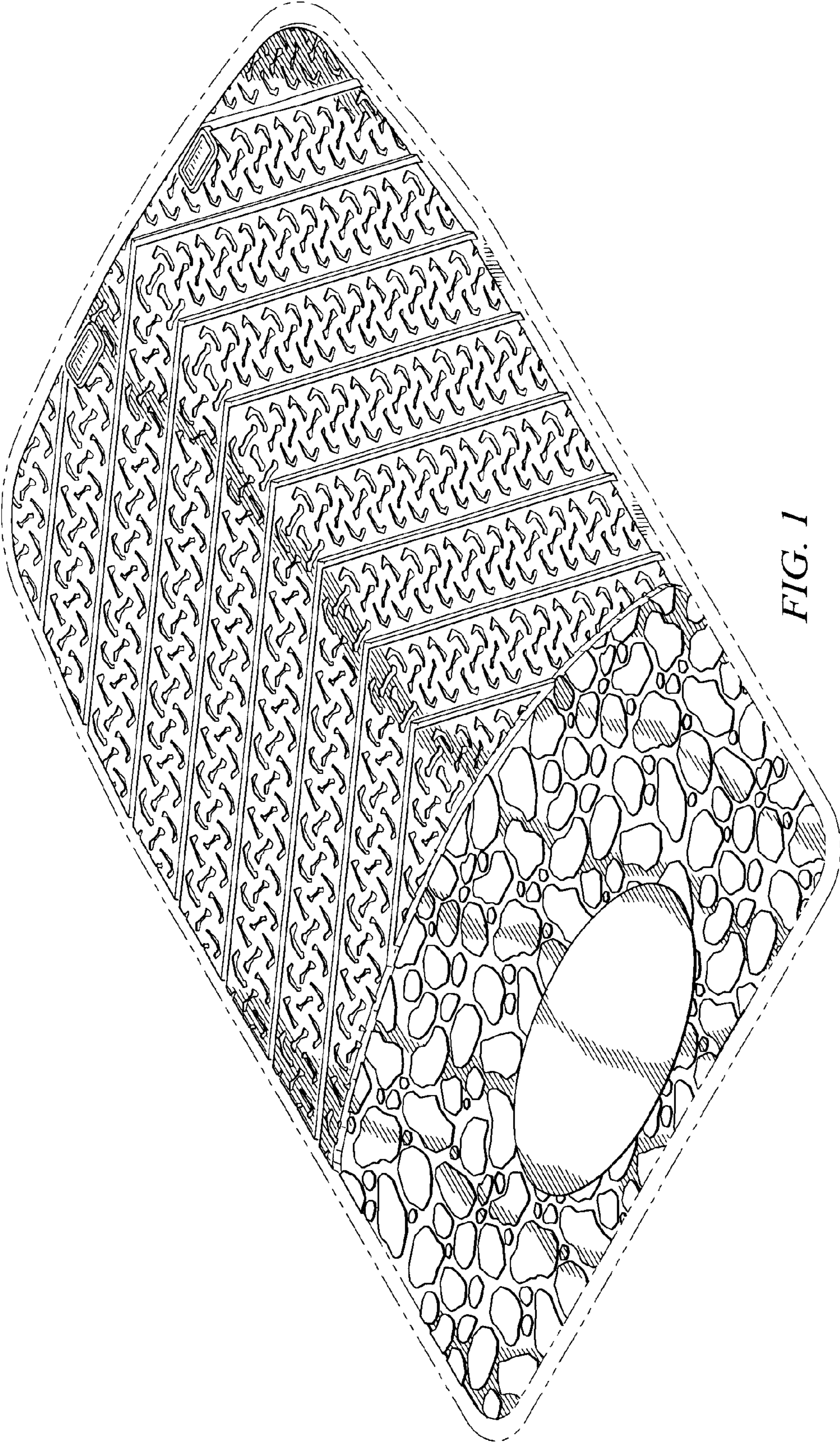

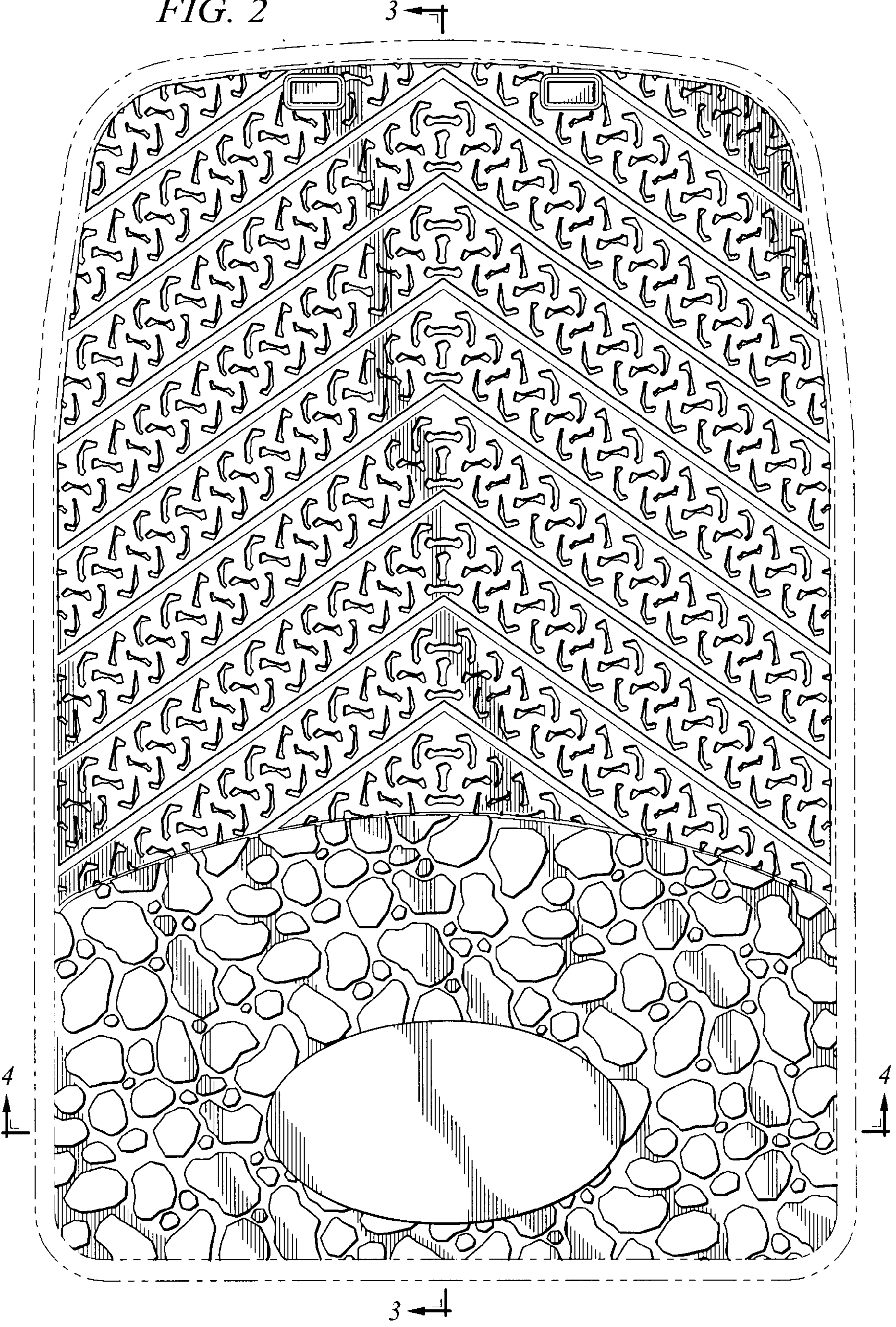
