(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sleeping bag kit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the assembled sleeping bag kit, the opposite view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the sleeping bag kit of FIG. 1 in an open configuration and with the ties removed for ease of disclosure, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view of the sleeping bag kit of FIG. 2.

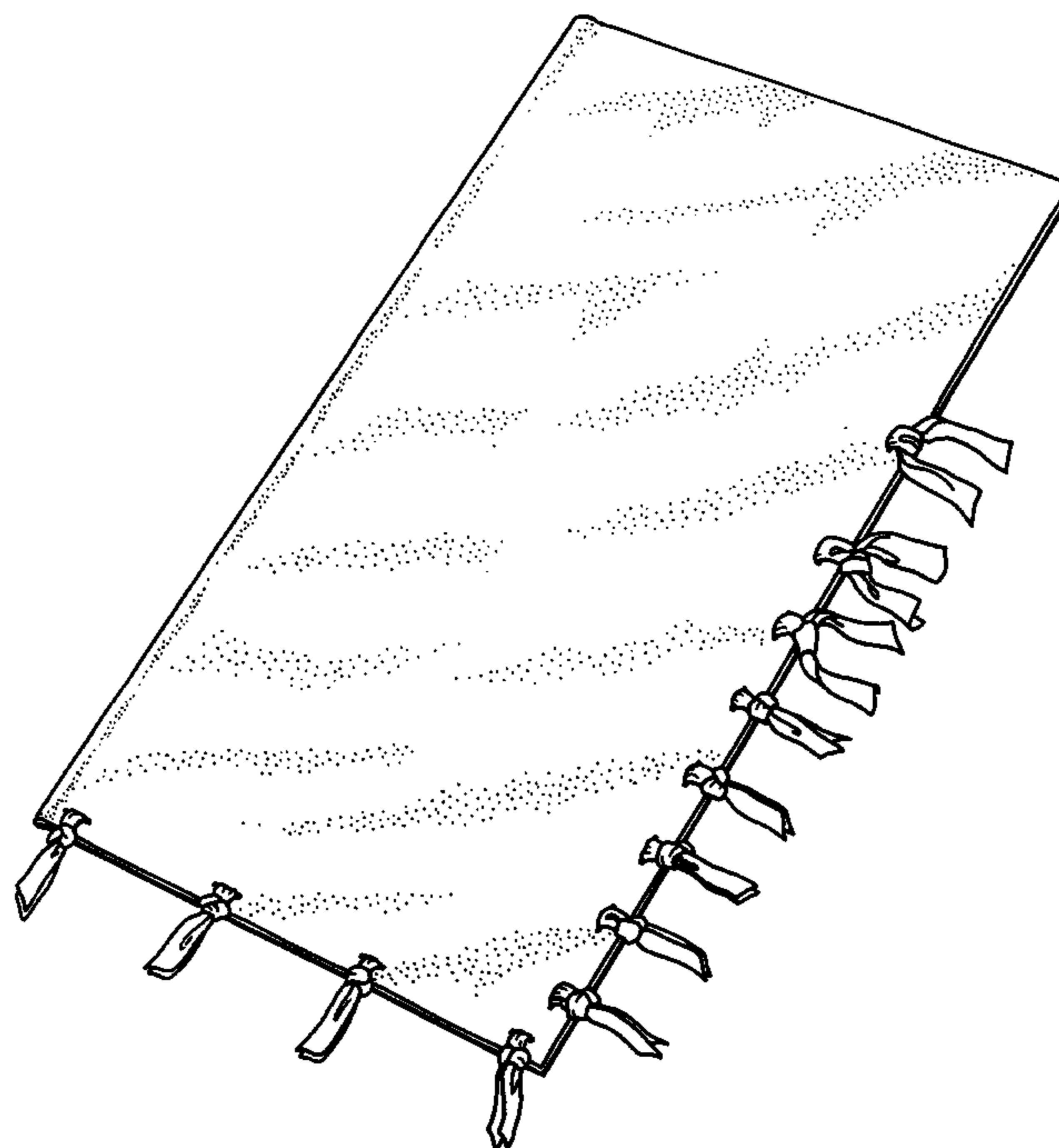

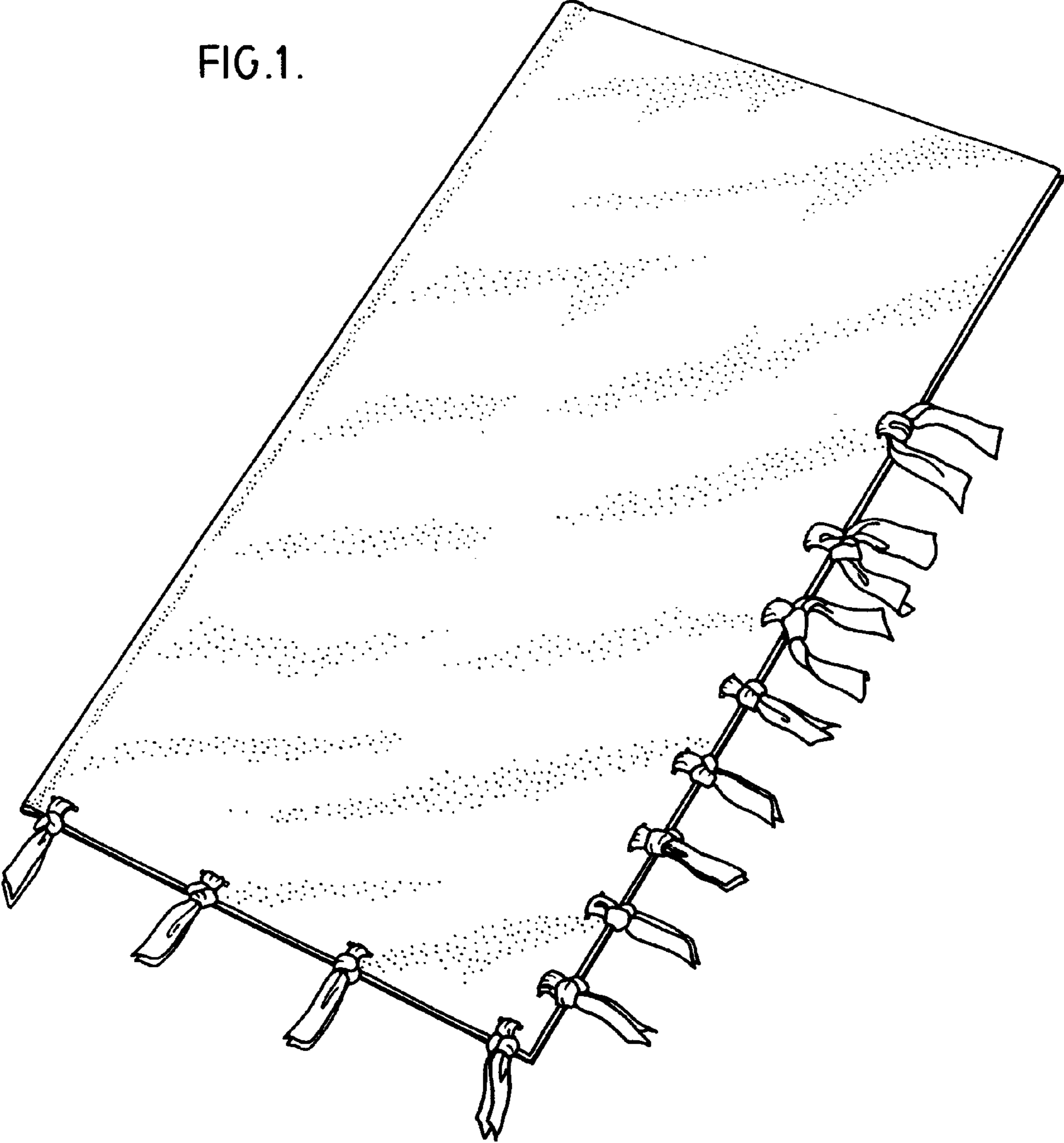
