FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;

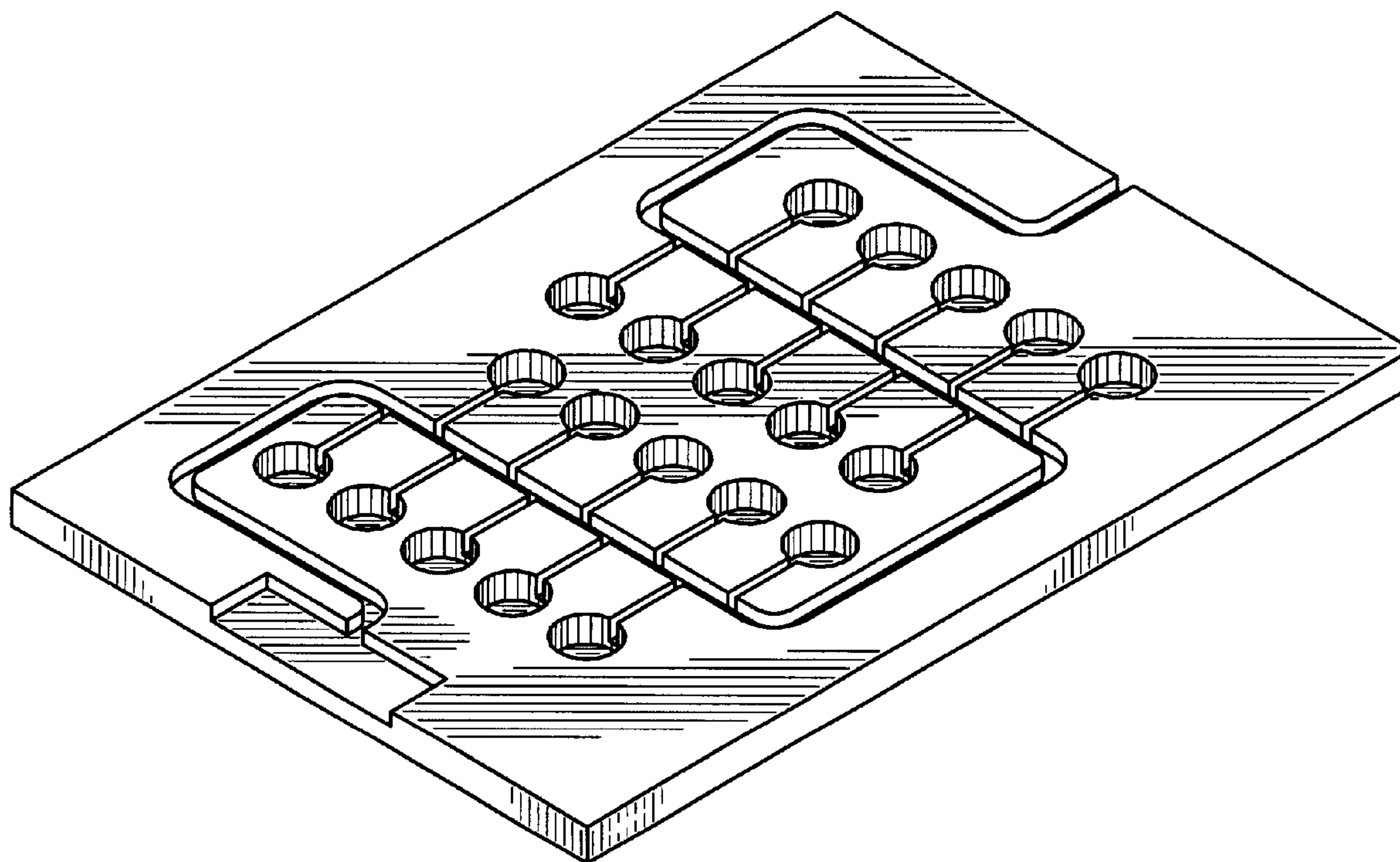
FIG. 4 is a cross section view taken along line 4—4 thereof;

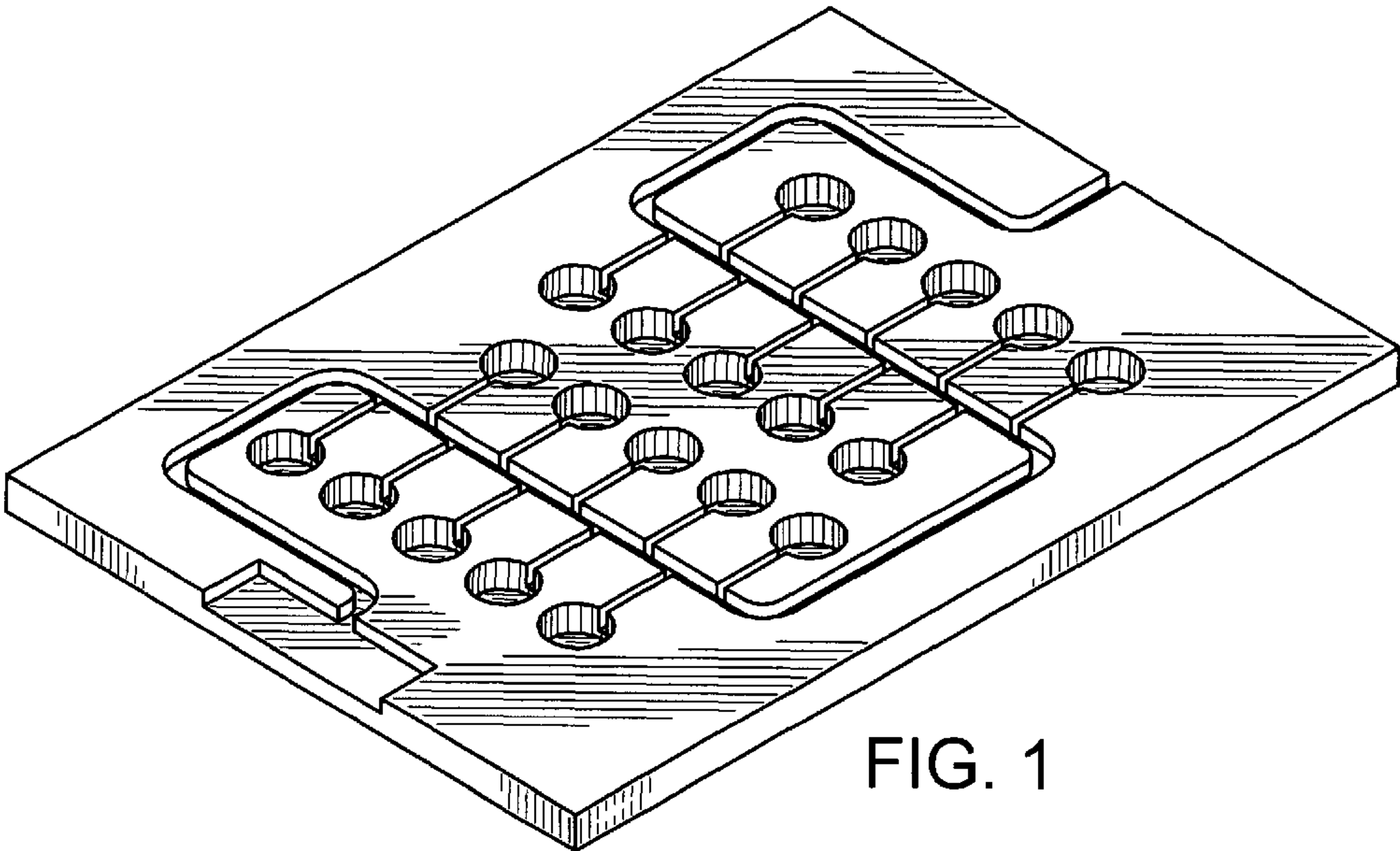

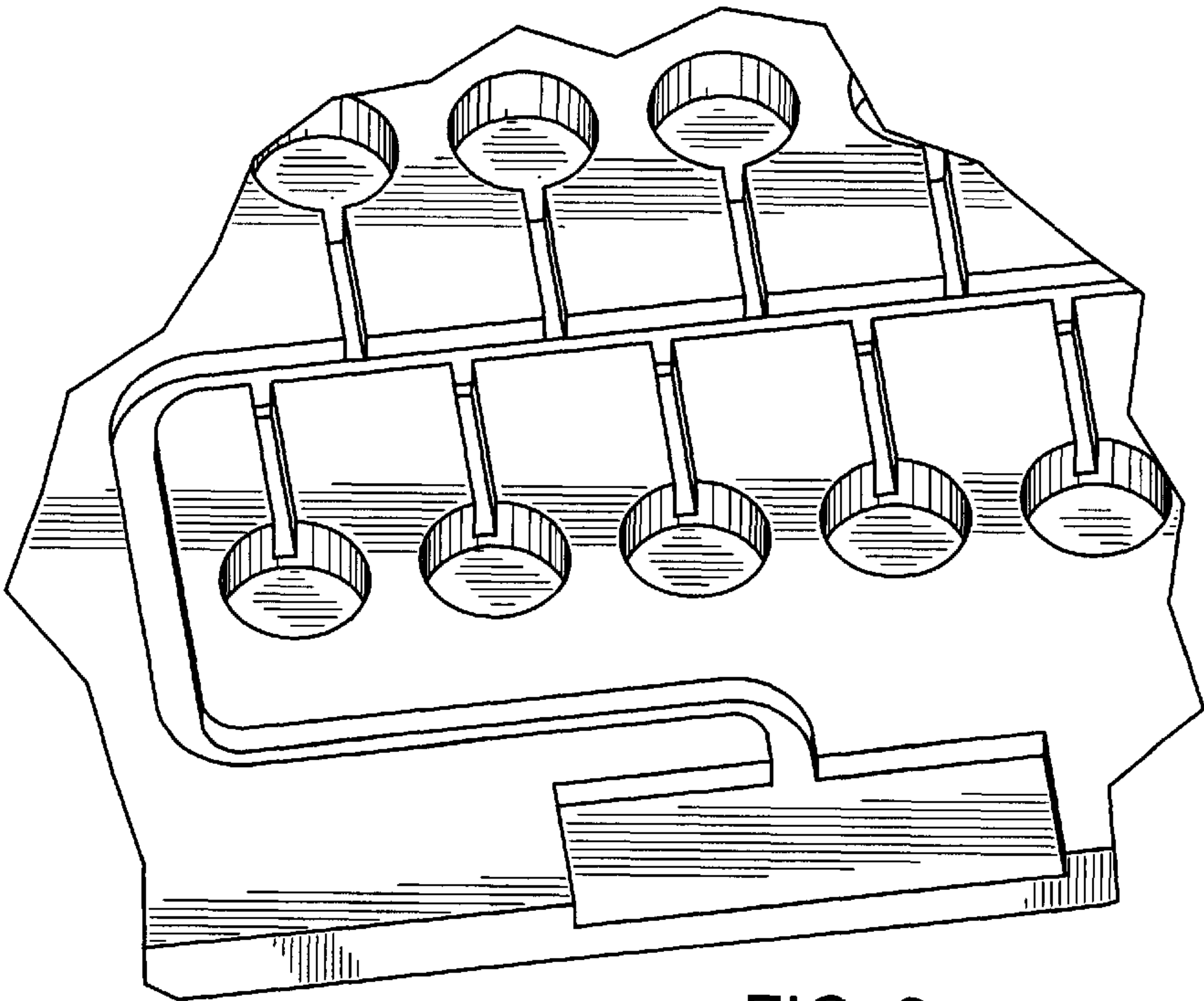

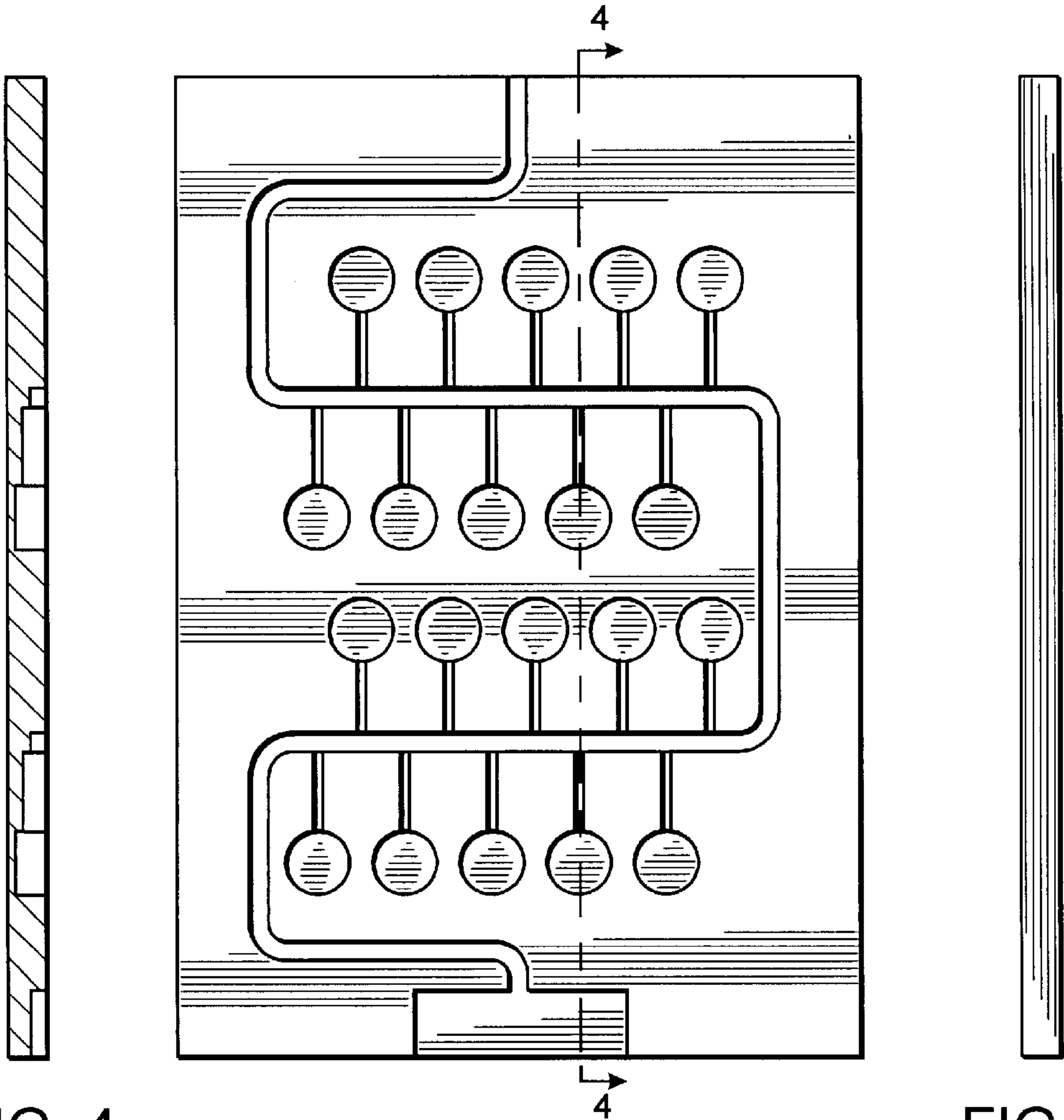
