FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

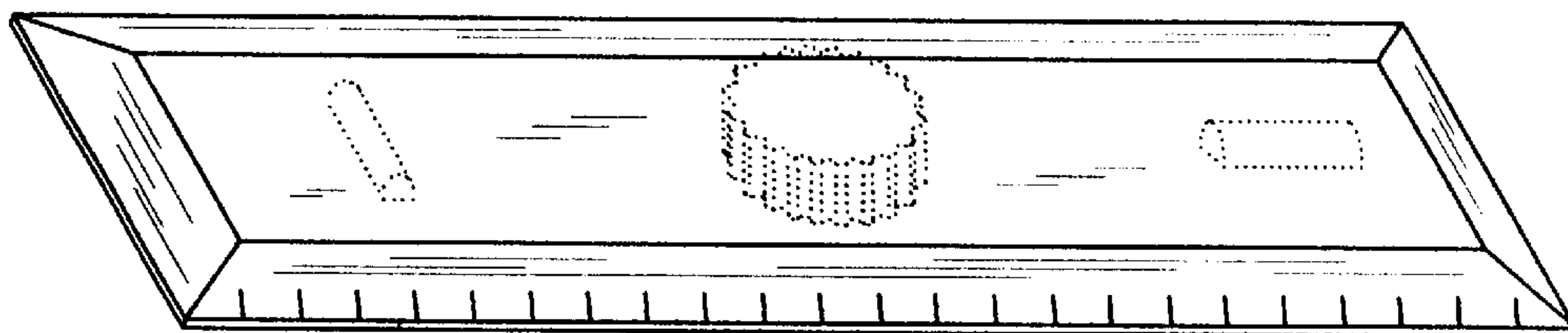
FIG. 3 is an elevational end view of FIG. 2, the opposite end being identical thereof;

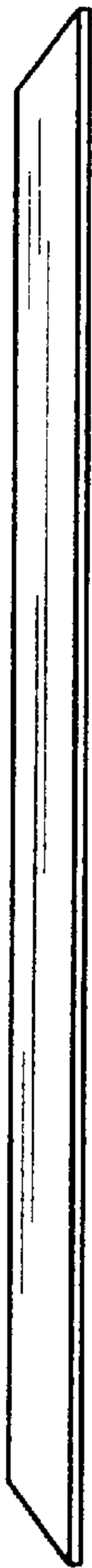

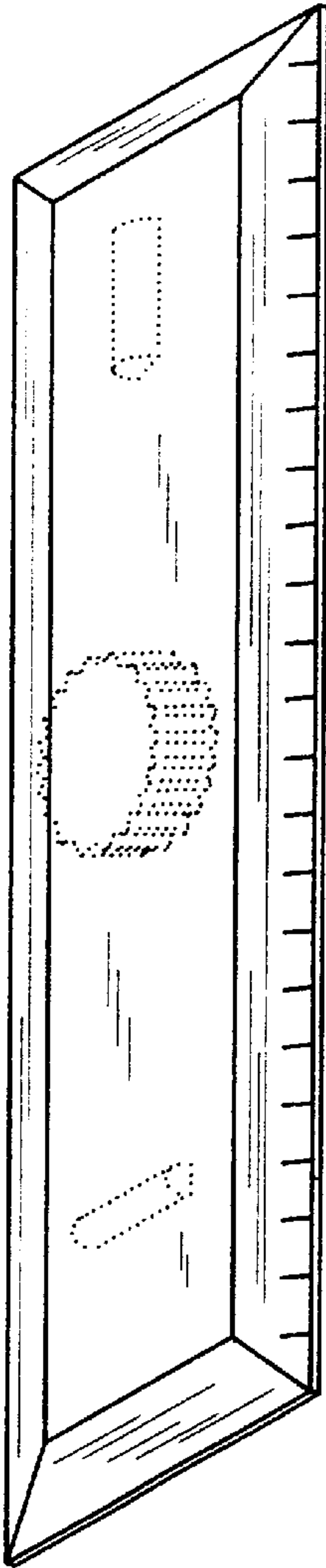

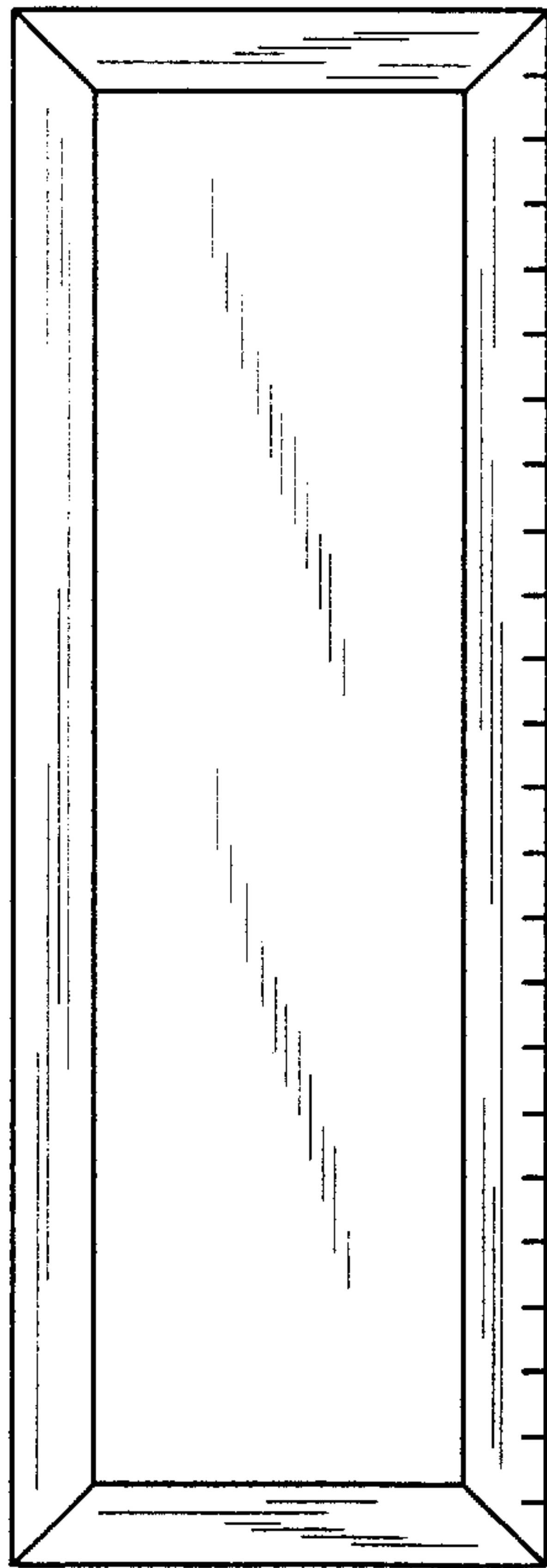
